DESCRIPTION

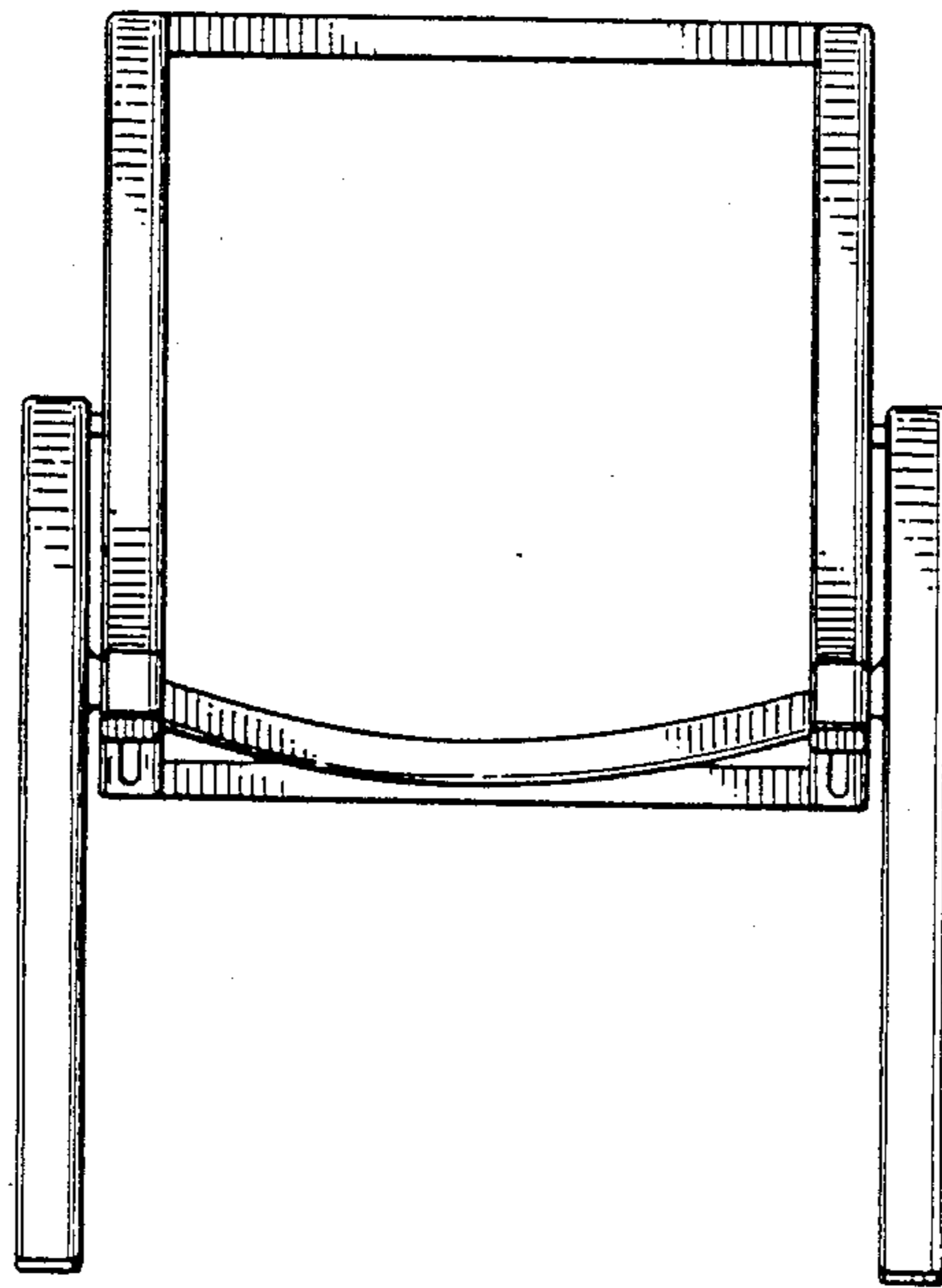
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the chair frame of the present invention.

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



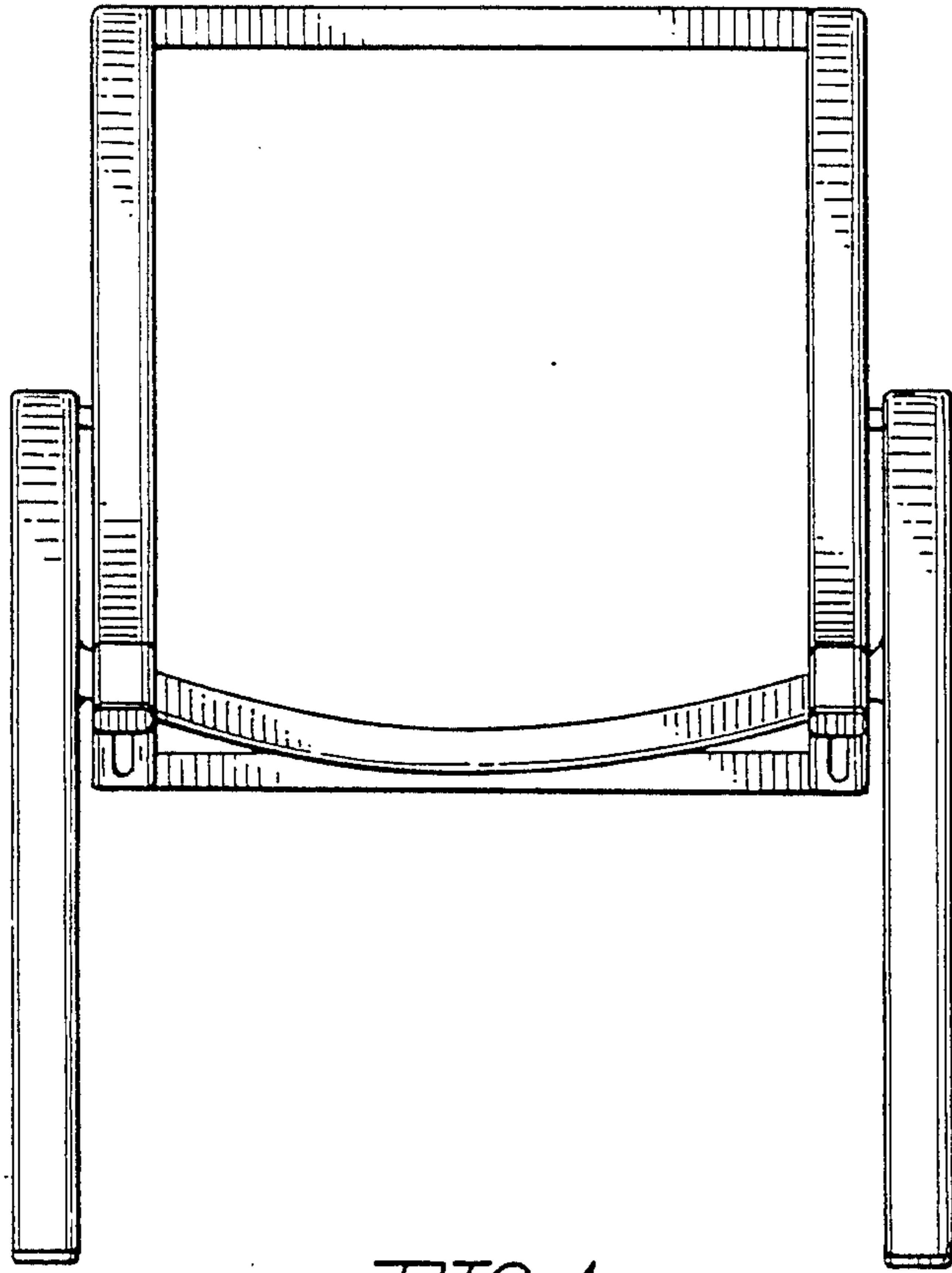

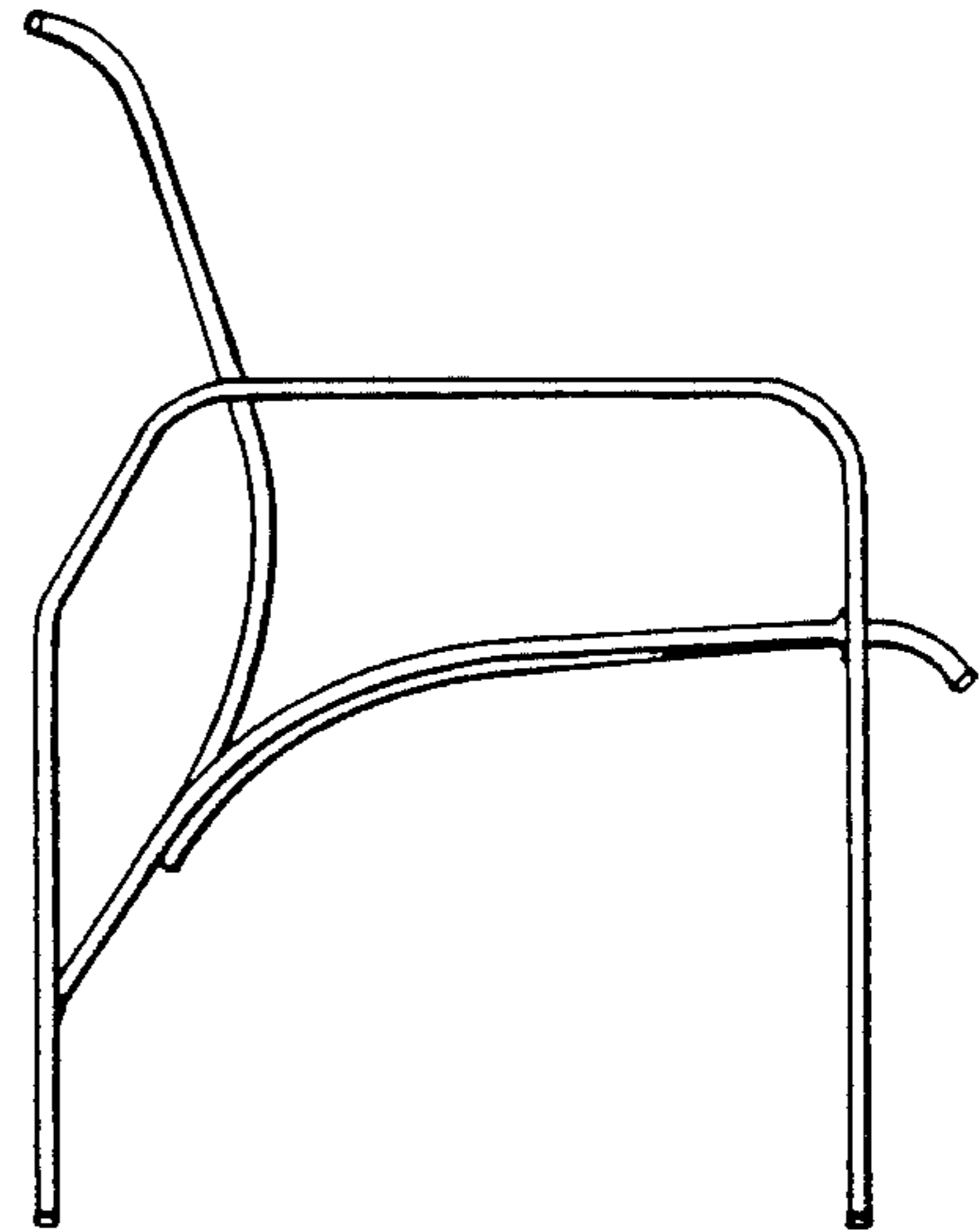

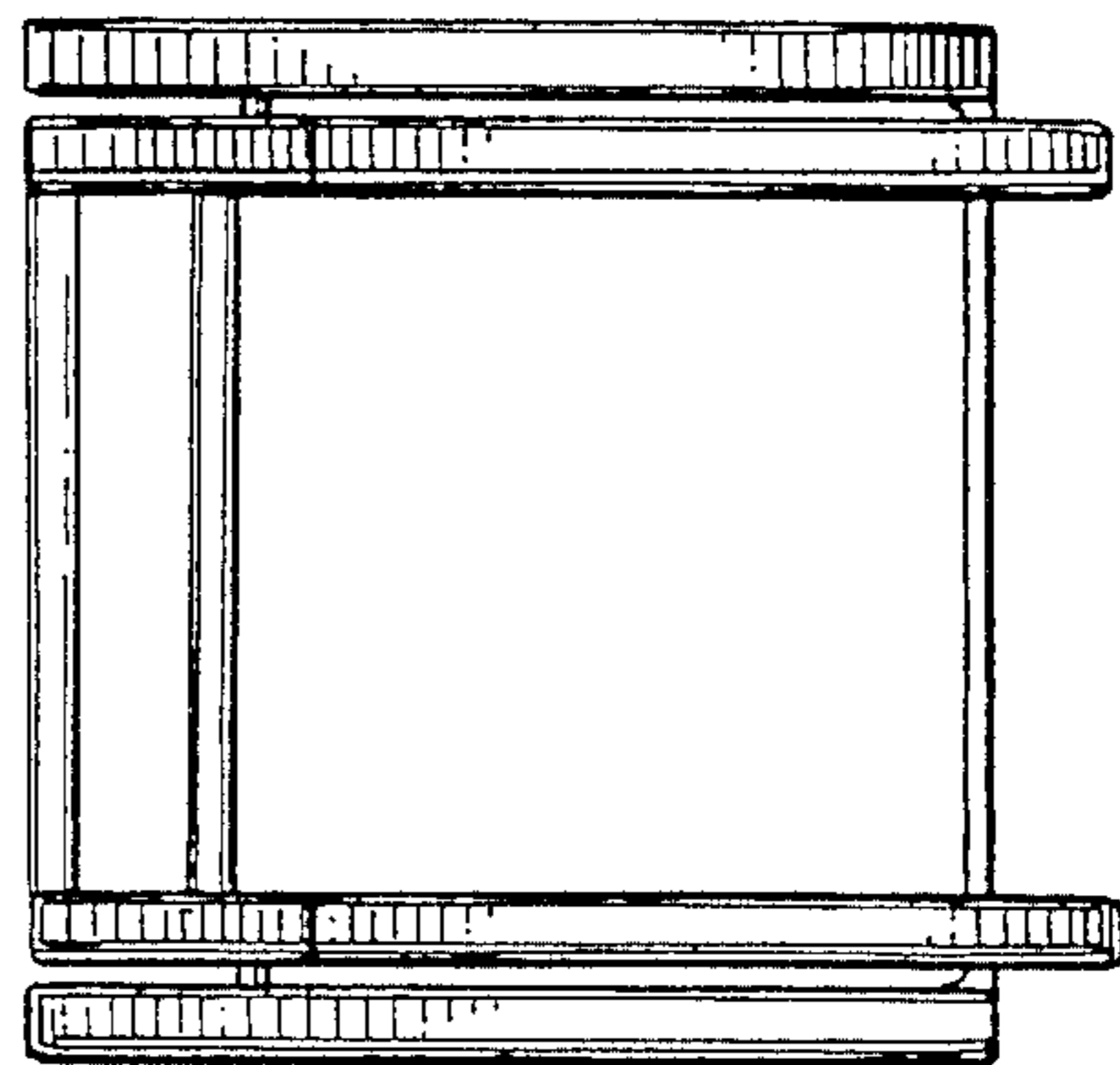

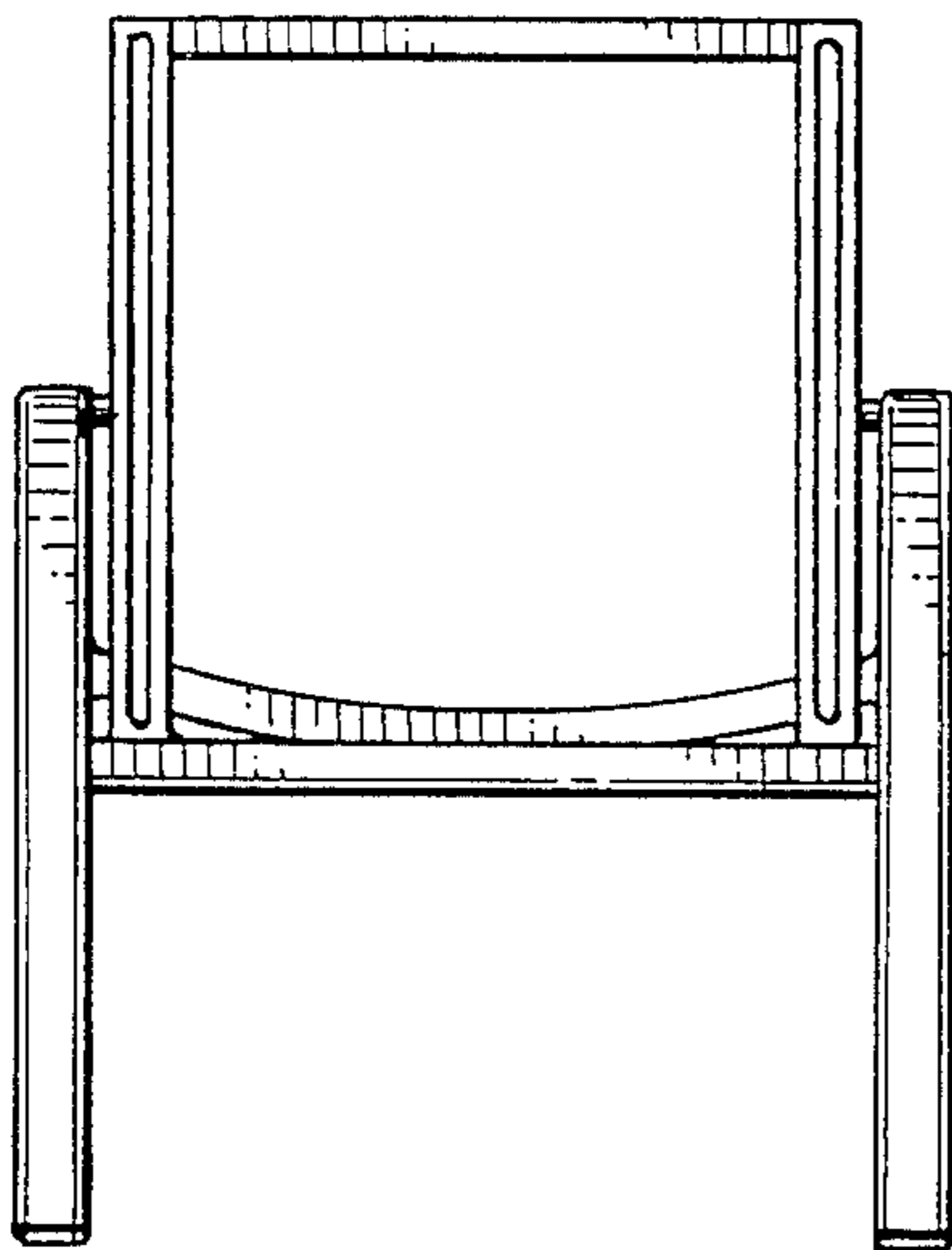

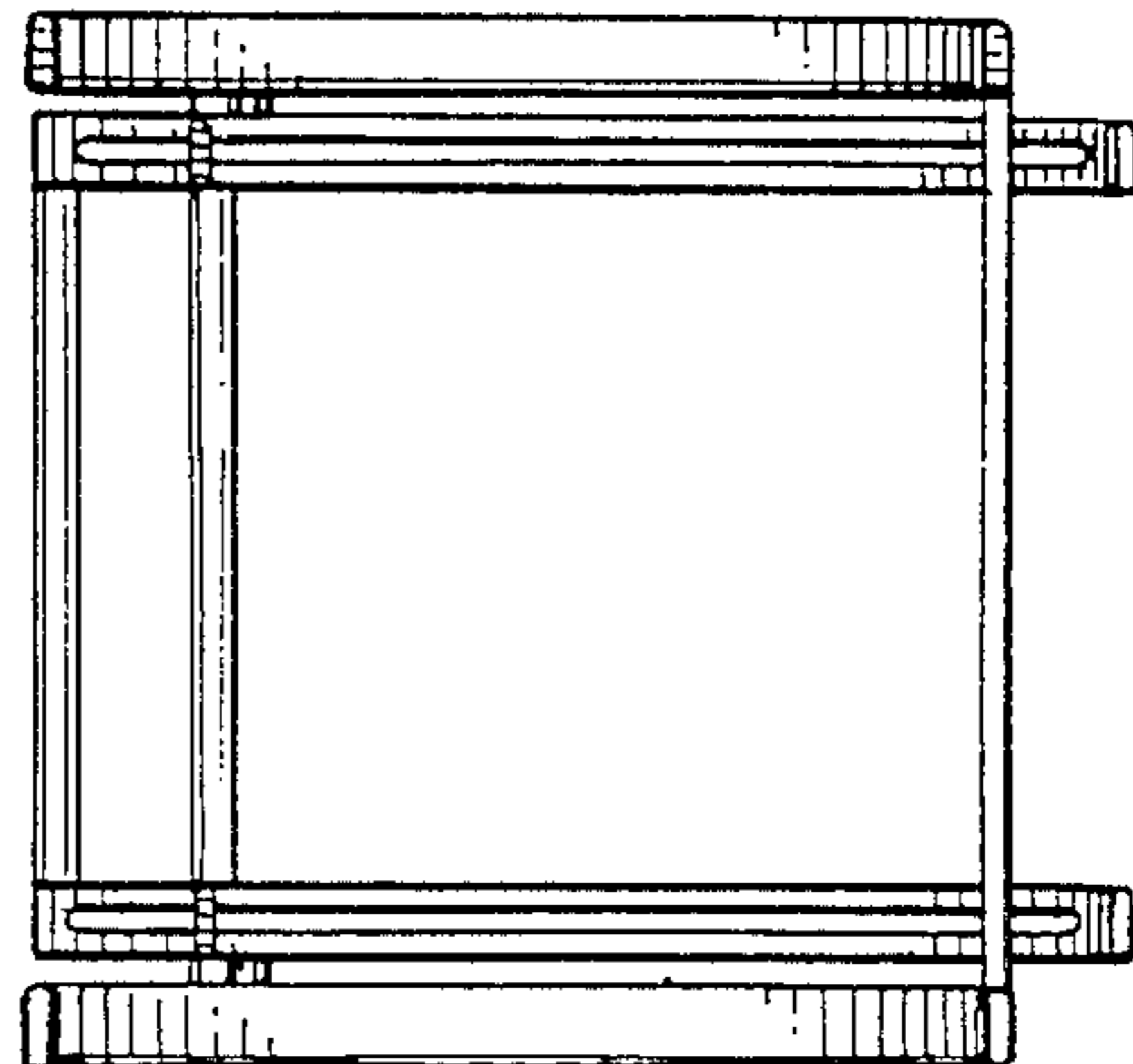
