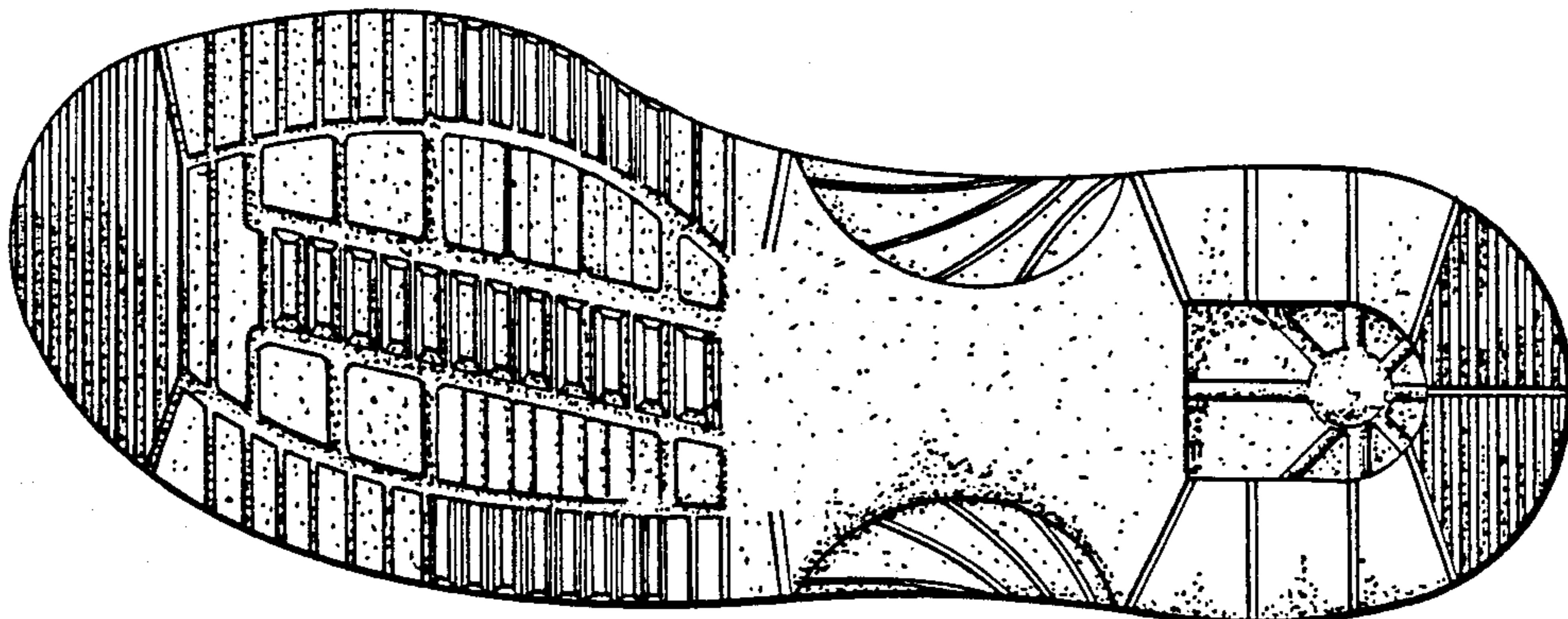

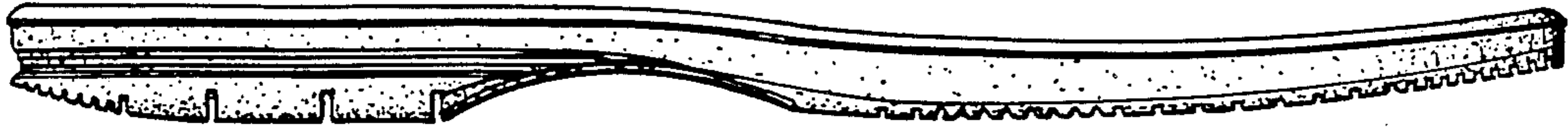
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a shoe sole, as shown and described.

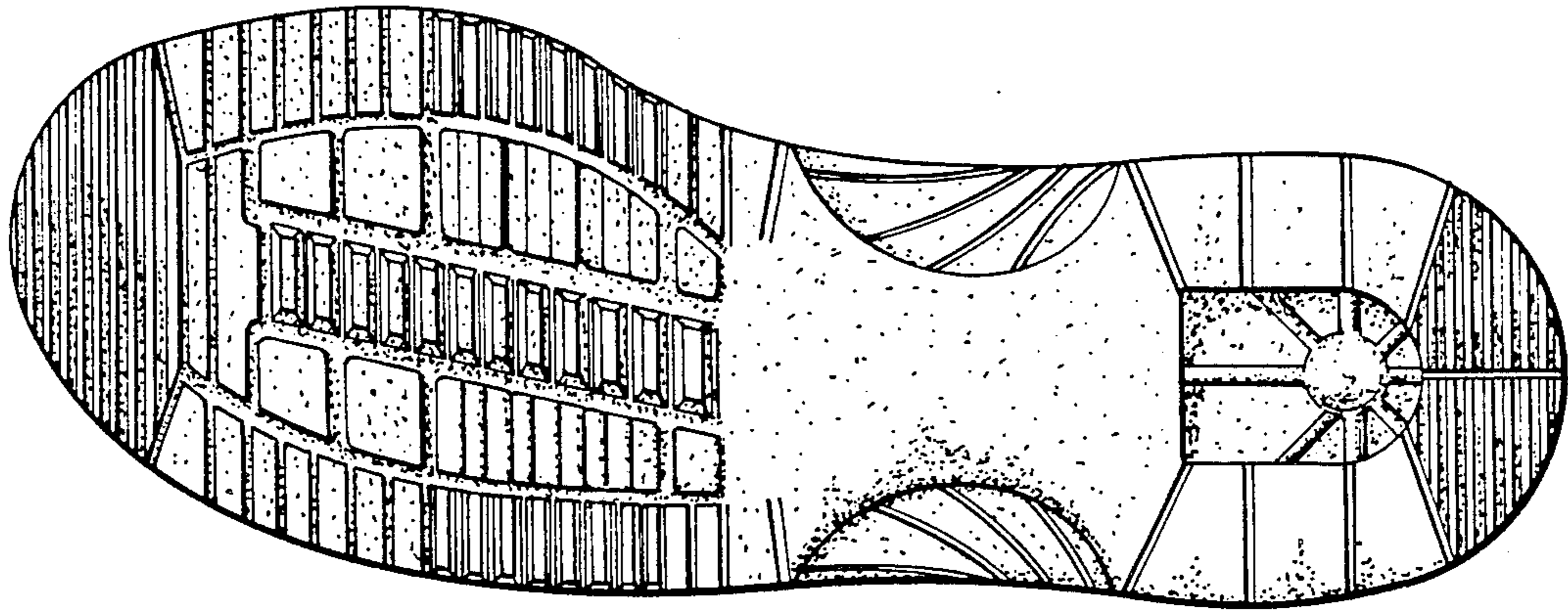
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a shoe sole showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof.





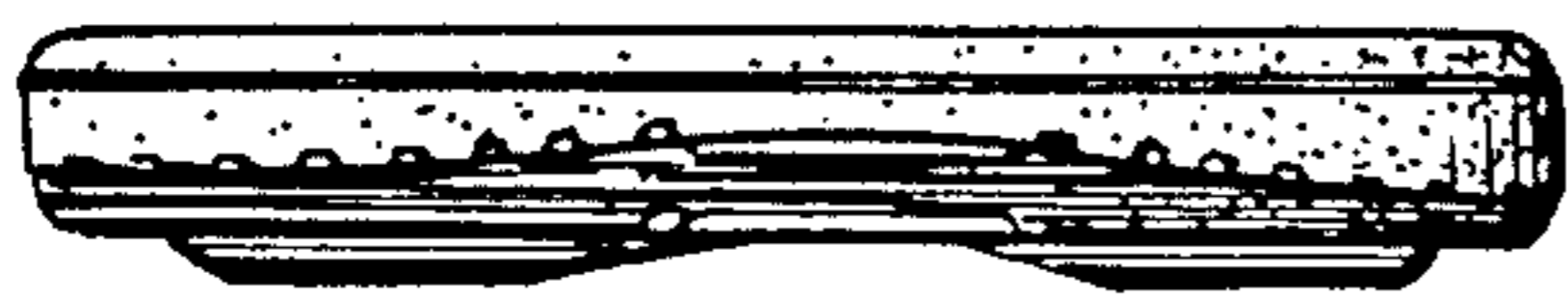

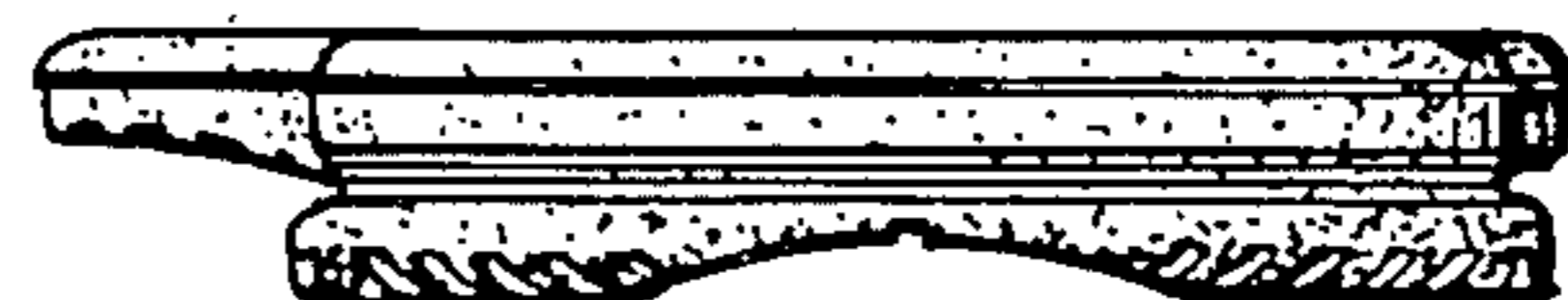
