The ornamental design for a handbag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a handbag showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof with the flap in a closed condition;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof taken along arrow #6 in FIG. 2;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a modified embodiment of the design shown in FIGS. 1 through 6;

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 12 is a side elevational view thereof taken along arrow #6 in FIG. 2.

Portions of the strap member have been shown in fragment in FIGS. 2 through 6 and 8 through 12 for ease of illustration.

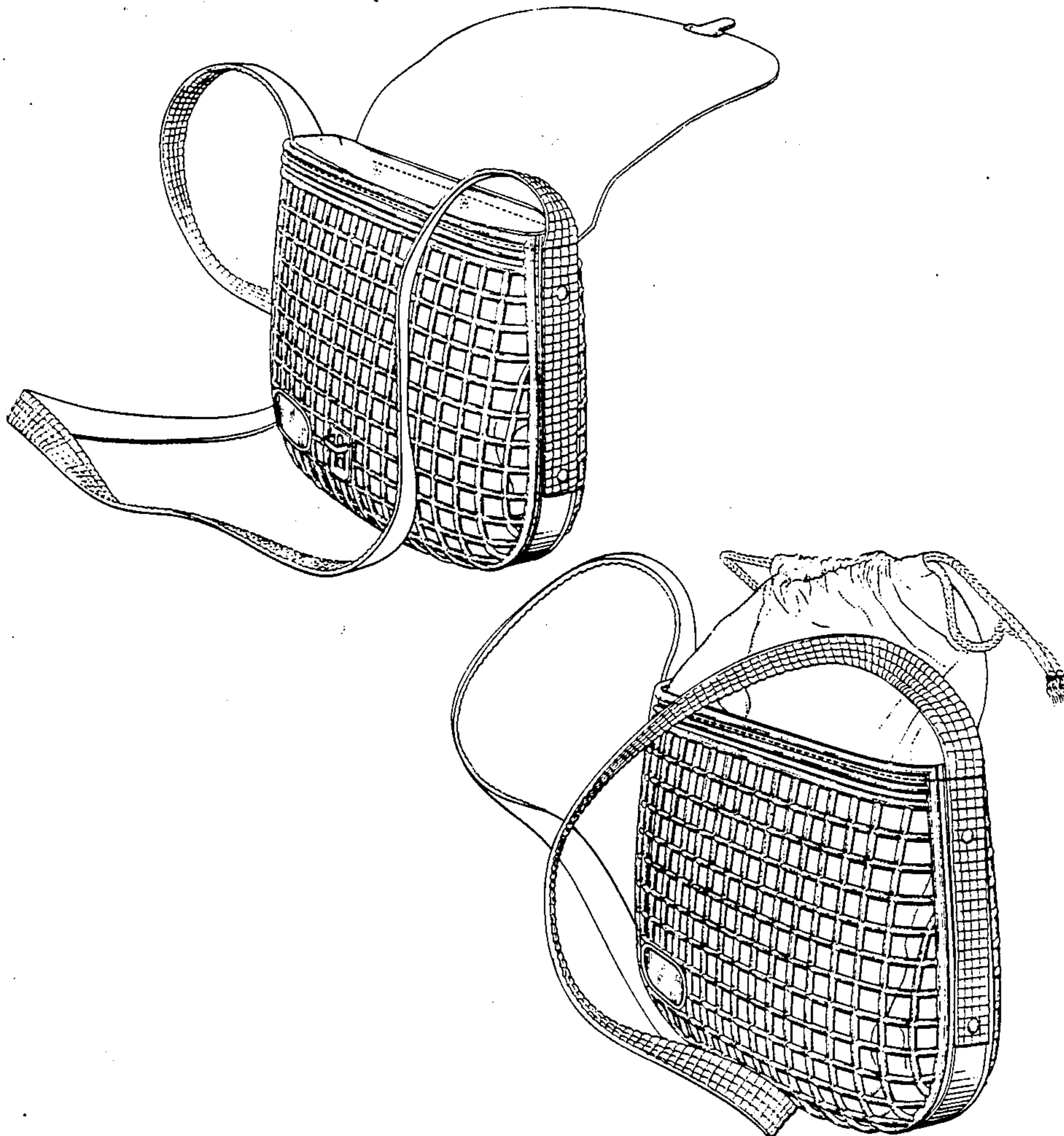

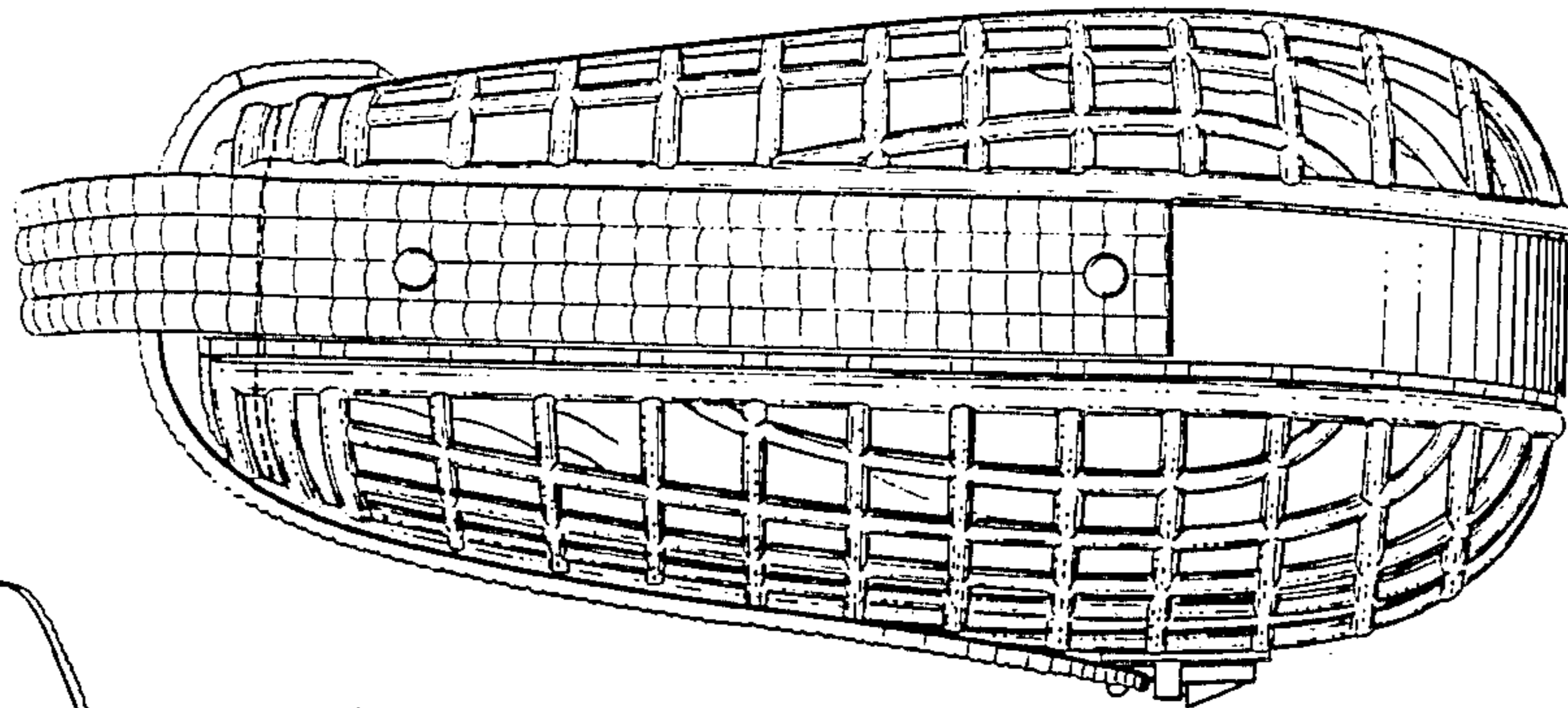

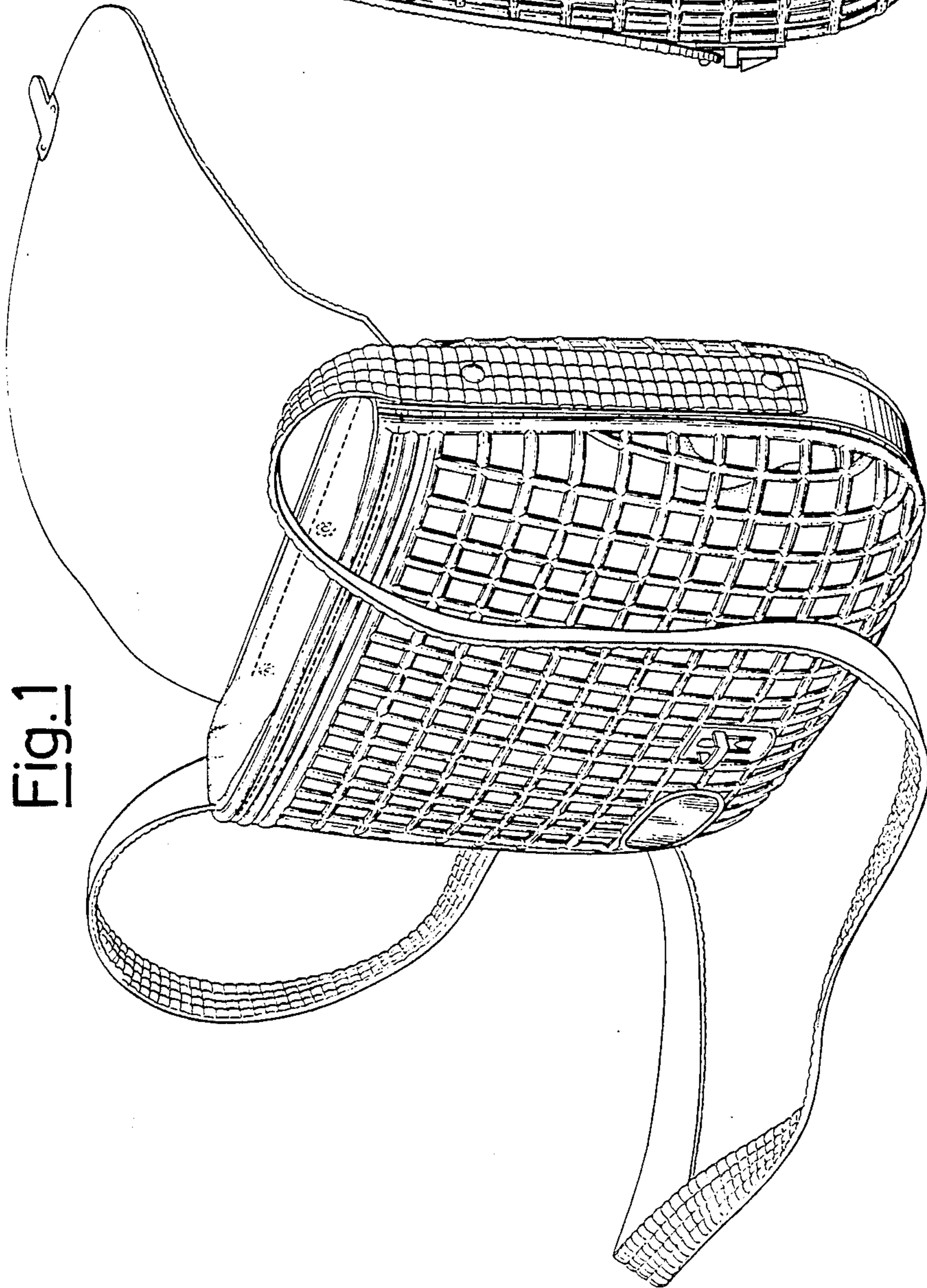

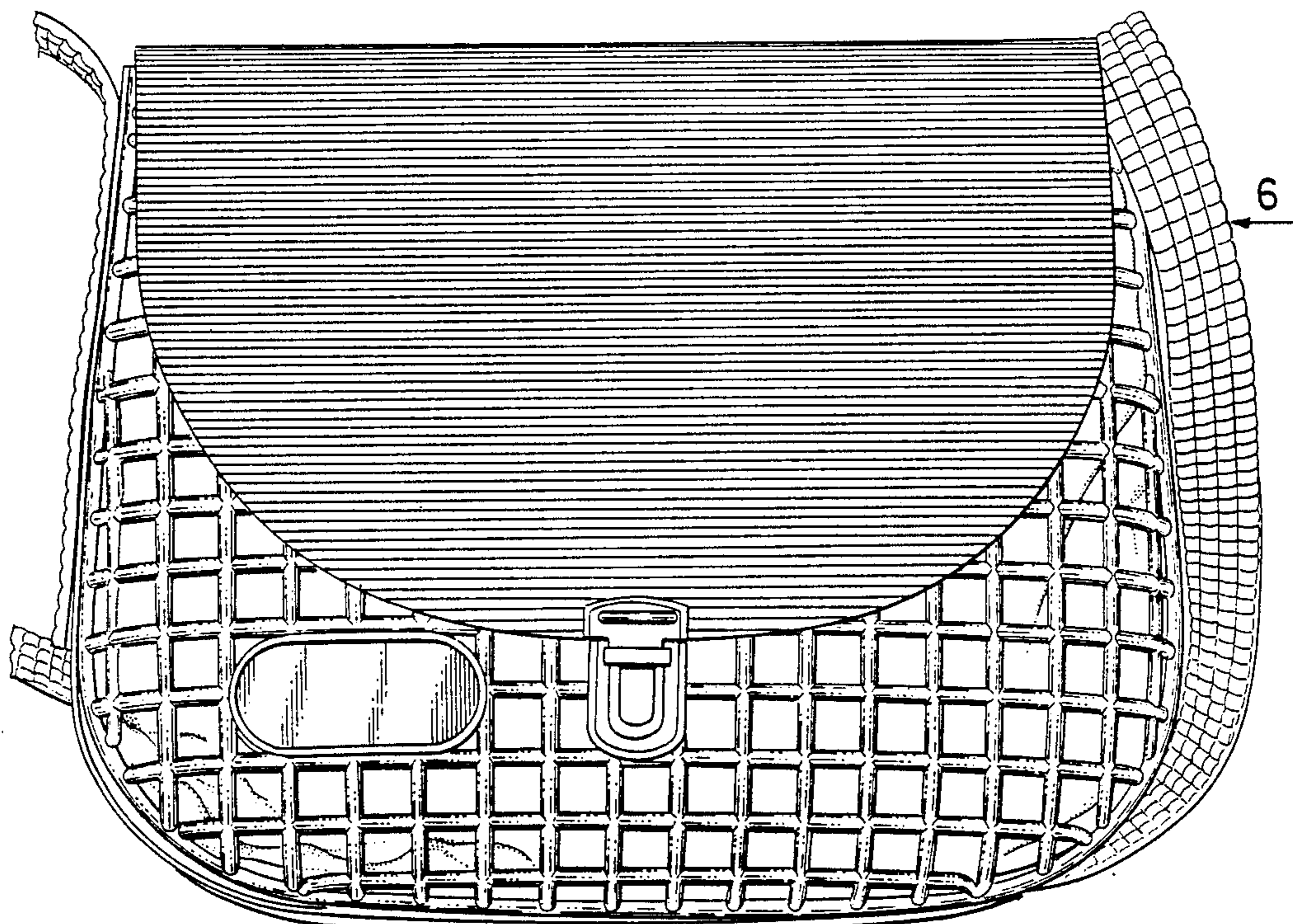

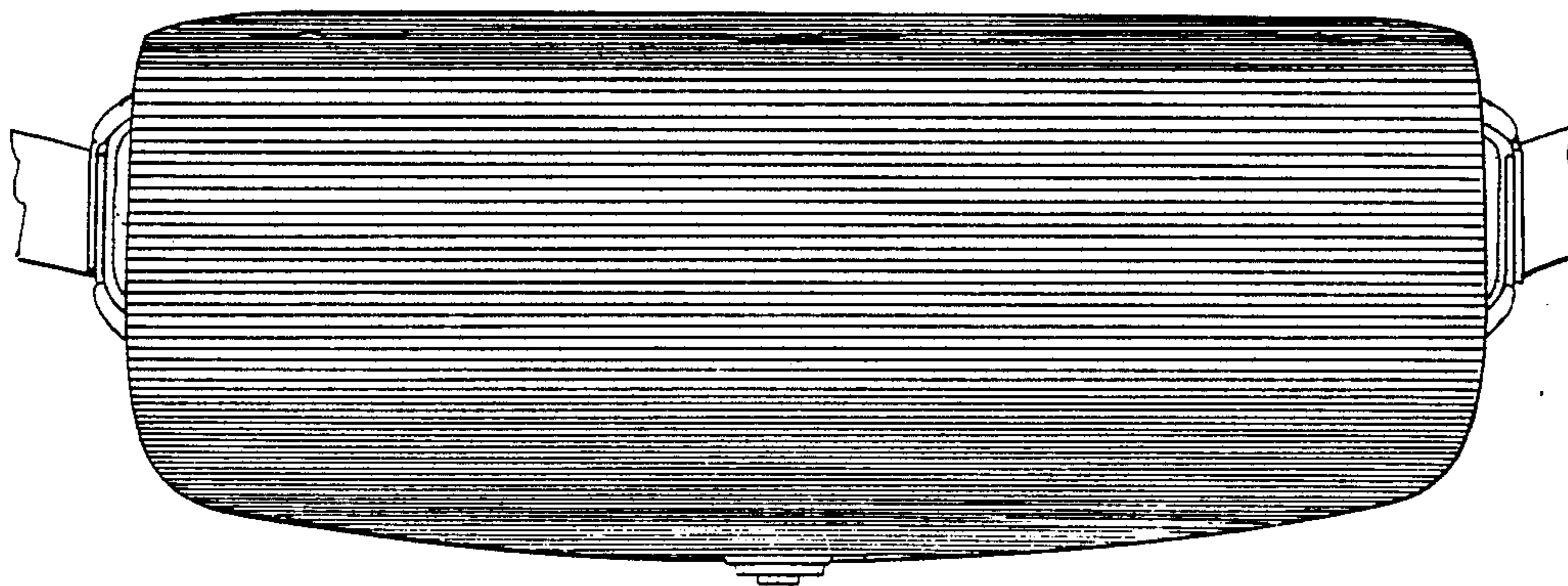

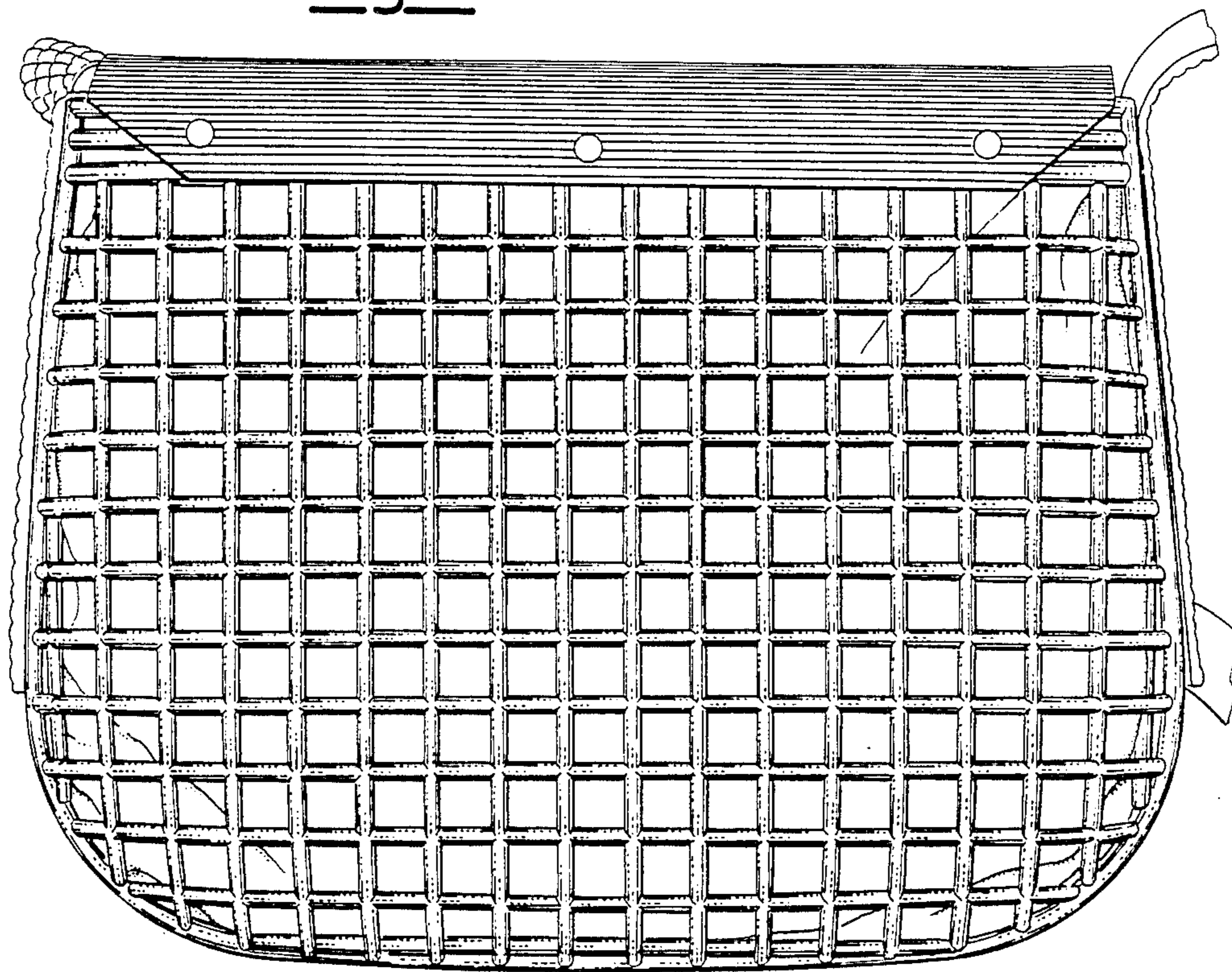

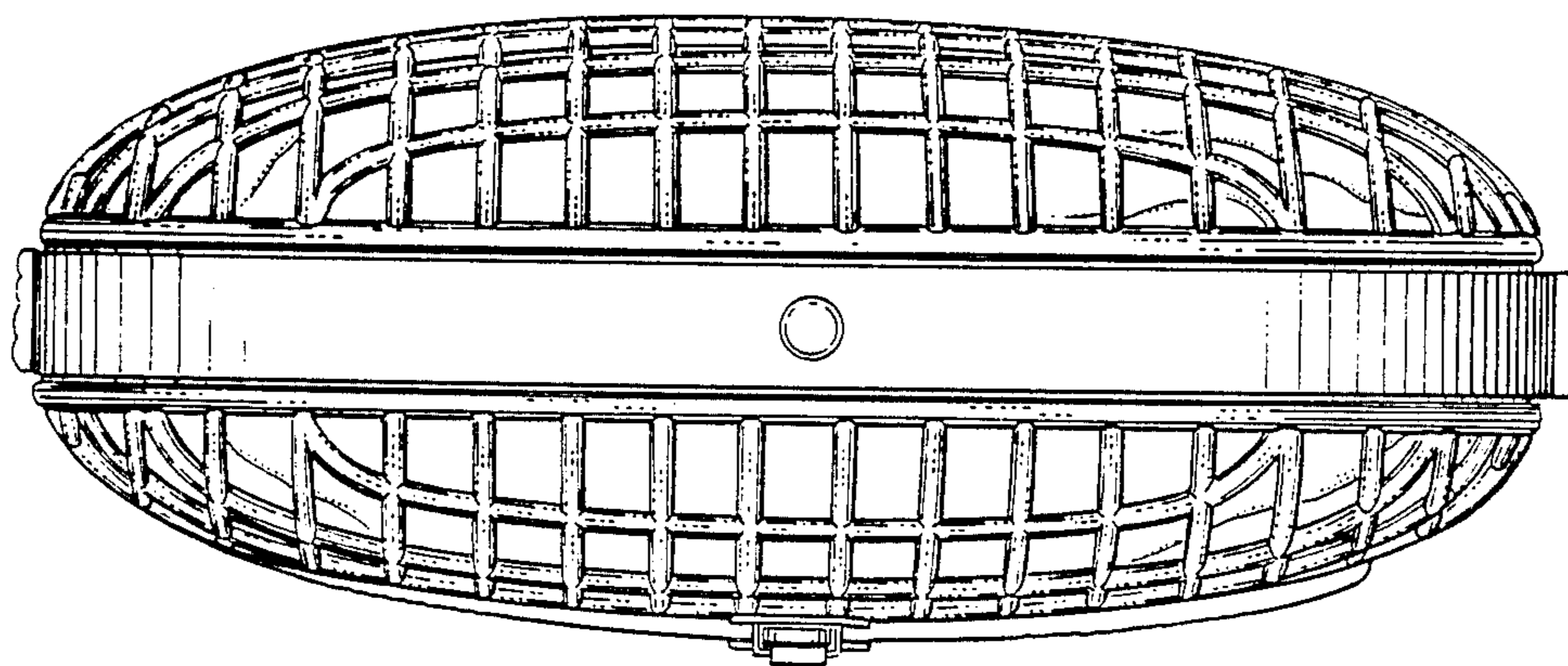

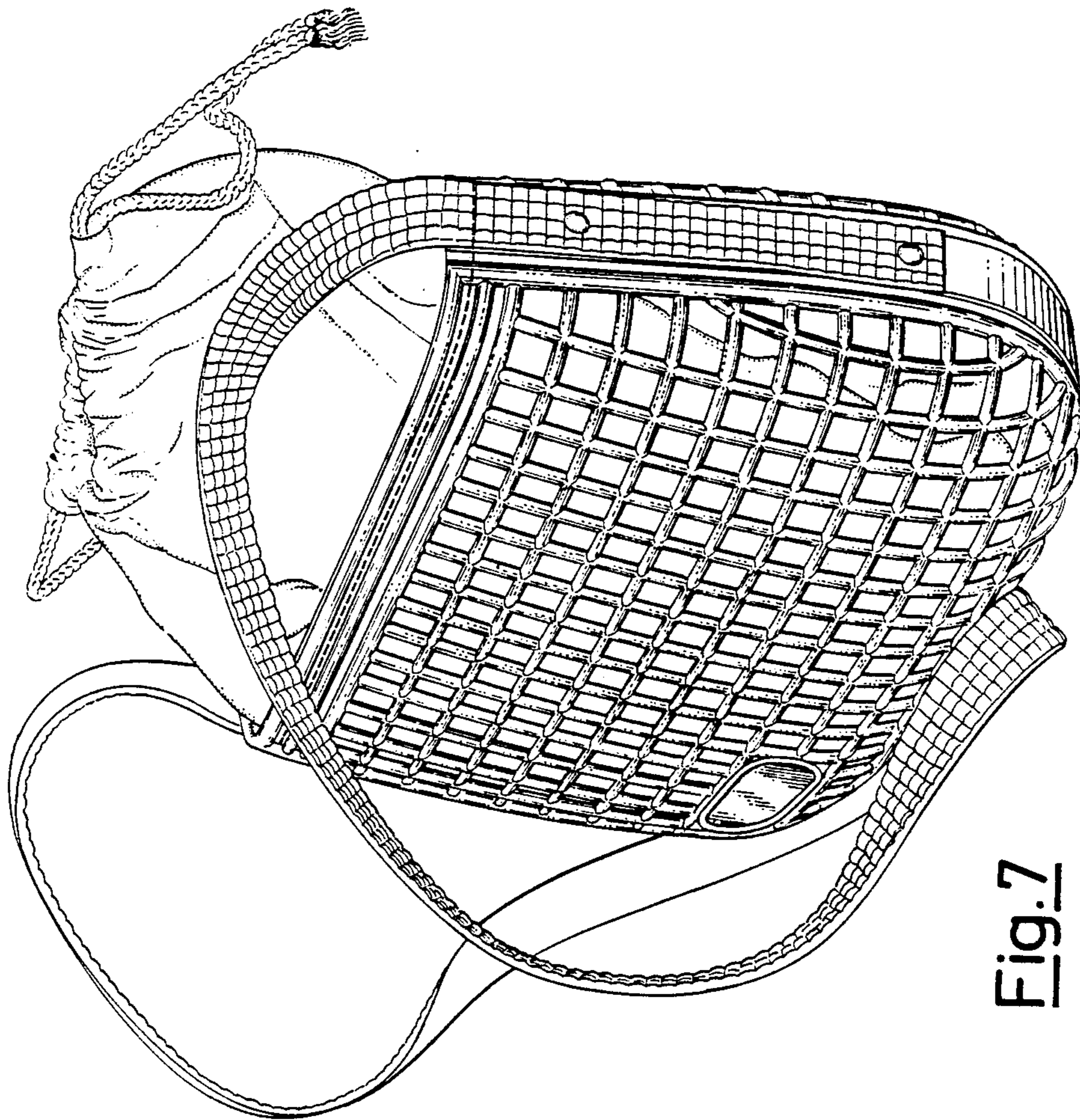
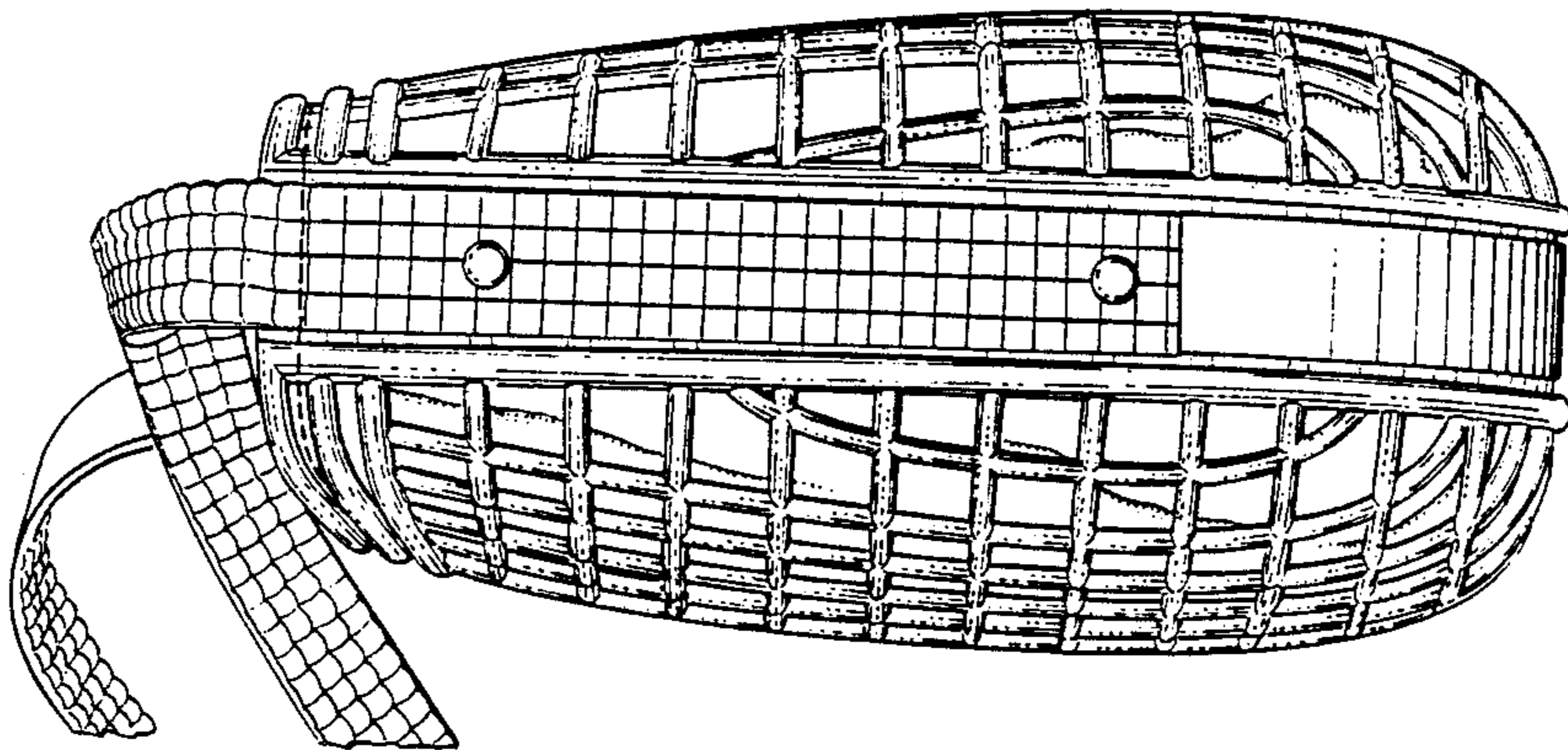

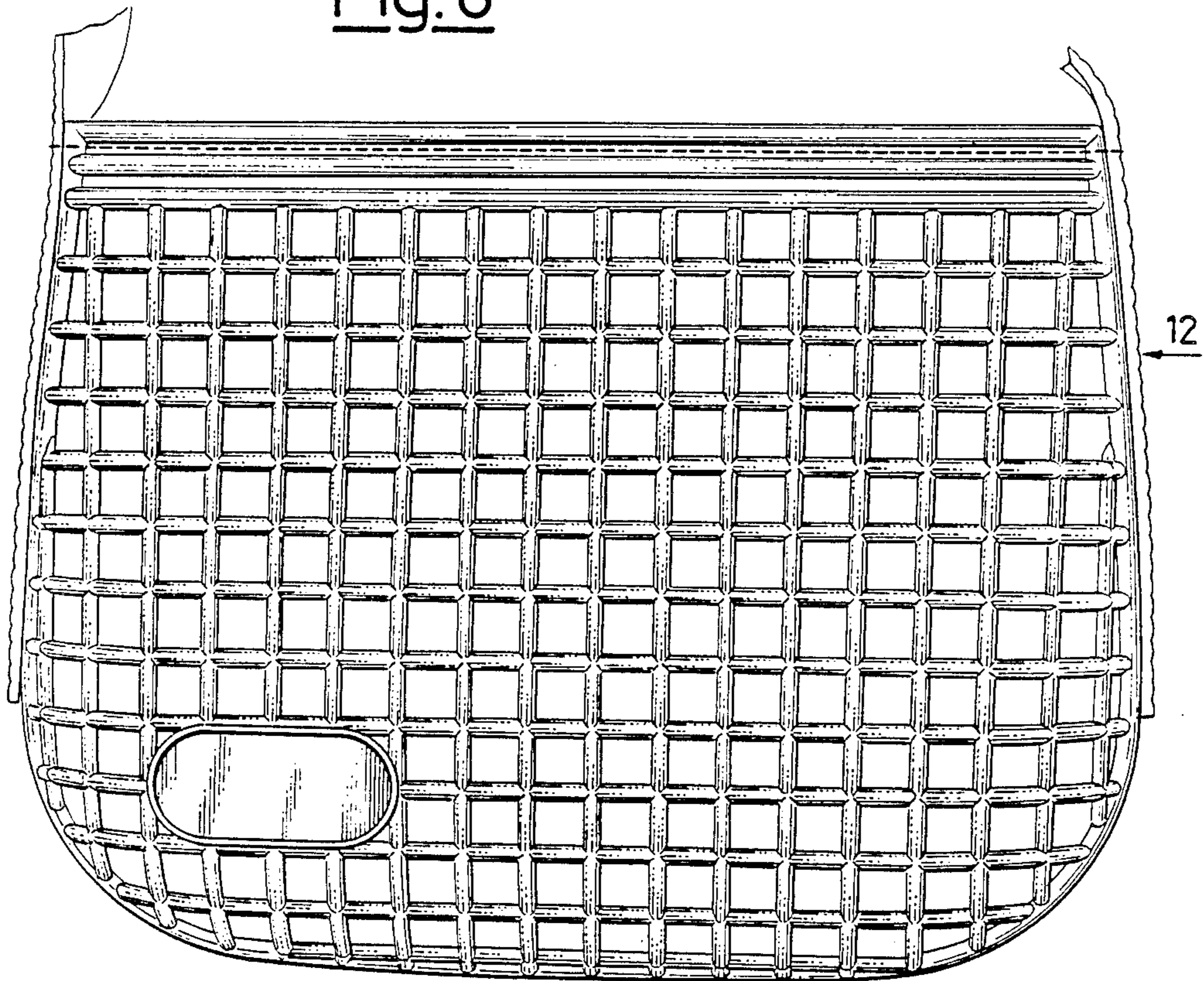

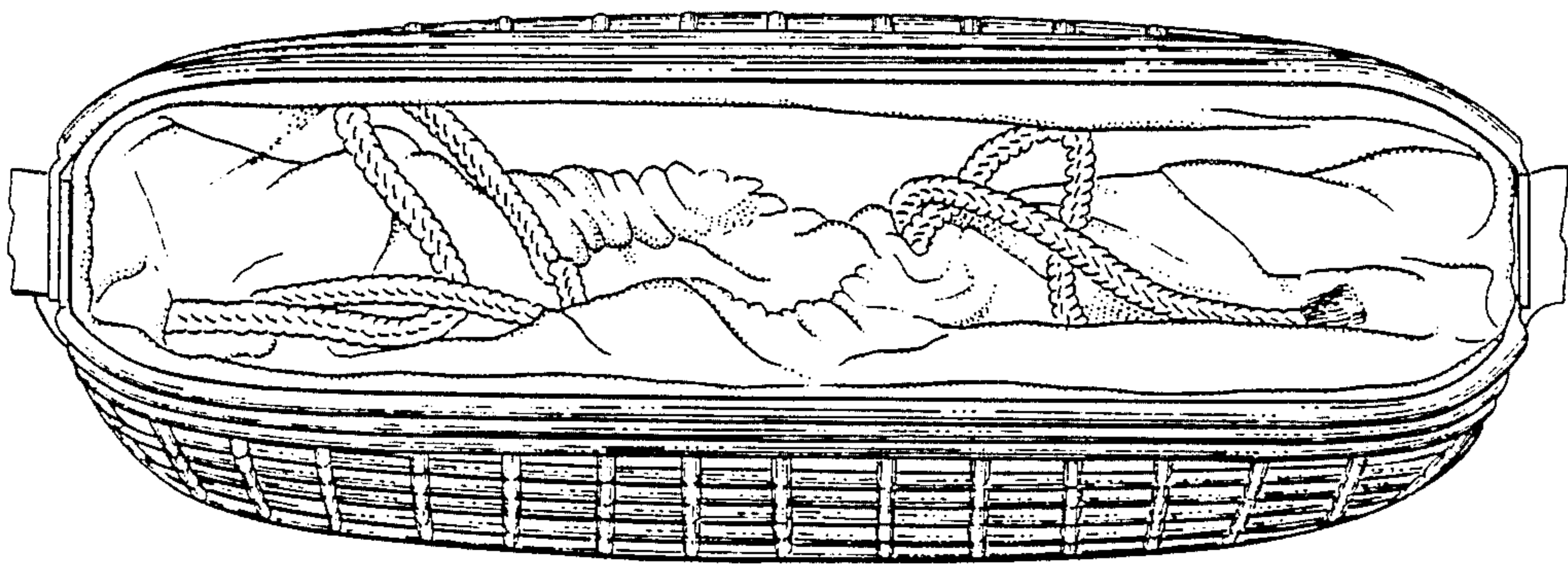

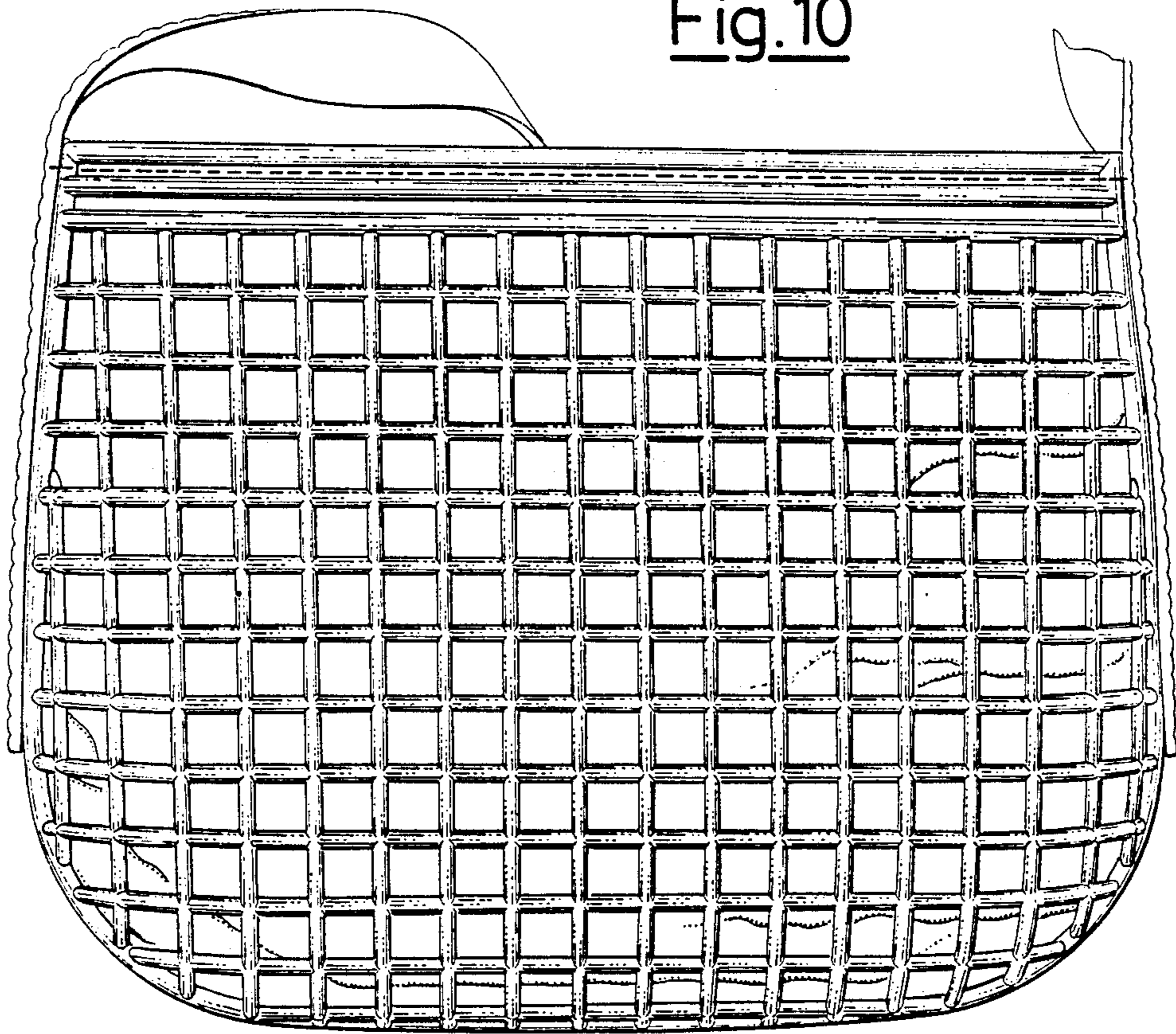
