FIG. 4 is a left end view of FIG. 1.

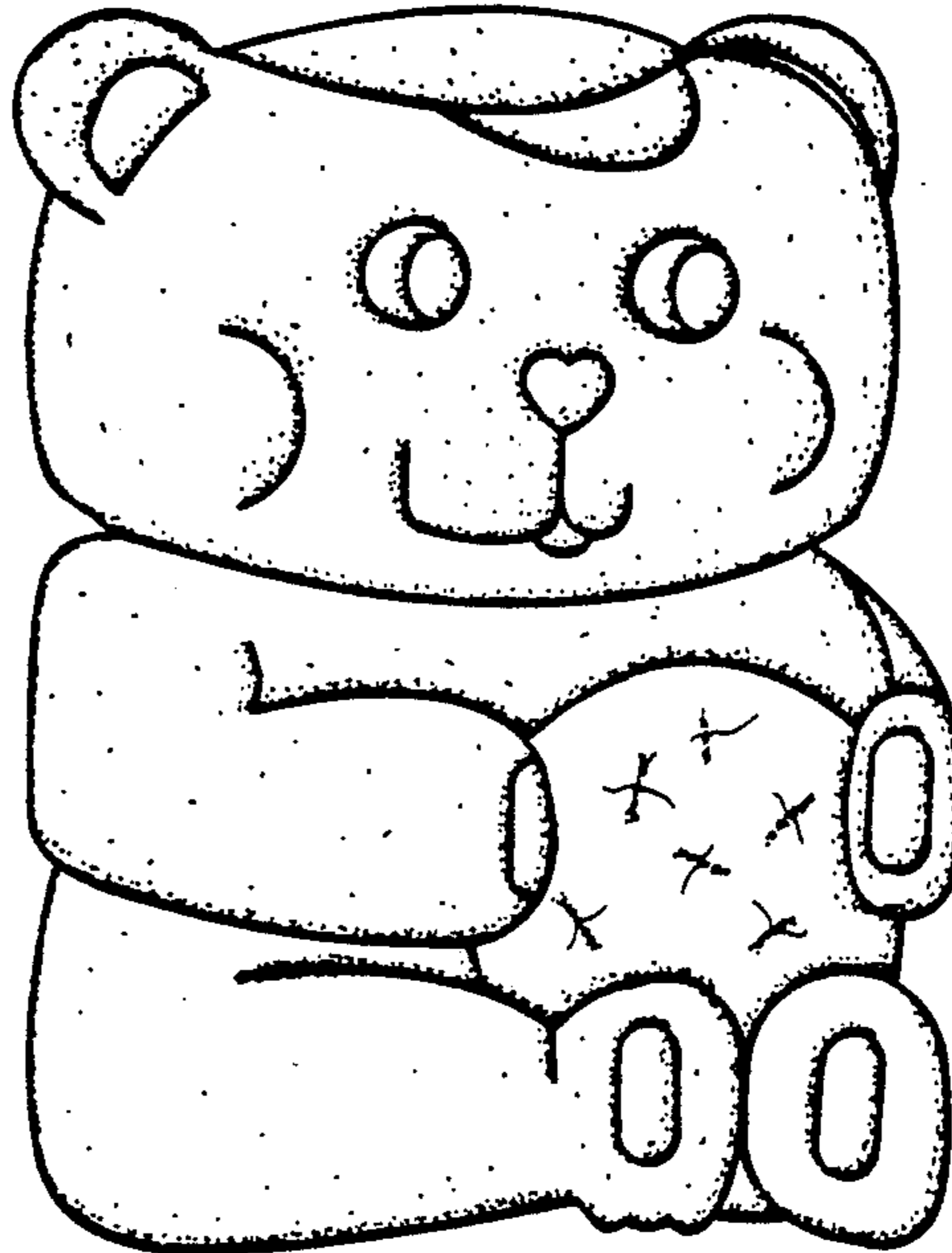
FIG. 5 is a top end view thereof.

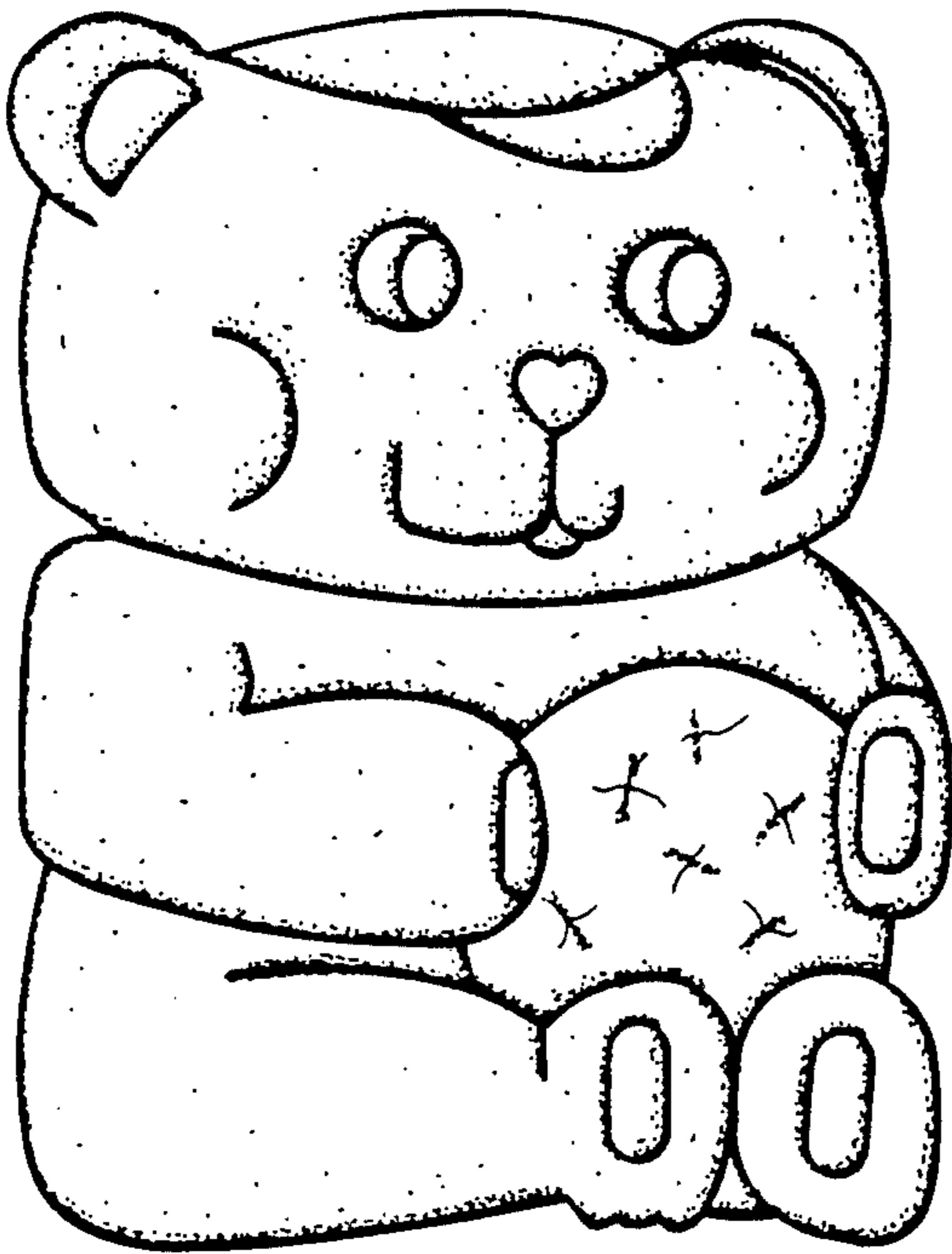

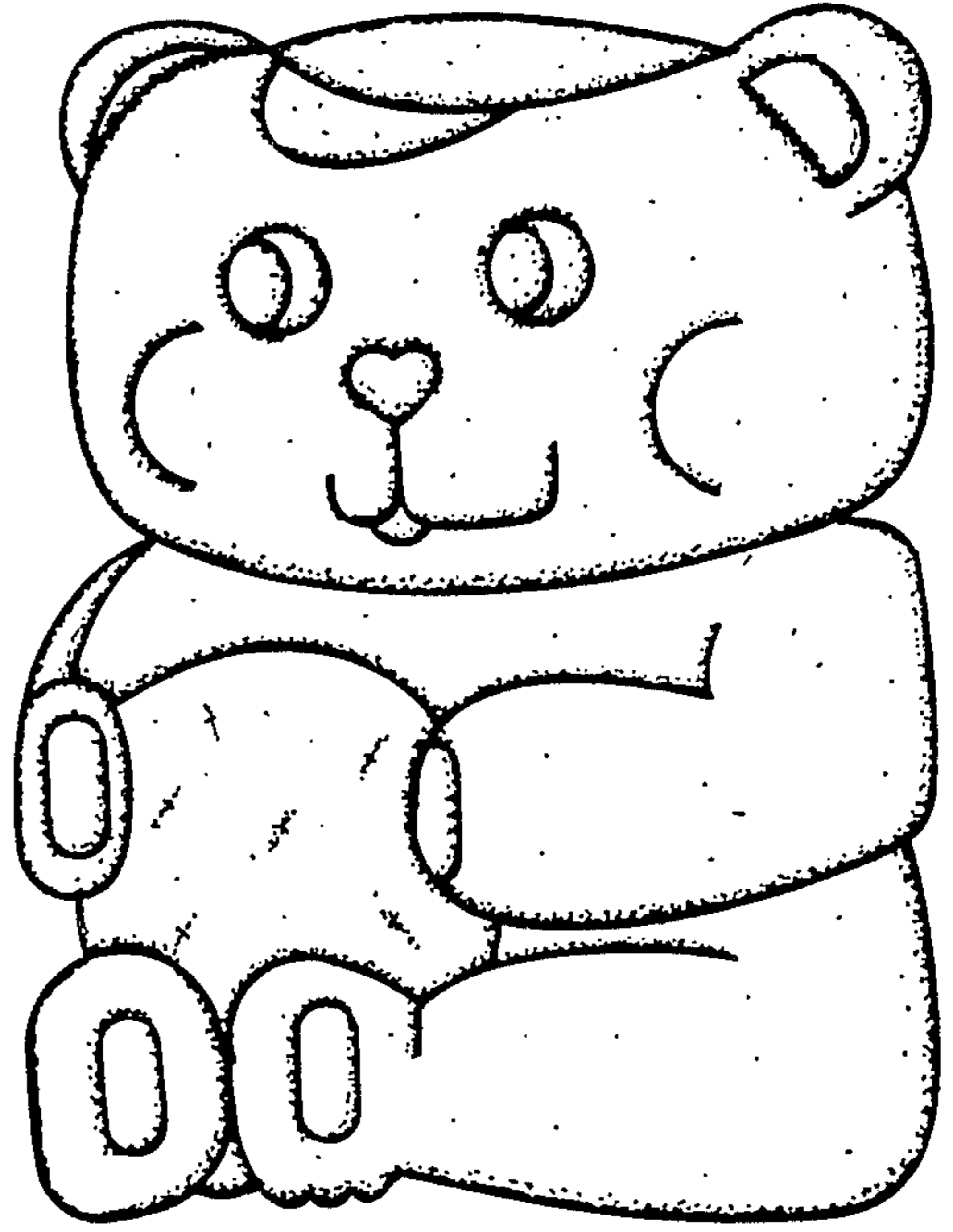

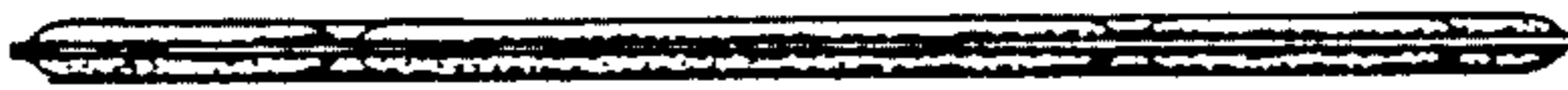

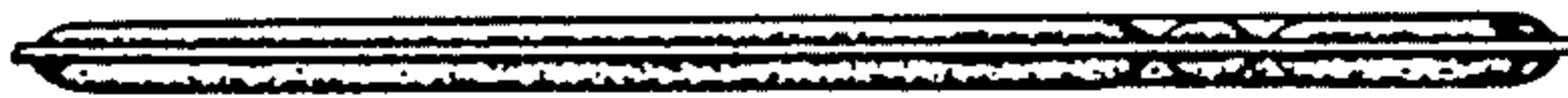
