The ornamental design for a clock, as shown and described.

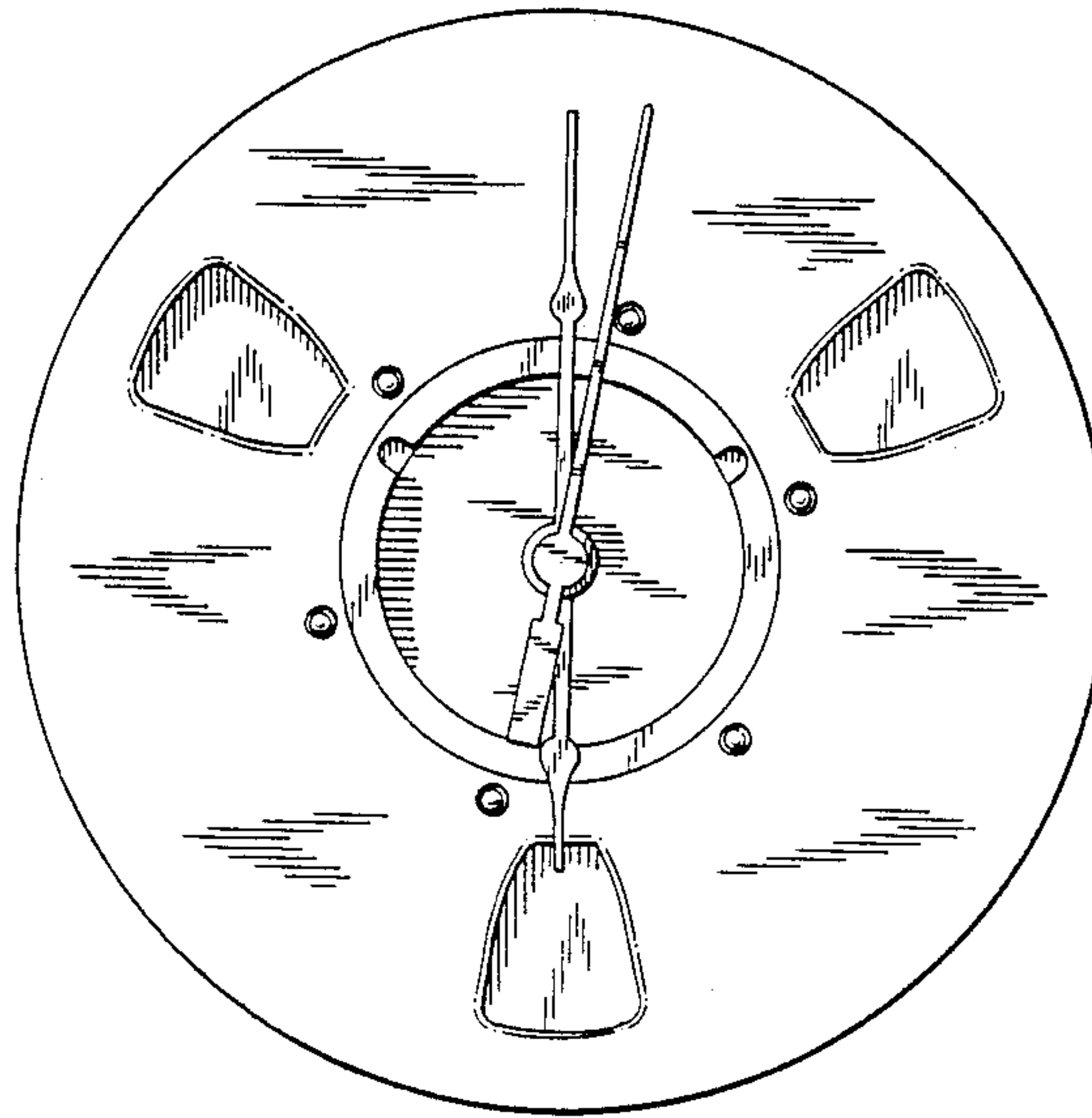
DESCRIPTION

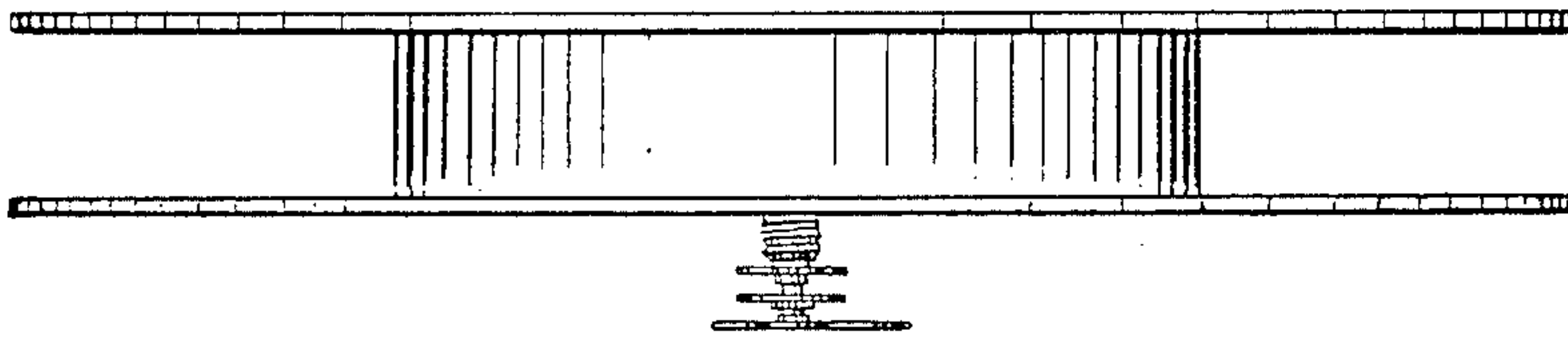

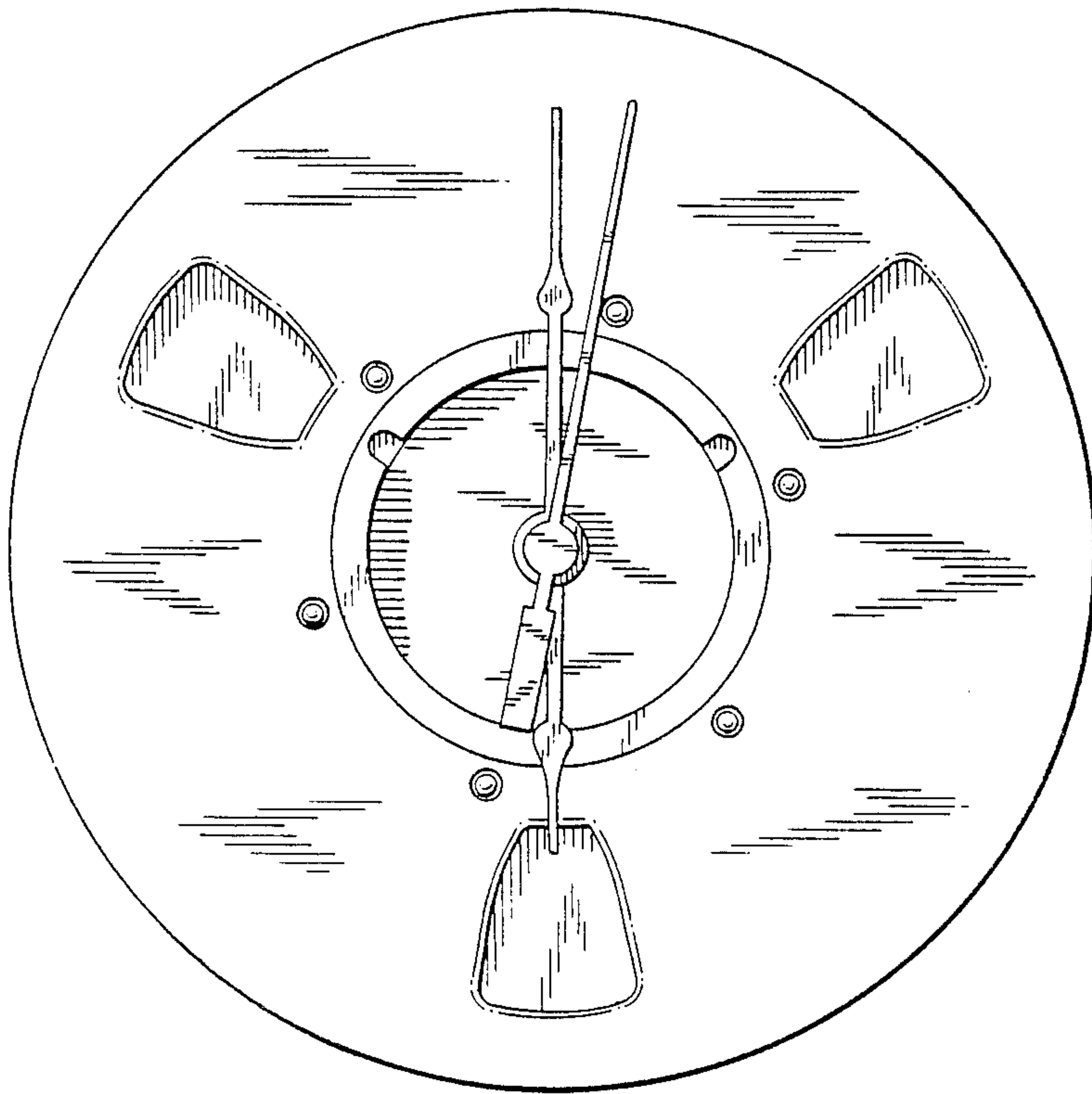

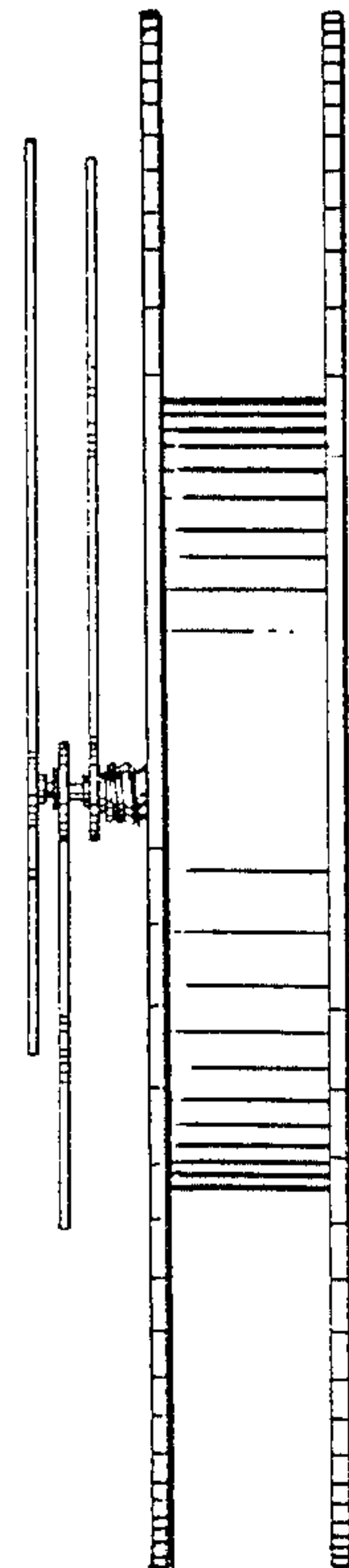
