DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a clock showing my new design, the rear being flat, plain and unornamented; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side being substantially similar thereto; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

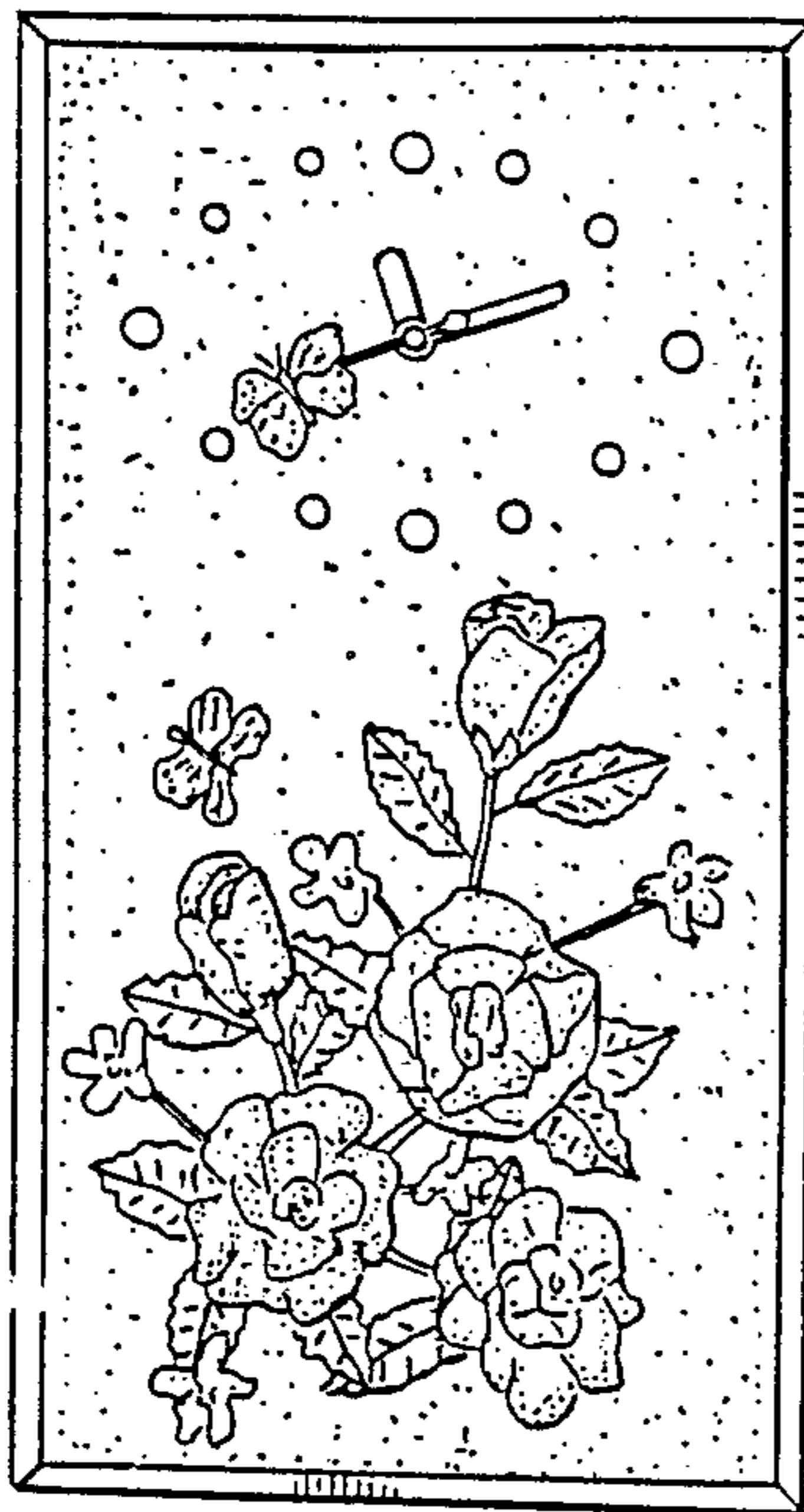

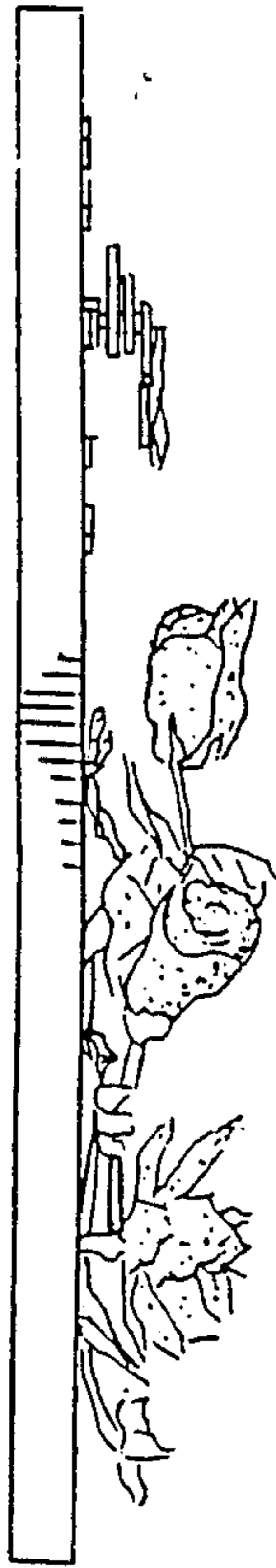

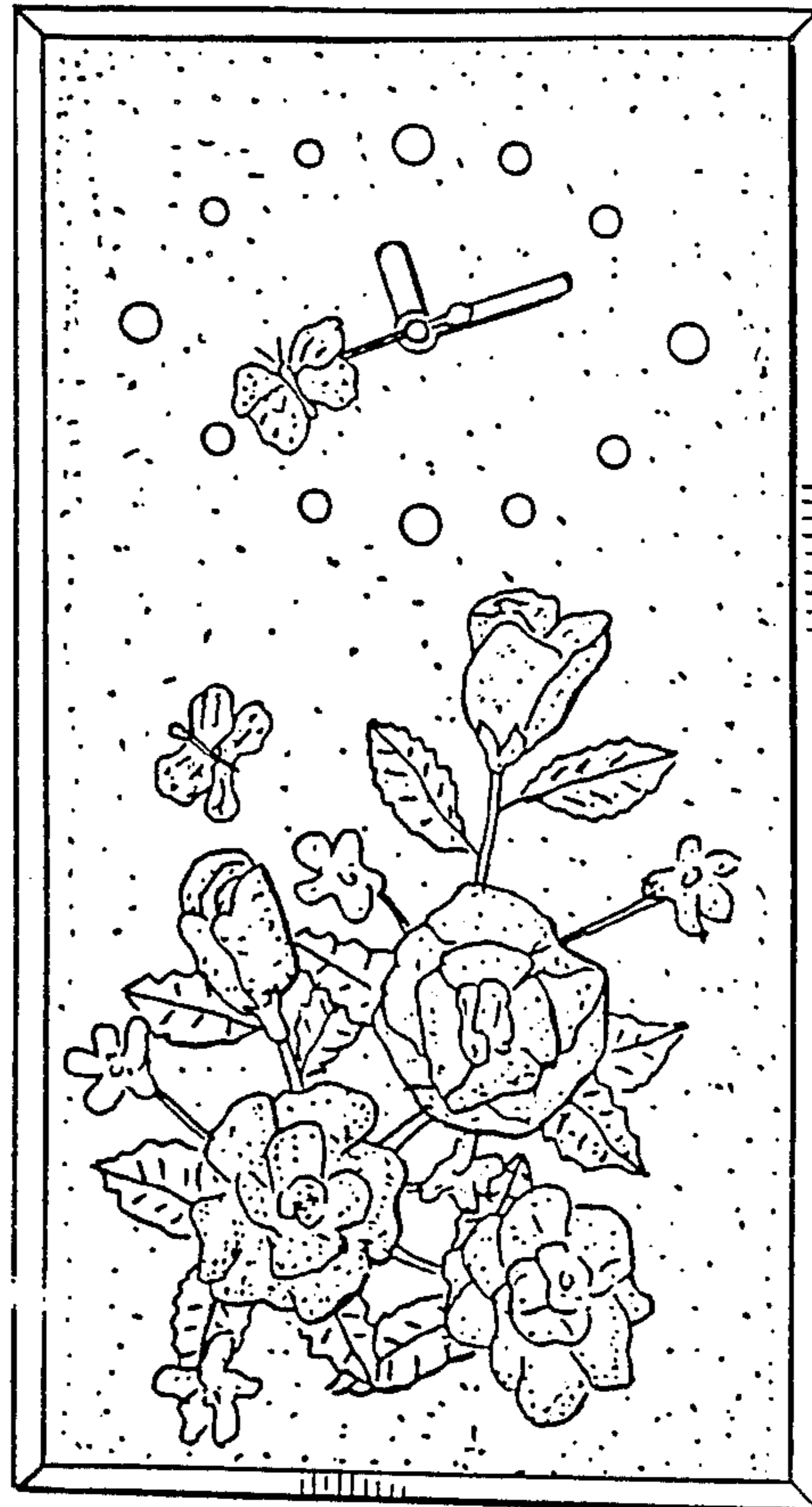

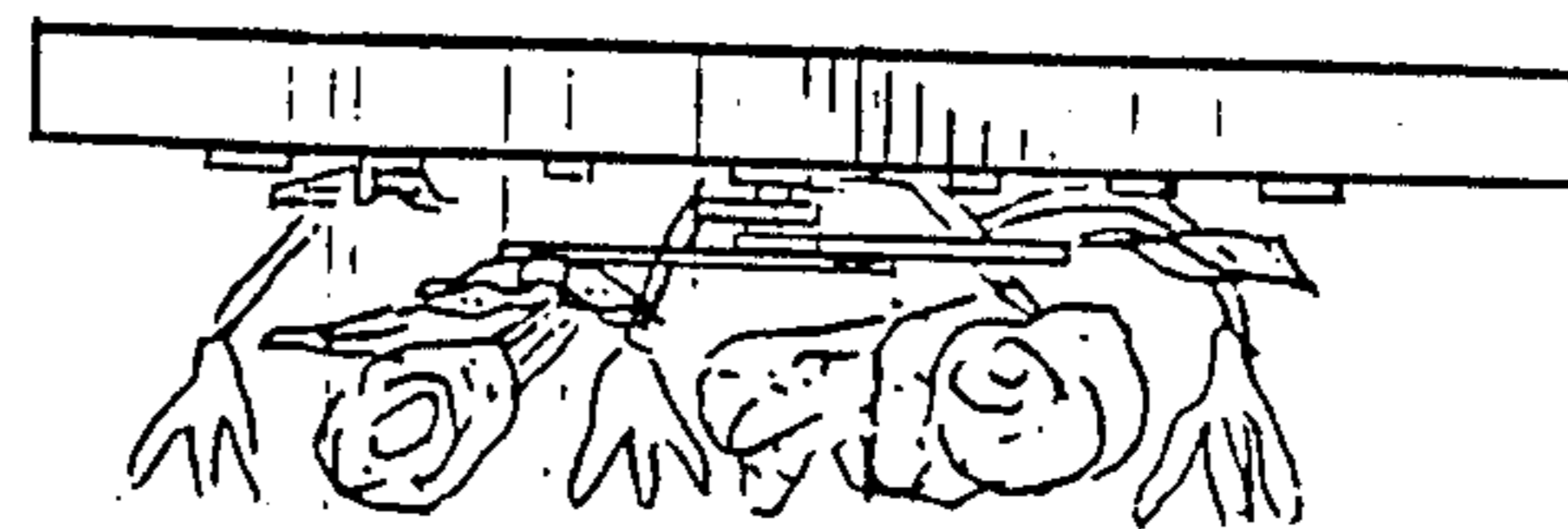
