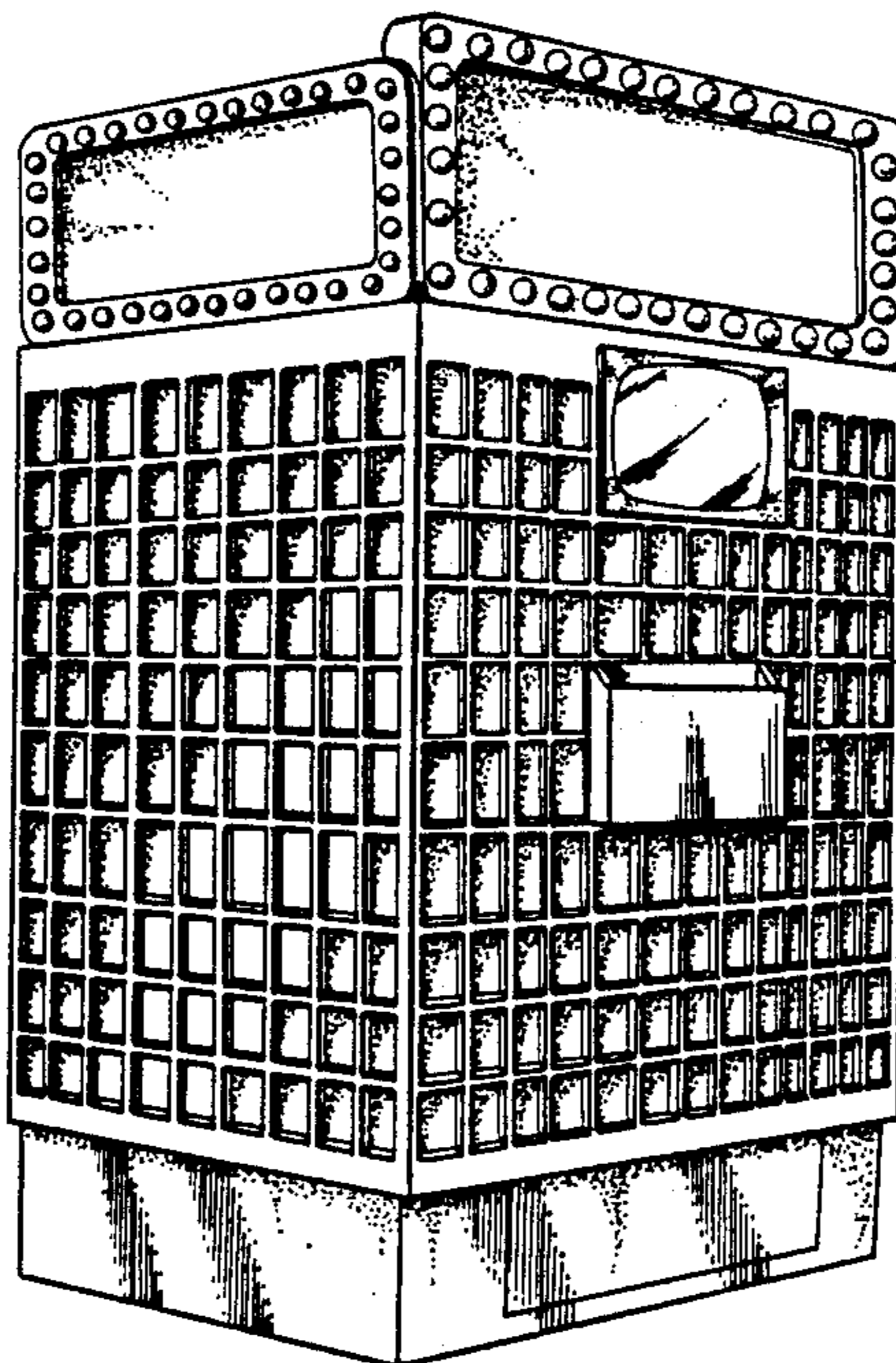

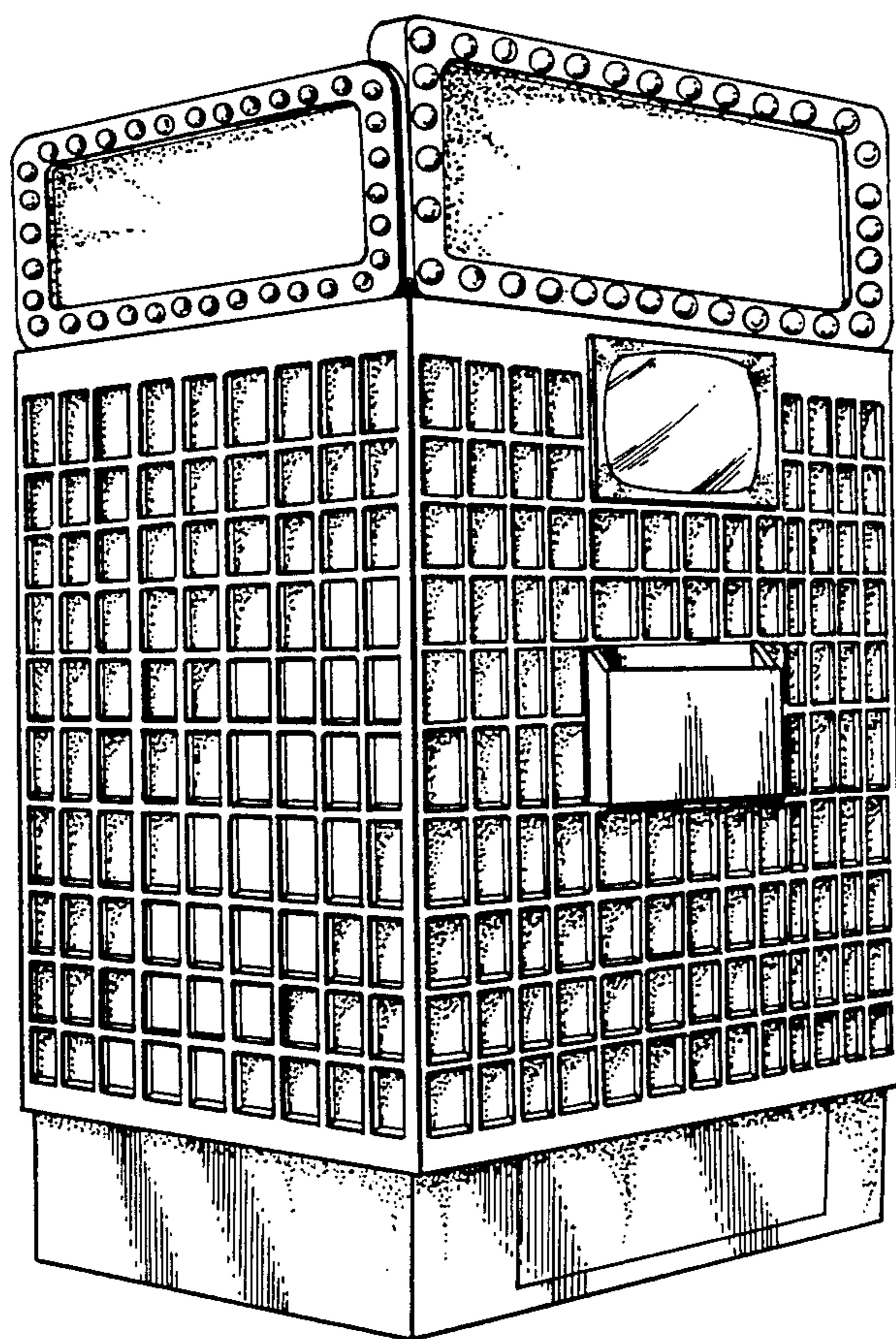
The ornamental design for a combined viewing screen and merchandising display for video taped movies or the like, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

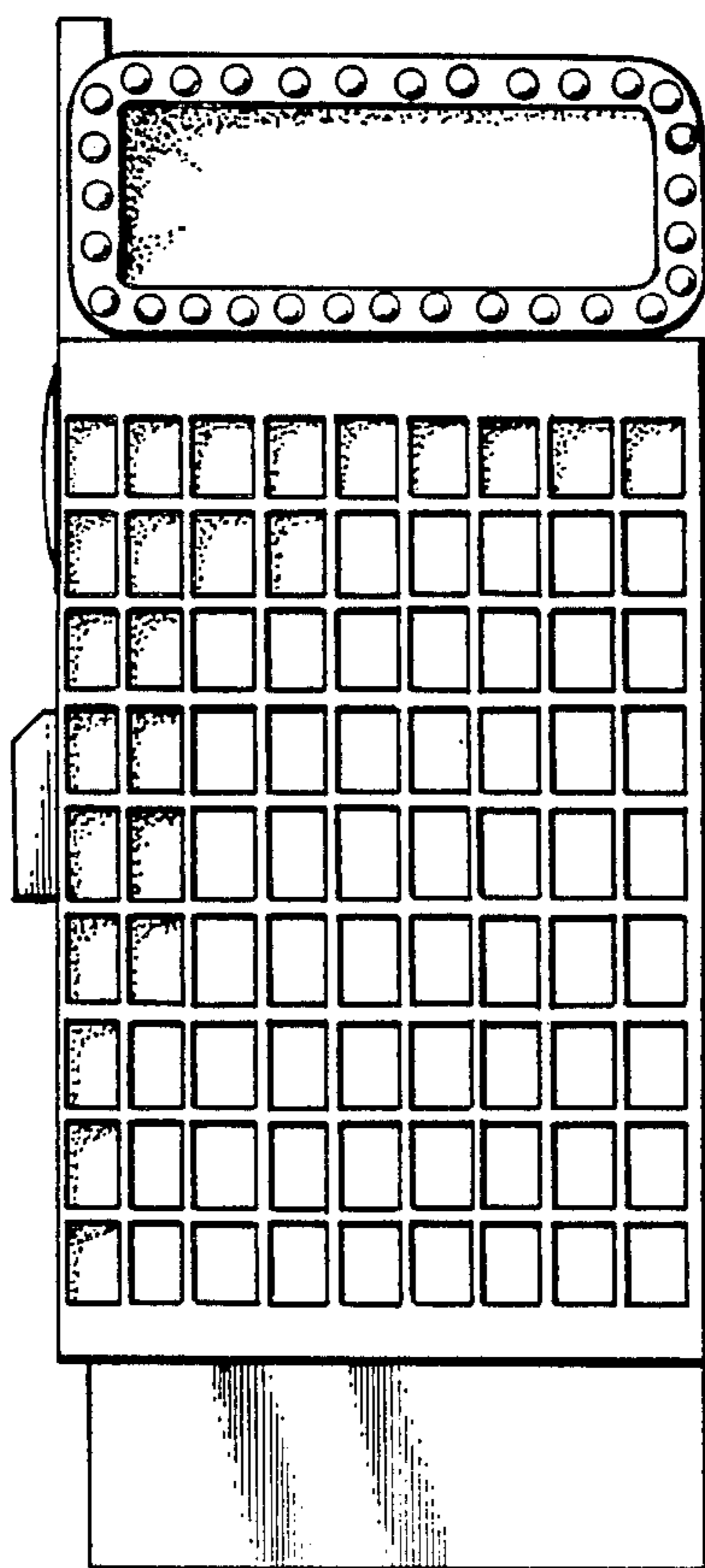
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined viewing screen and merchandising display for video taped movies or the like showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

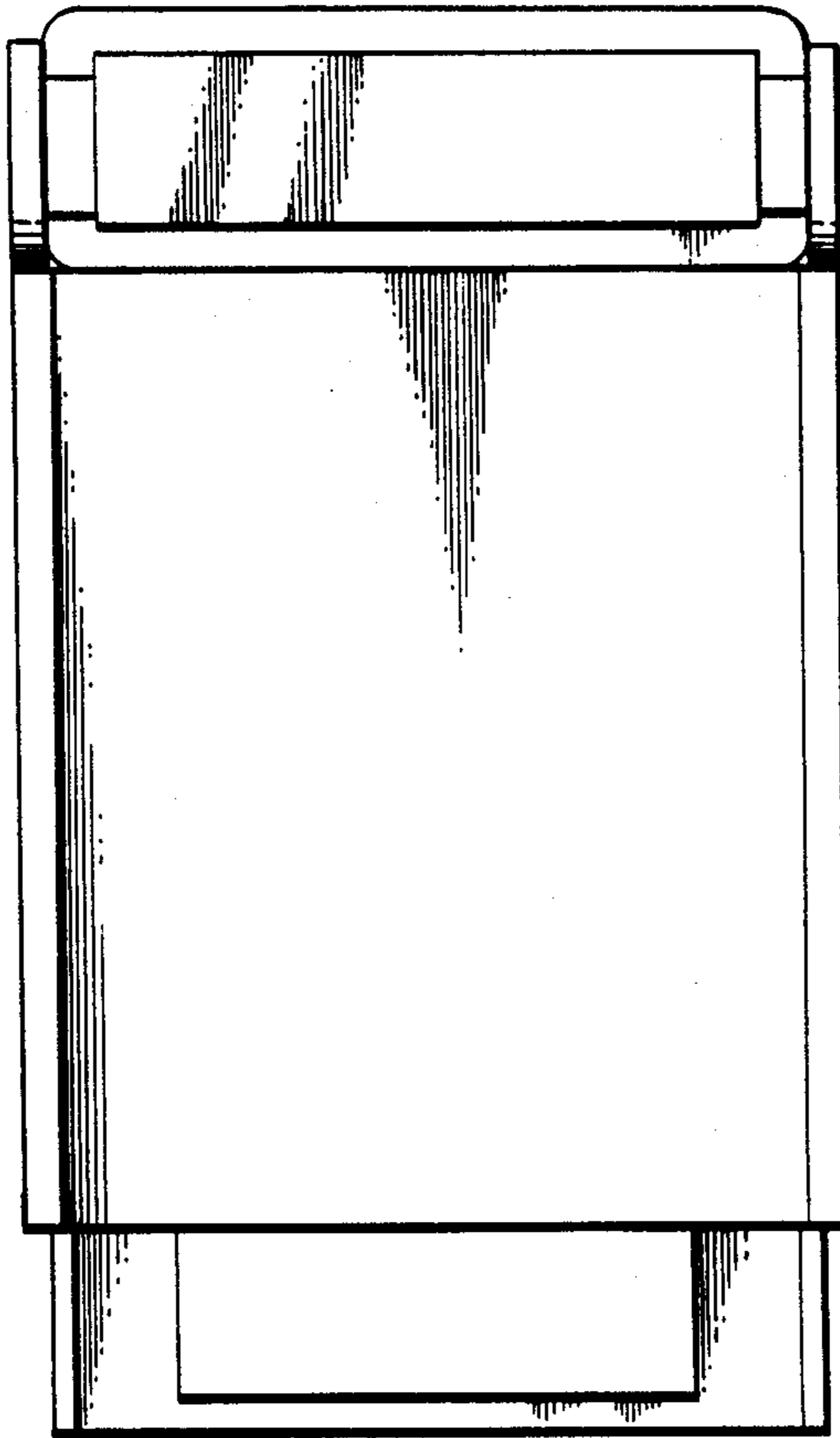

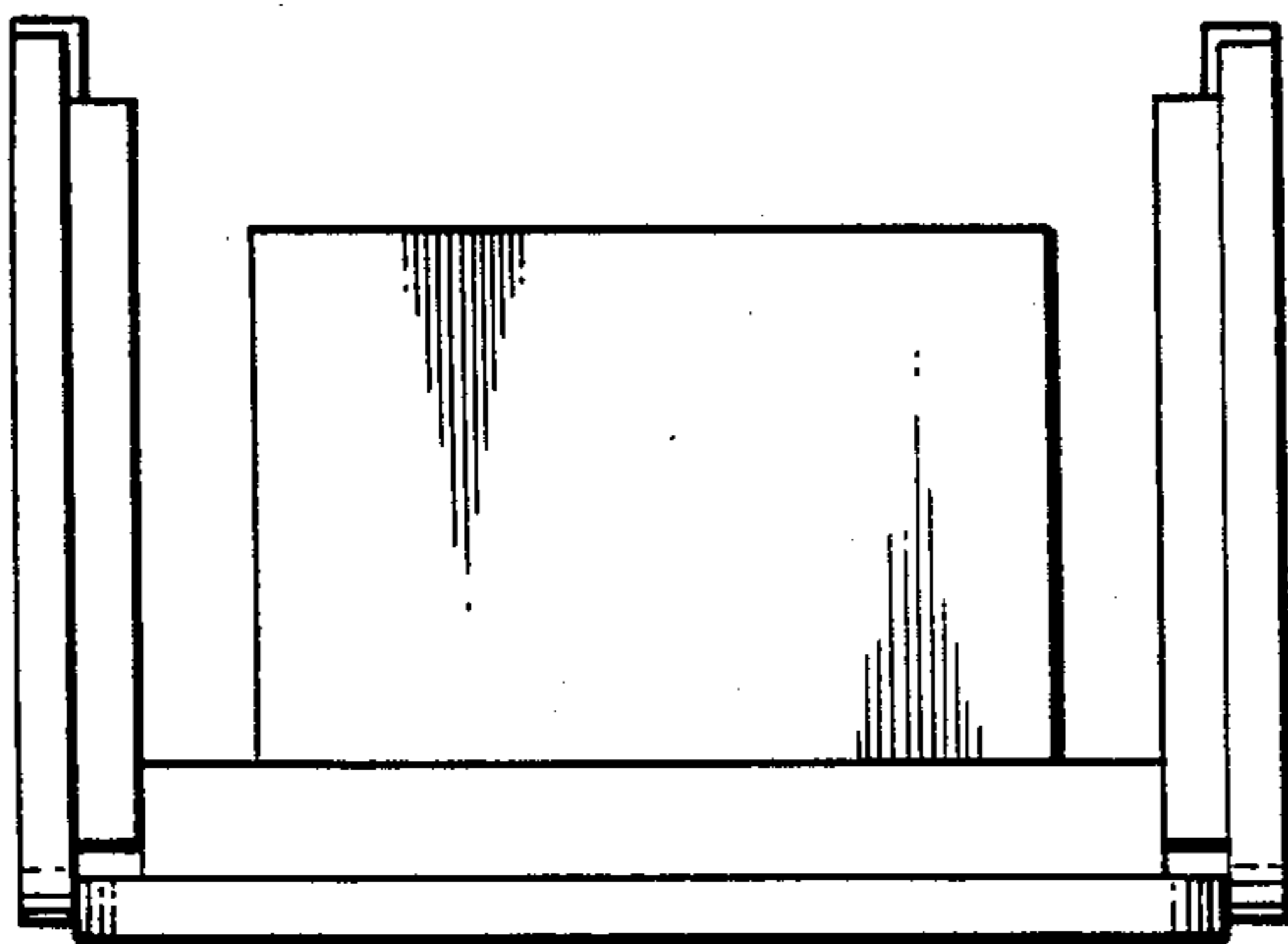

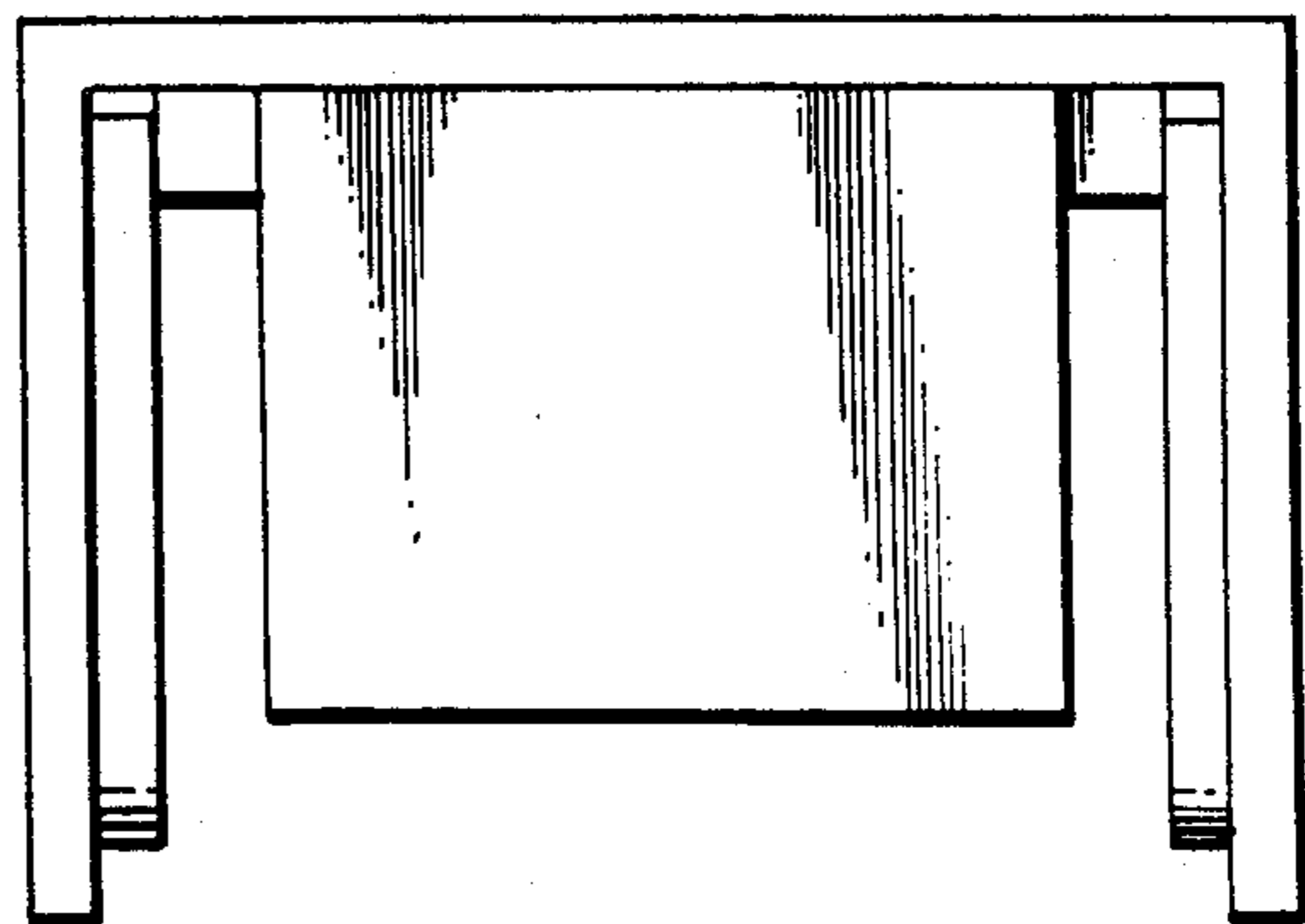
