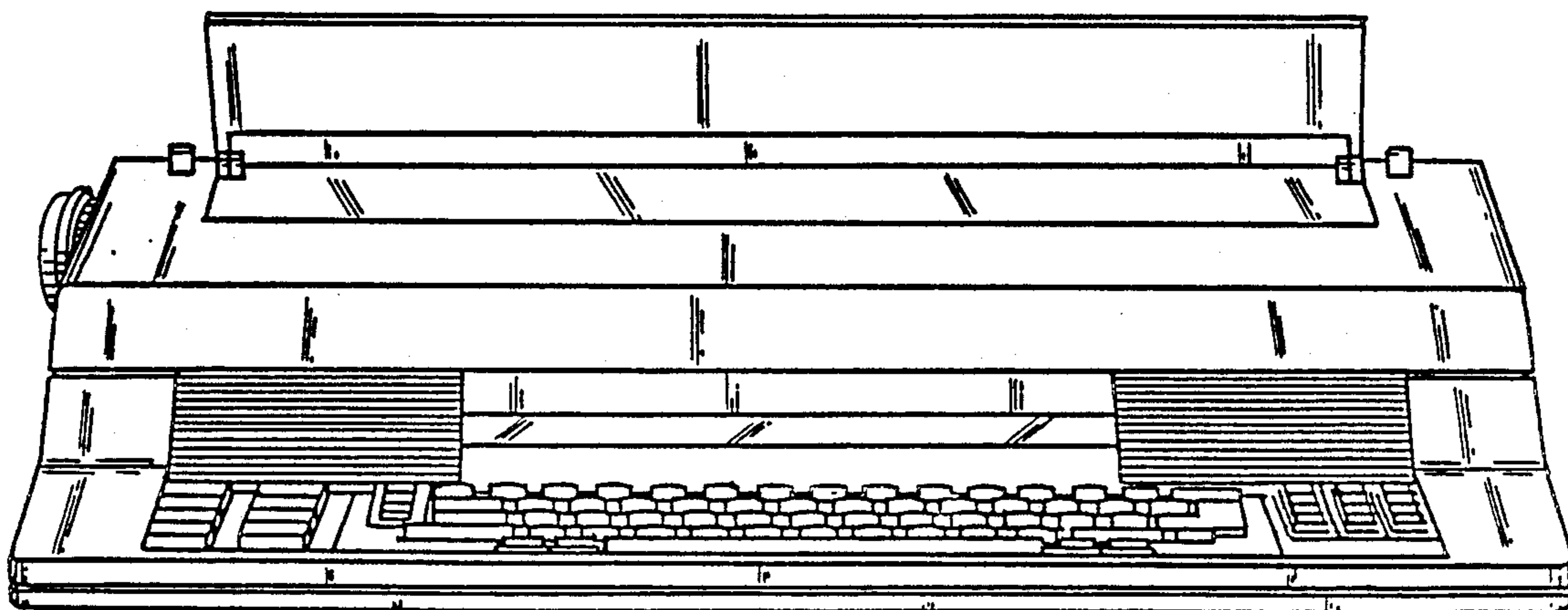
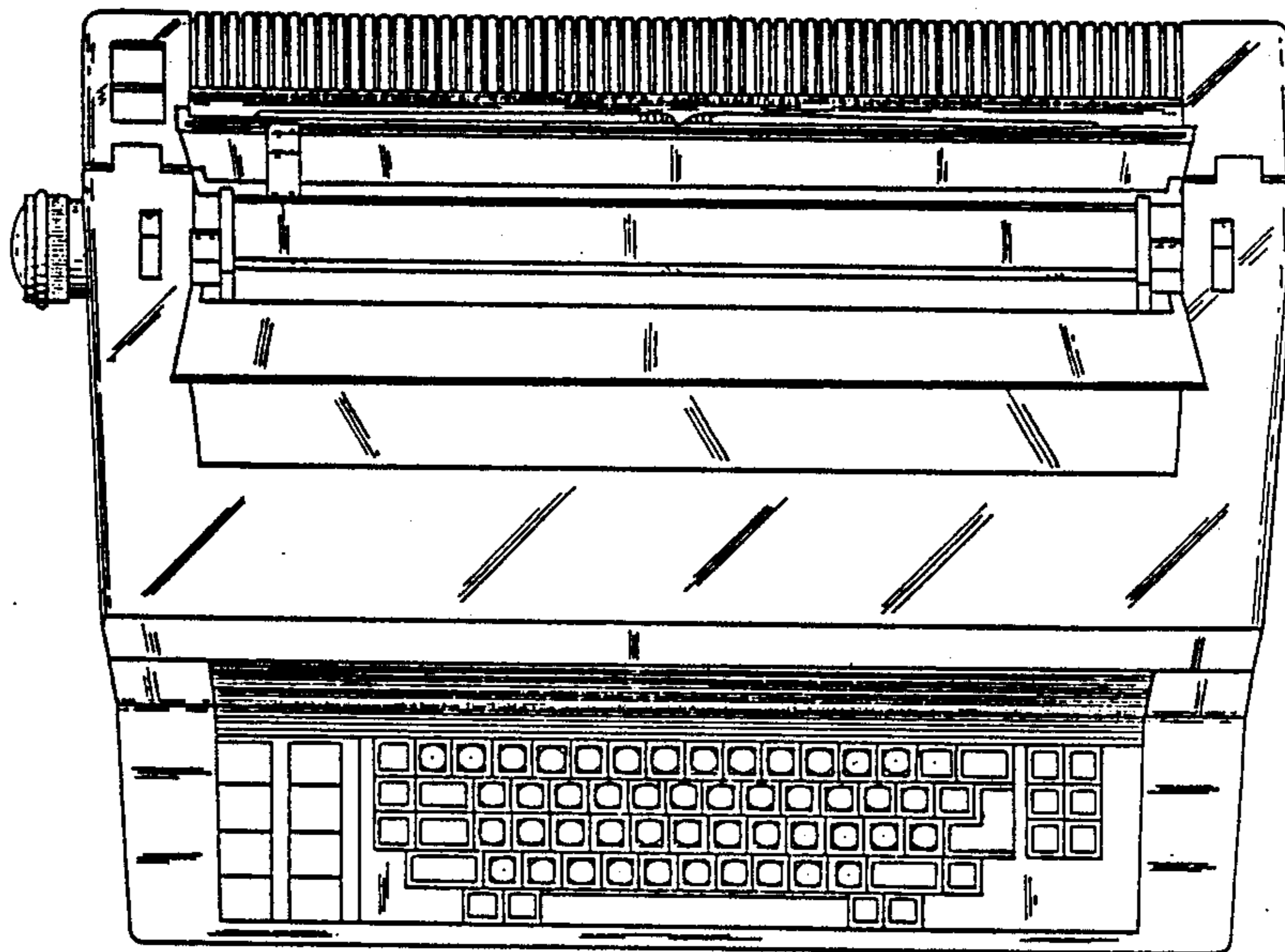
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a electronic typewriter showing our new design;

 FIG. 7 is a front perspective view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 6.

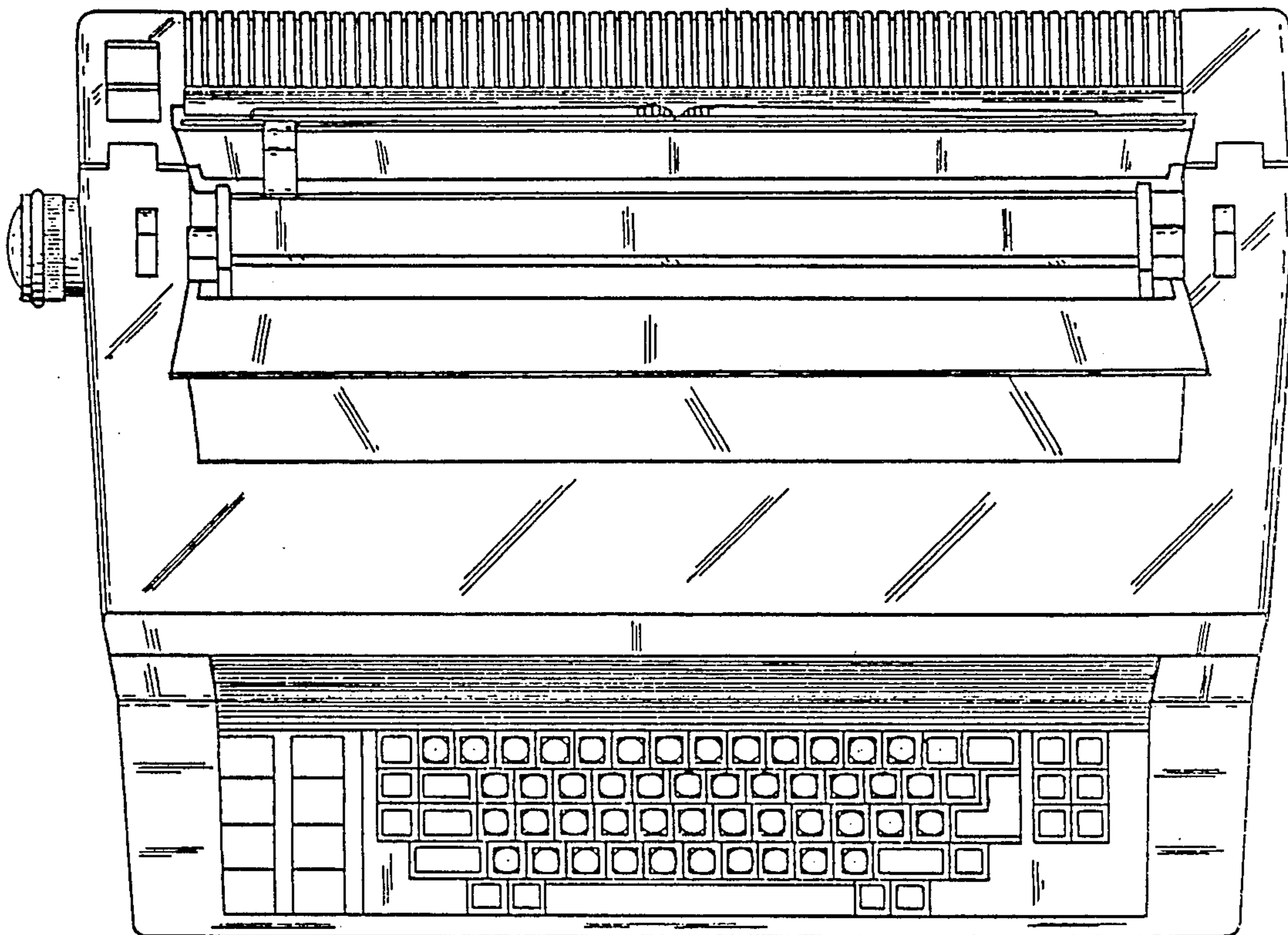

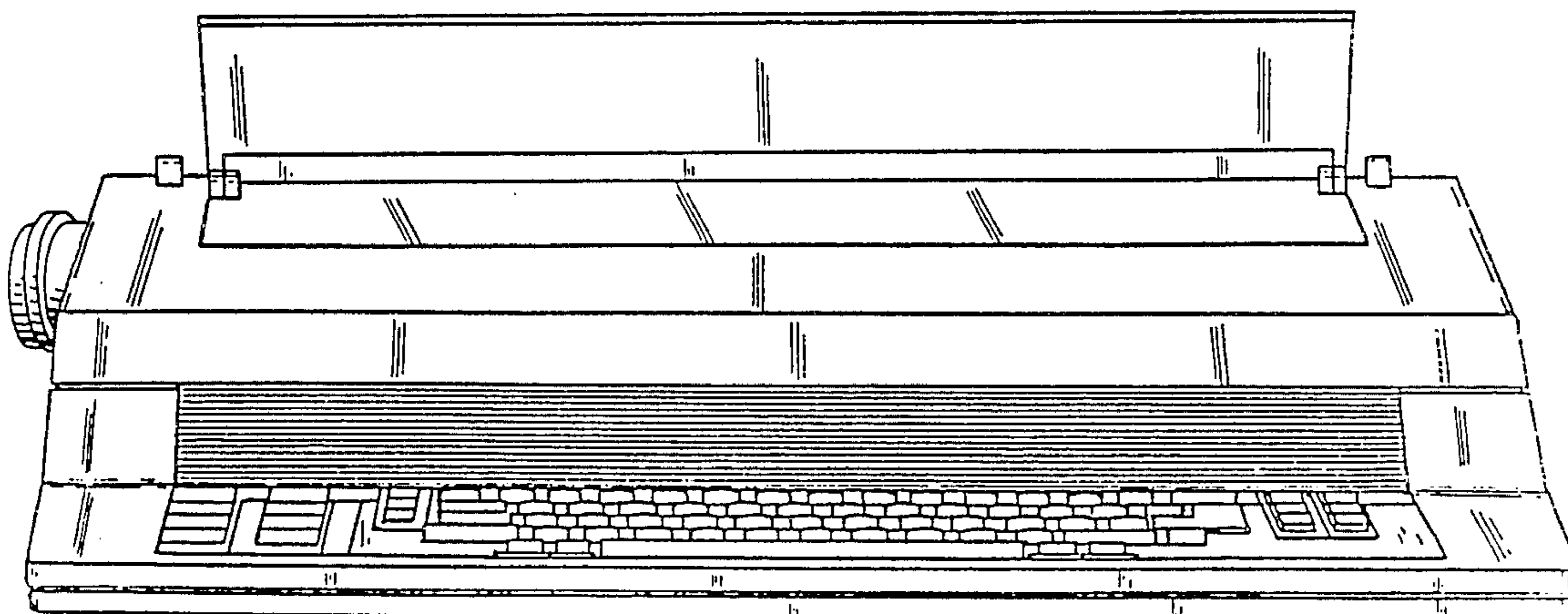

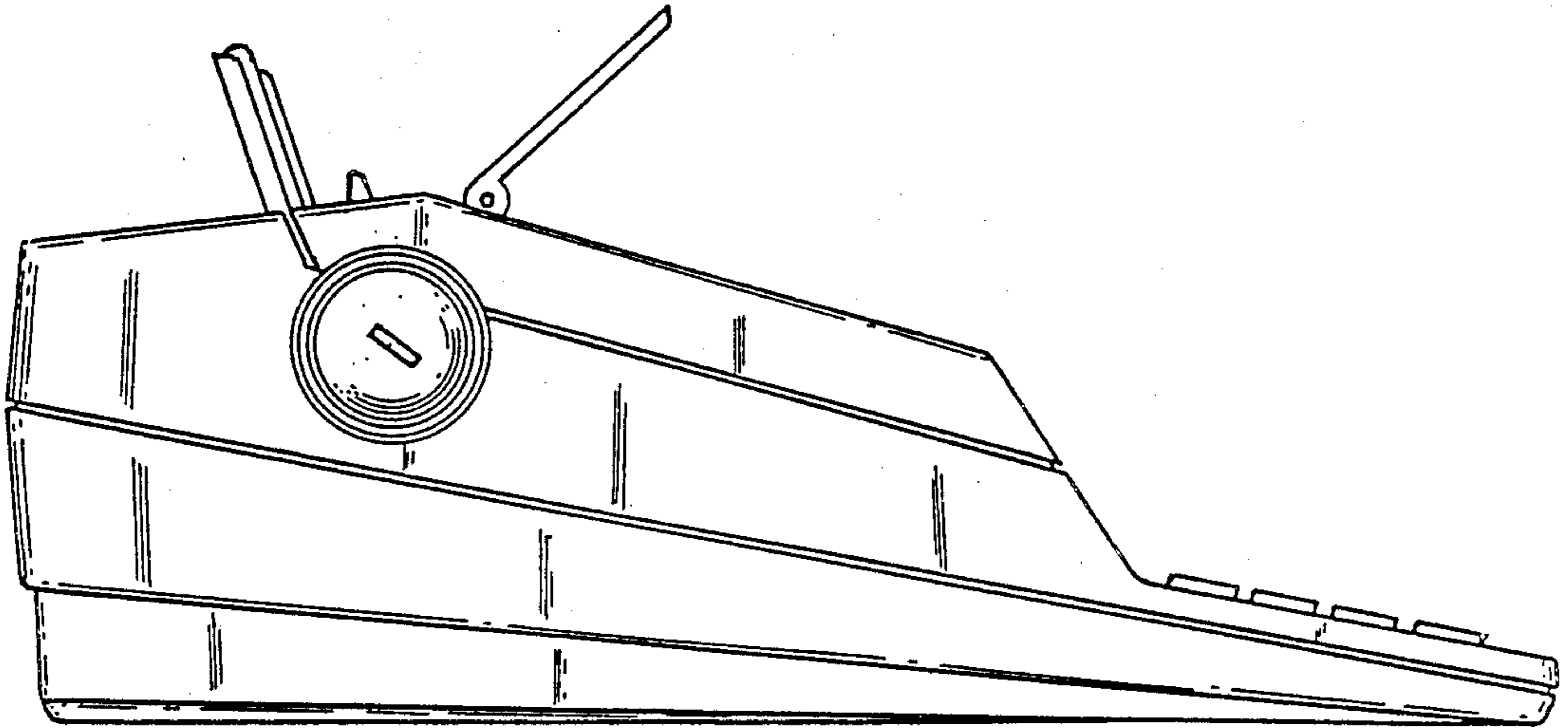




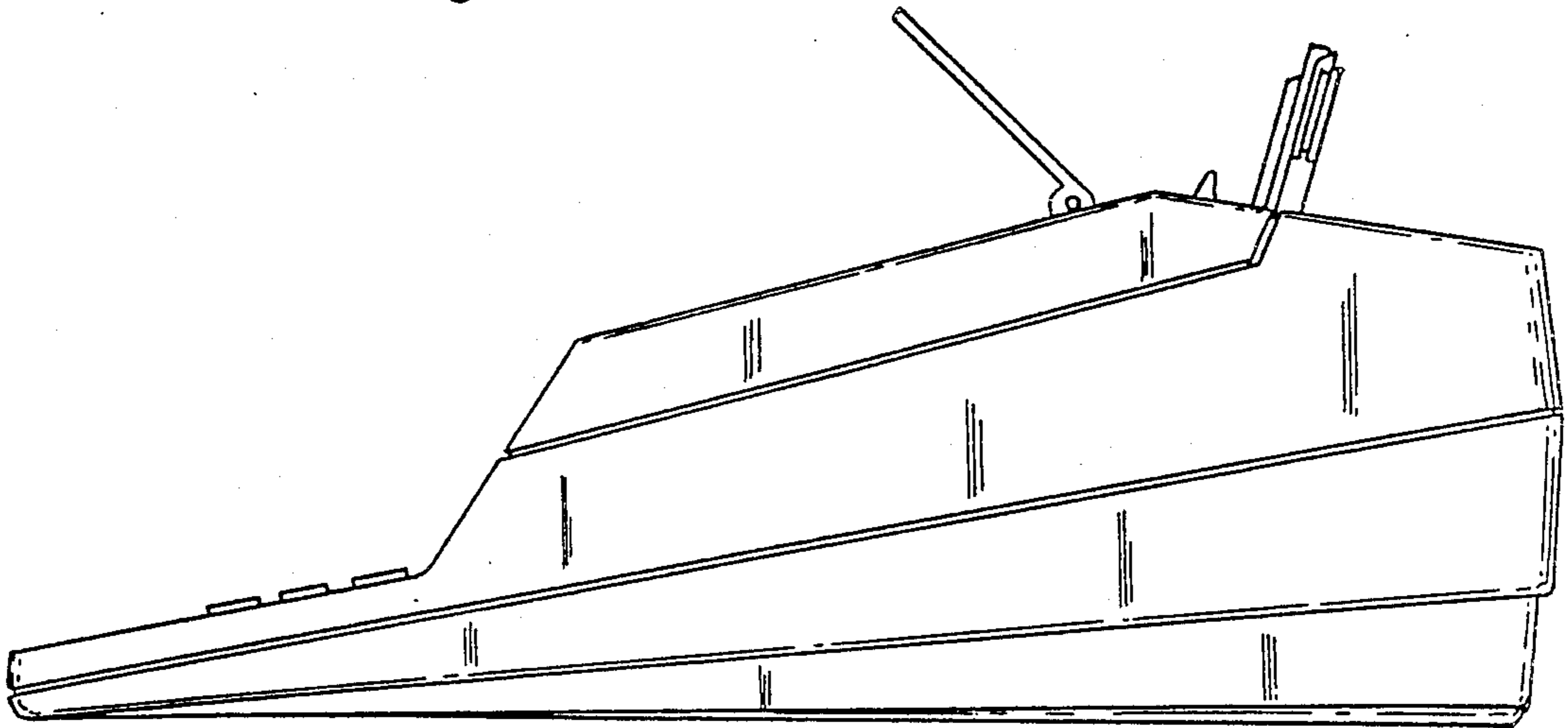

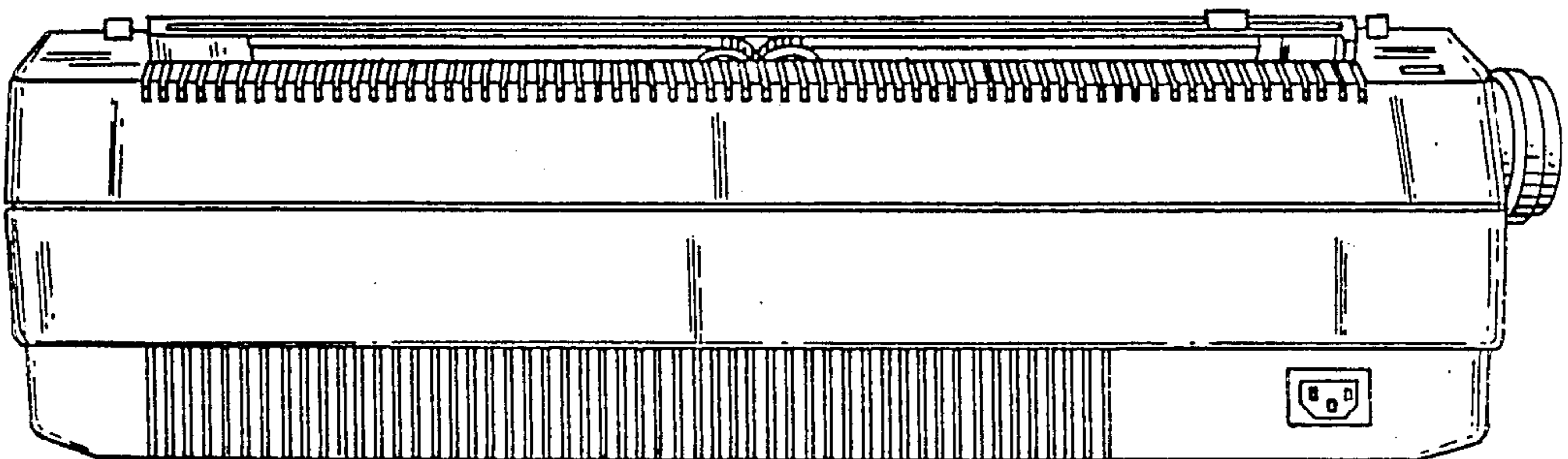

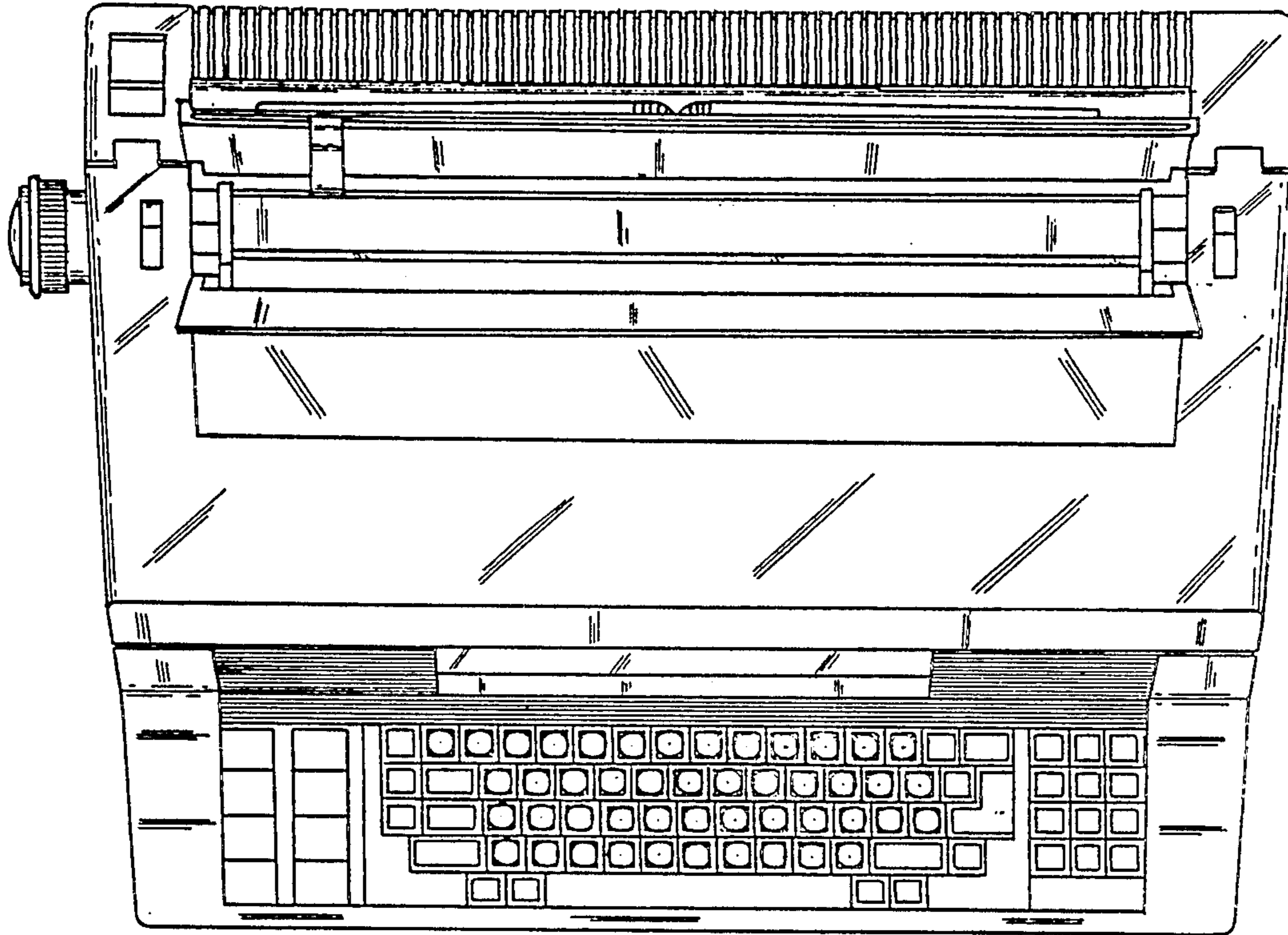

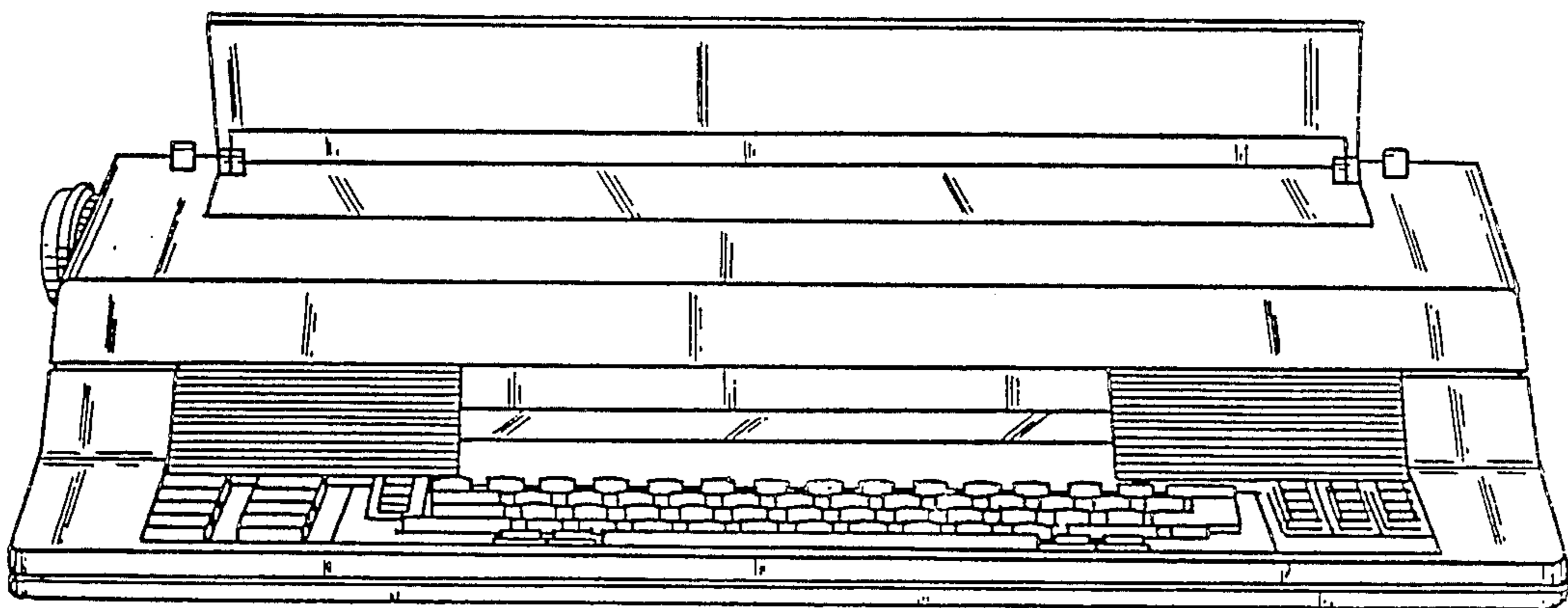
