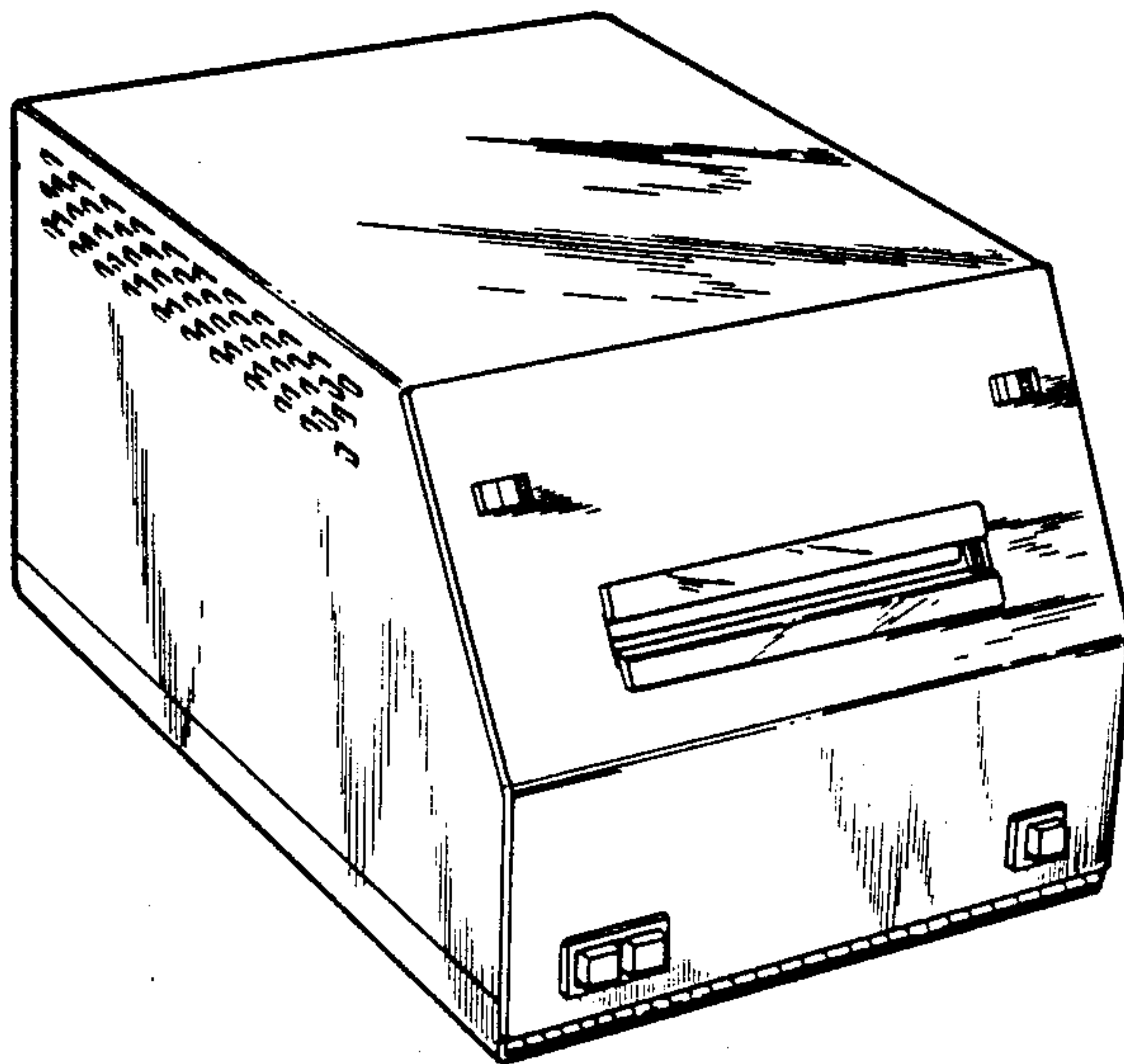

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a 40 column printer cabinet, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top, and left side perspective view of a 40 column printer cabinet showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a rear, top, and right side perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



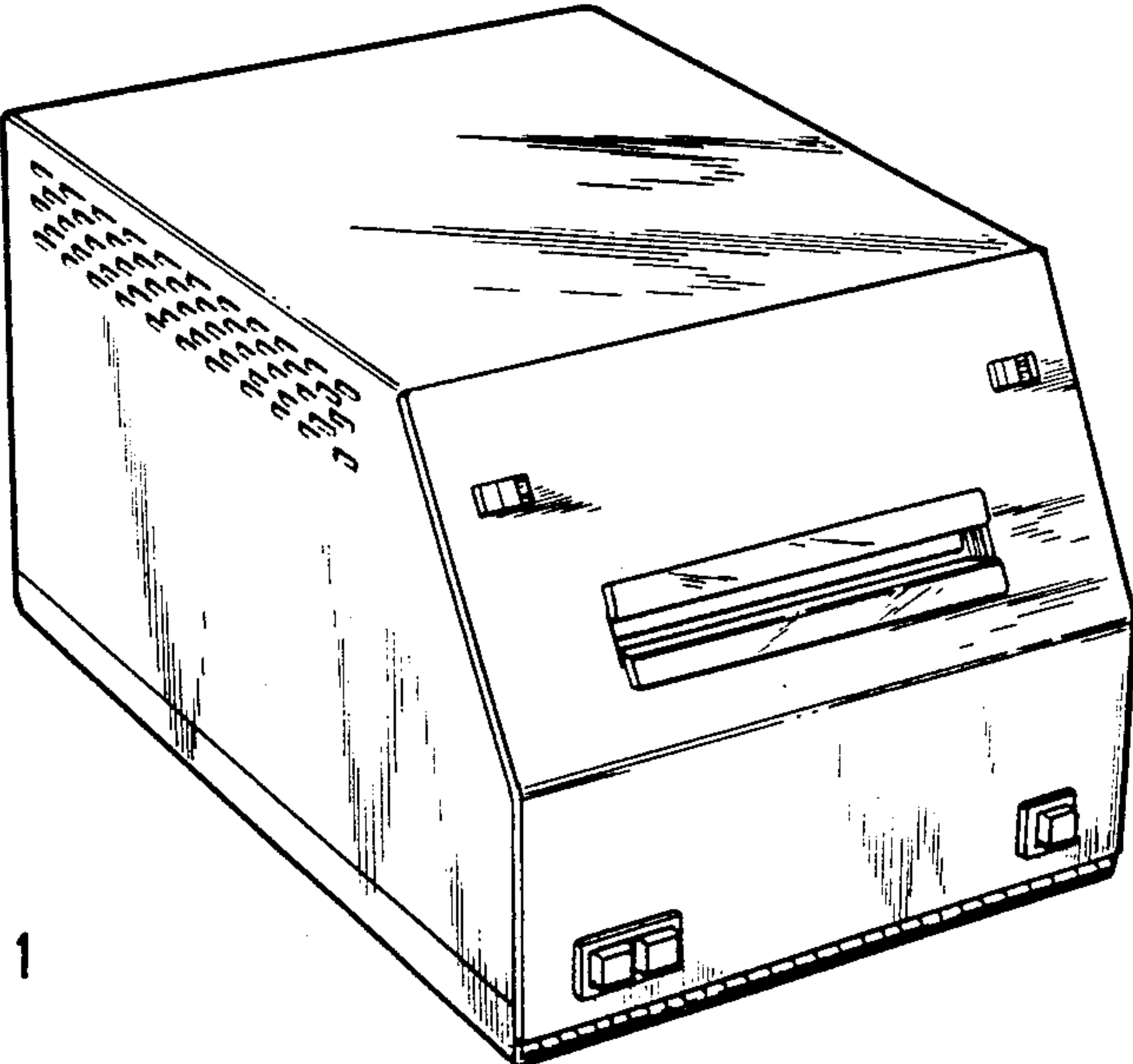

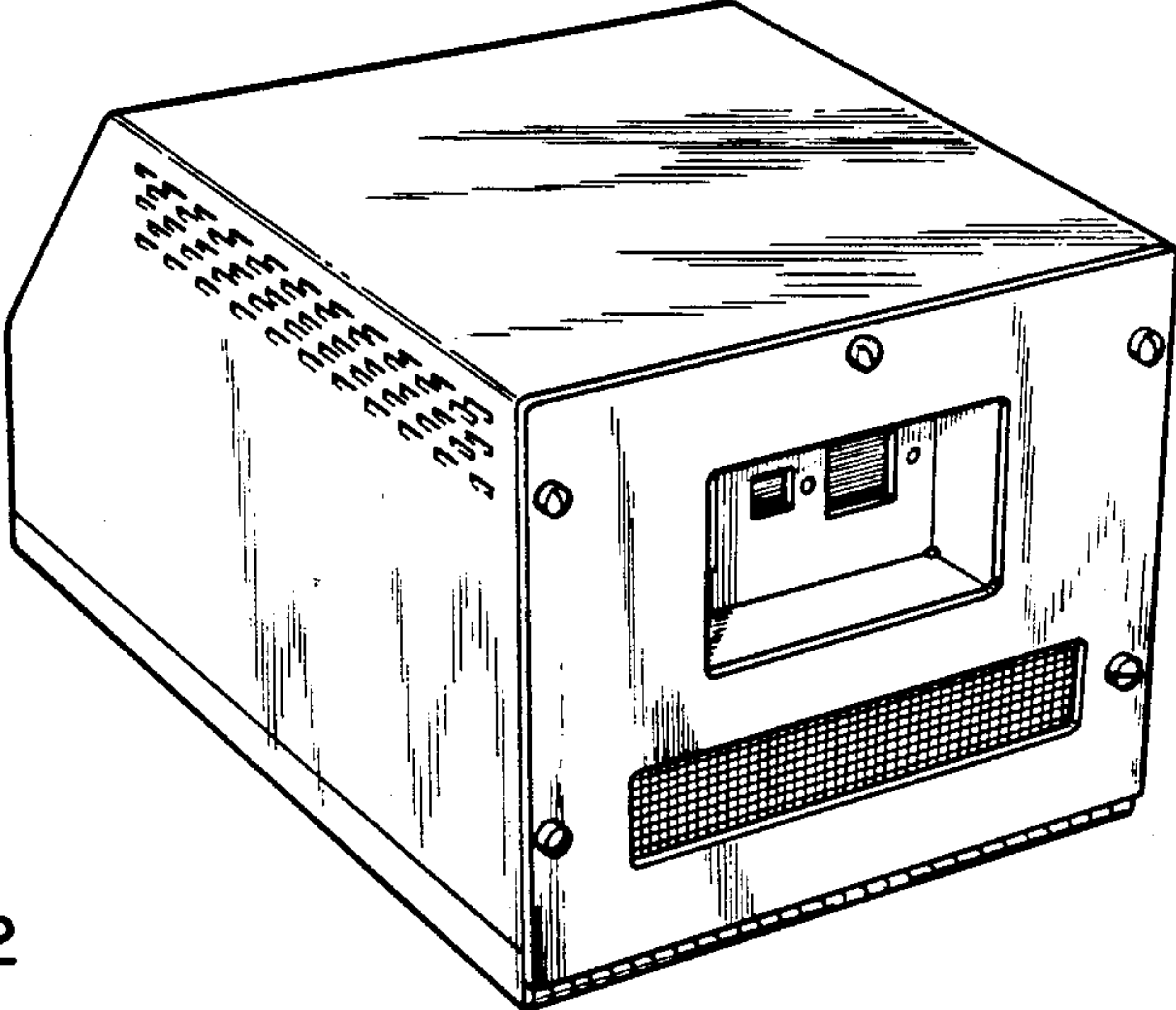

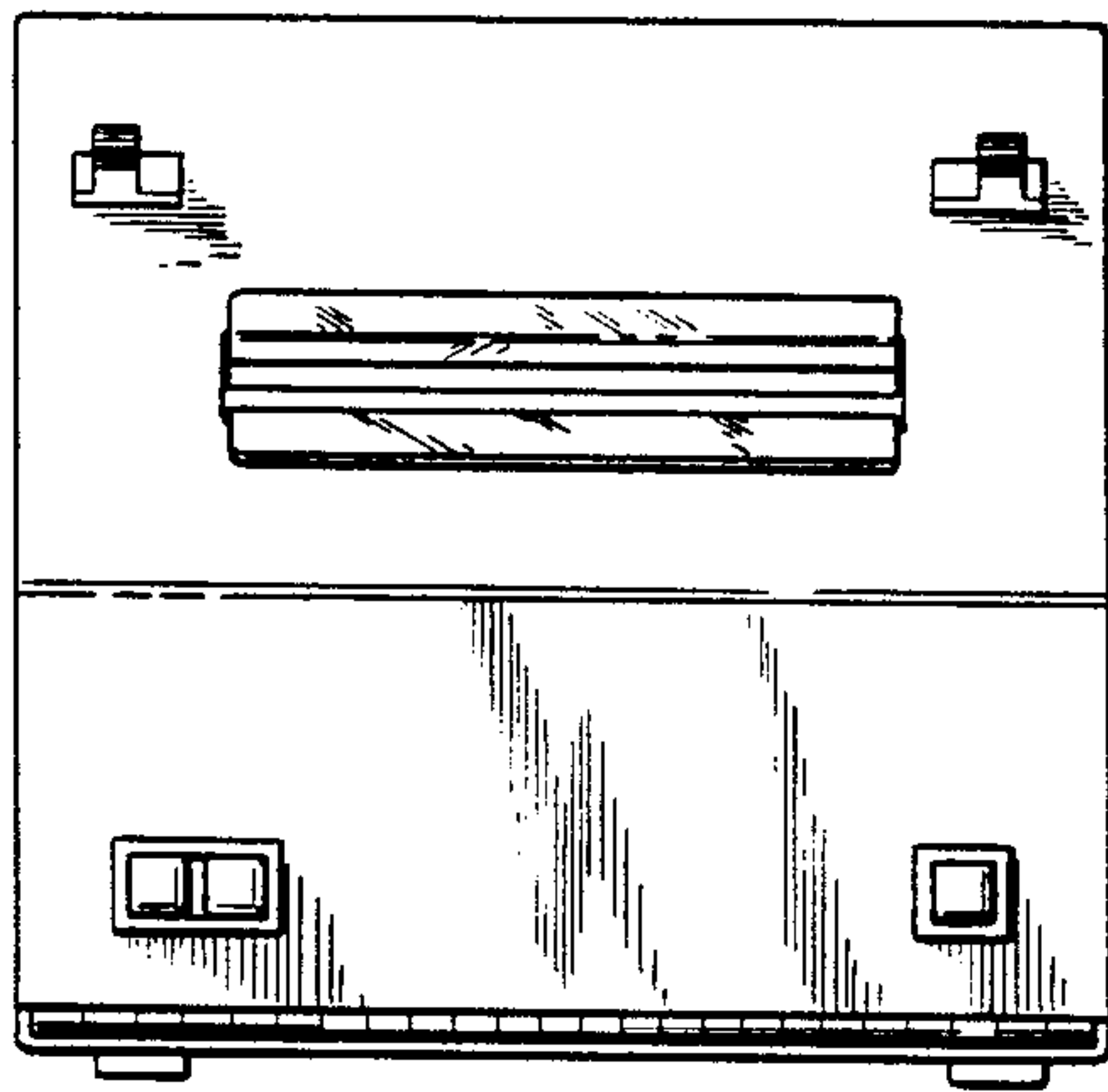
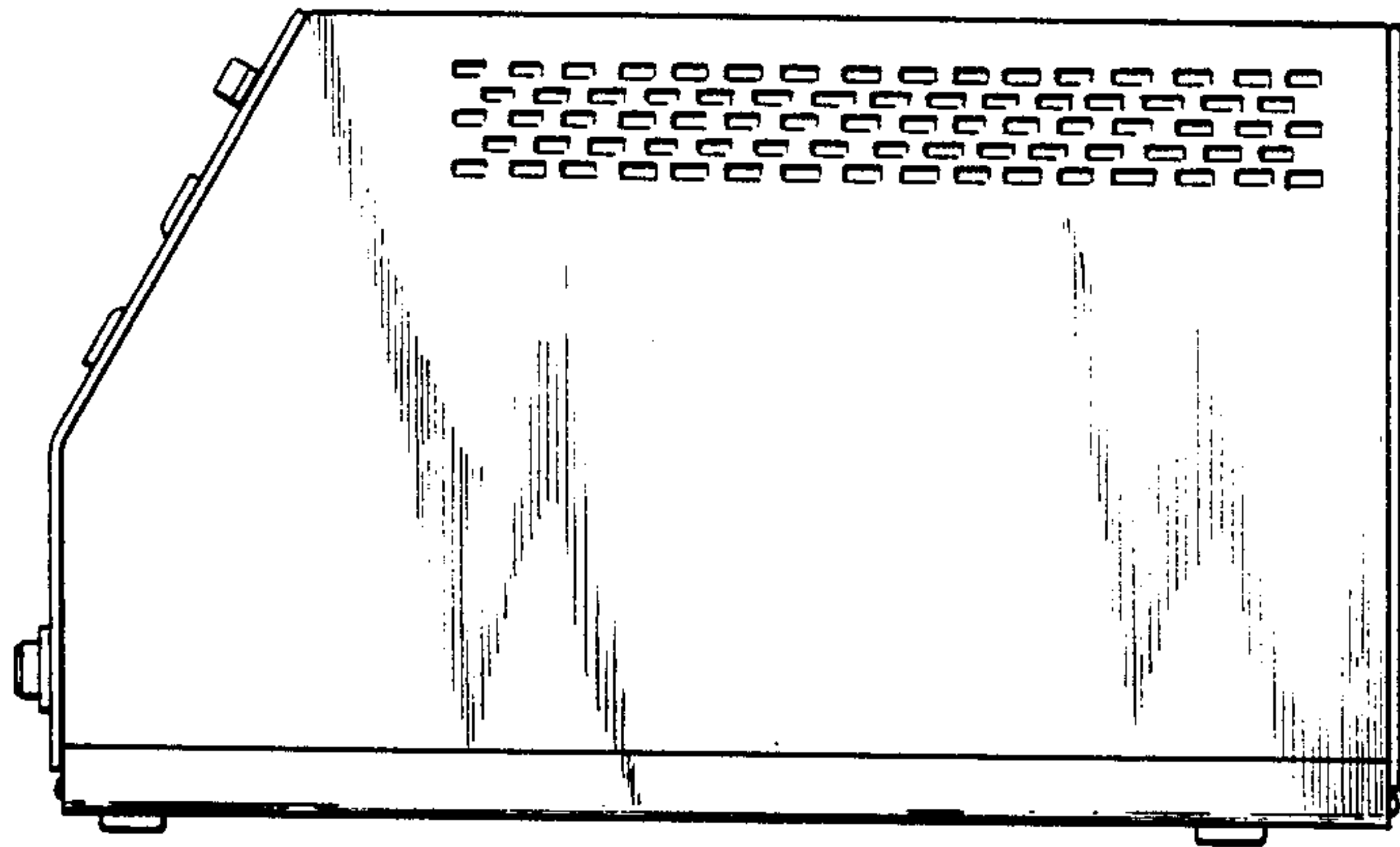
