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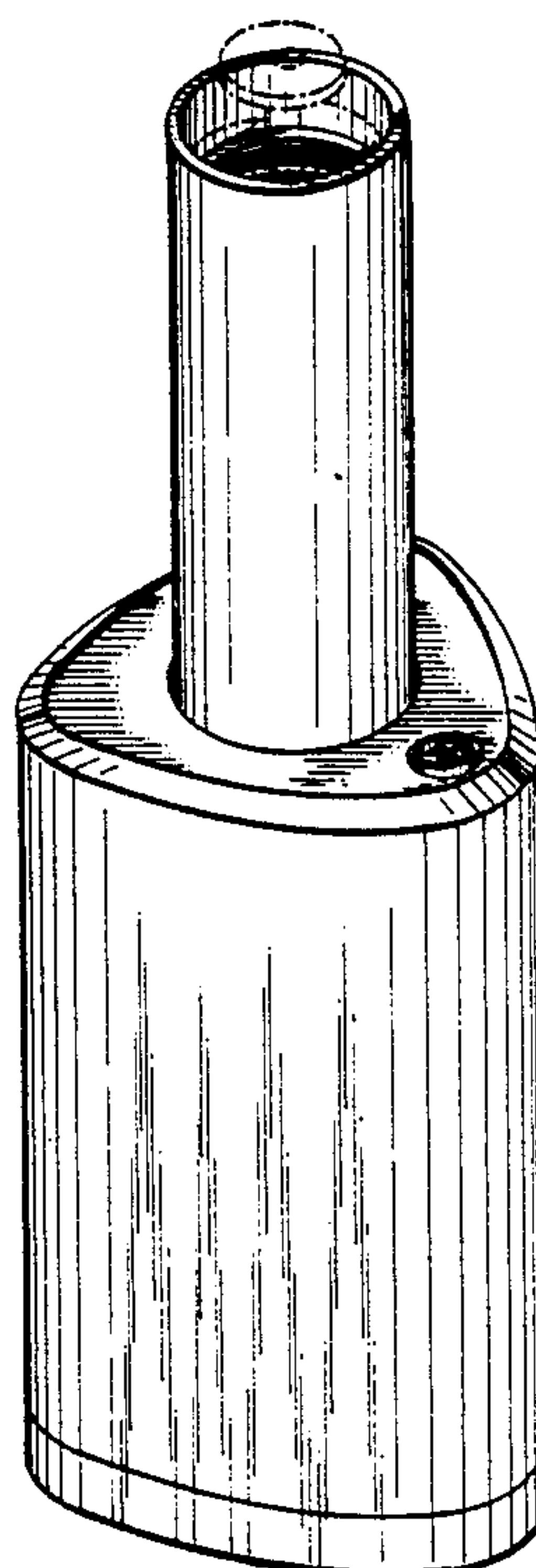
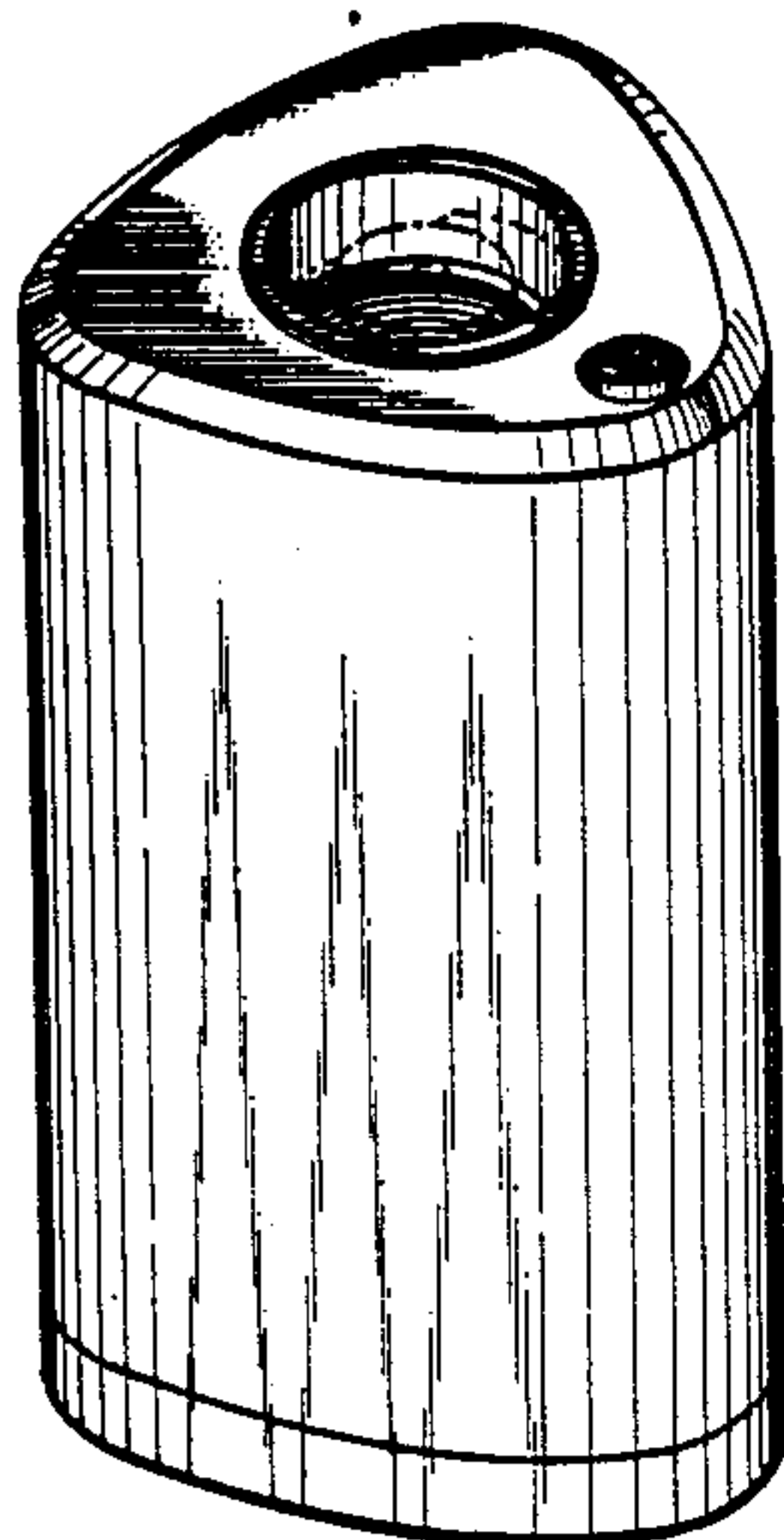

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a pop-up sprinkler showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is an elevational view taken from the top side of FIG. 3.
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is an elevational view taken from the left side of FIG. 3.
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 6 is a top perspective view thereof with the pop-up sprinkler shown in the extended position.
The broken-line showing of the sprinkler head is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



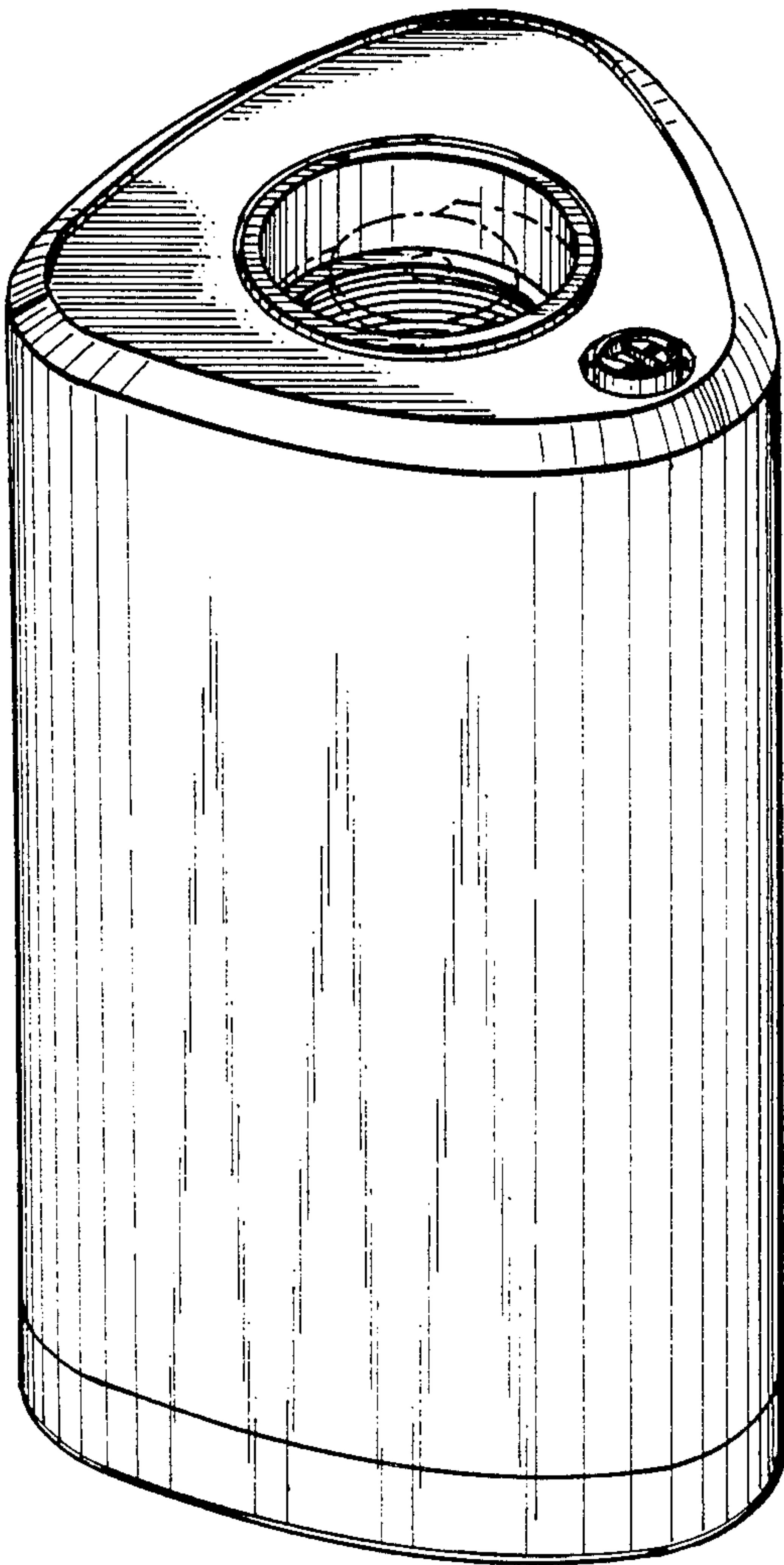

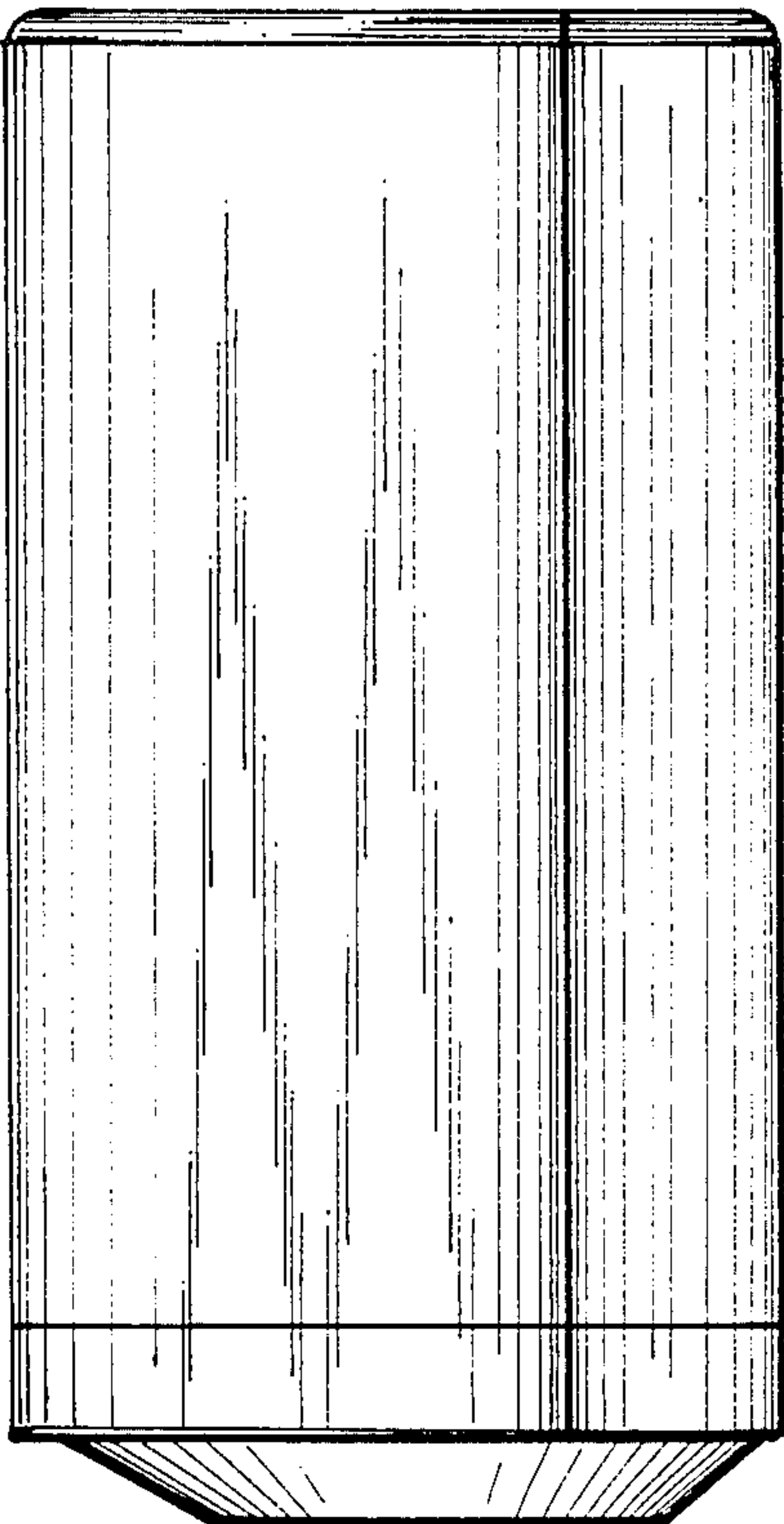
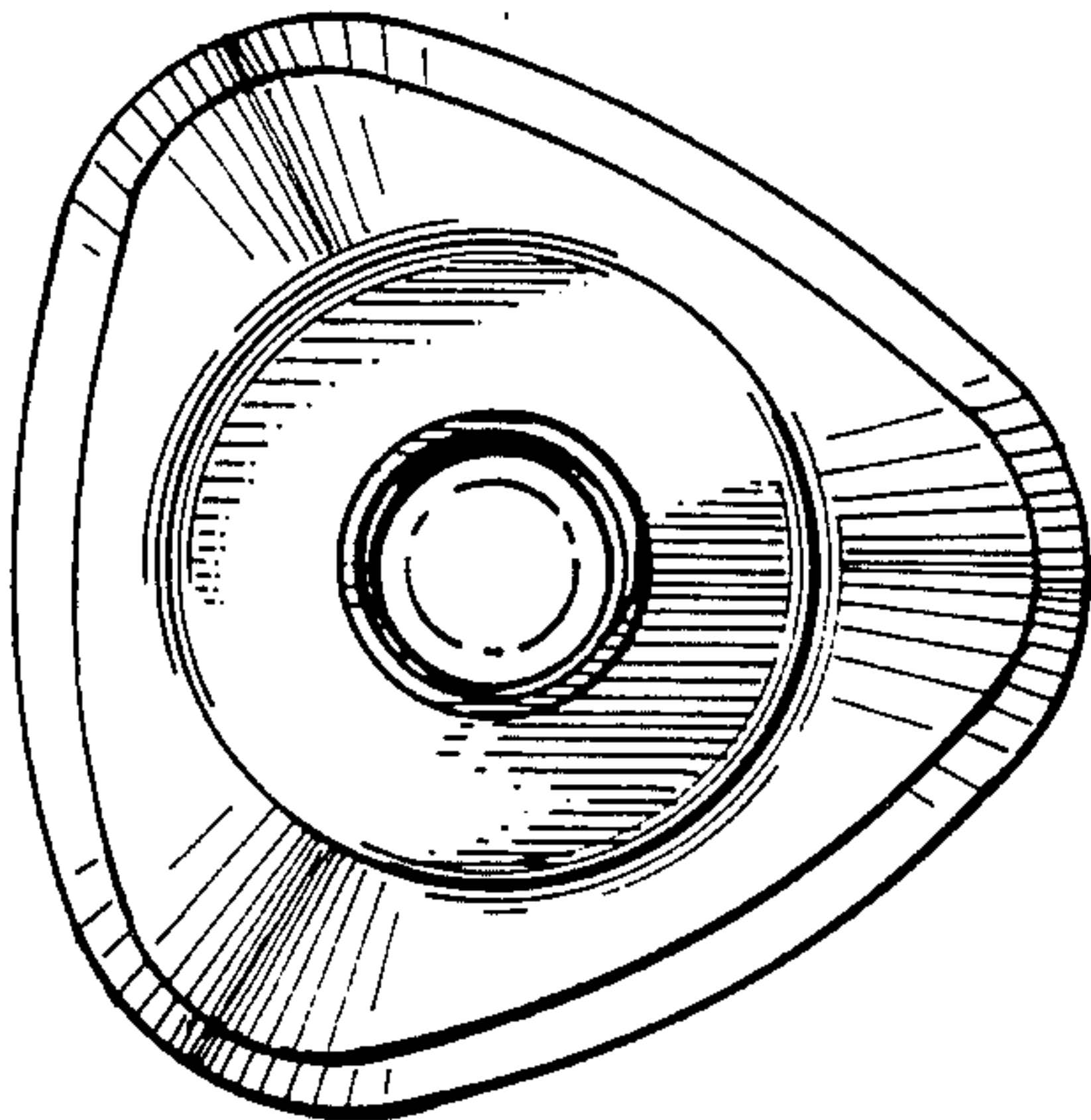

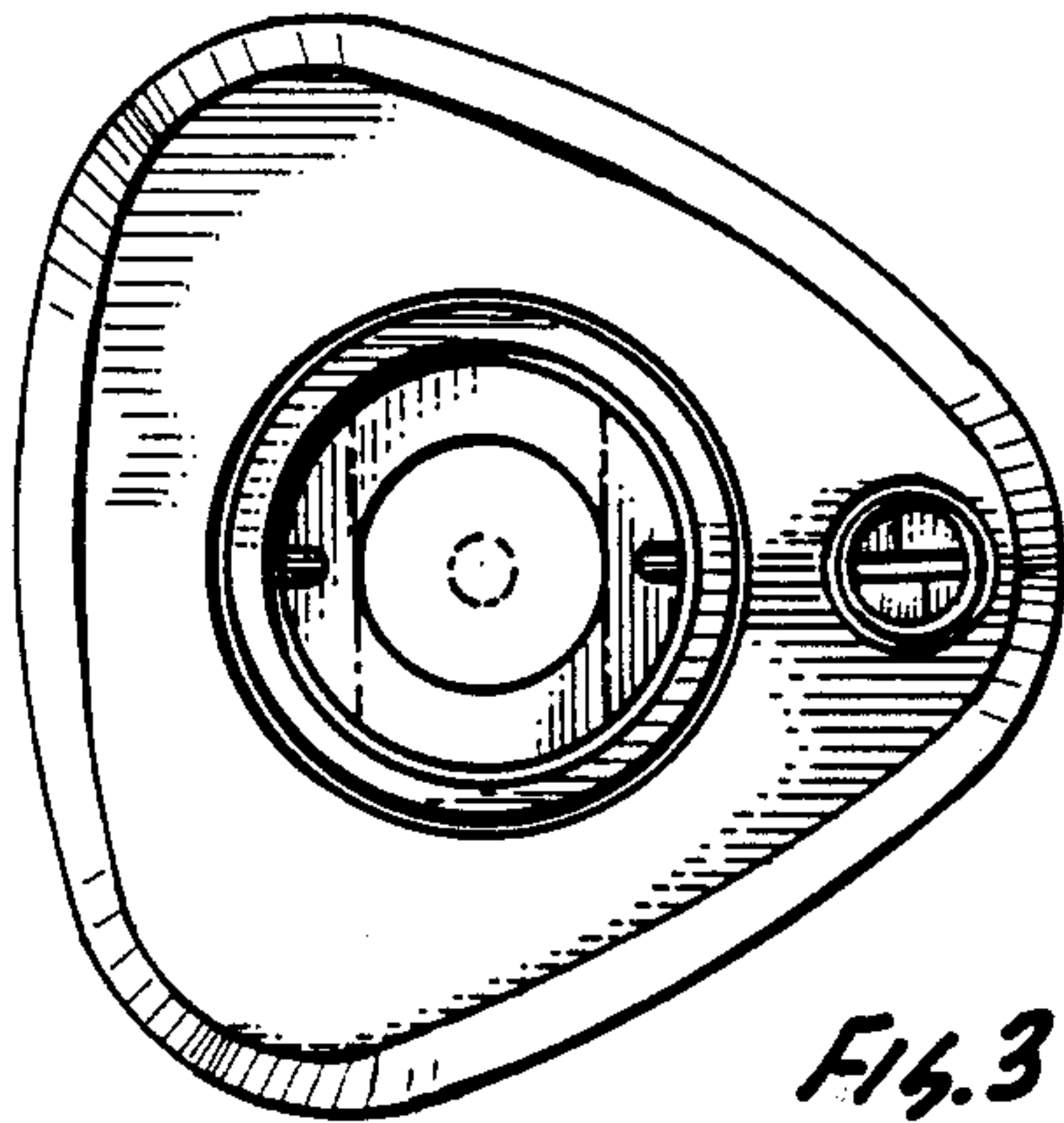

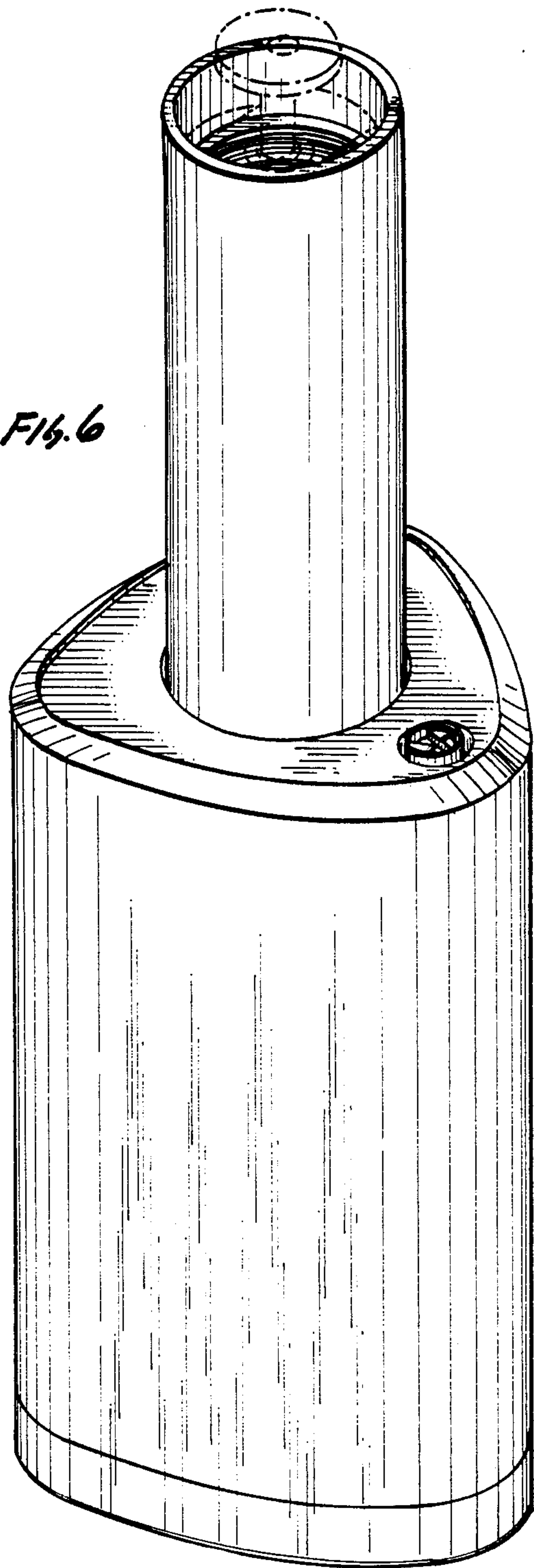

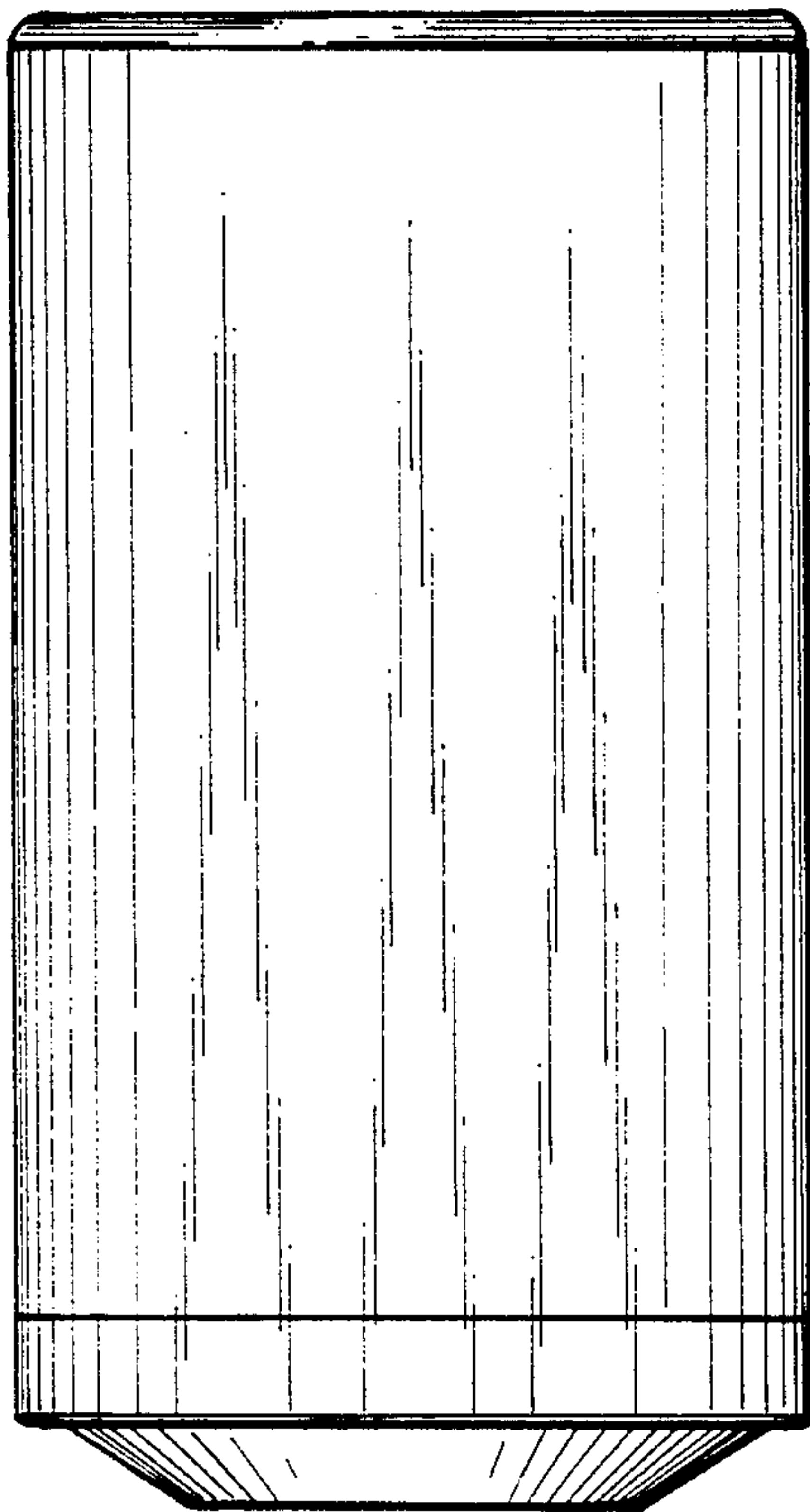
