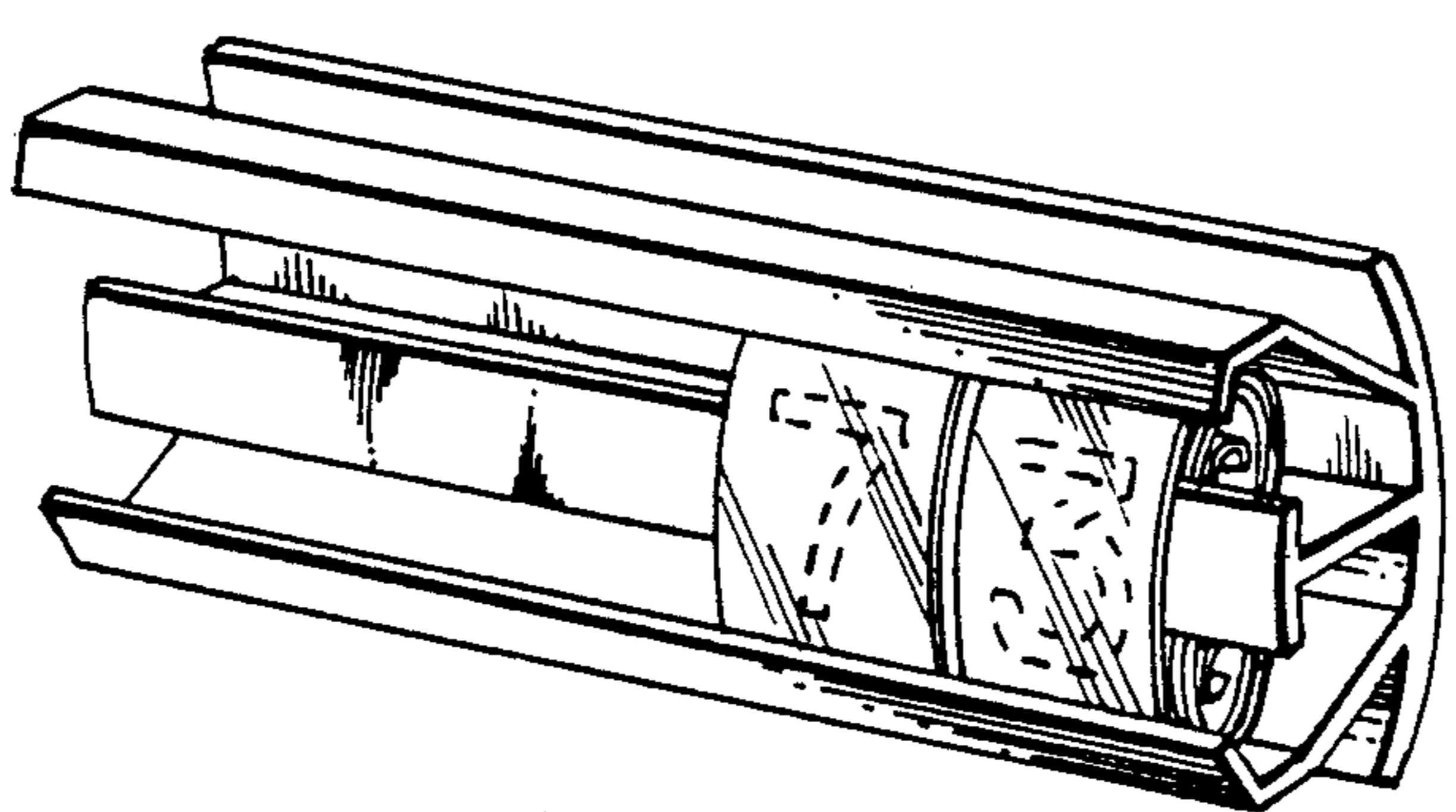

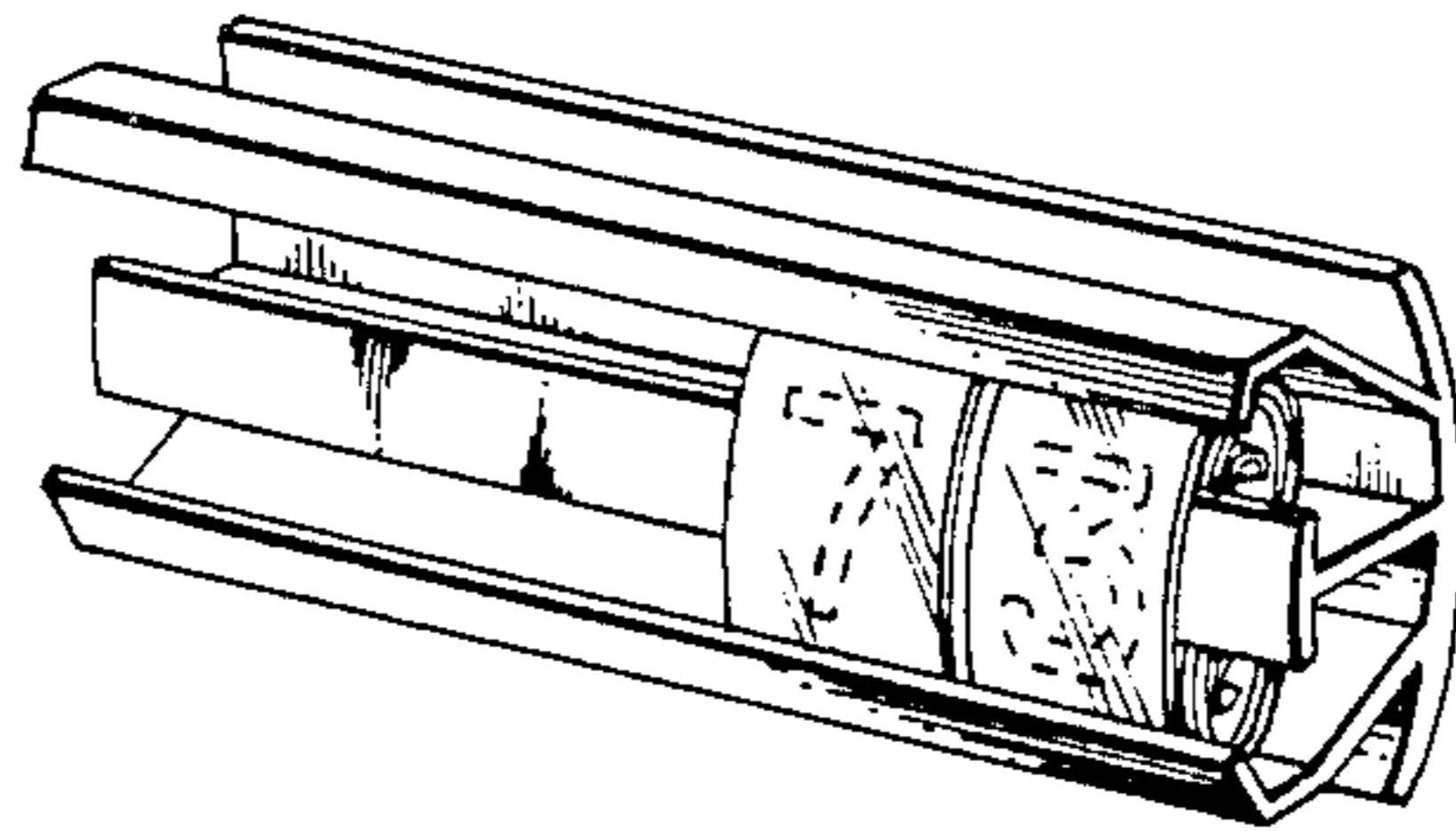
The ornamental design for a merchandising indicator, as shown and described.

### DESCRIPTION

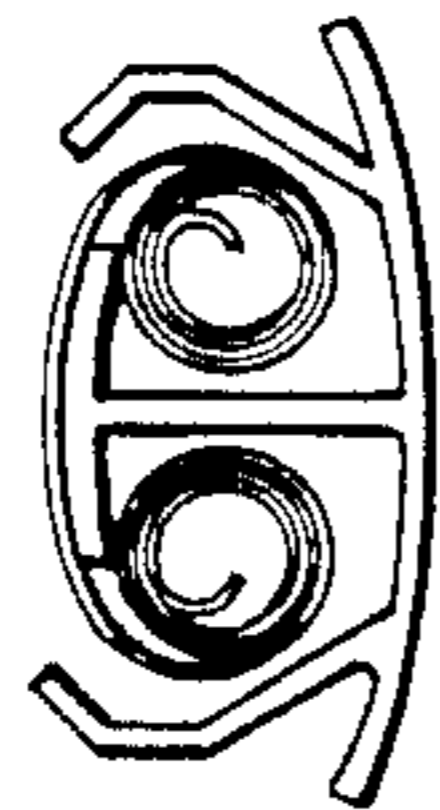
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a merchandising indicator showing my new design;

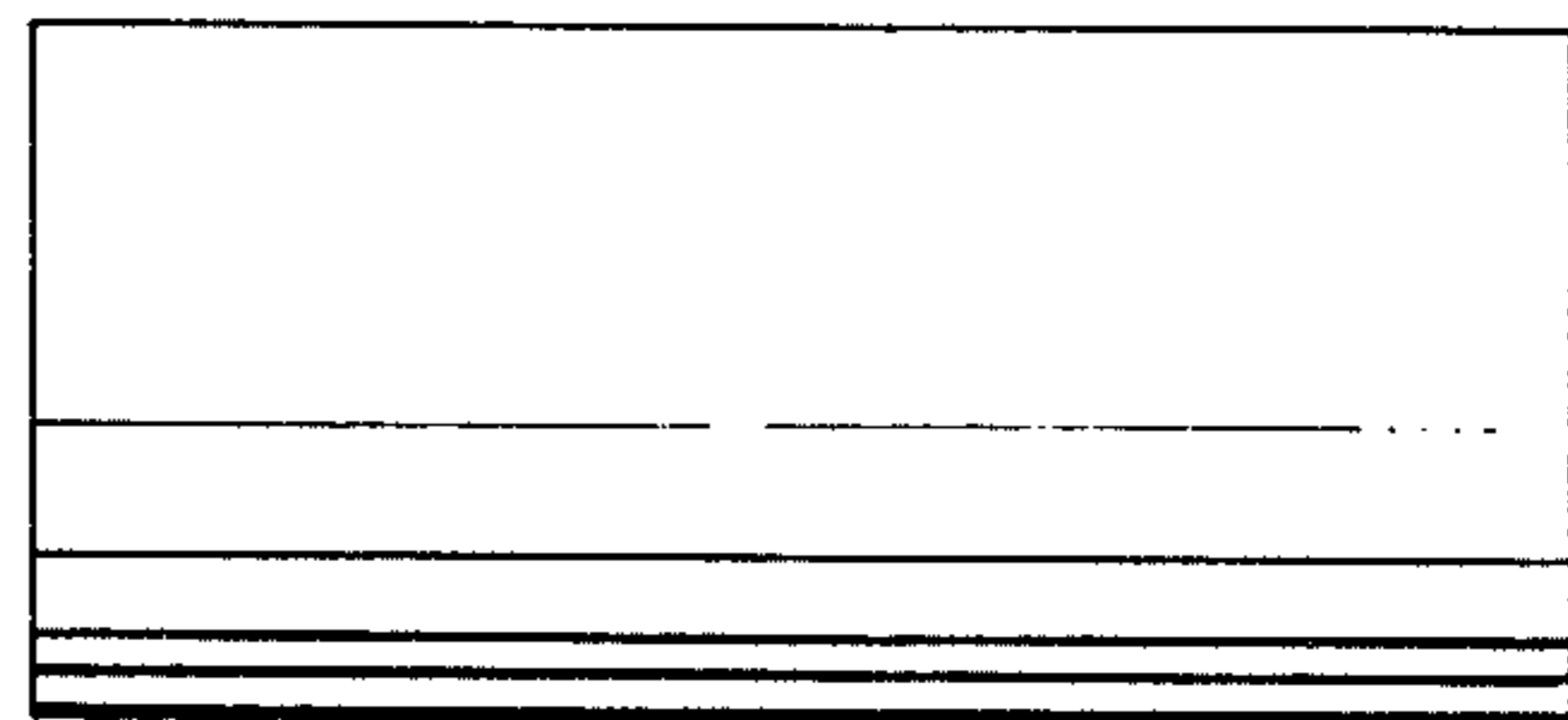




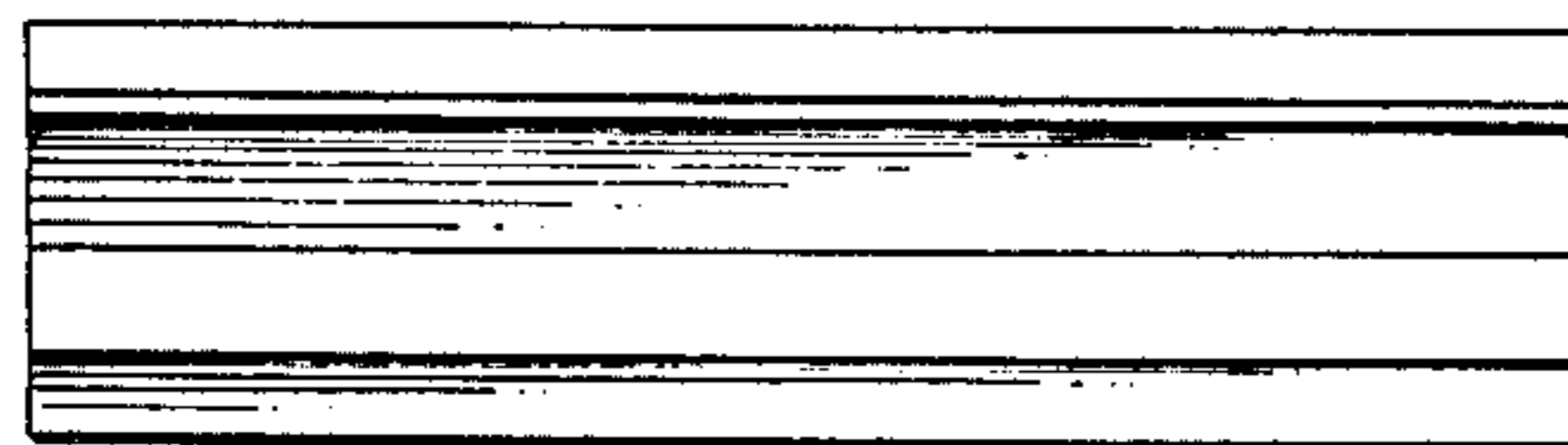
