The ornamental design for a pen and pencil holder for
automobile visor or similar article, substantially as
shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pen and pencil holder
for automobile visor or similar article, showing my new
design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

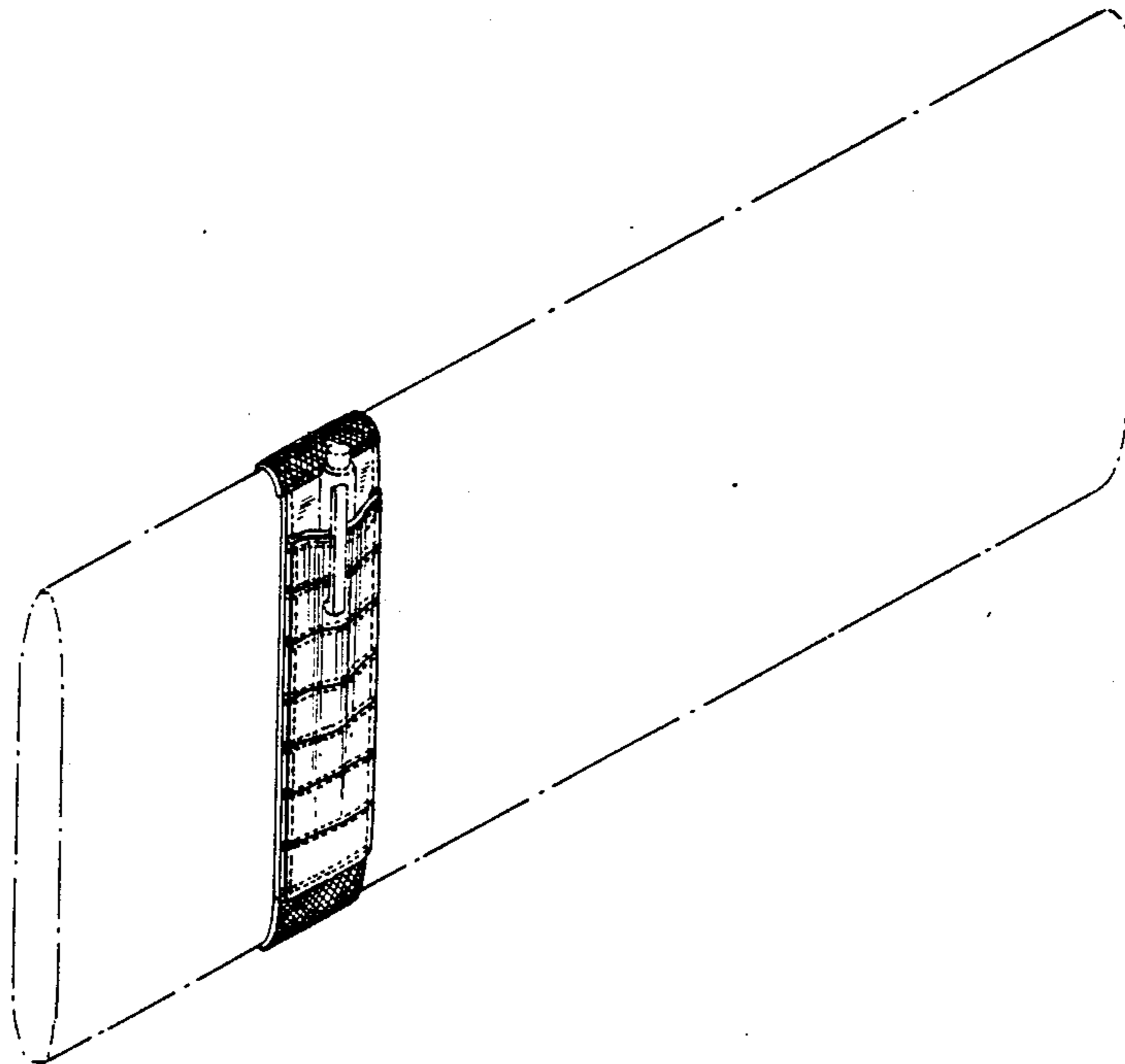
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the side

part of the claimed design.



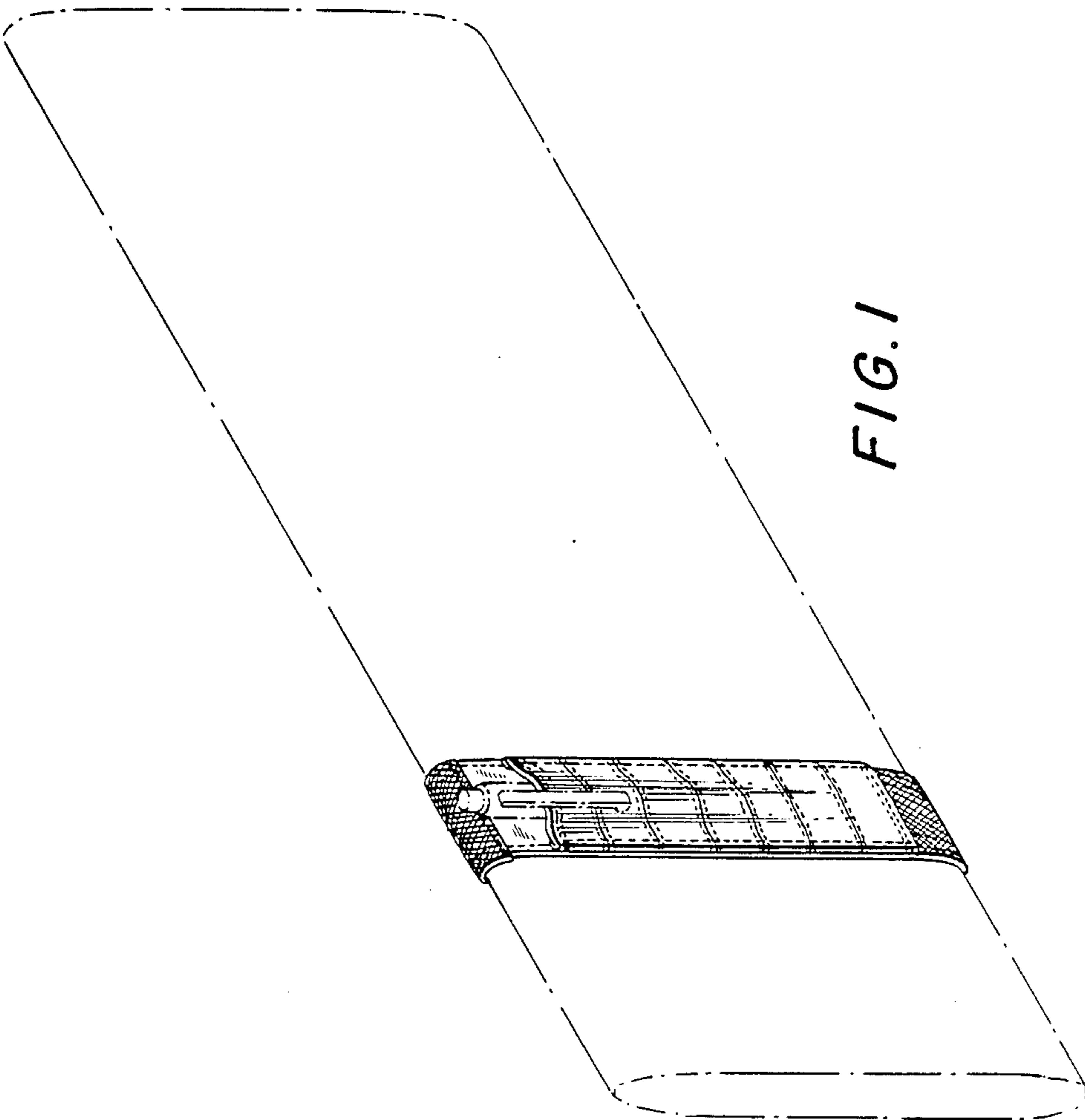

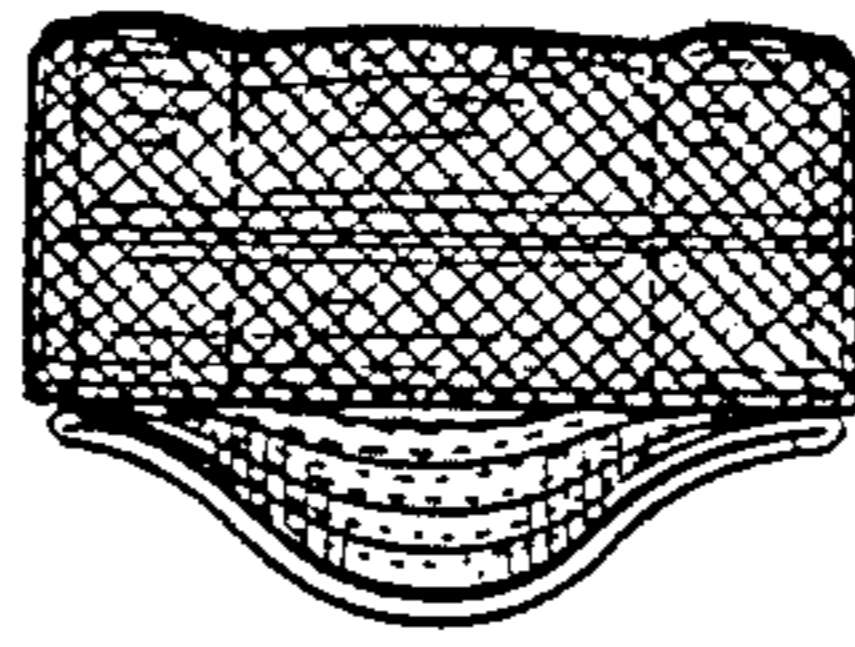

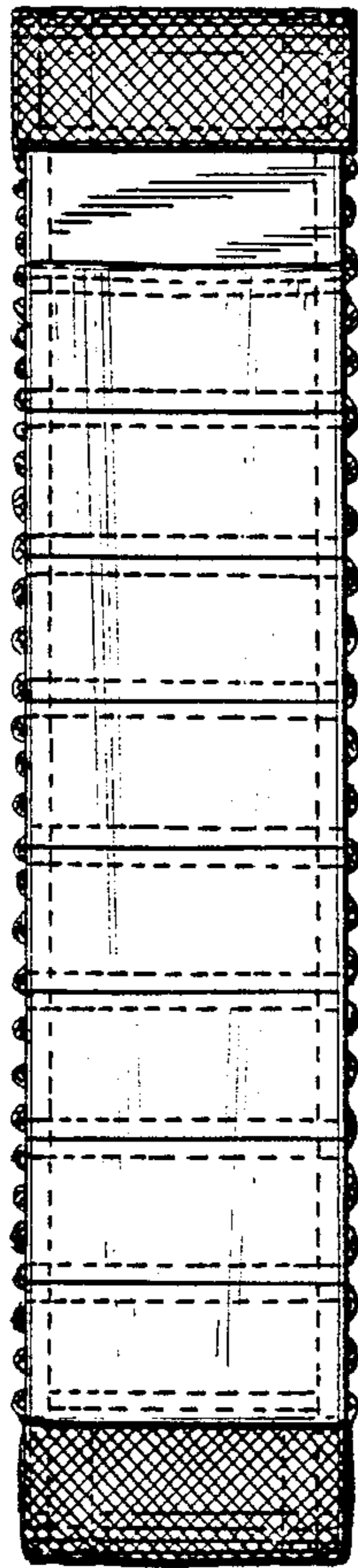

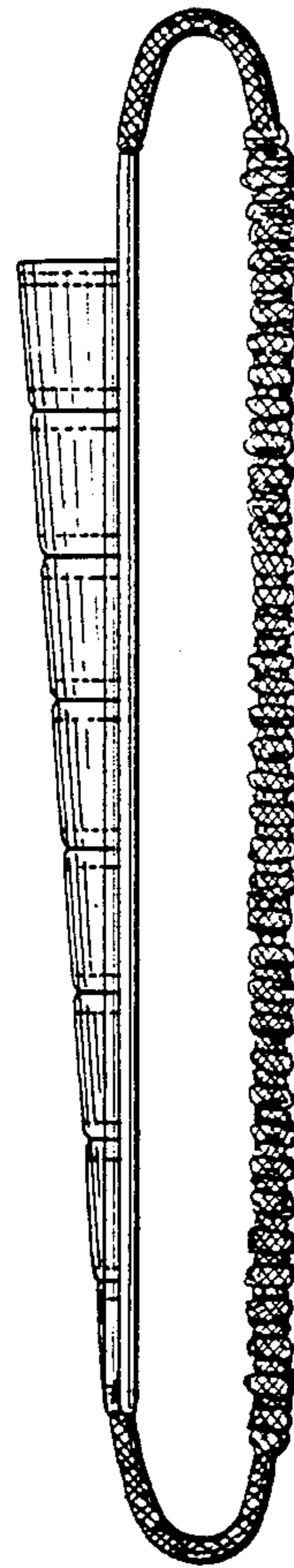

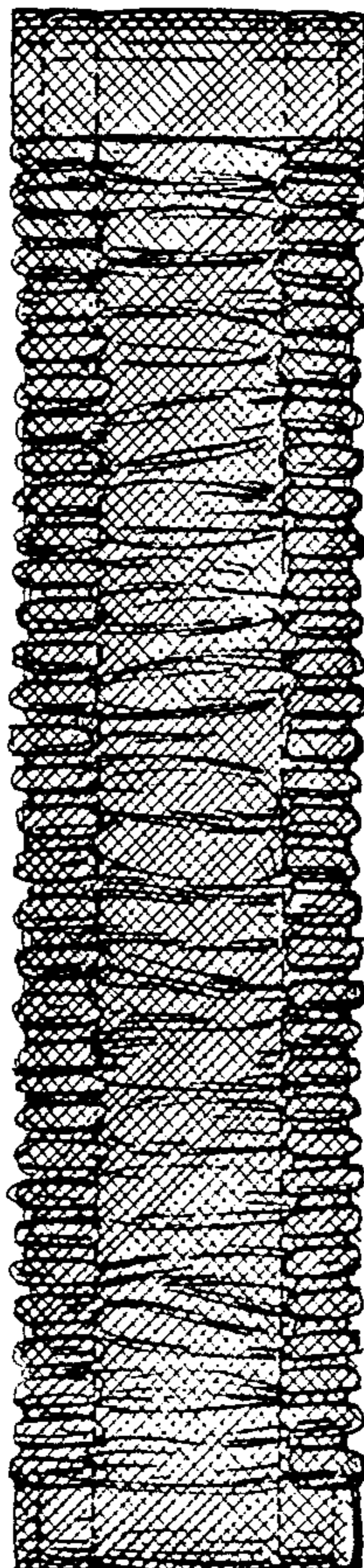
