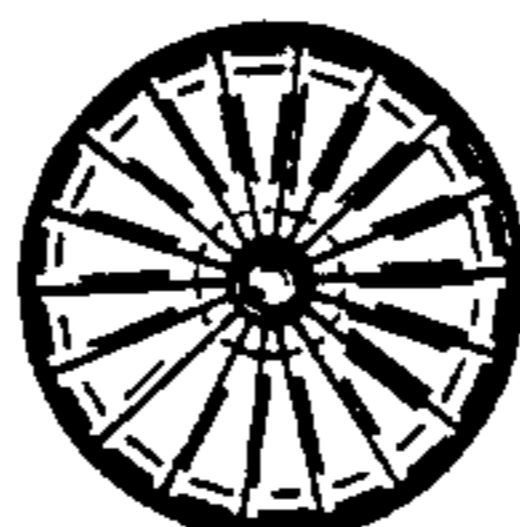
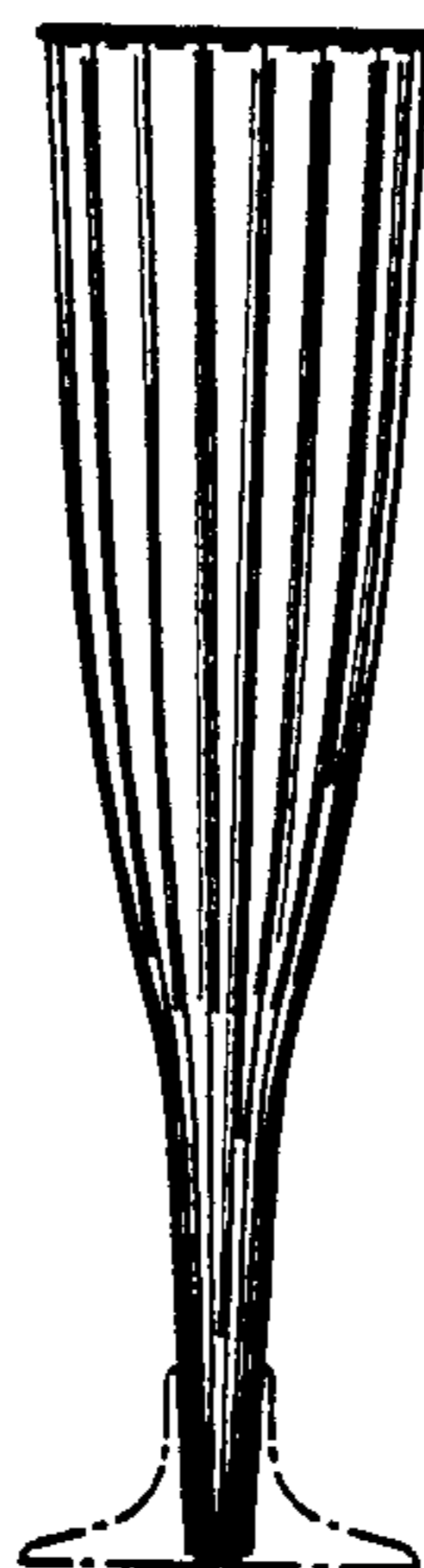

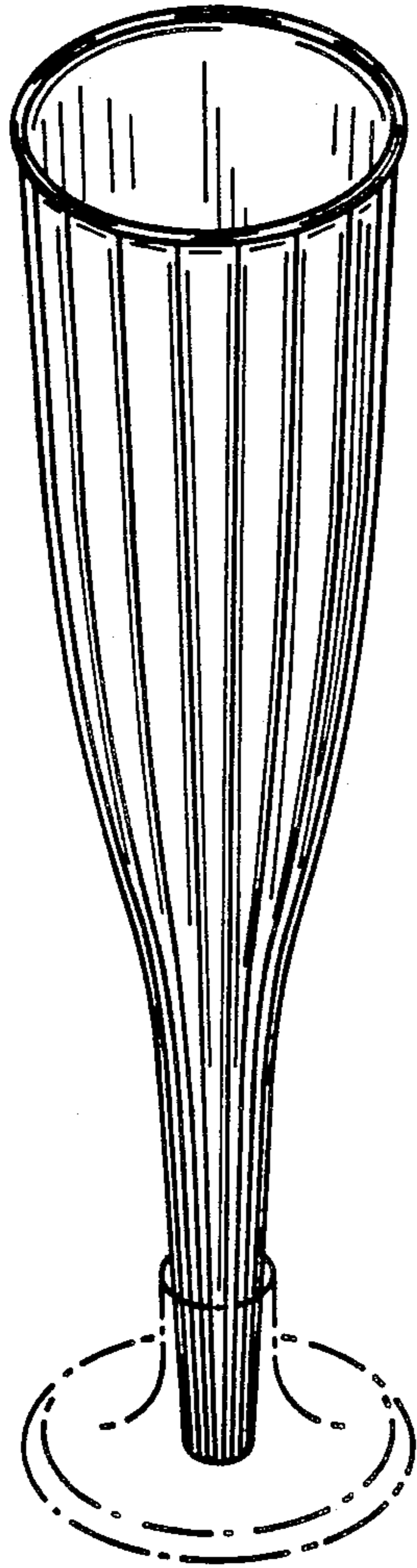
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined bowl and stem for a goblet or the like, as shown and described.

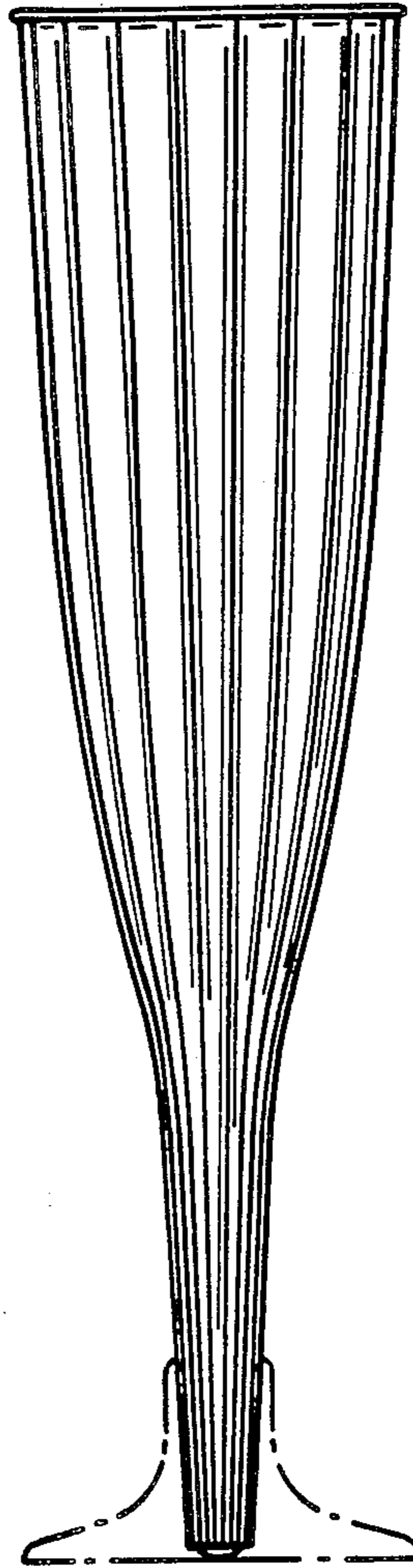
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a combined bowl and stem for a goblet or the like showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof. The broken line showing of the base in FIGS. 1 and 2 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

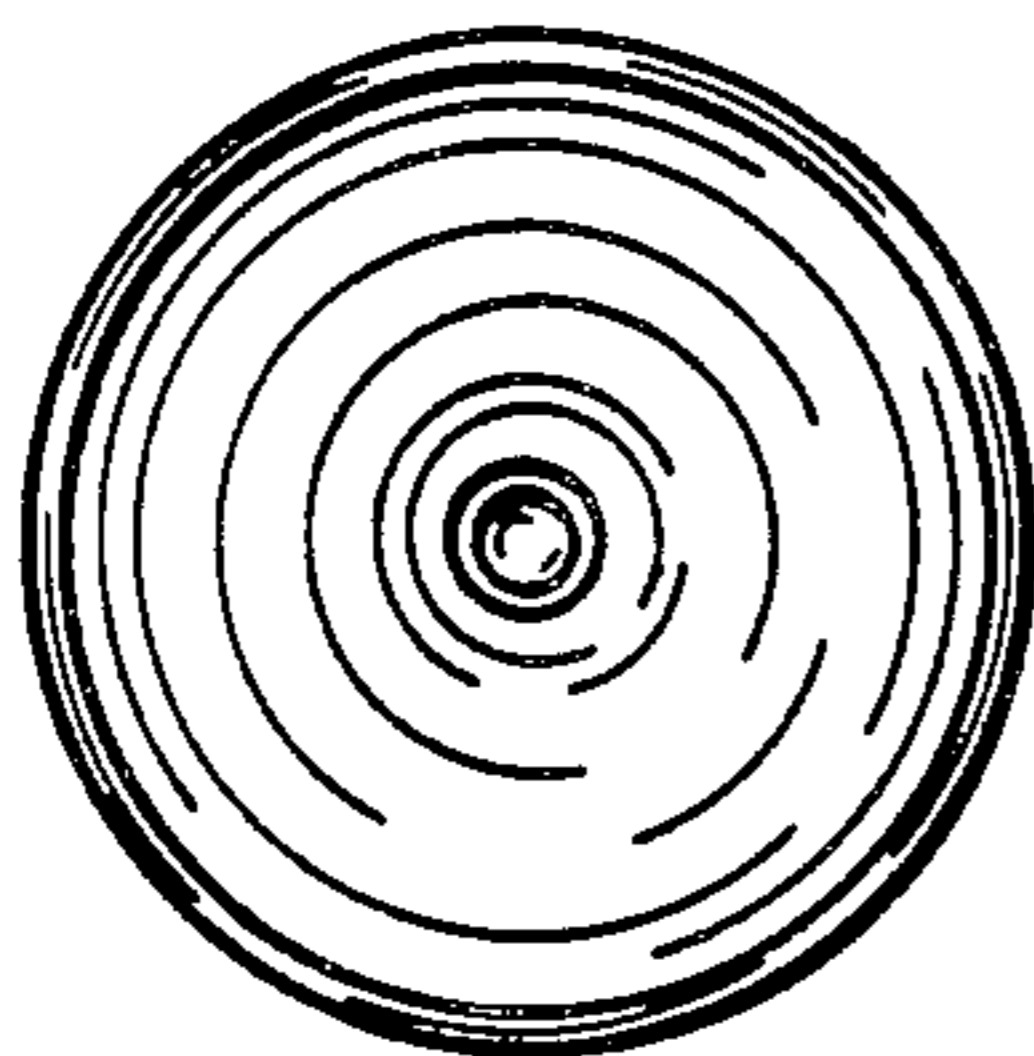




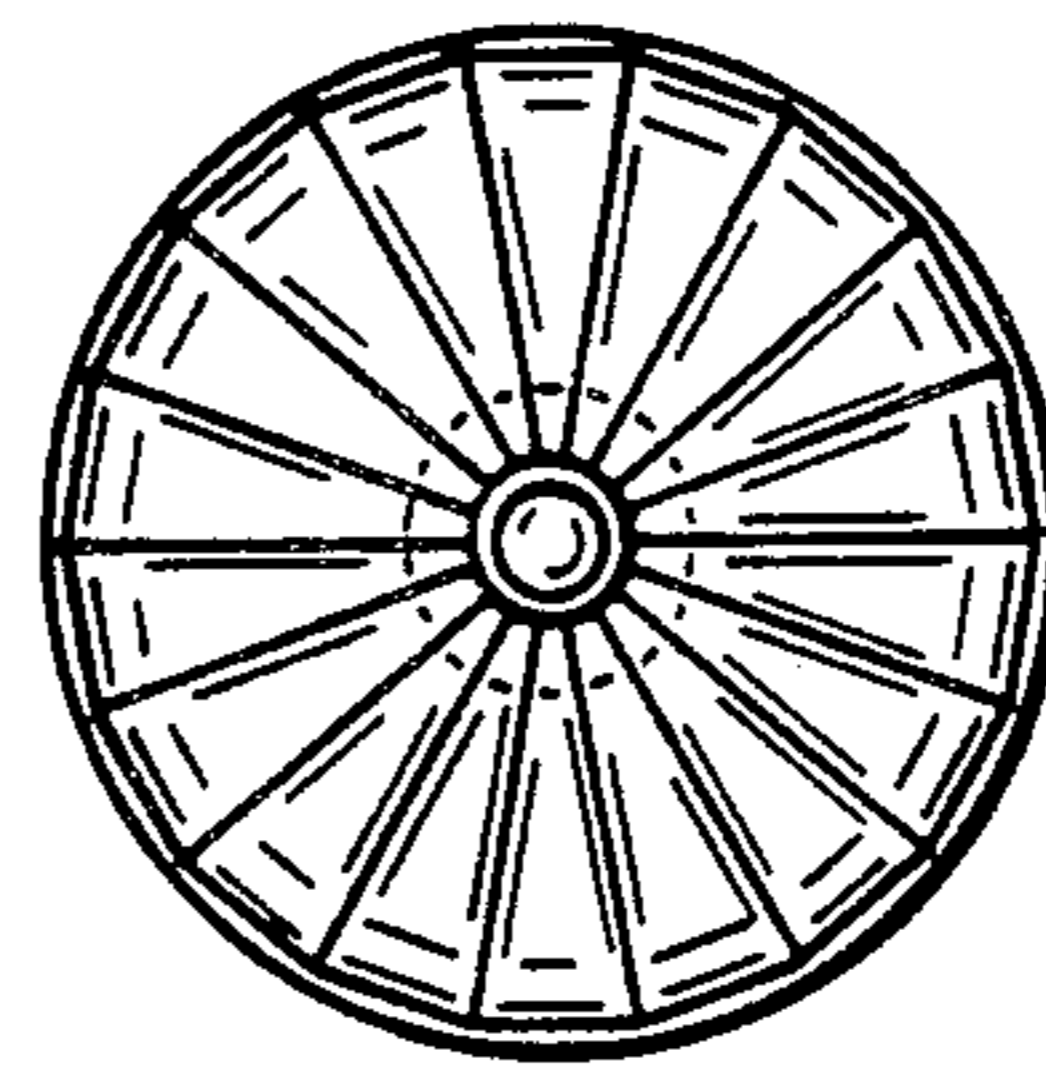
