[57] **CLAIM**
 The ornamental design for a fillet knife, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a fillet knife embodying our new design.
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a side view in elevation thereof;
 FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof from the right of FIG. 3;
 FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
 FIG. 6 is a side view in elevation showing the opposite side from that of FIG. 3; and
 FIG. 7 is an end elevational view thereof, from the right of FIG. 6.
