DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a portable television set showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom plan view being identical to the top plan view;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a top, front and right side perspective view thereof.

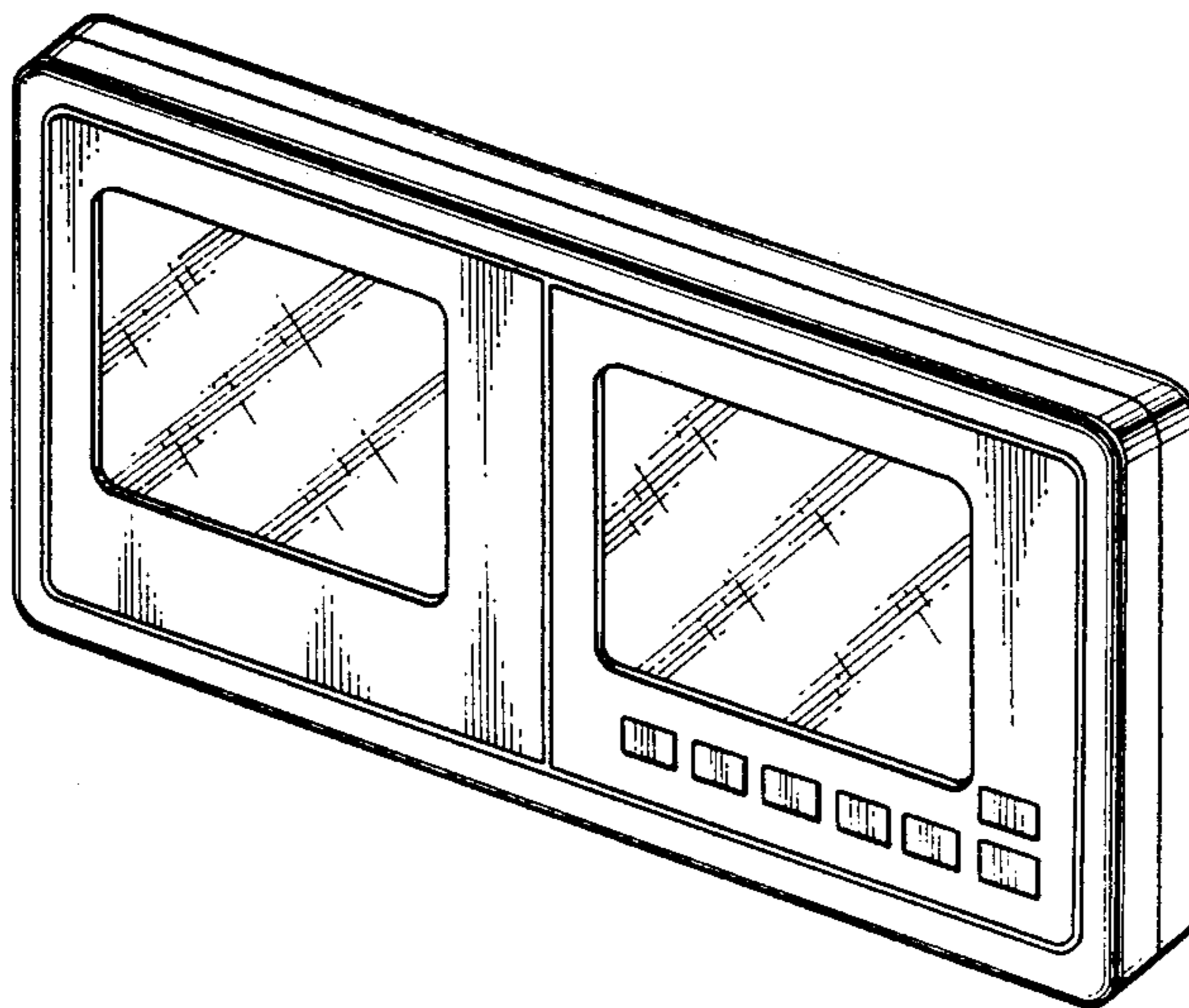

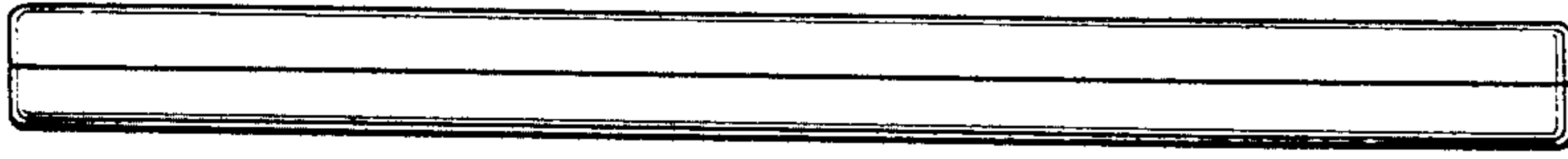

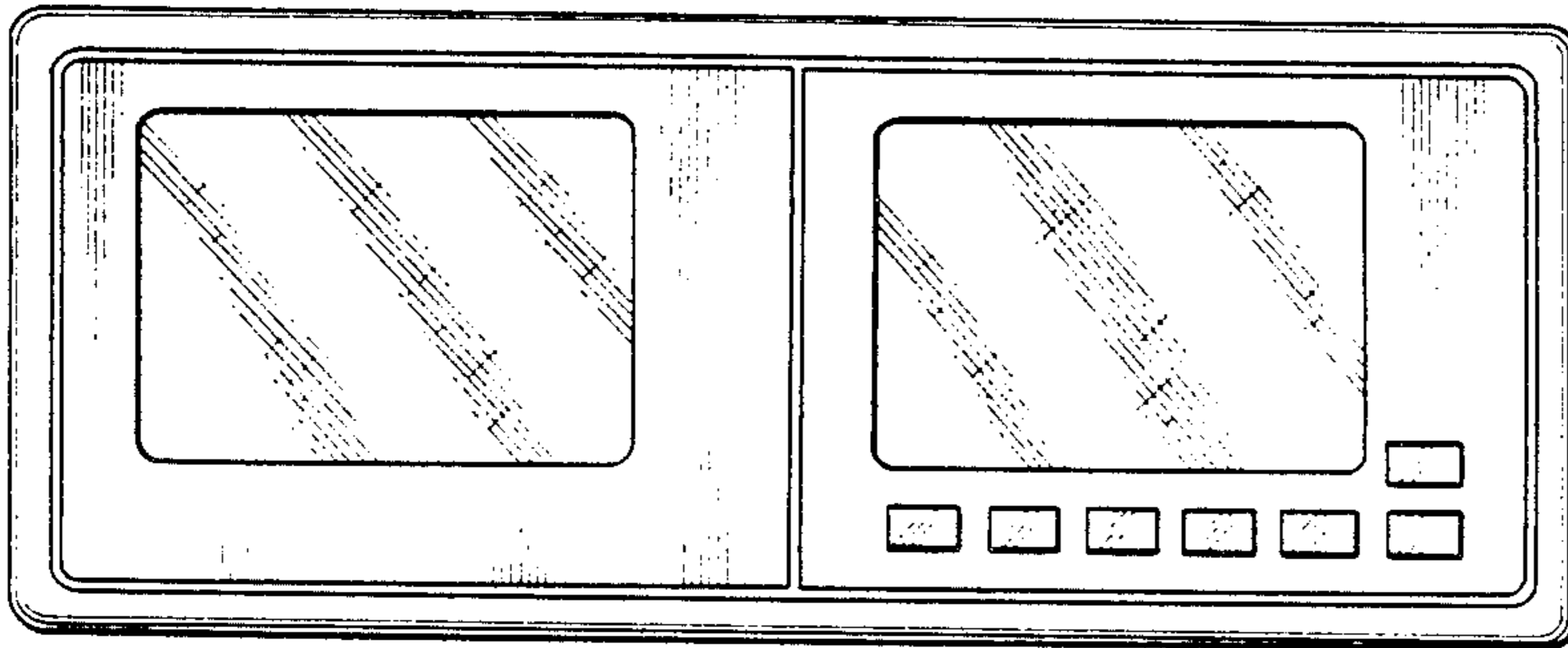

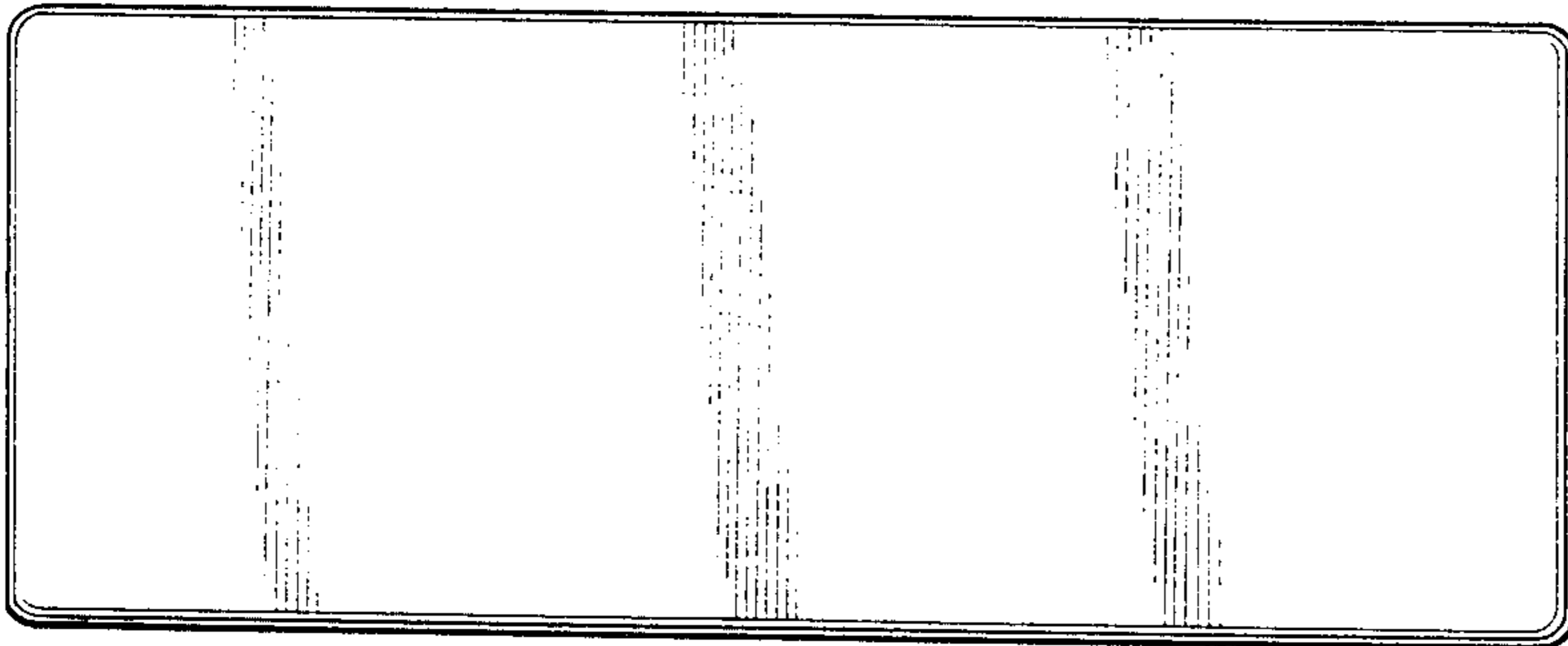

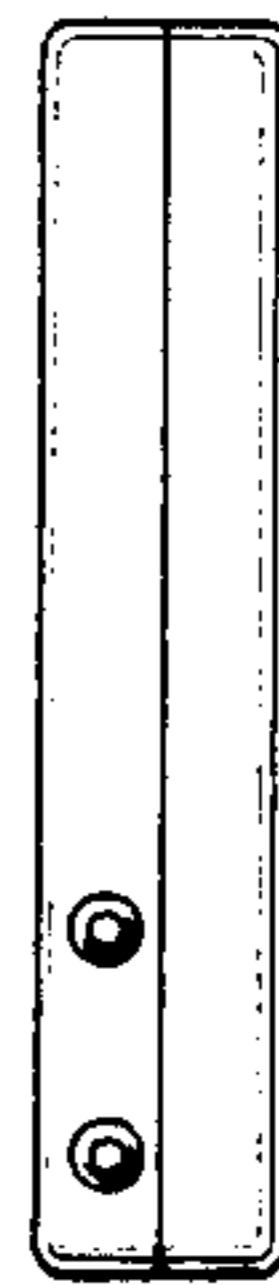
