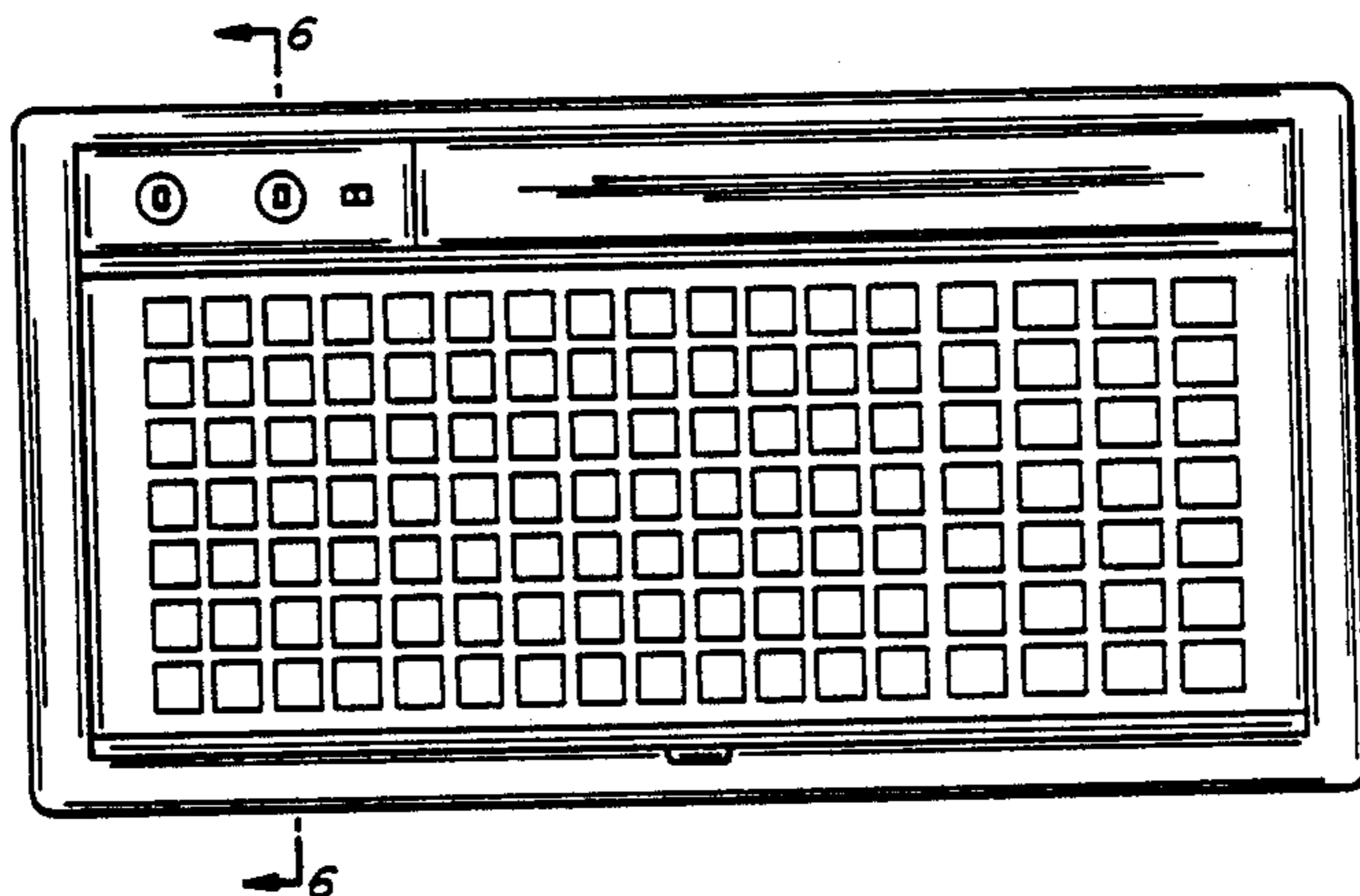

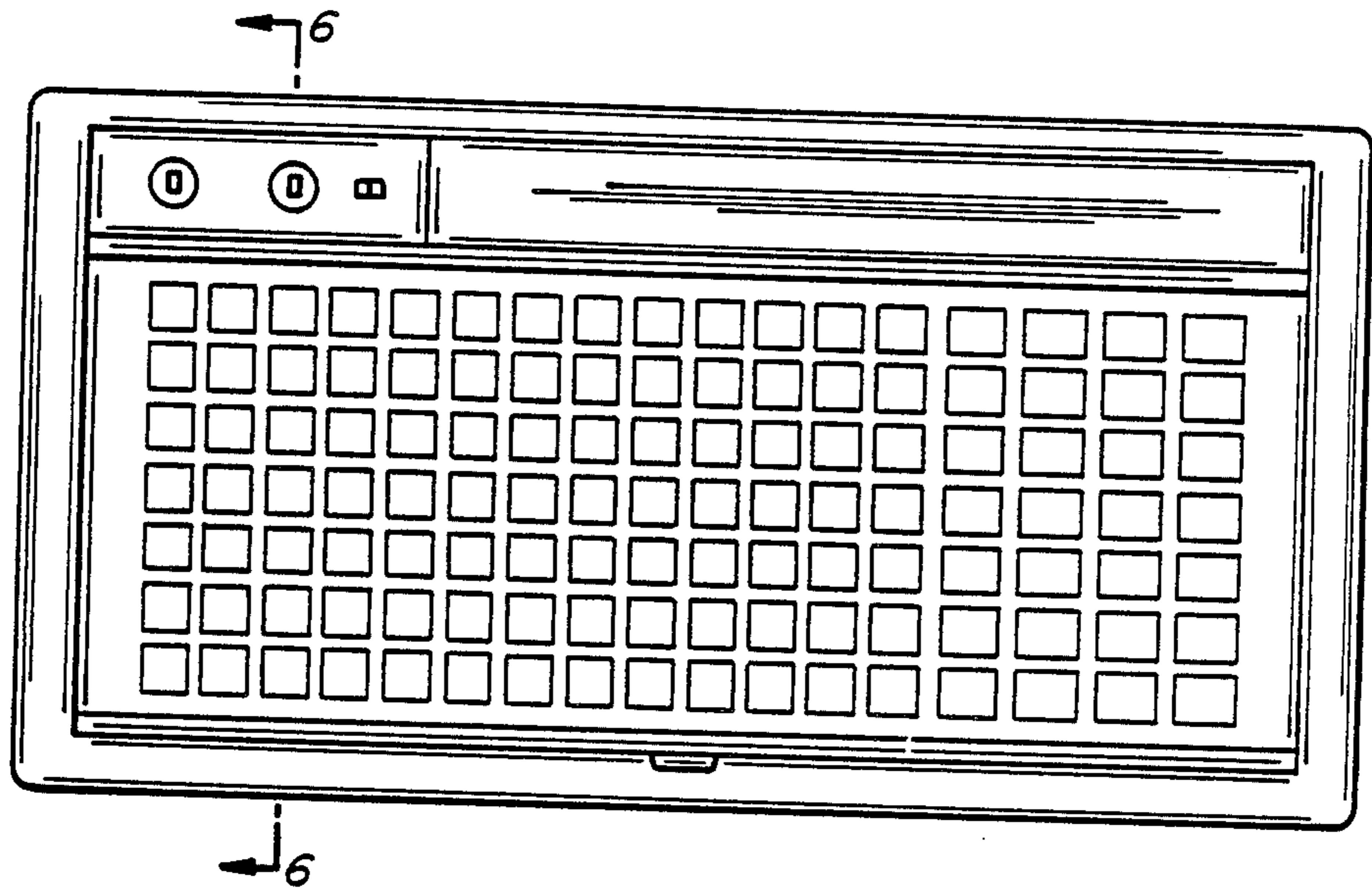
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a keyboard for cash register, as shown and described.

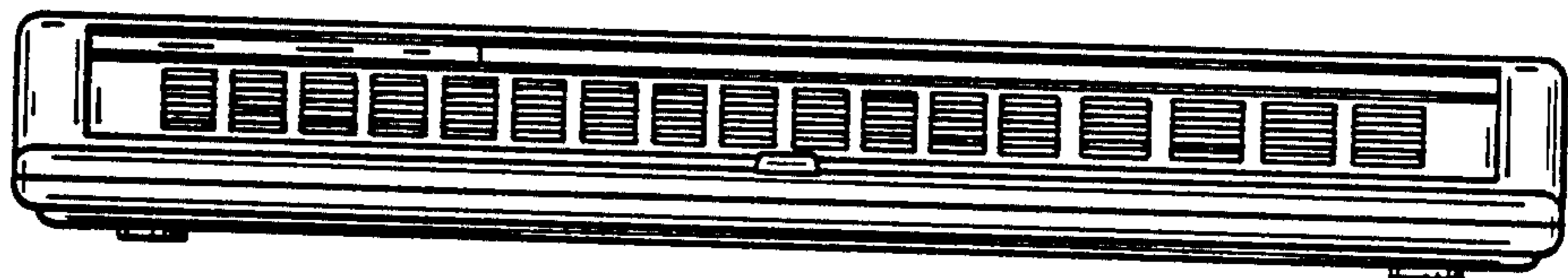
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a keyboard for cash register showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof; and
FIG. 6 is an enlarged sectional view taken along the line 6—6 of FIG. 1 thereof with internal parts omitted.

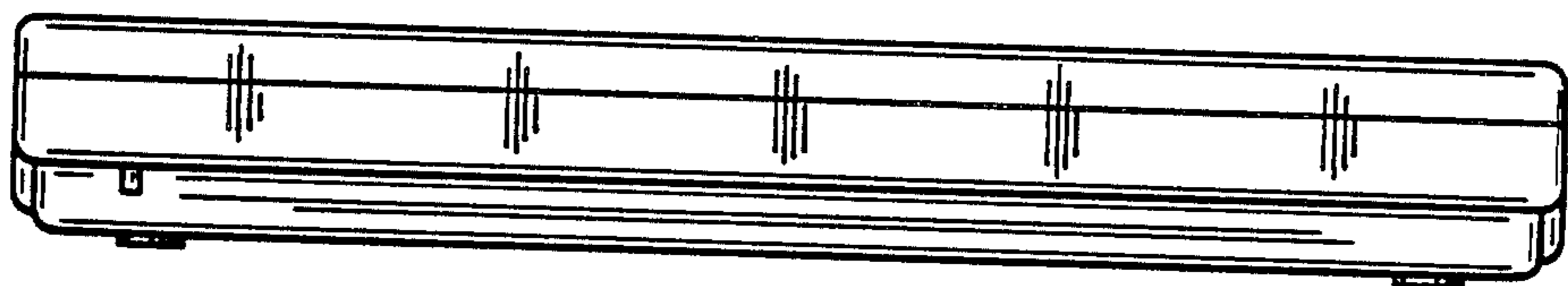




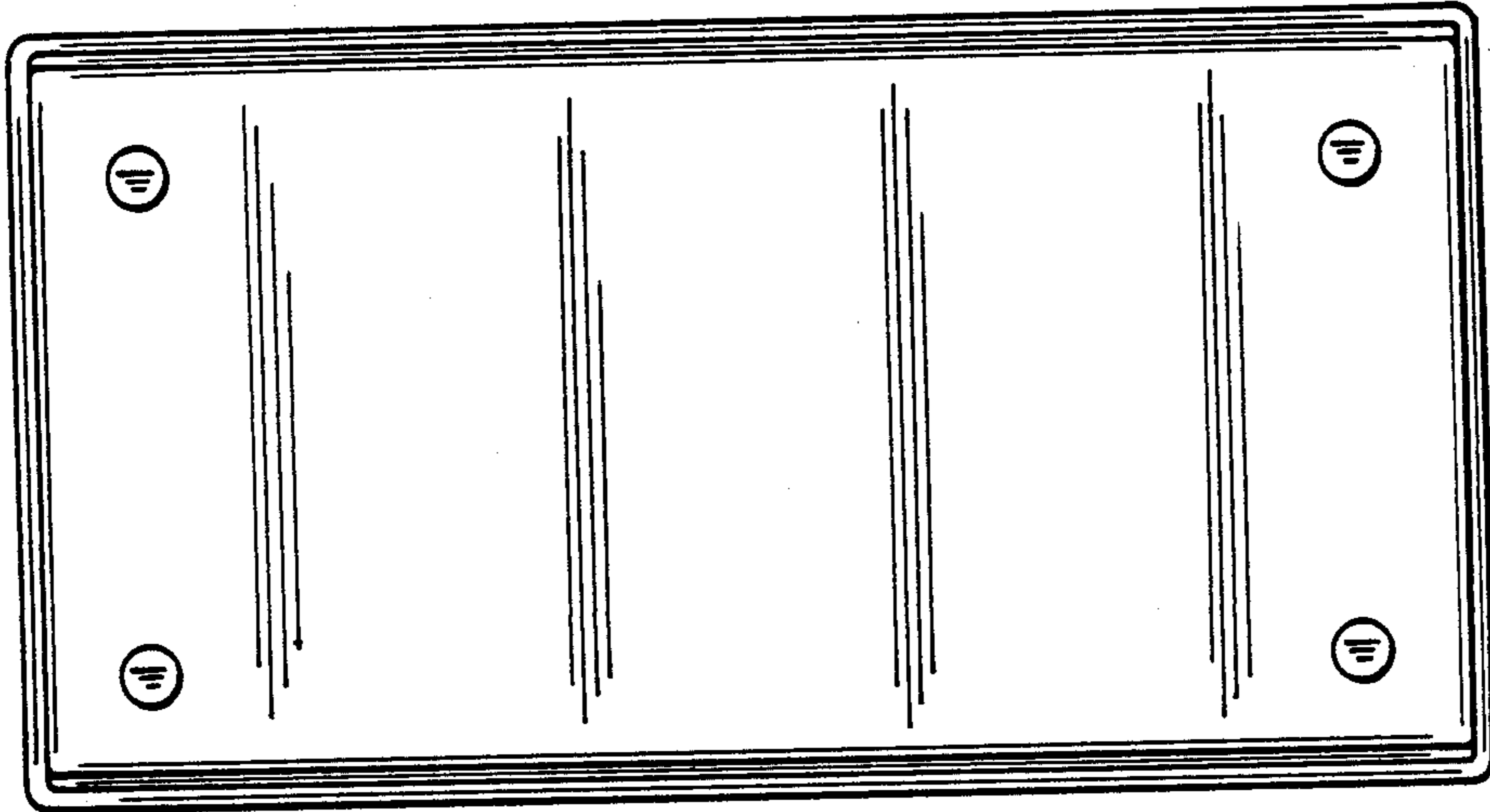

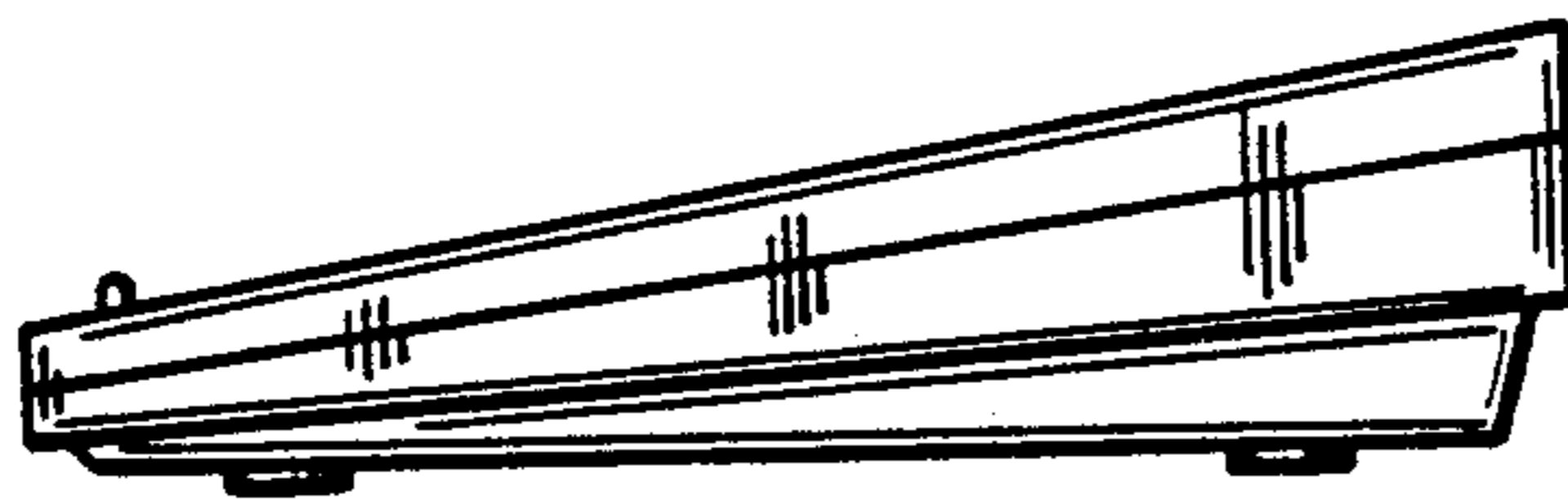

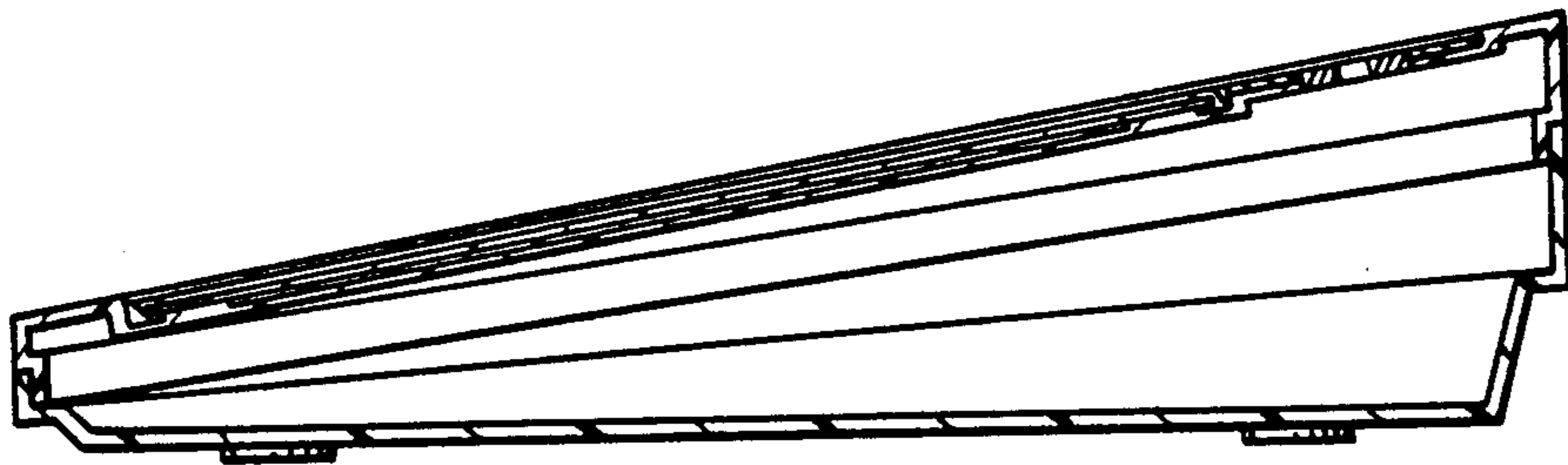
