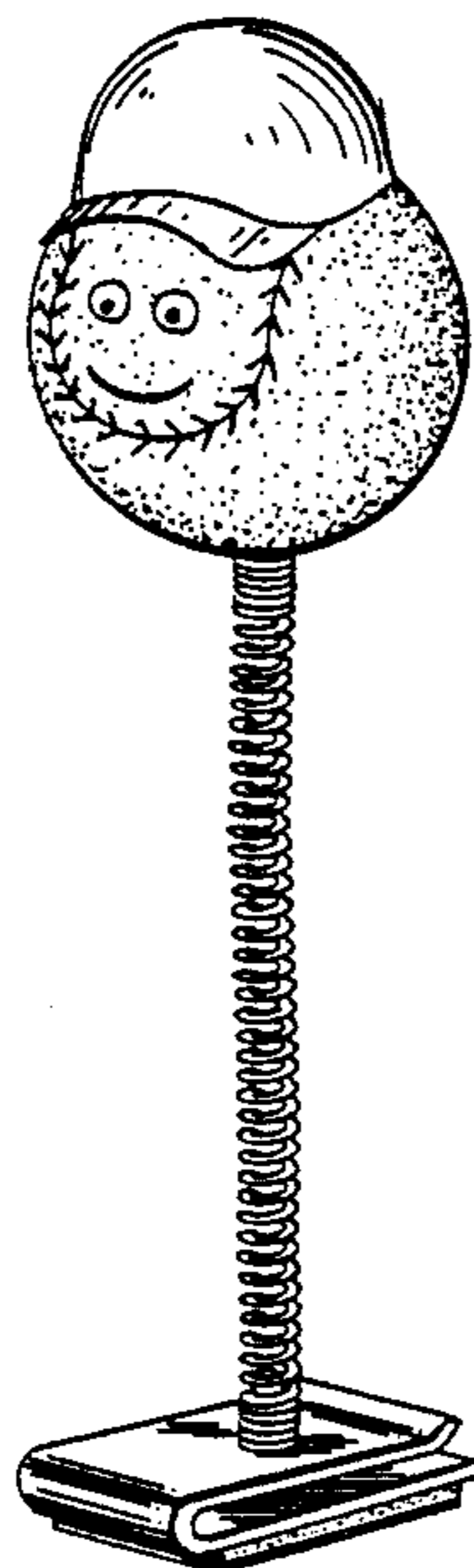

FIG. 6 is a view in rear elevation thereof.



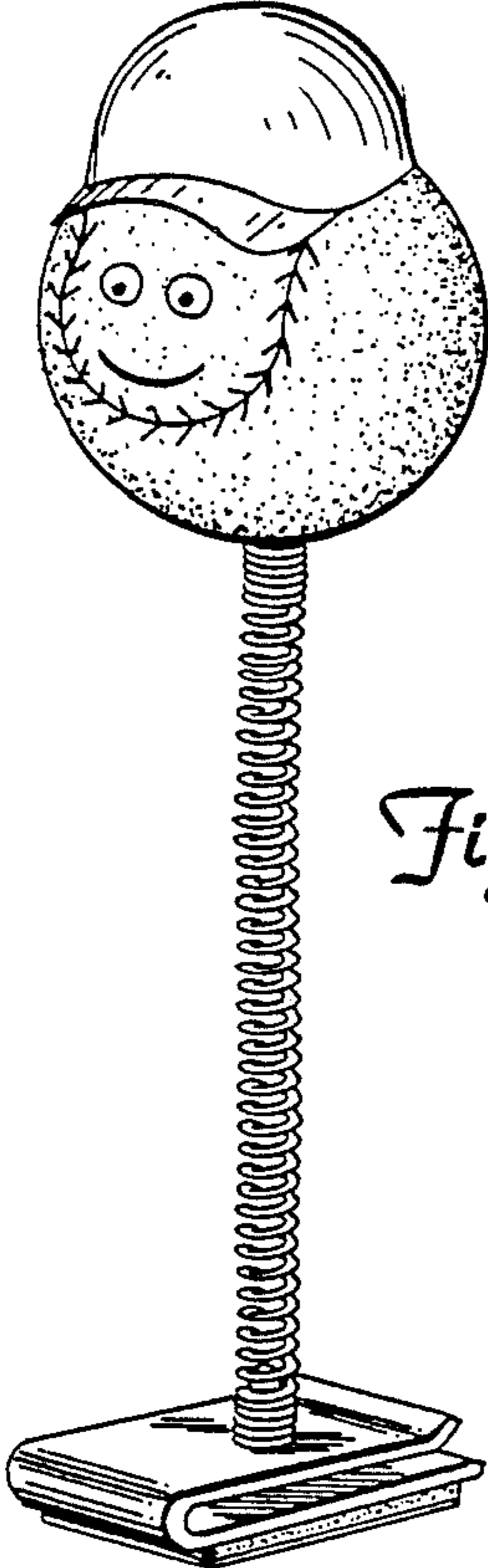

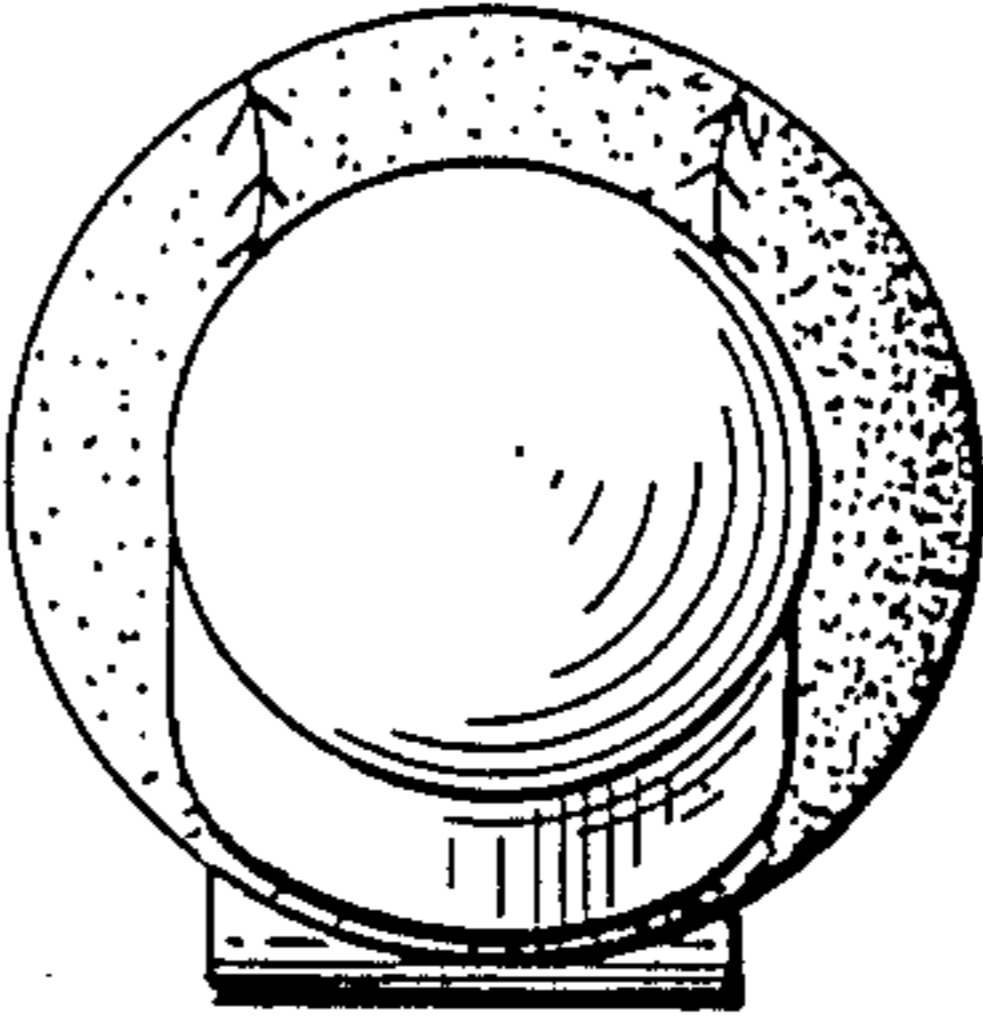

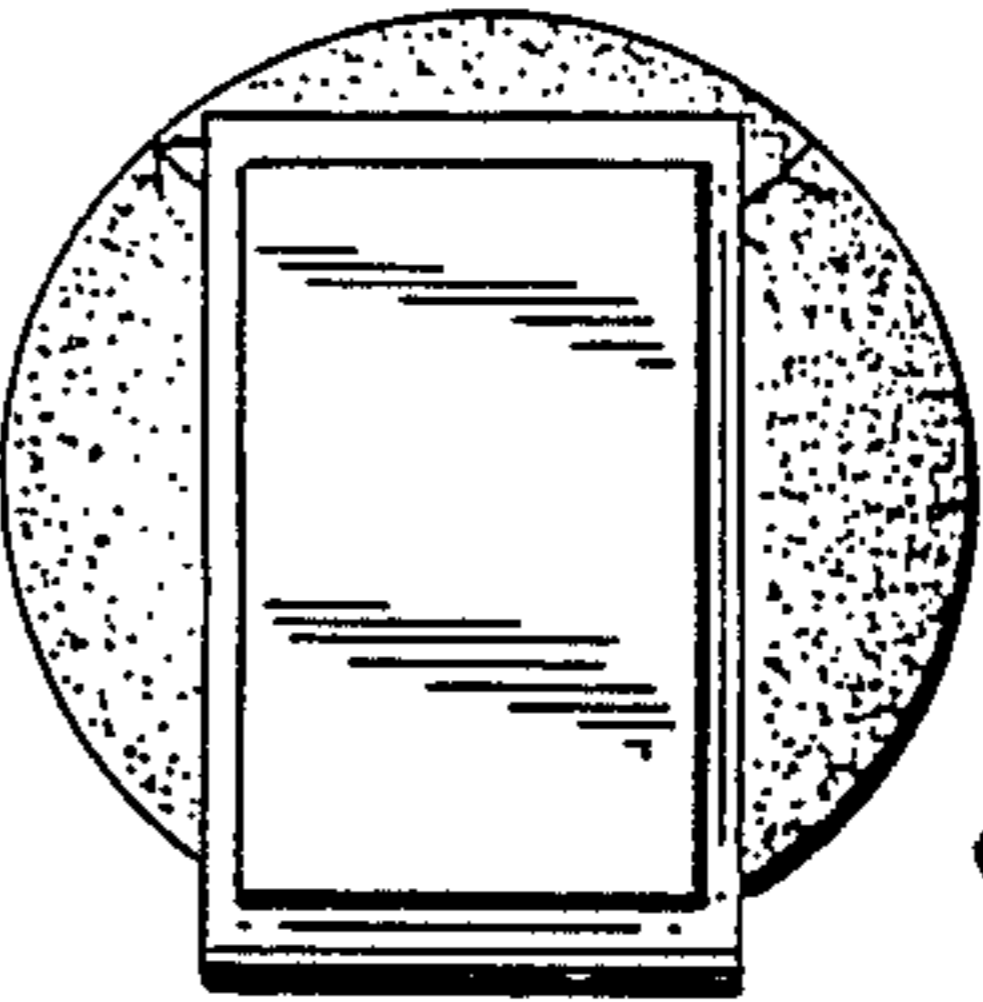

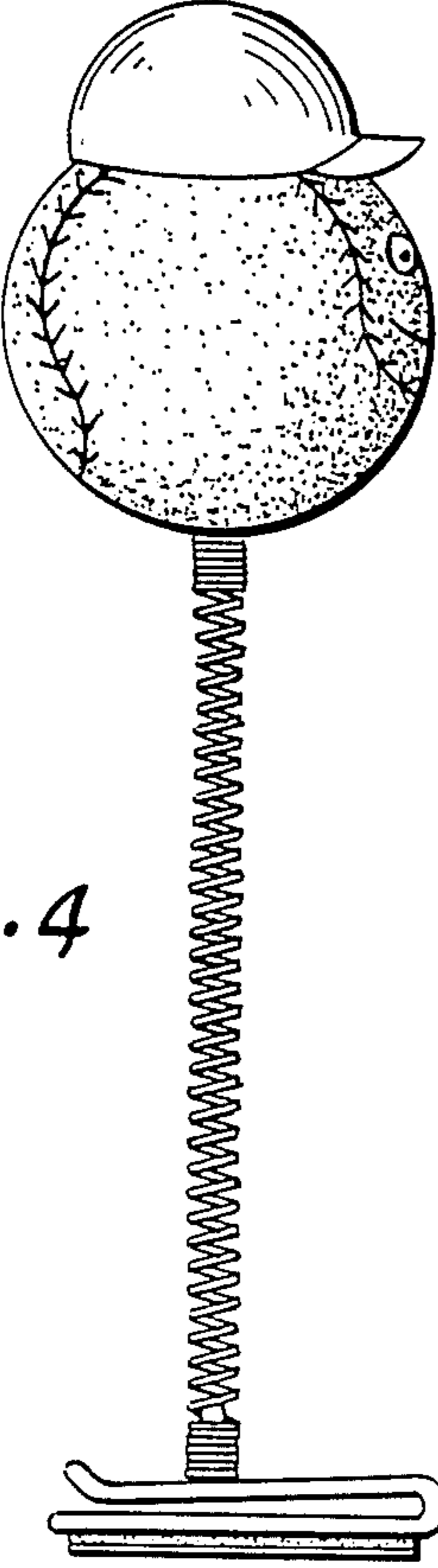

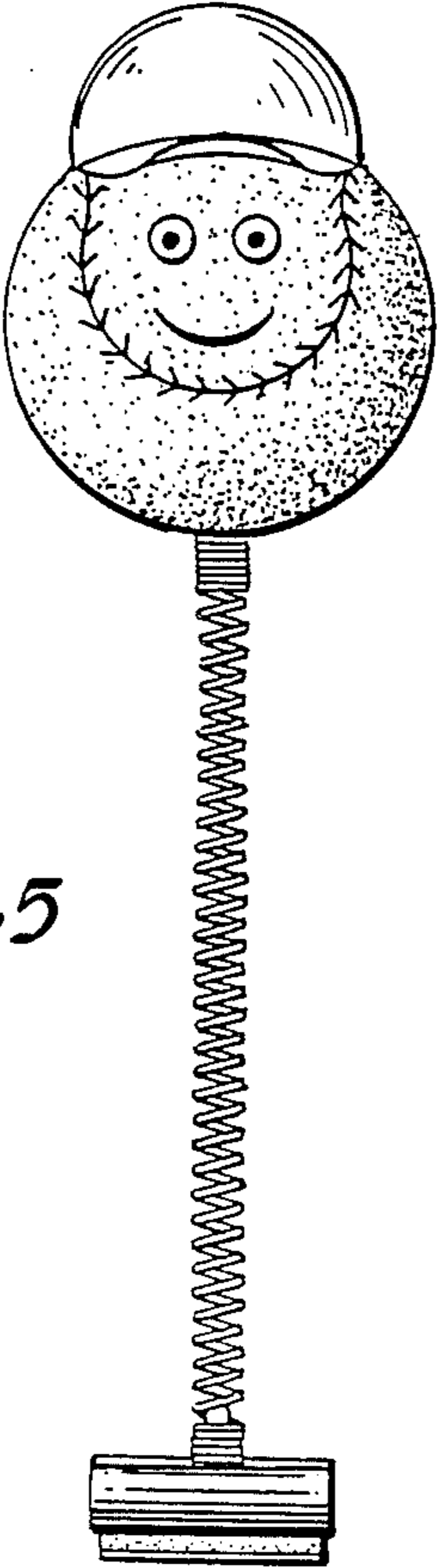

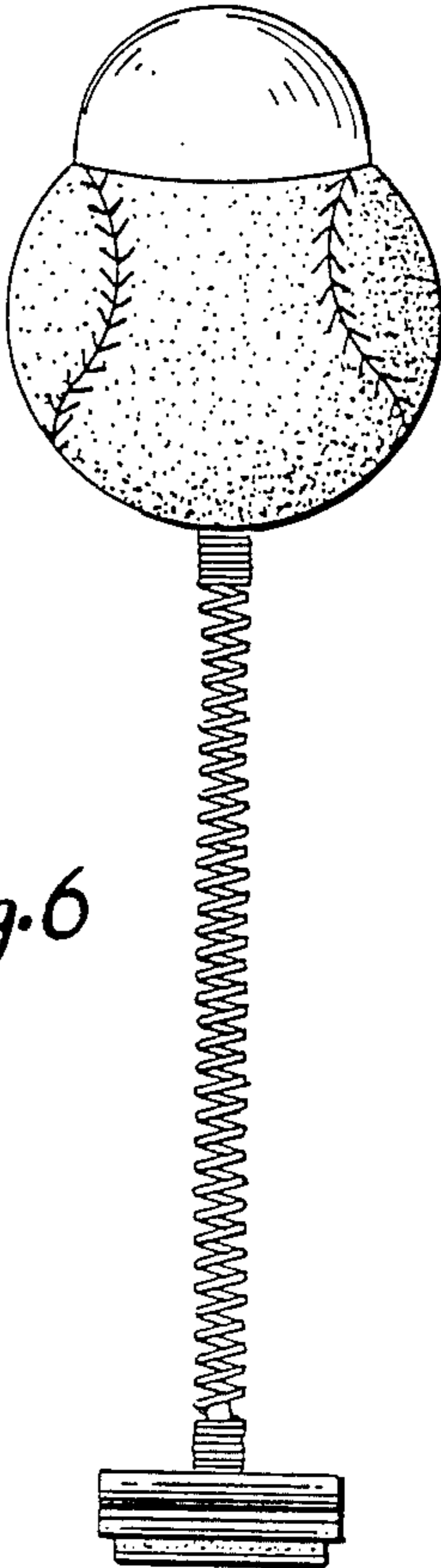
