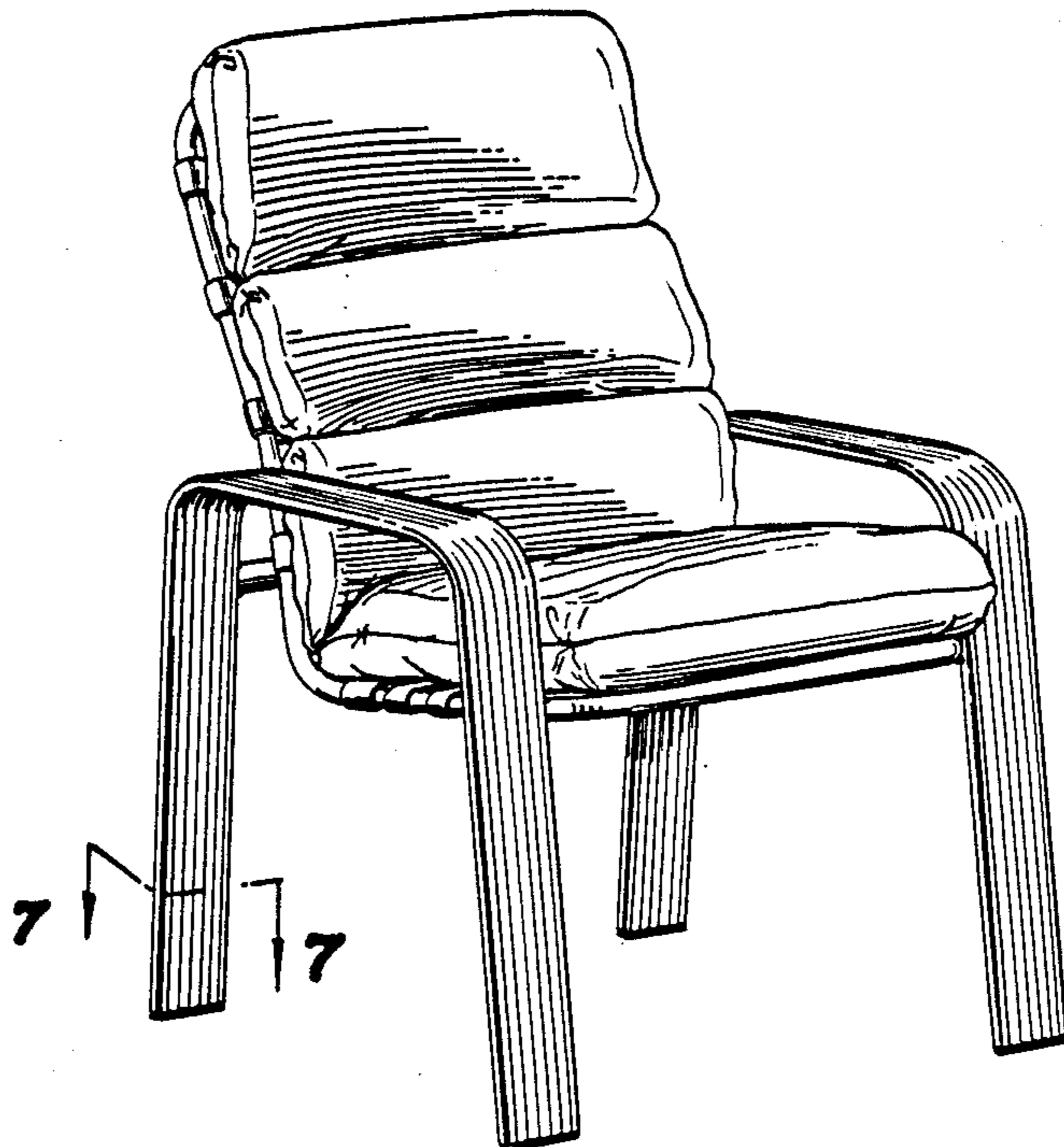

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a dining chair showing my design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is an enlarged sectional view taken along lines 7—7 of FIG. 1.



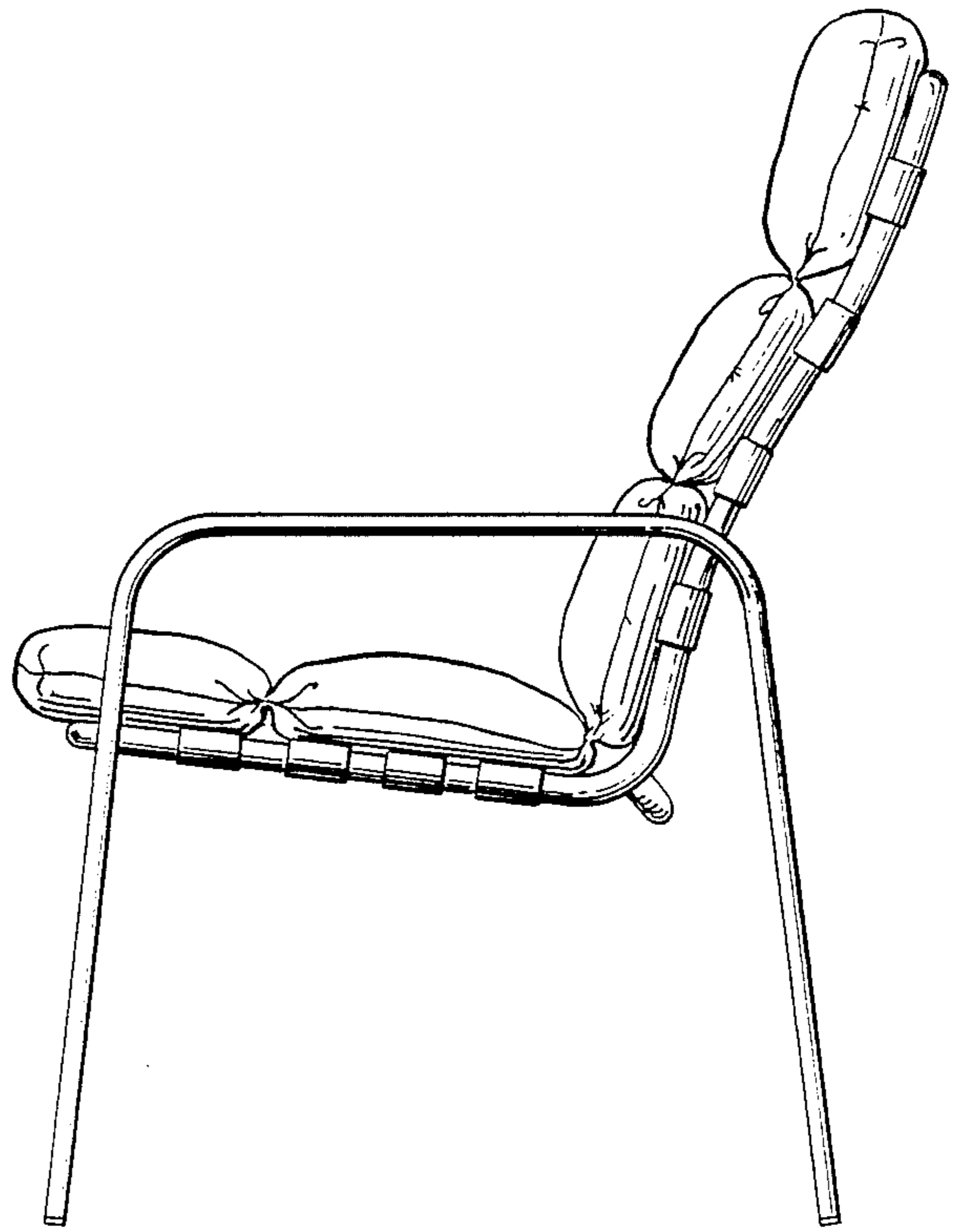
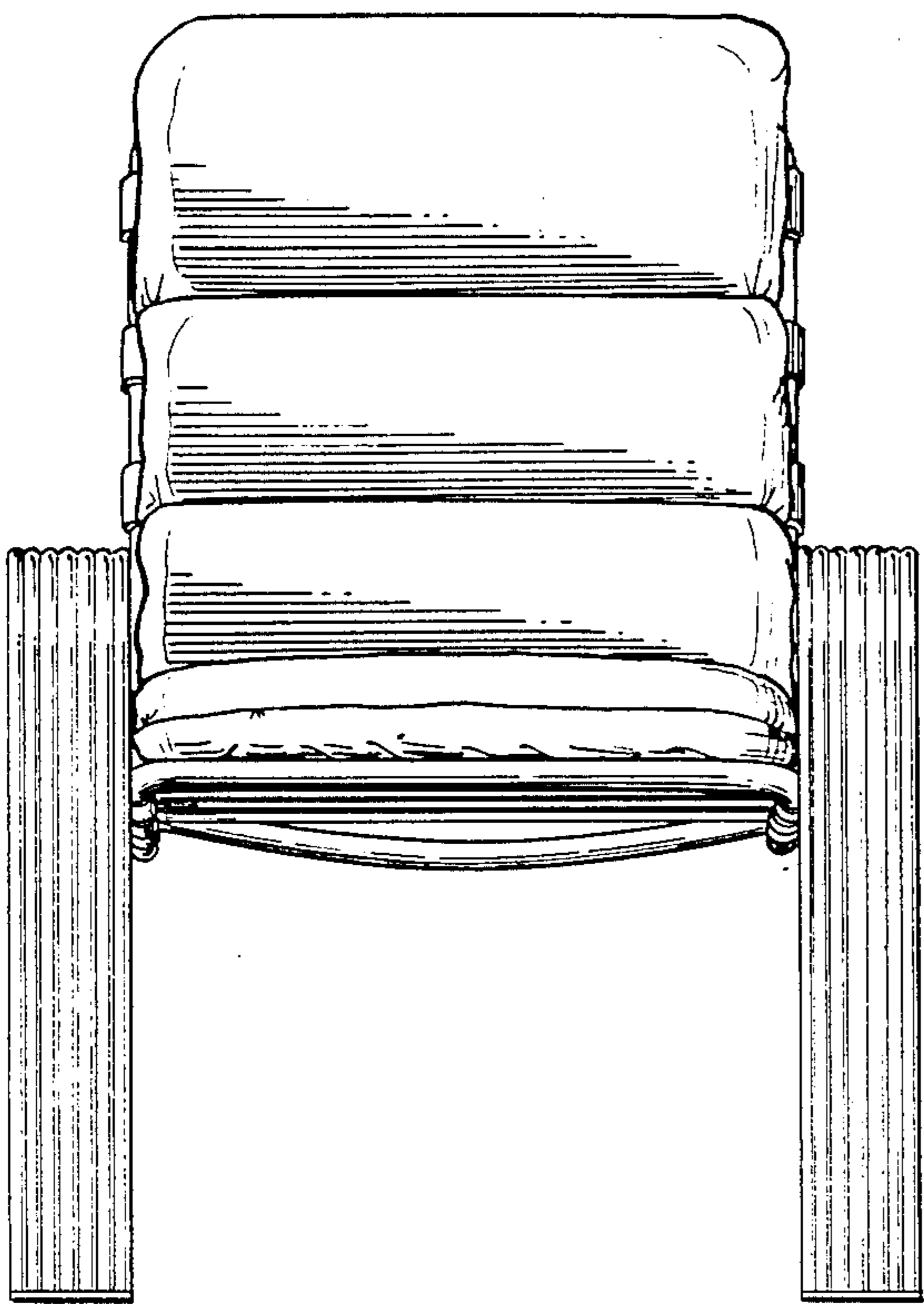
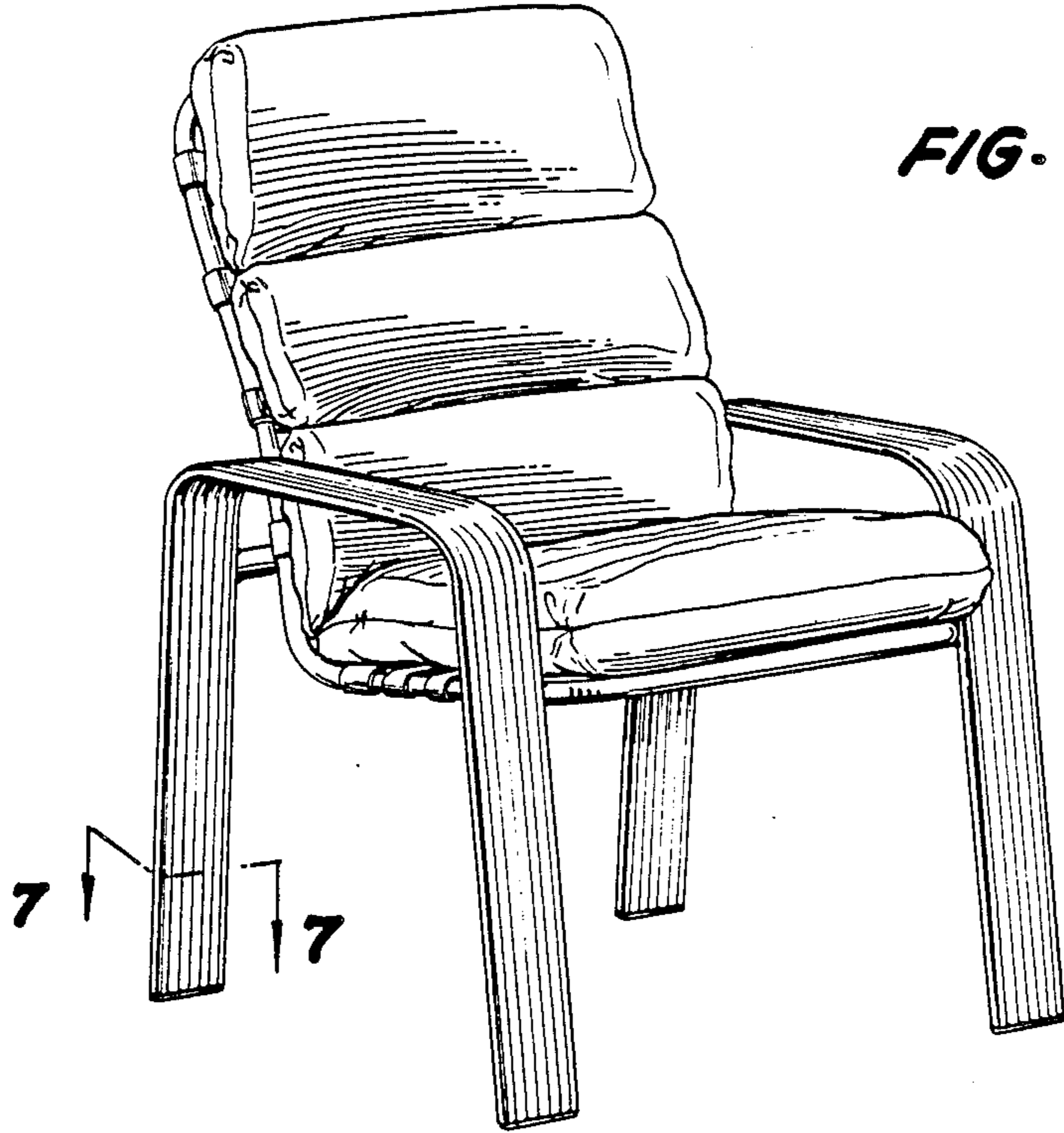

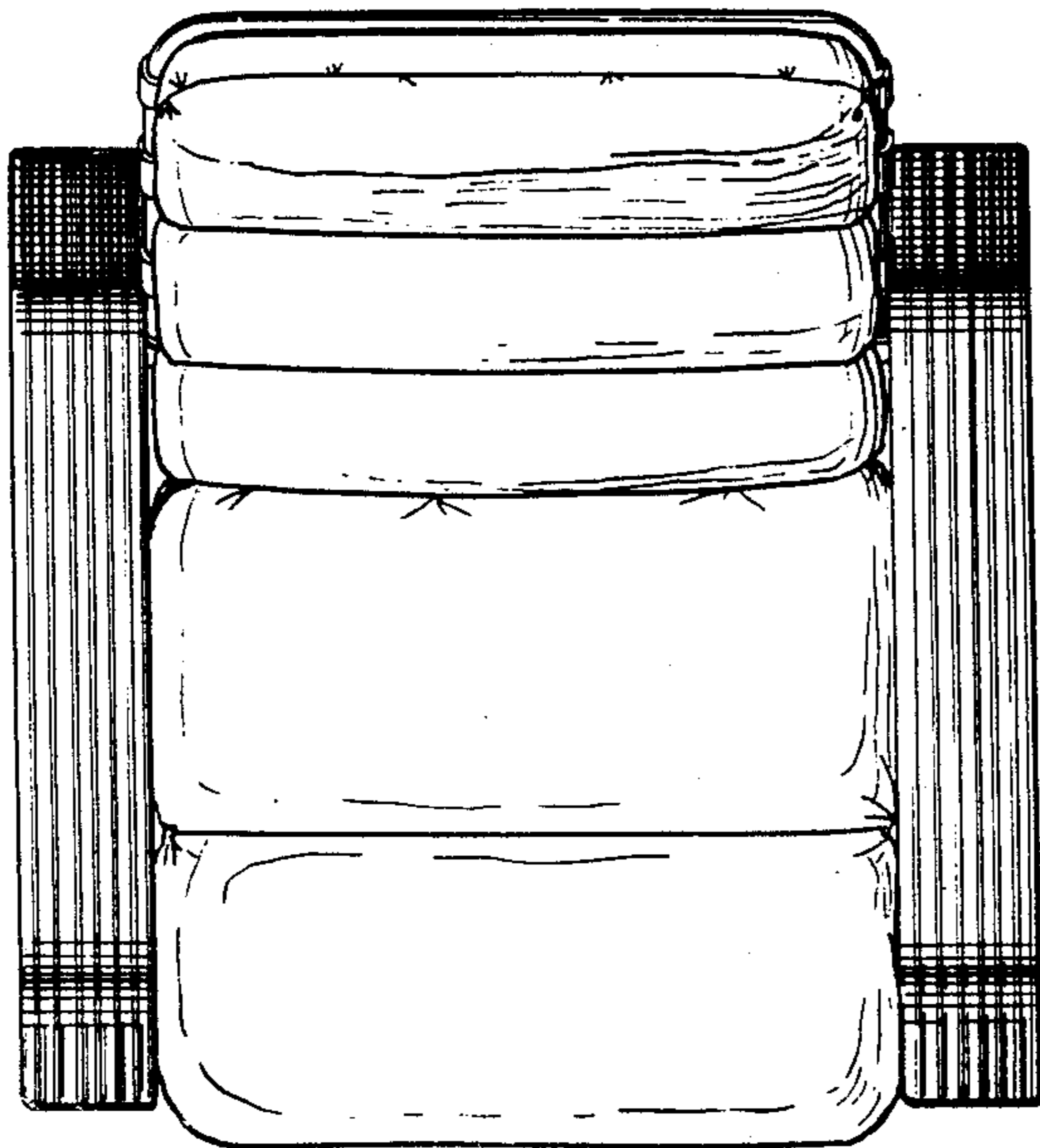

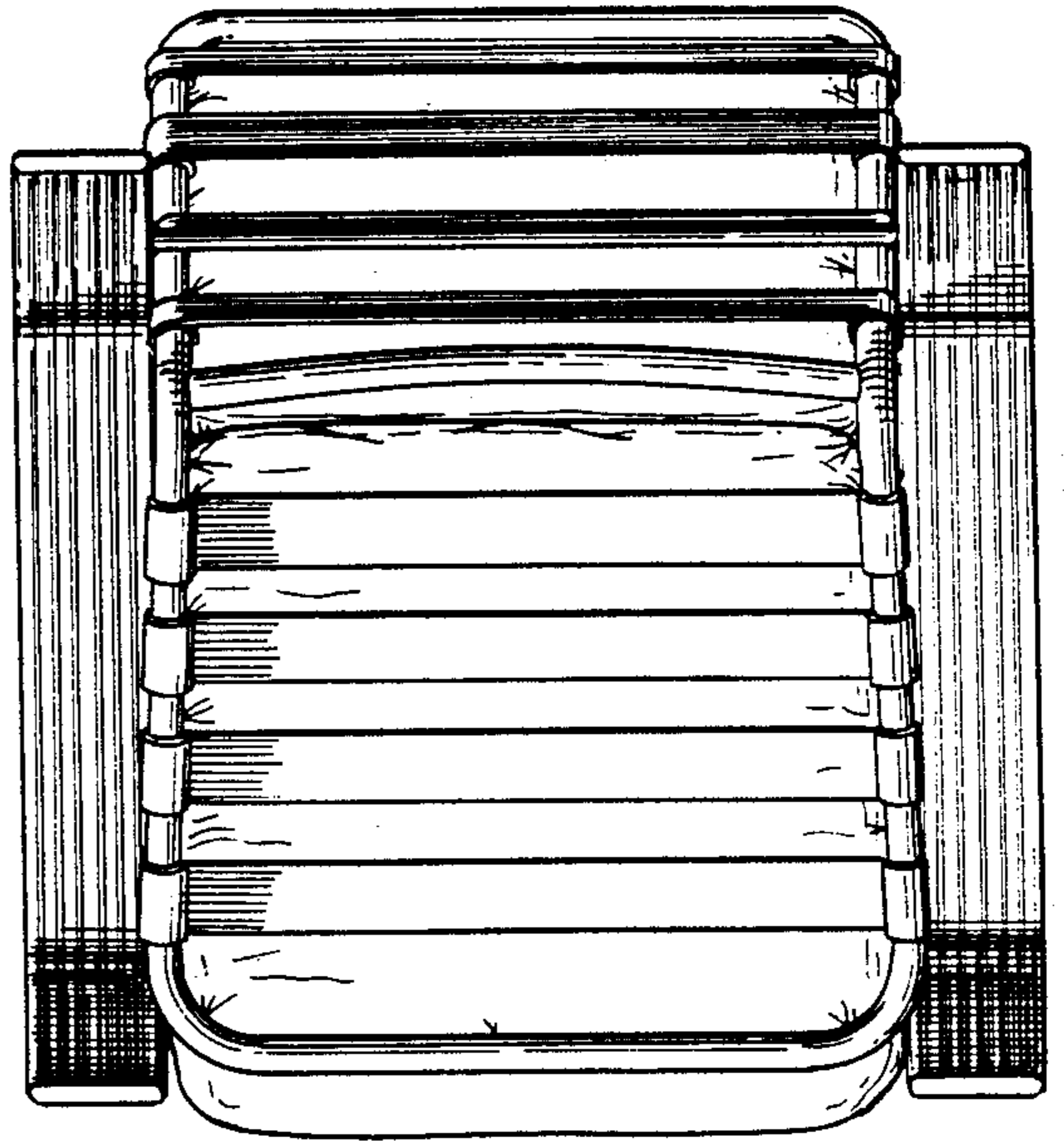

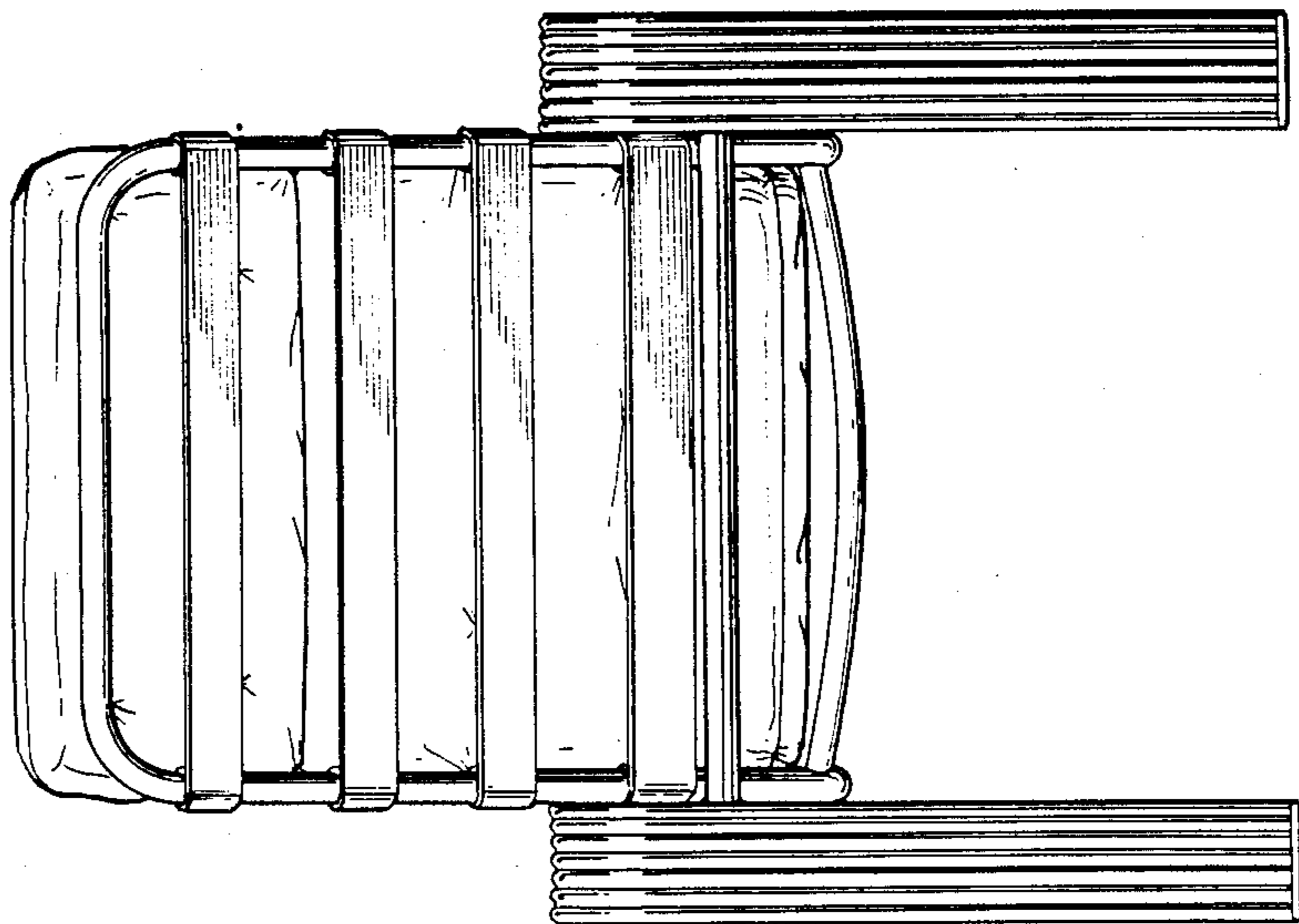
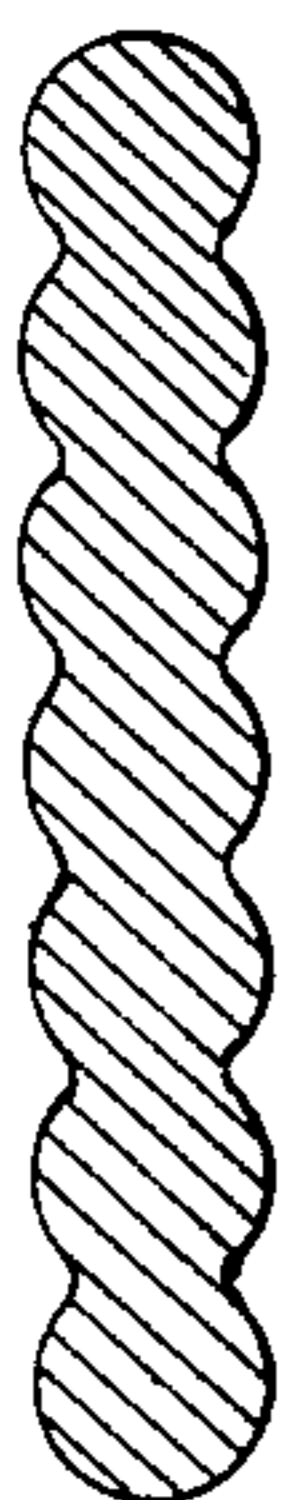
