FIG. 1 is a reduced perspective view of a handle grip for a vacuum cleaner showing my new design, with the vacuum cleaner being shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

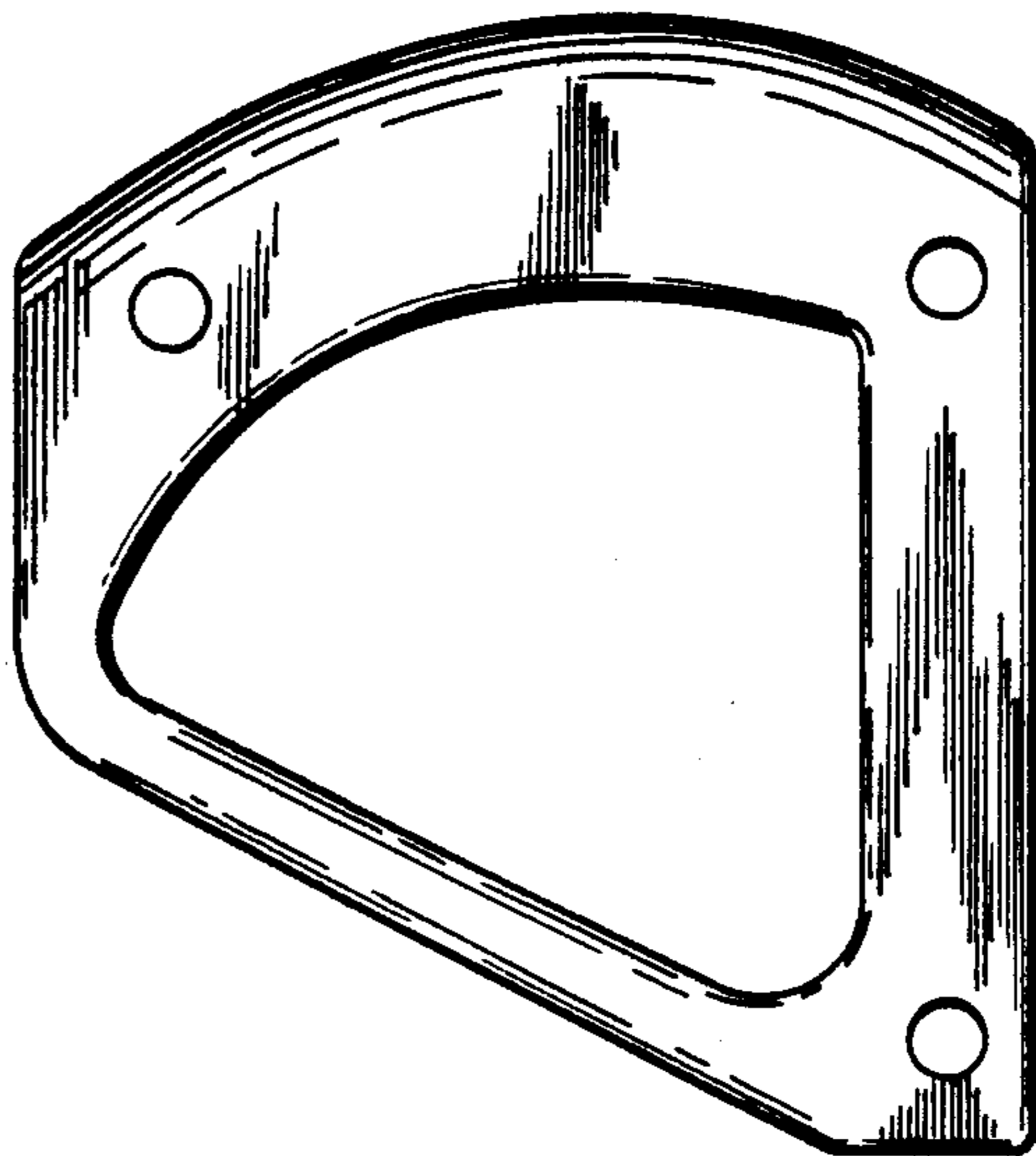
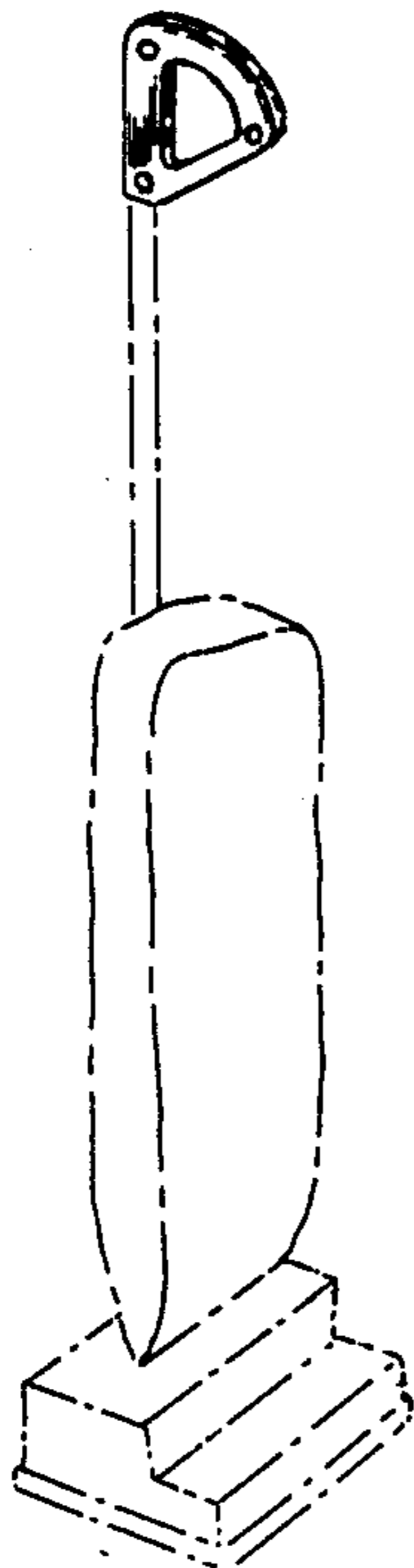
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof; the right side being a mirror image;

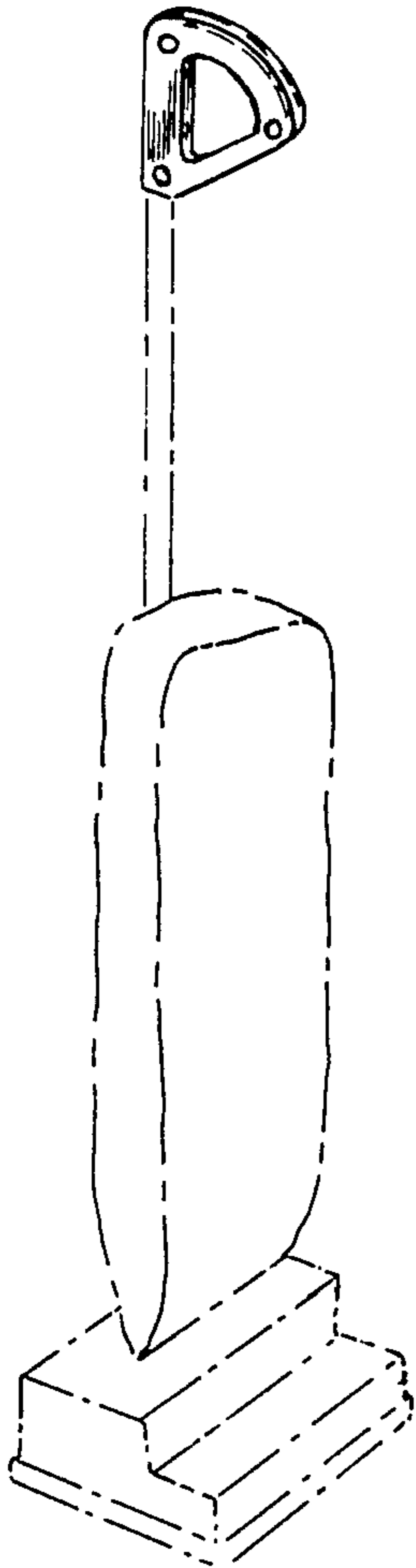
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

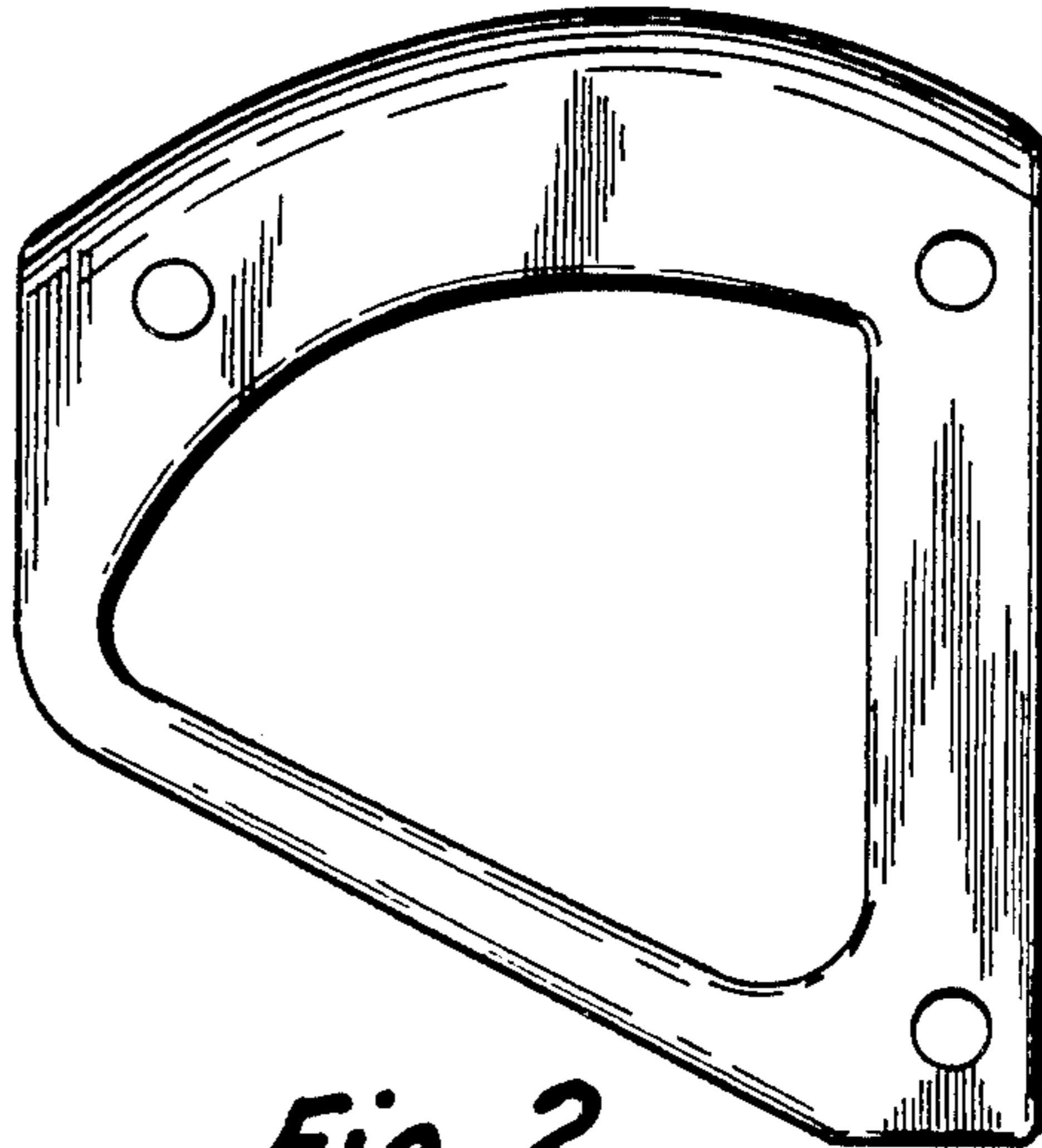
FIG. 5 is an end elevation thereof taken from the left side of FIG. 2; and

FIG. 6 is an end elevation thereof taken from the right side of FIG. 2.

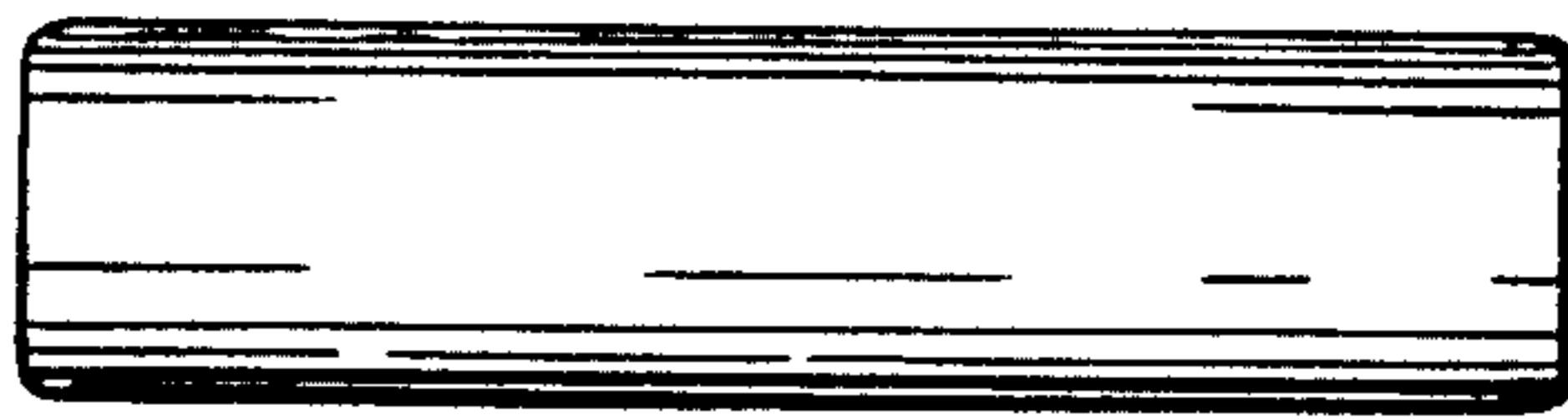




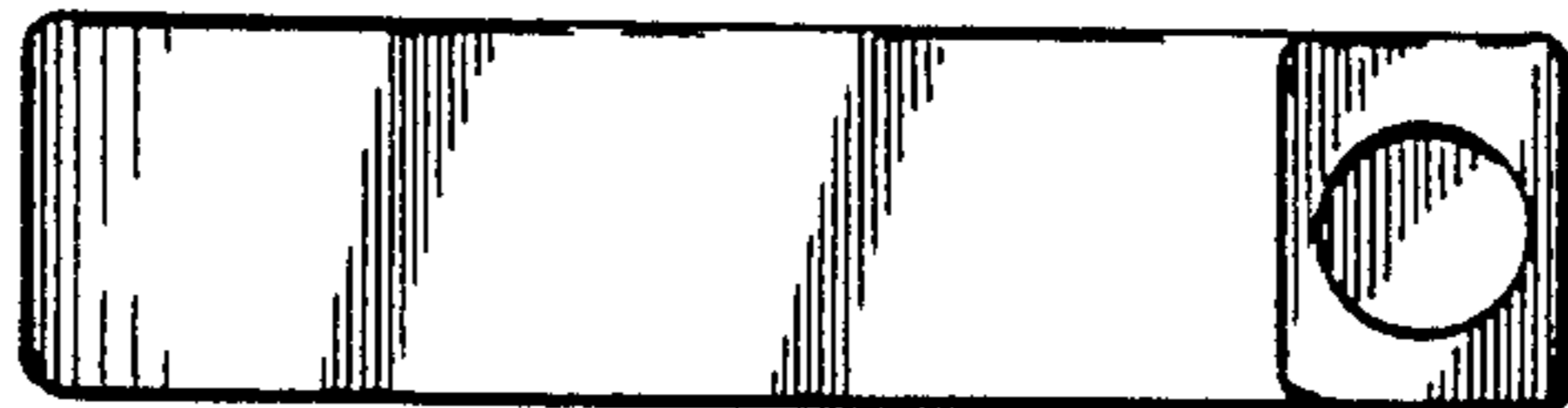

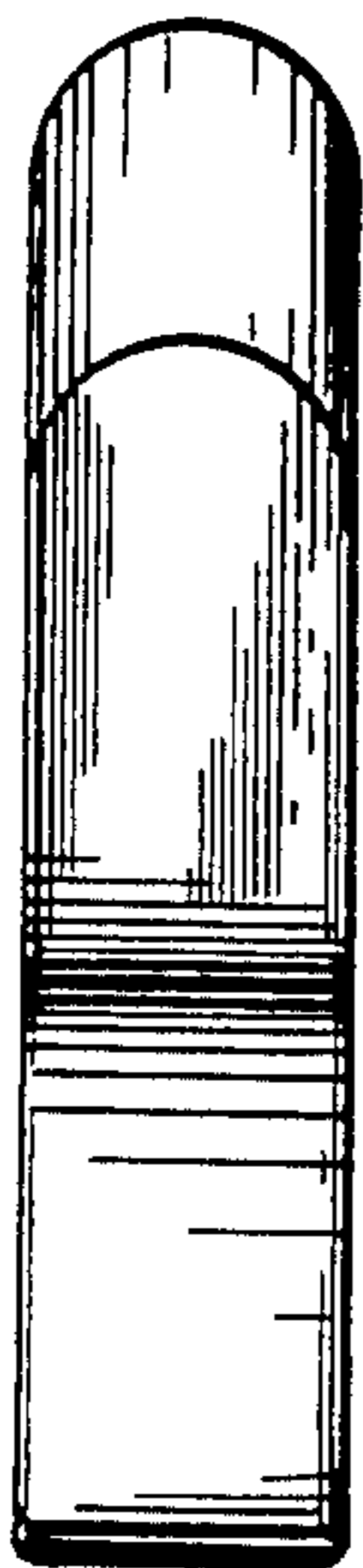
