FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the bicycle seat shown in FIG. 1.

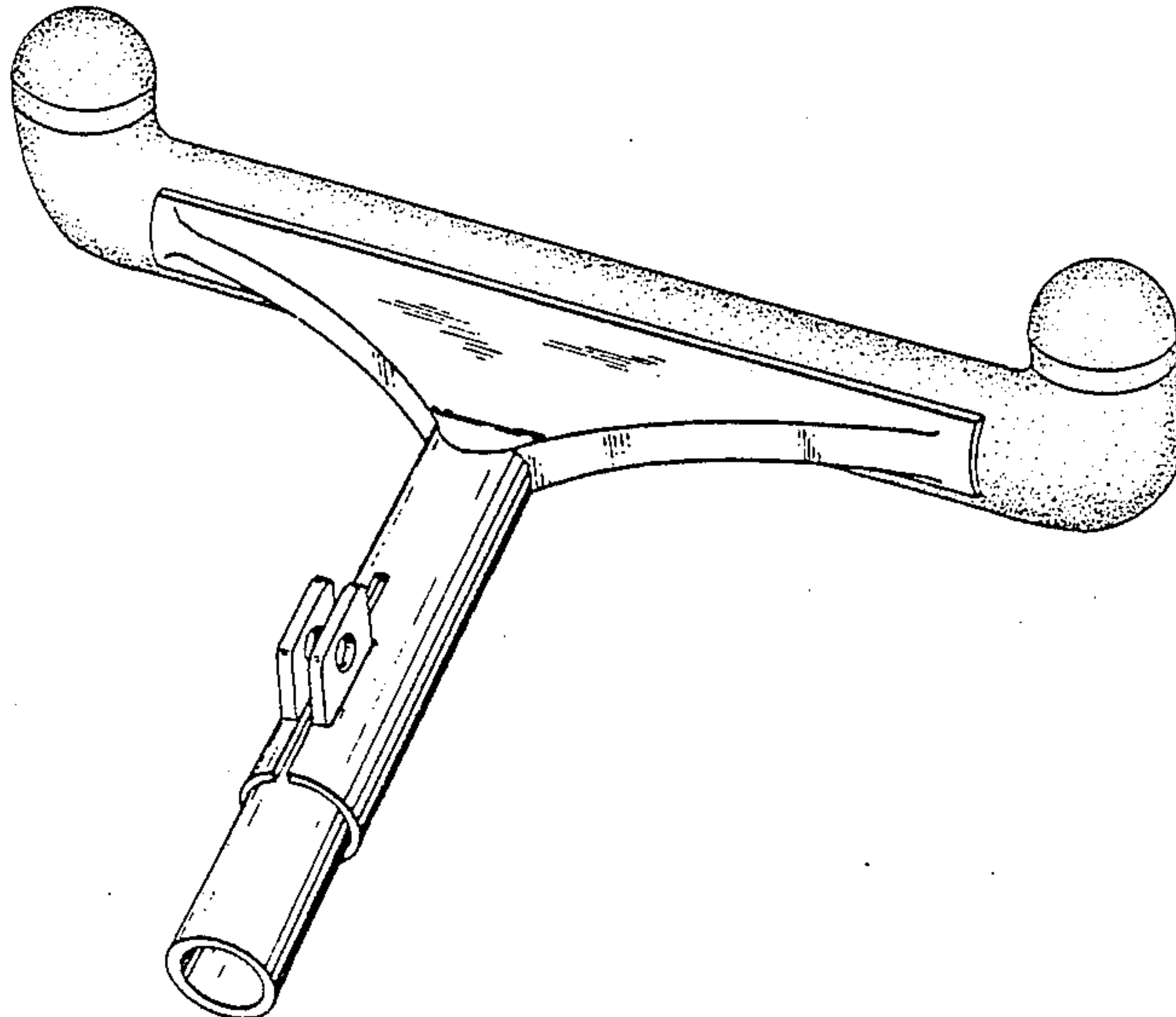

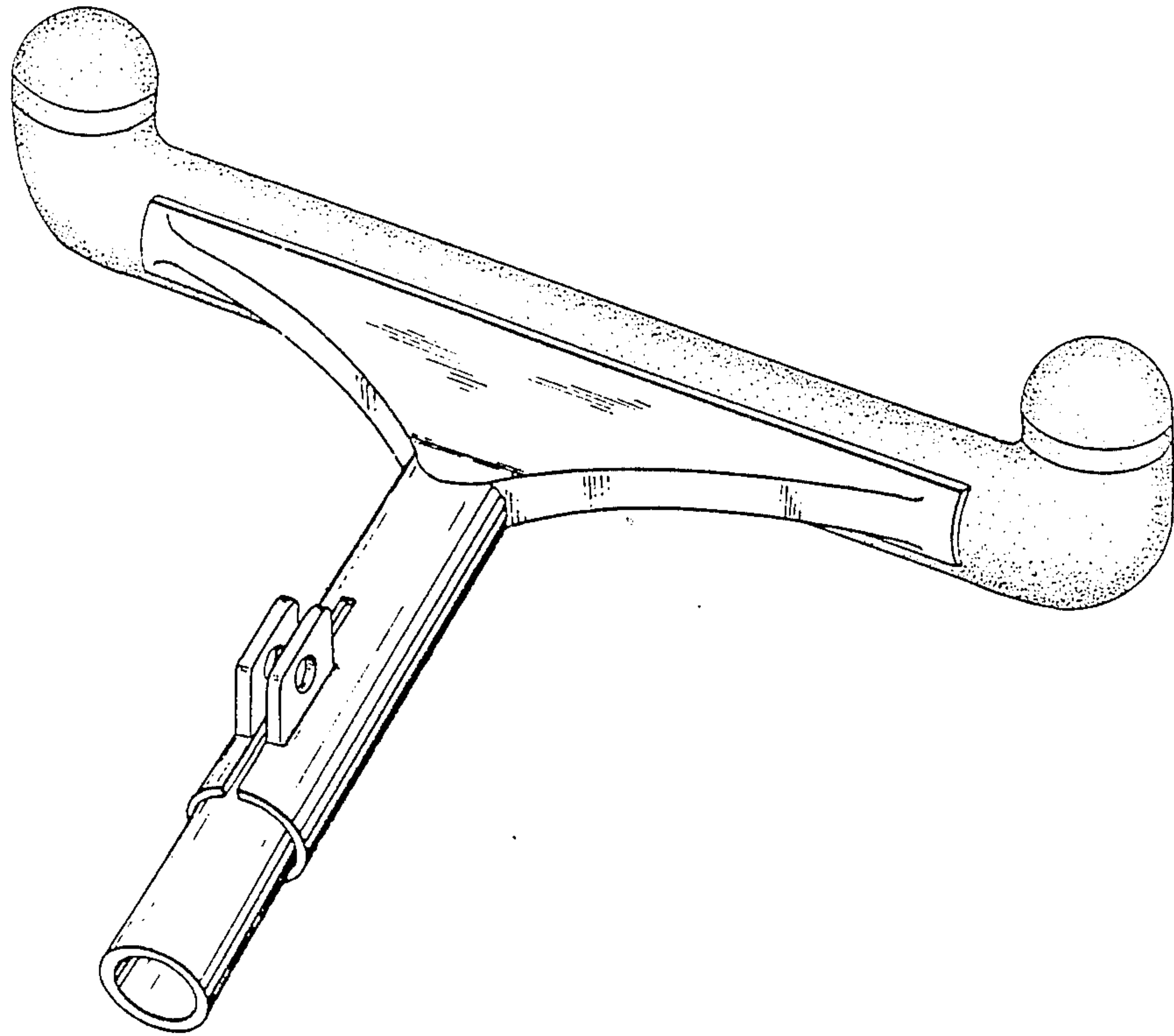

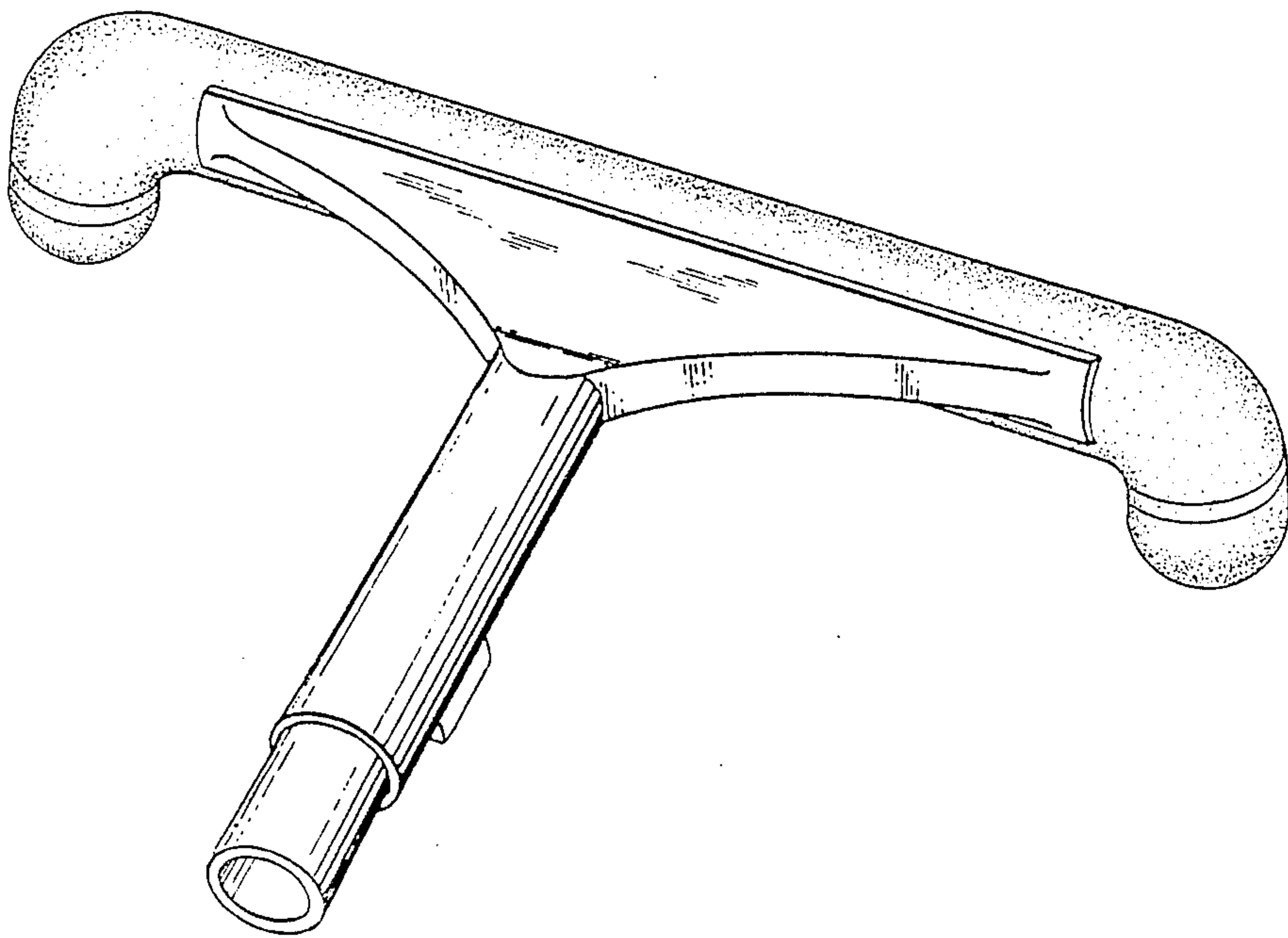
