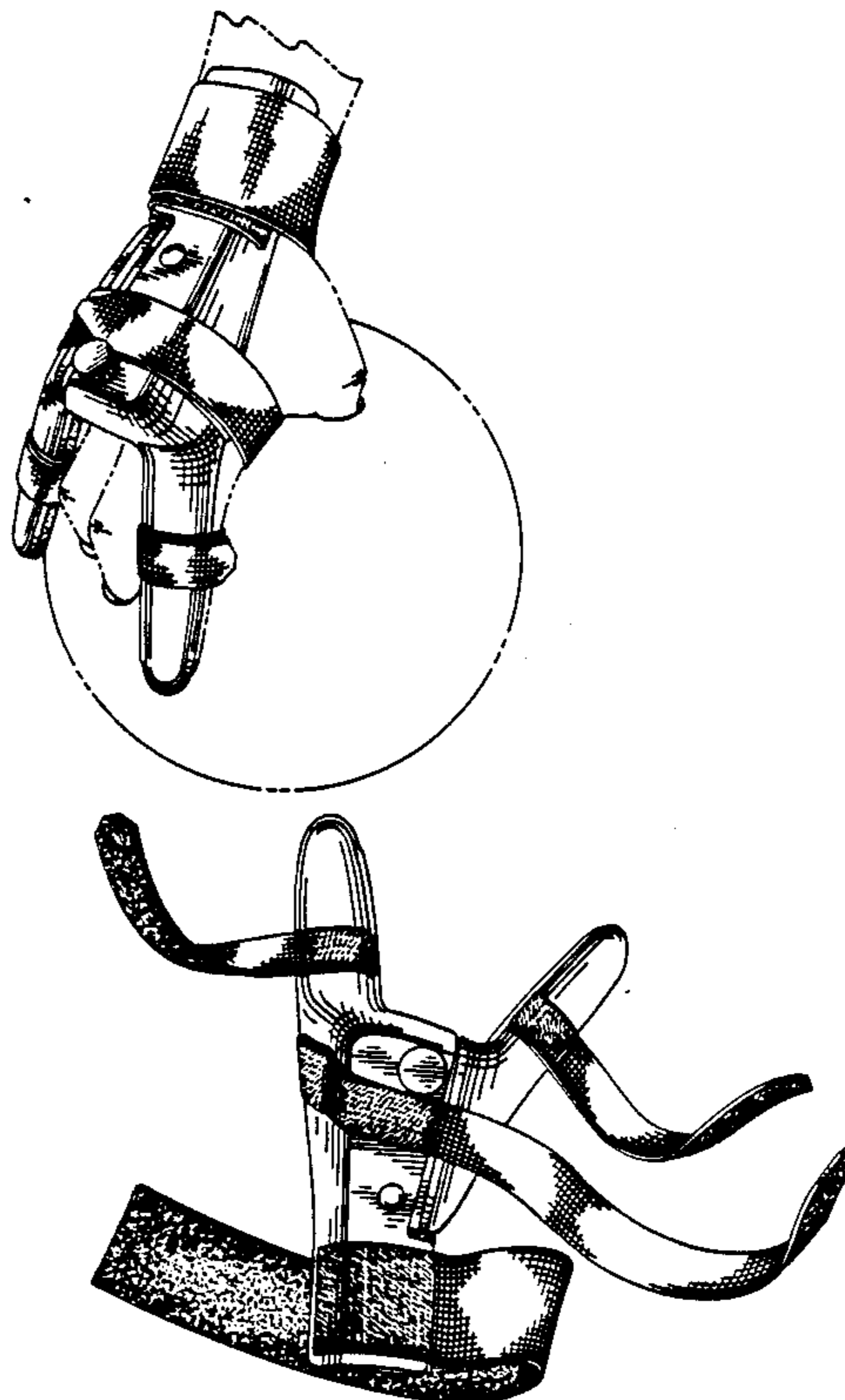

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bowling glove, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bowling glove showing our new design, the broken lines indicate environmental structure and form no part of the claimed design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view in unstrapped position; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof. The straps are broken away in FIGS. 3-6 for convenience of illustration.



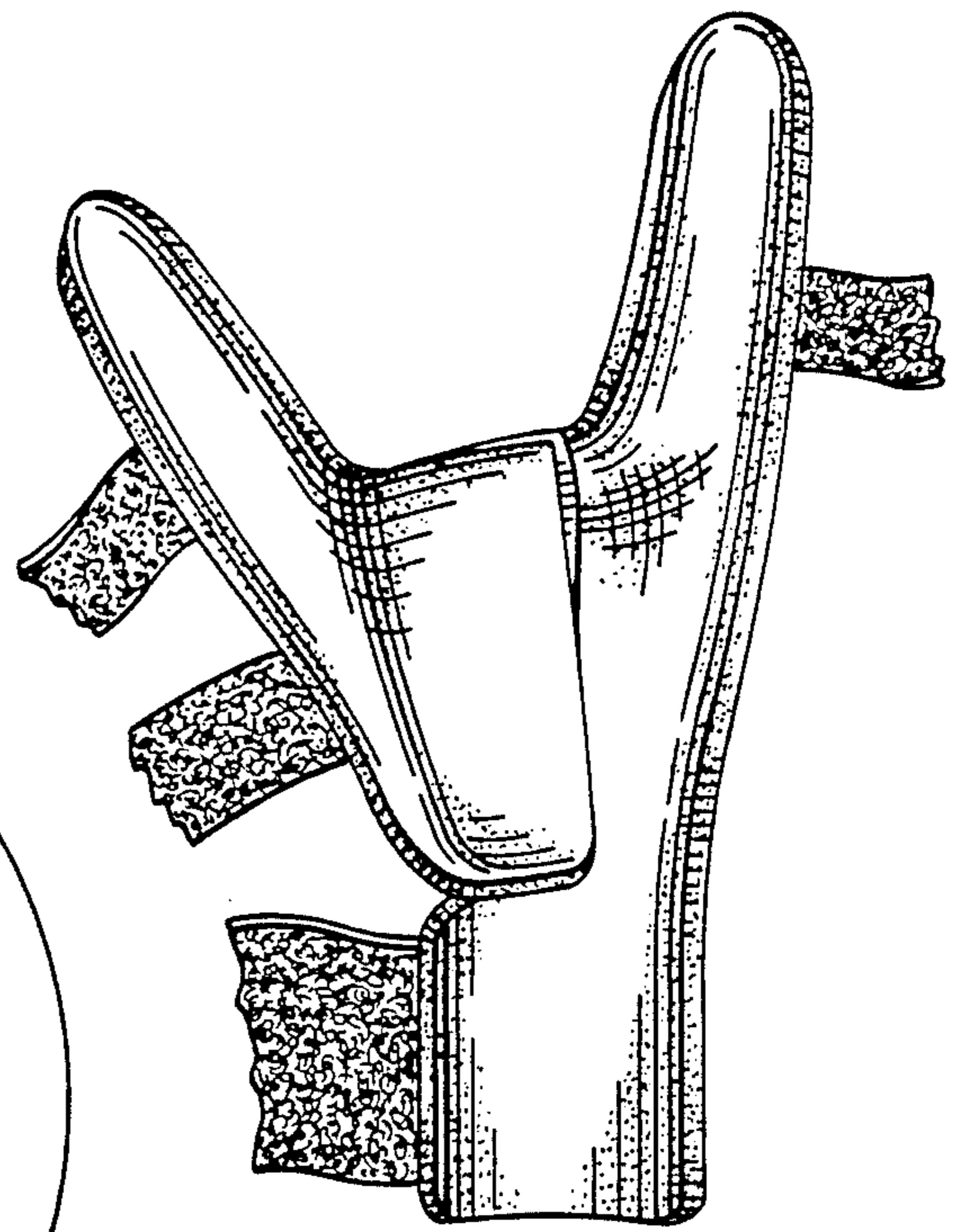
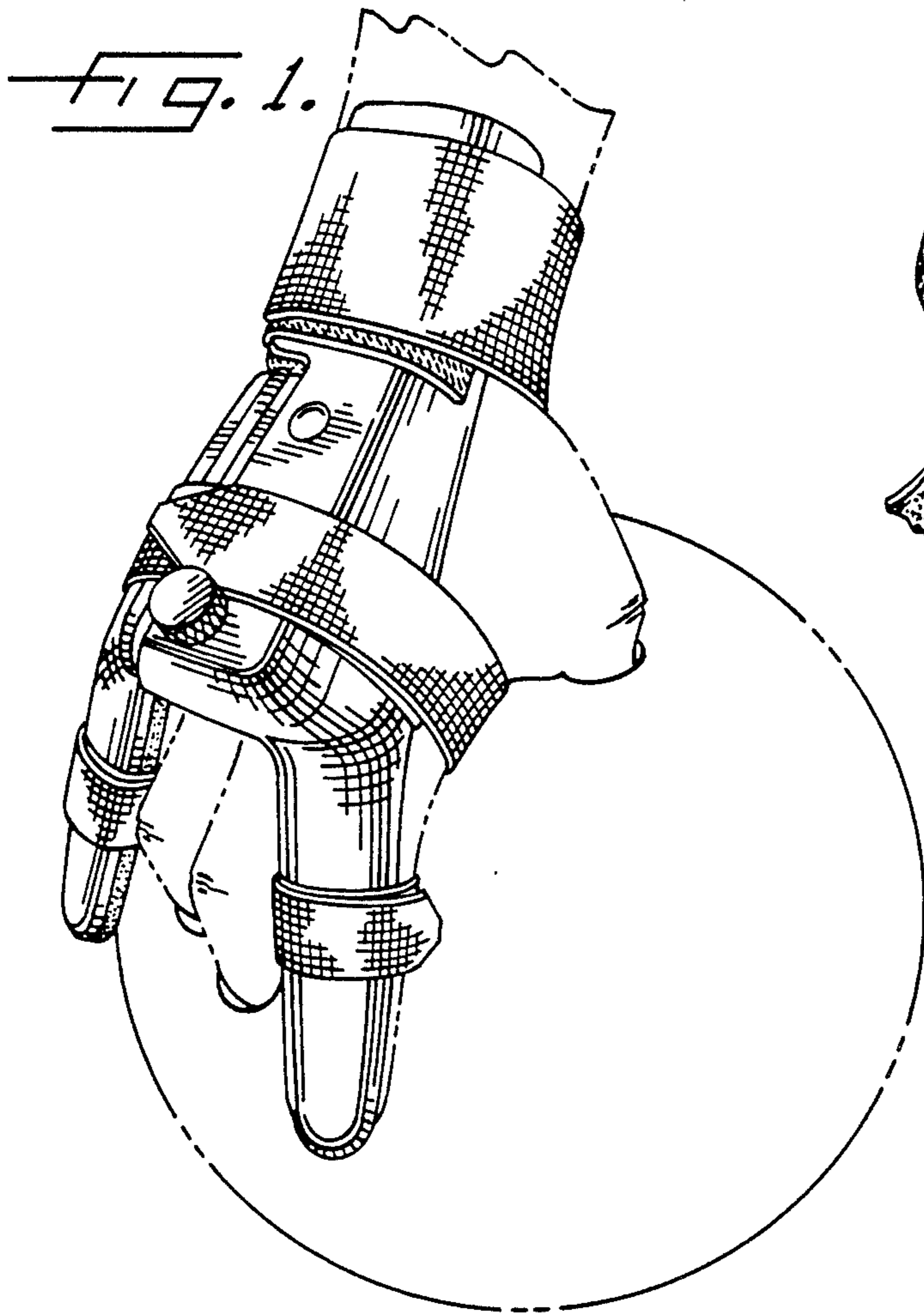
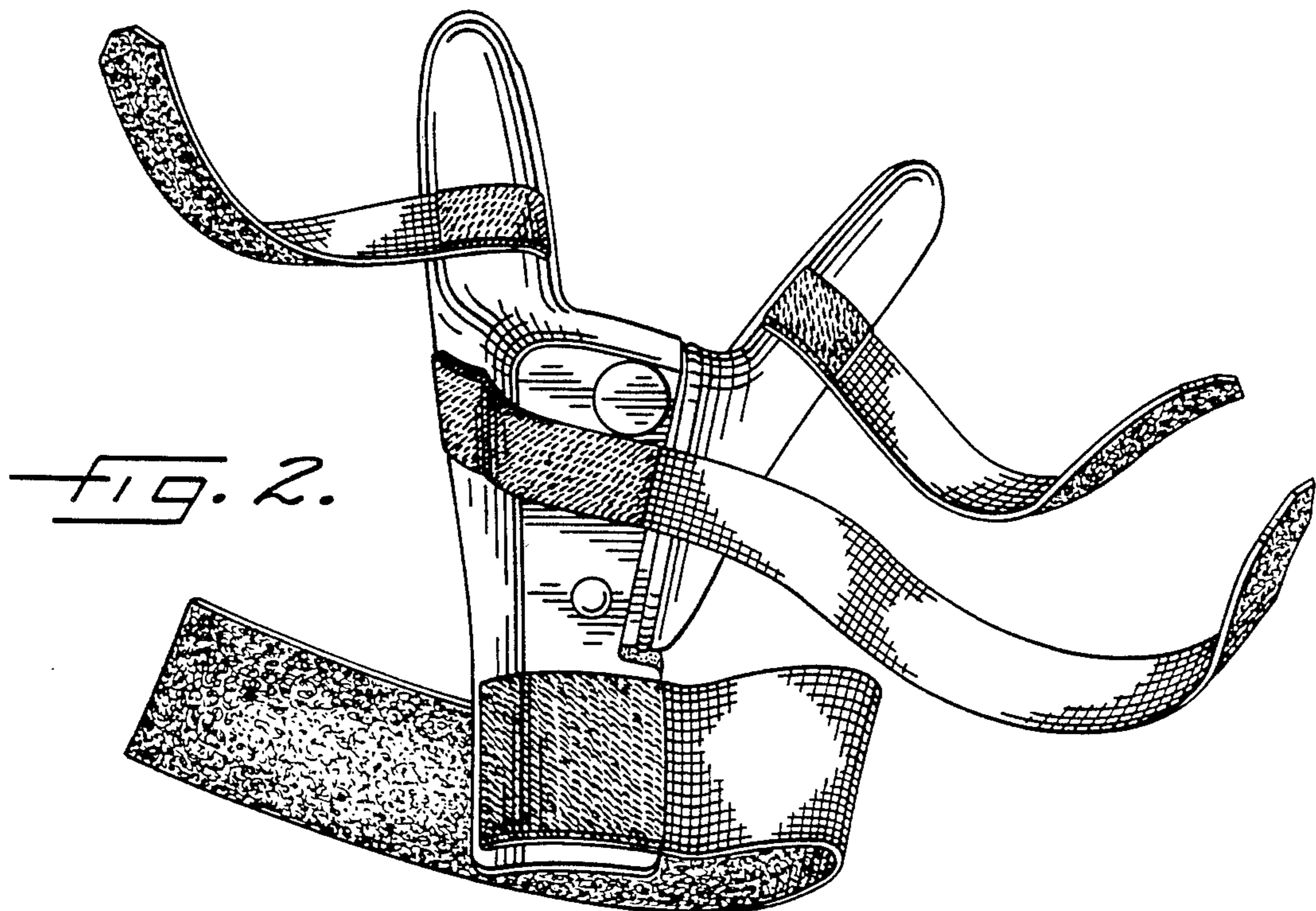

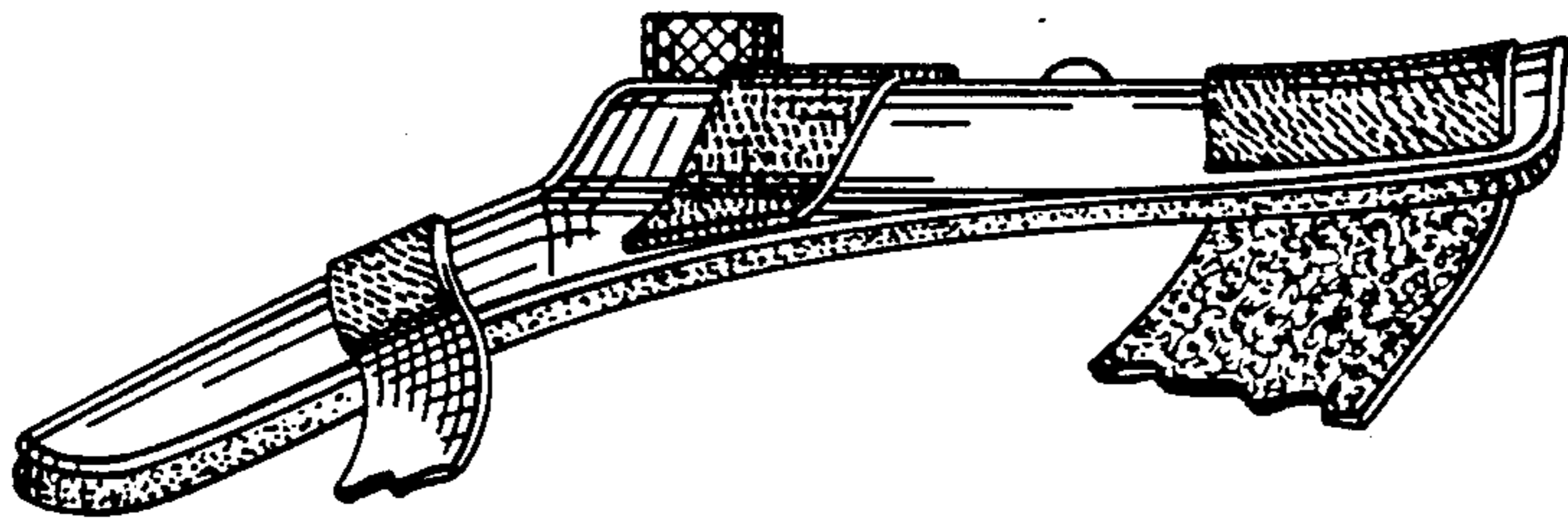

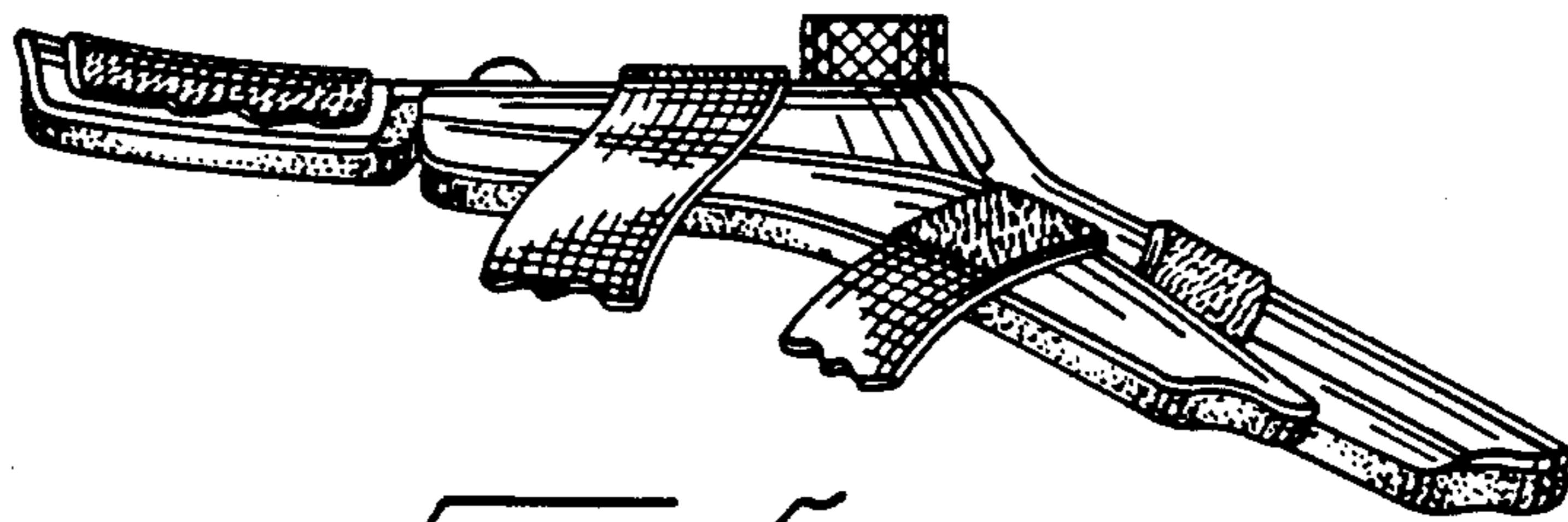

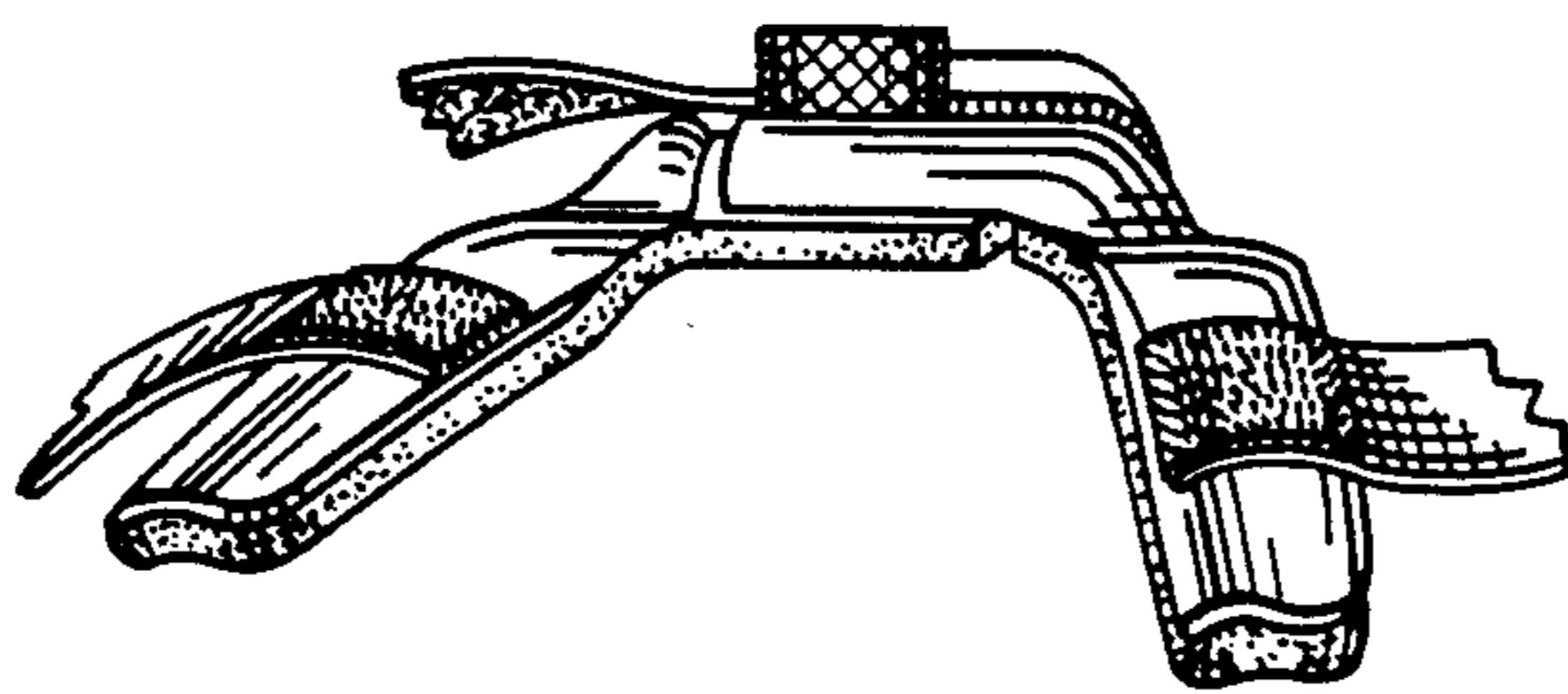
