FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view of the invention.

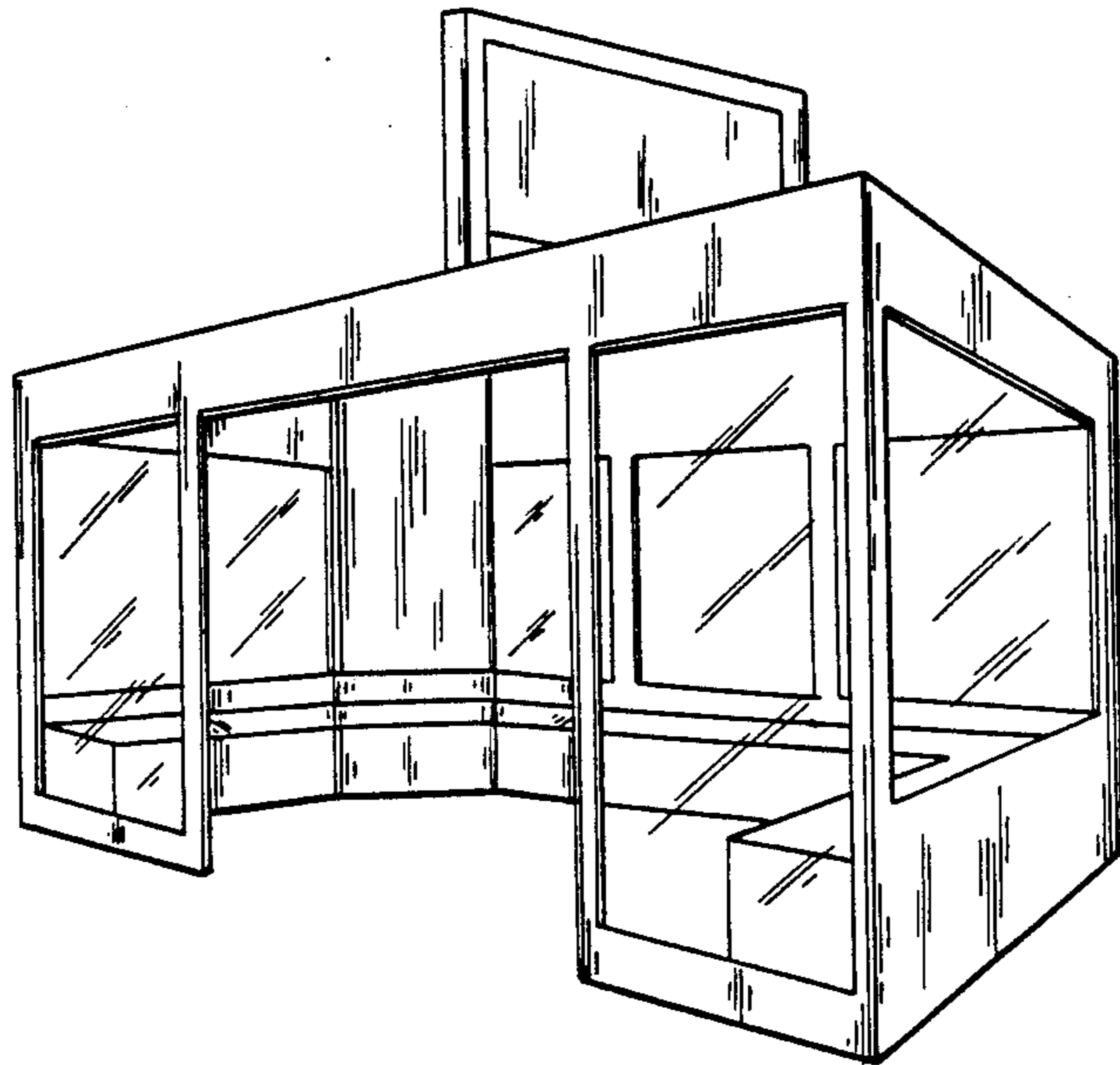
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the invention.

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view of the invention.



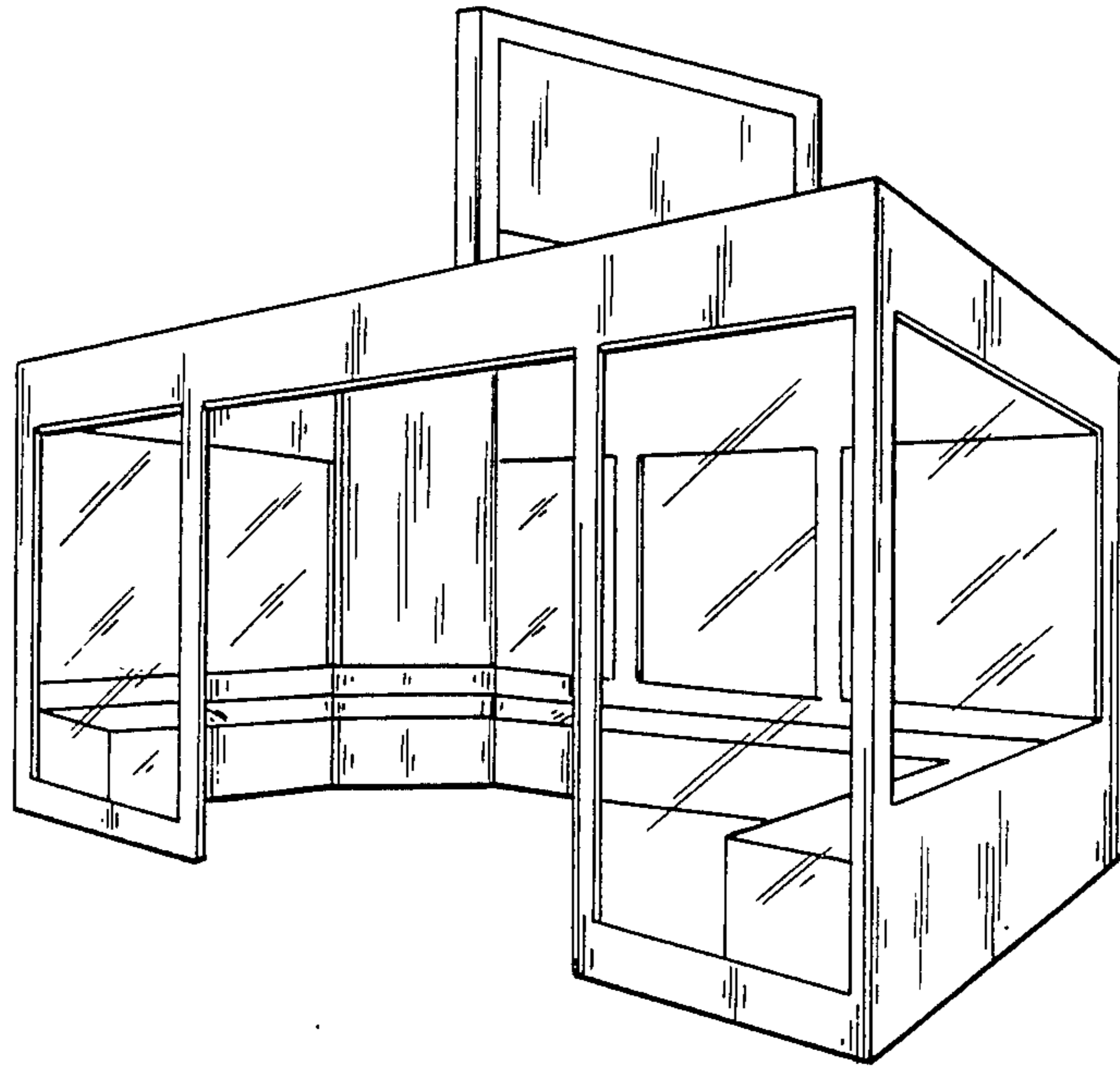

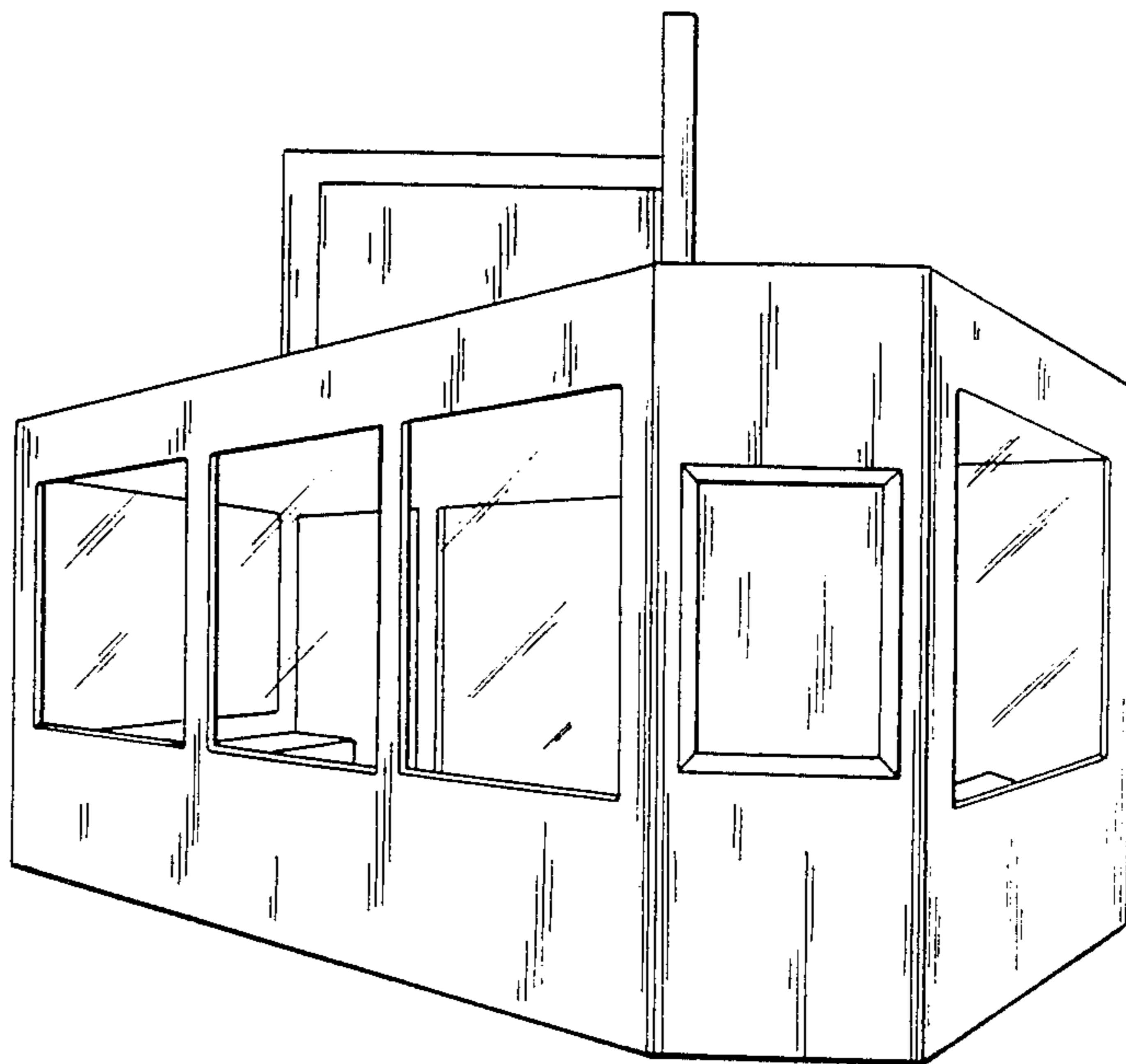

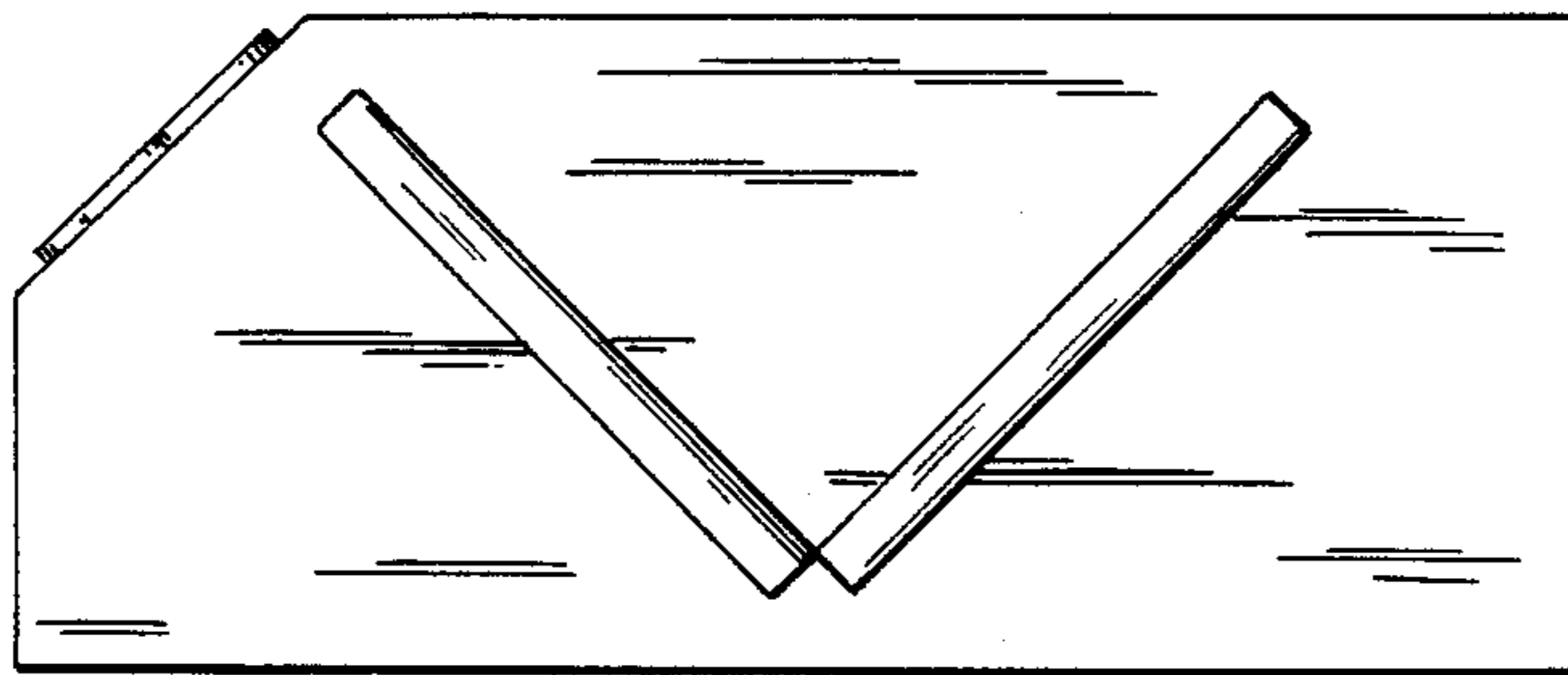

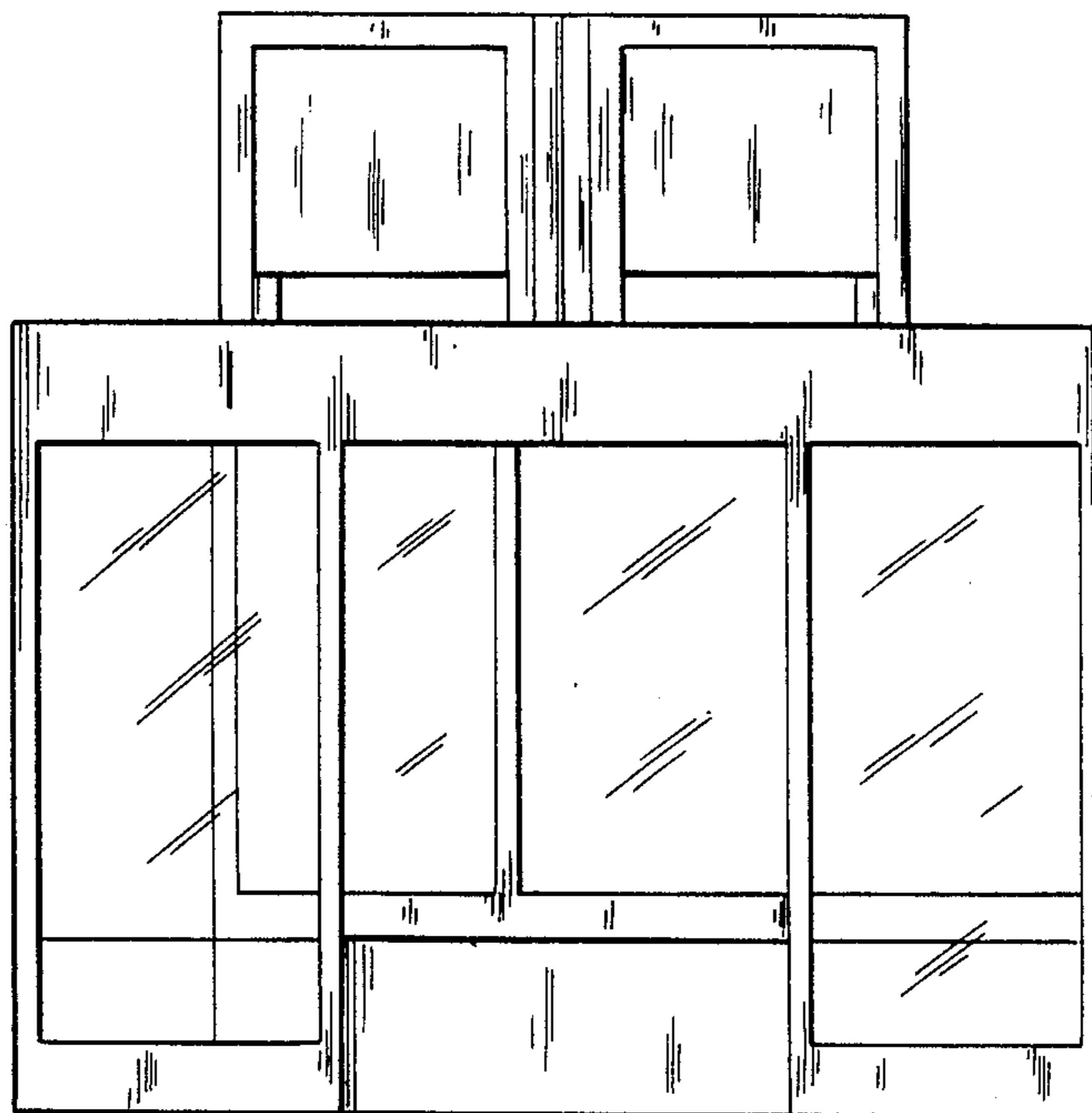

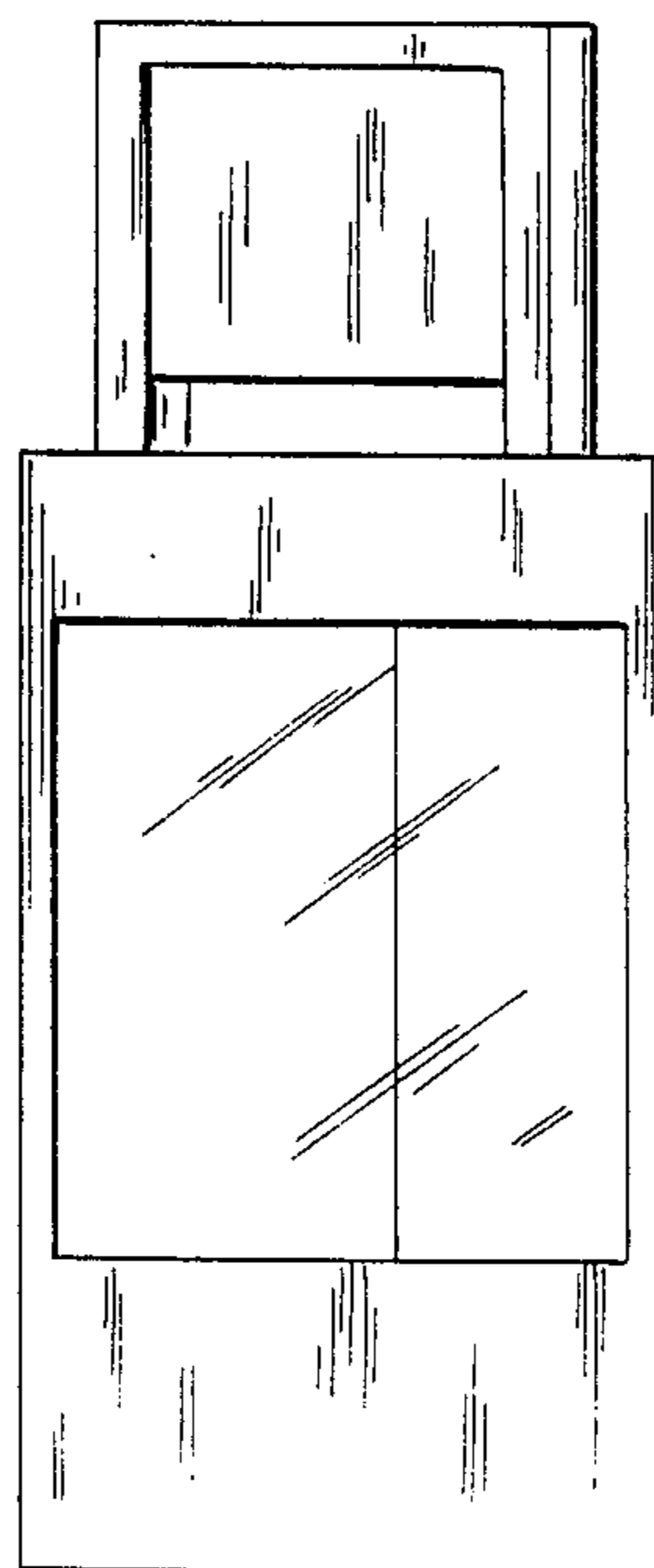

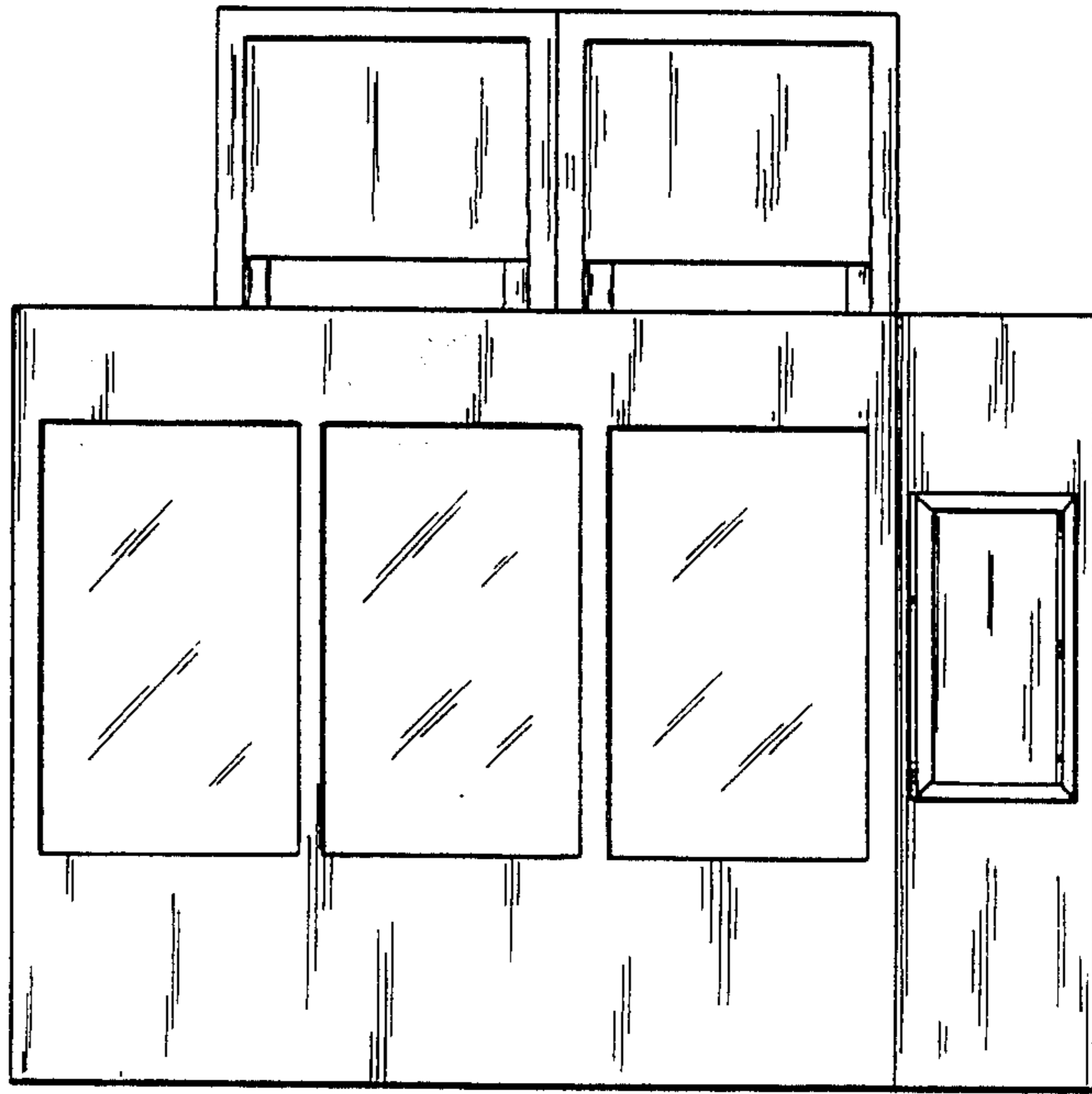

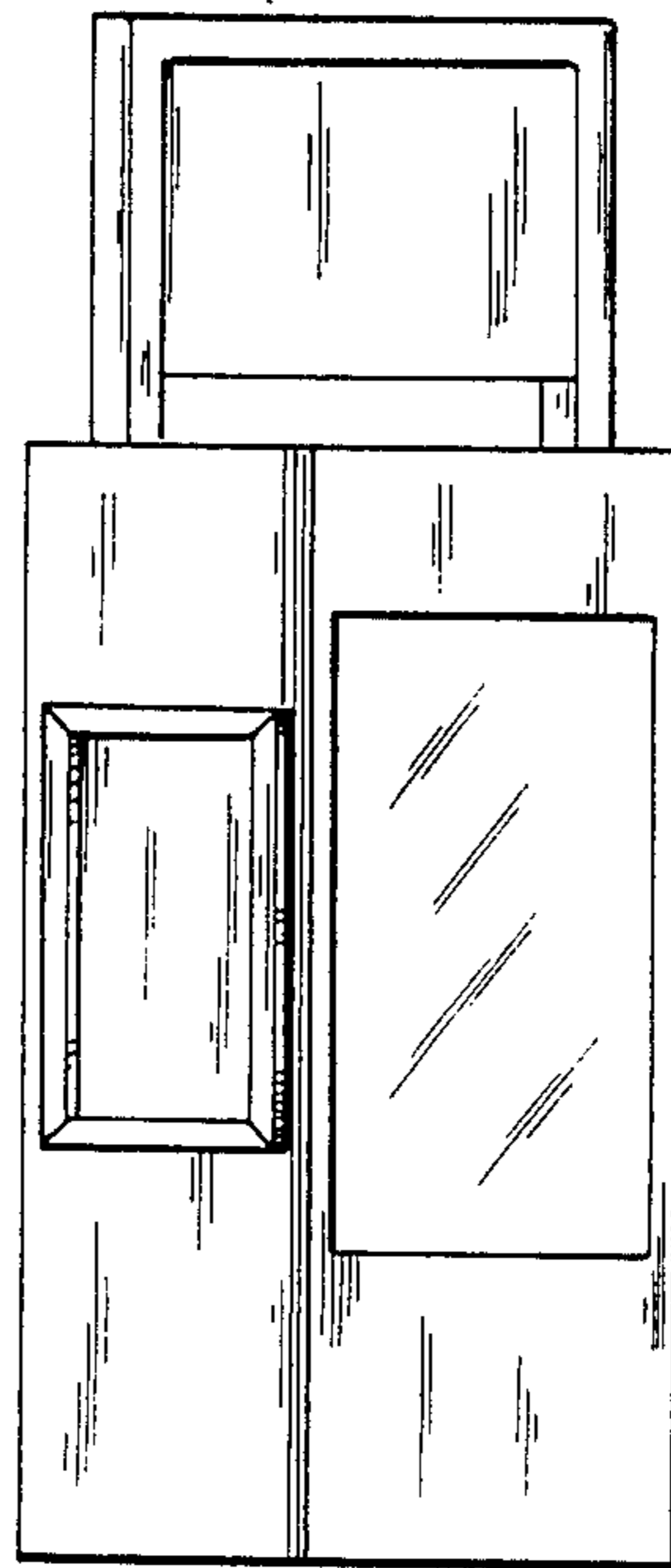
