FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the casket in closed position;

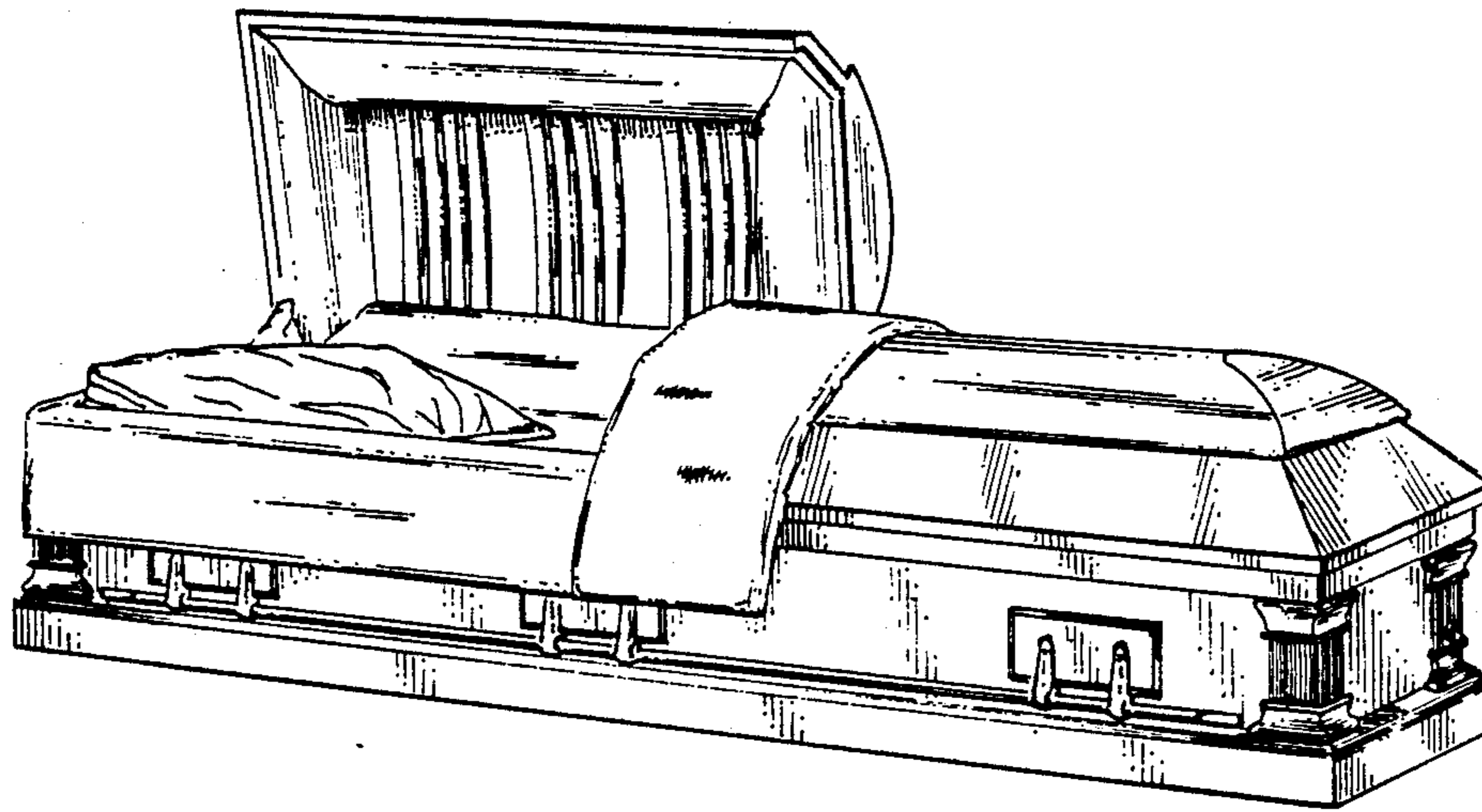
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, the appearance being the same on both sides; and

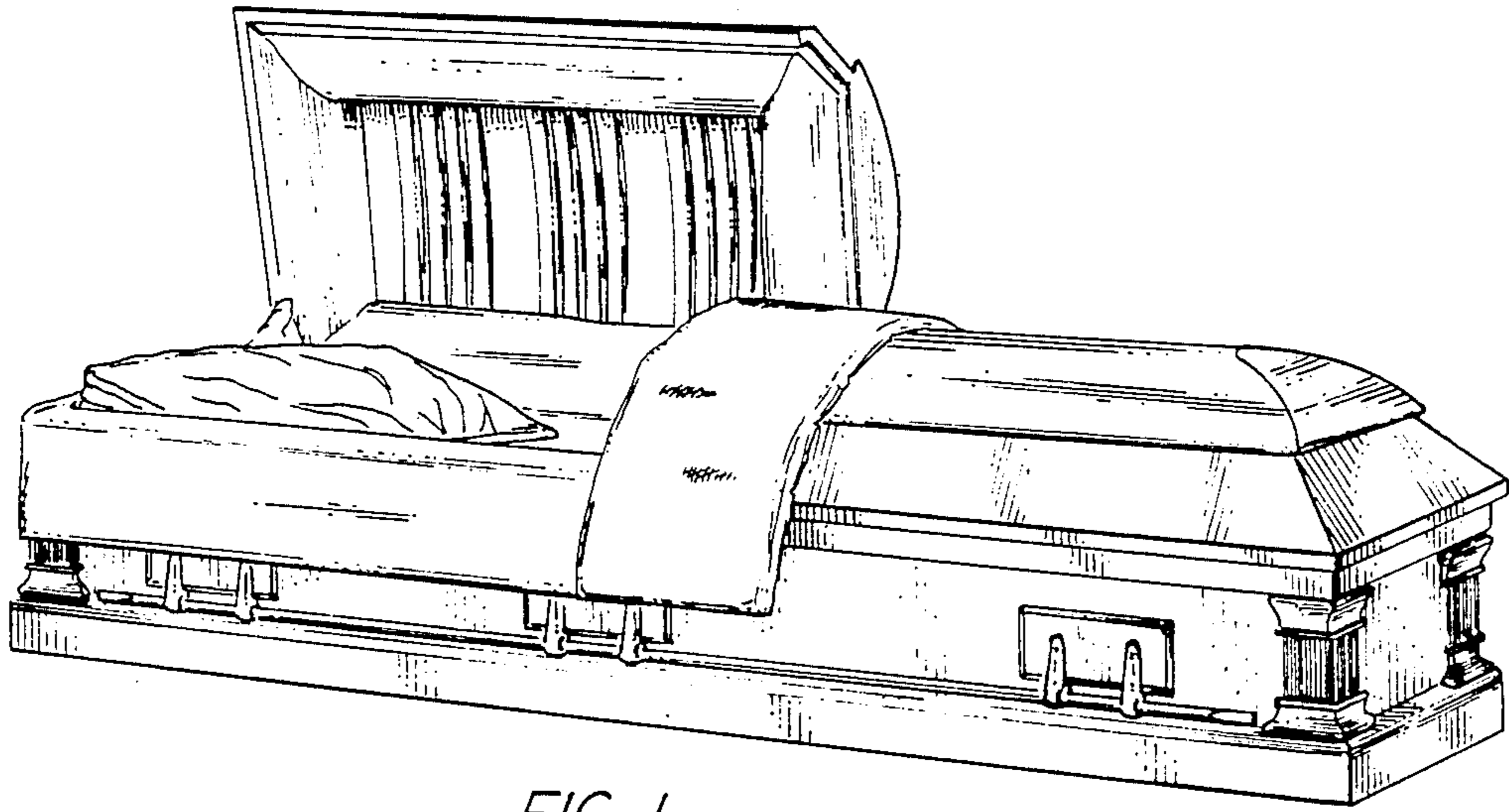

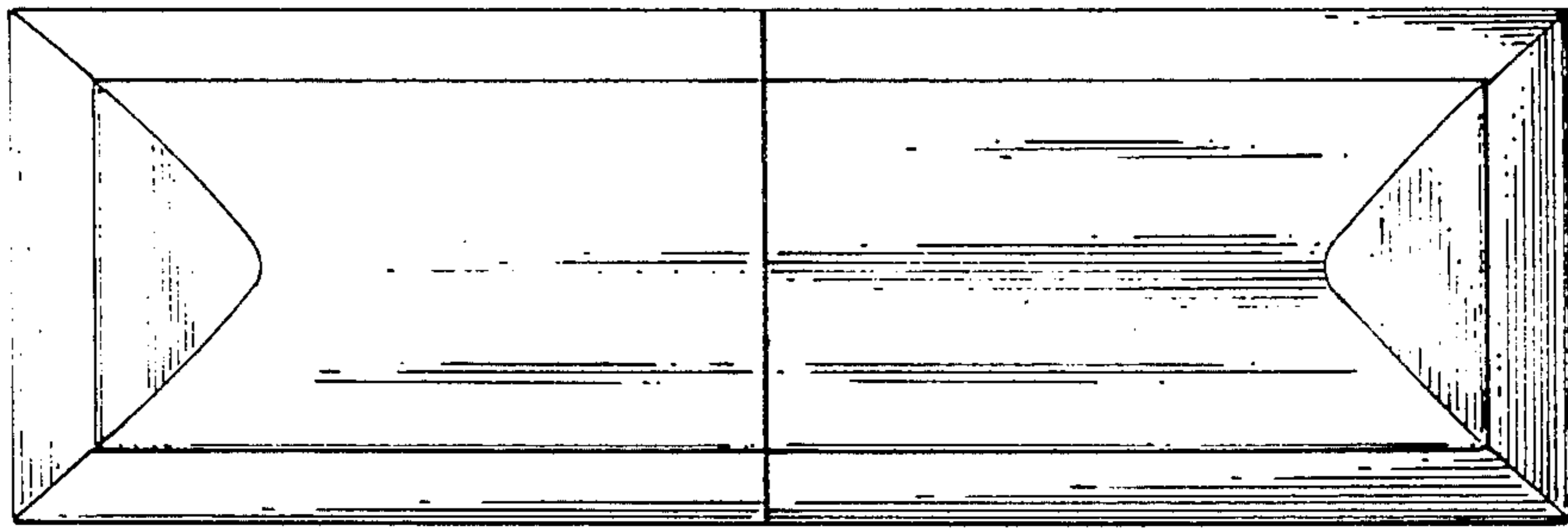

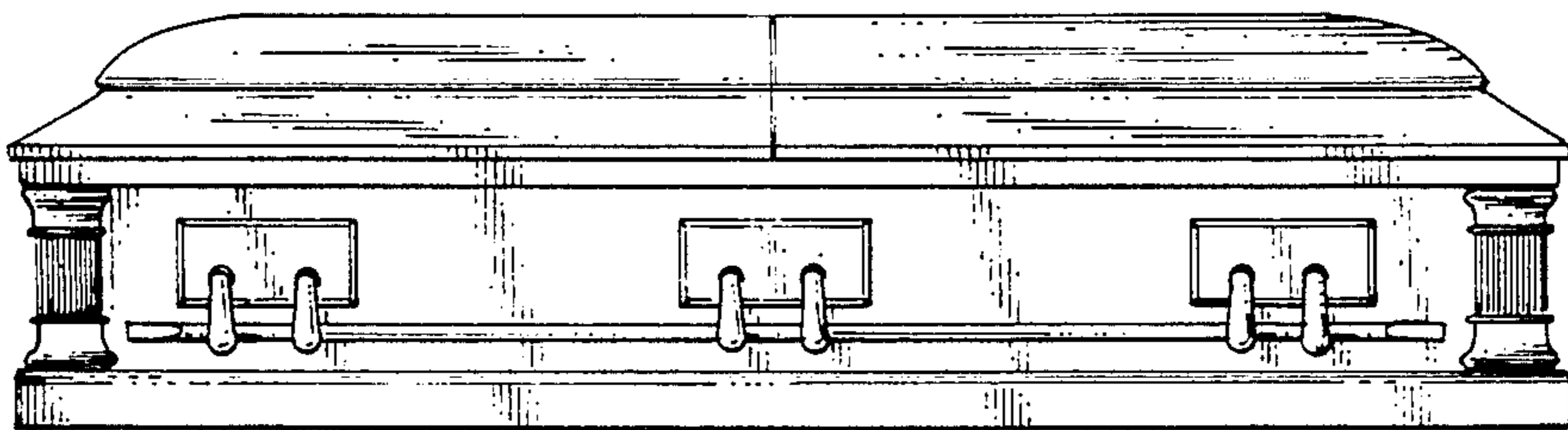

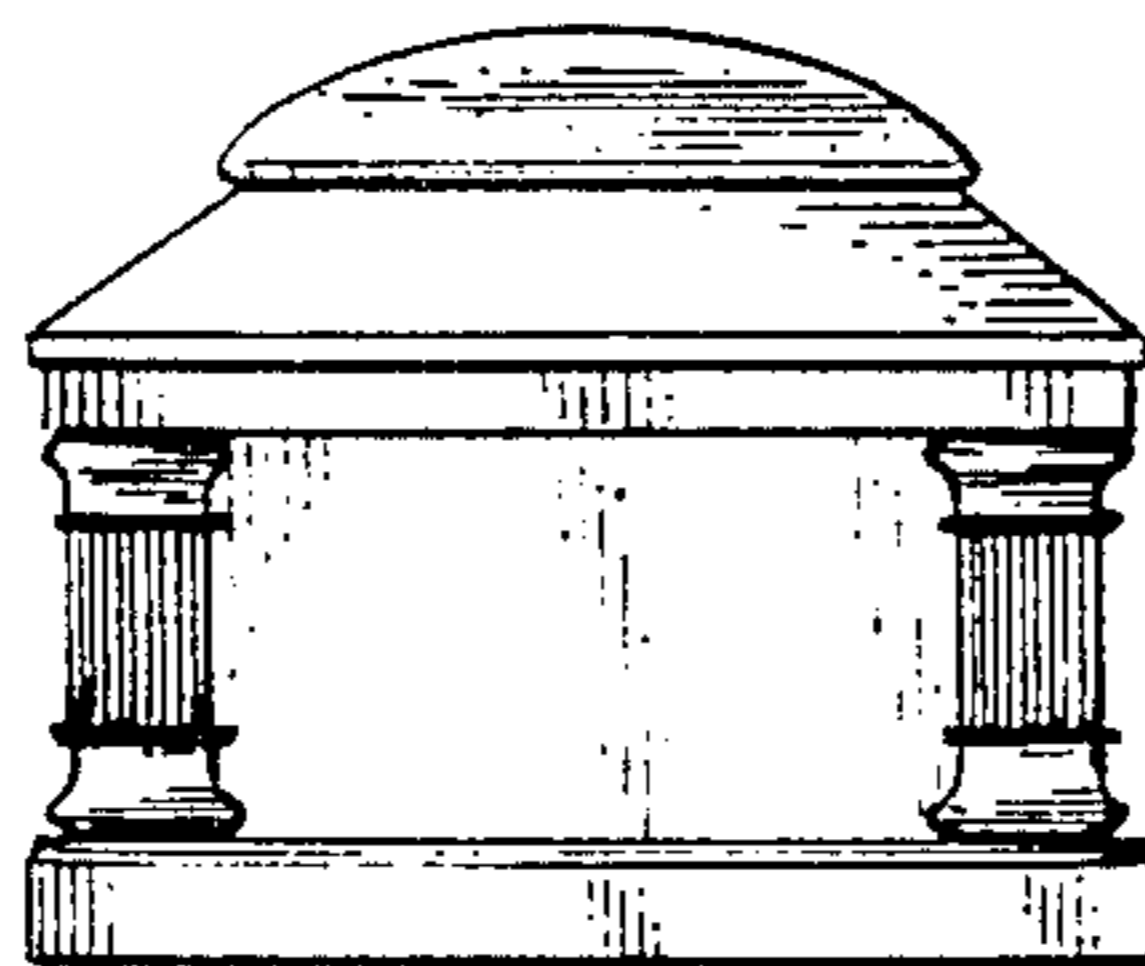
