FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being substantially a mirror image thereto.

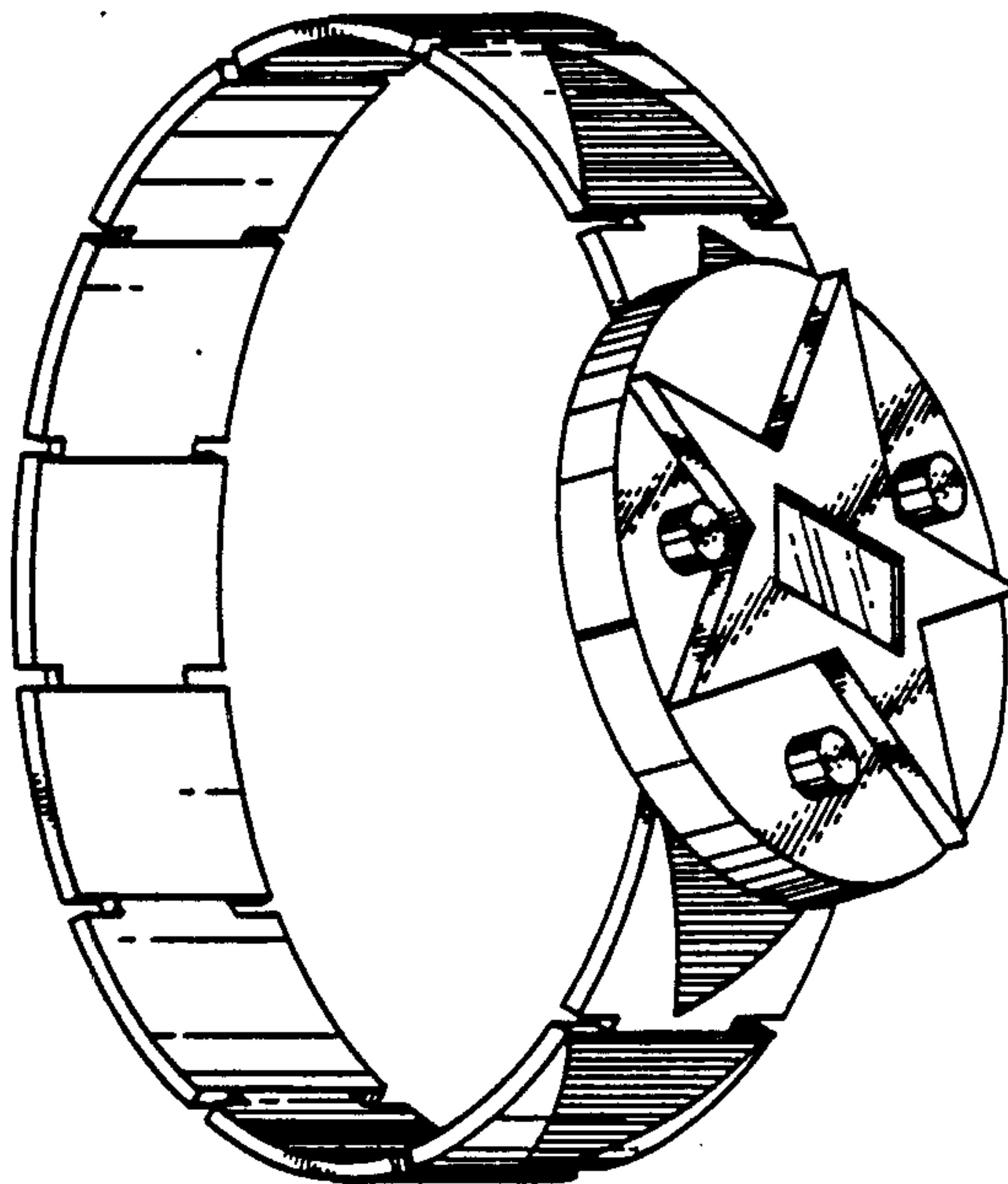

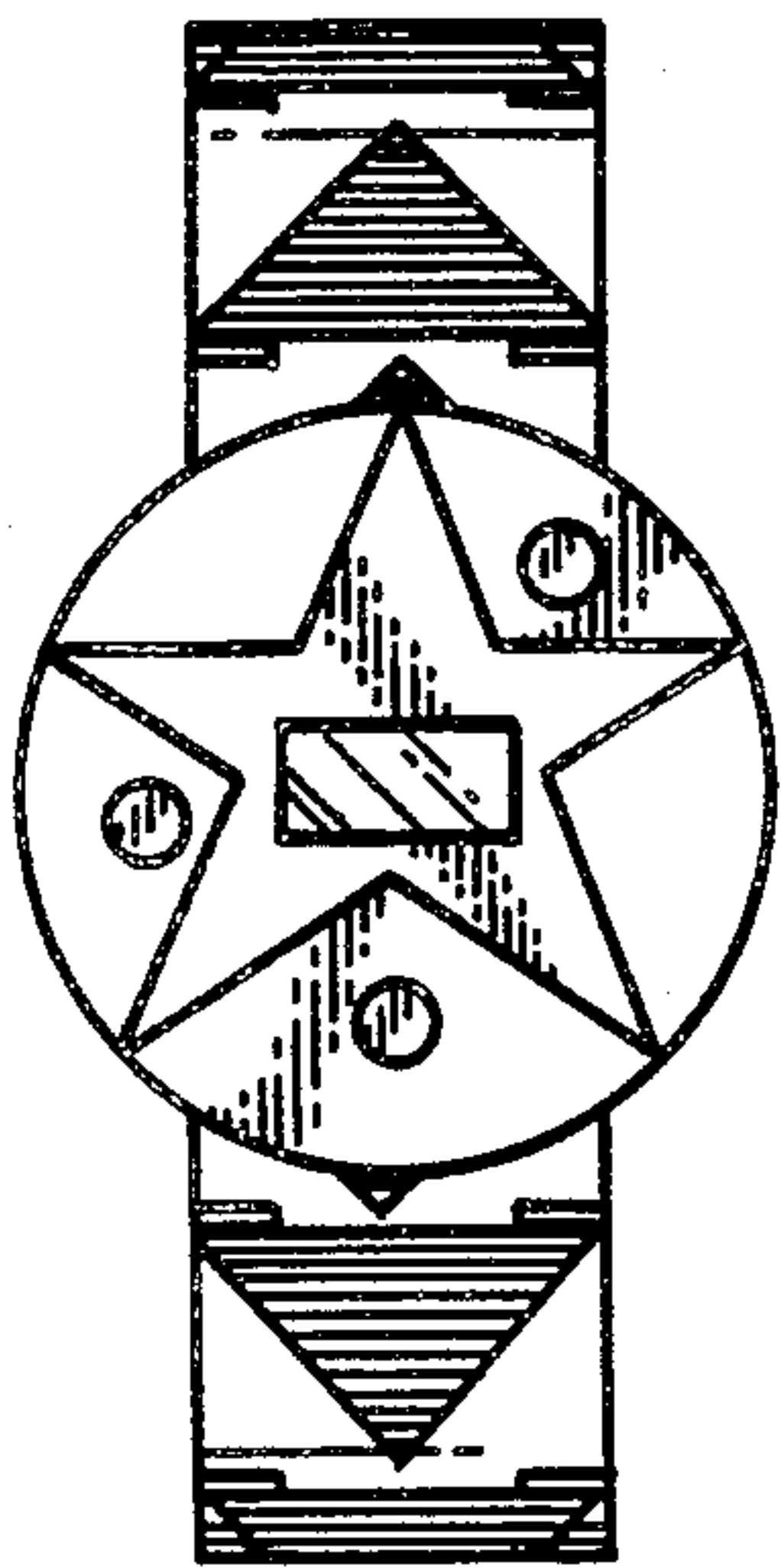
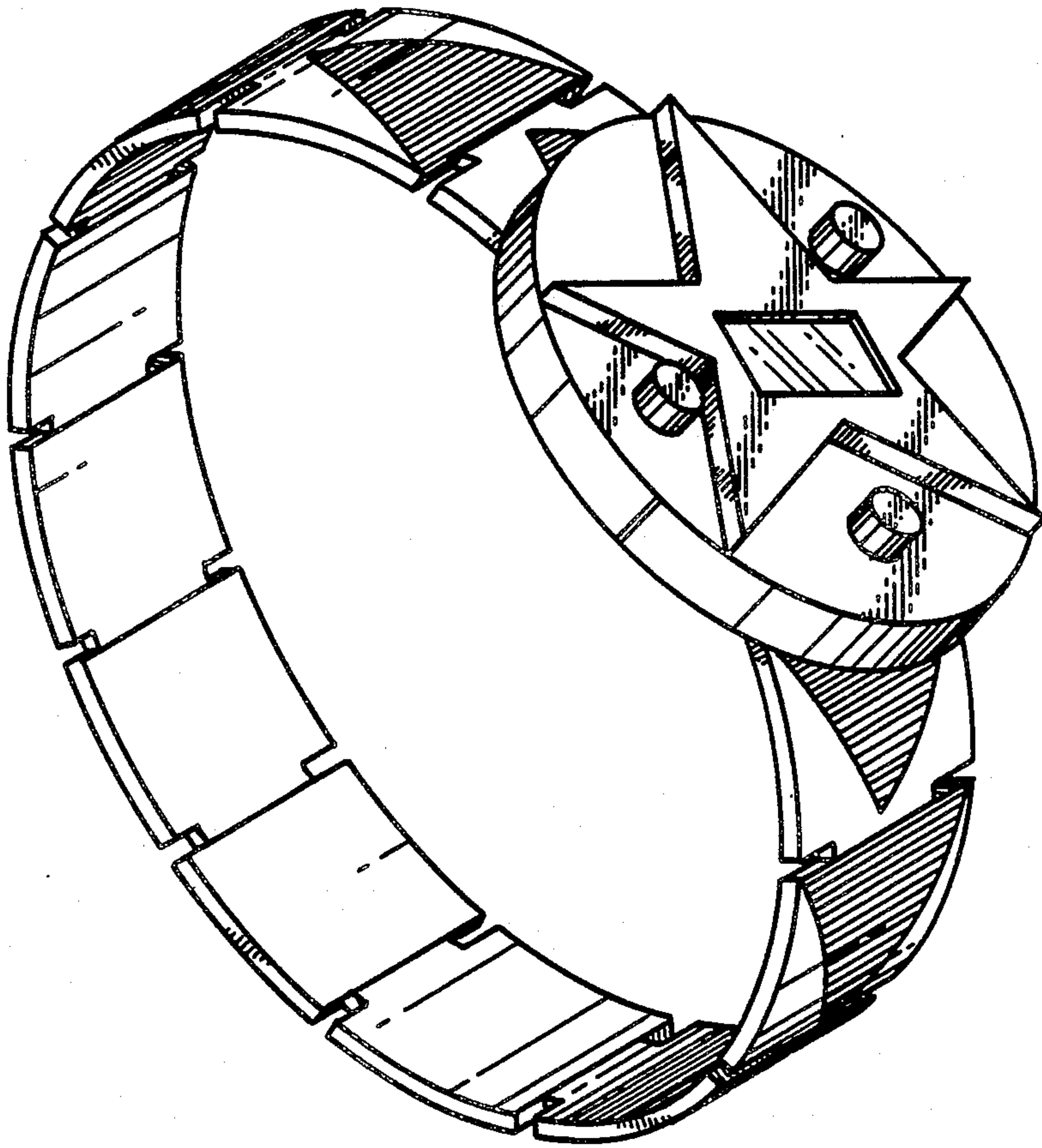

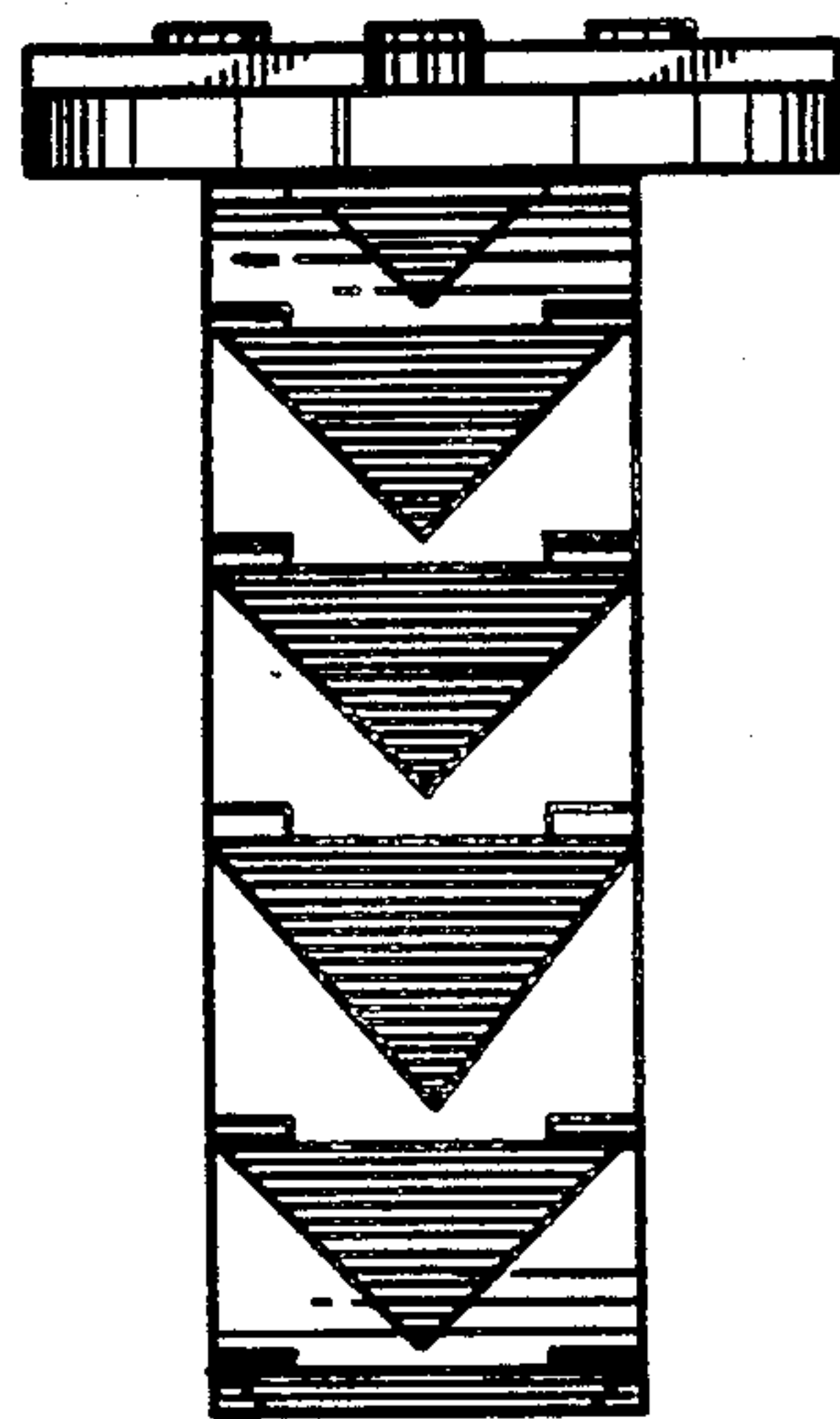
