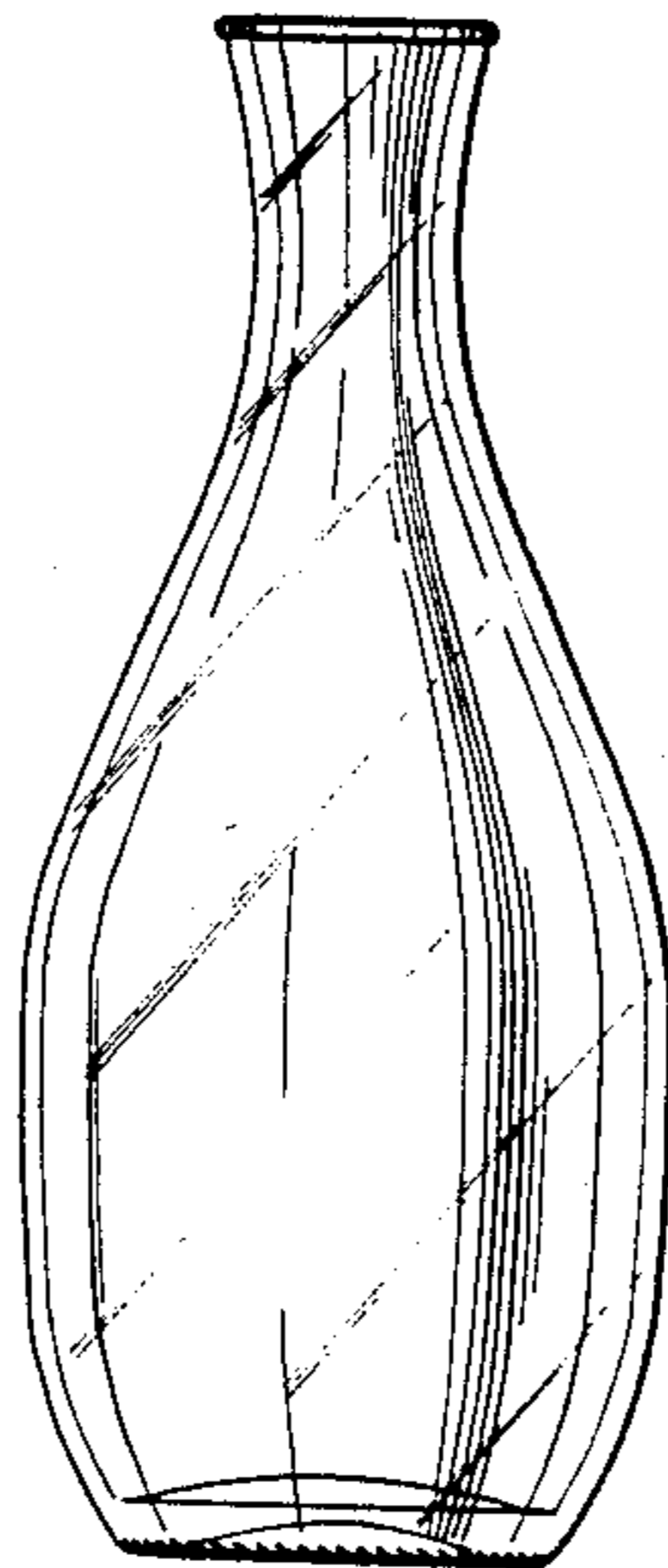

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a carafe showing my new design, the opposite side being the same in appearance;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view; and
FIG. 4 is an elevational view partly in section.



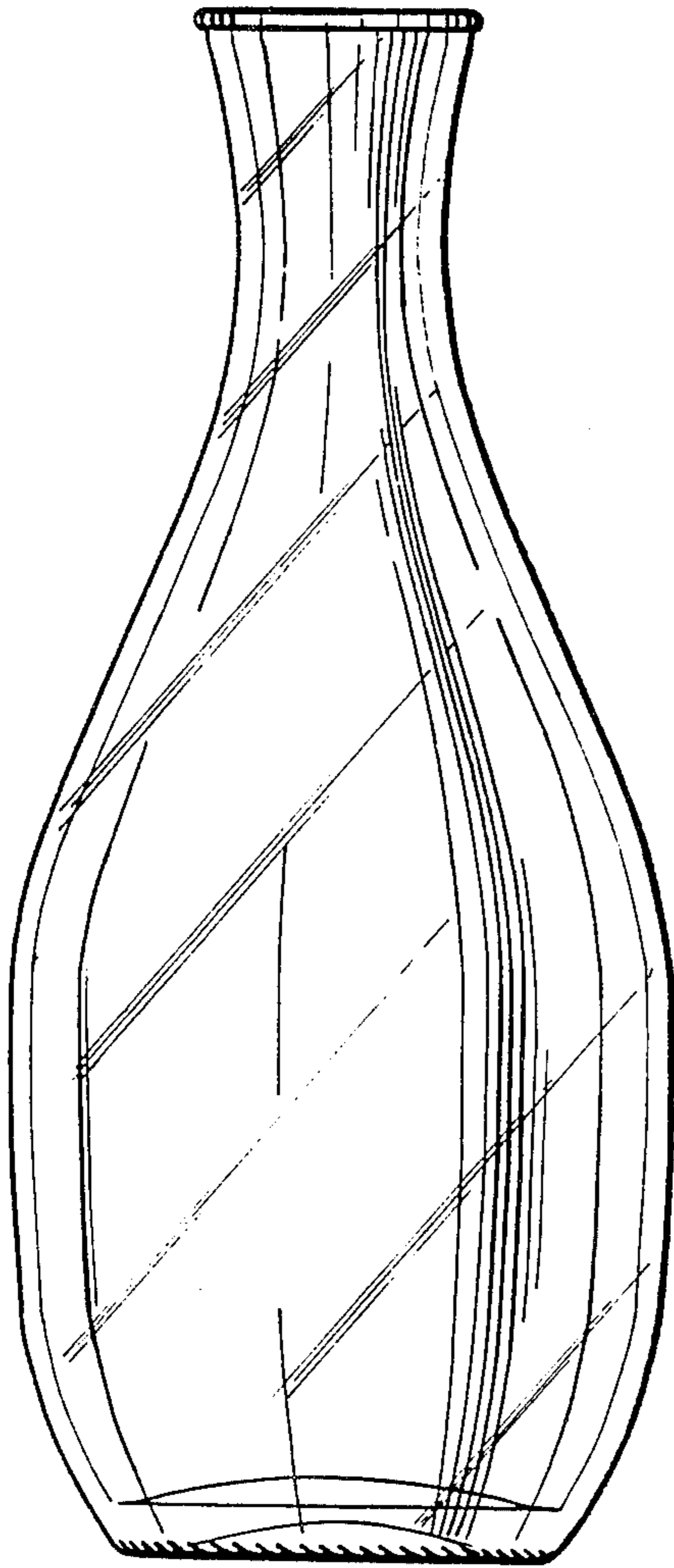

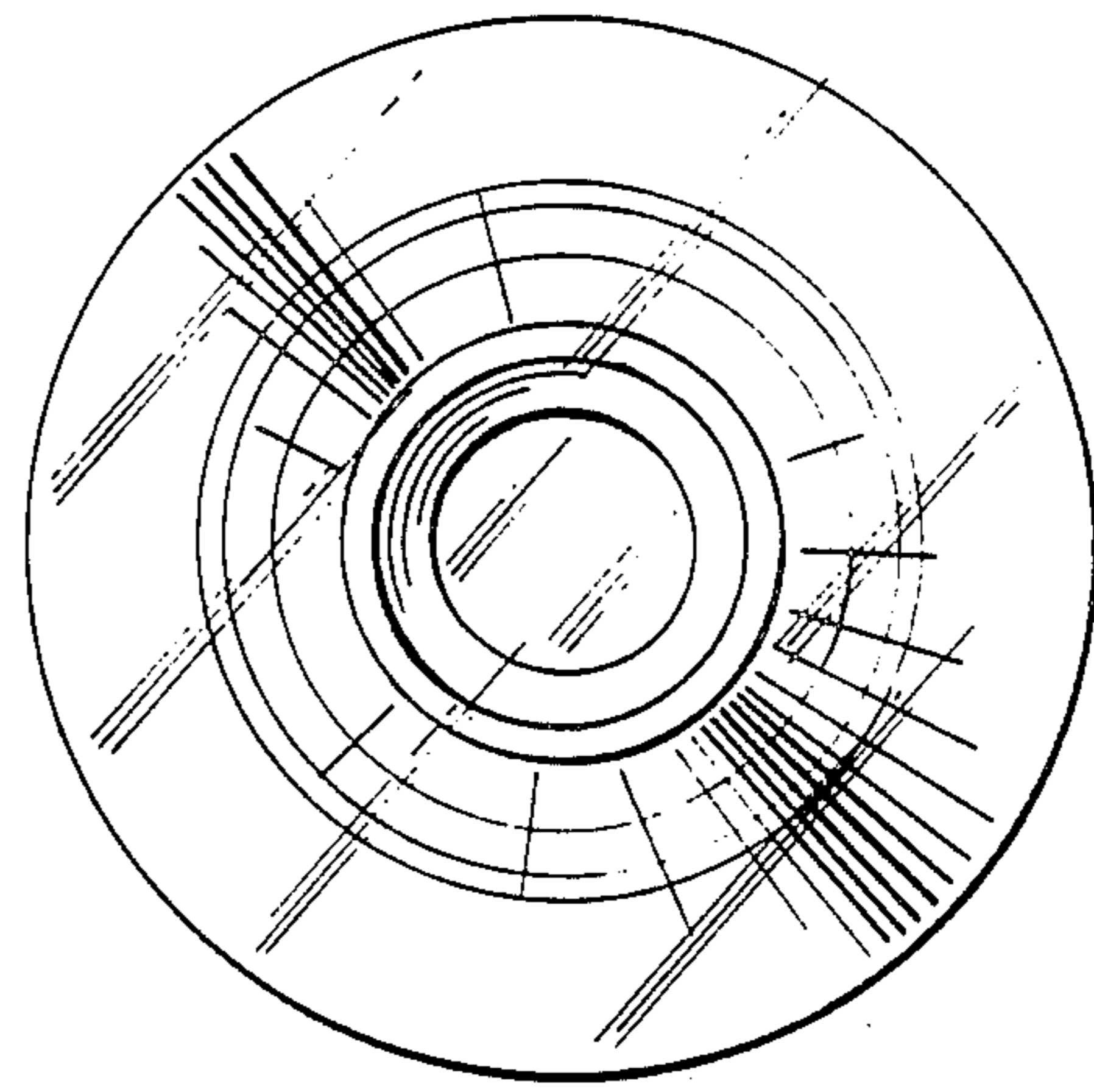

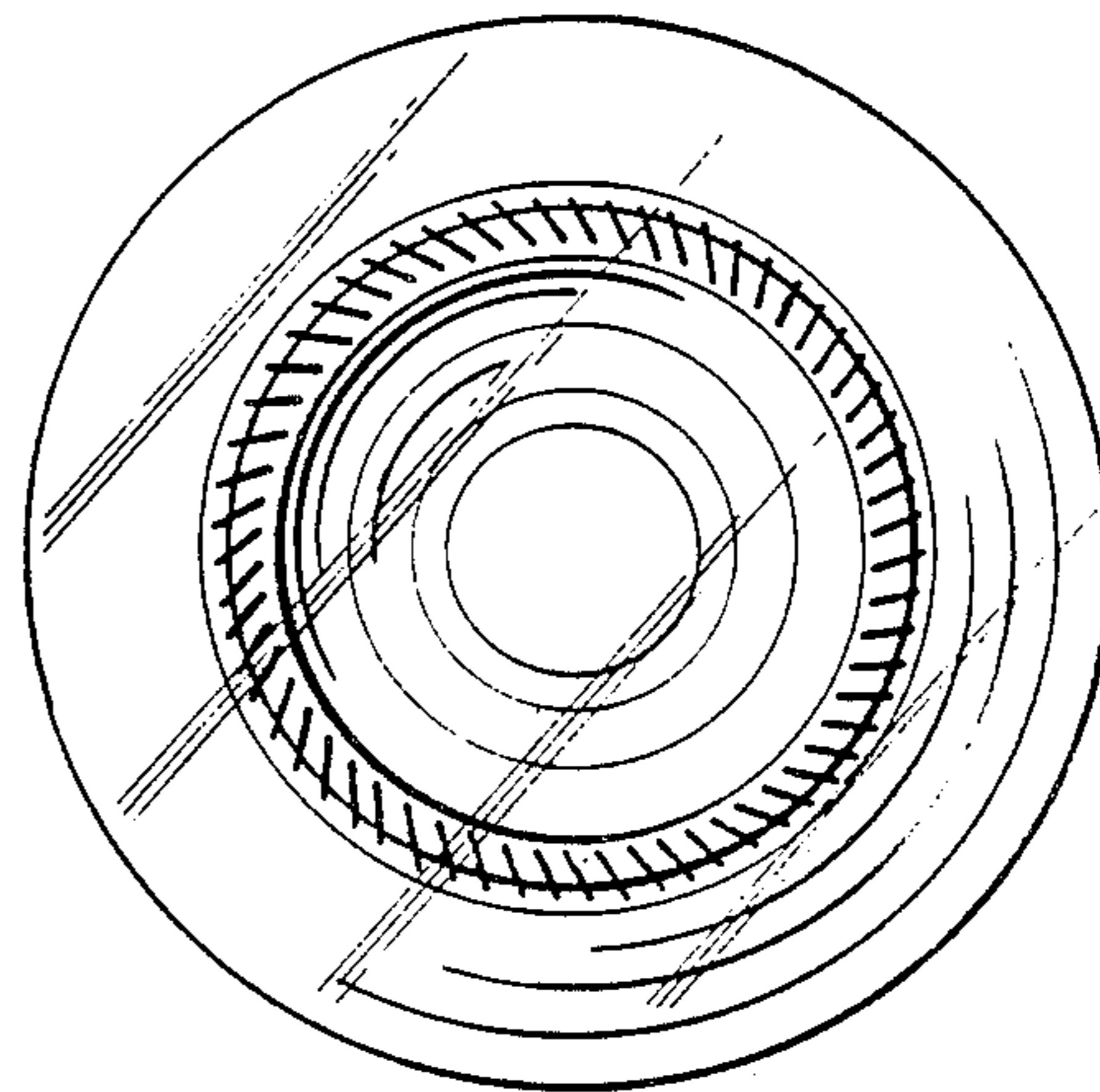

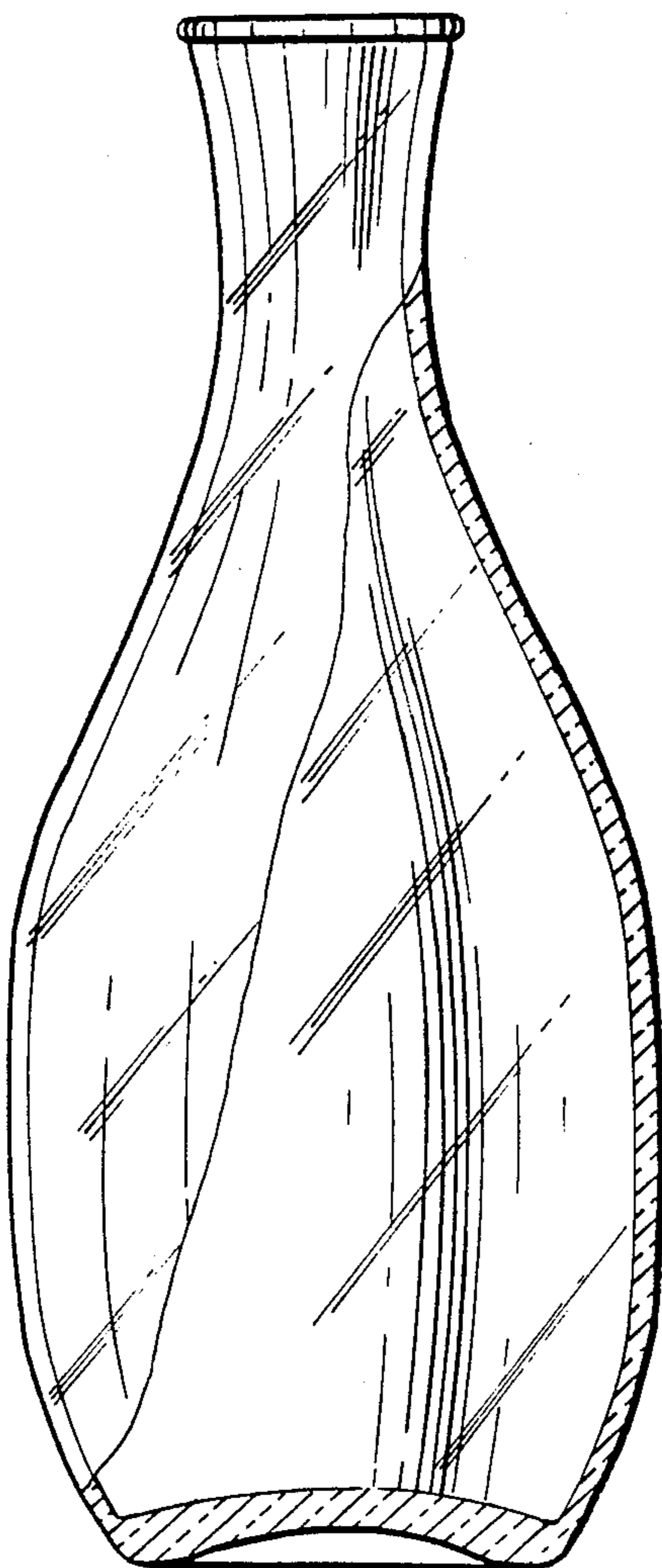
