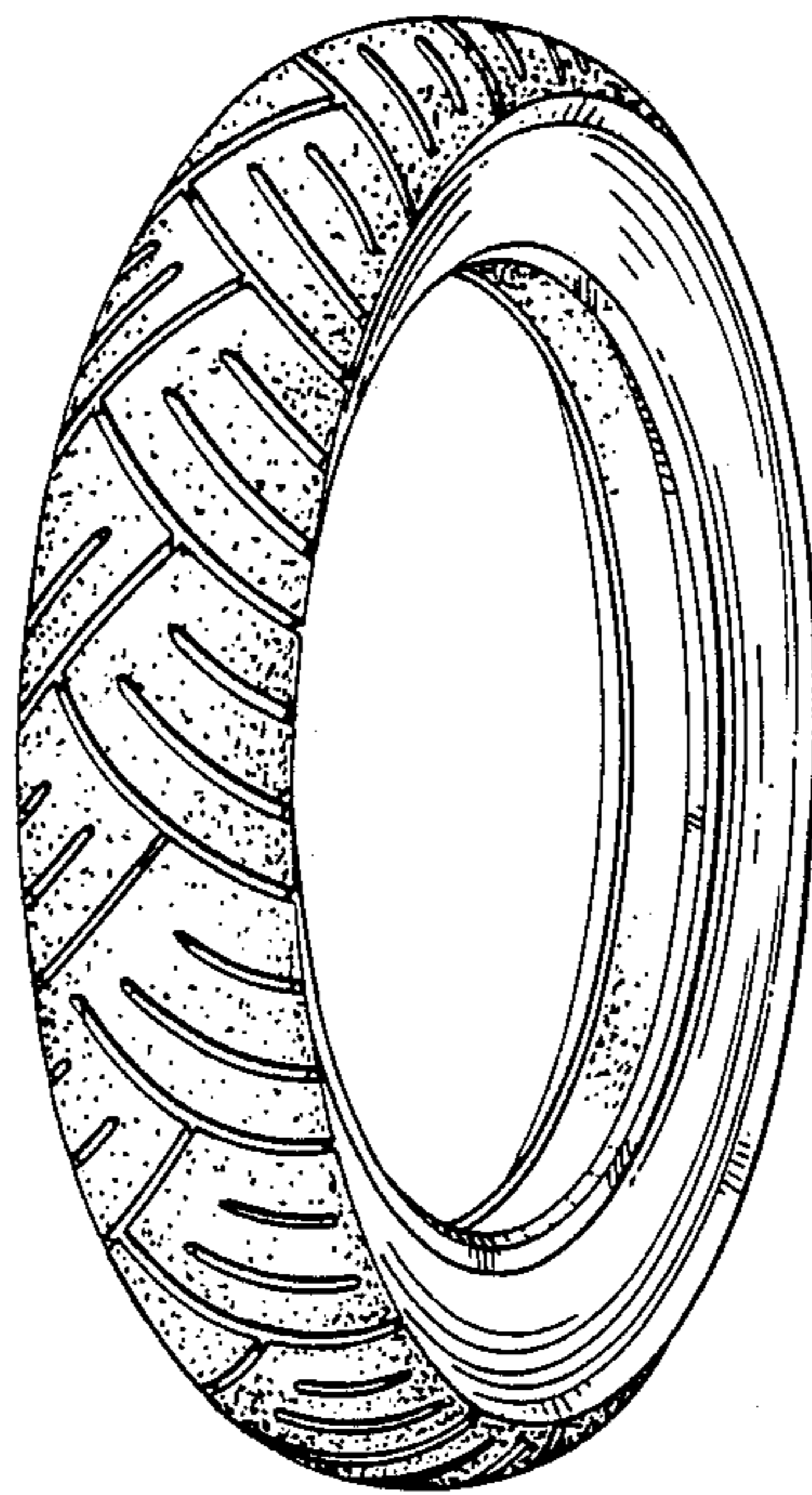

FIG. 4 is a perspective view thereof, it being understood that the tread pattern is repeated uniformly throughout the circumference of the tire.



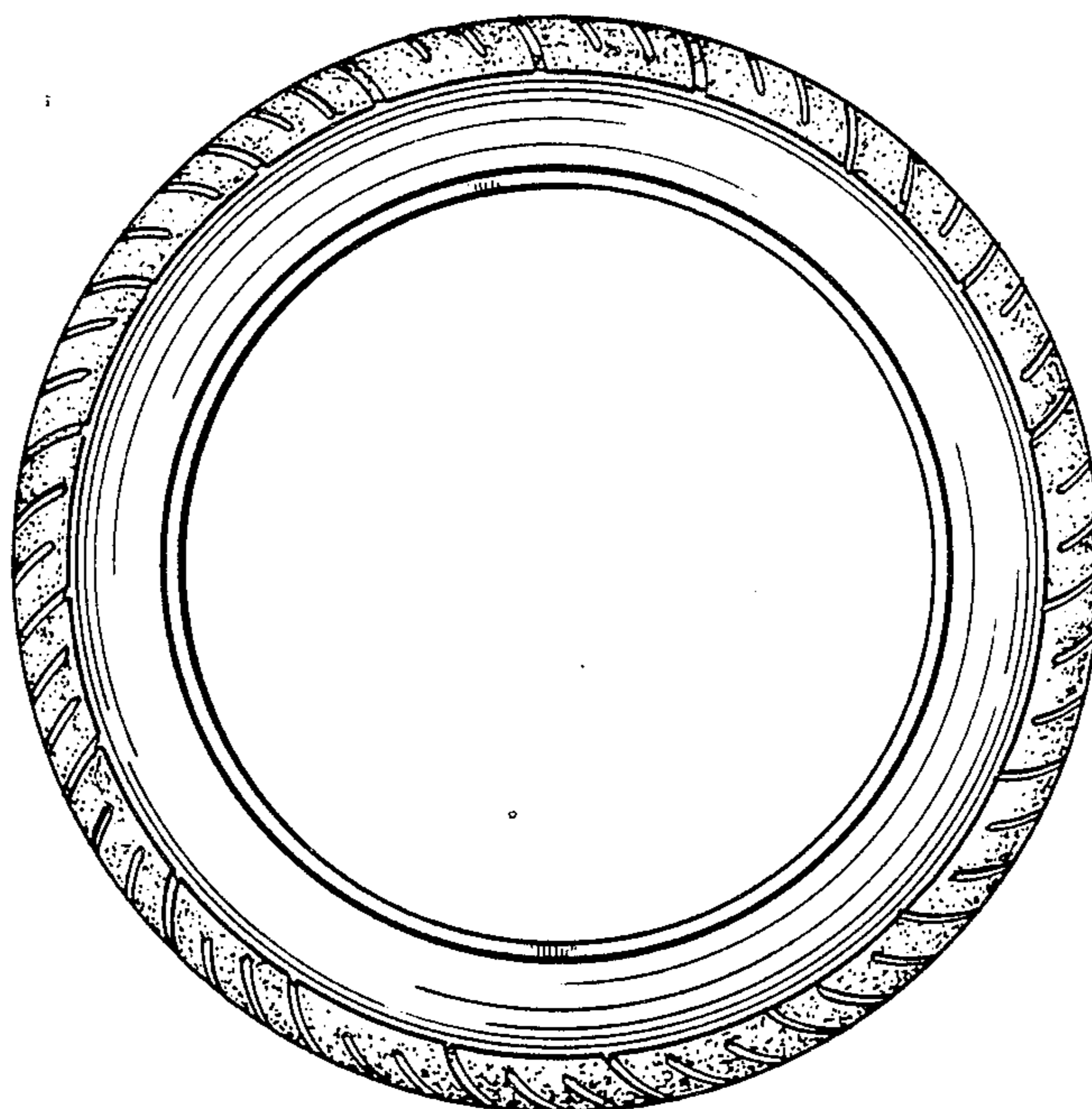

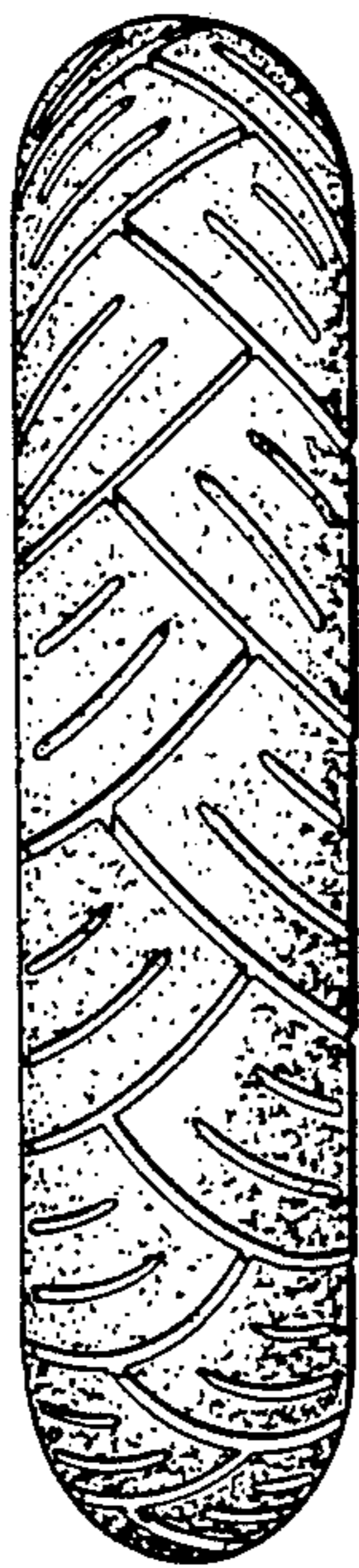

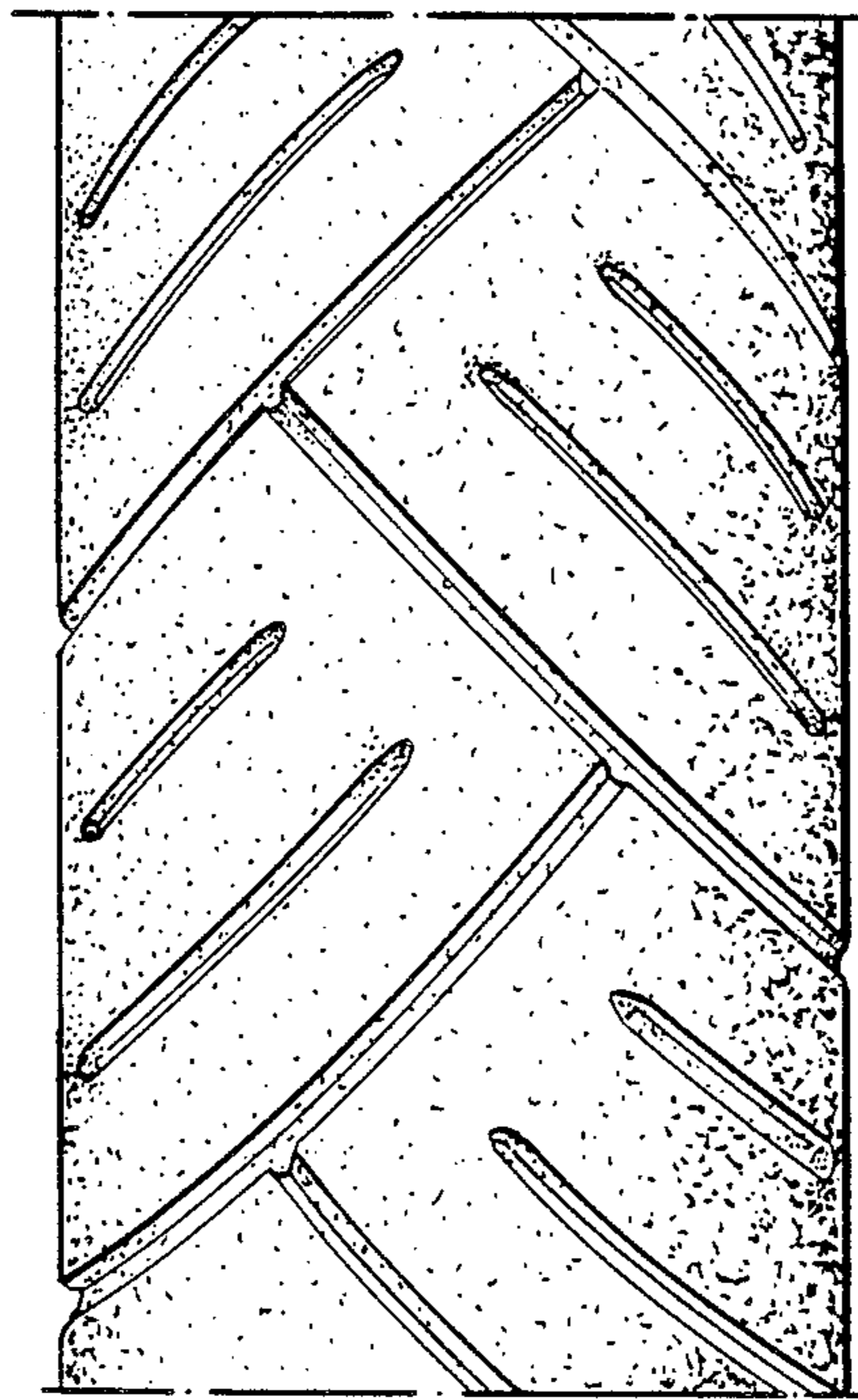

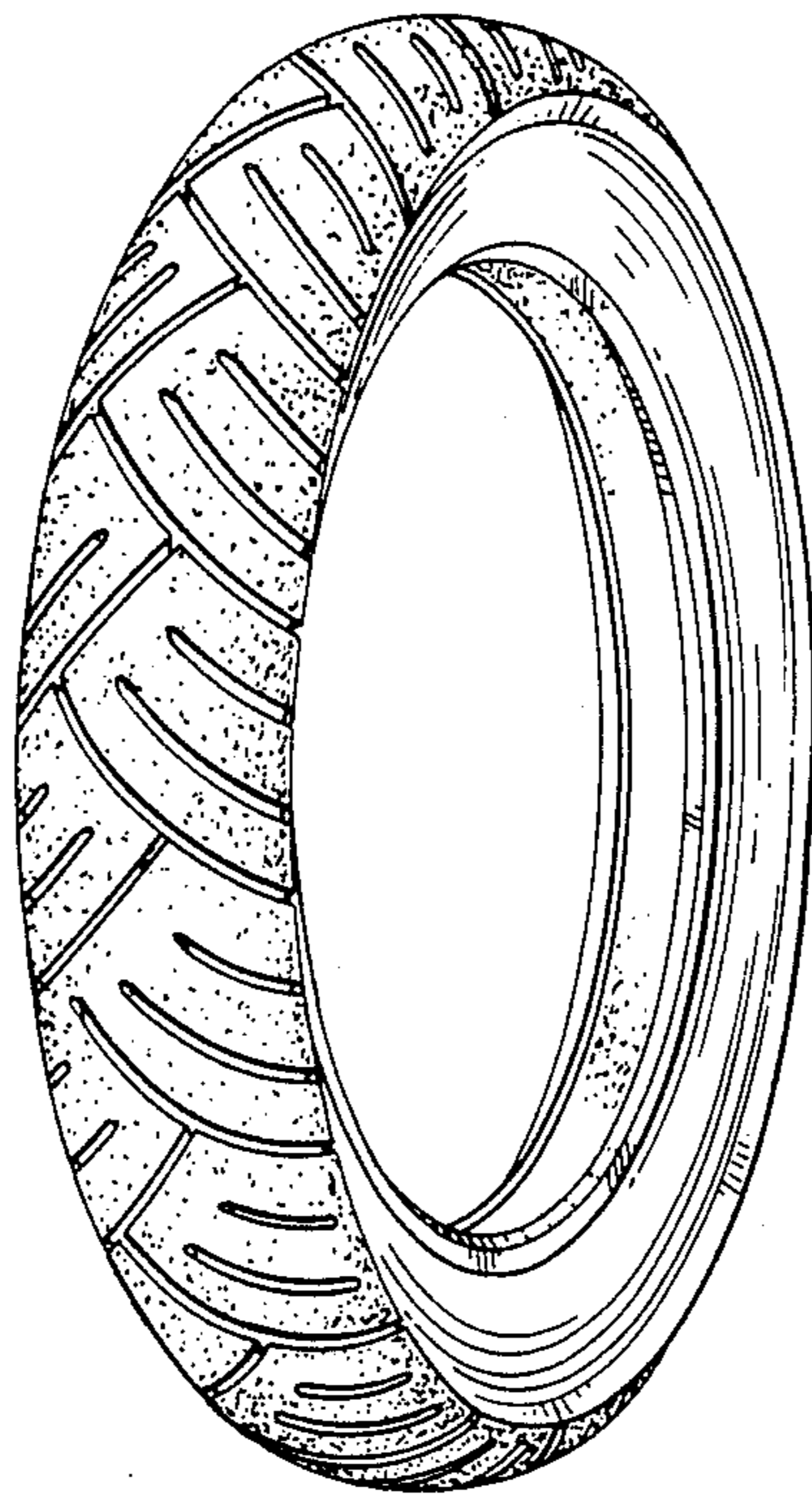
