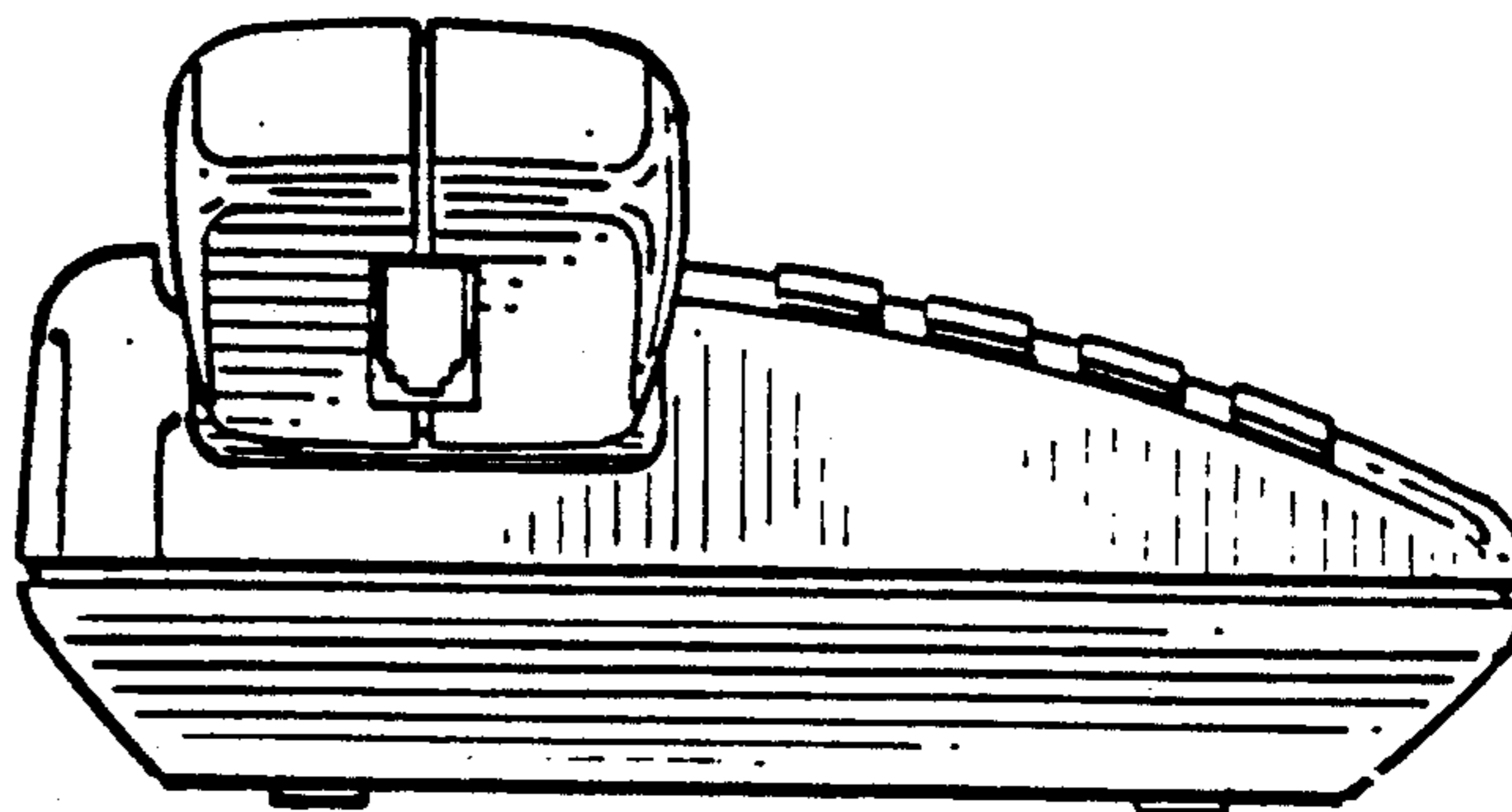
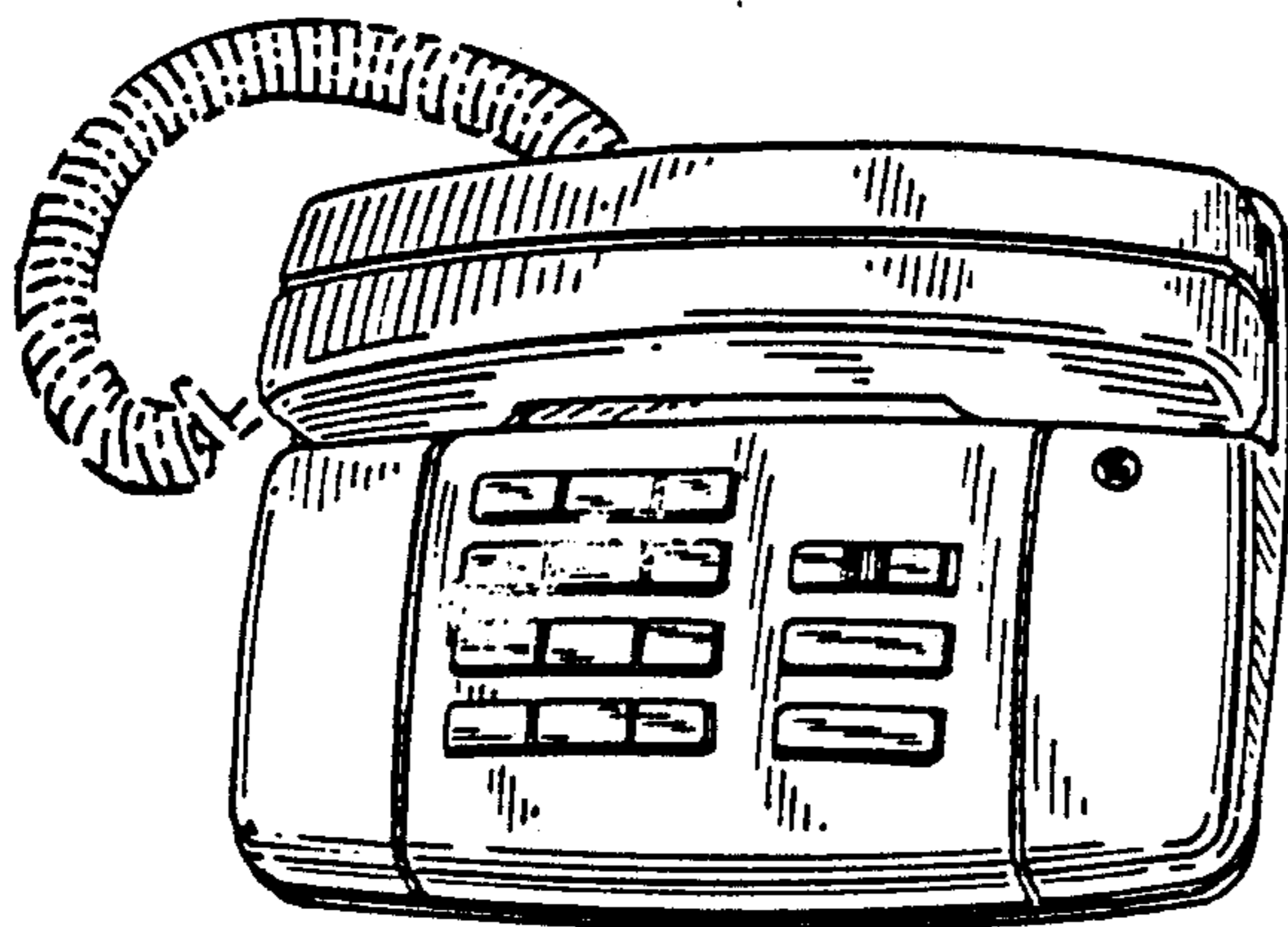

The ornamental design for a combination handset and stand telephone, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a combination handset and stand telephone, showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,  
FIGS. 5 and 6 are respectively right and left side elevational views thereof.  
The broken line showing of a coiled cord in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



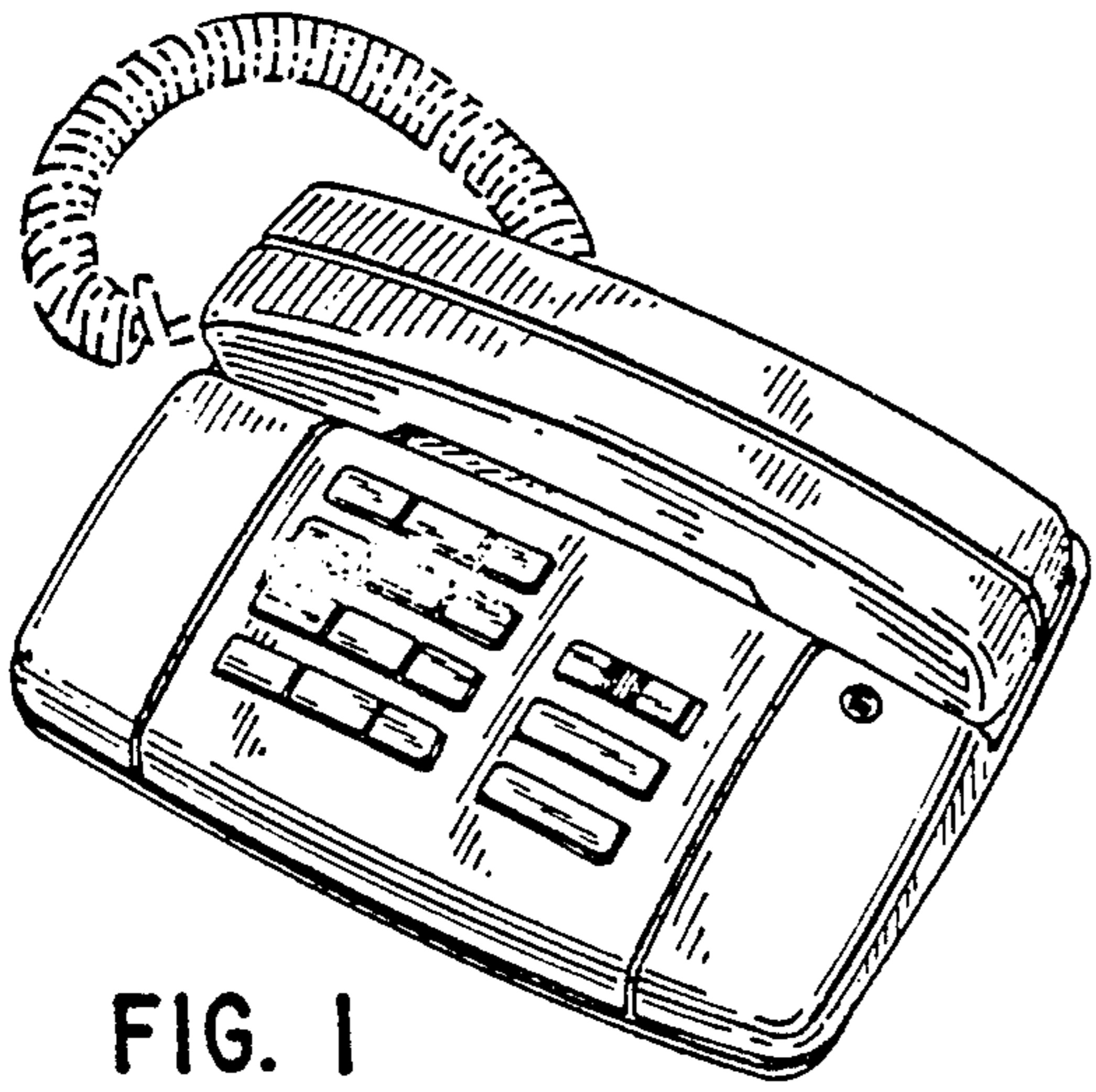

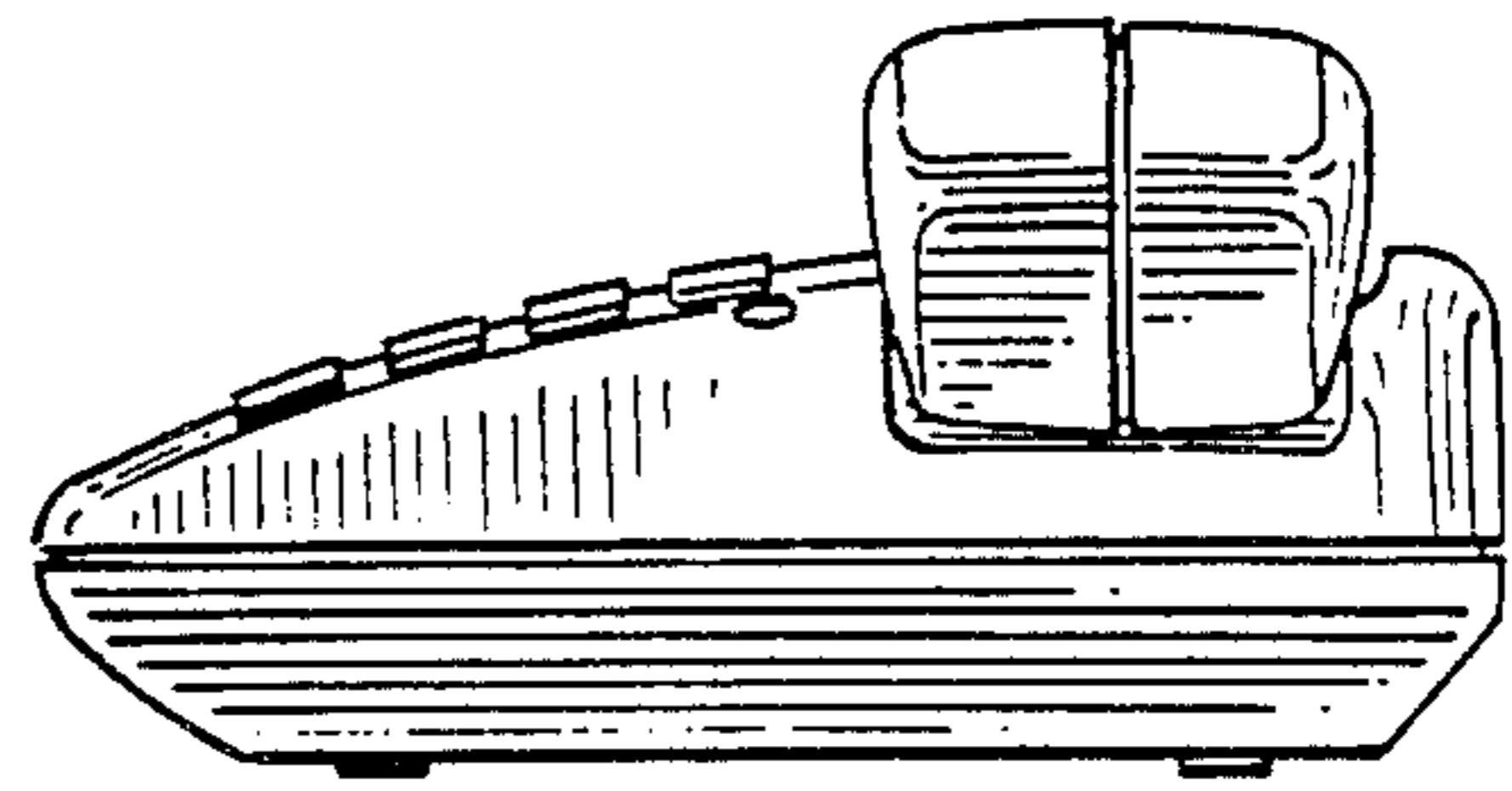

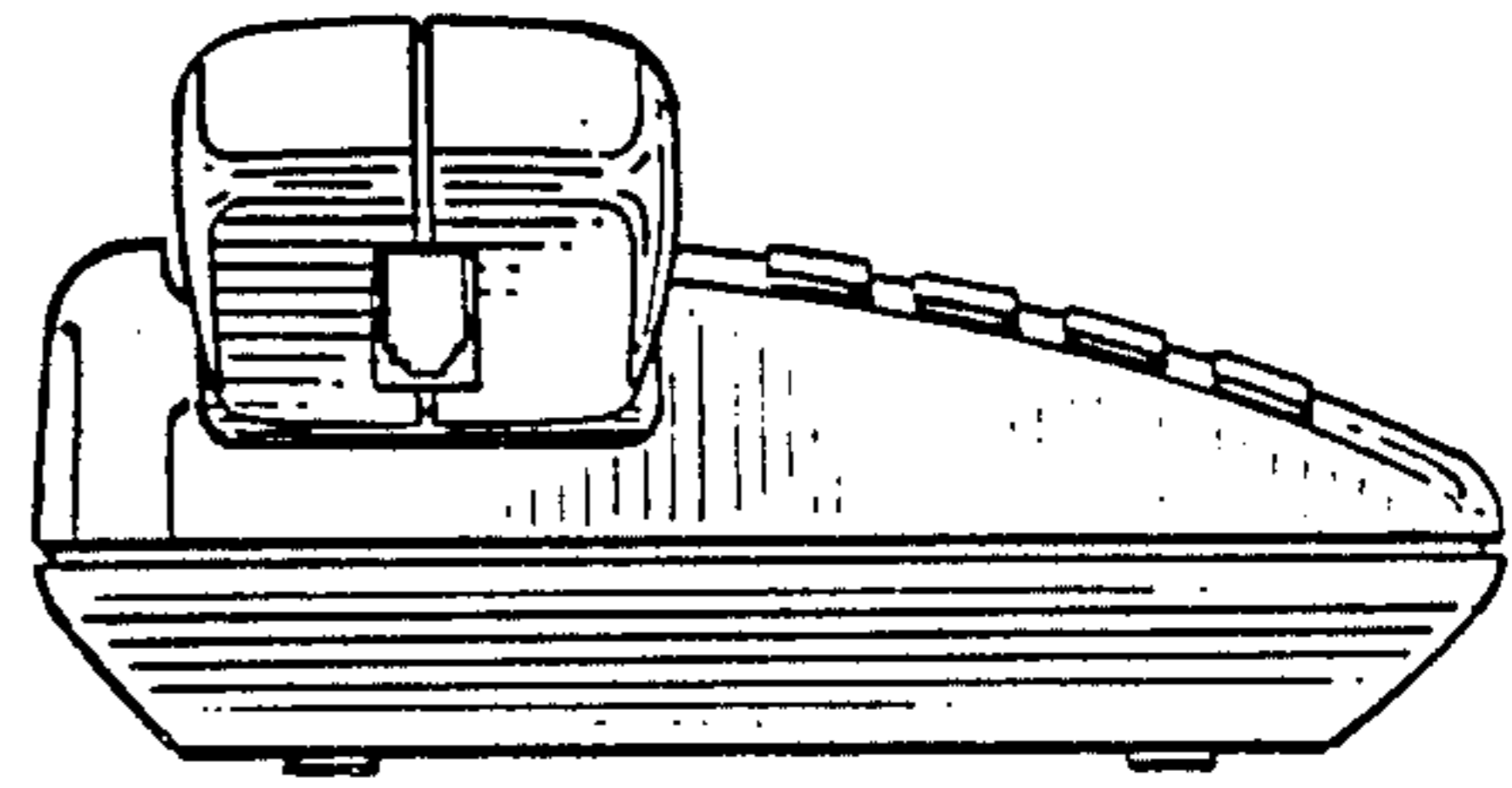

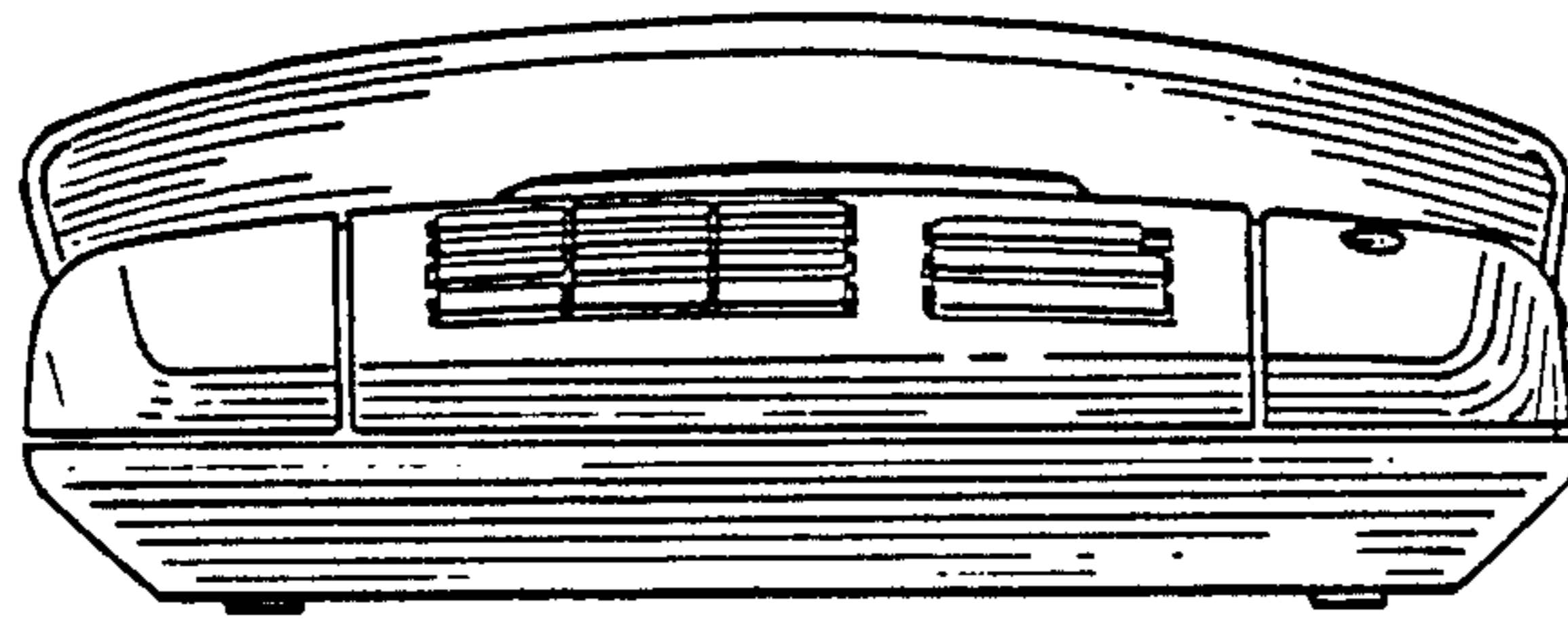

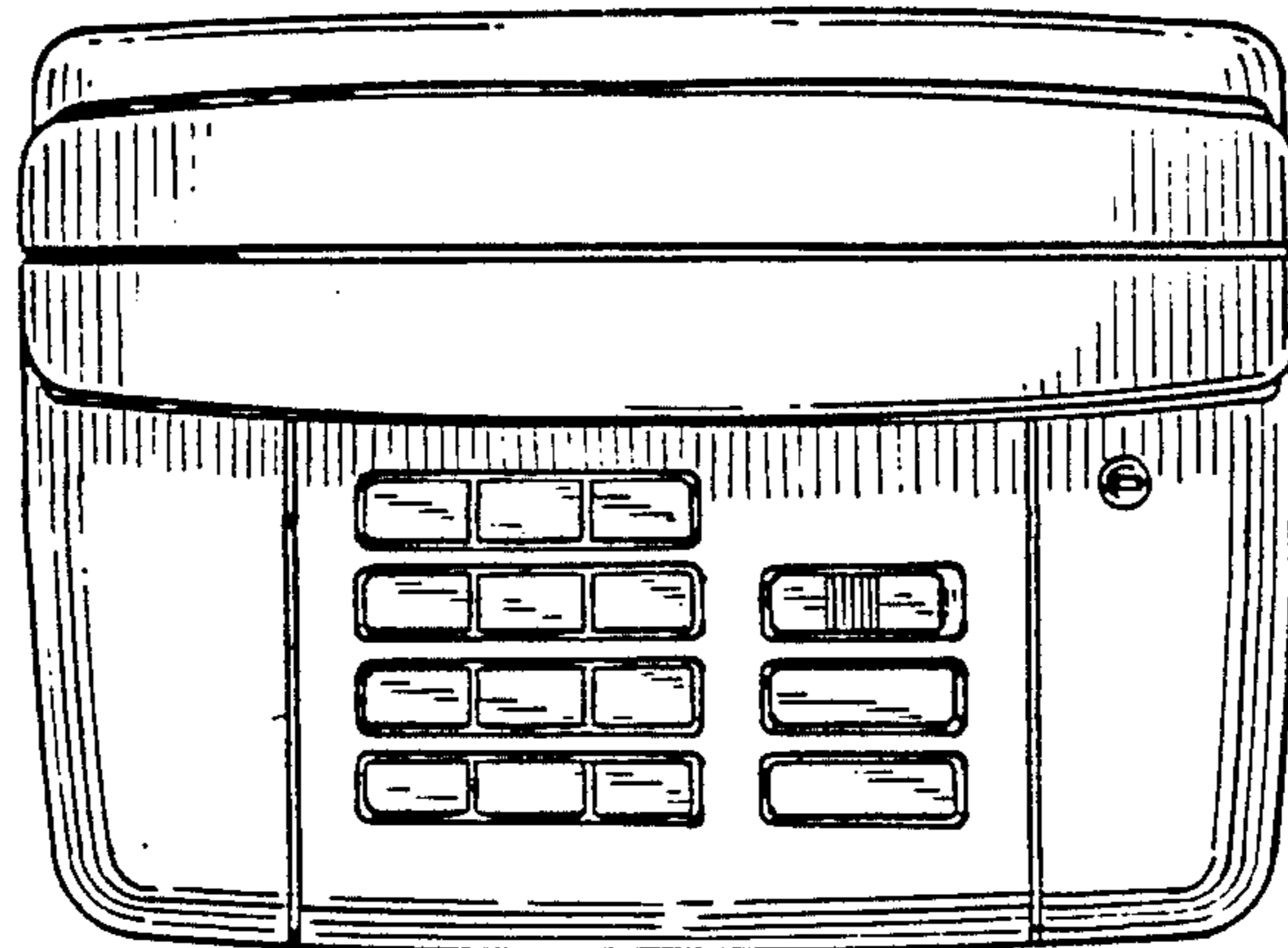

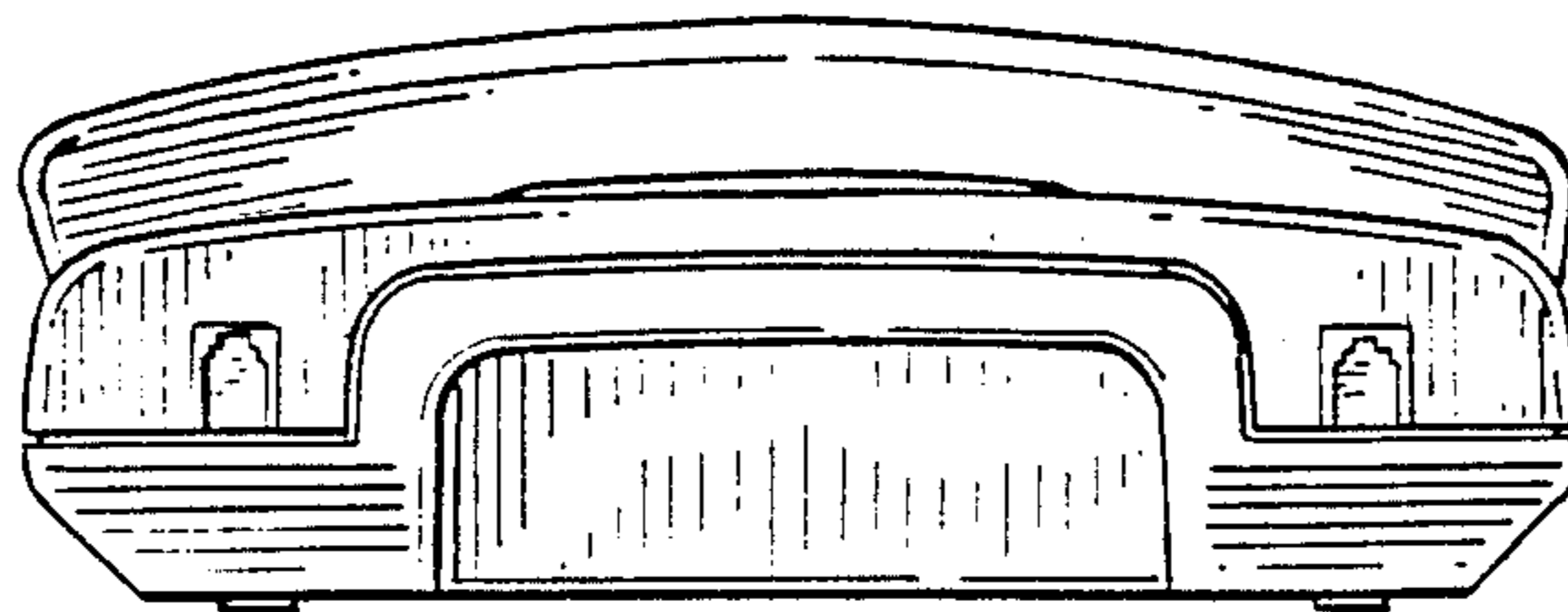
