DESCRIPTION

The features shown in broken lines in FIGS. 2 and 8 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

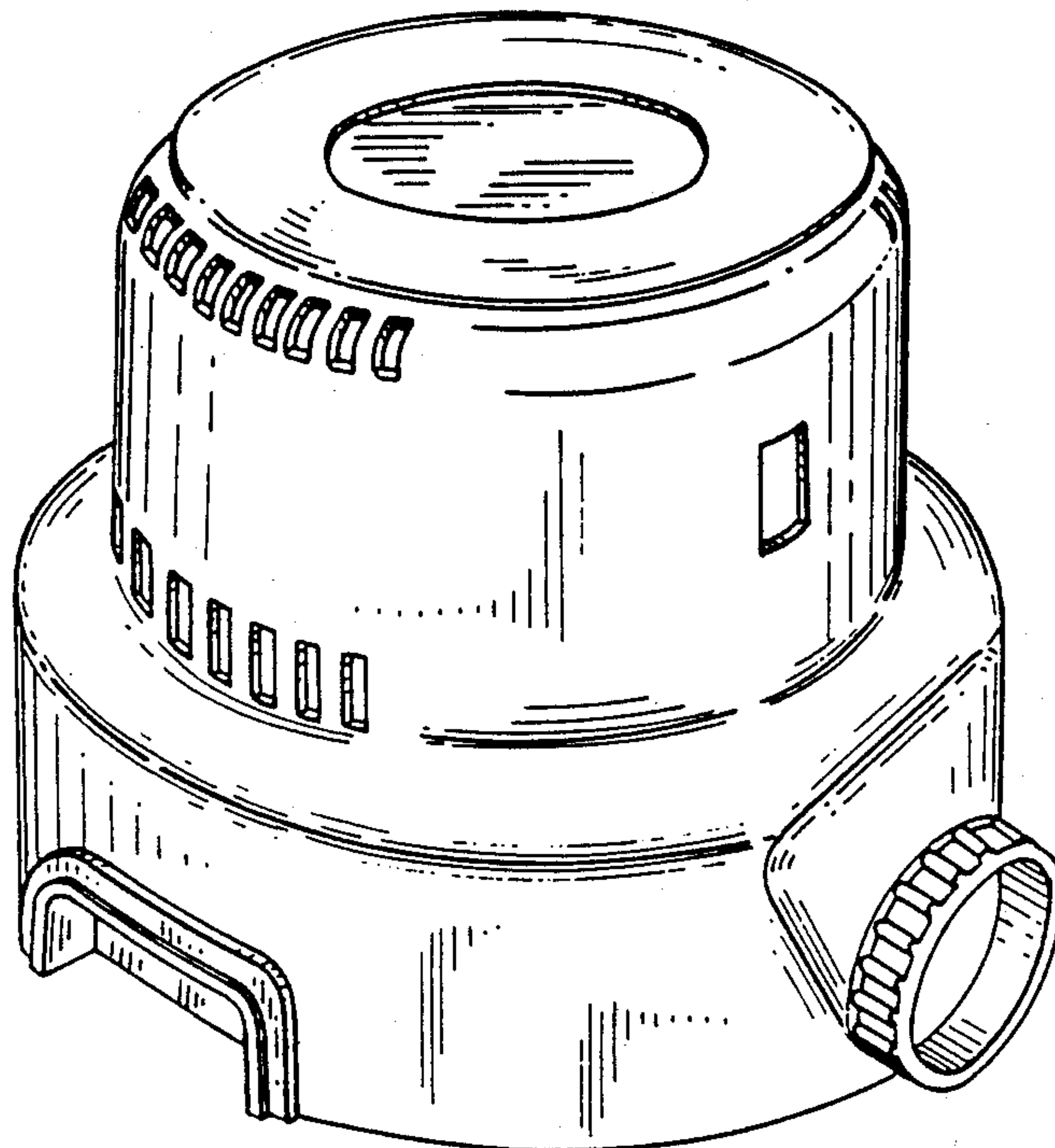

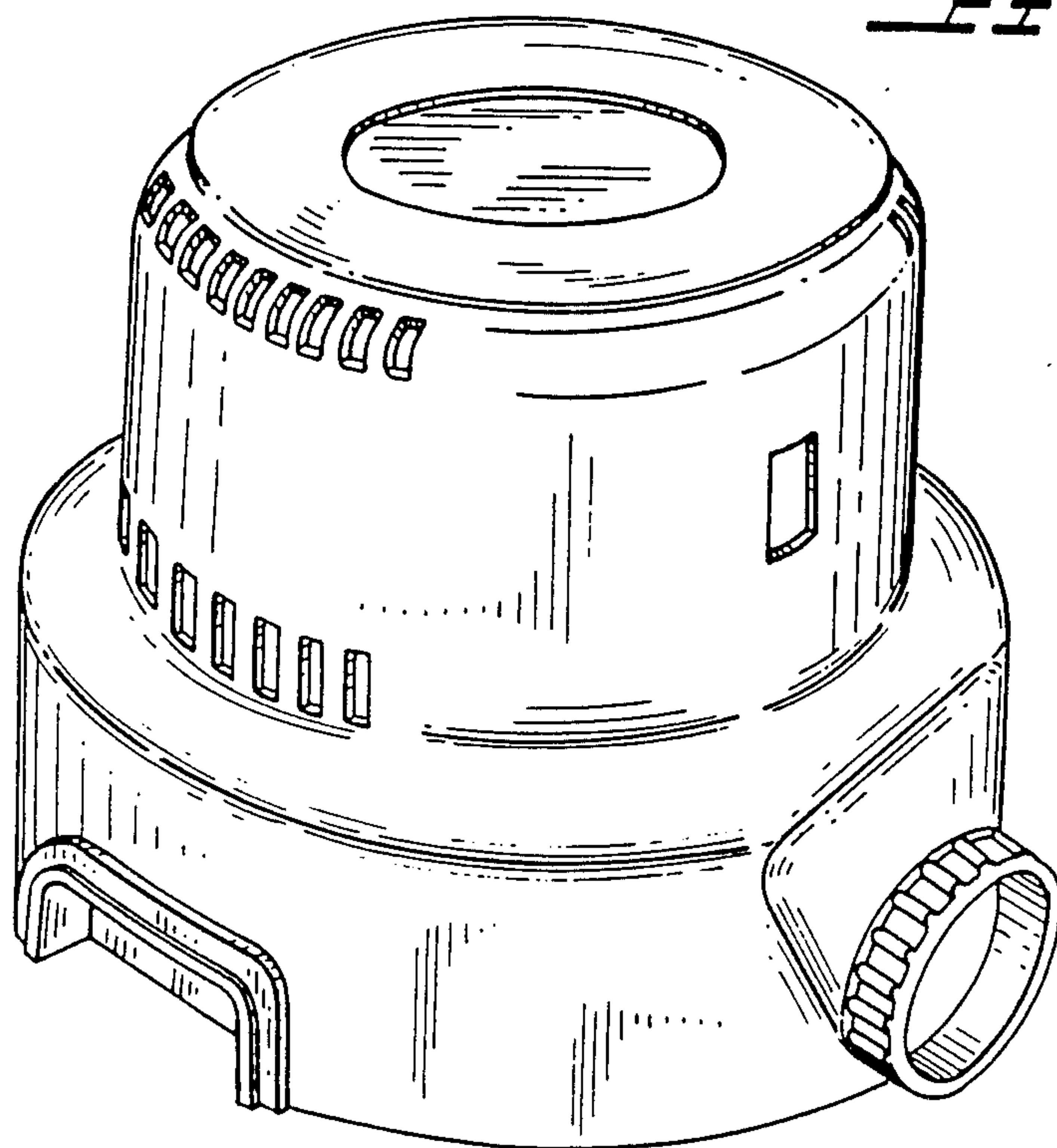

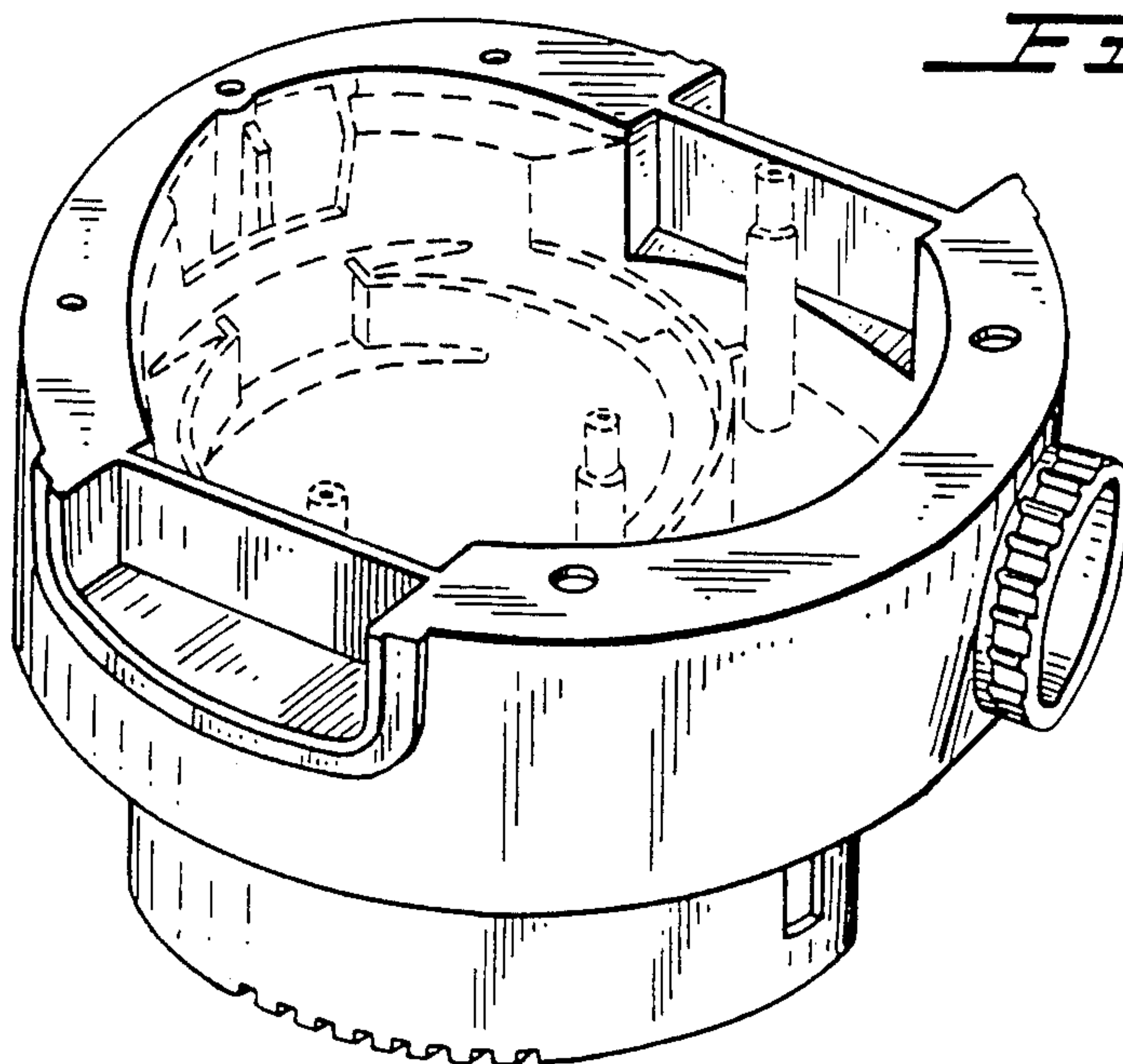


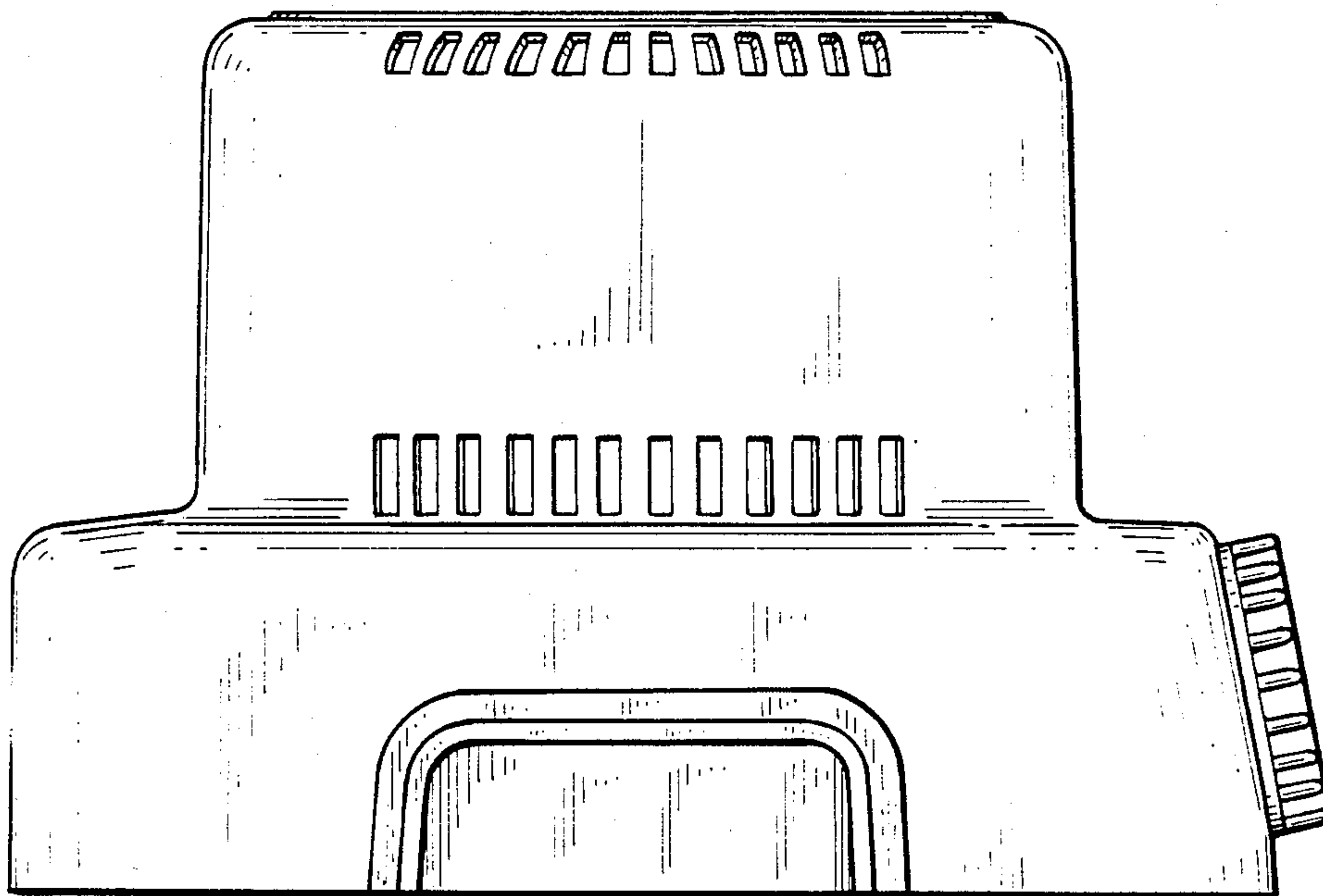
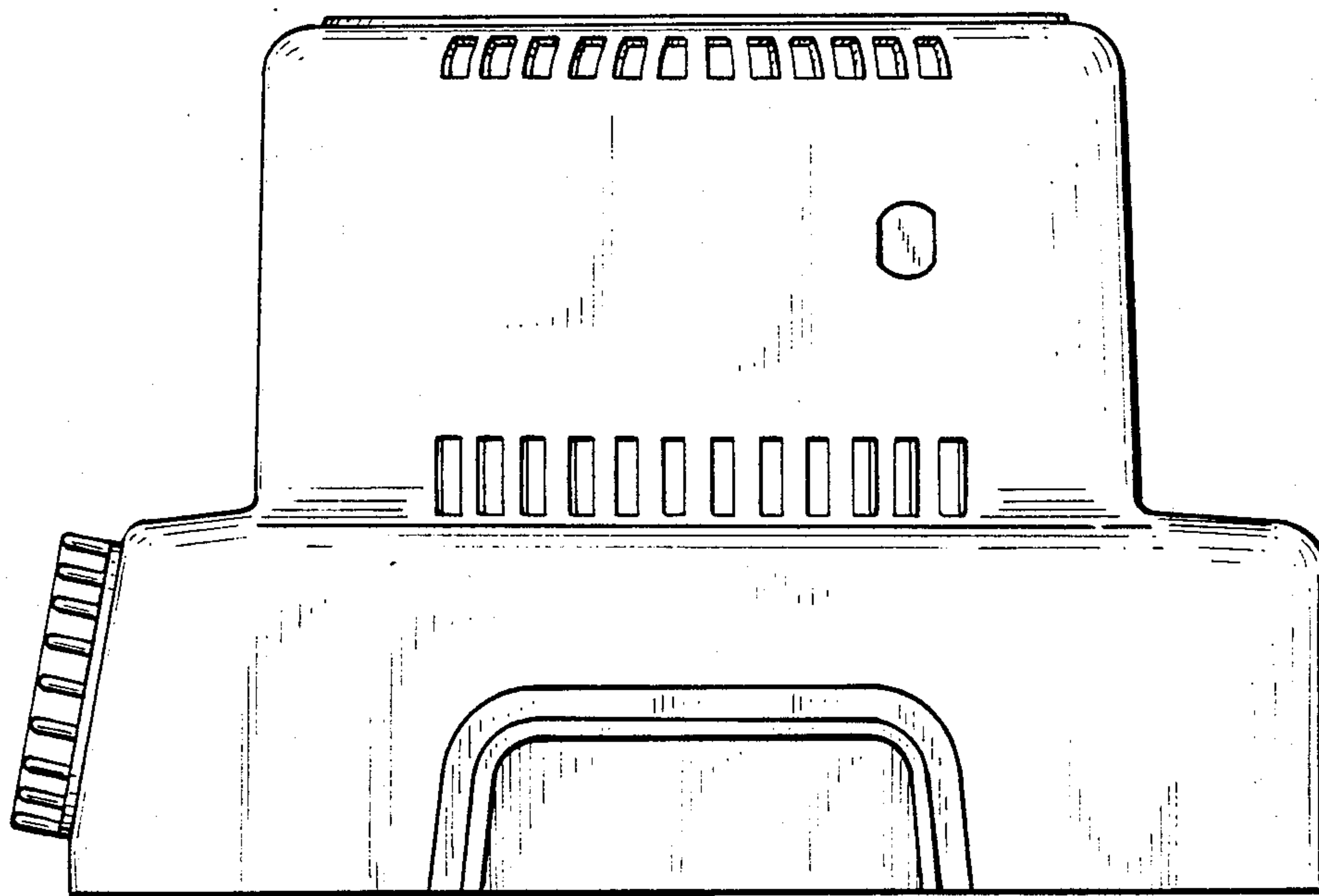
FIG. 3.FIG. 4.

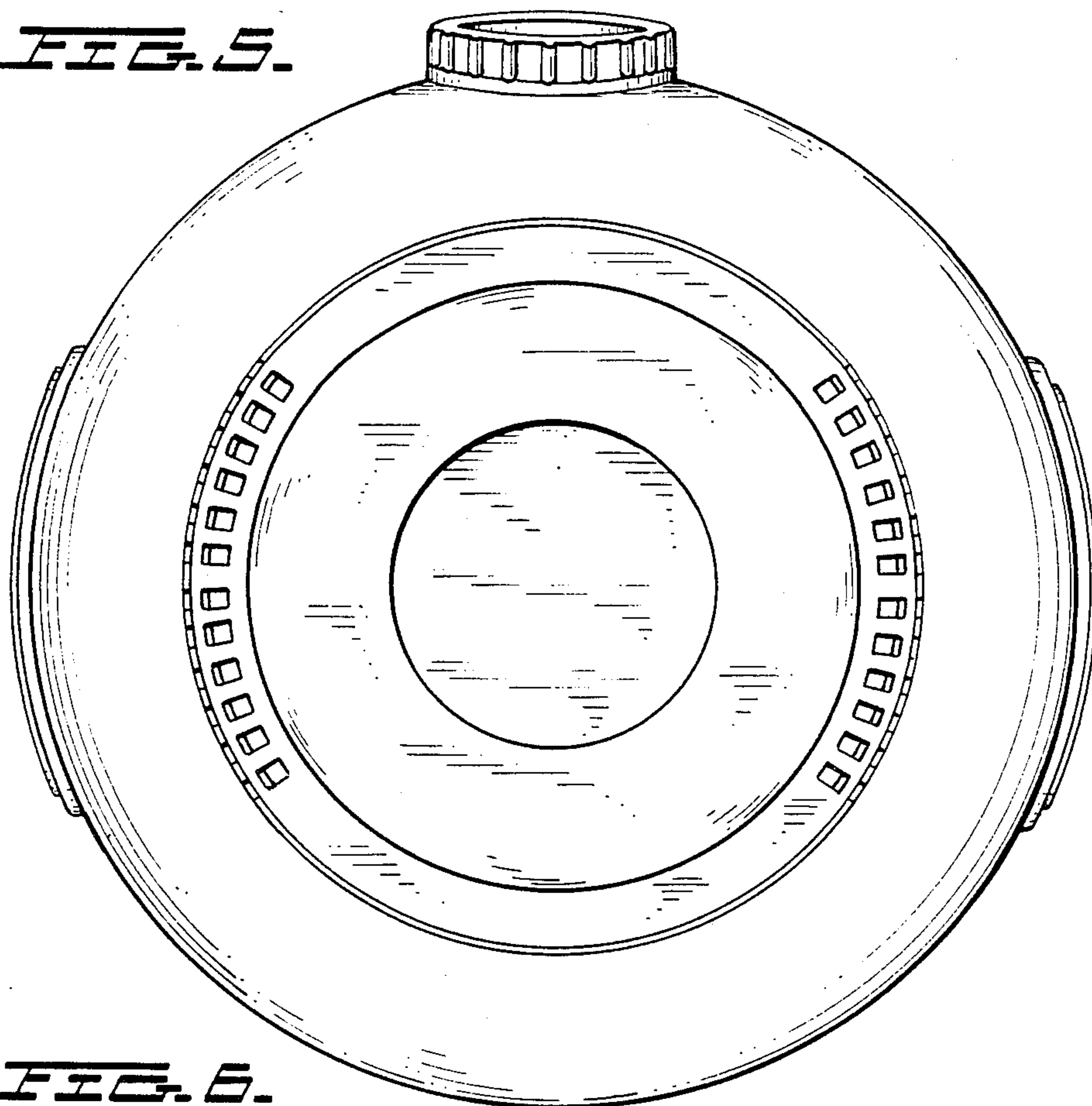
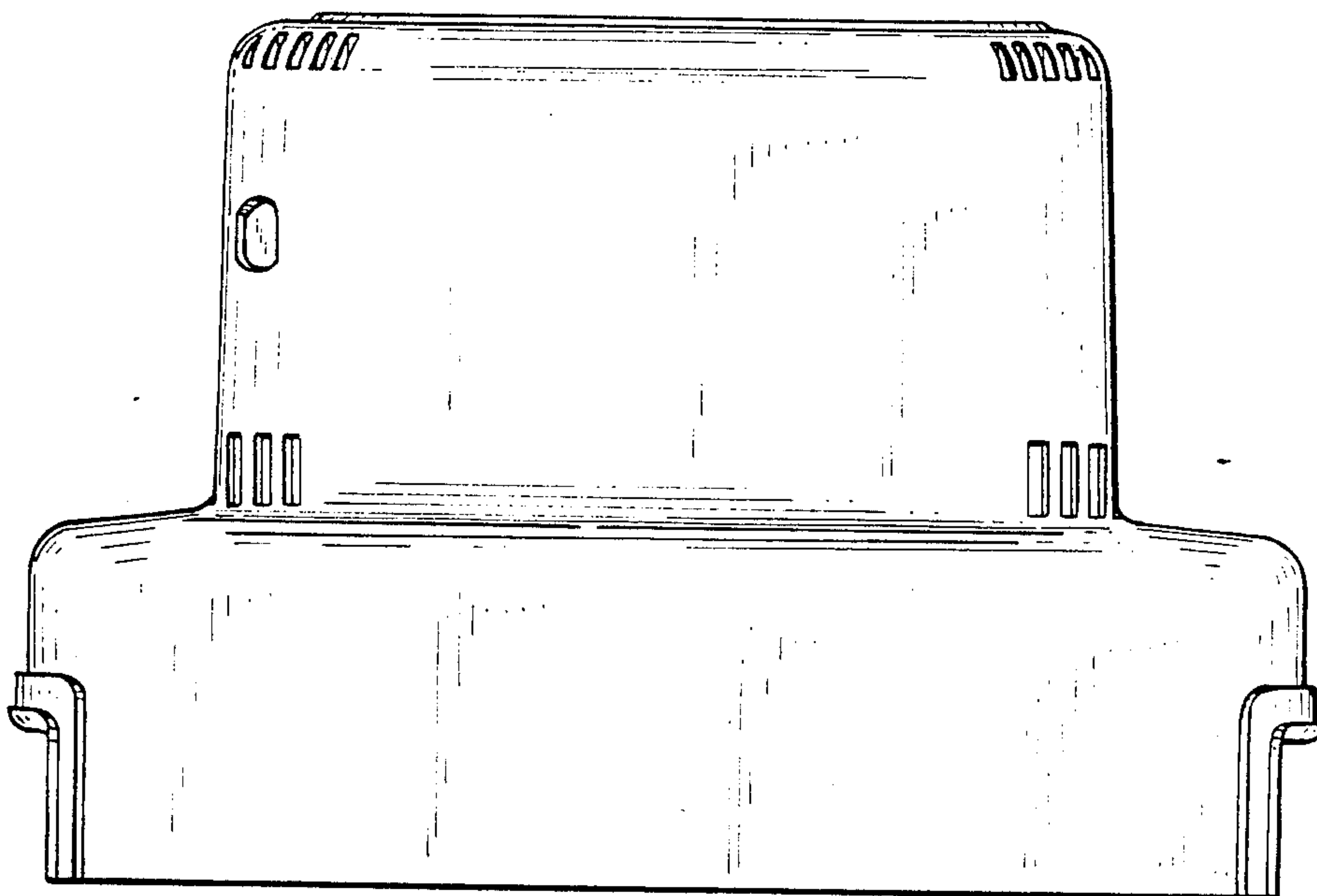

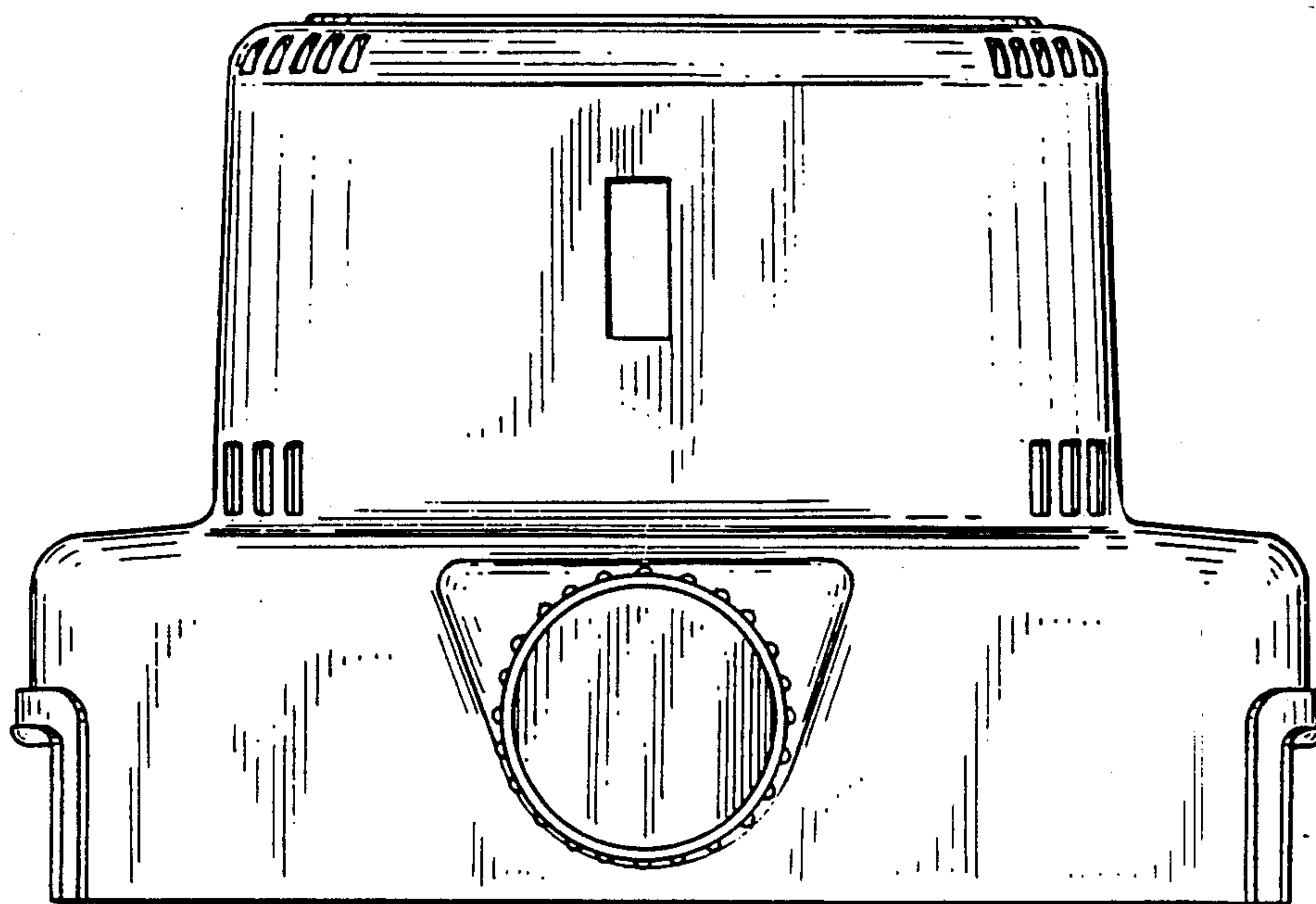

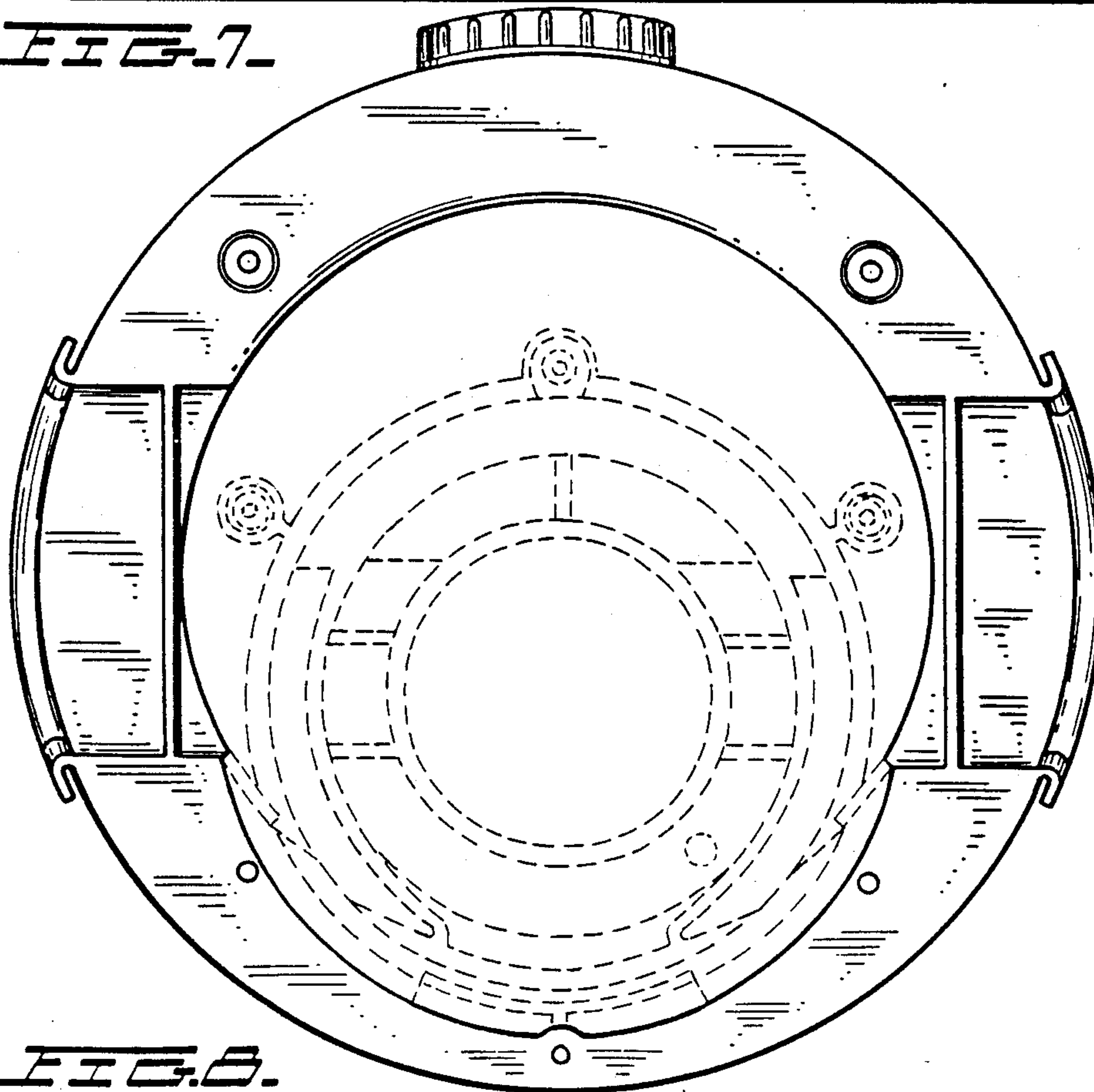
