FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

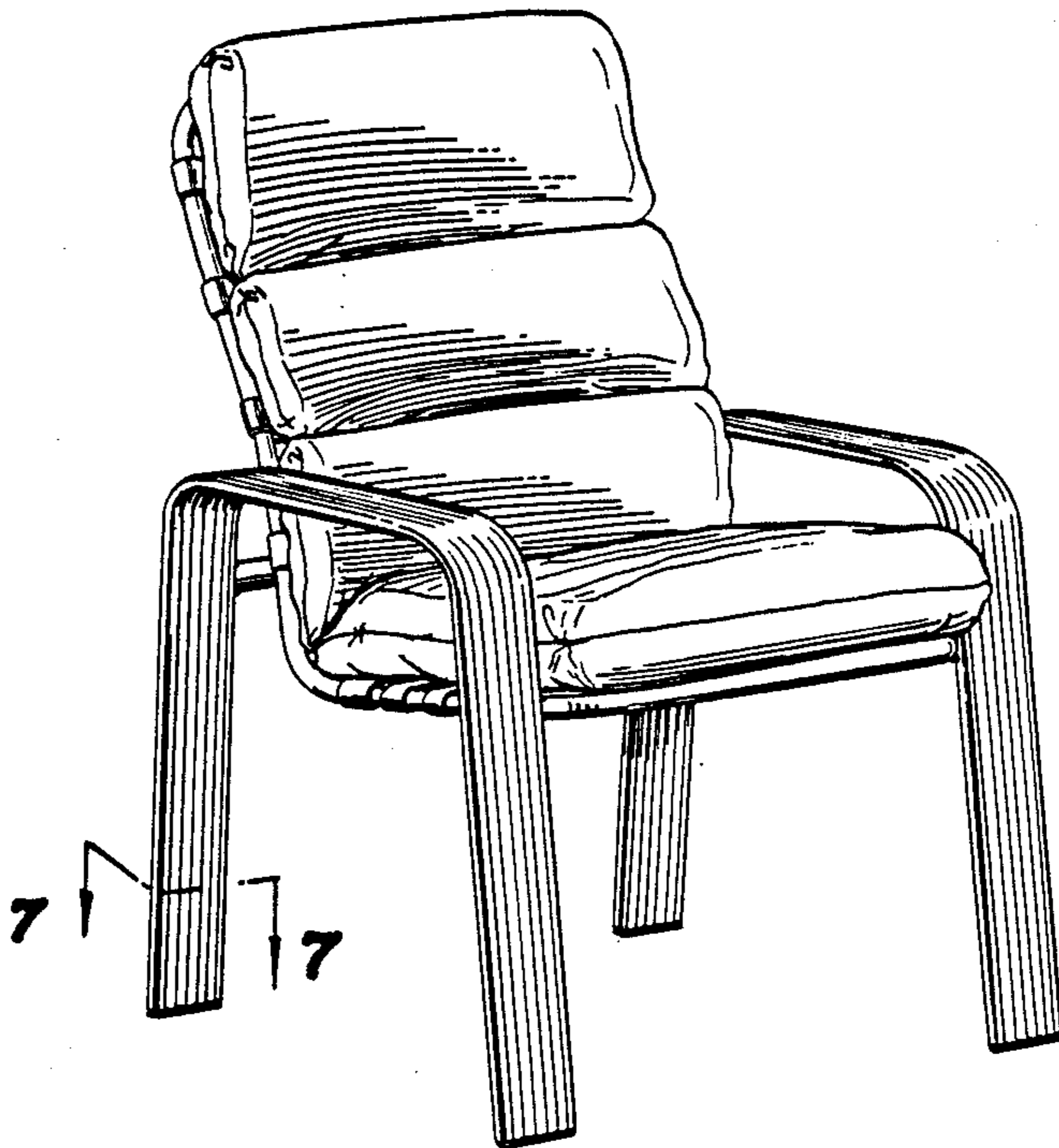
FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 7 is an enlarged sectional view taken along lines 7—7 of FIG. 1.



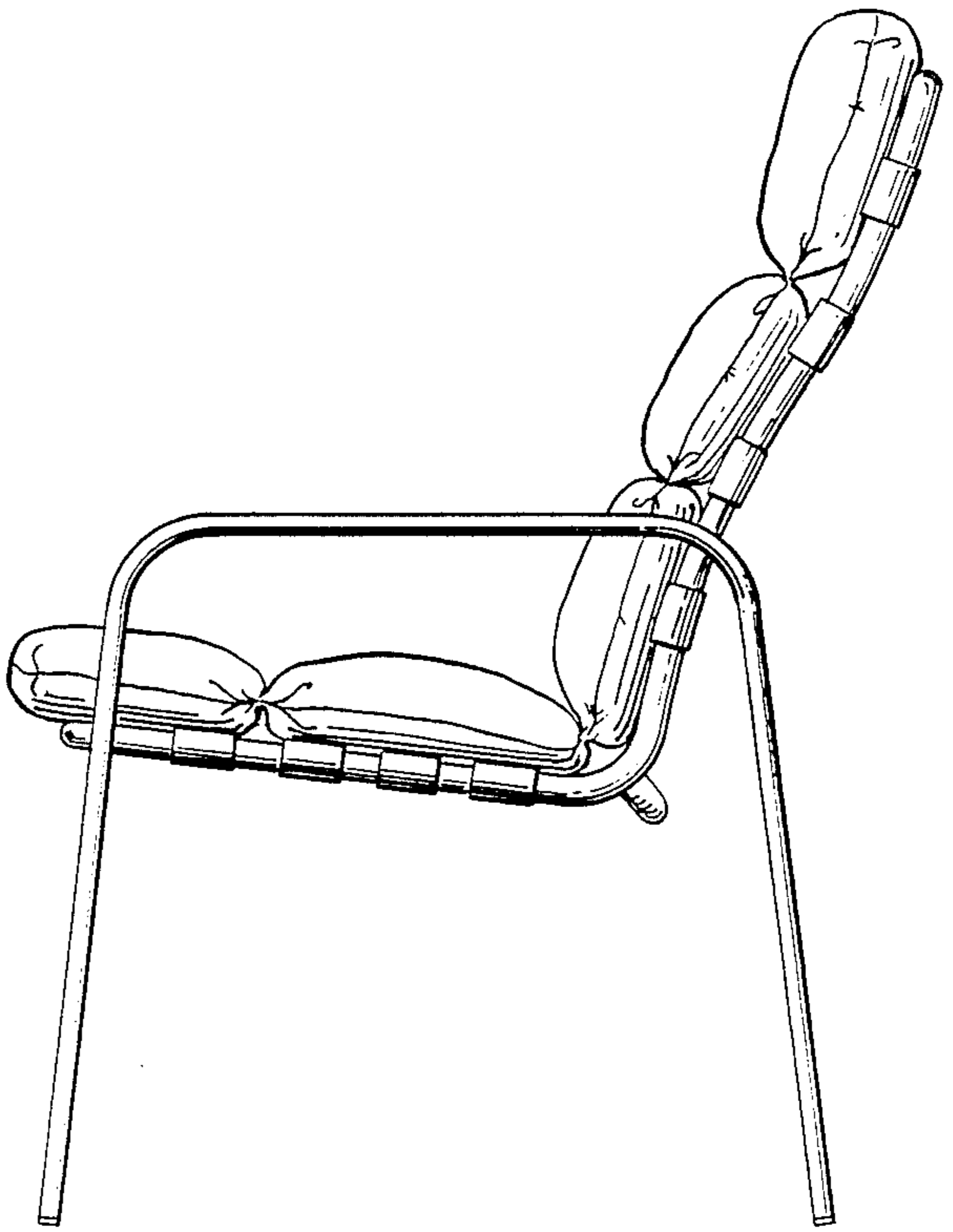
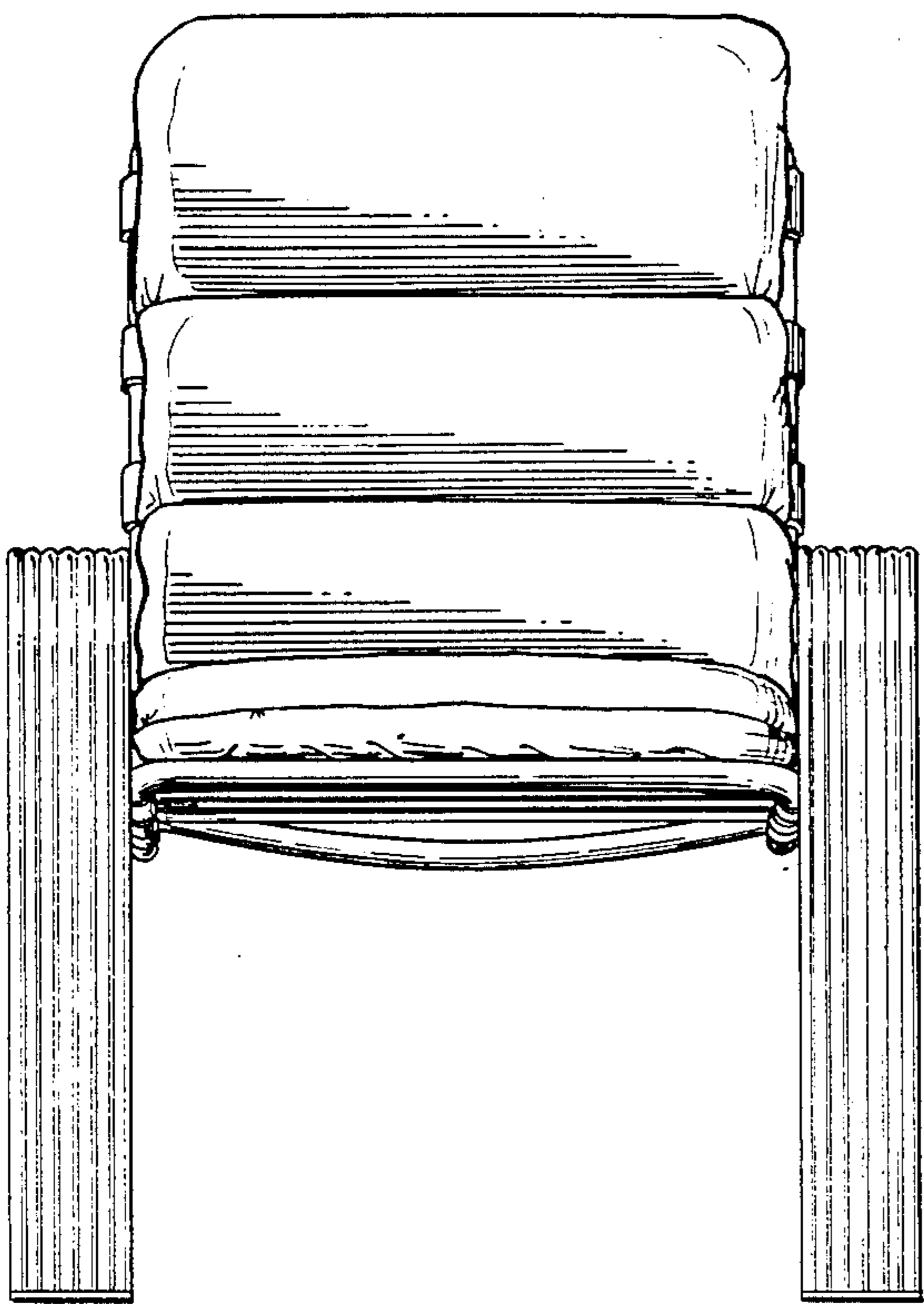
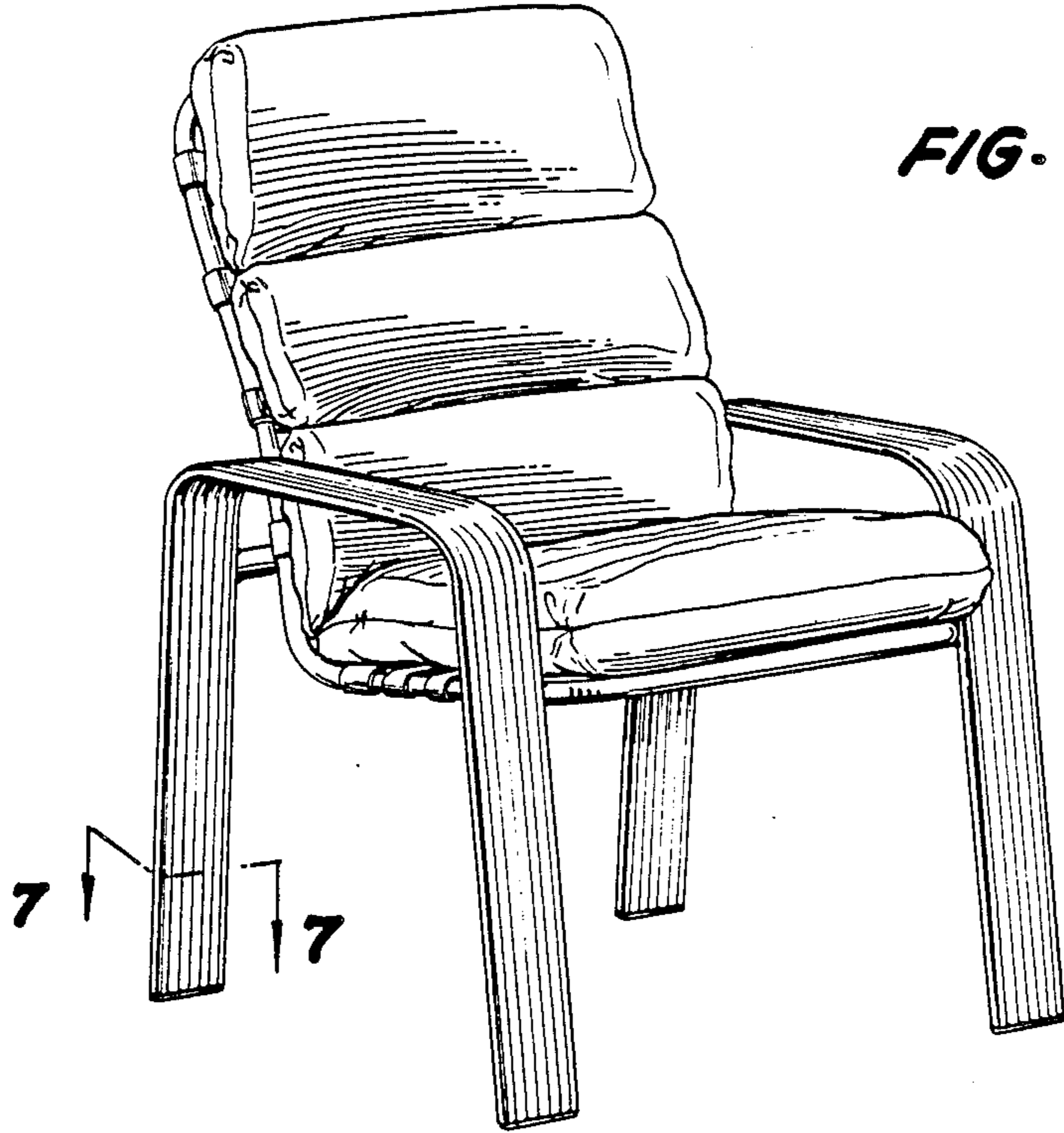

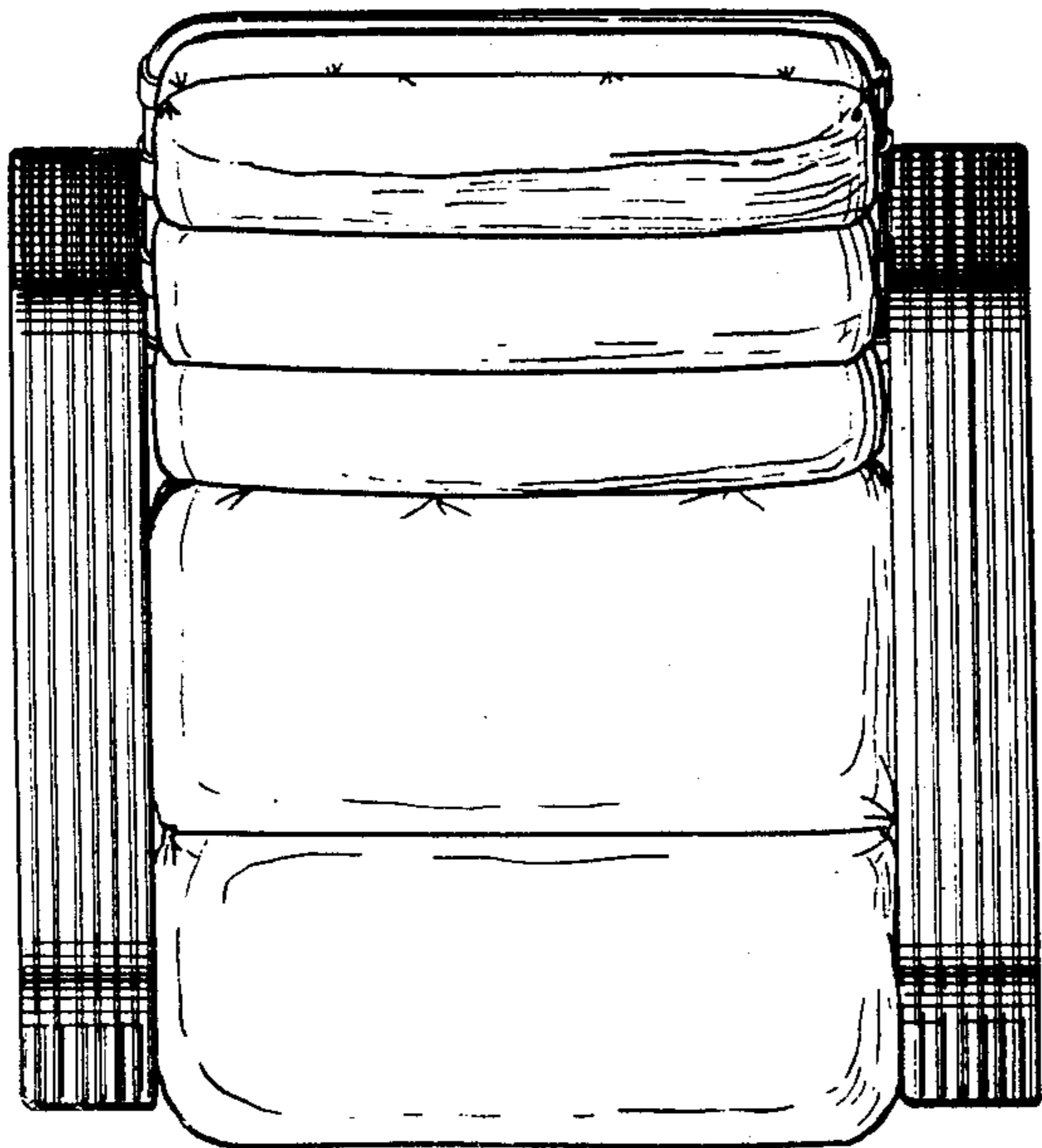

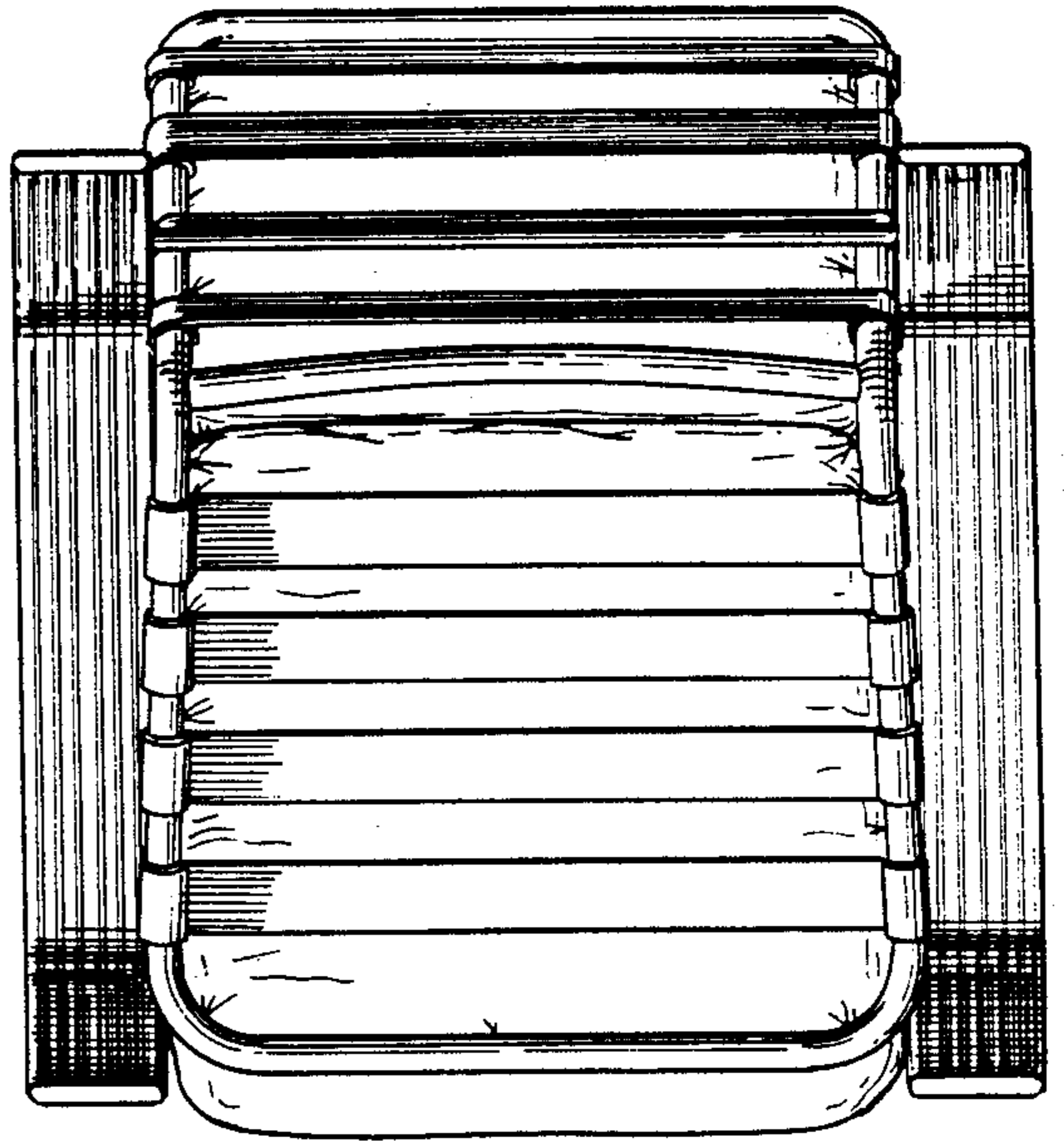

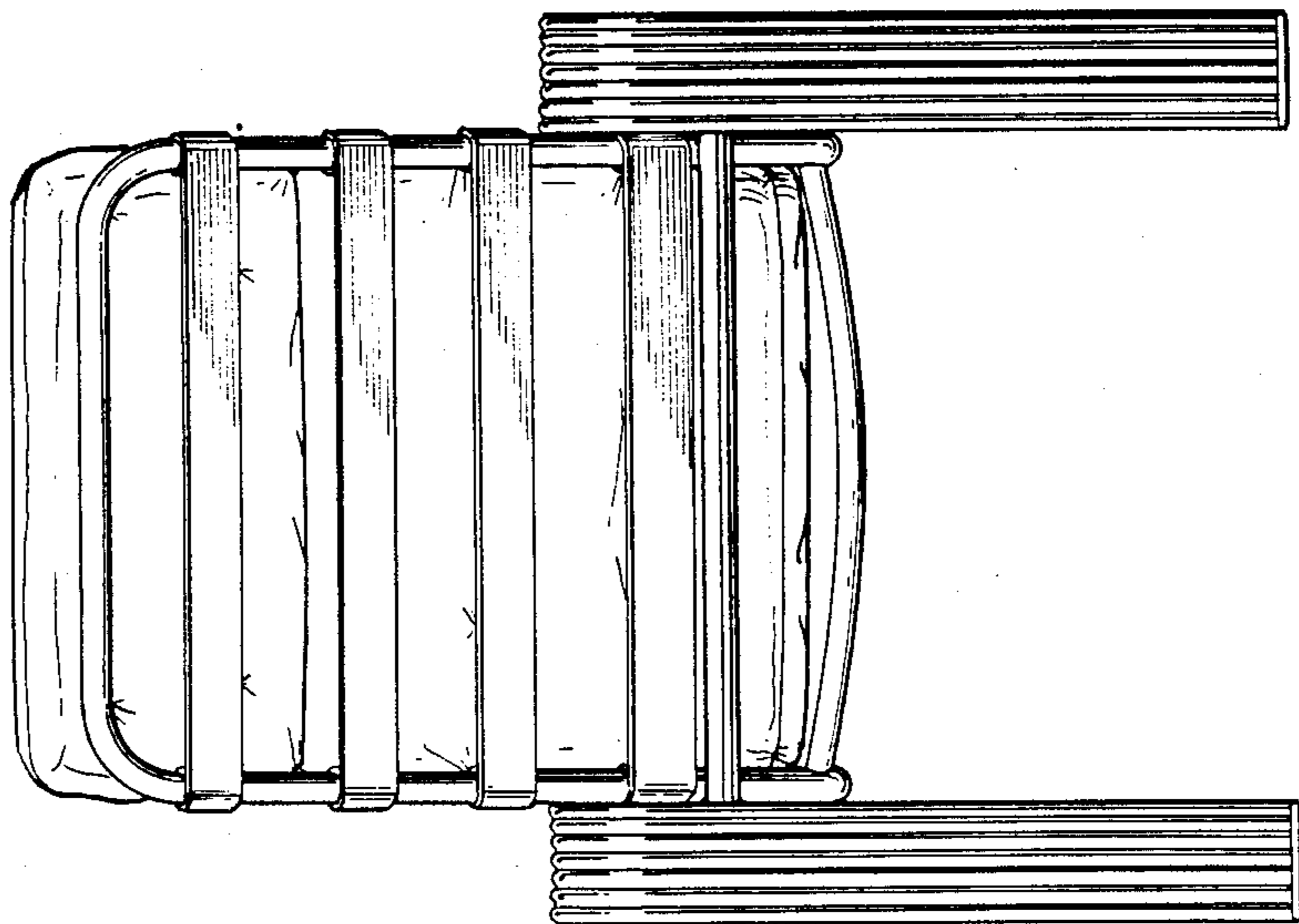
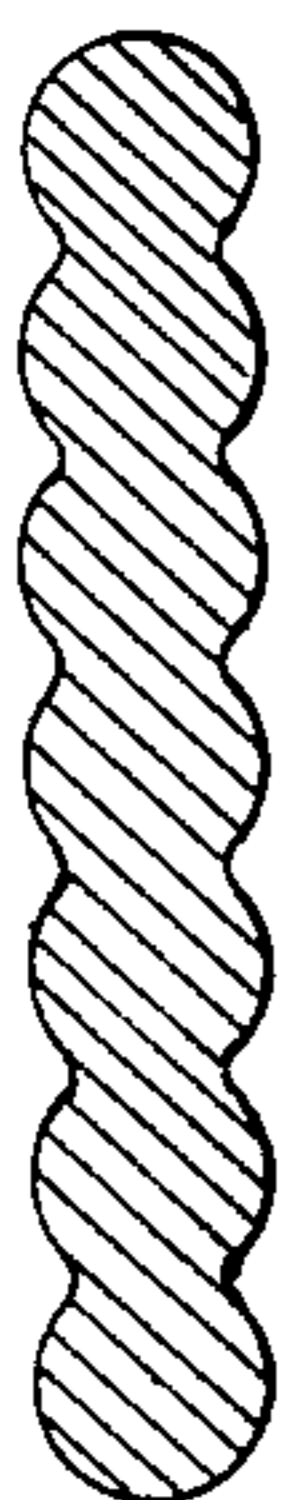
