DESCRIPTION

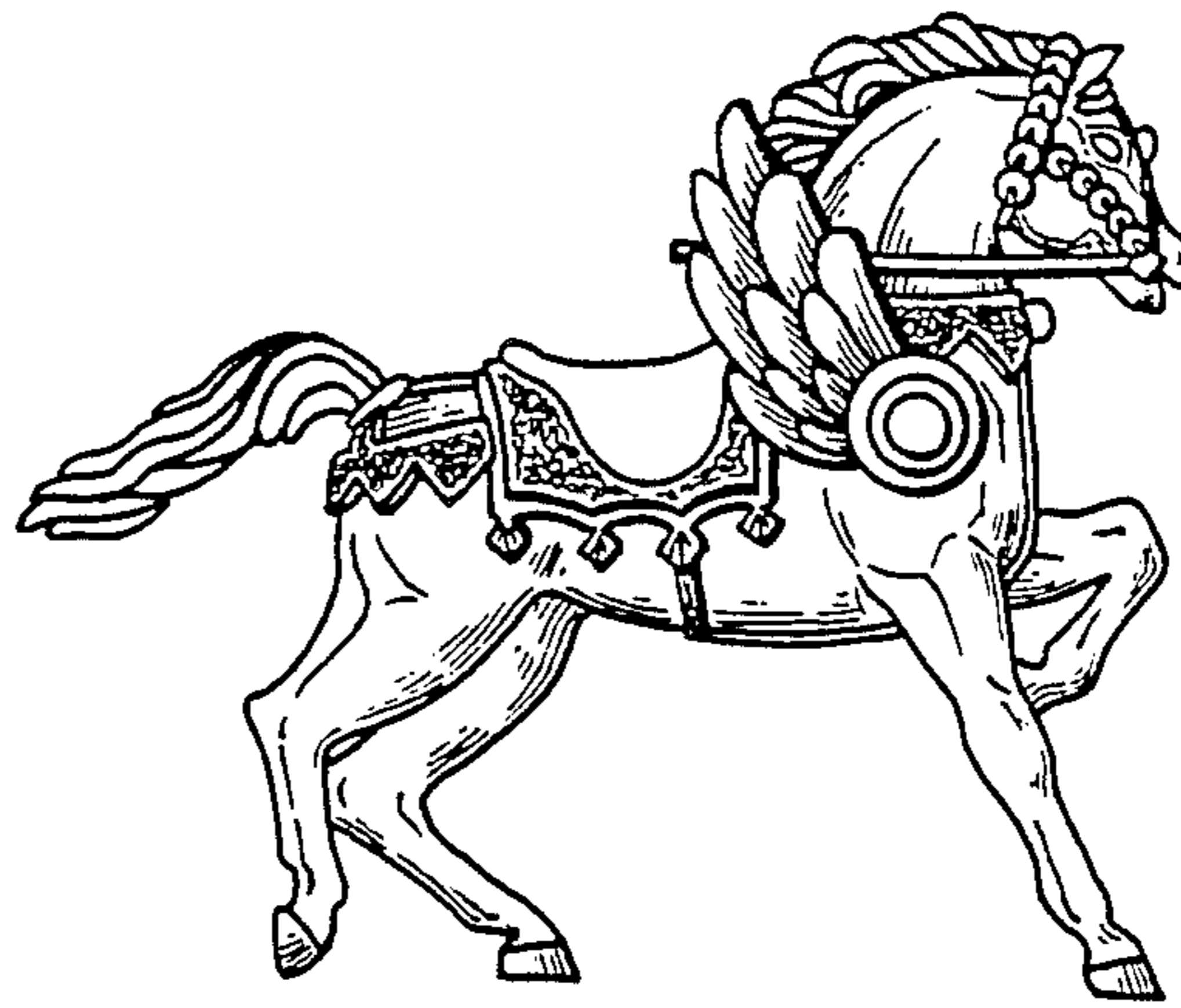

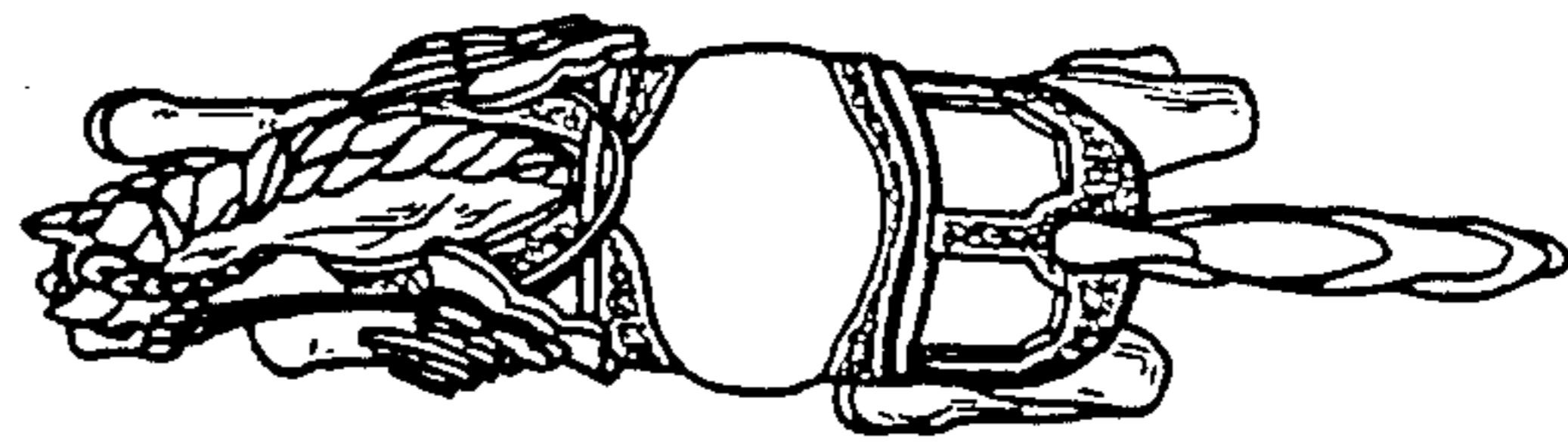
