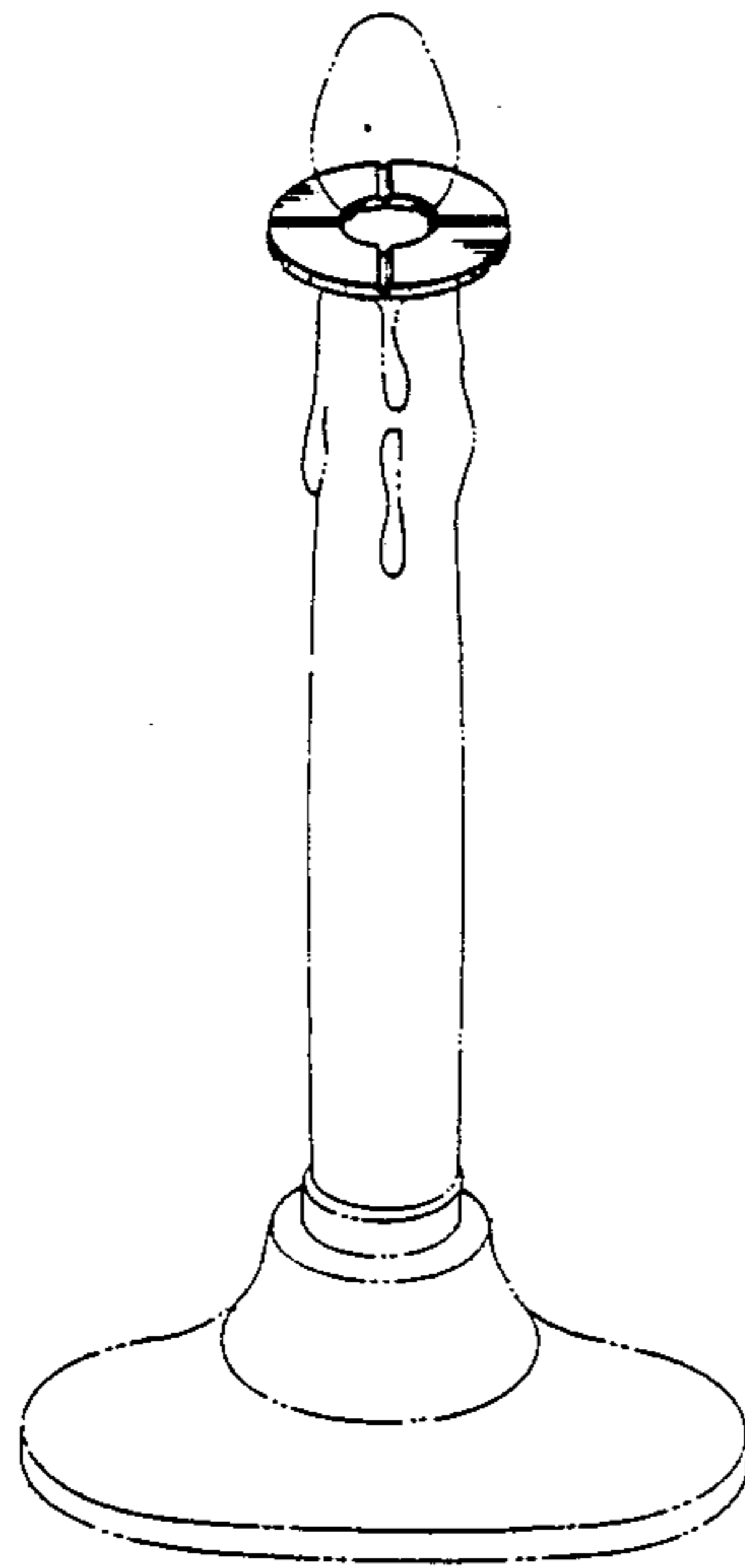

The ornamental design for a collar for an electric candle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a collar for an electric candle showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image; and
 FIG. 5 is a perspective view thereof on a reduced scale, the electric candle being shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.



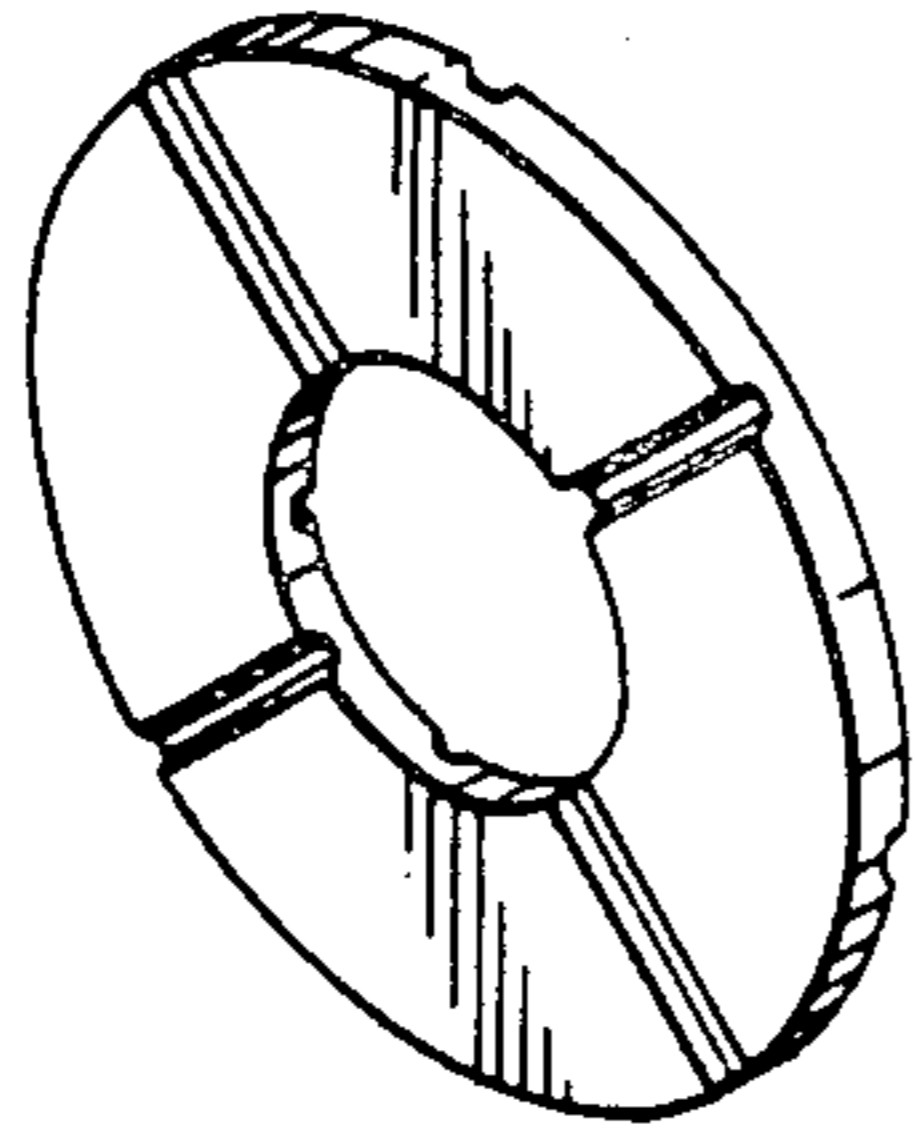

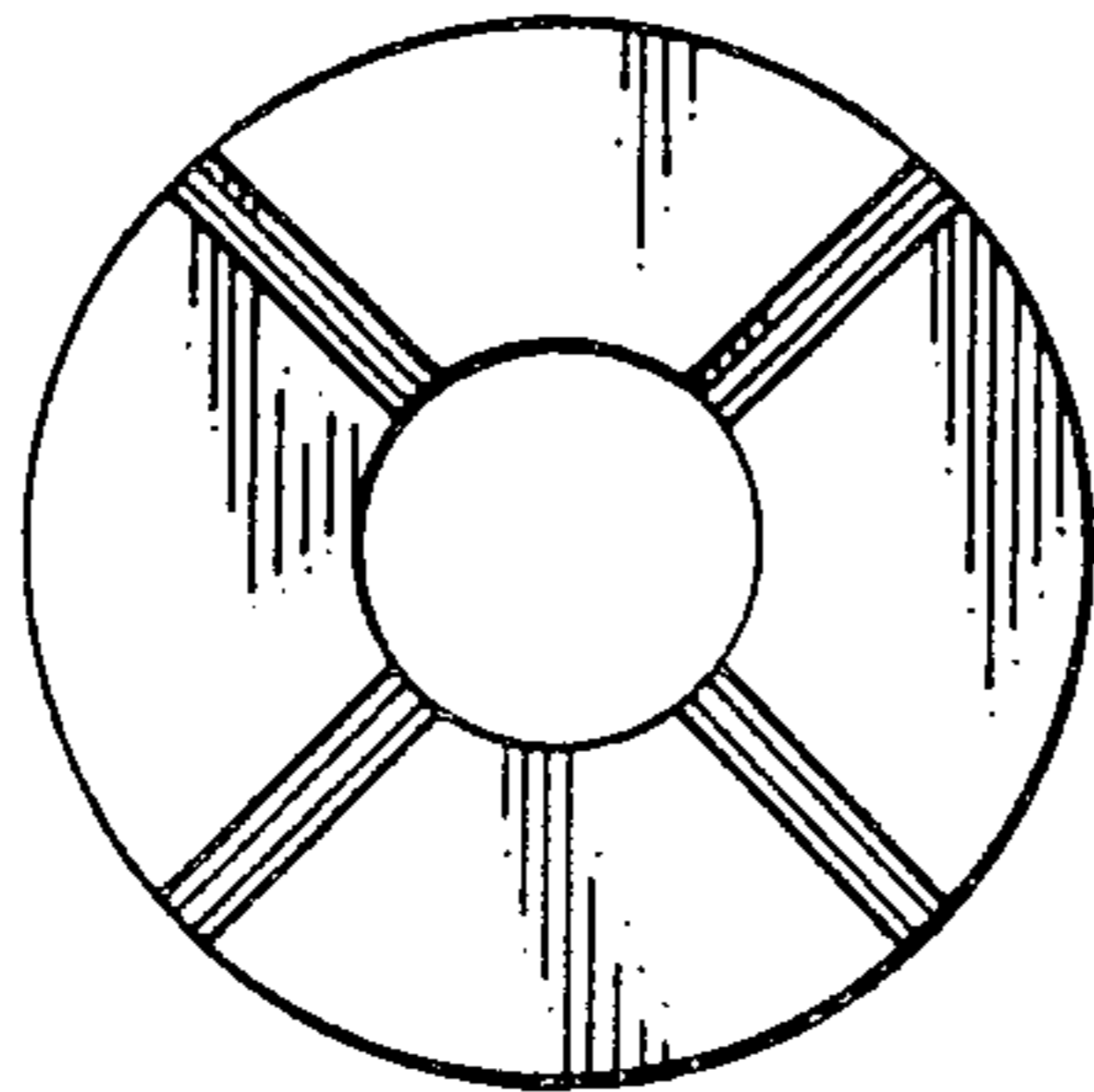

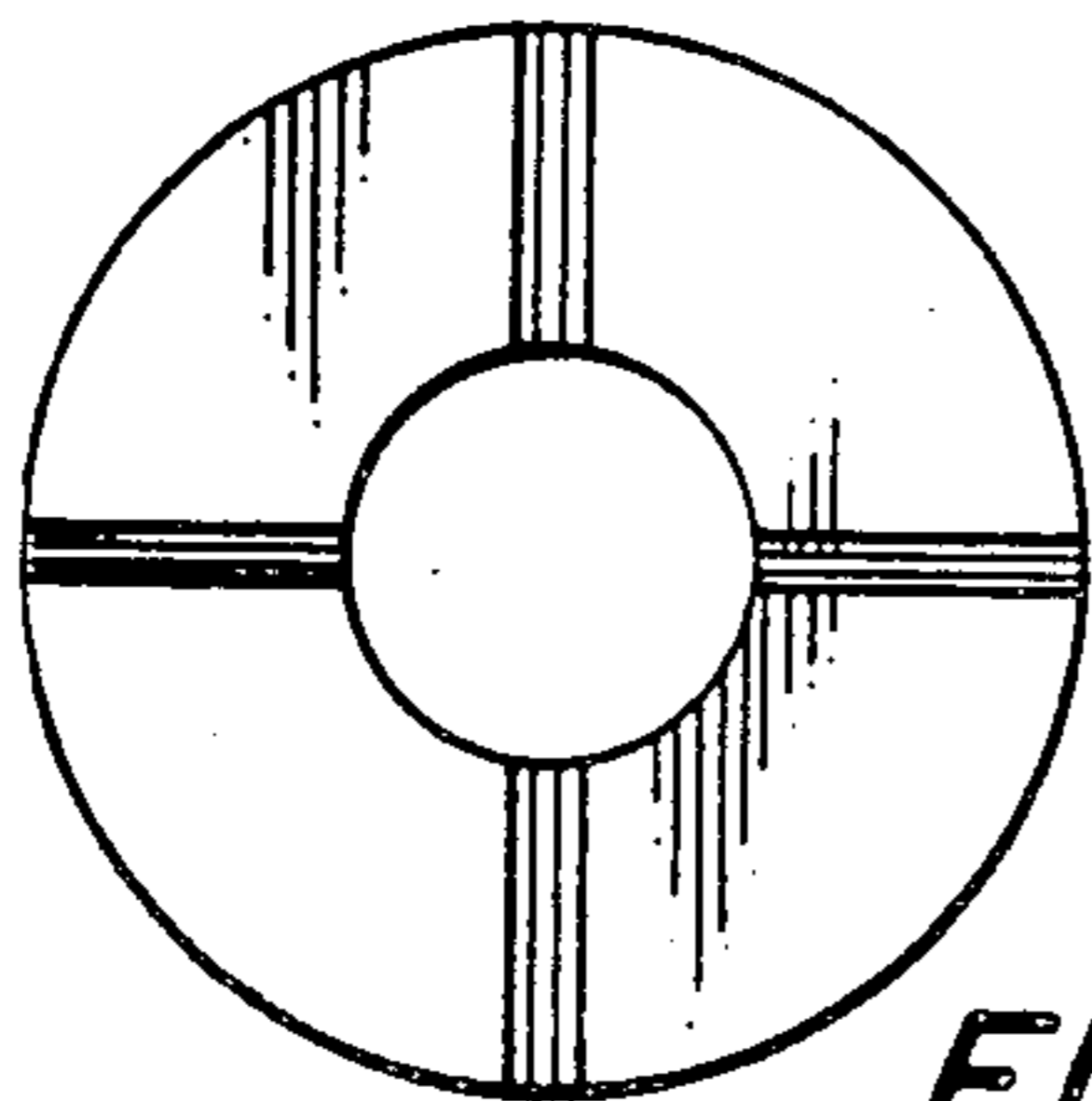

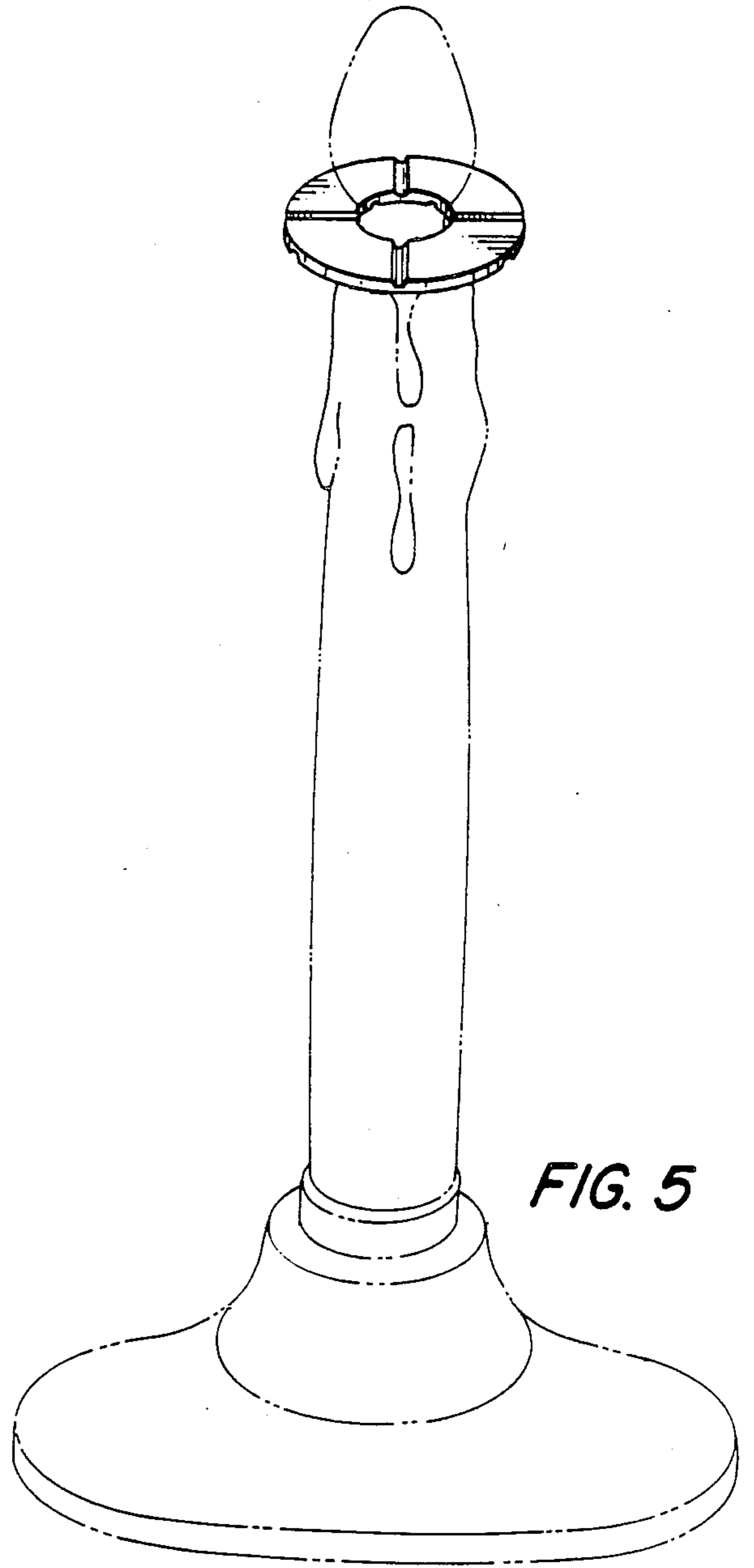
