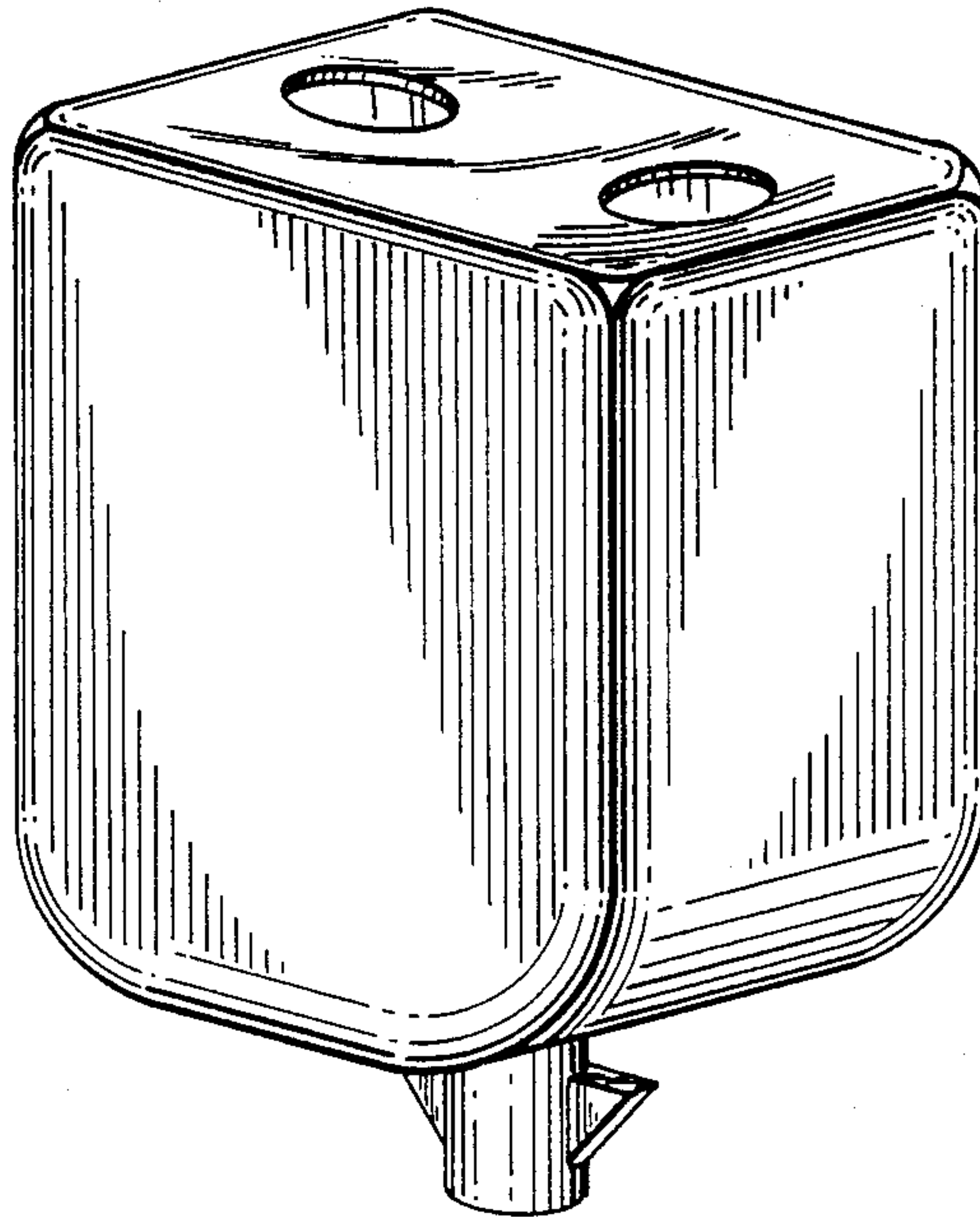

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for oil filler, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an oil filler showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being identical in appearance;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being identical in appearance;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



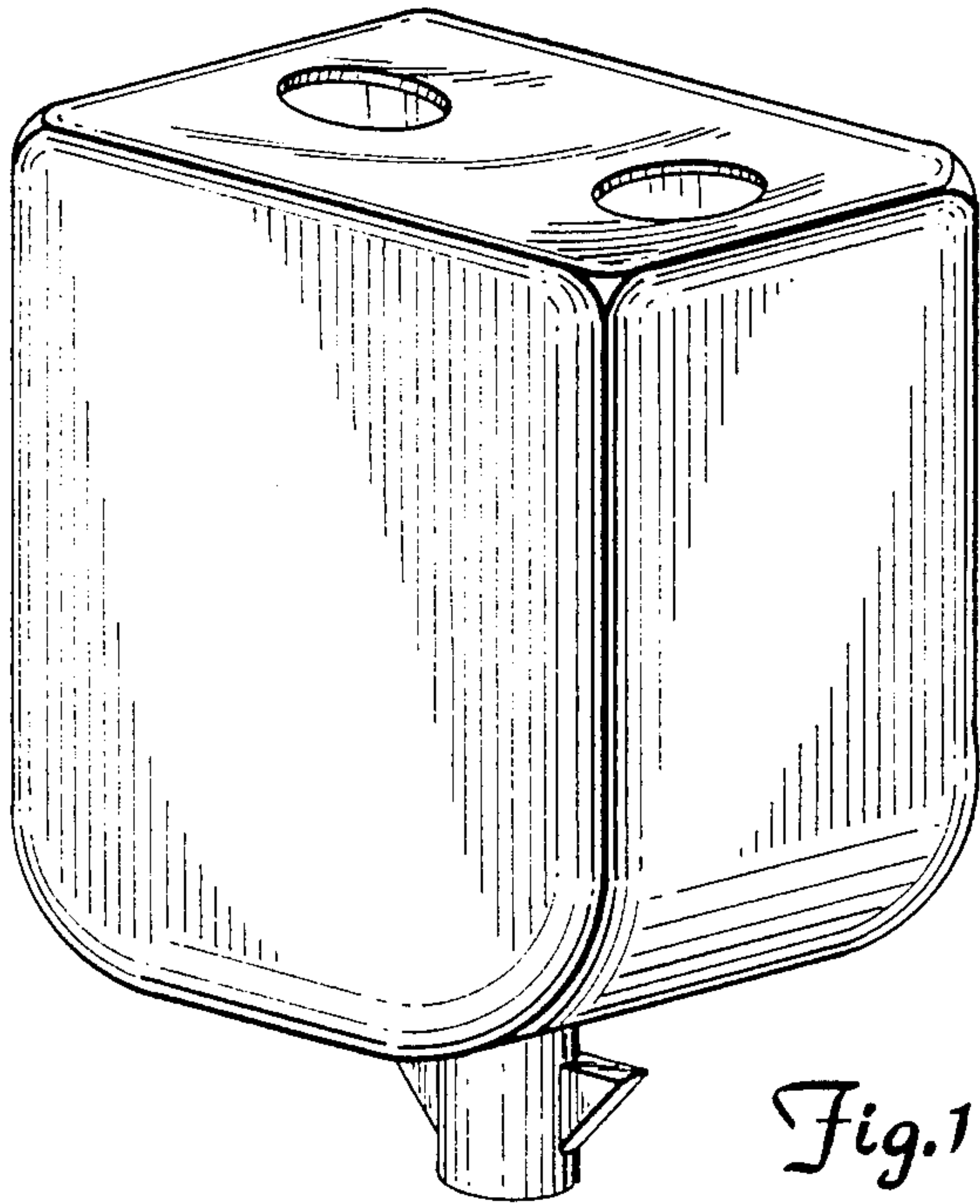

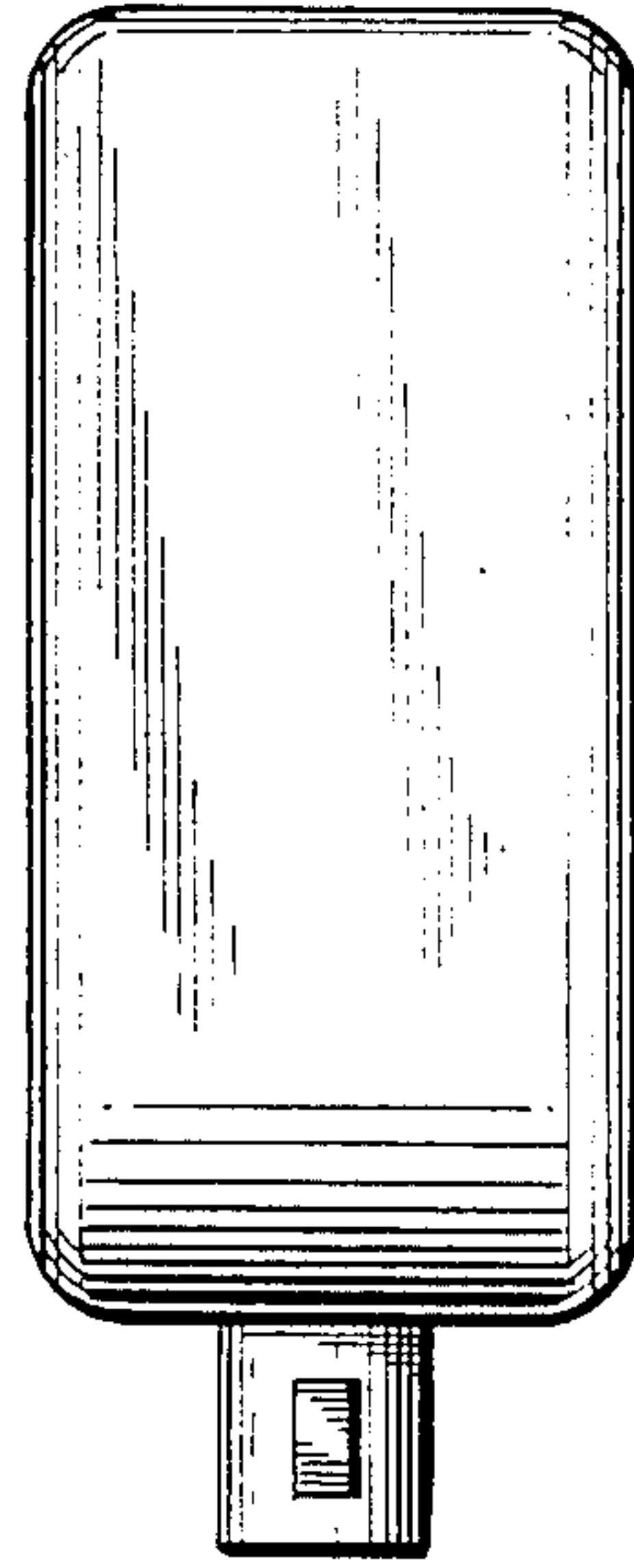

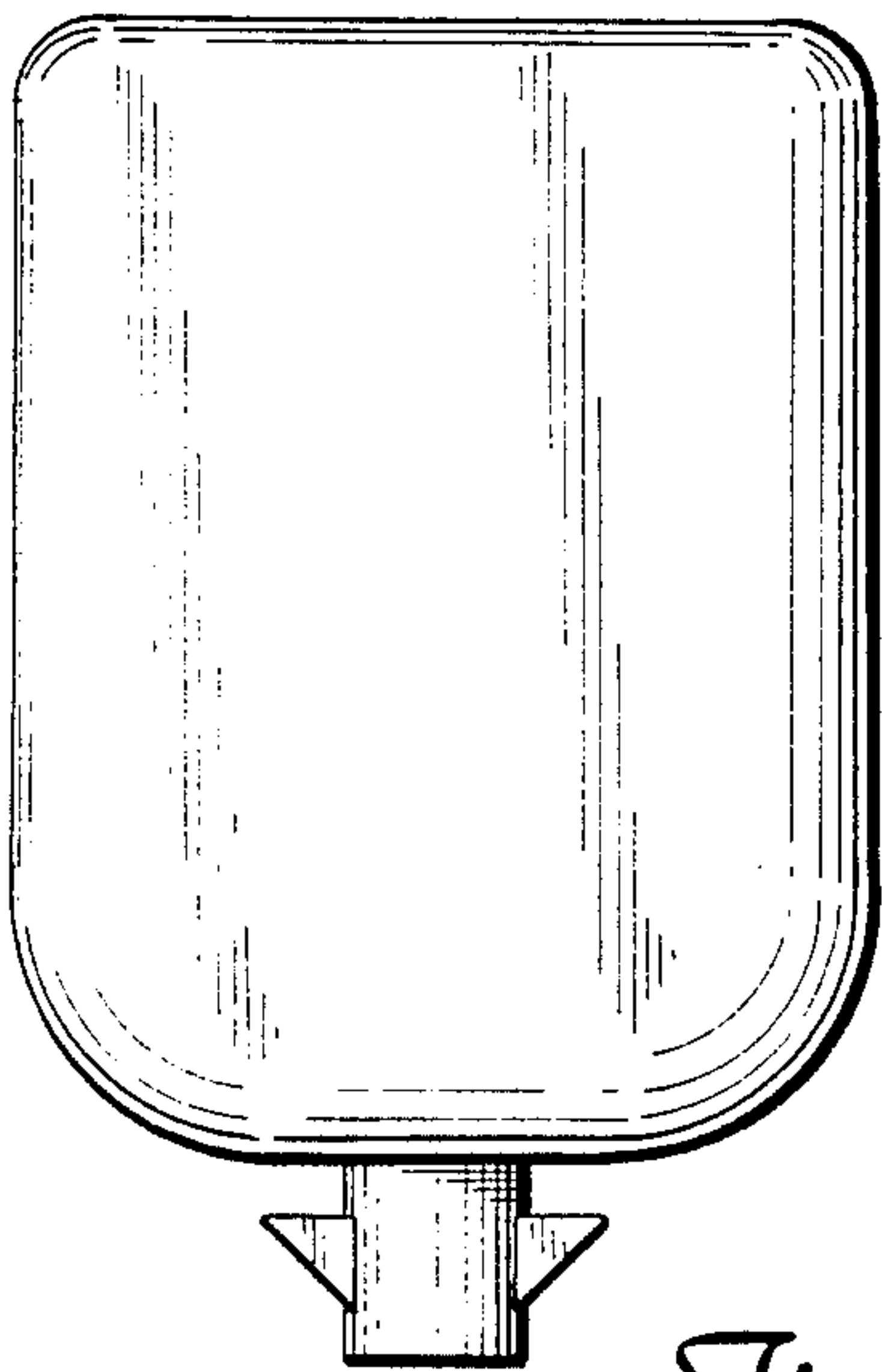

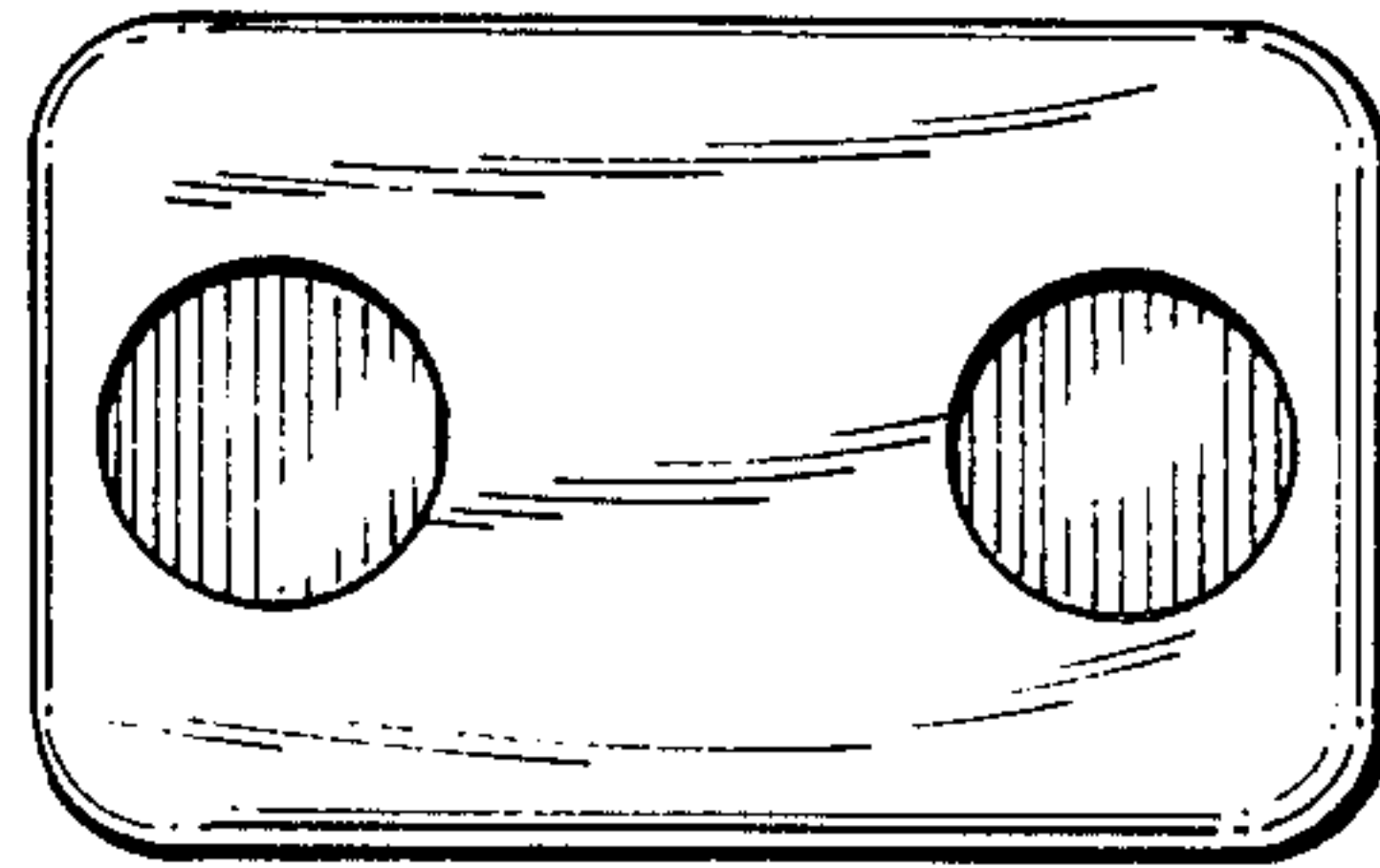

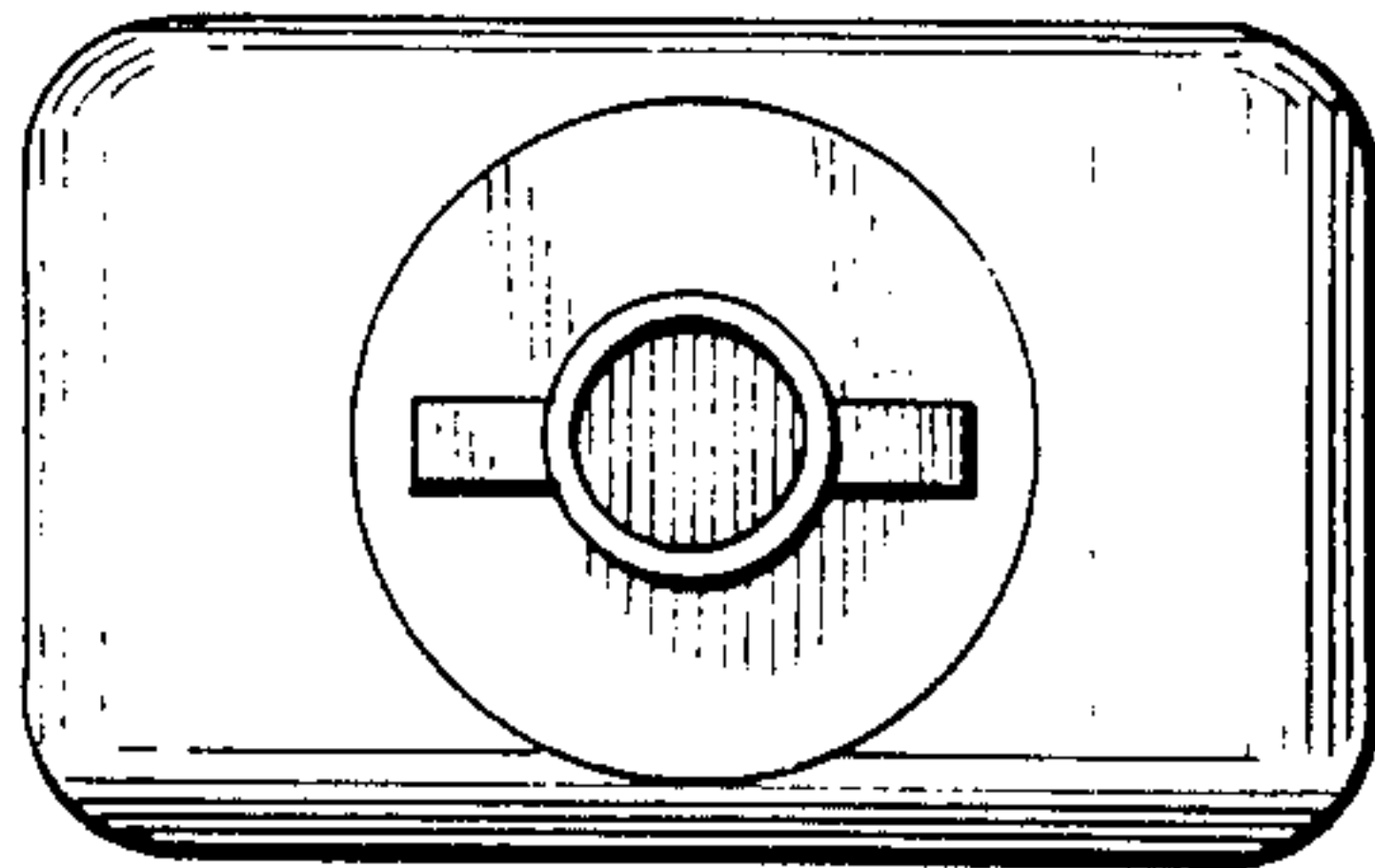
