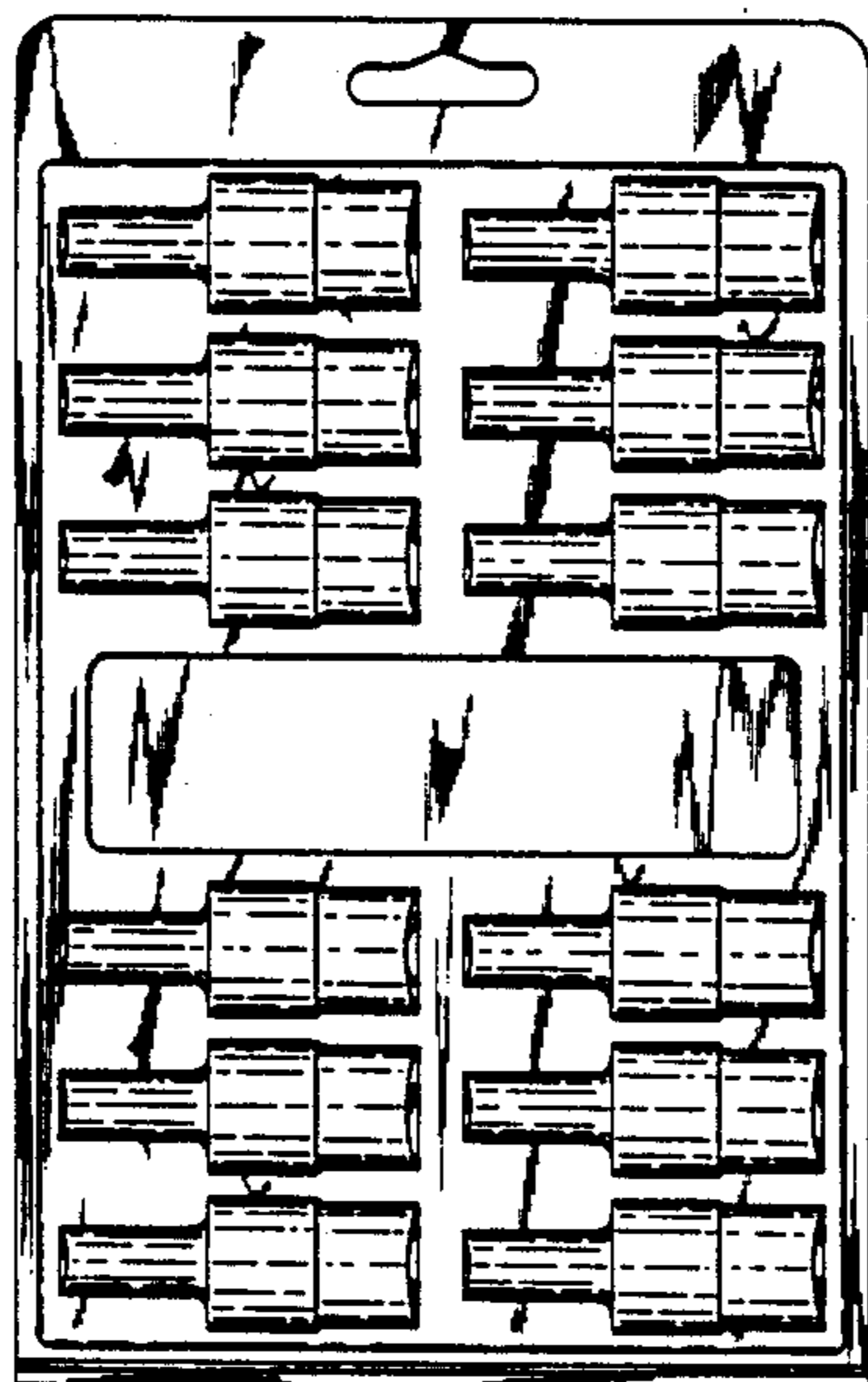

The ornamental design for a packaging container for faucet valves, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a packaging container for faucet valves showing my new design;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



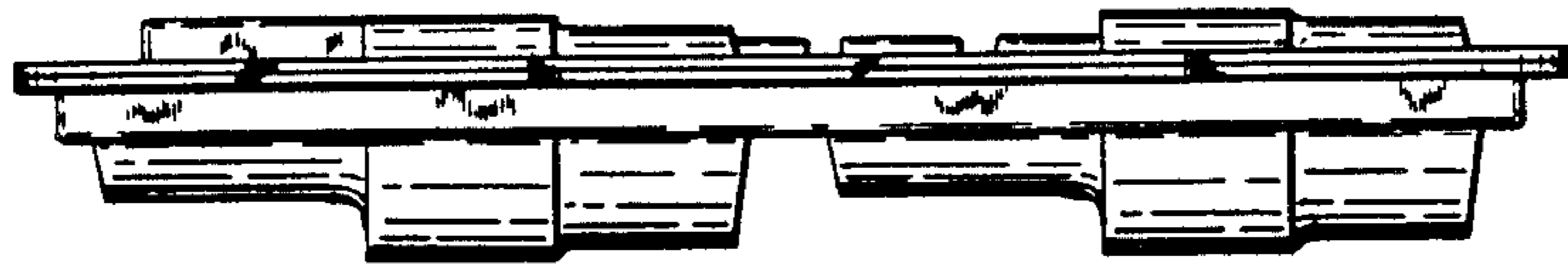

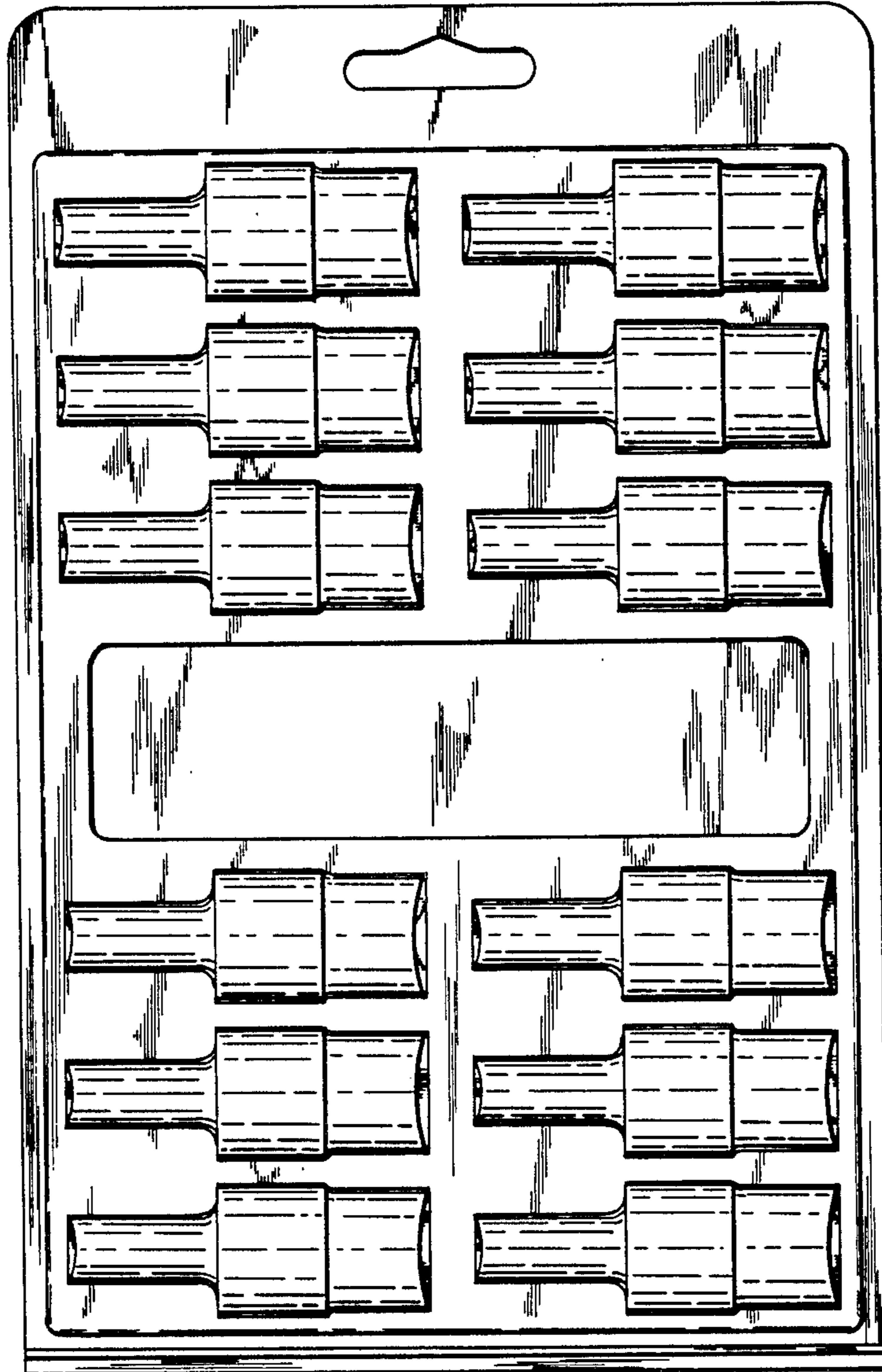

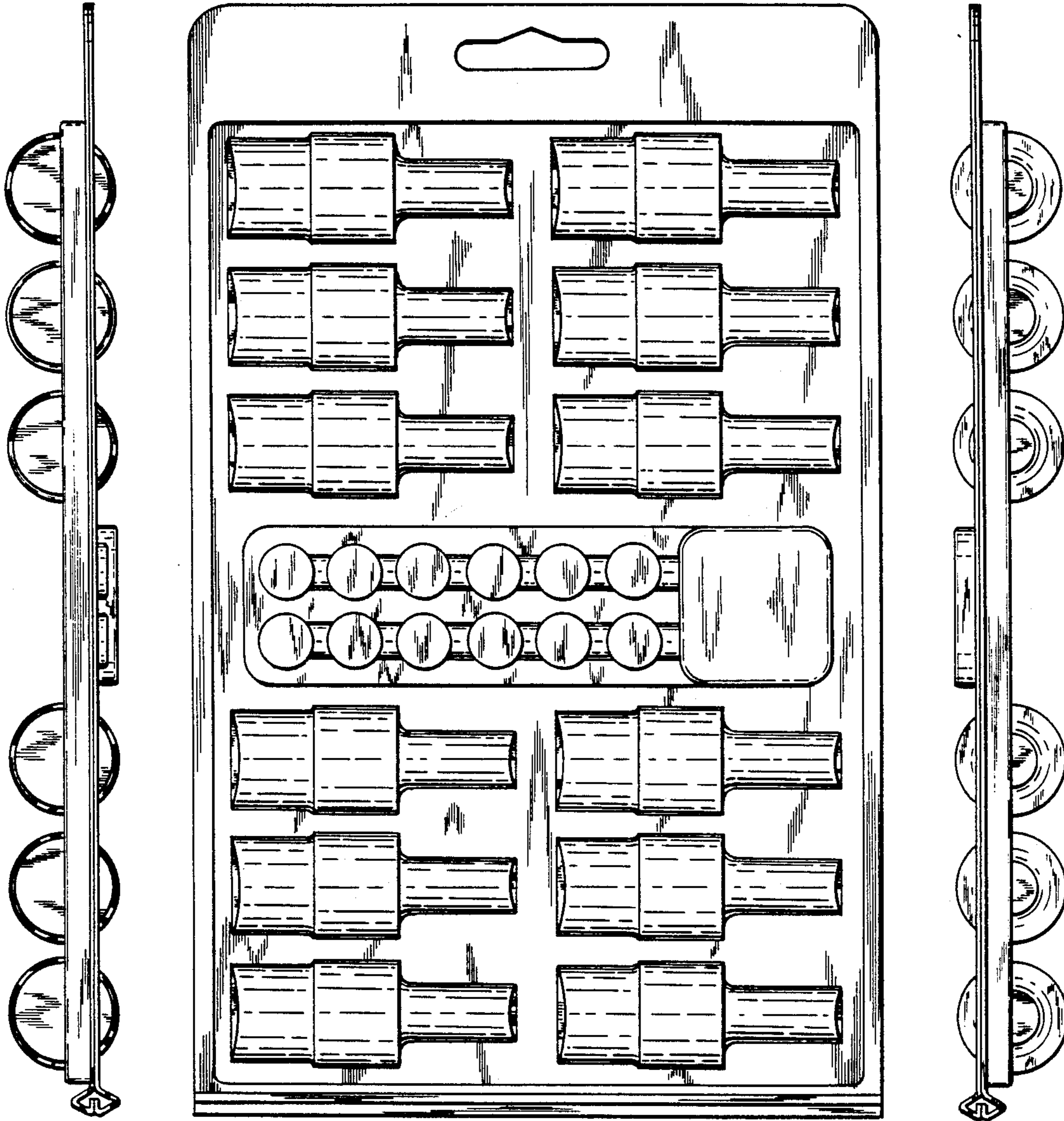
