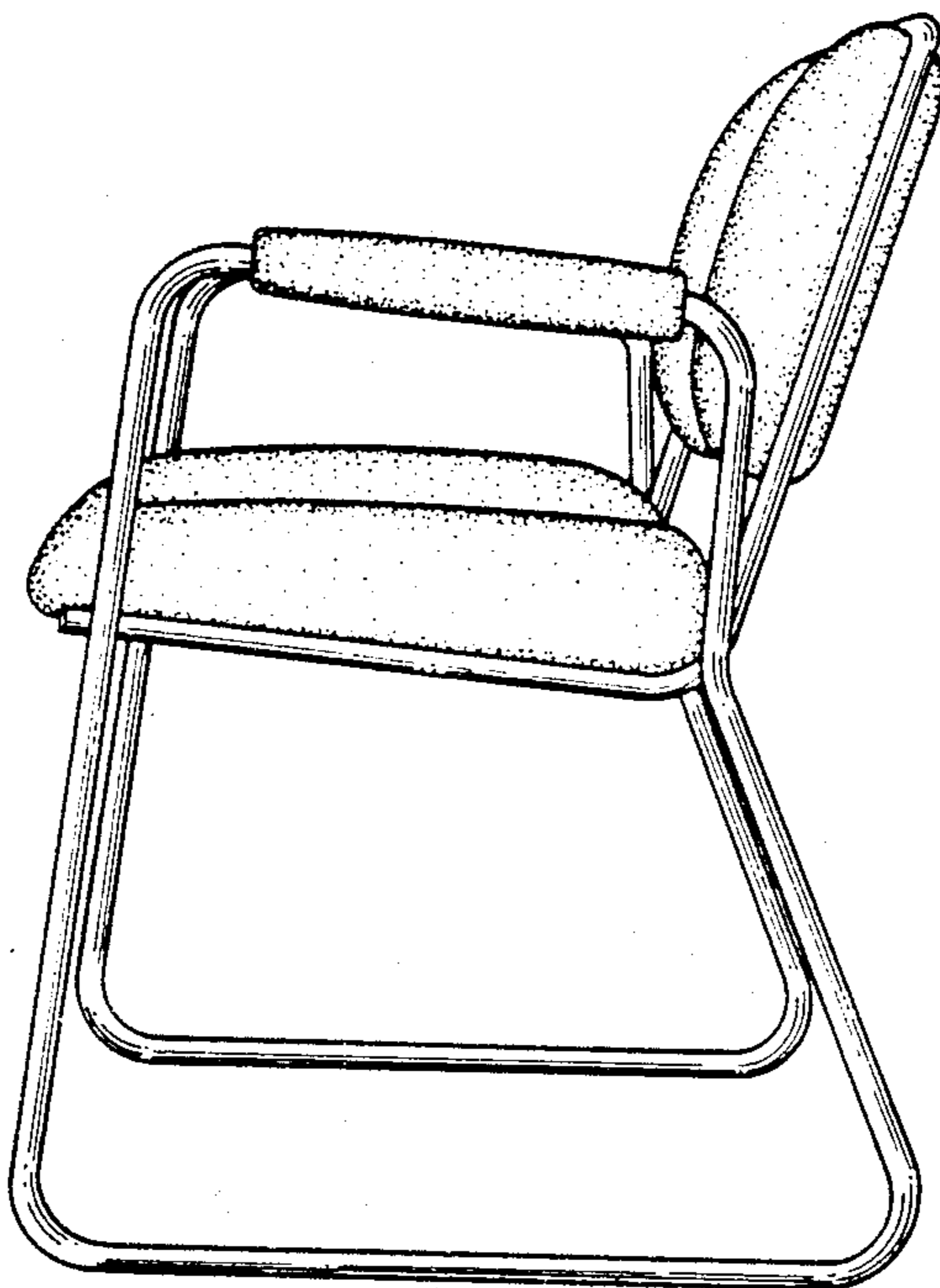
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chair, showing my new design;

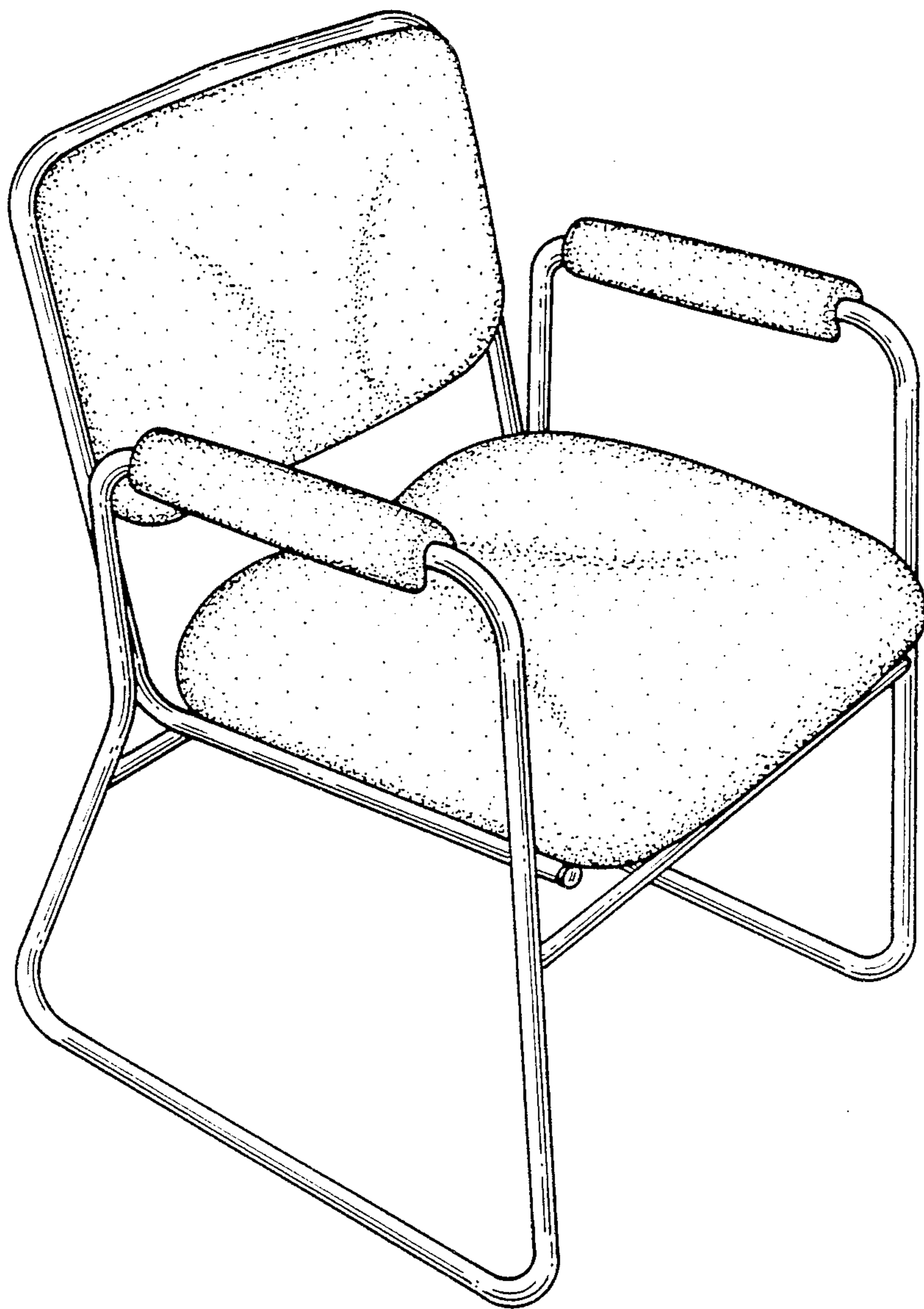
FIG. 2 is a front perspective view;

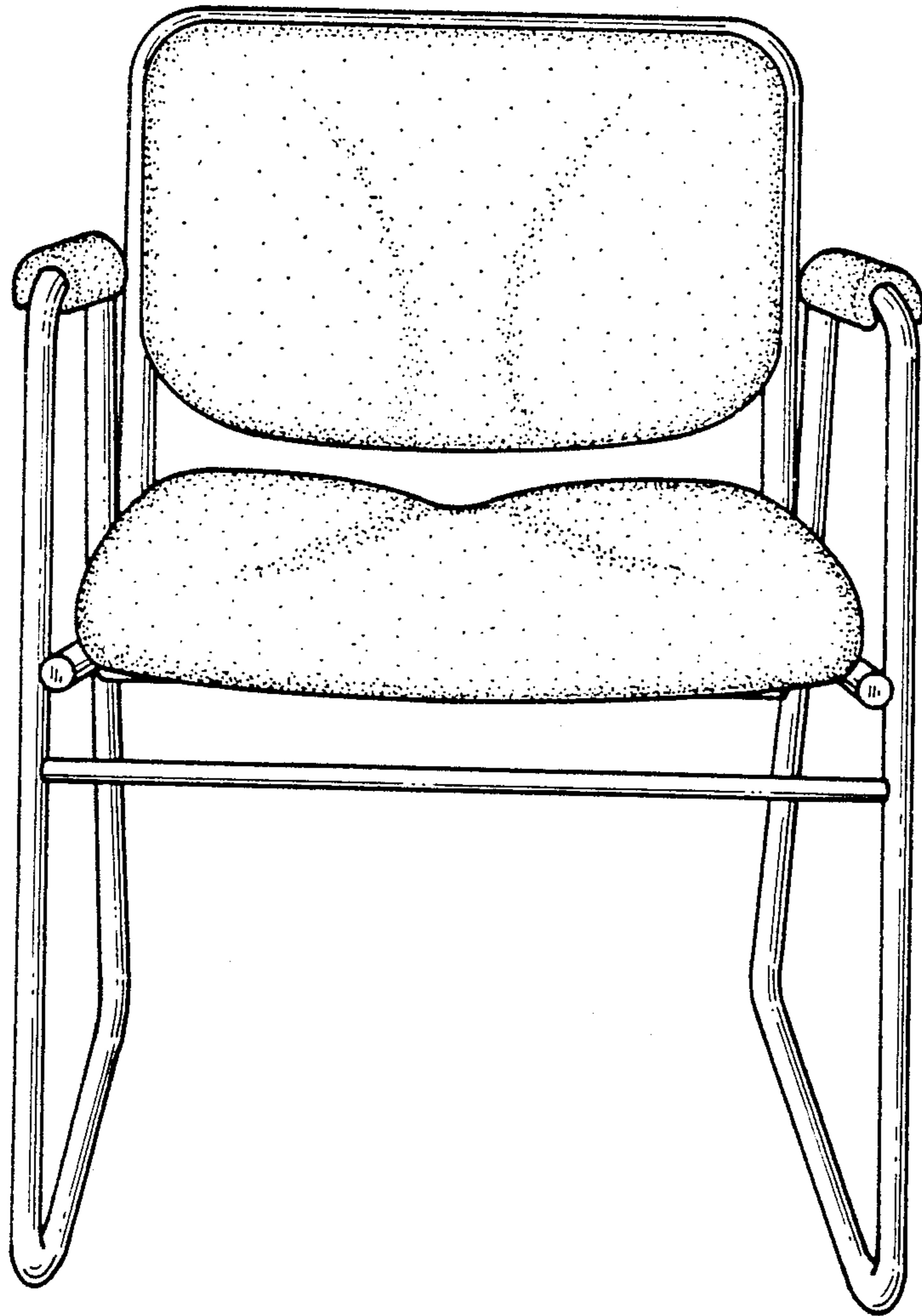

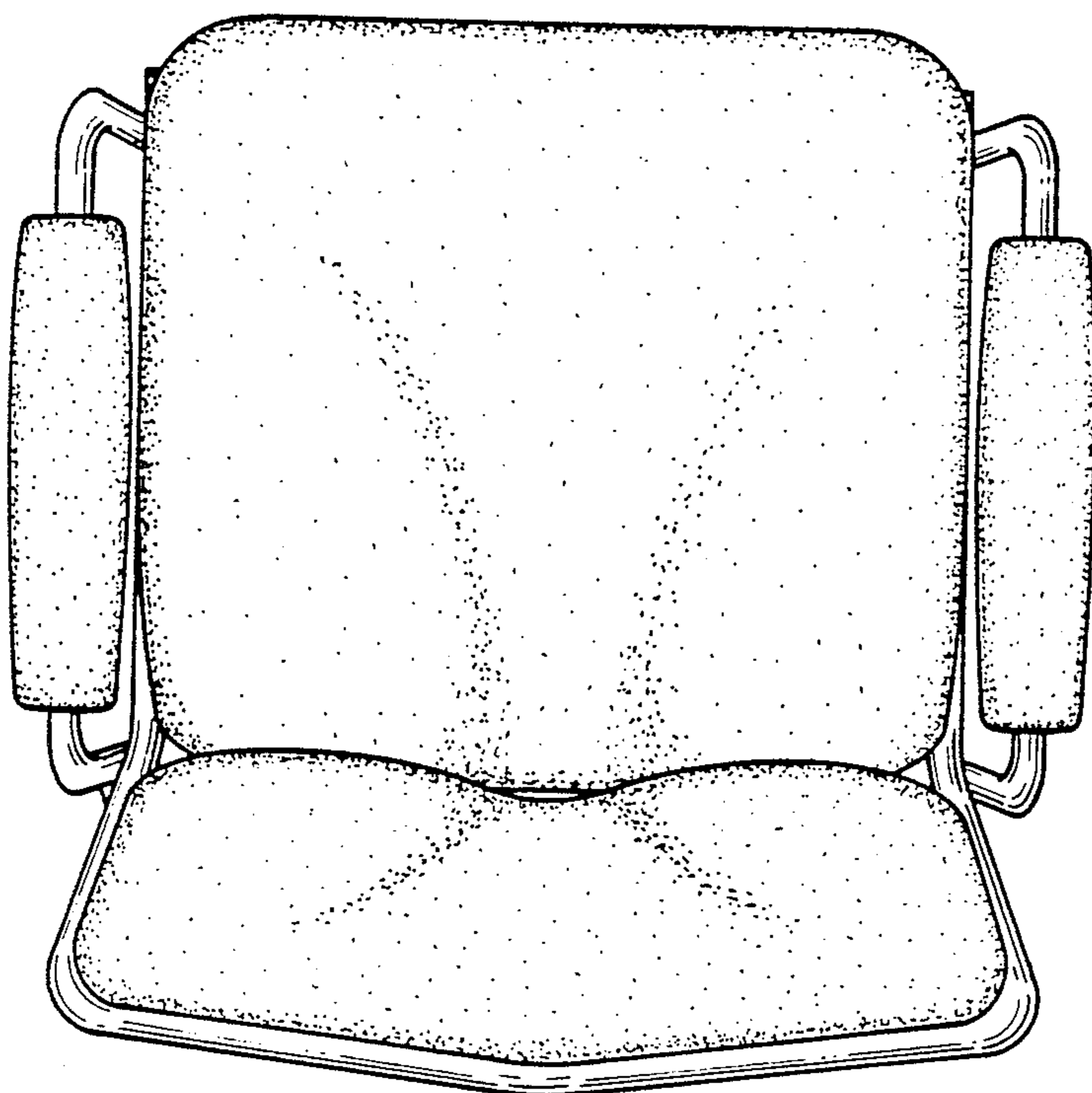
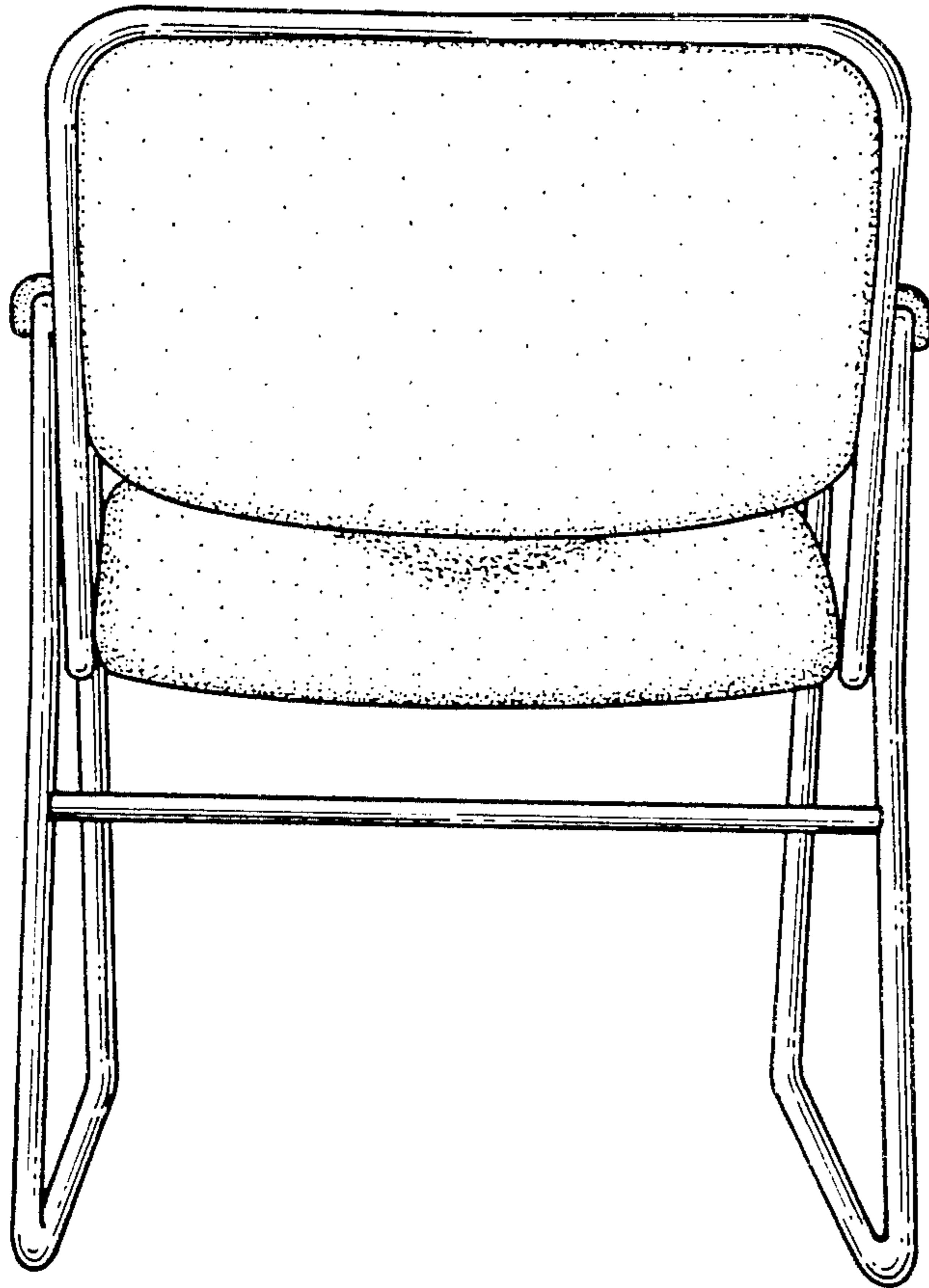
