FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

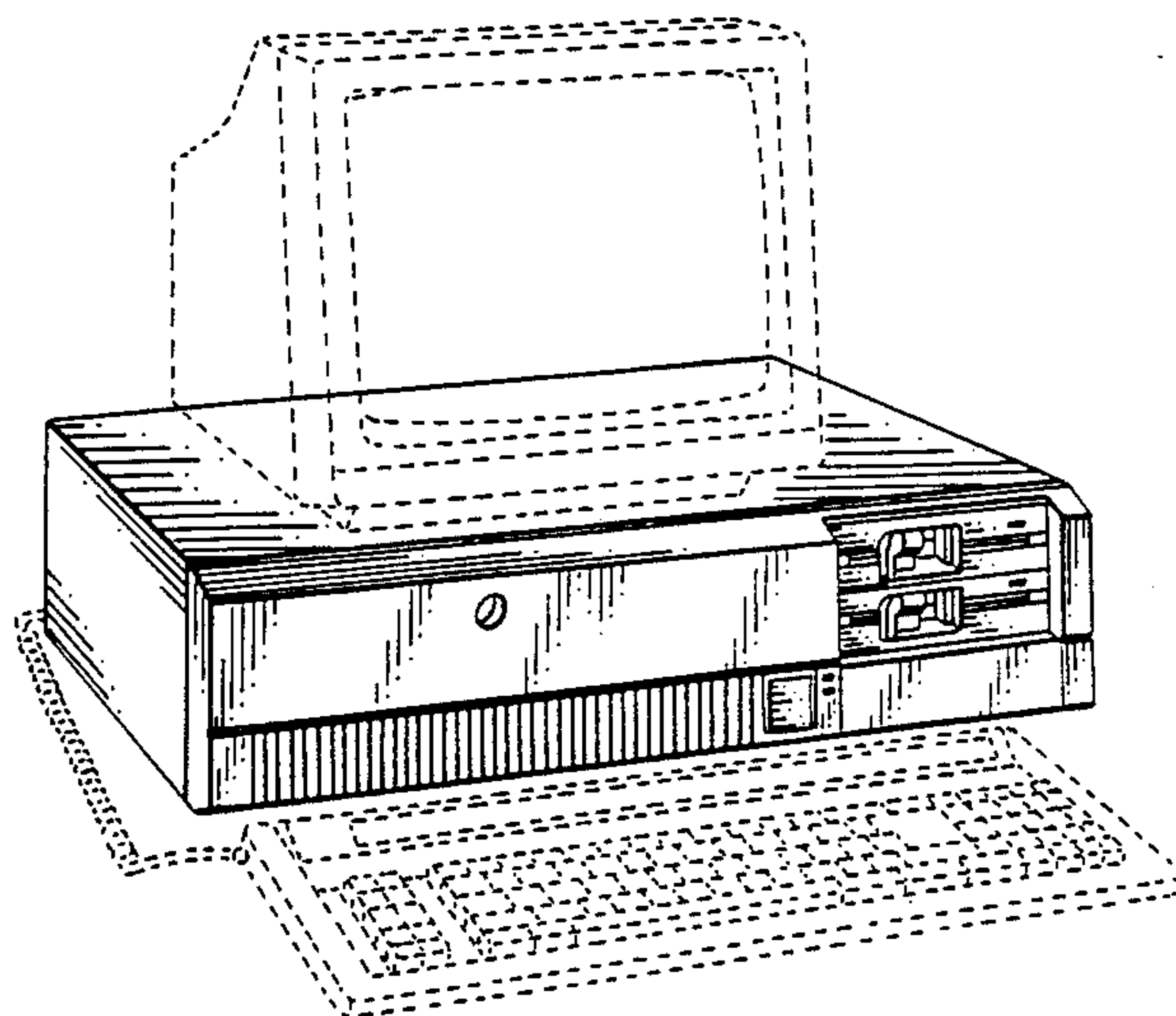
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

illustrative purposes only.



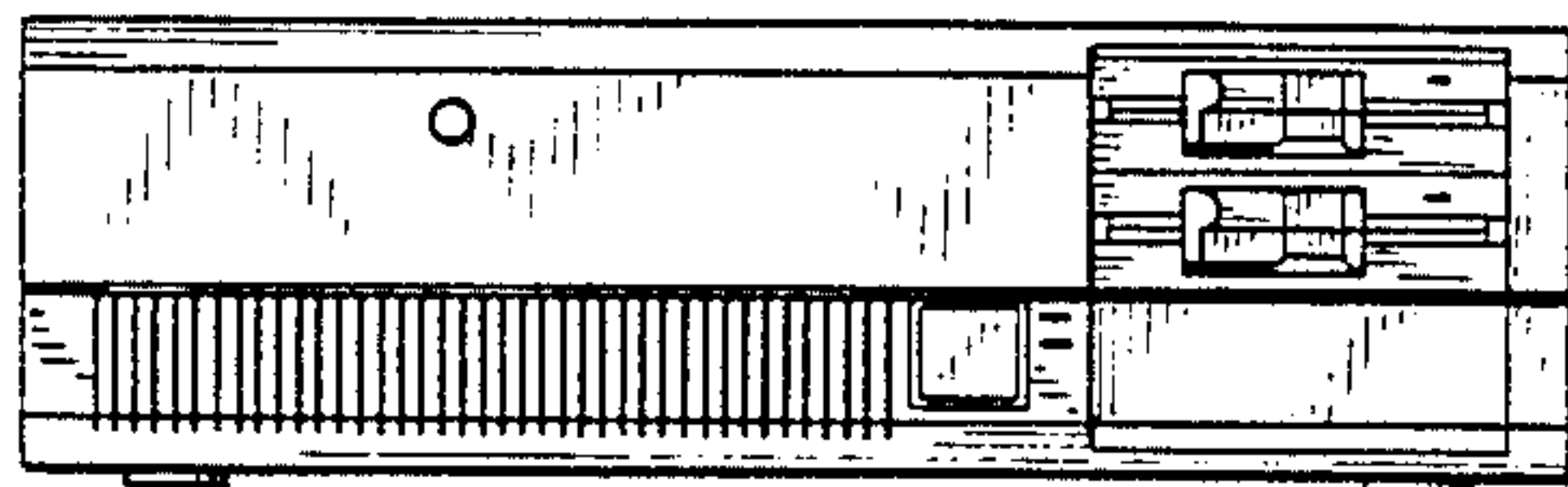

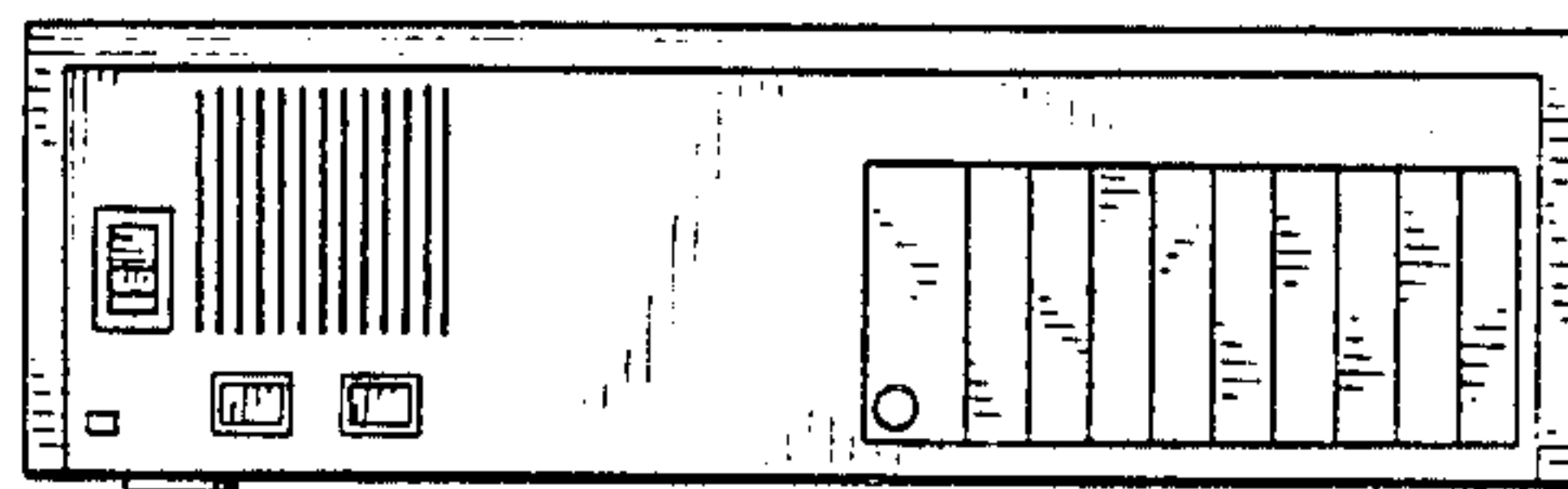

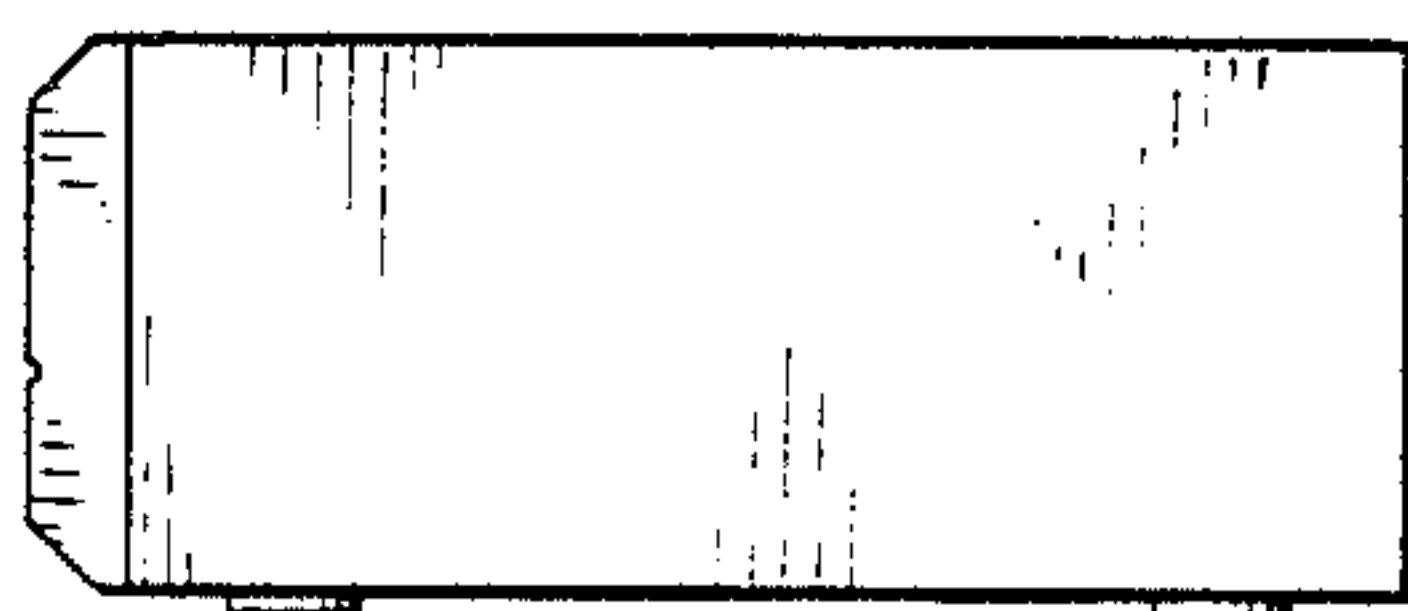

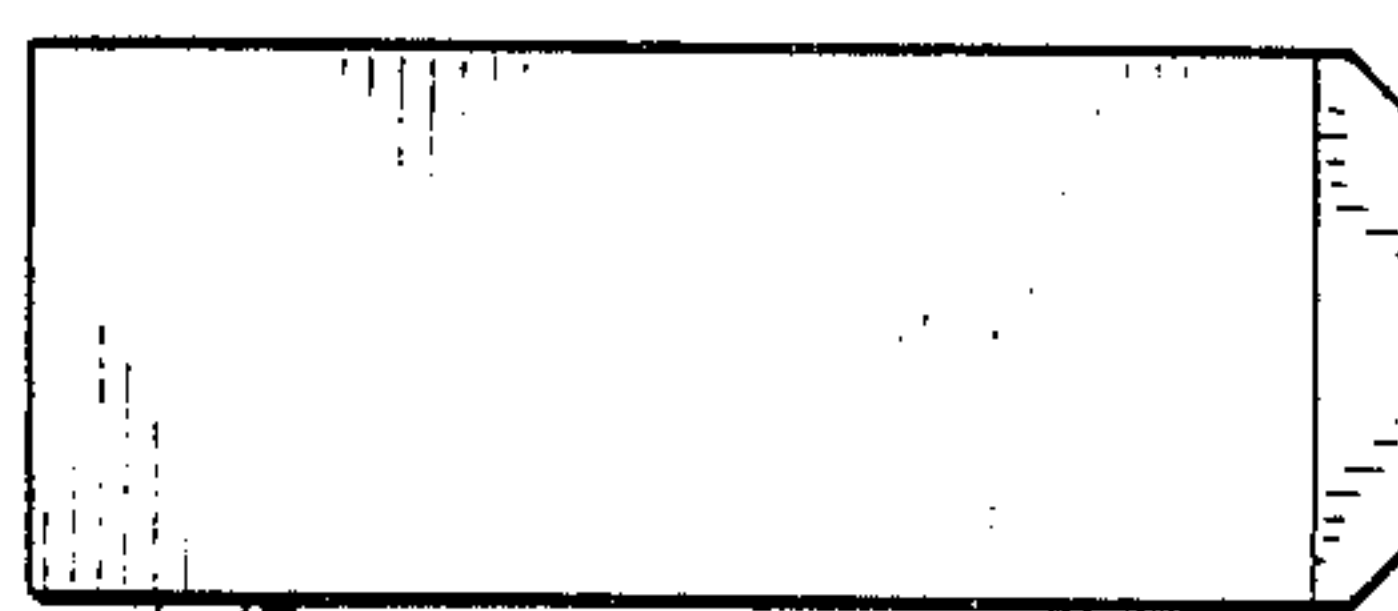

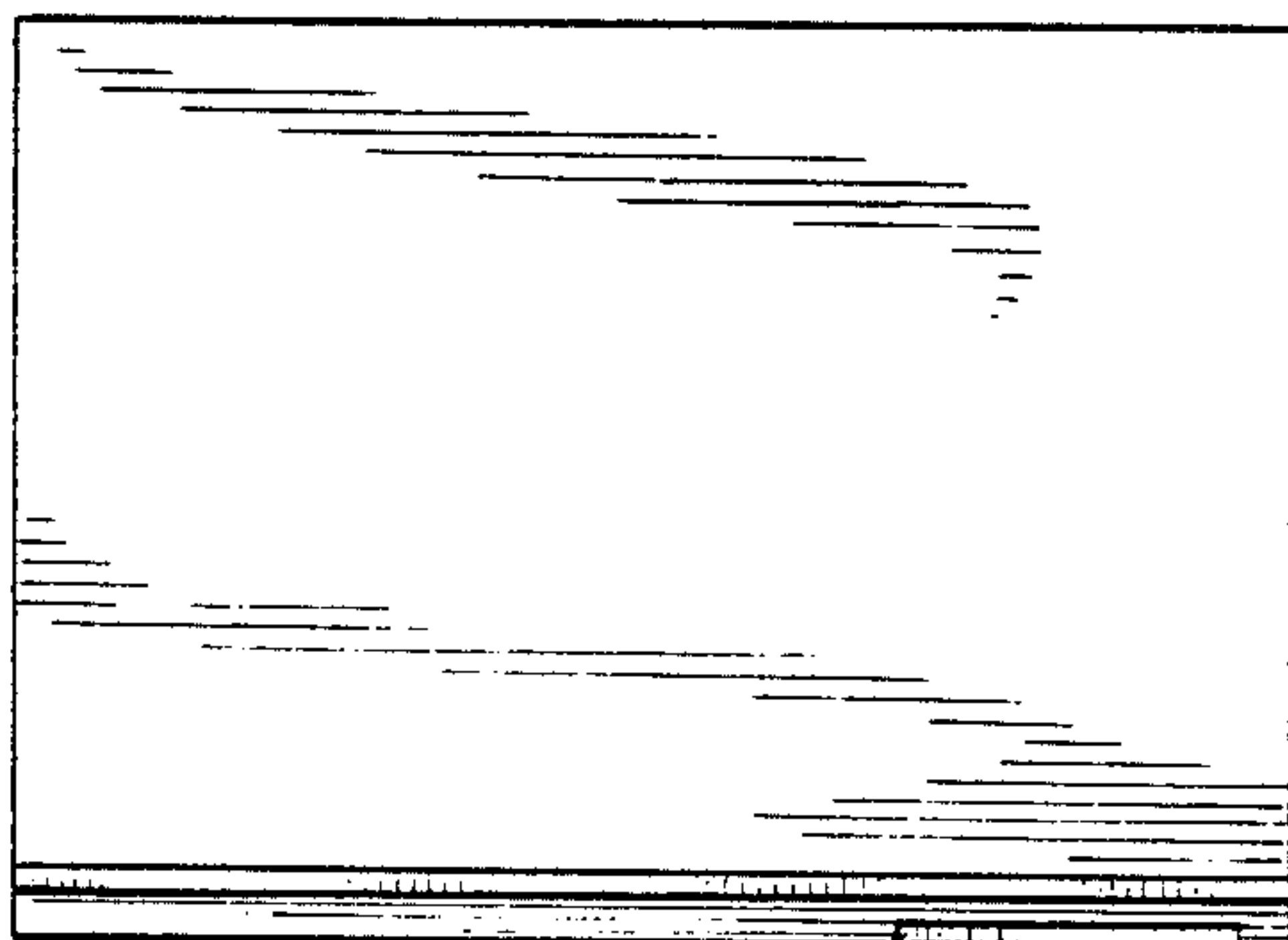

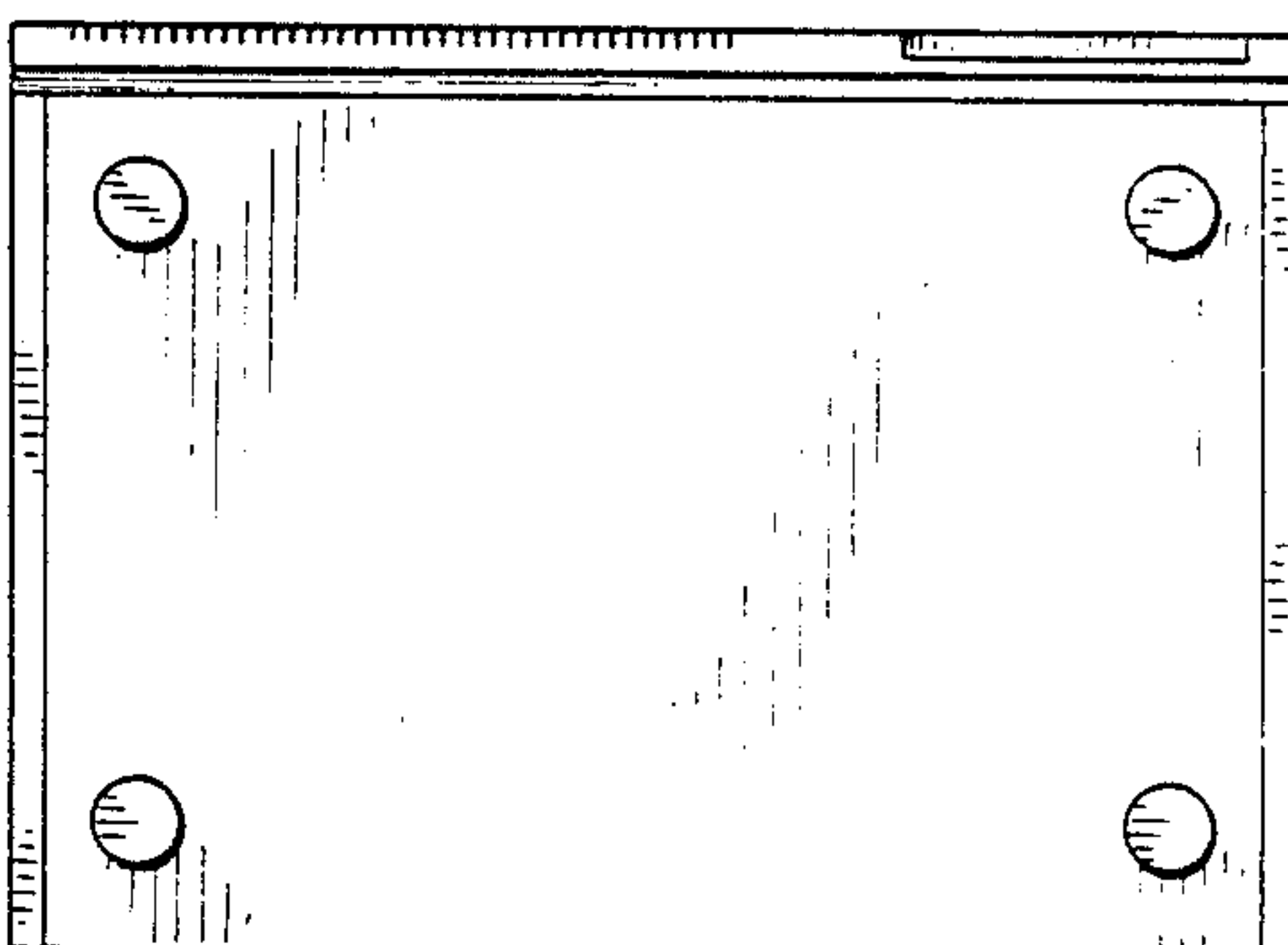

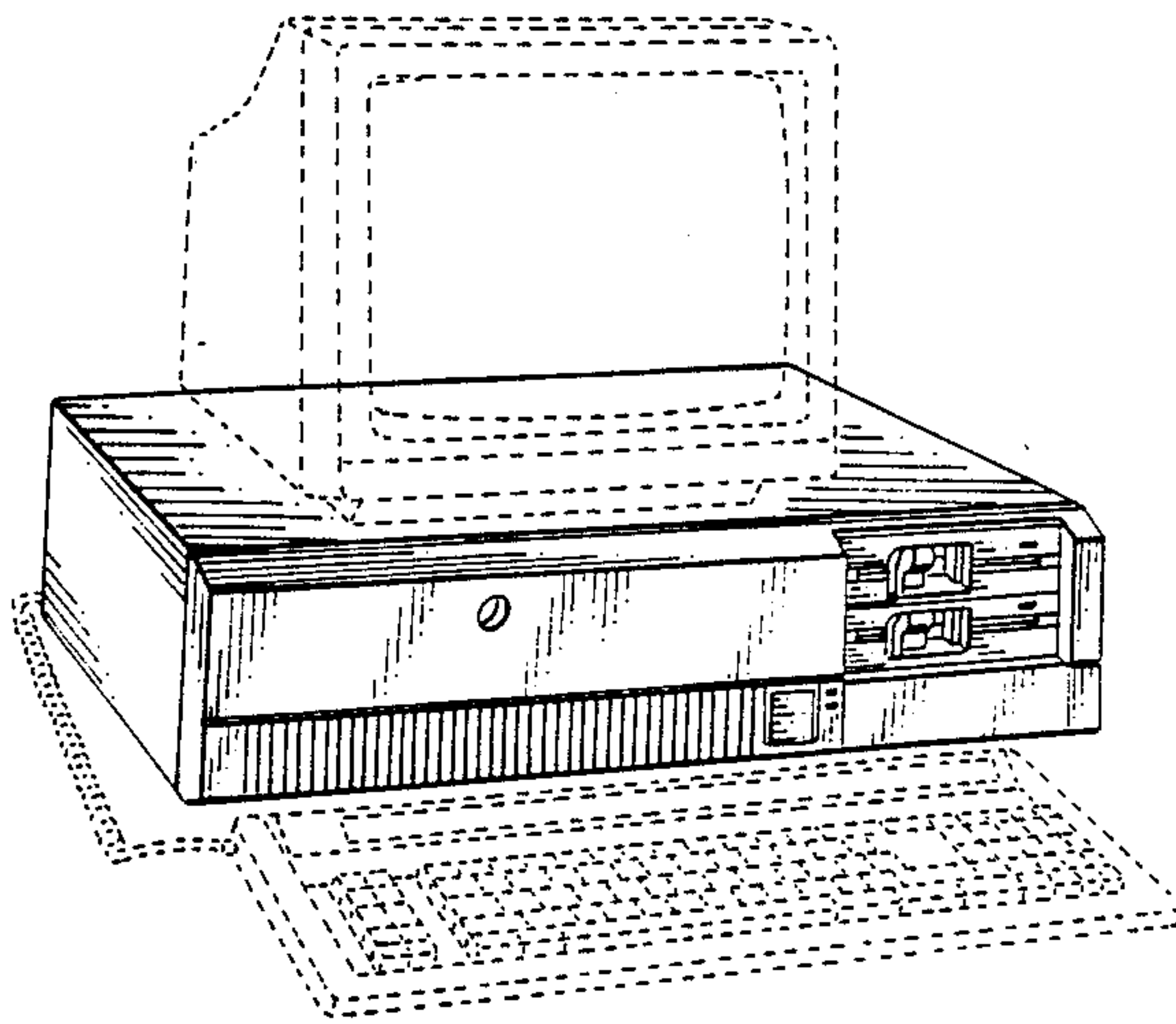
