[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a wind protector support frame for an outdoor sportsman, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a wind protector support frame for an outdoor sportsman, showing my design;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof.

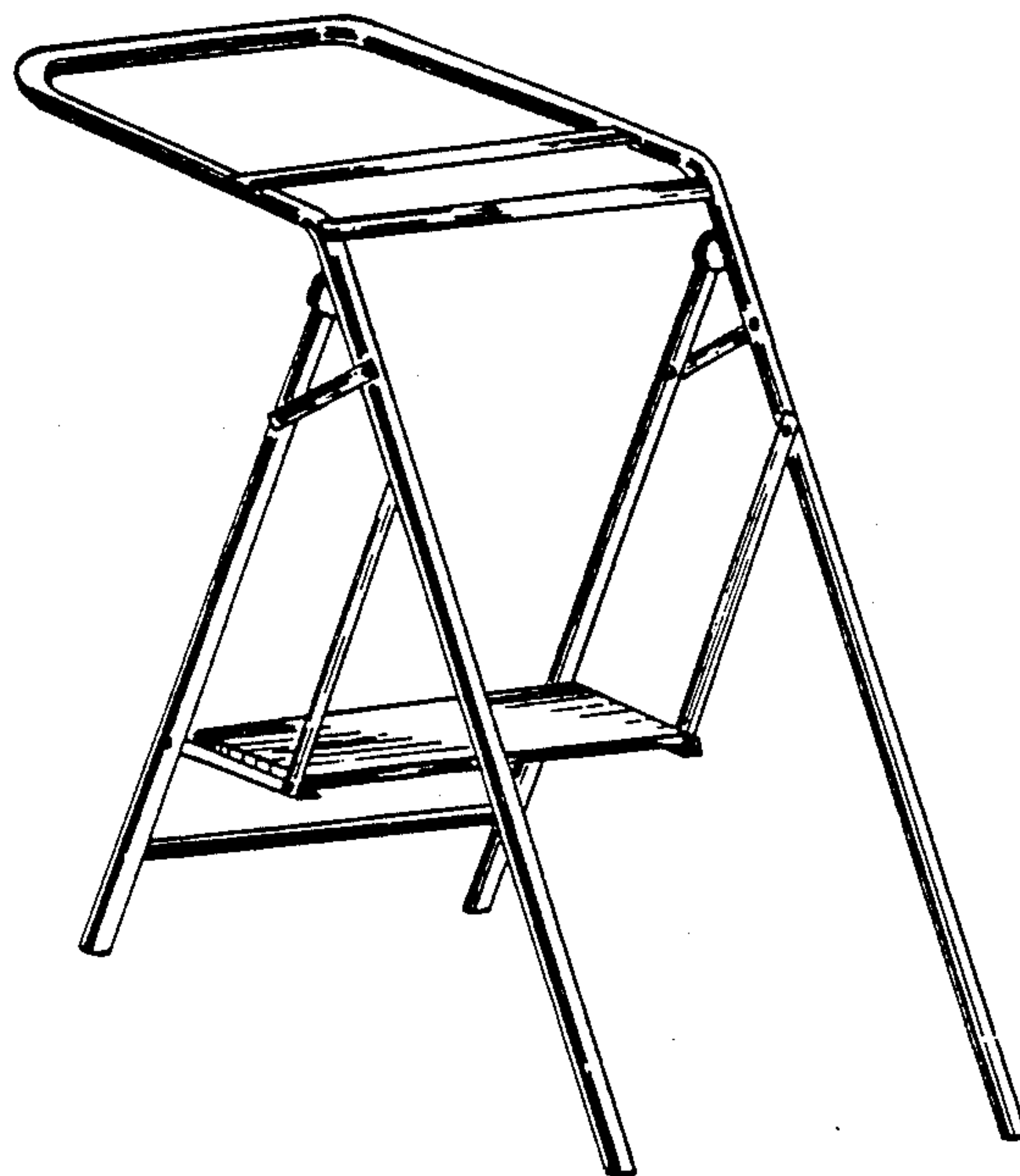

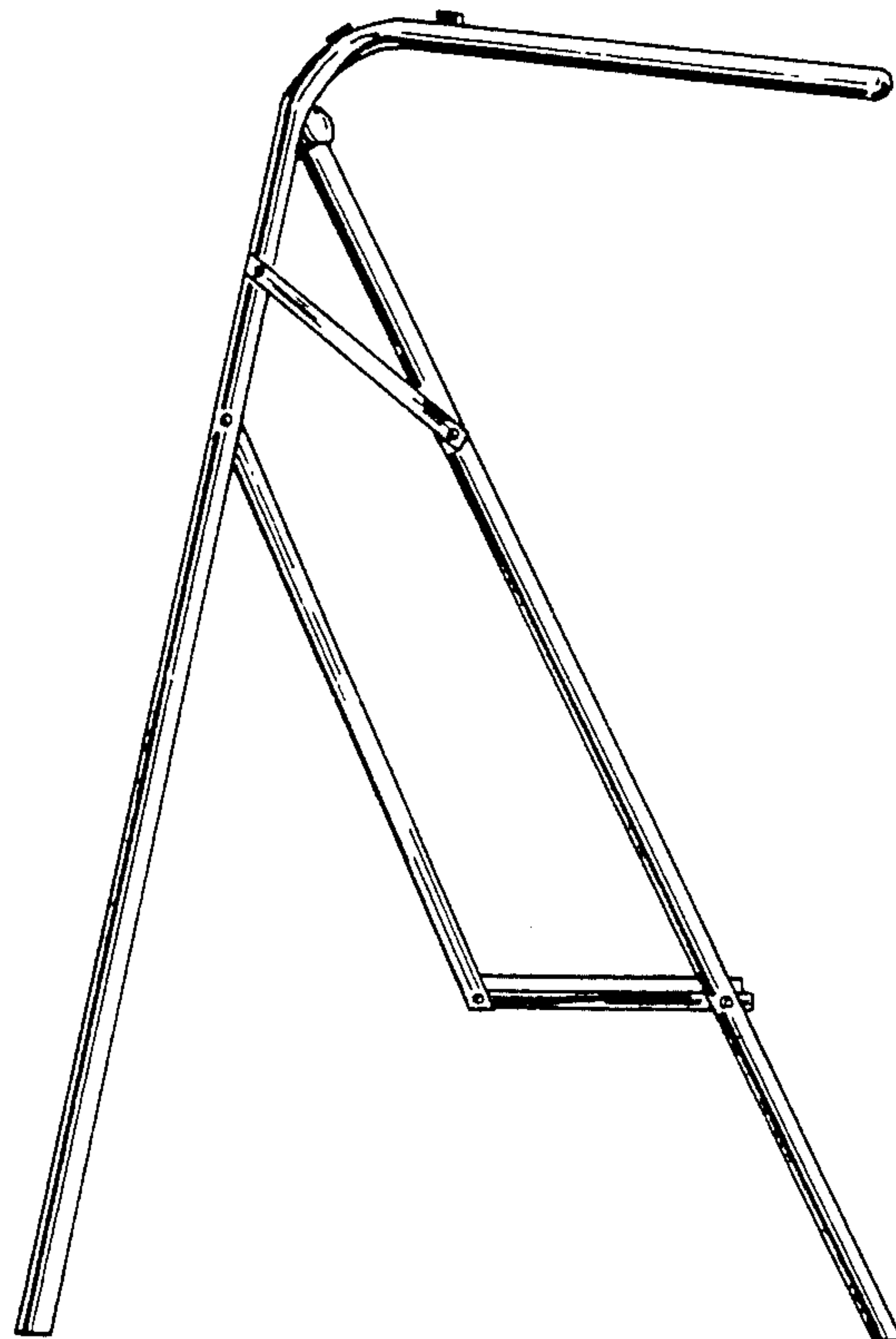

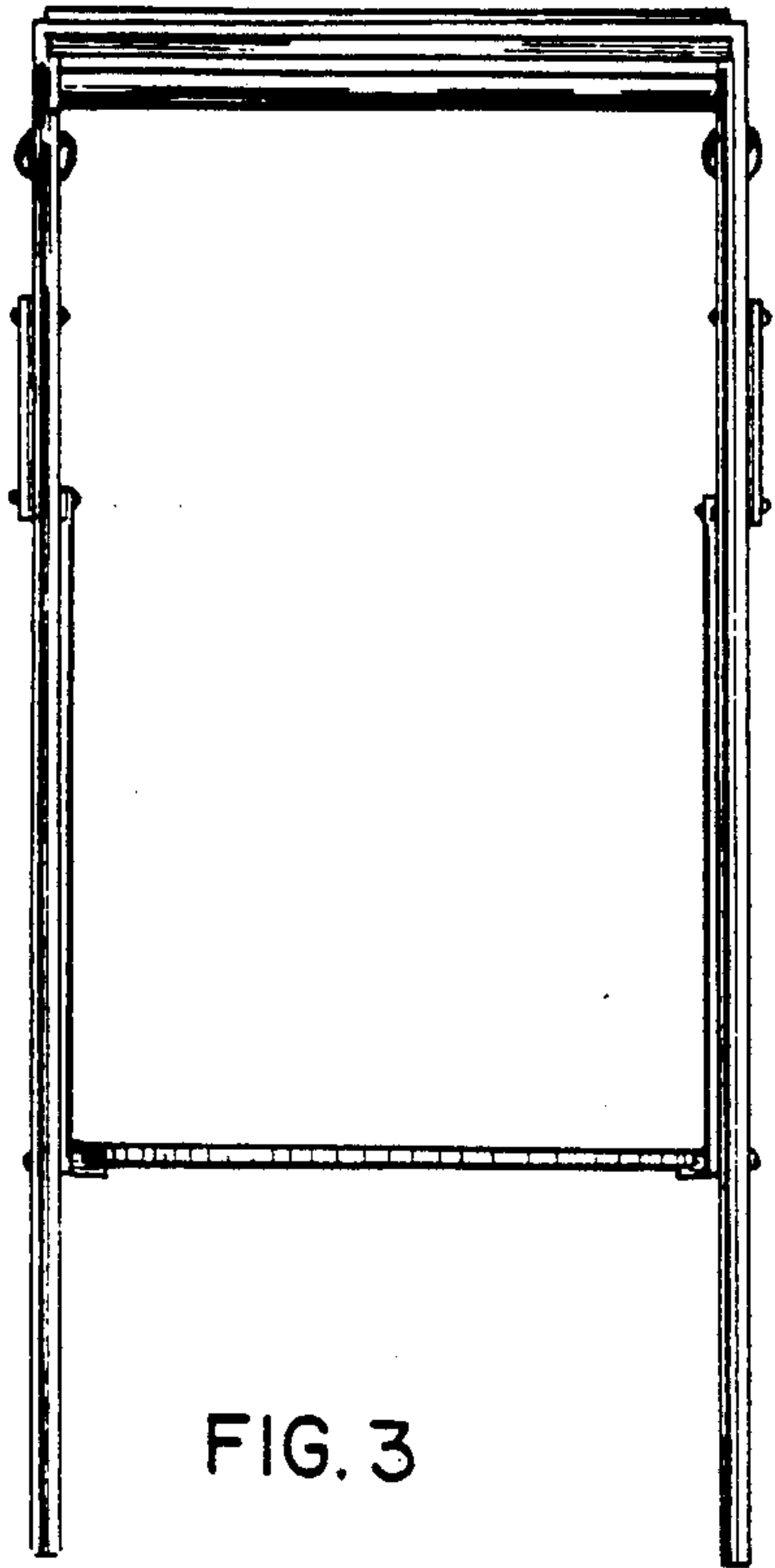

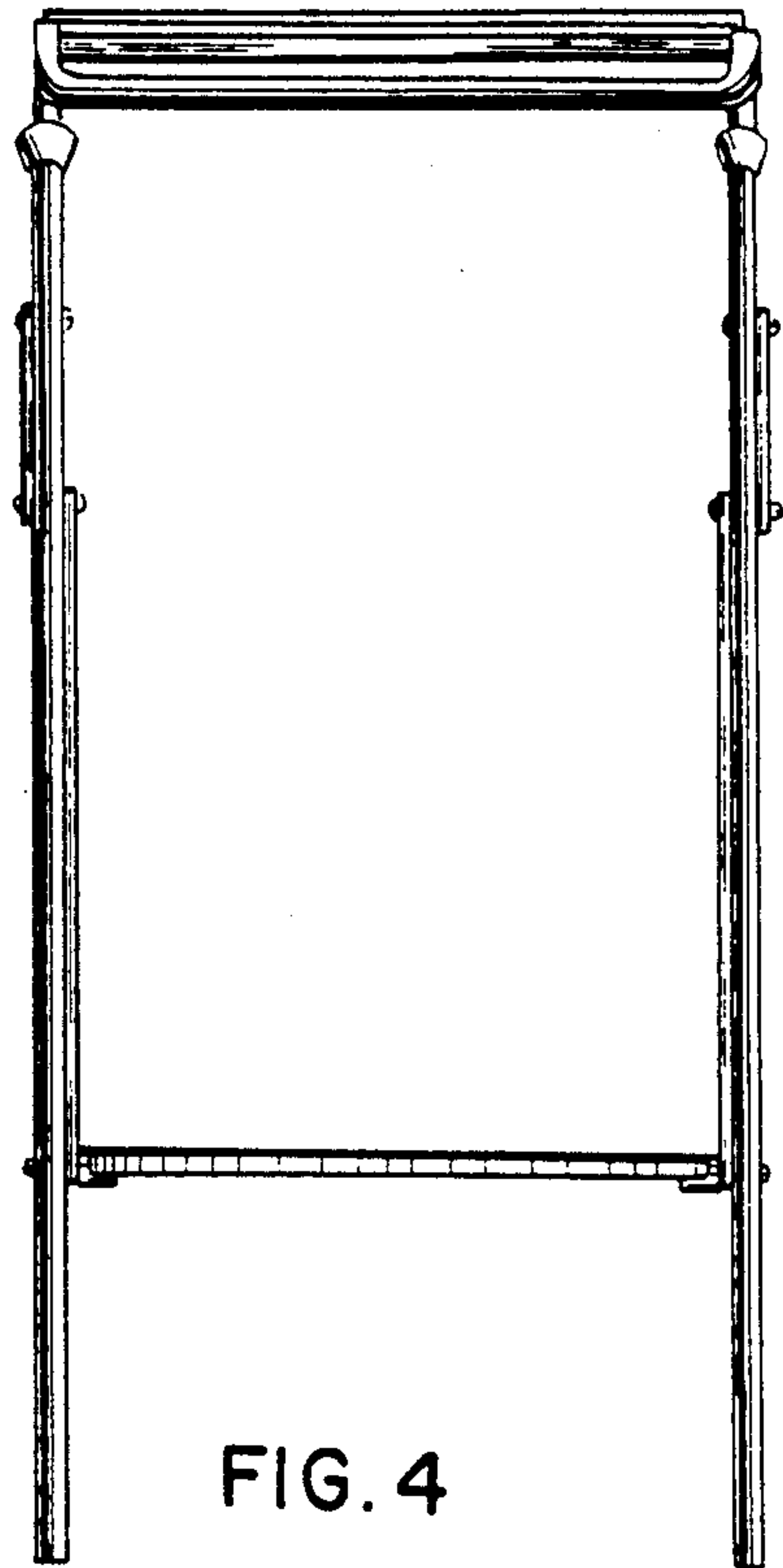

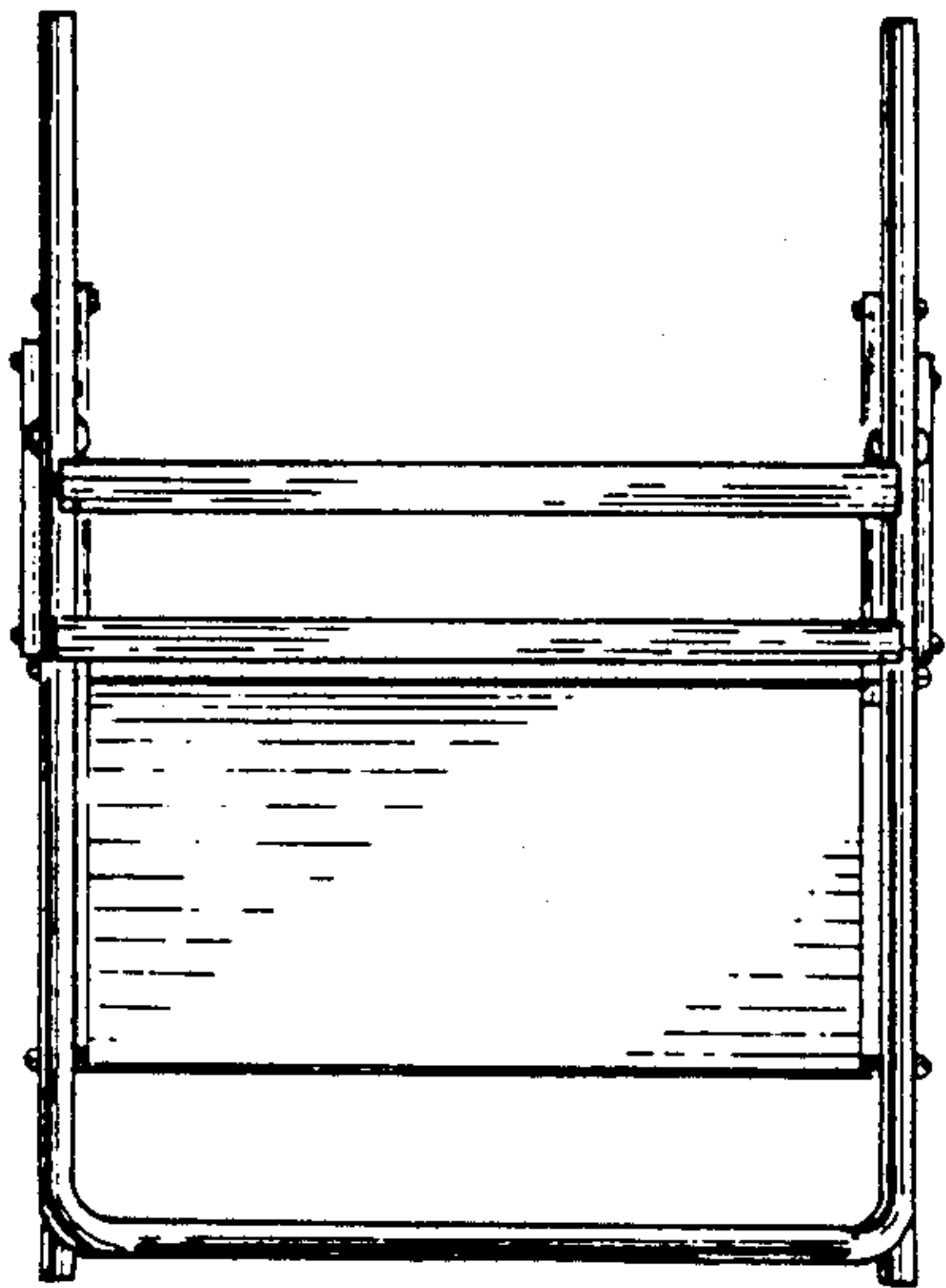
