FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

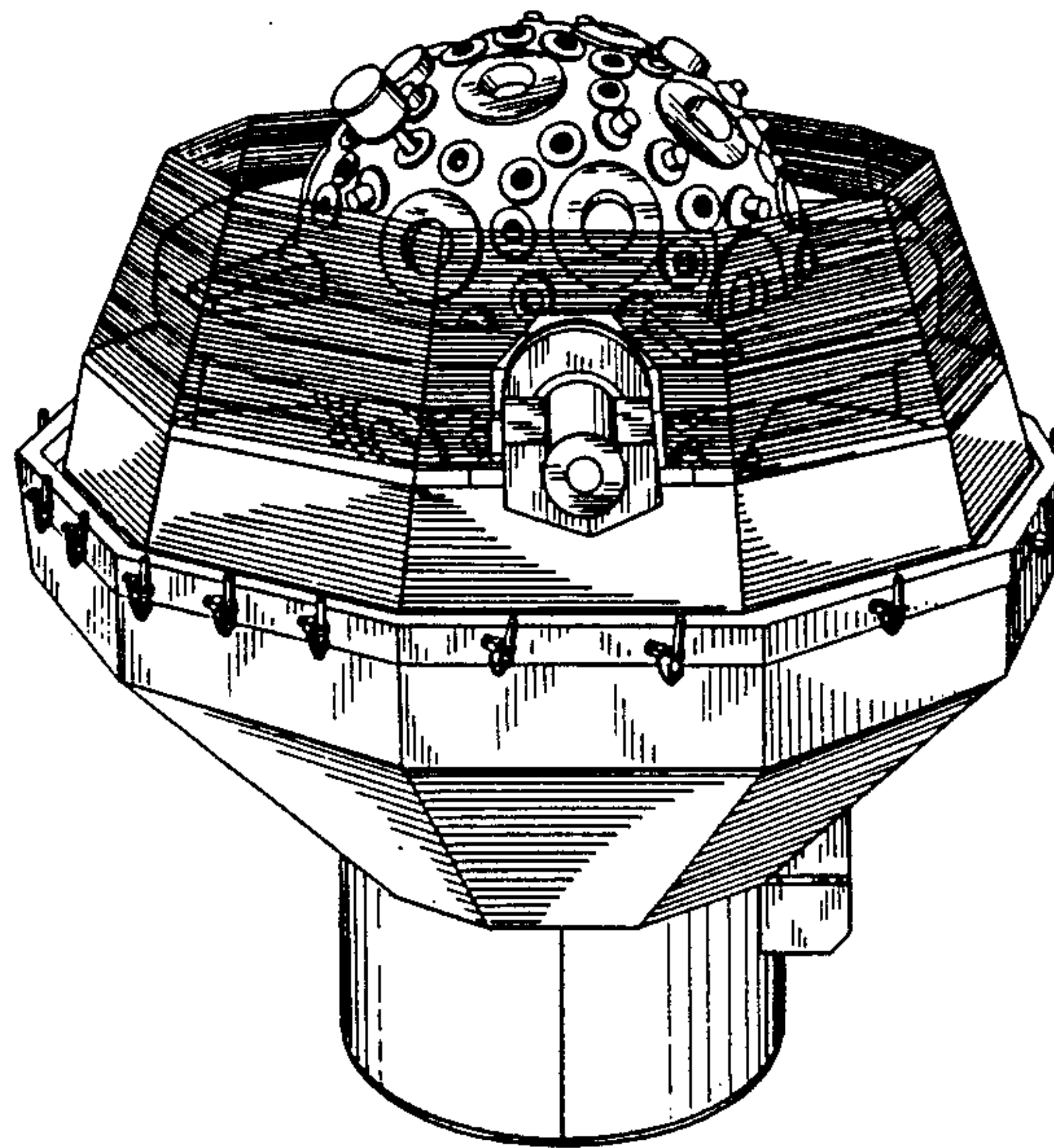
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

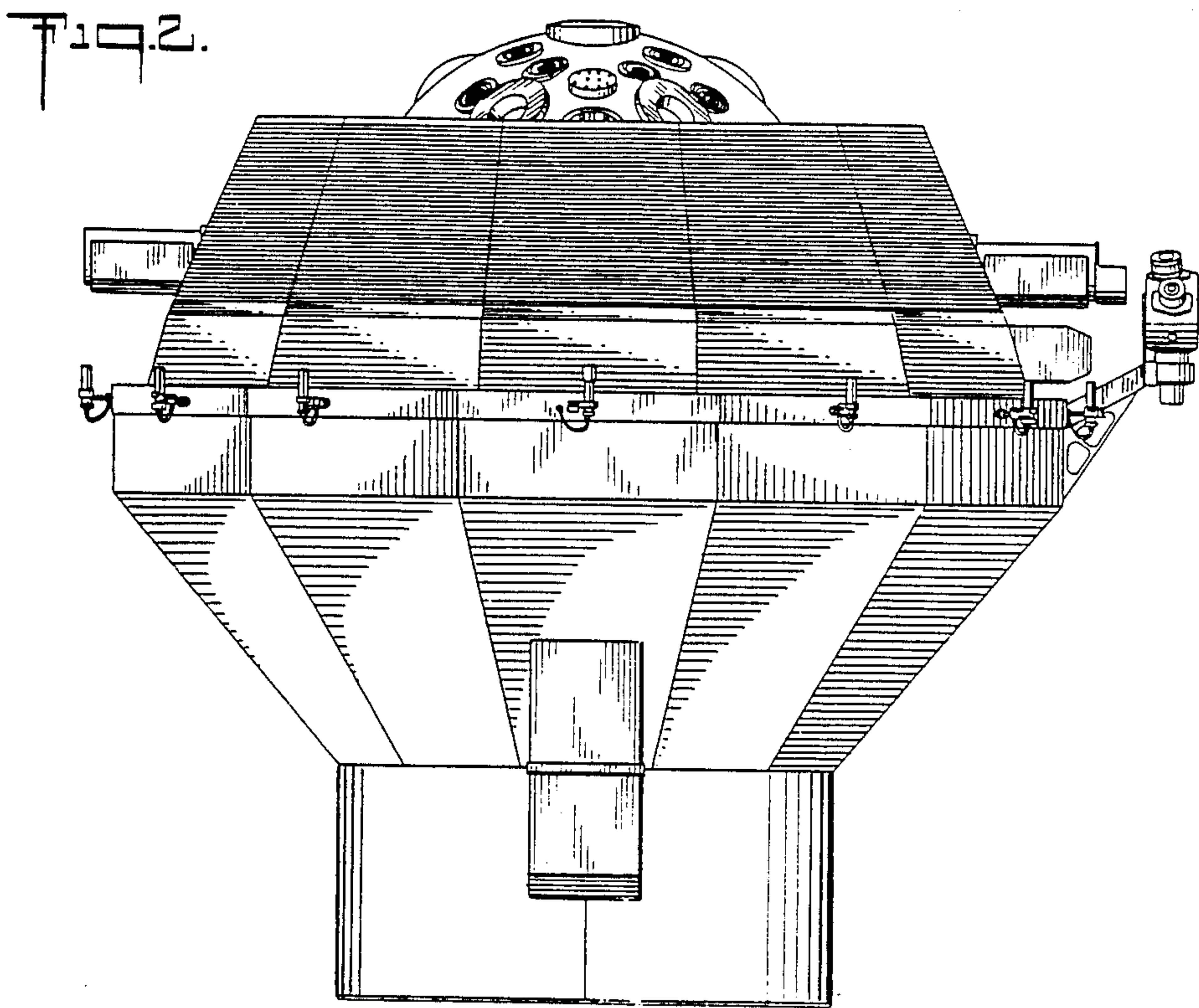
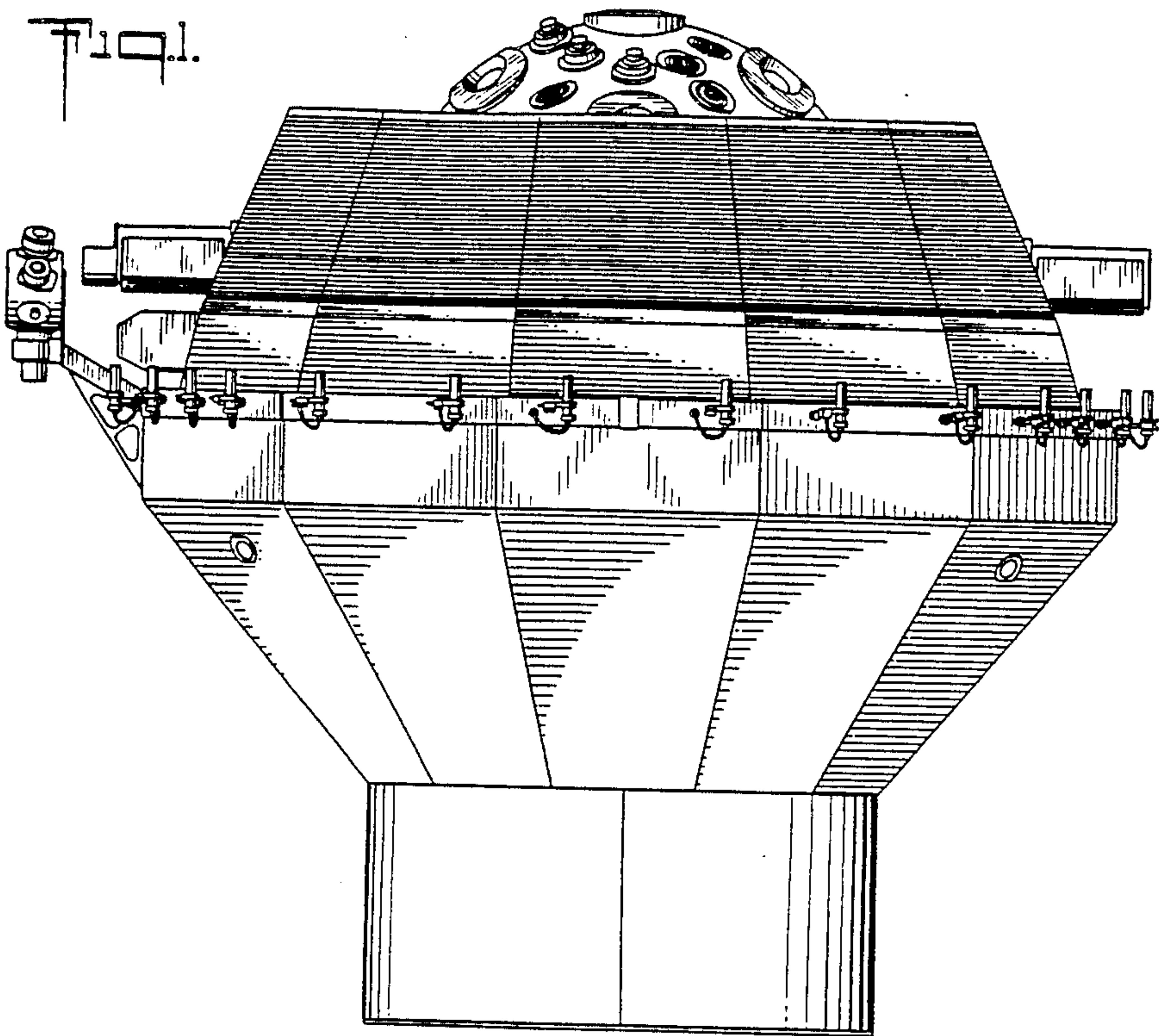
FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.





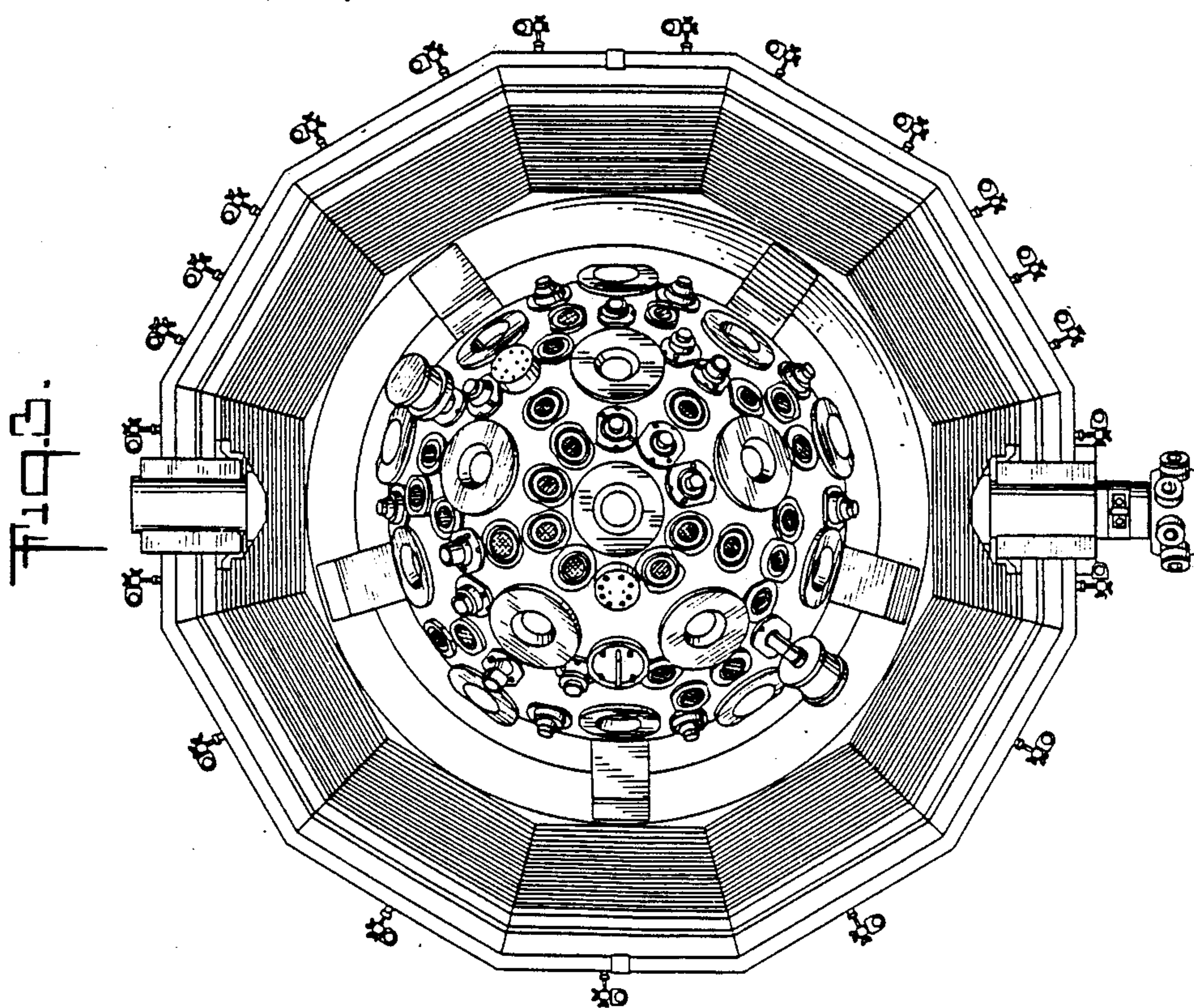
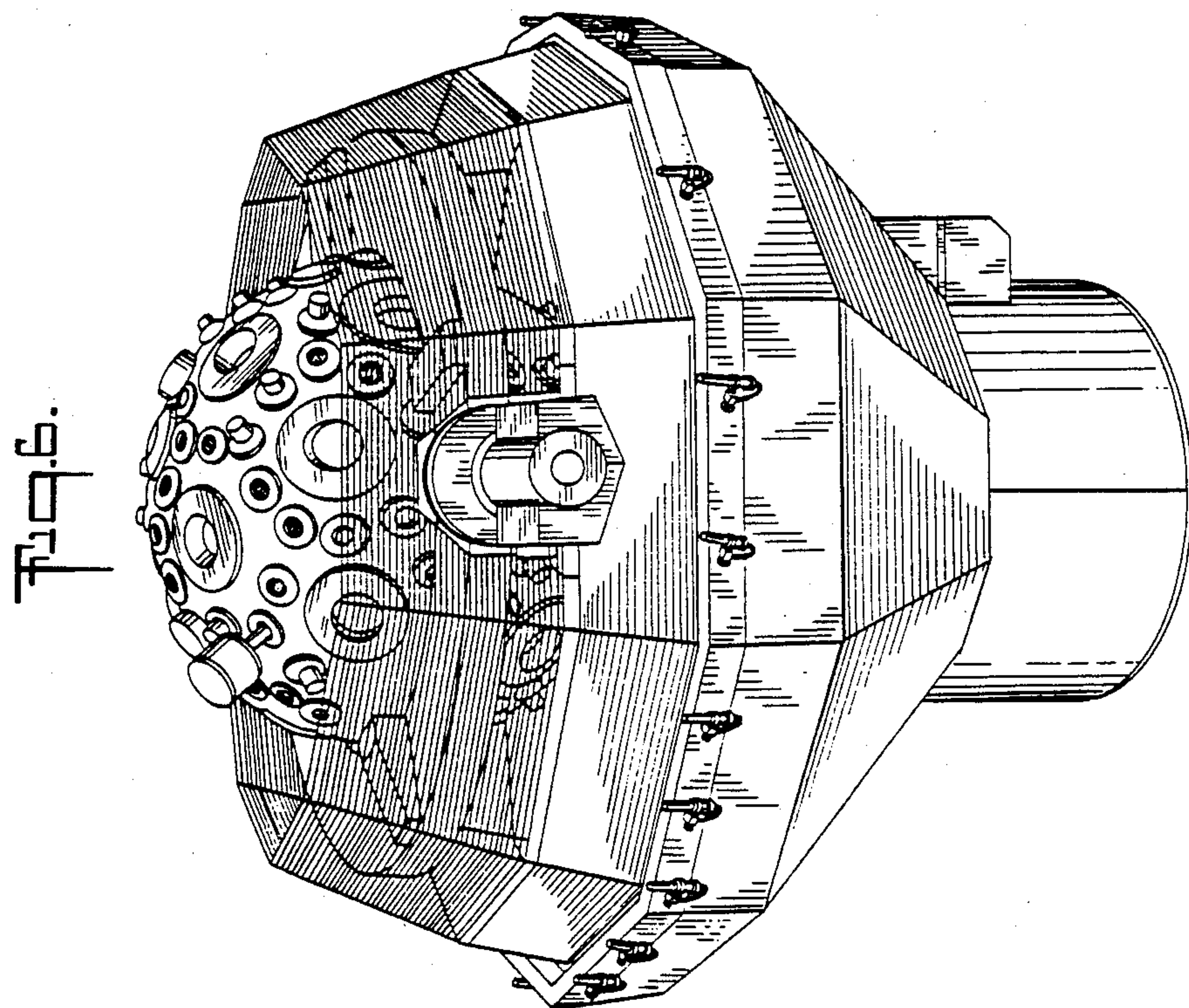

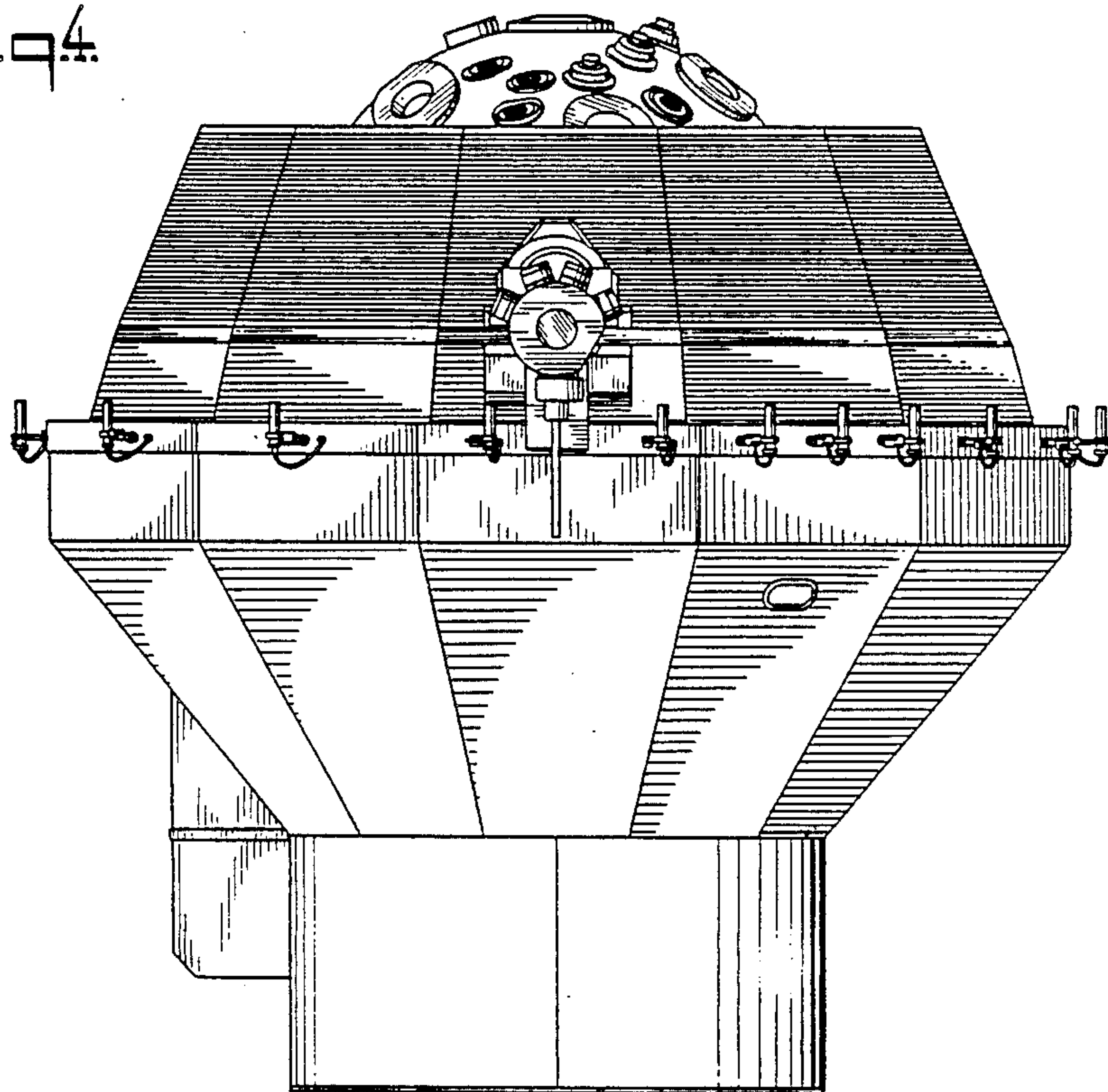

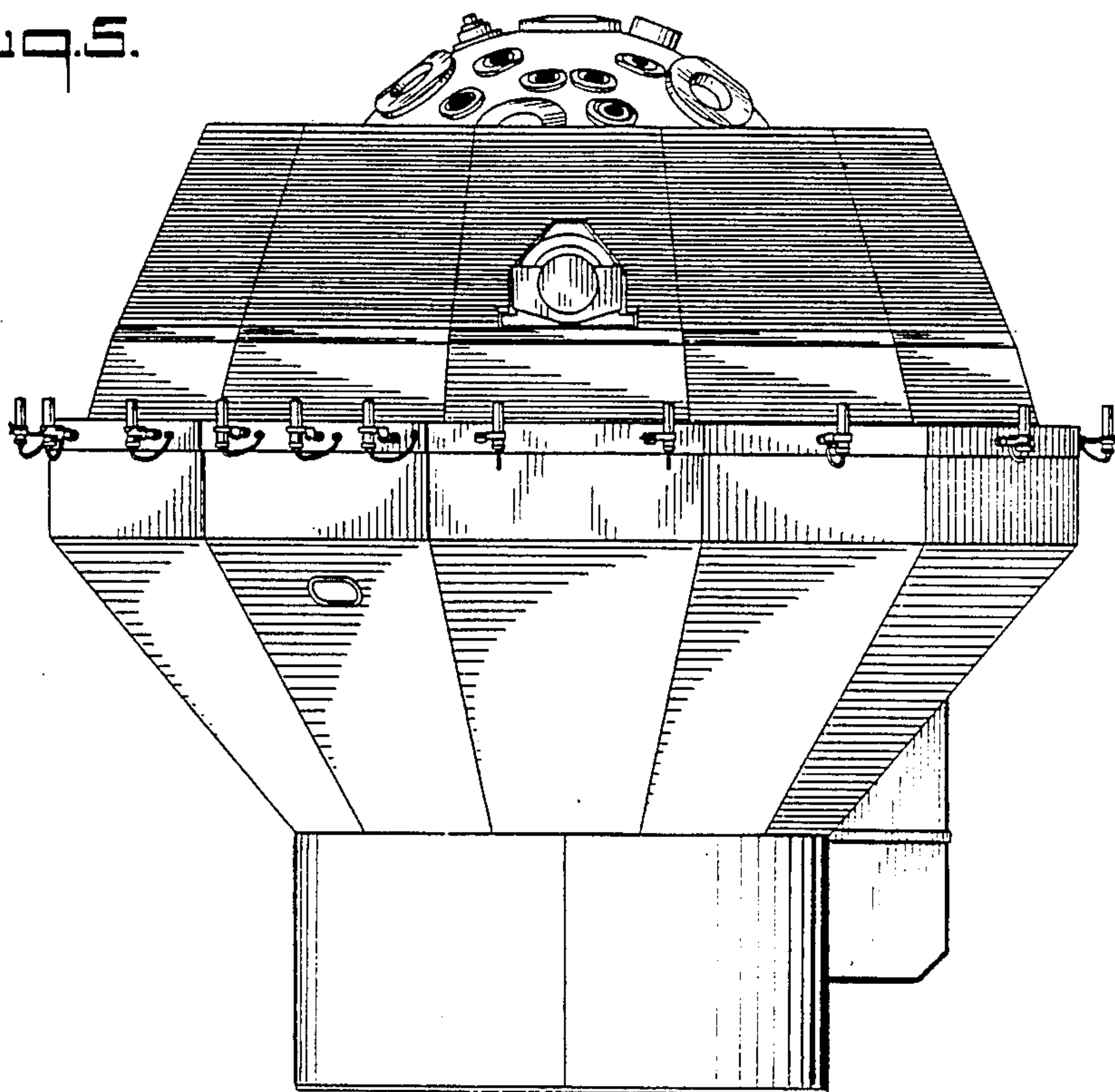
