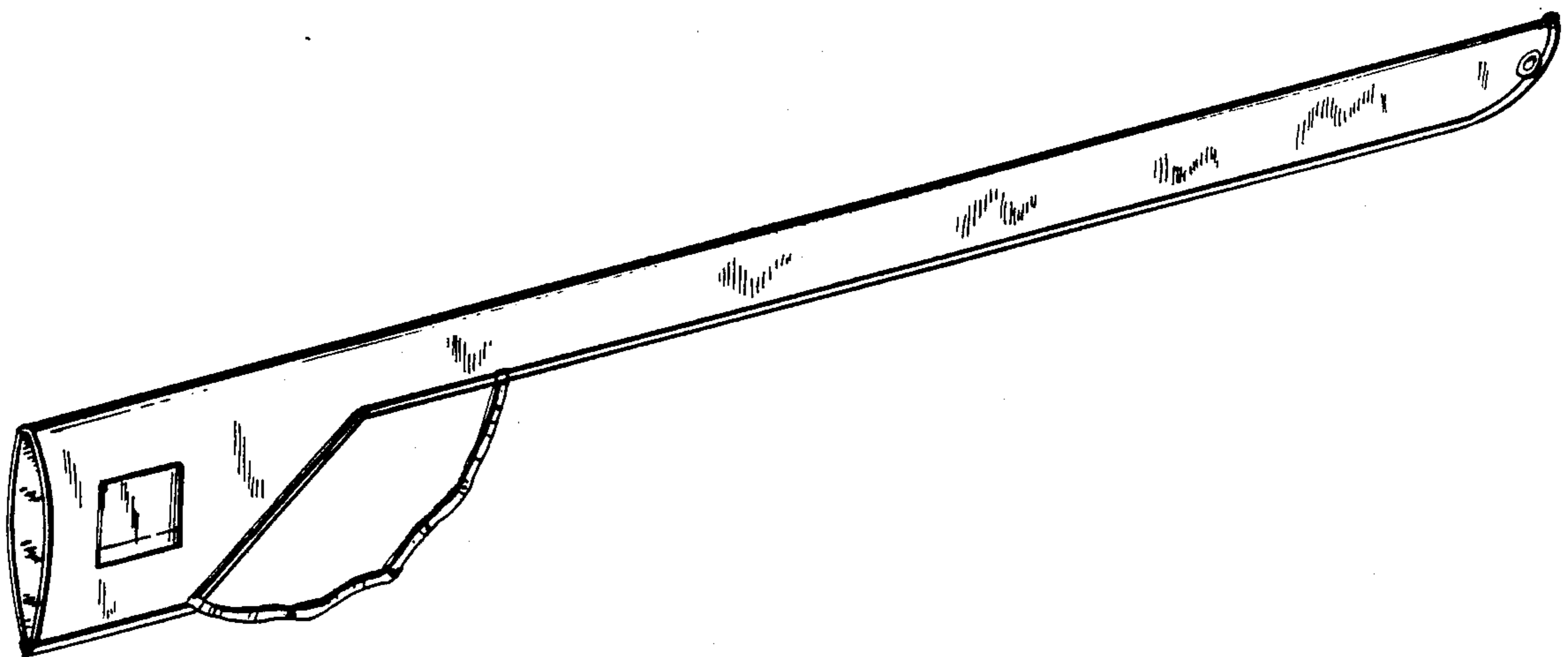

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a fishing rod case, substan-
tially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a fishing rod case, showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is an elevational view of the side opposite that shown in FIG. 1, in an inverted condition;
 FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of a modified embodiment of the design shown in FIGS. 1 and 2;
 FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the side opposite that shown in FIG. 3 in an inverted condition;
 FIG. 5 is cross-sectional view thereof, taken along line 5—5 in FIGS. 2 or 4; and,
 FIG. 6 is a side perspective view thereof.



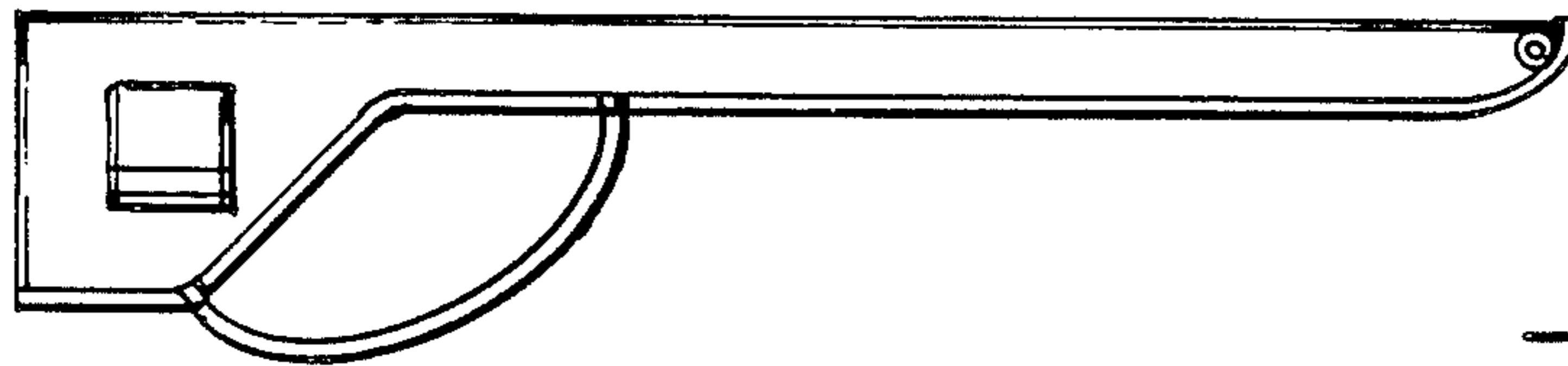

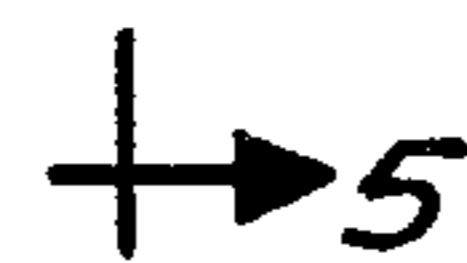
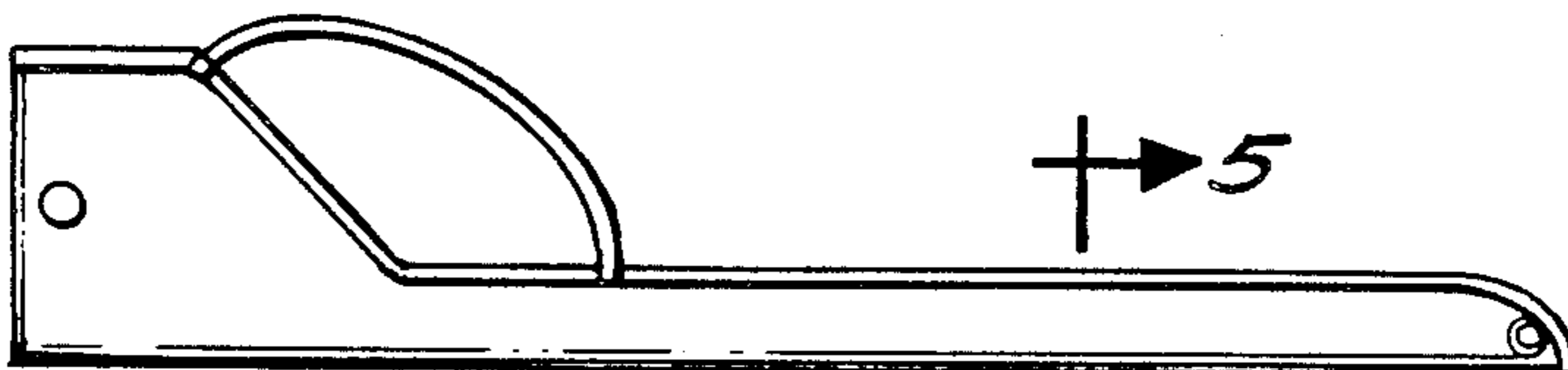

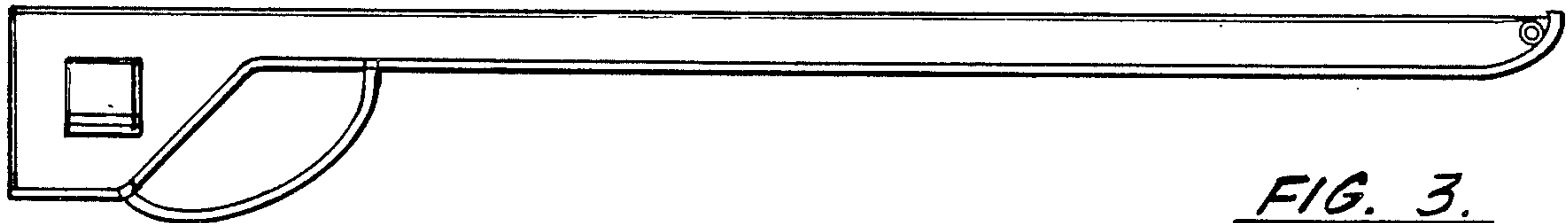

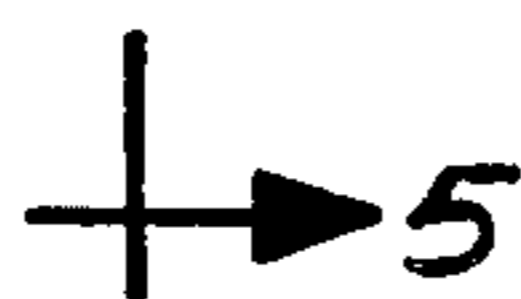
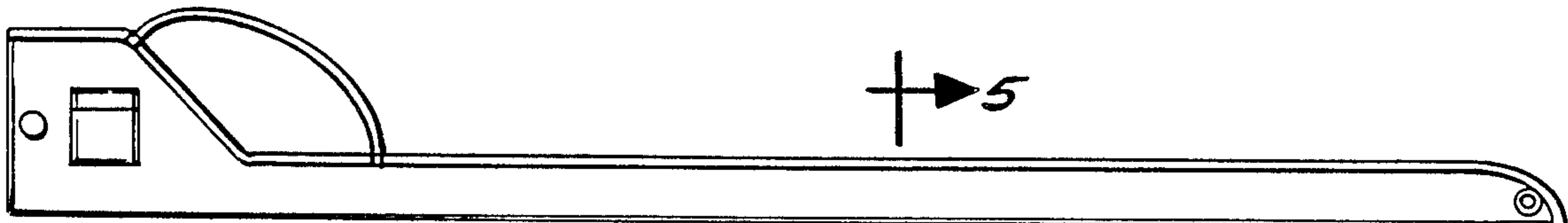

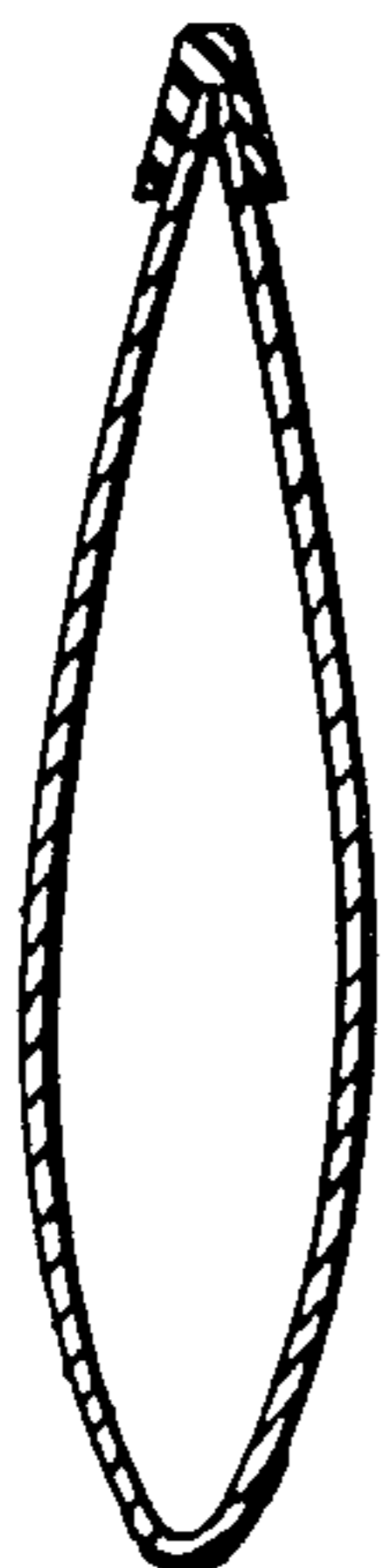

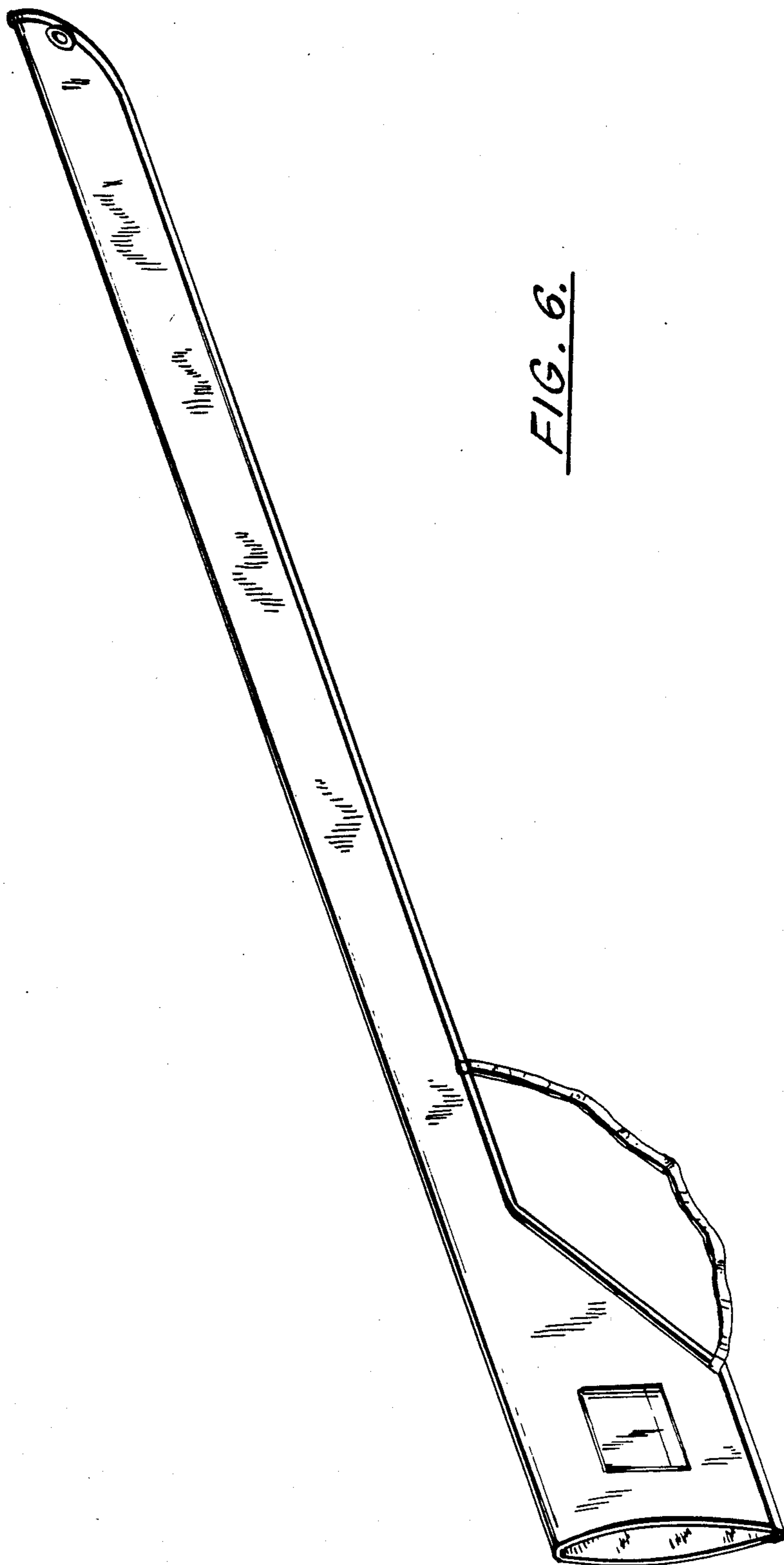
