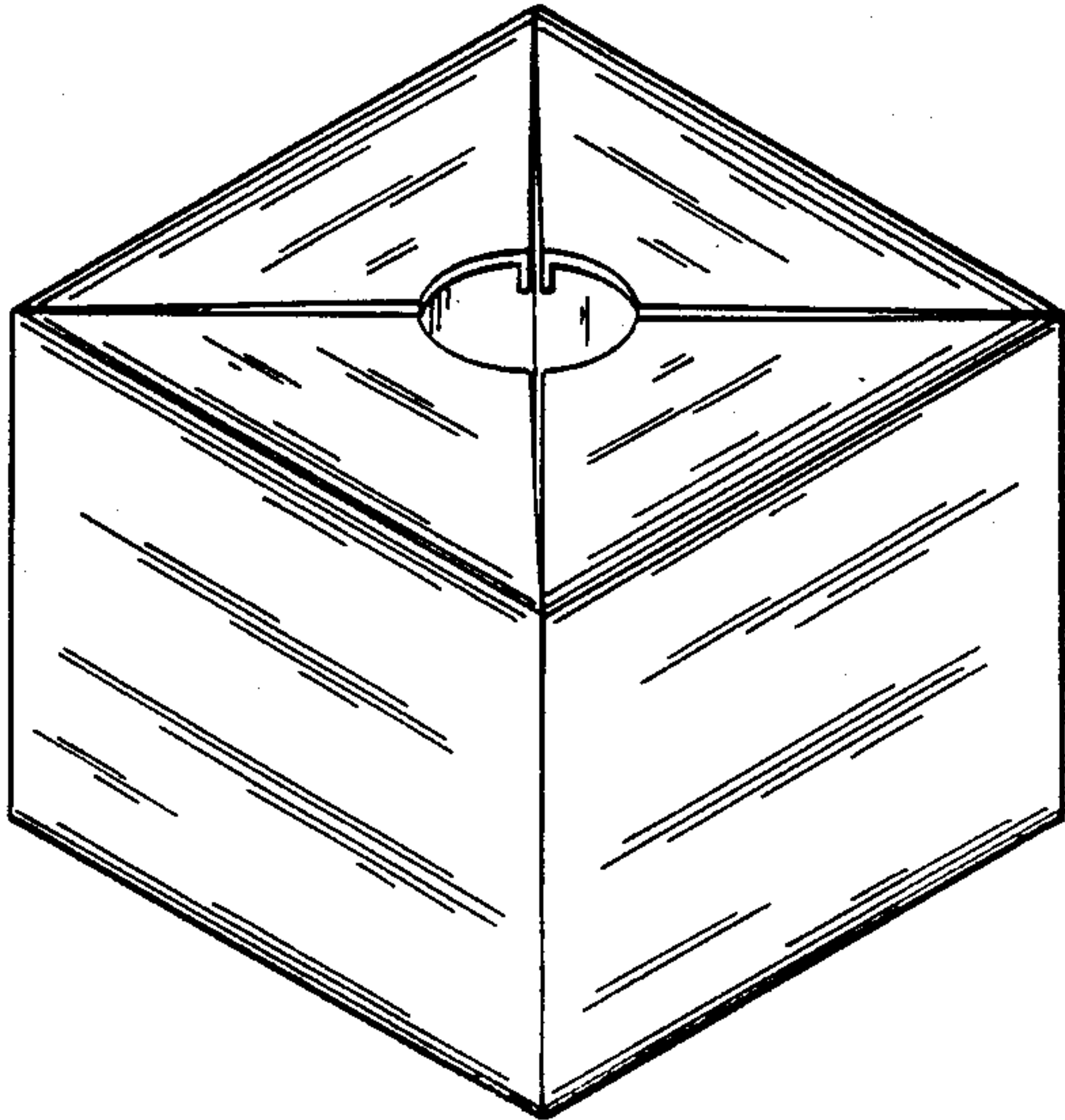

[57] CLAIM

The new and ornamental design for a packaging container, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a packaging container showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevation view, the other three sides being the same in appearance;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view; and
FIG. 4 is a top perspective view with a portion of a packaged article being shown in broken lines to illustrate environmental use only.
The dash lines in FIG. 3 represent score lines.



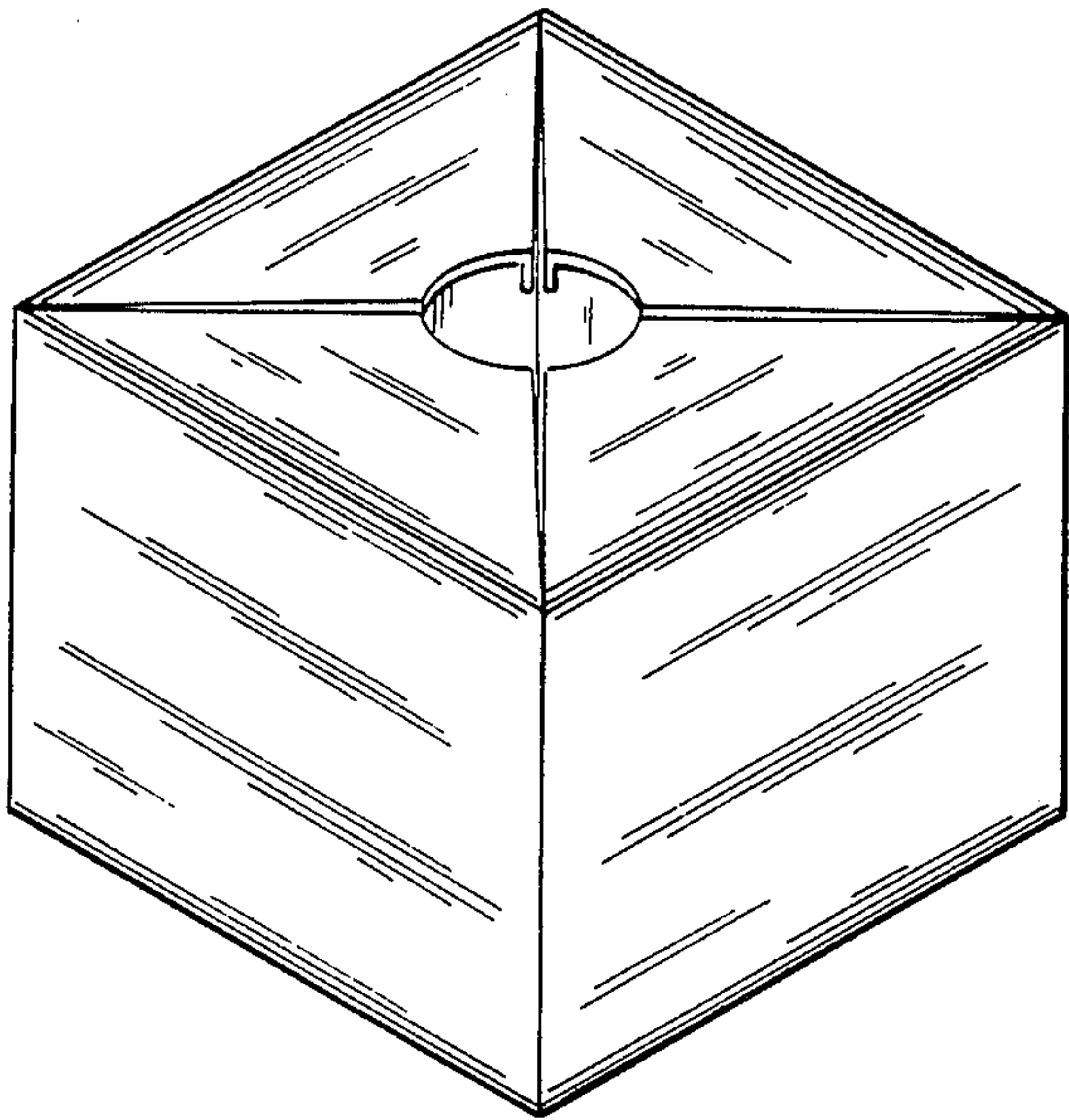

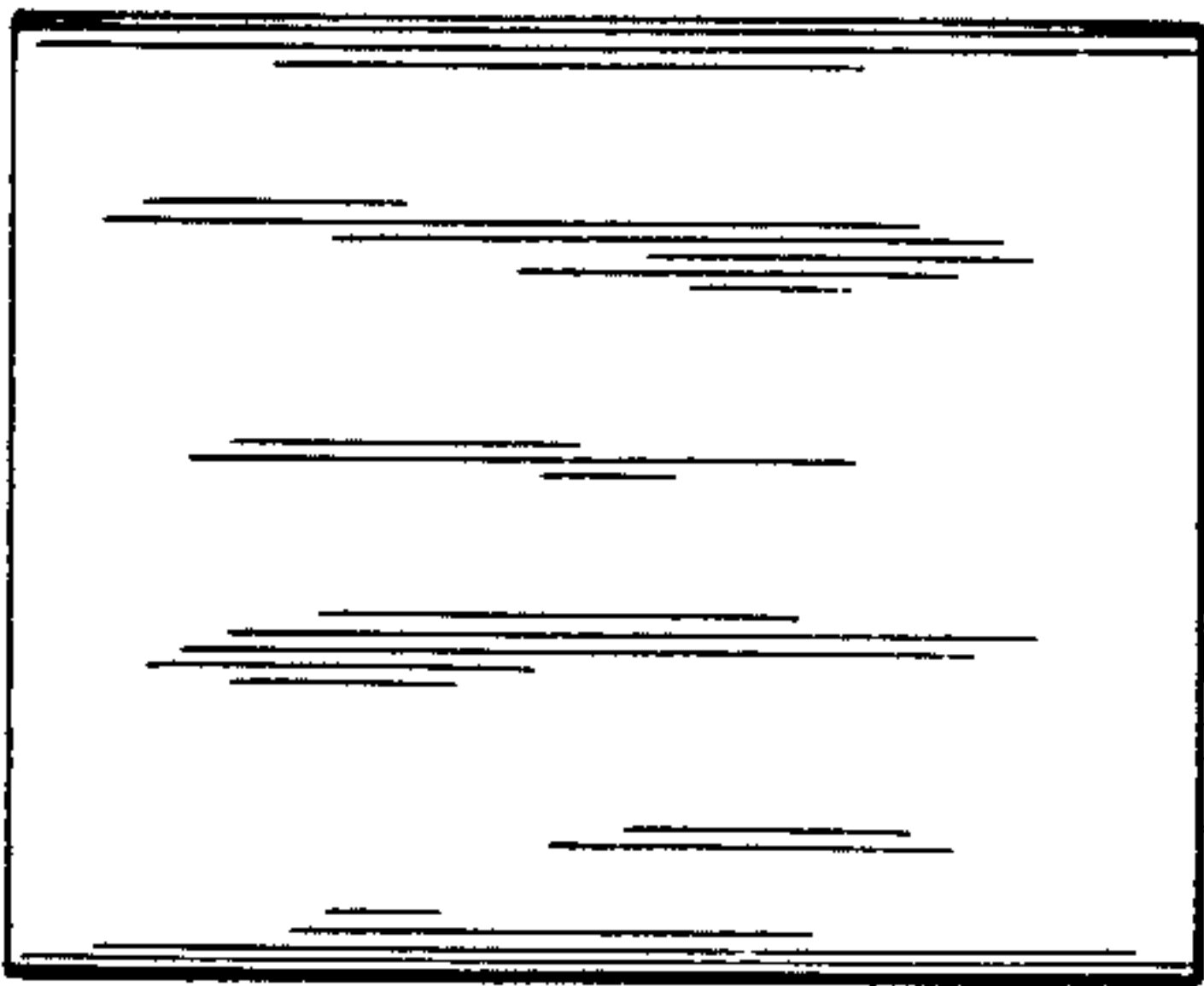

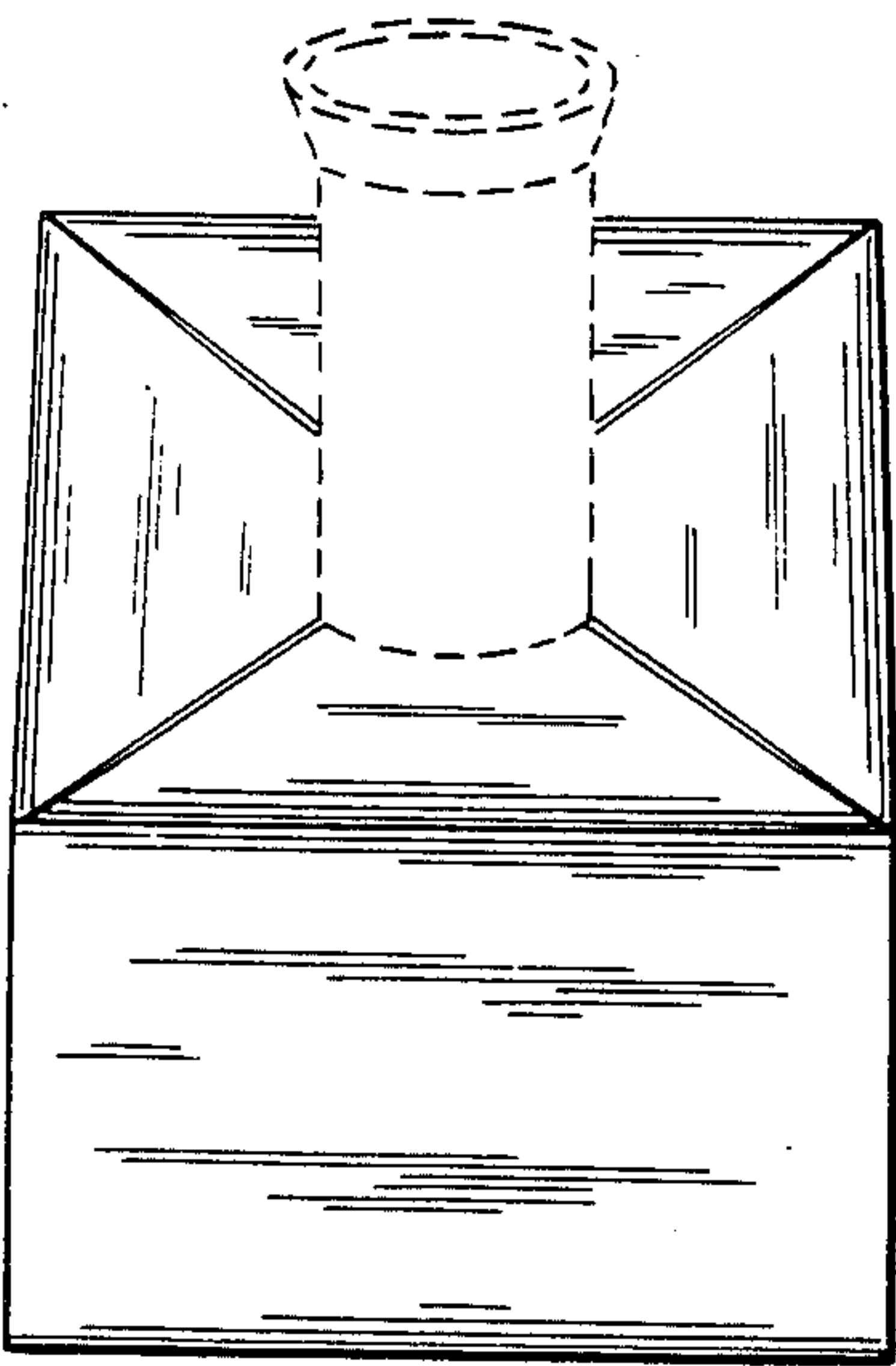

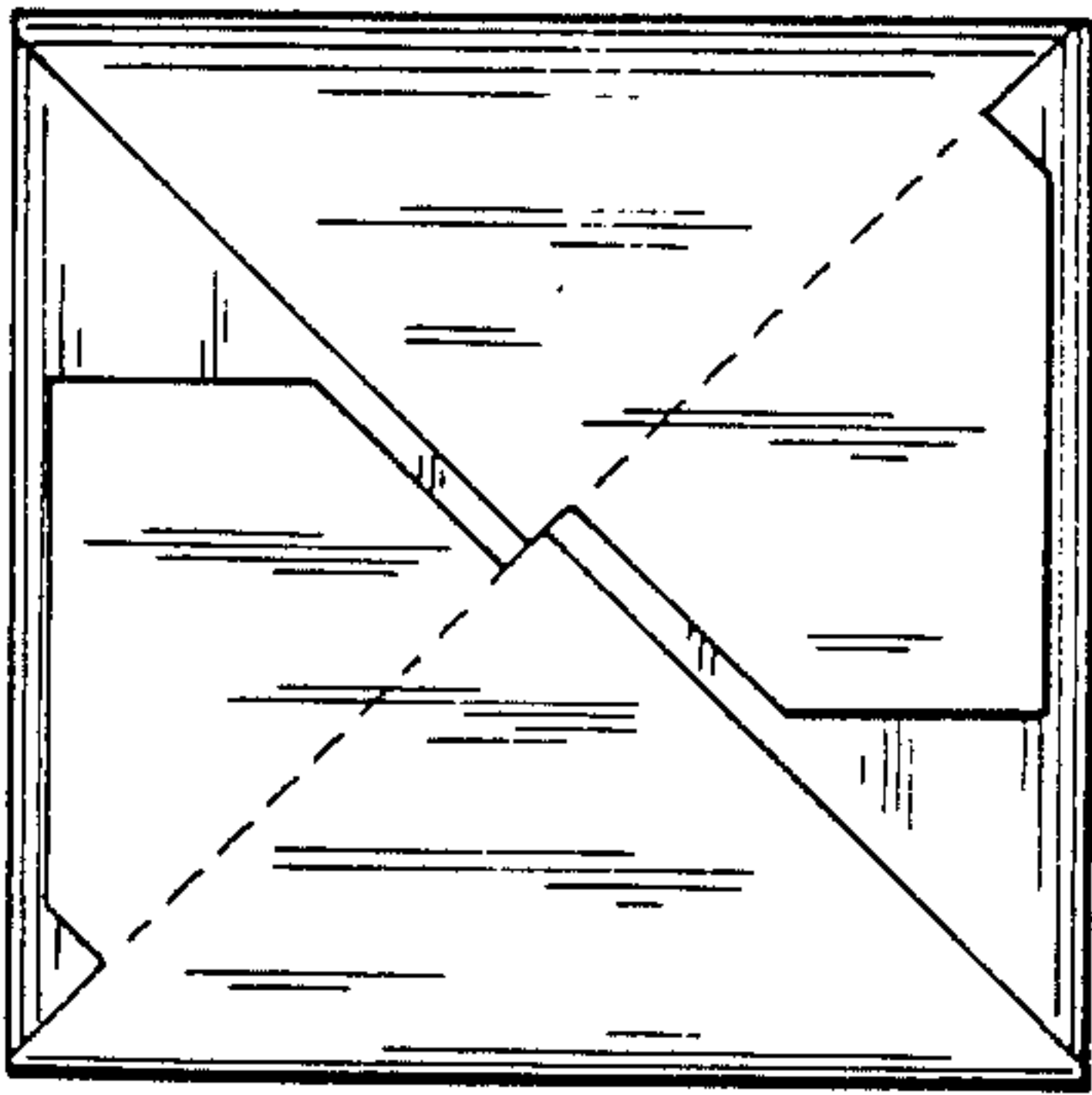
