[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a ball flight on golf club head, substantially as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a ball flight progression on a golf club head, the head shown in broken lines to show environment;  
FIG. 2 is an enlarged section on lines 2—2 of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 3 is an end view on lines 3—3 of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 4 is a rear view on lines 4—4 of FIG. 3;  
FIG. 5 is an end view on lines 5—5 of FIG. 1;  
FIGS. 6 and 7 are like FIG. 1, and show modified forms of the ball flight progression;  
FIGS. 7 and 8 are sections on line 8—8 of FIG. 6 and 9—9 of FIG. 7.
