FIG. 8 is a right end elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 9 is a left end elevational view thereof; and,  
FIG. 10 is a bottom plan thereof.

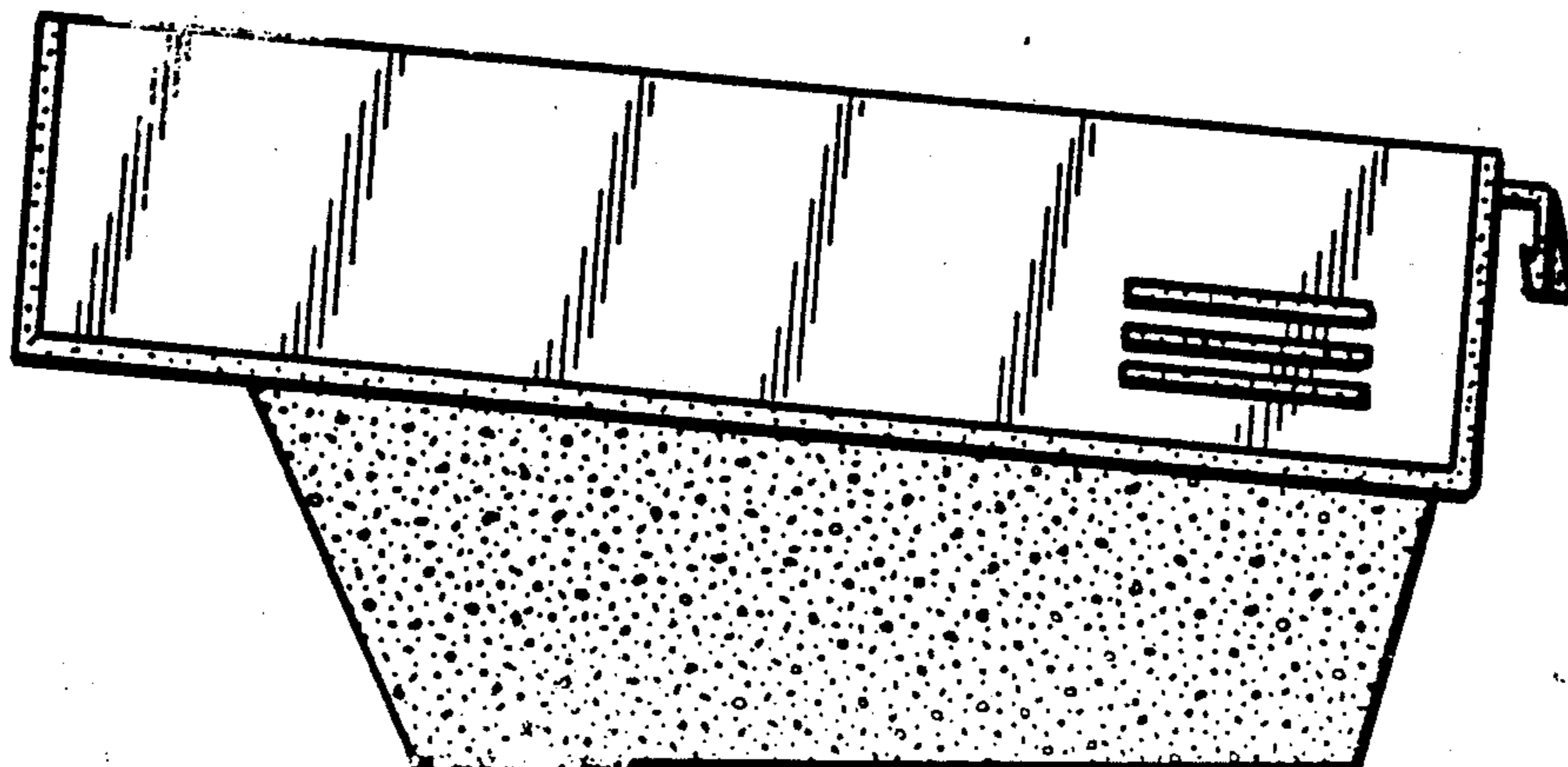
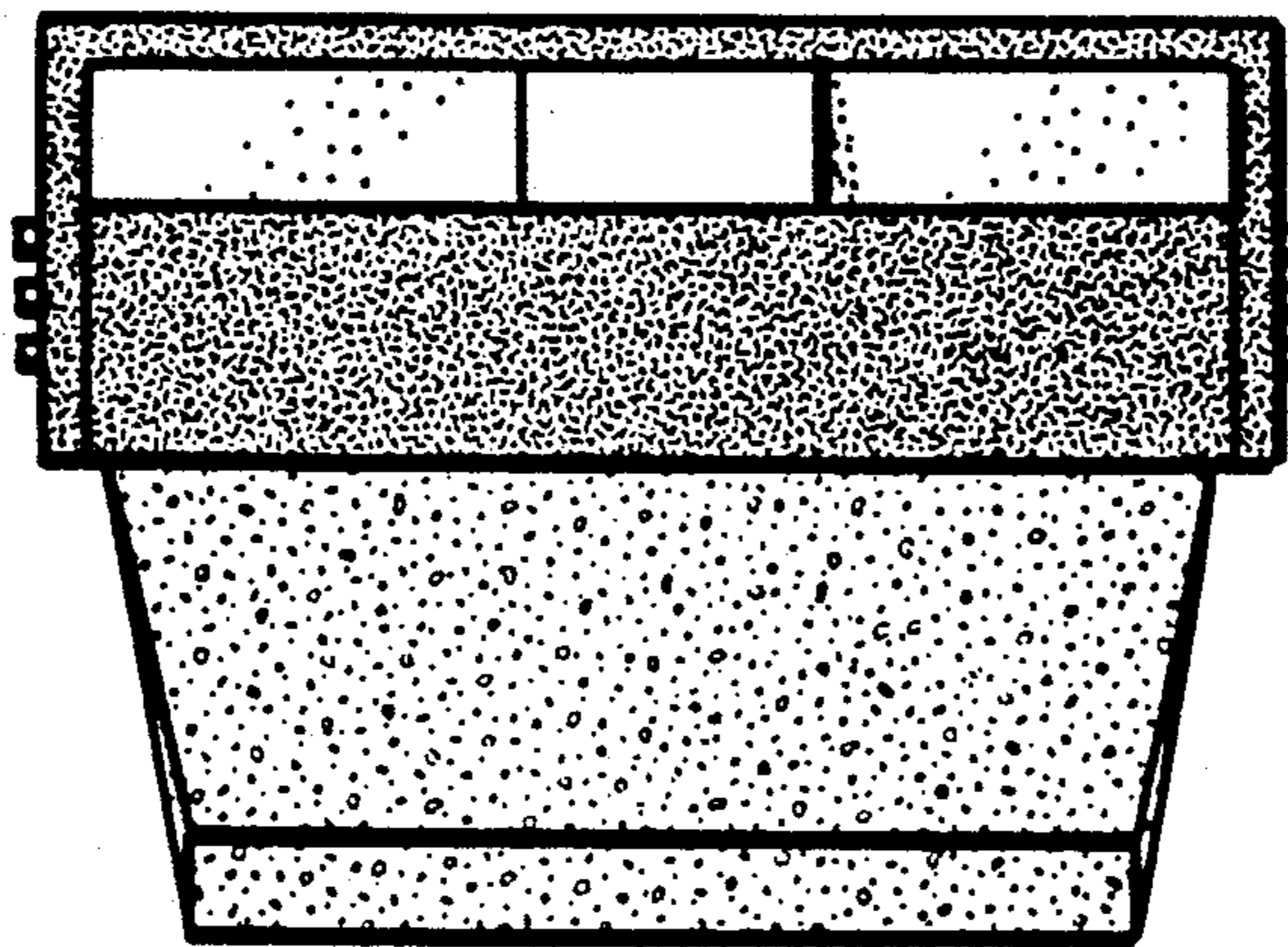

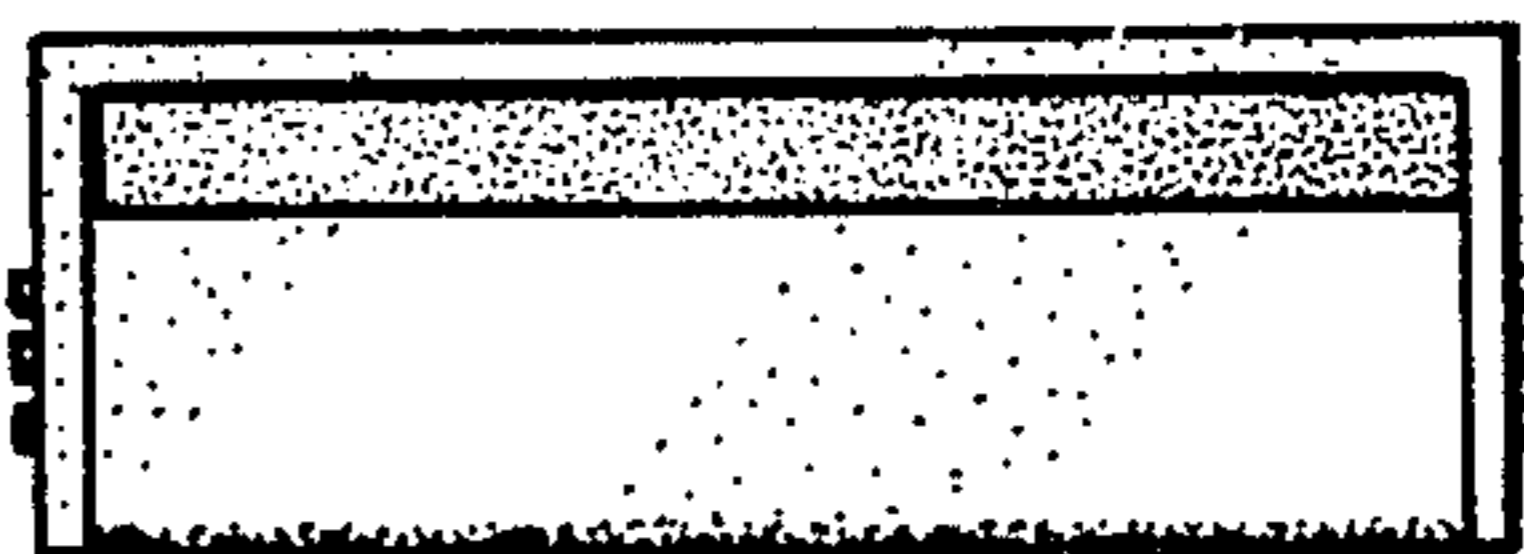

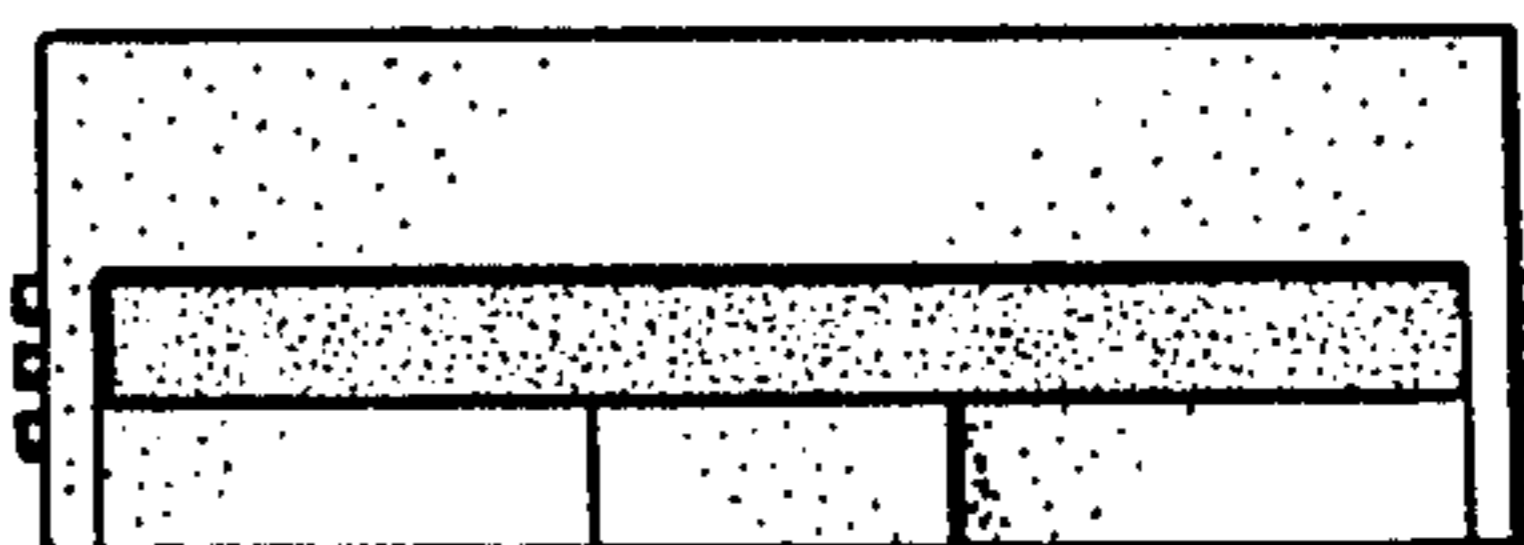

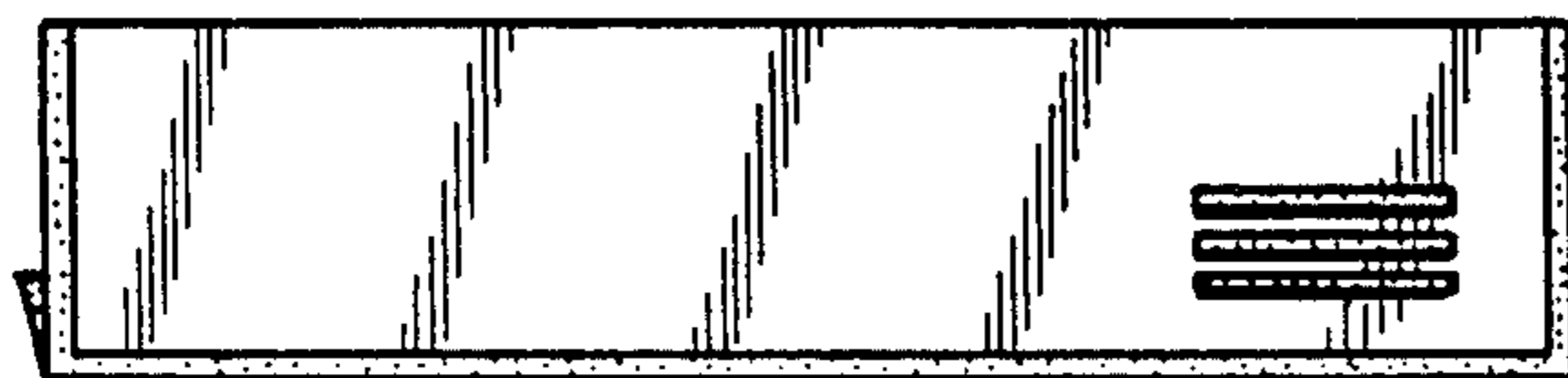

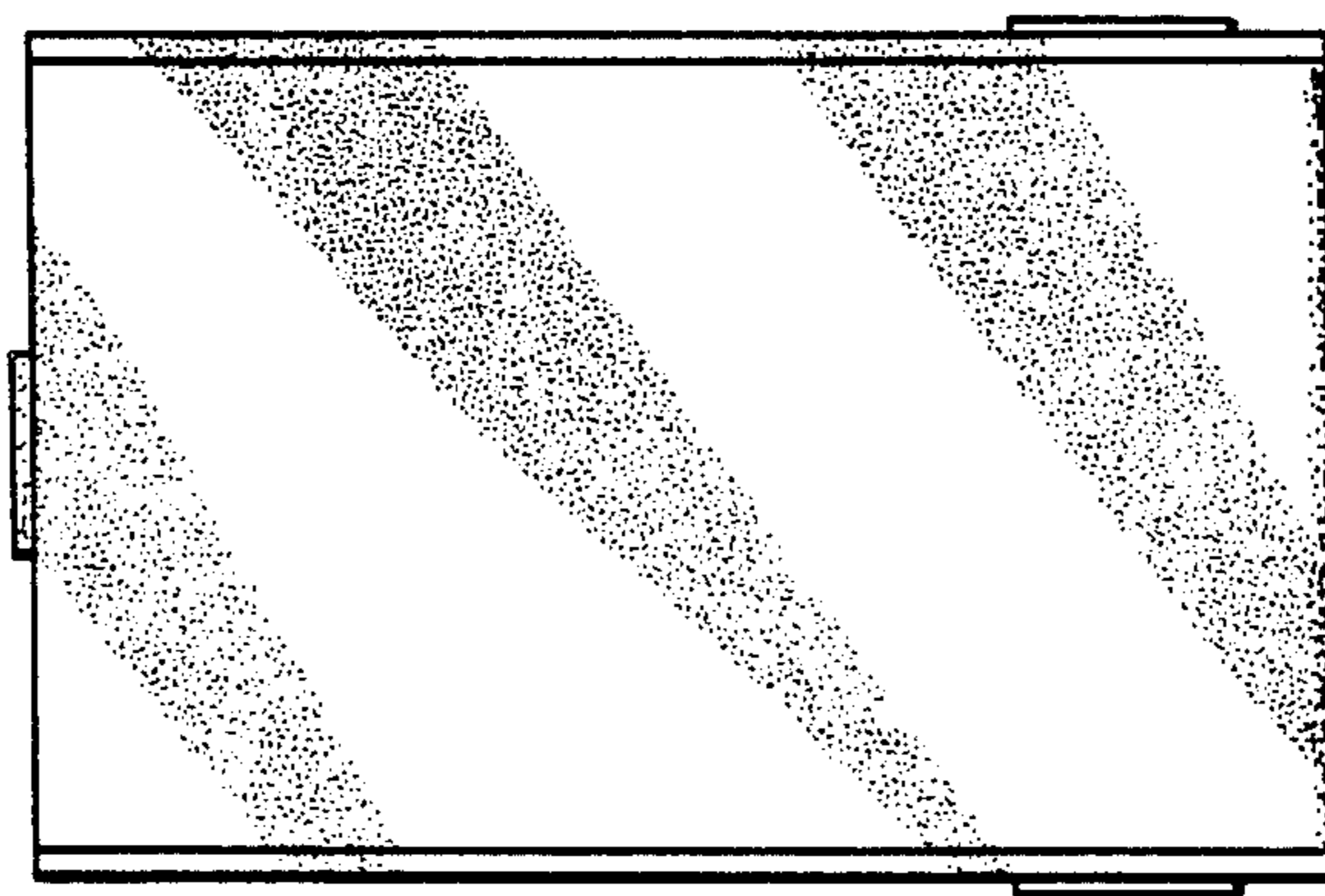

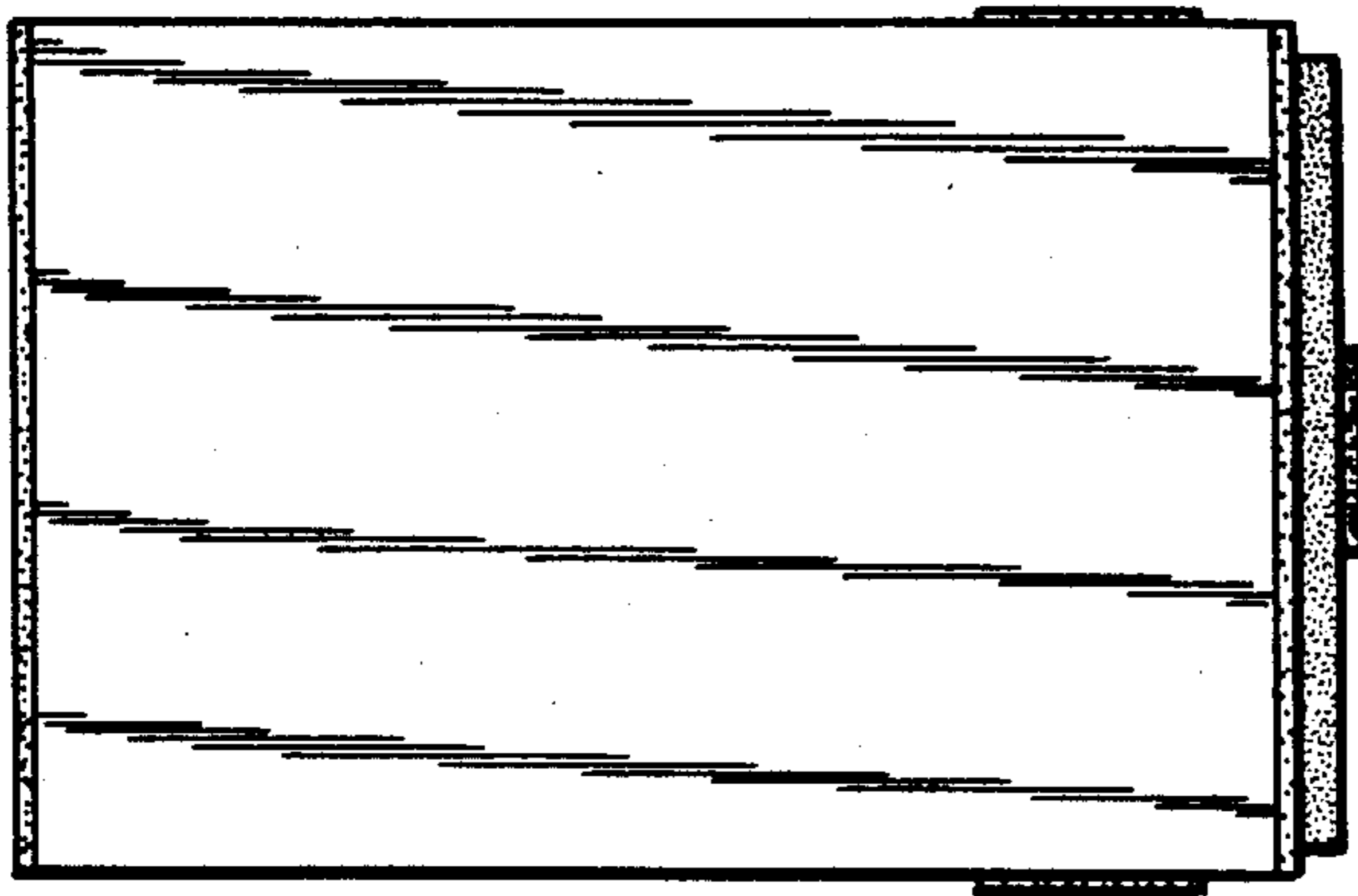

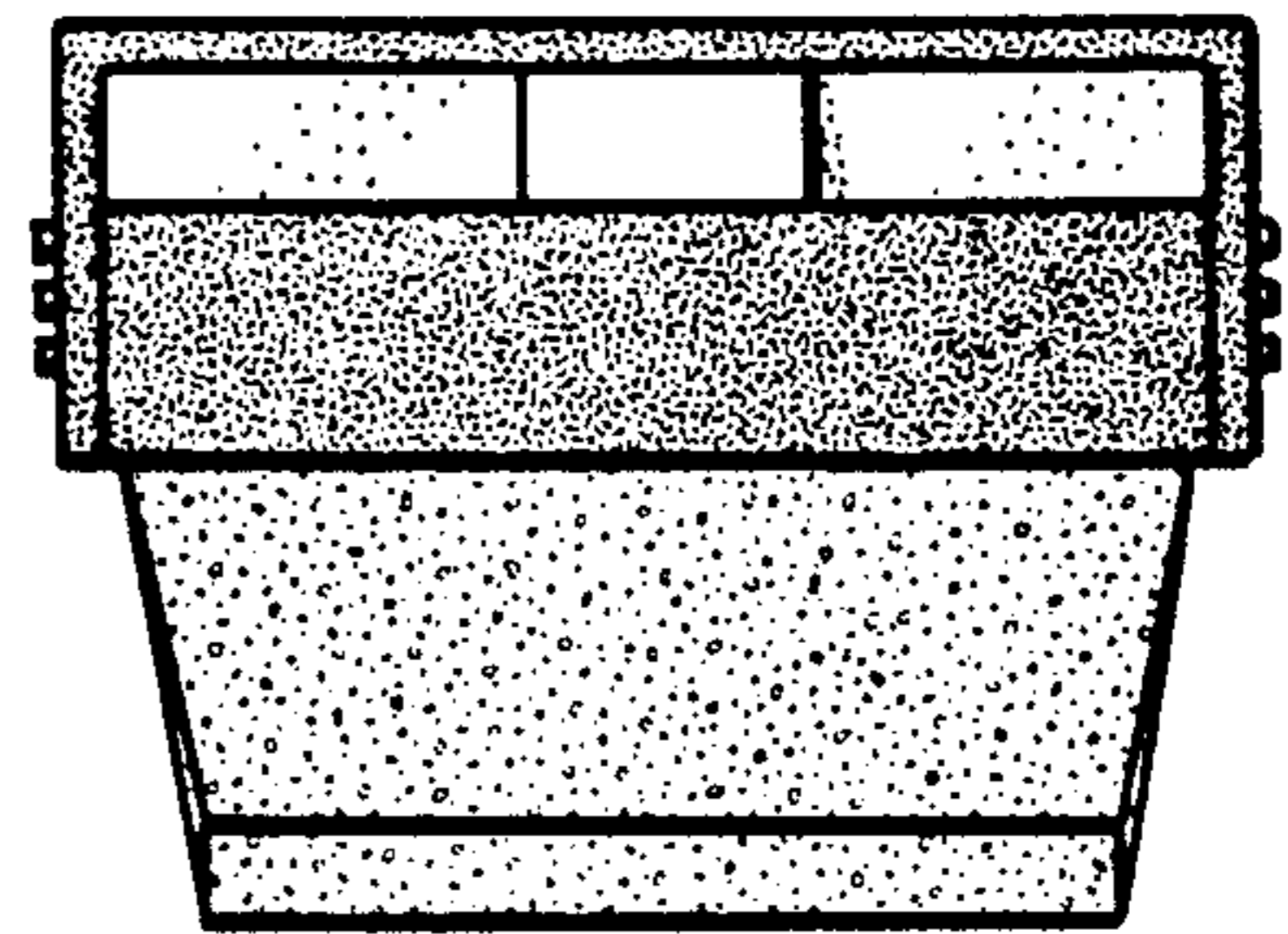

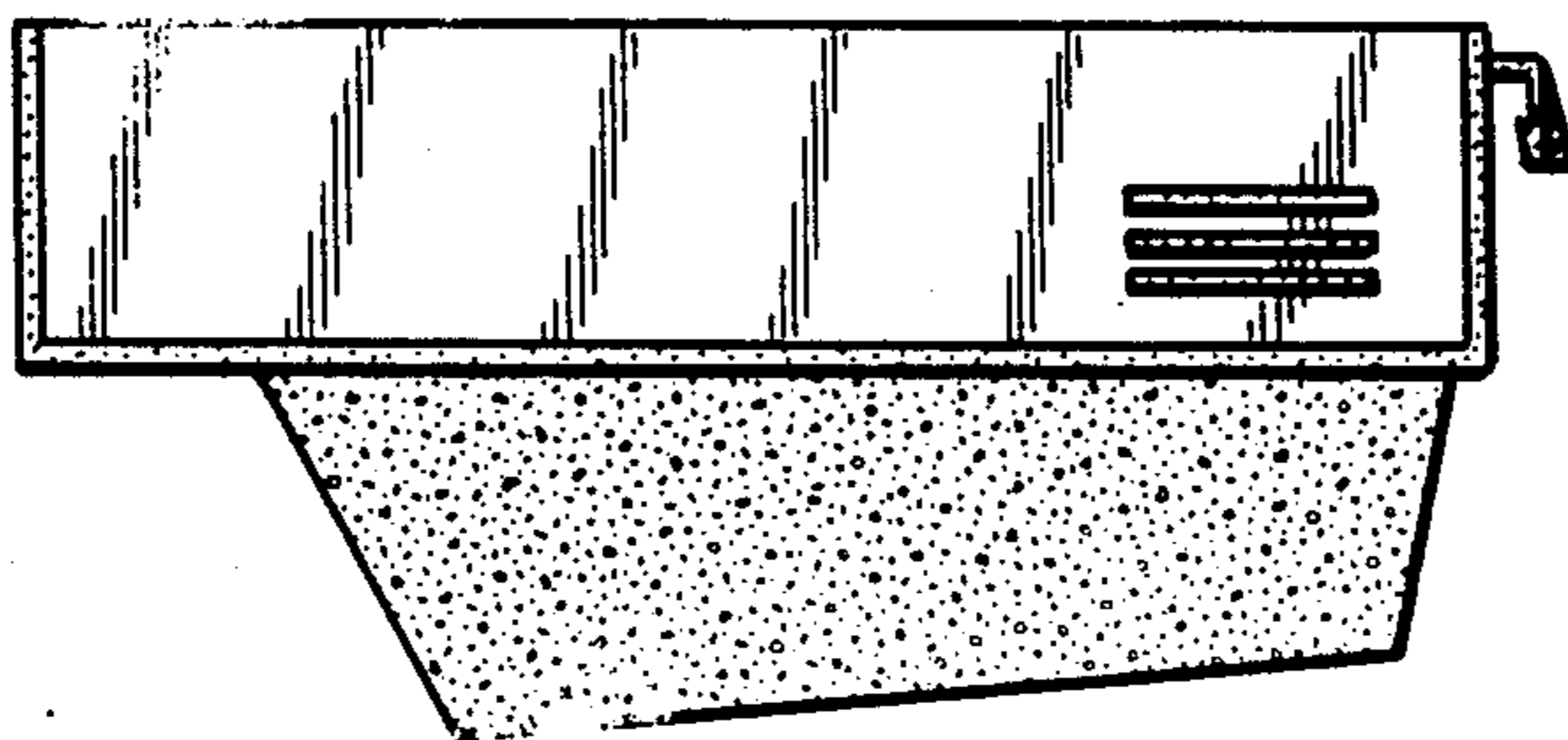

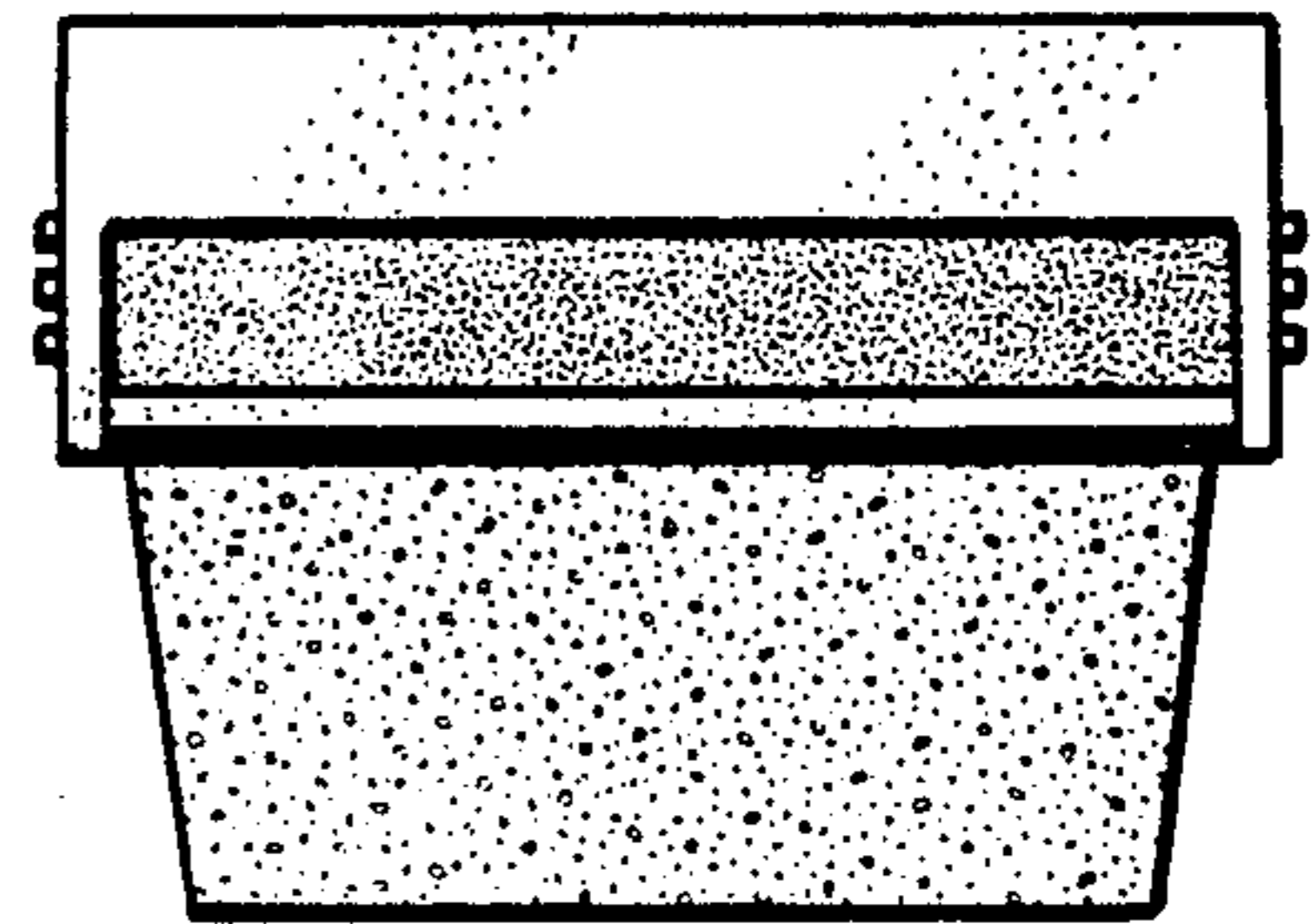

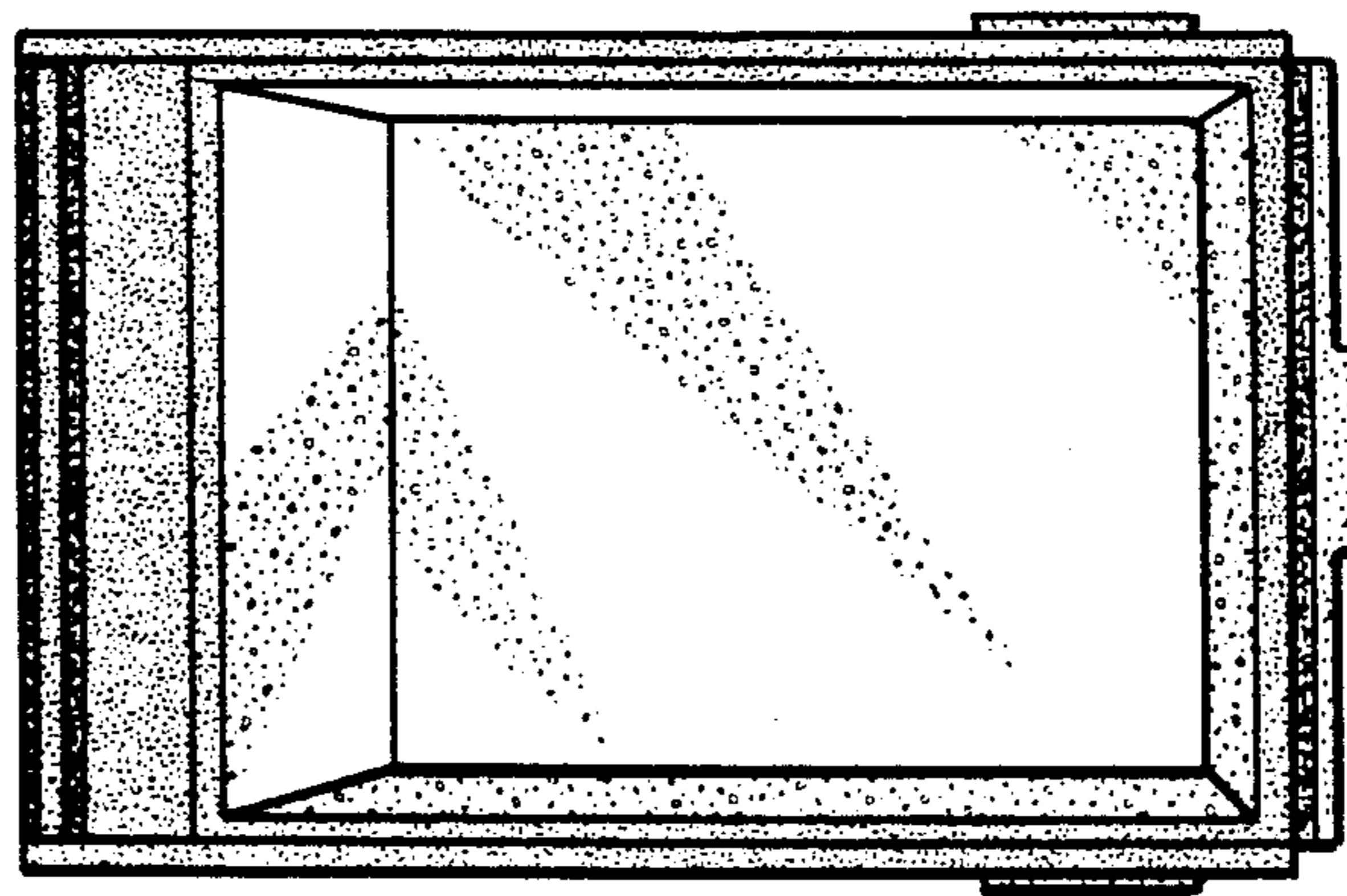
