FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a vacuum mug or similar article showing my new design.

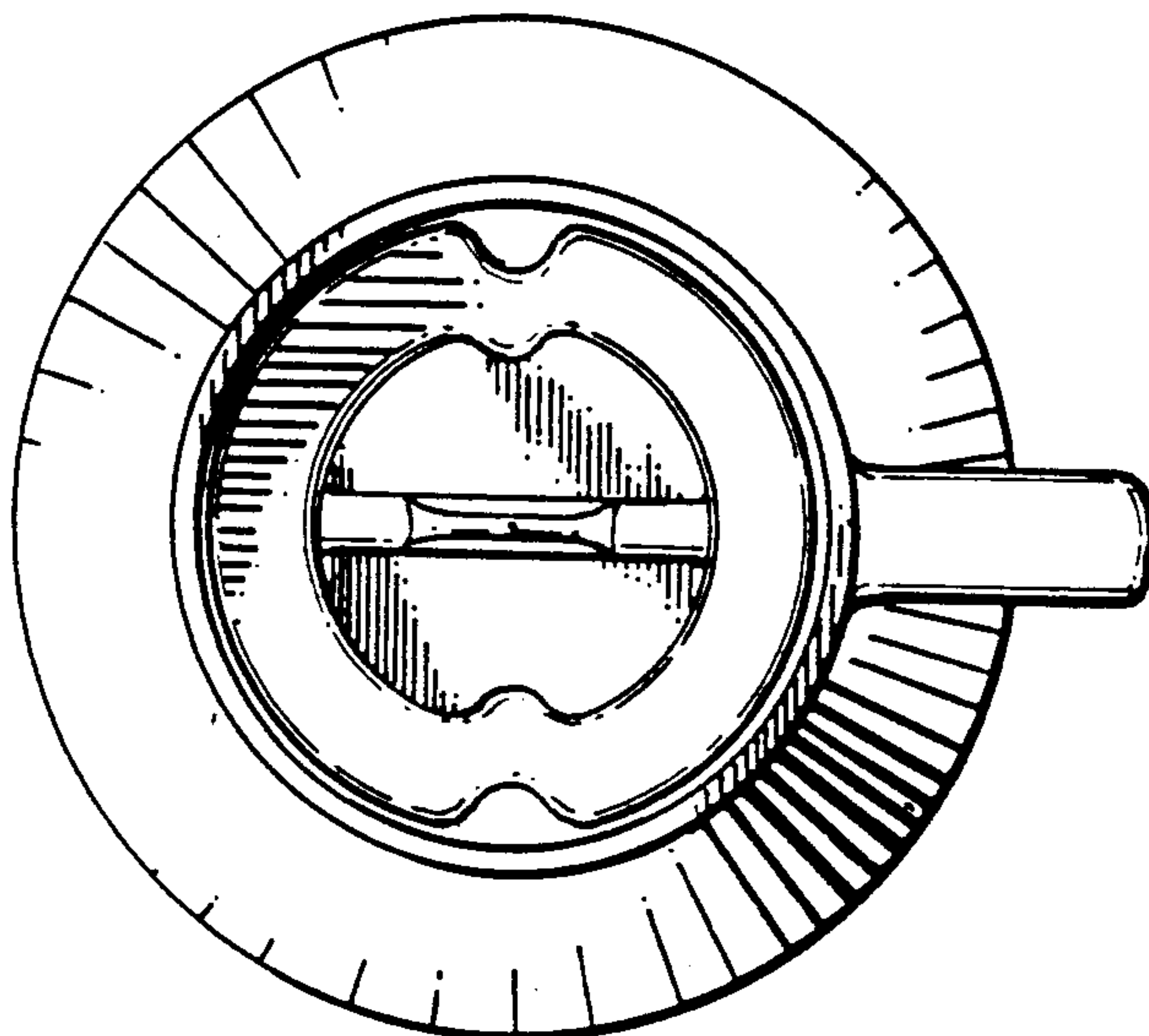
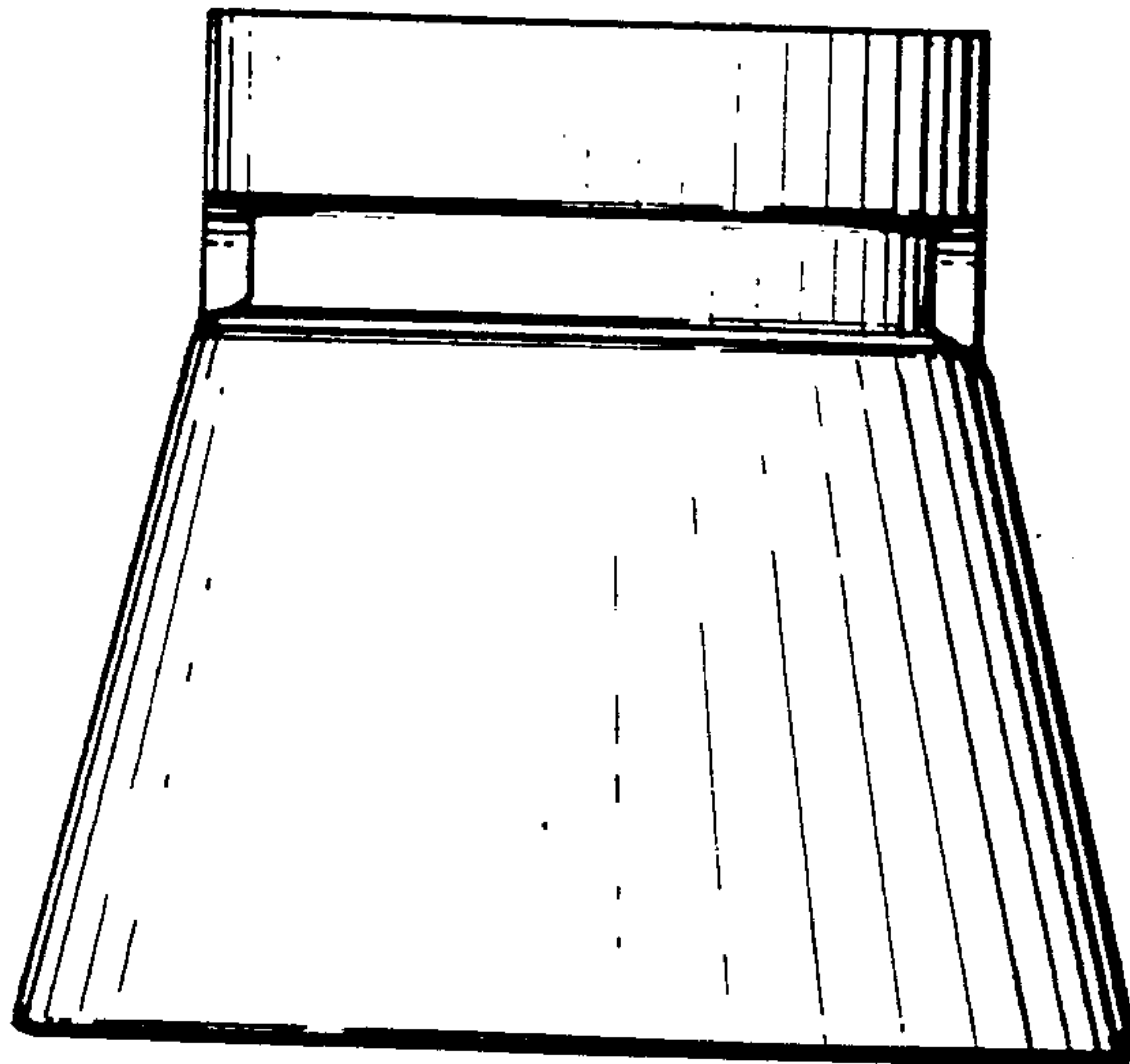
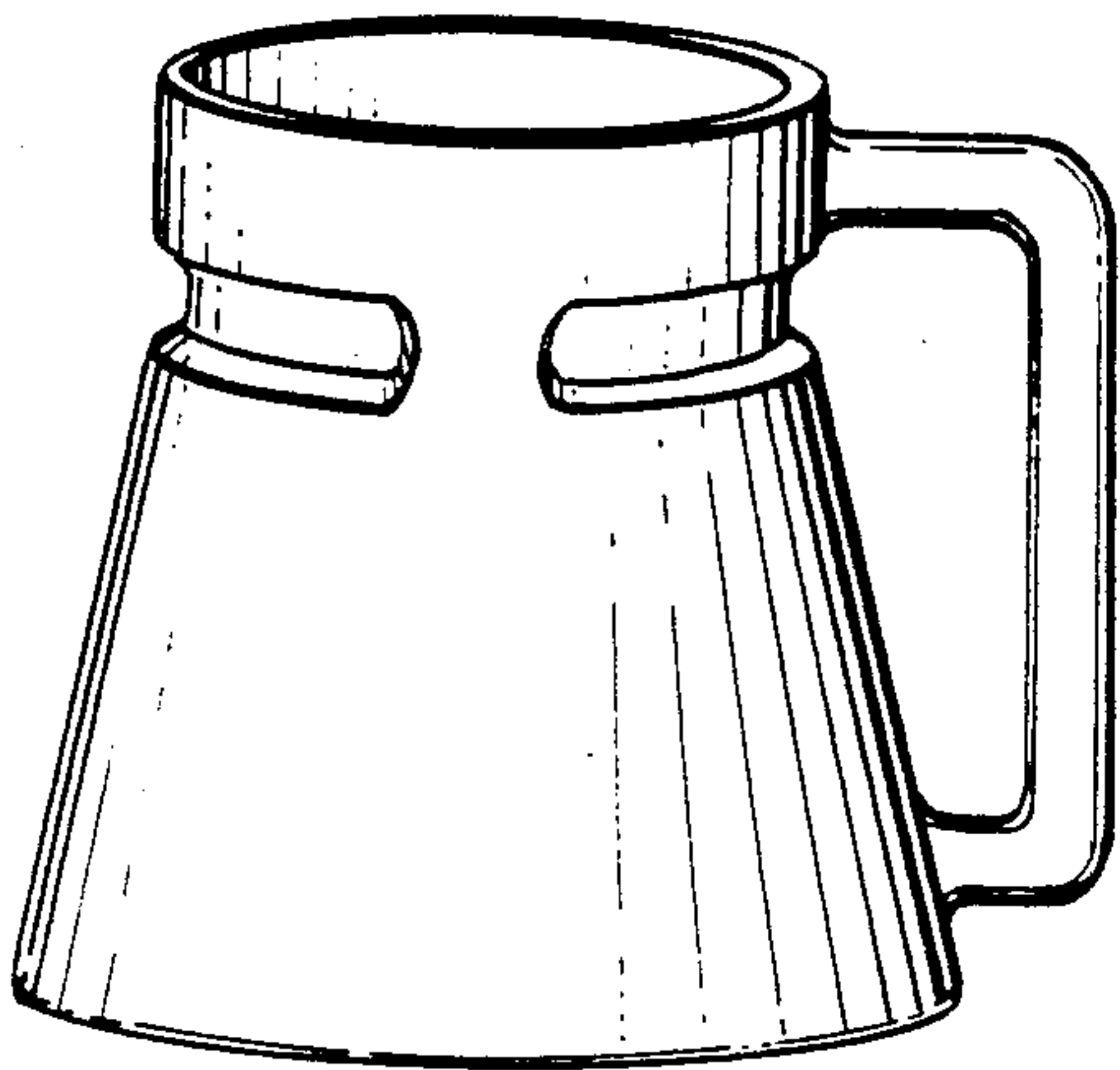
FIG. 2 is a top plan view.

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view.



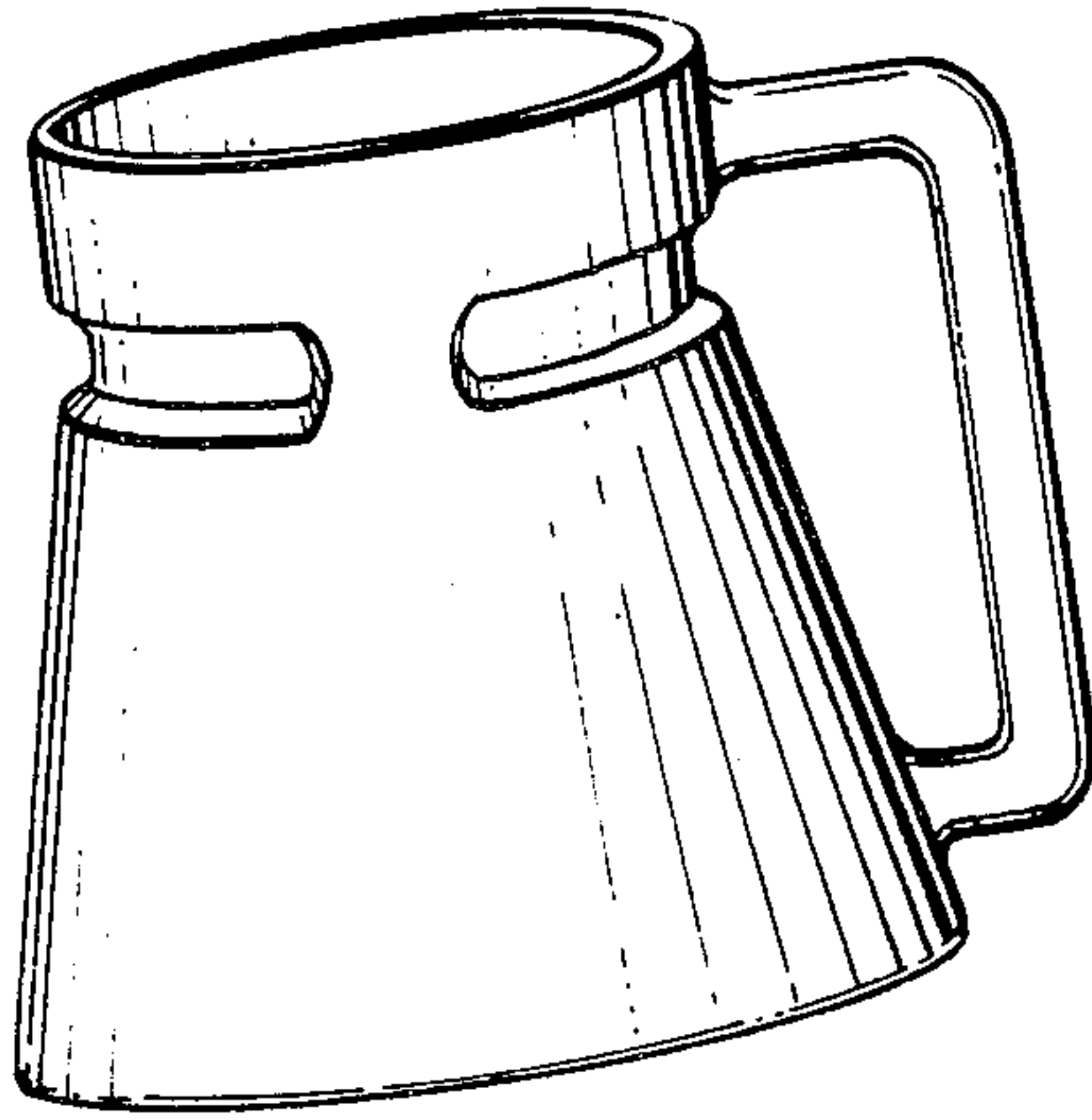

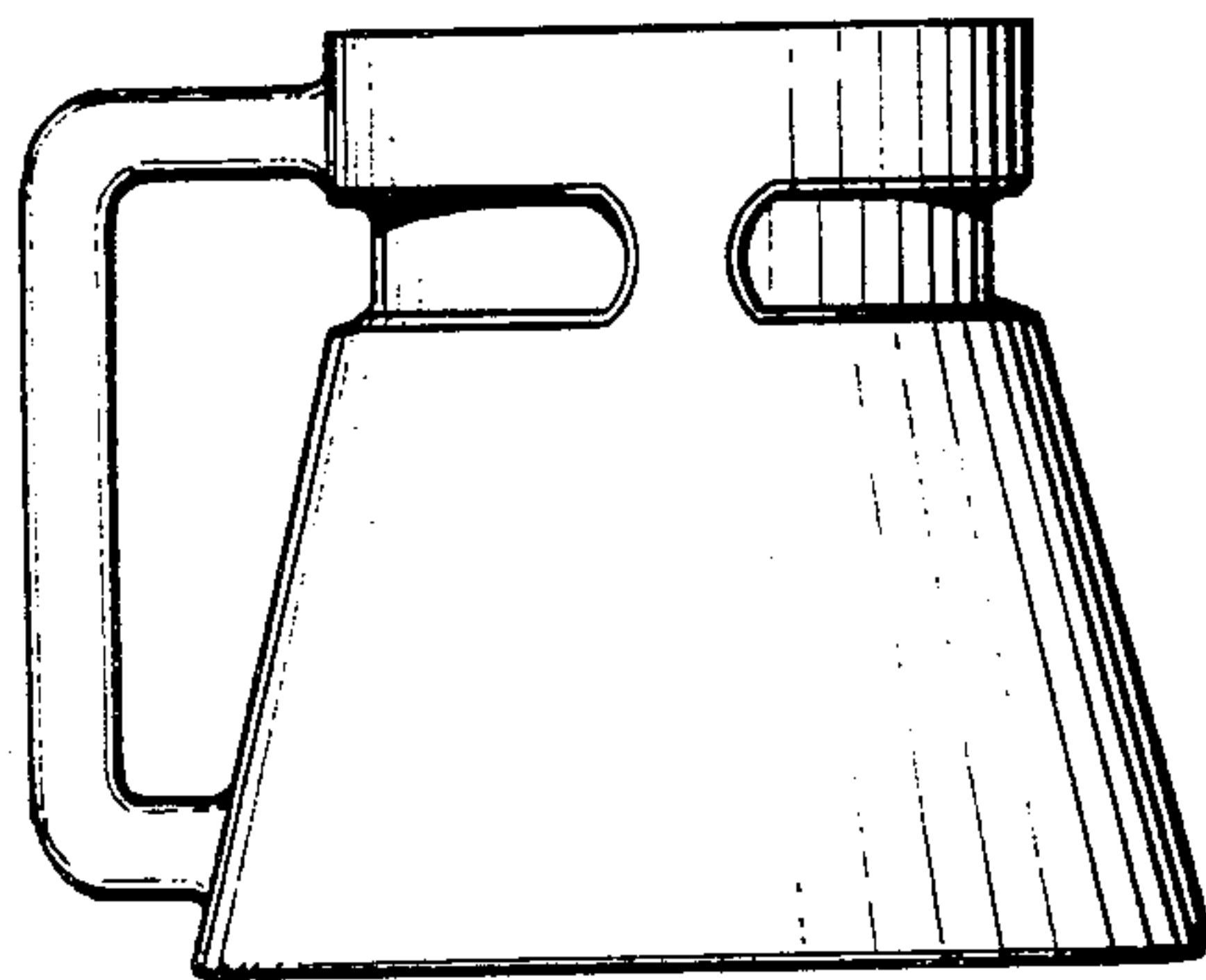
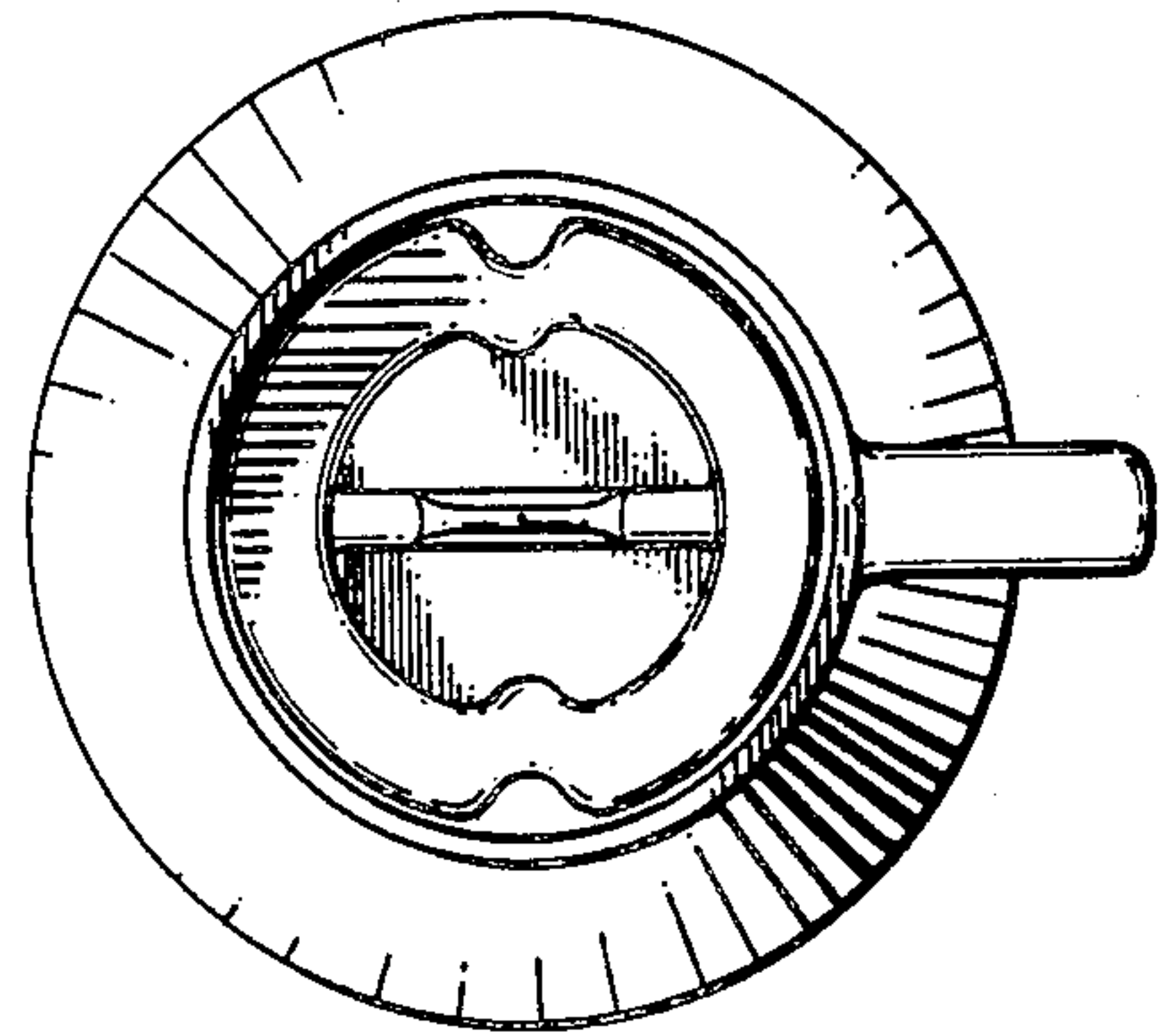

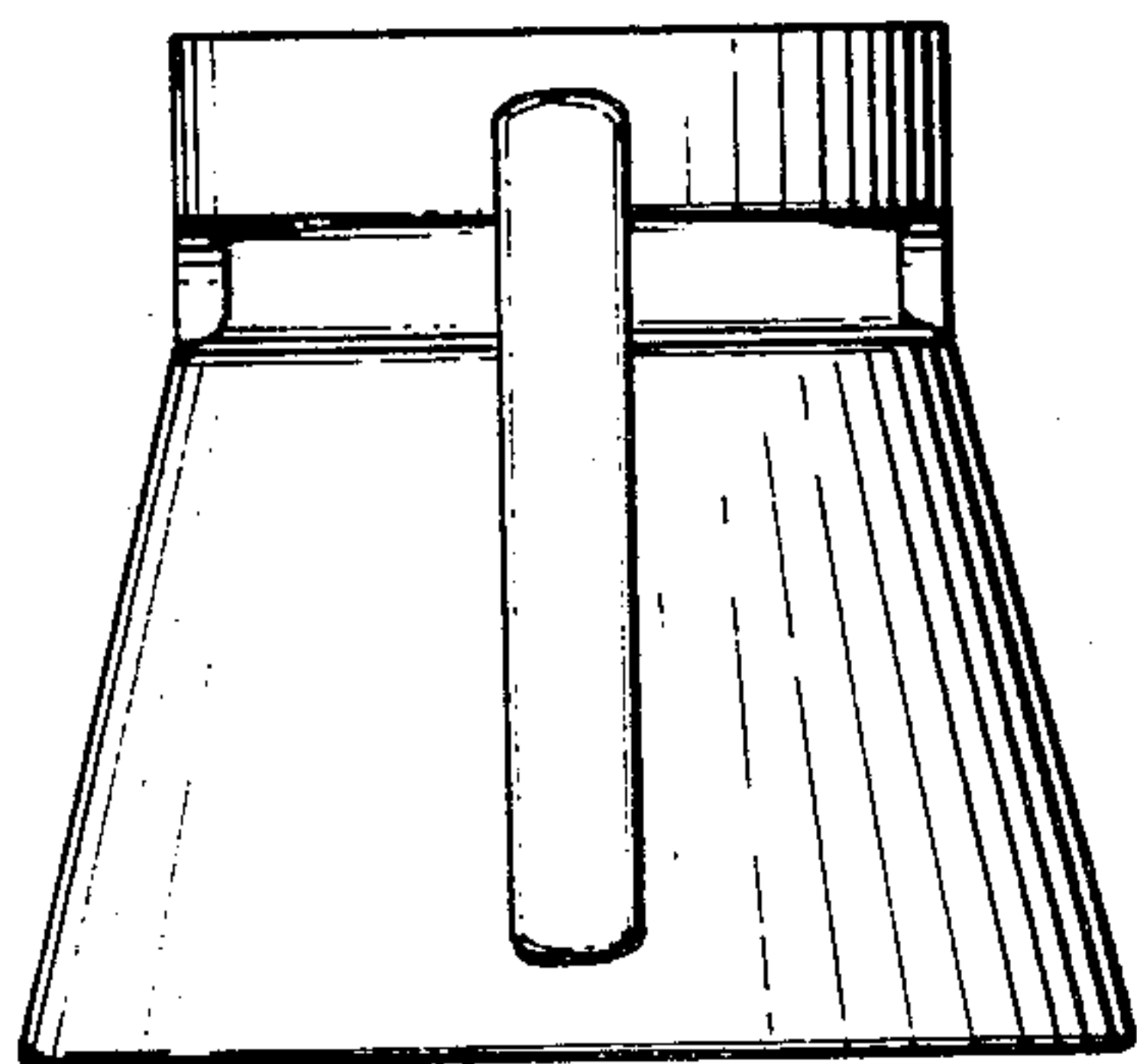
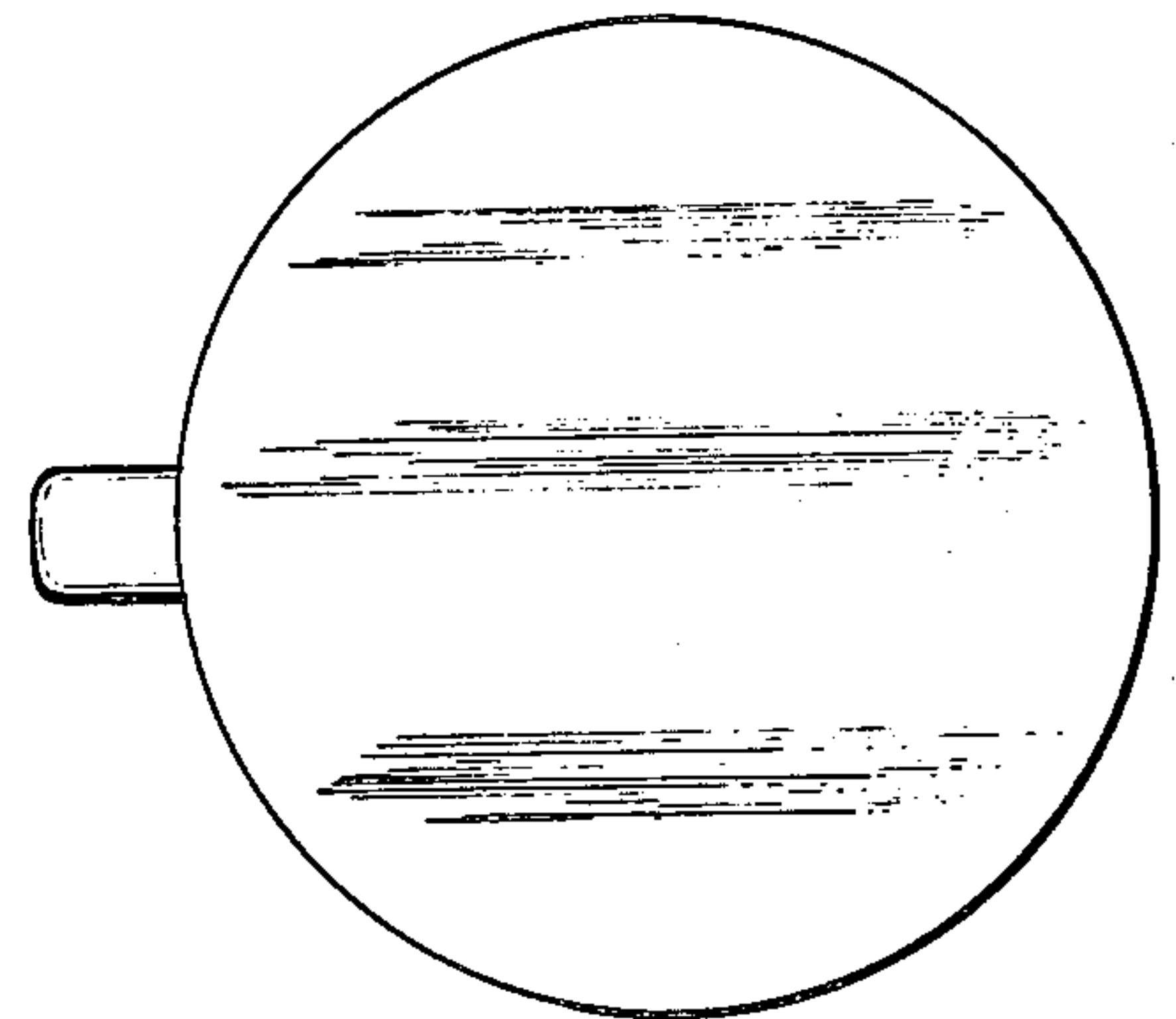

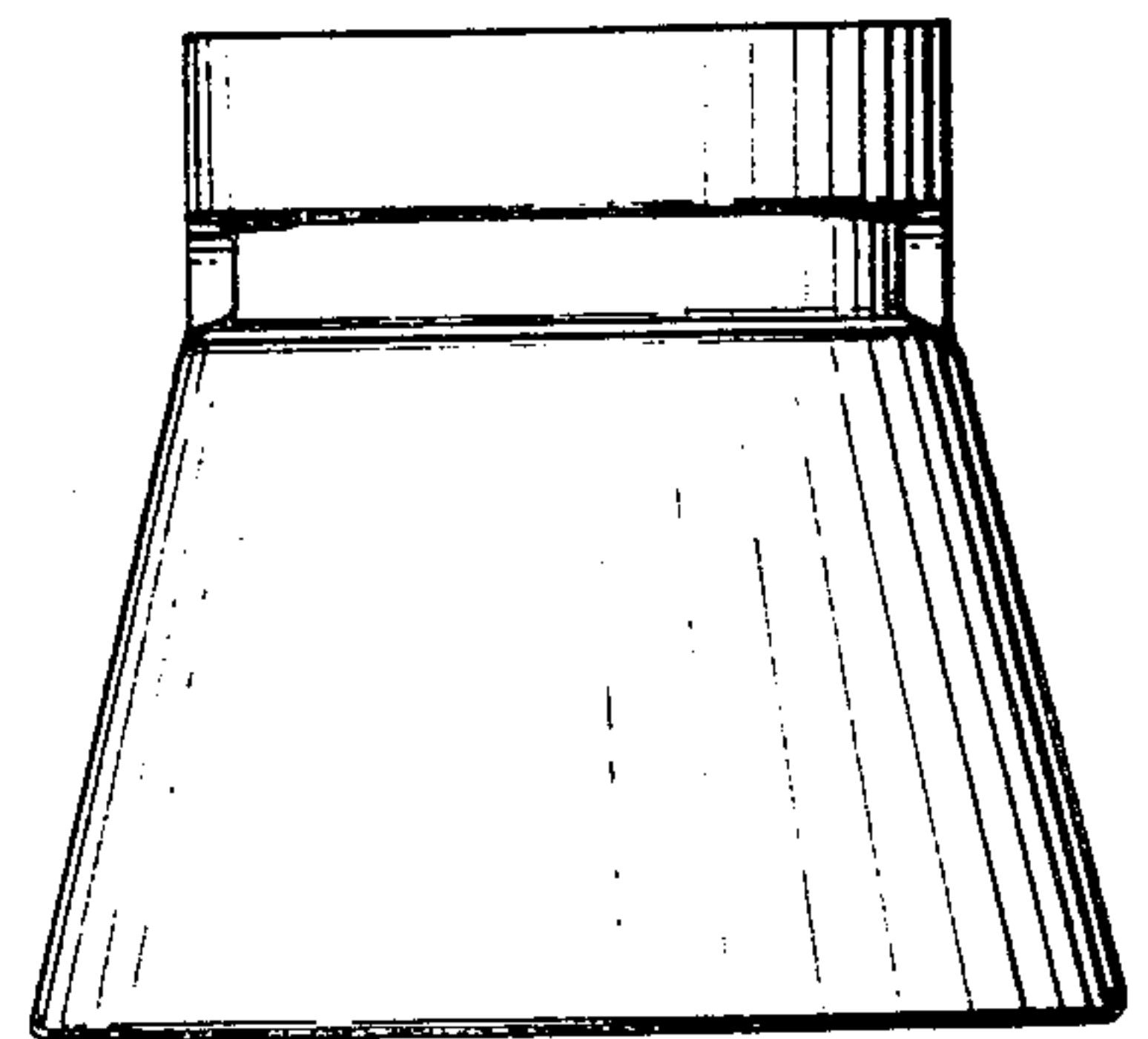
