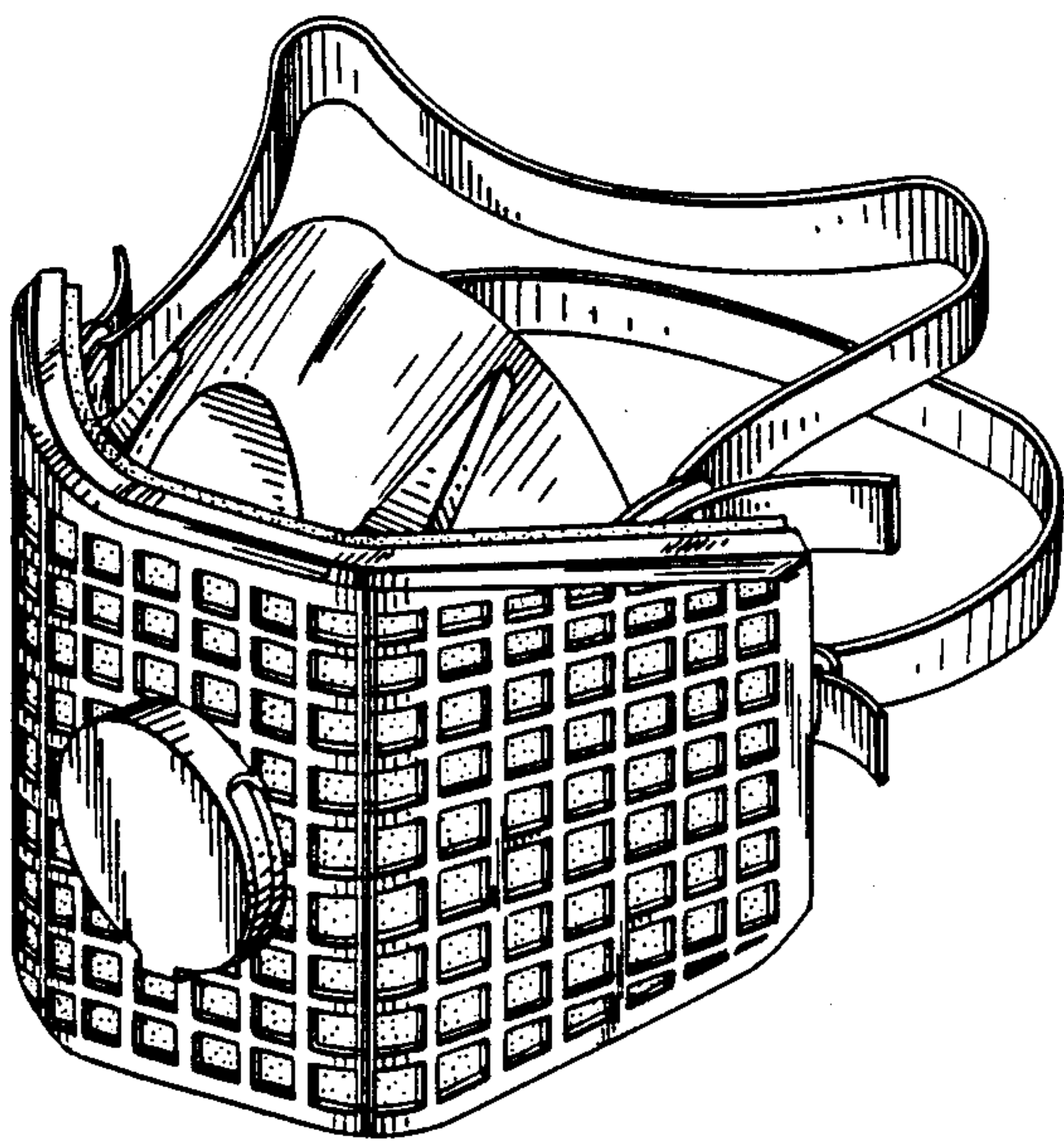

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of FIG. 2.



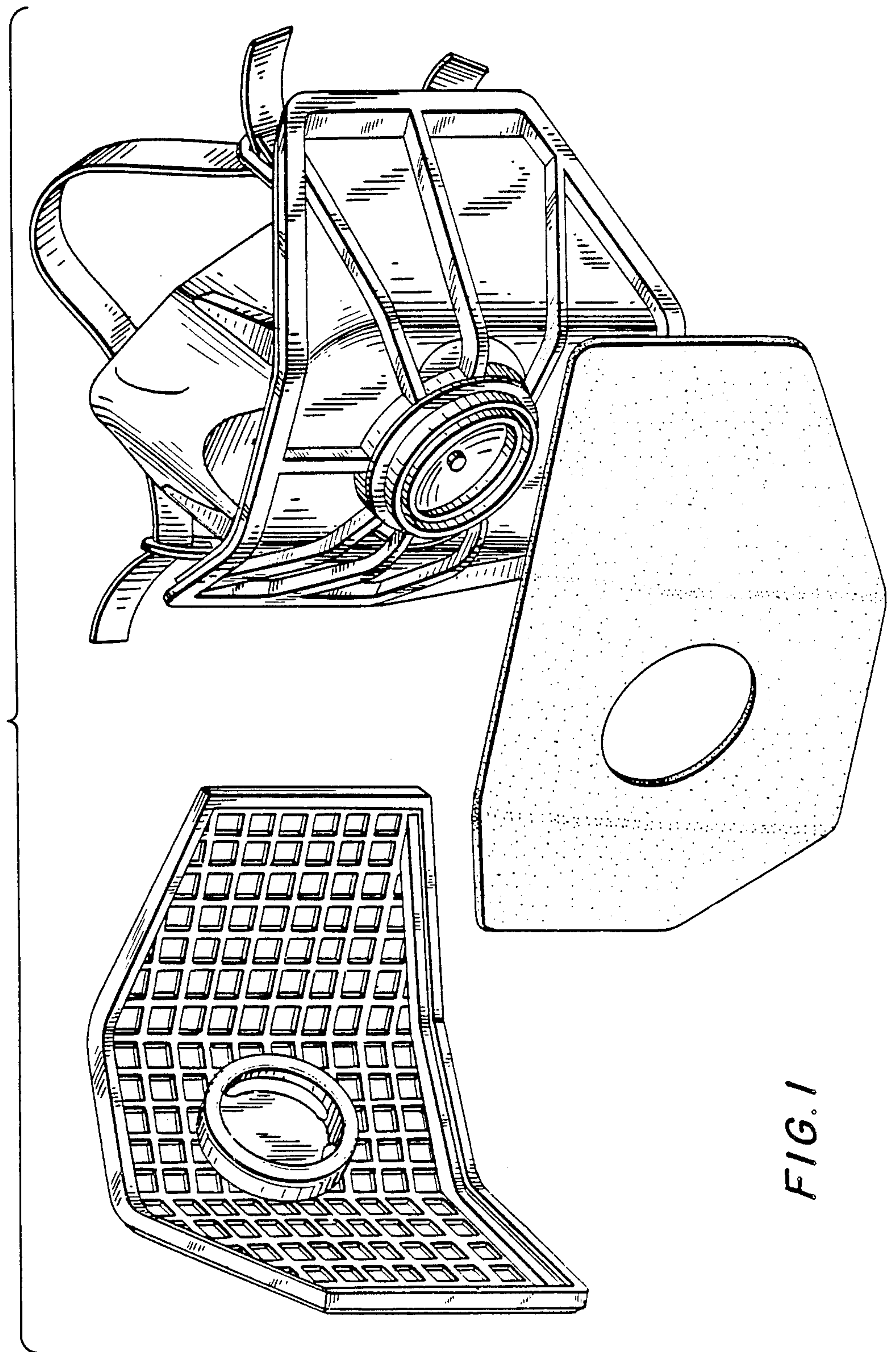

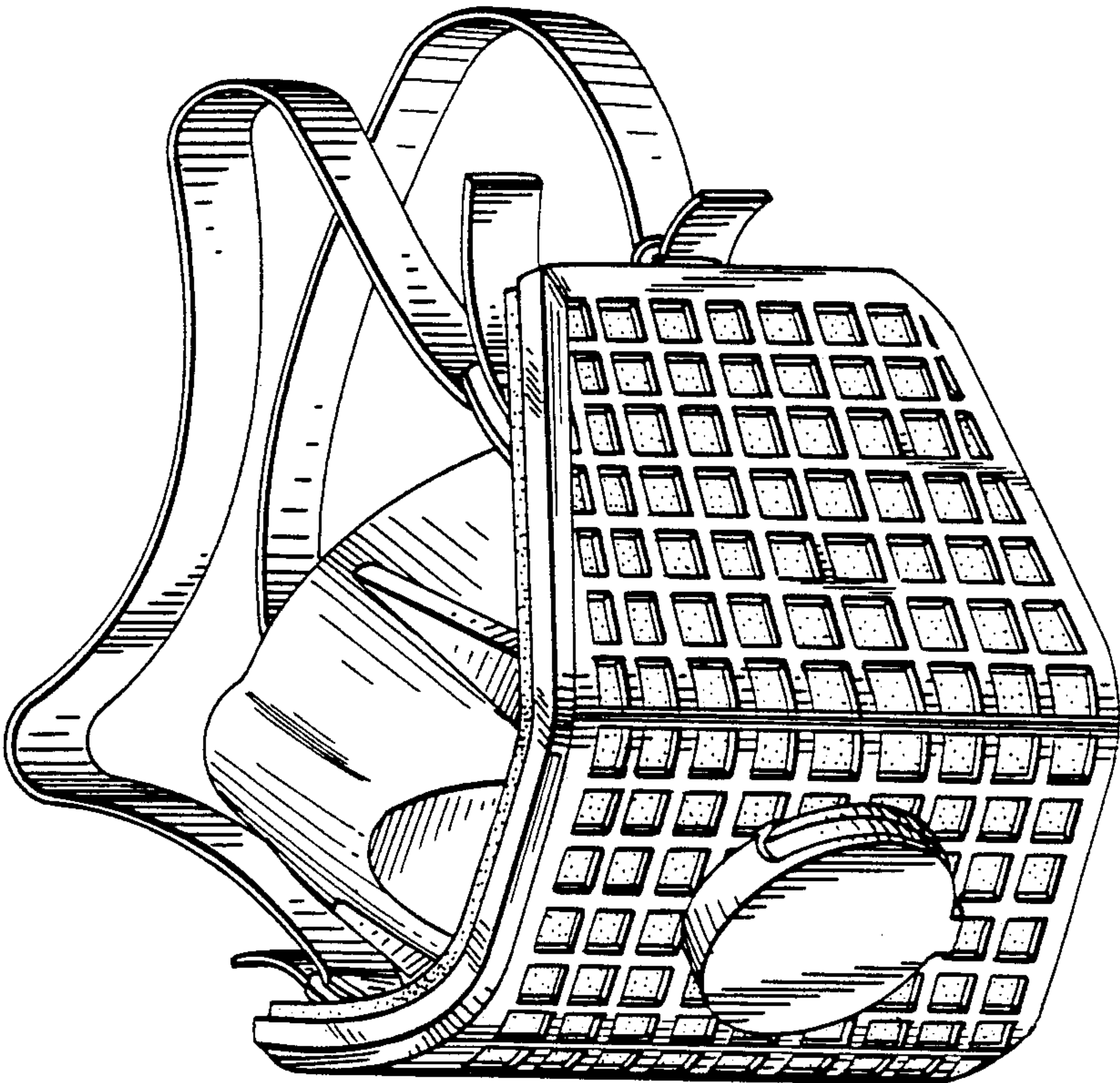
