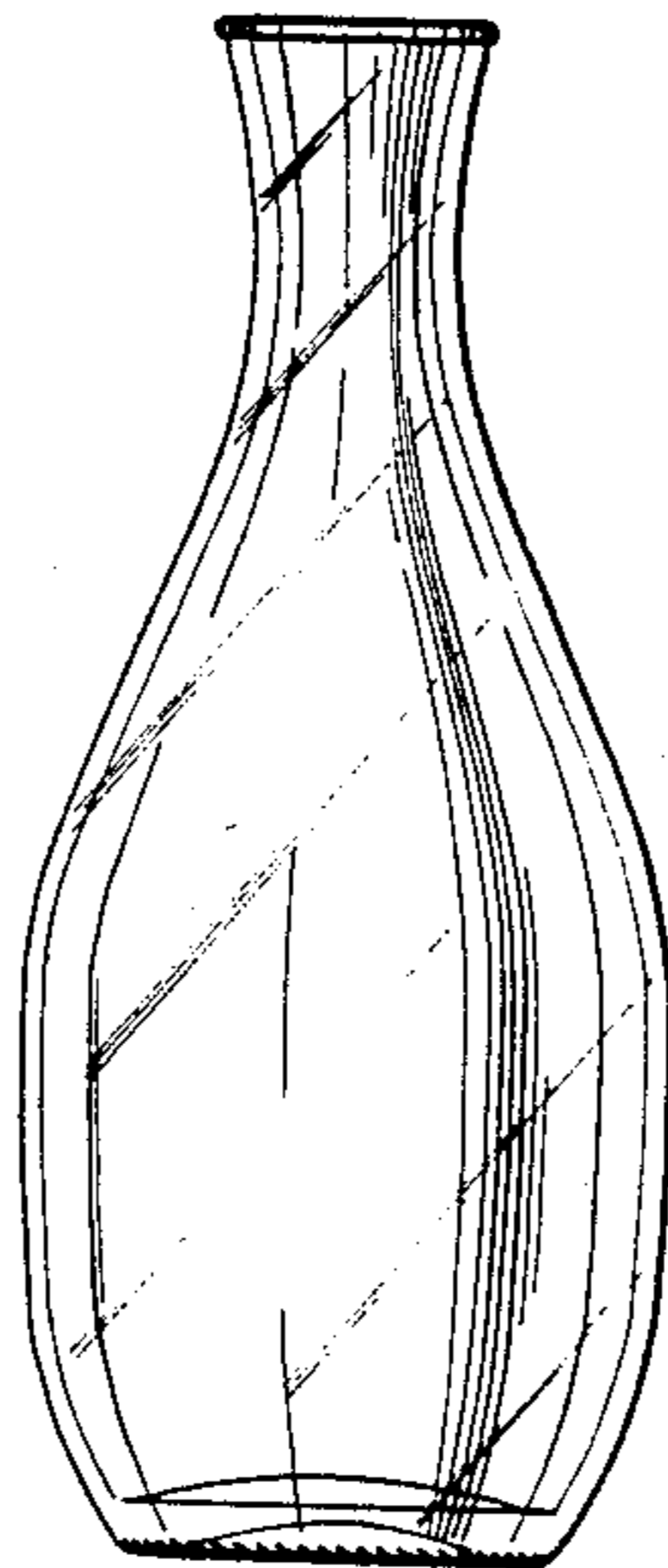

FIG. 4 is an elevational view partly in section.



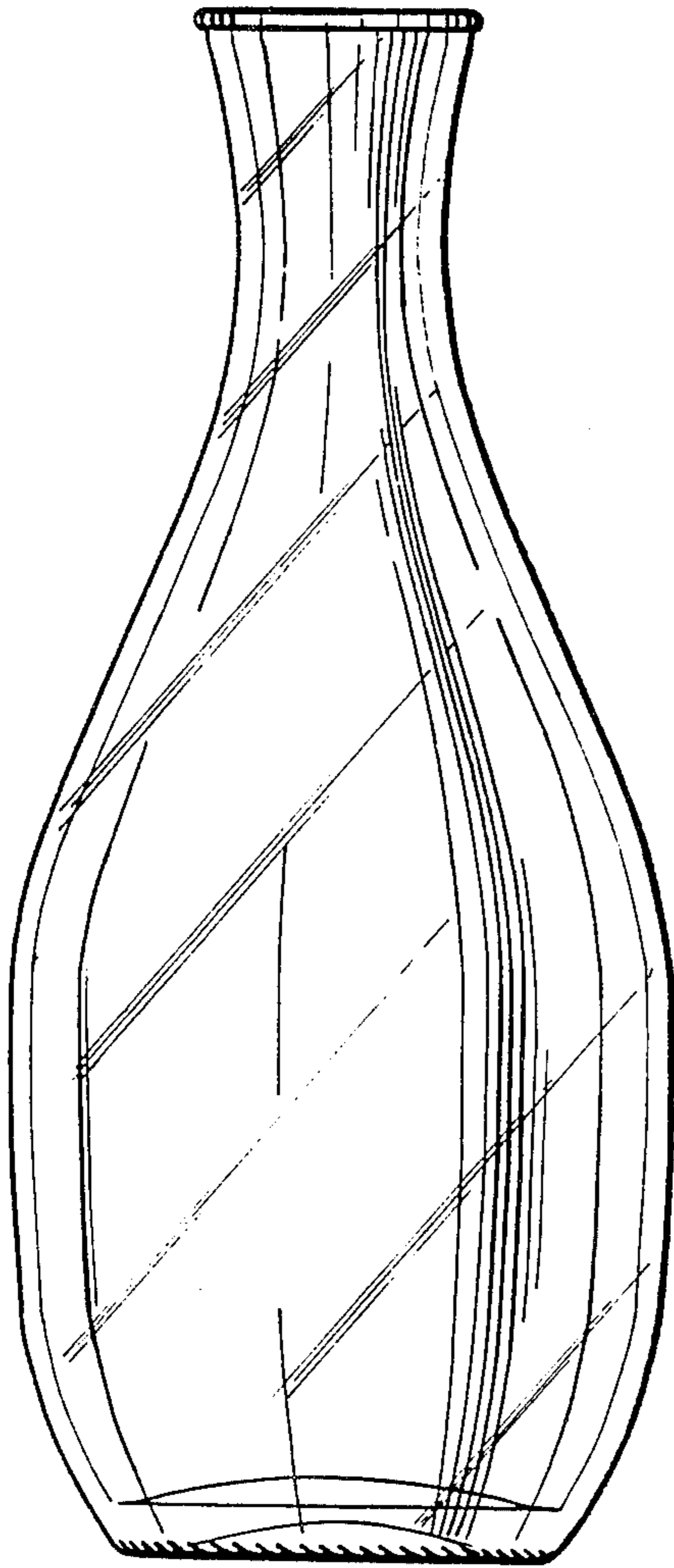

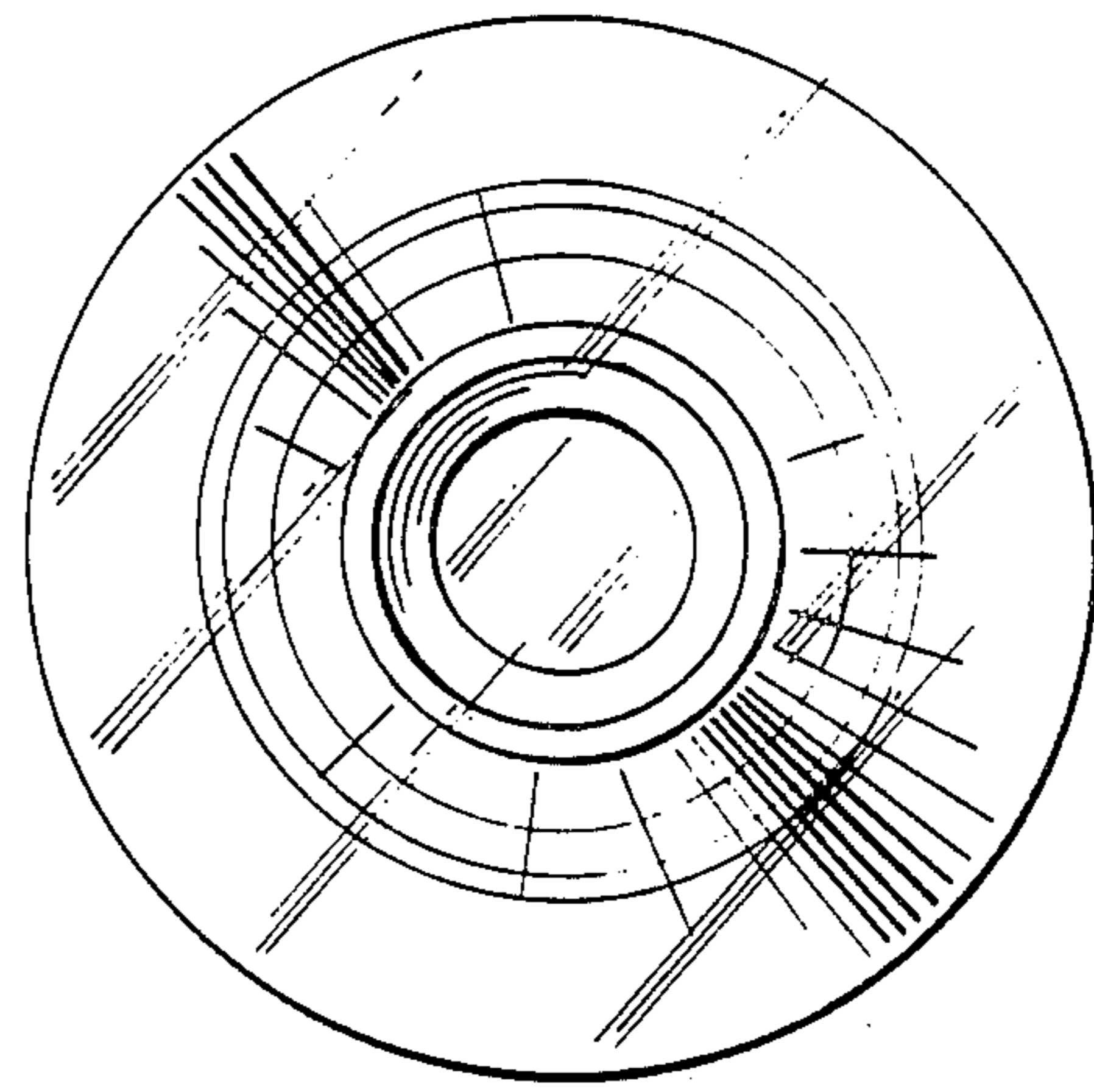

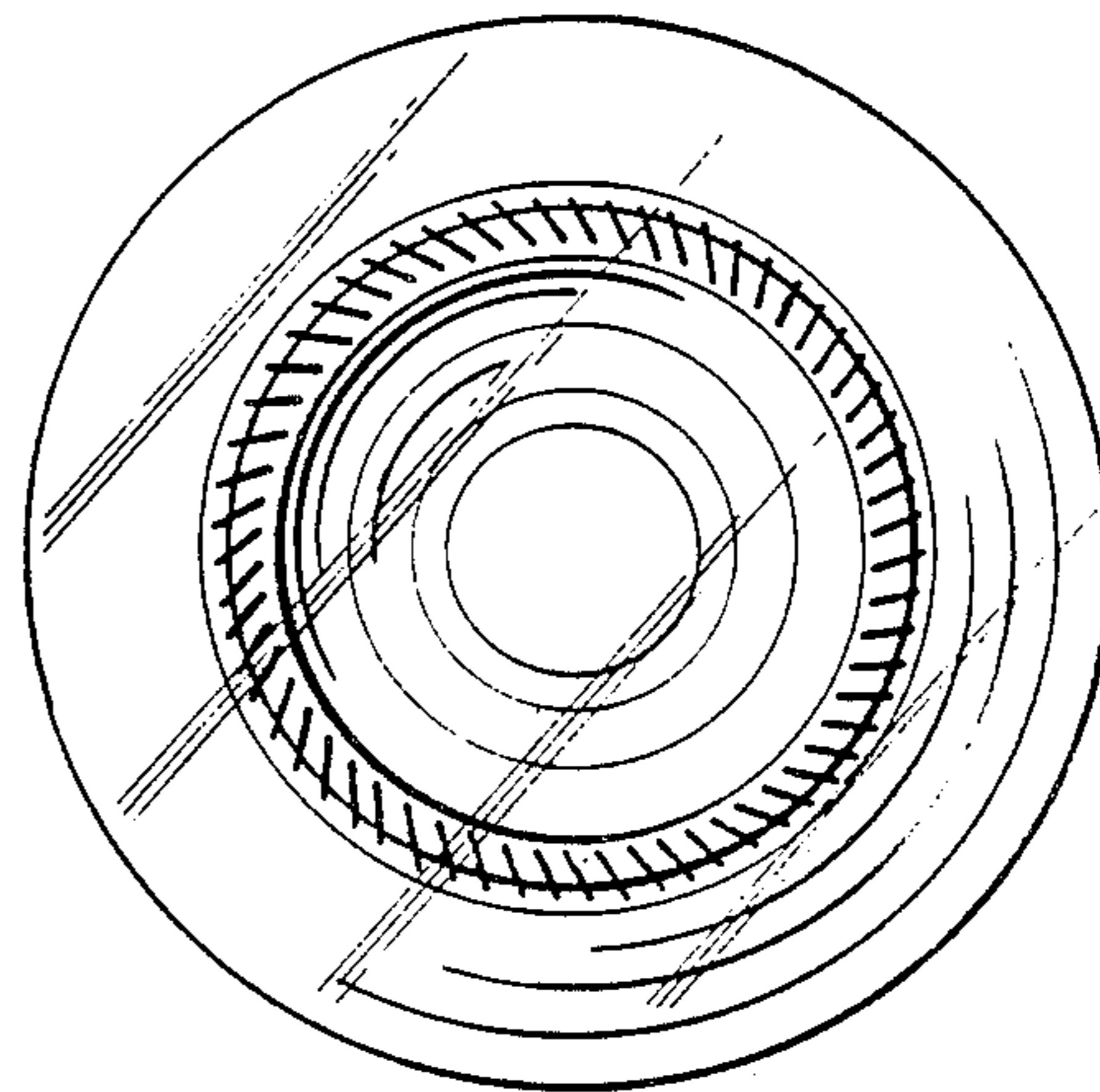

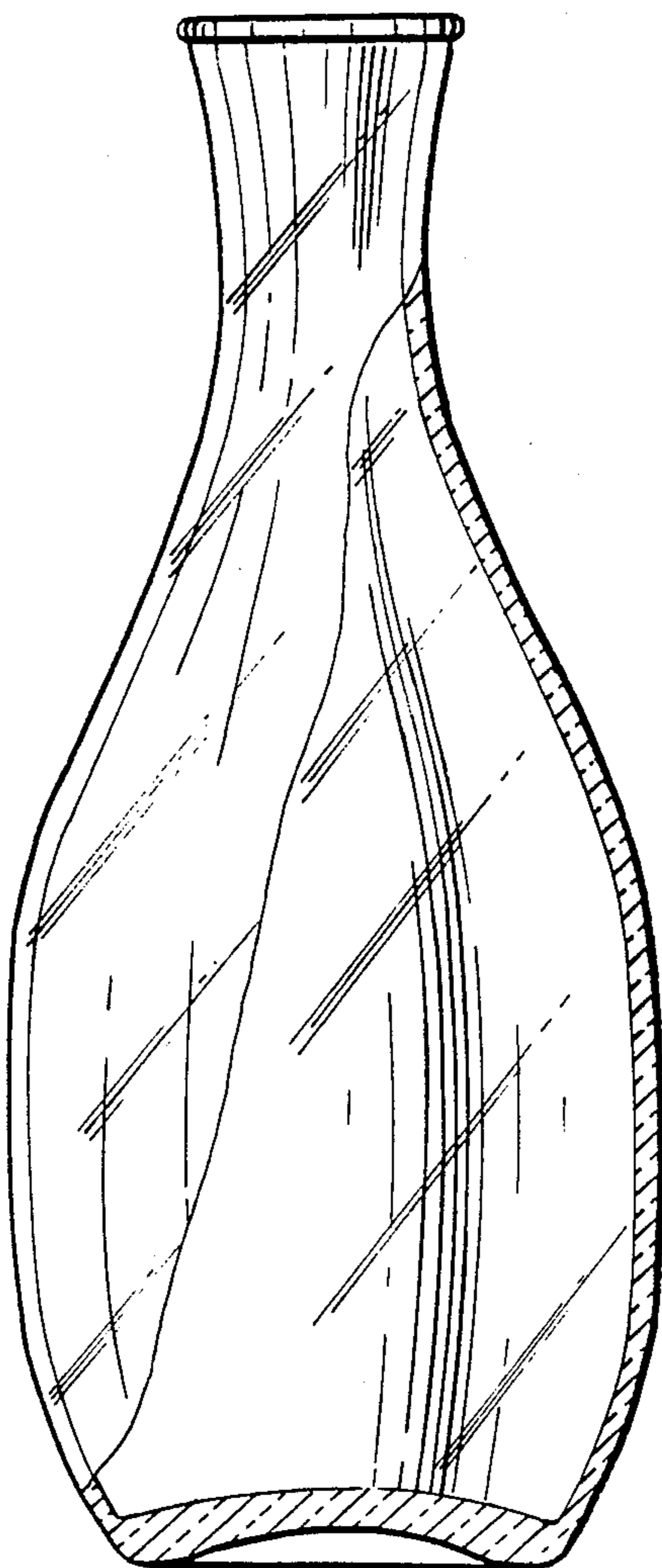
