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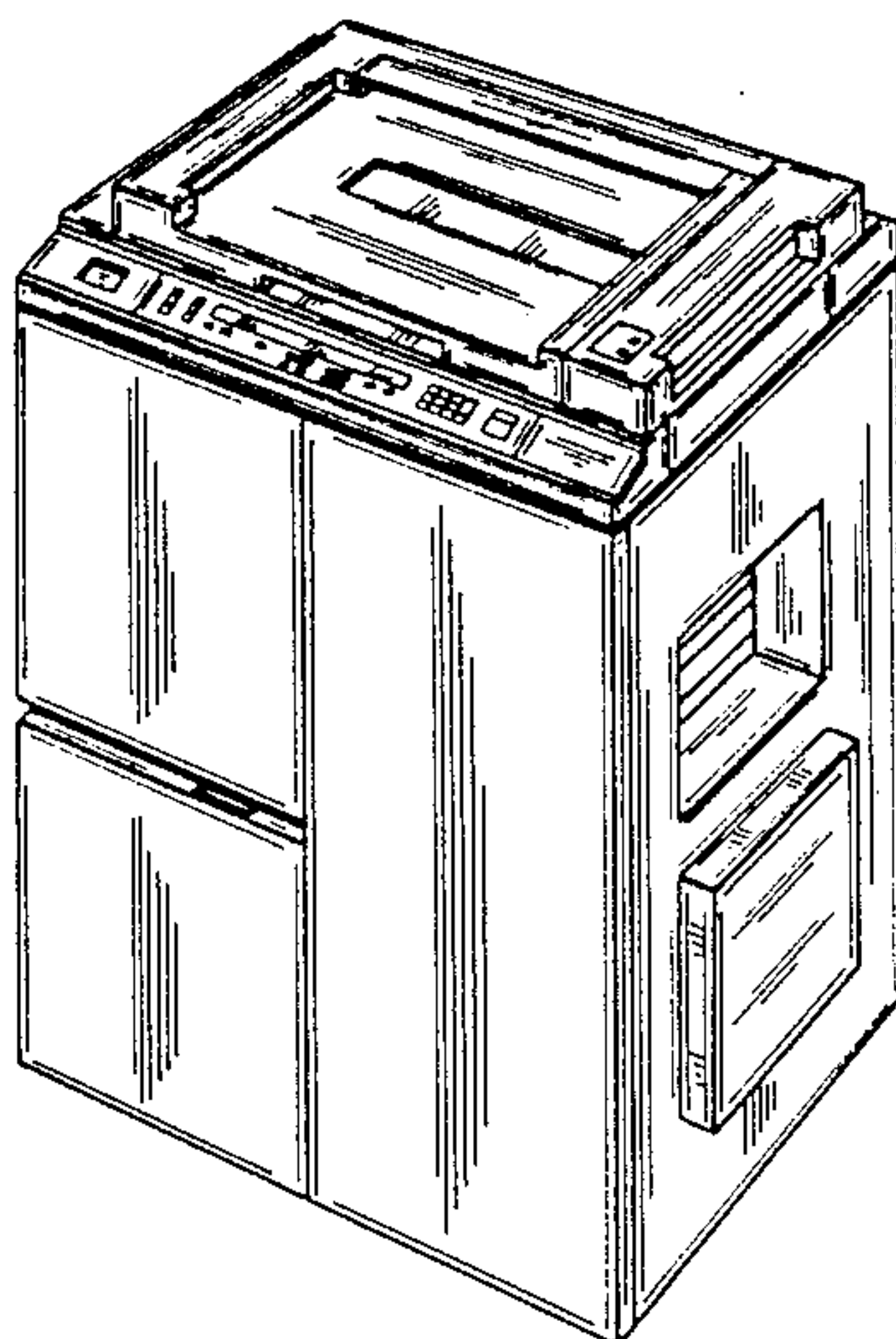

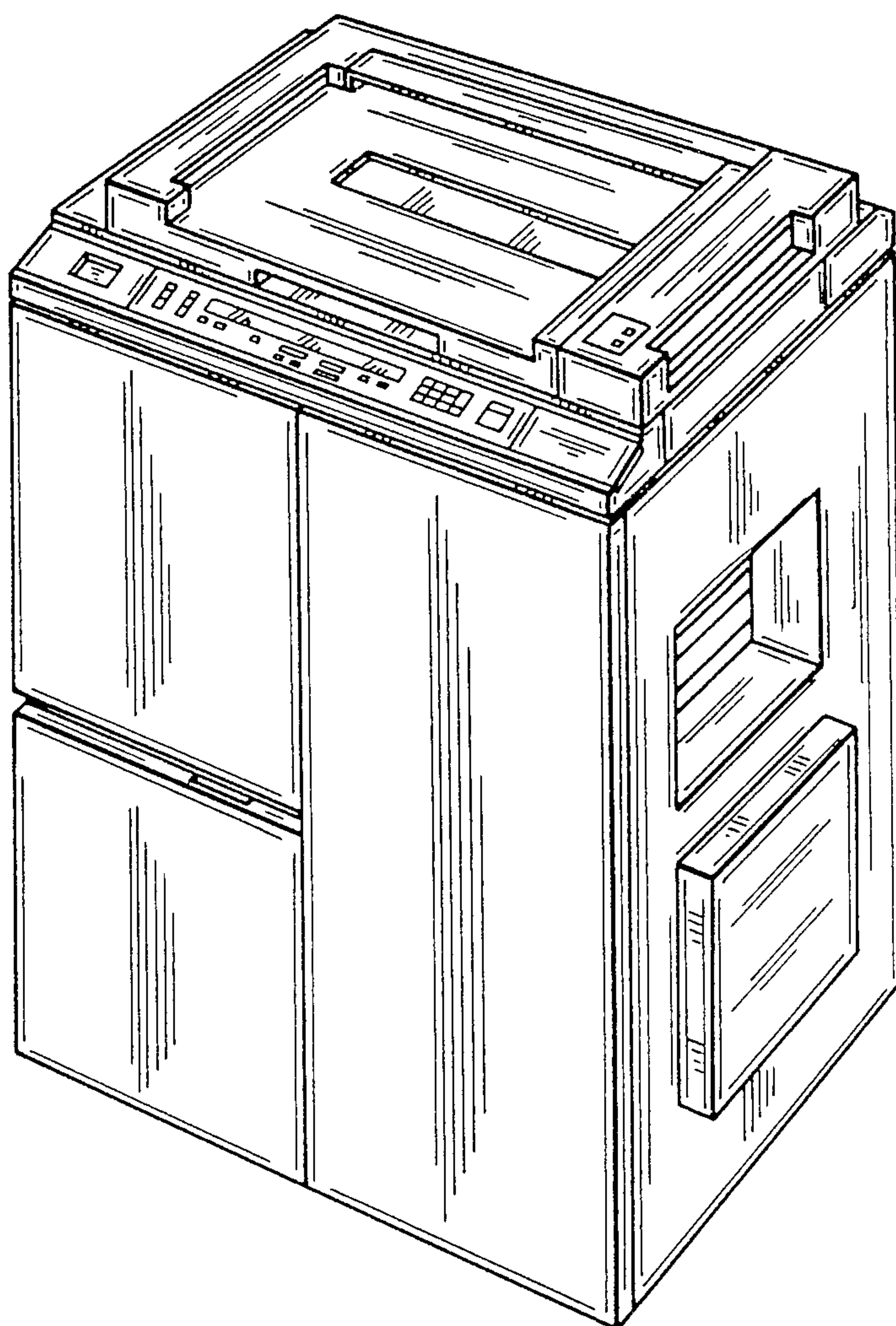

The ornamental design for a copying machine, as shown and described.

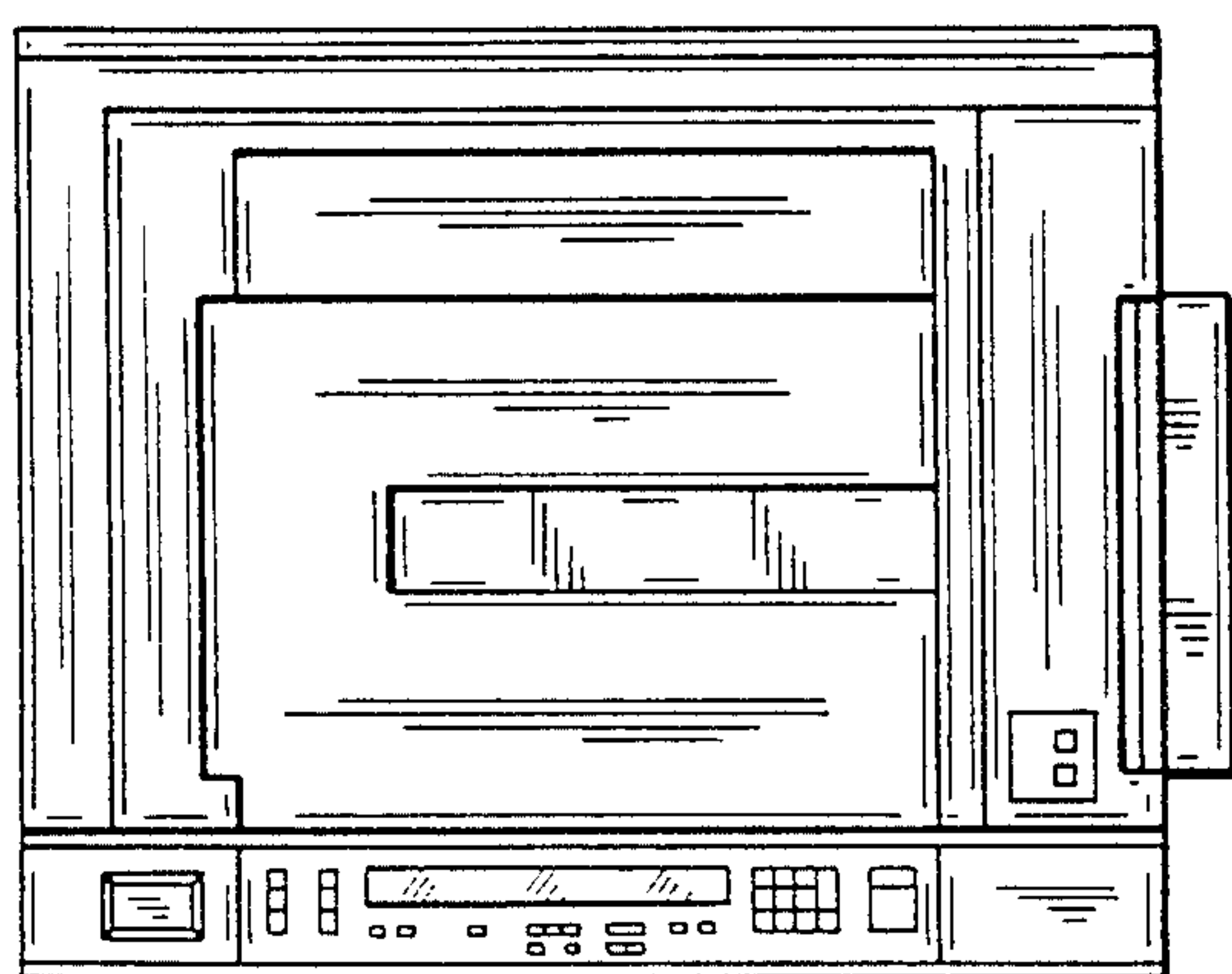
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof.

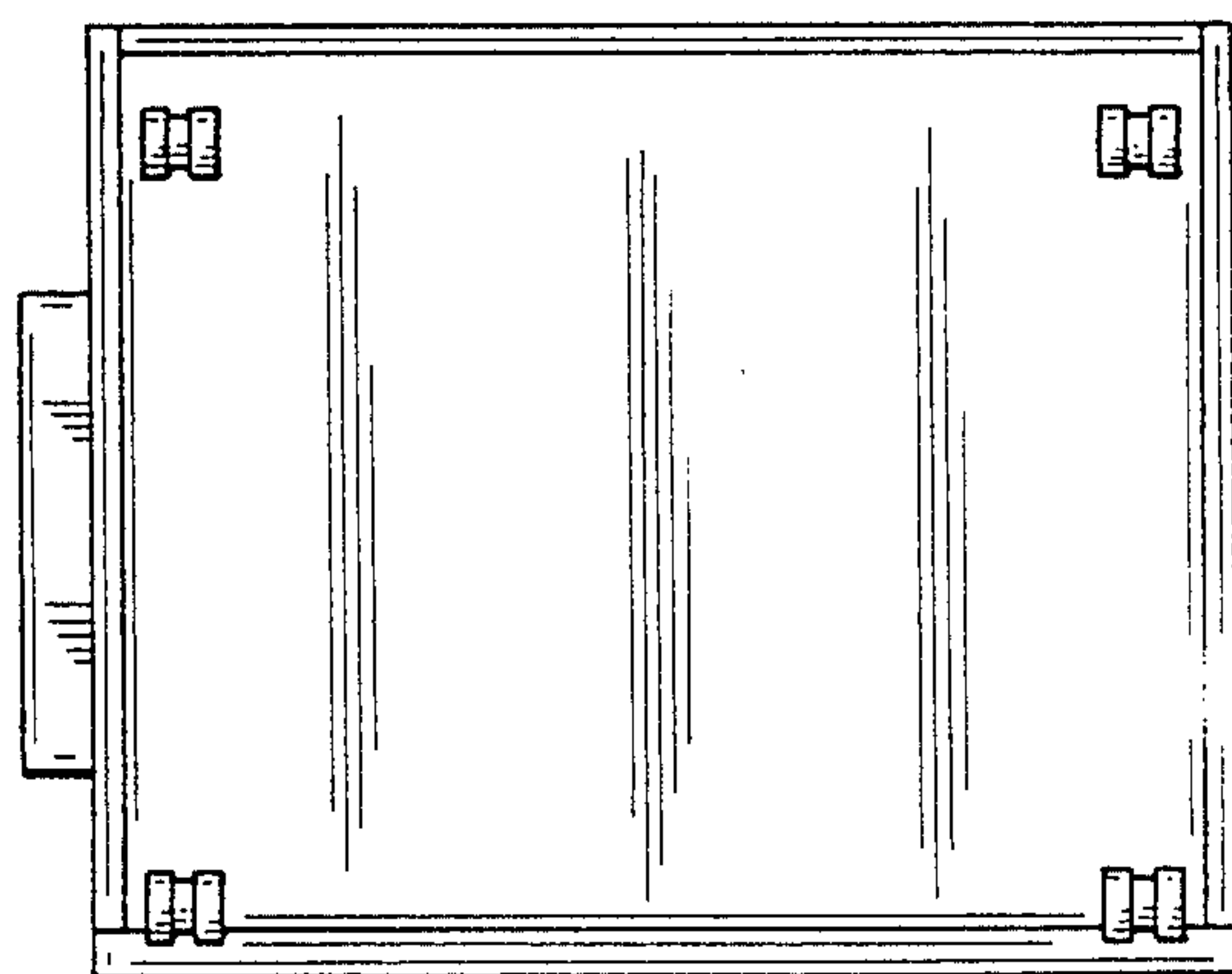




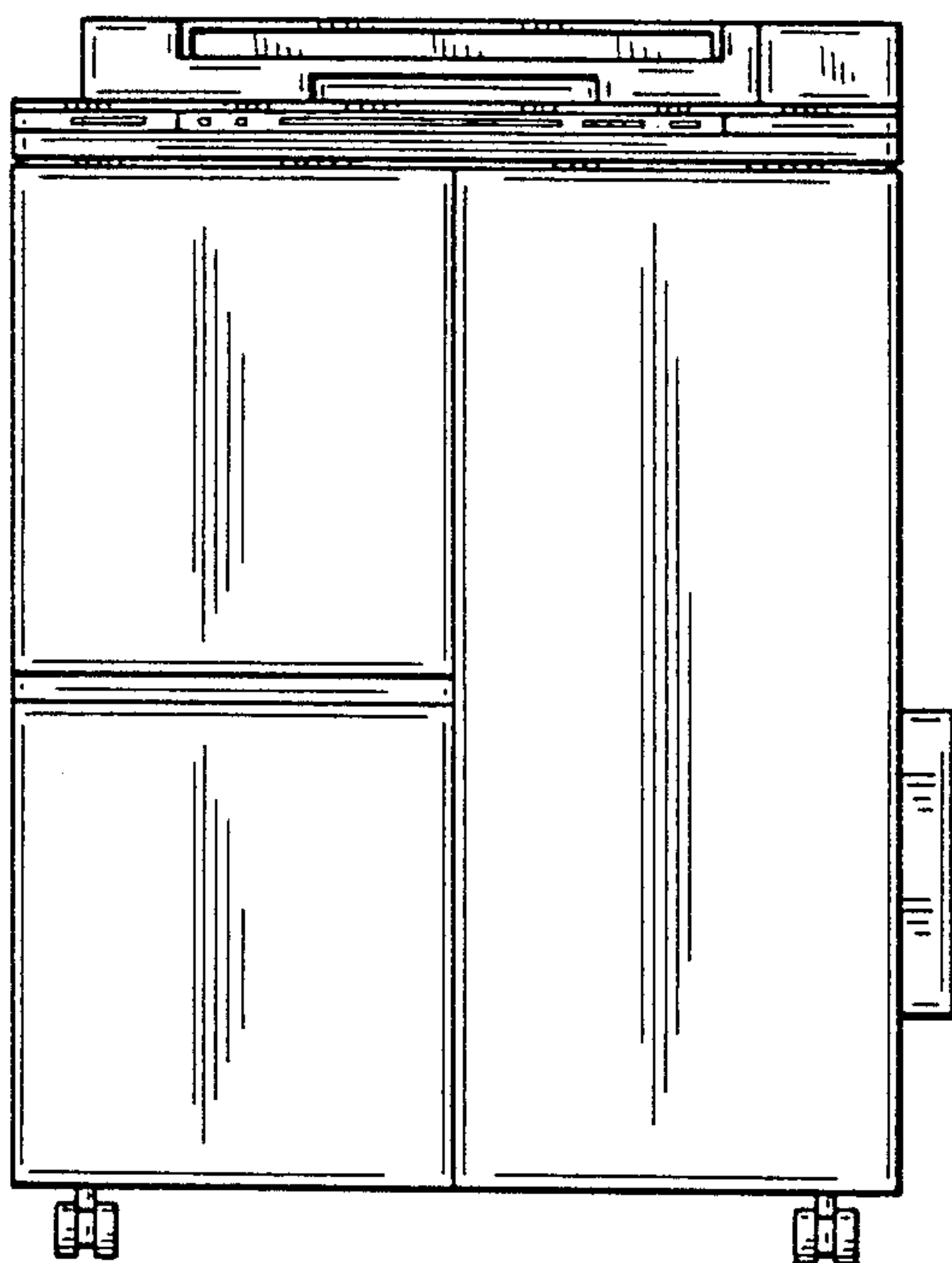

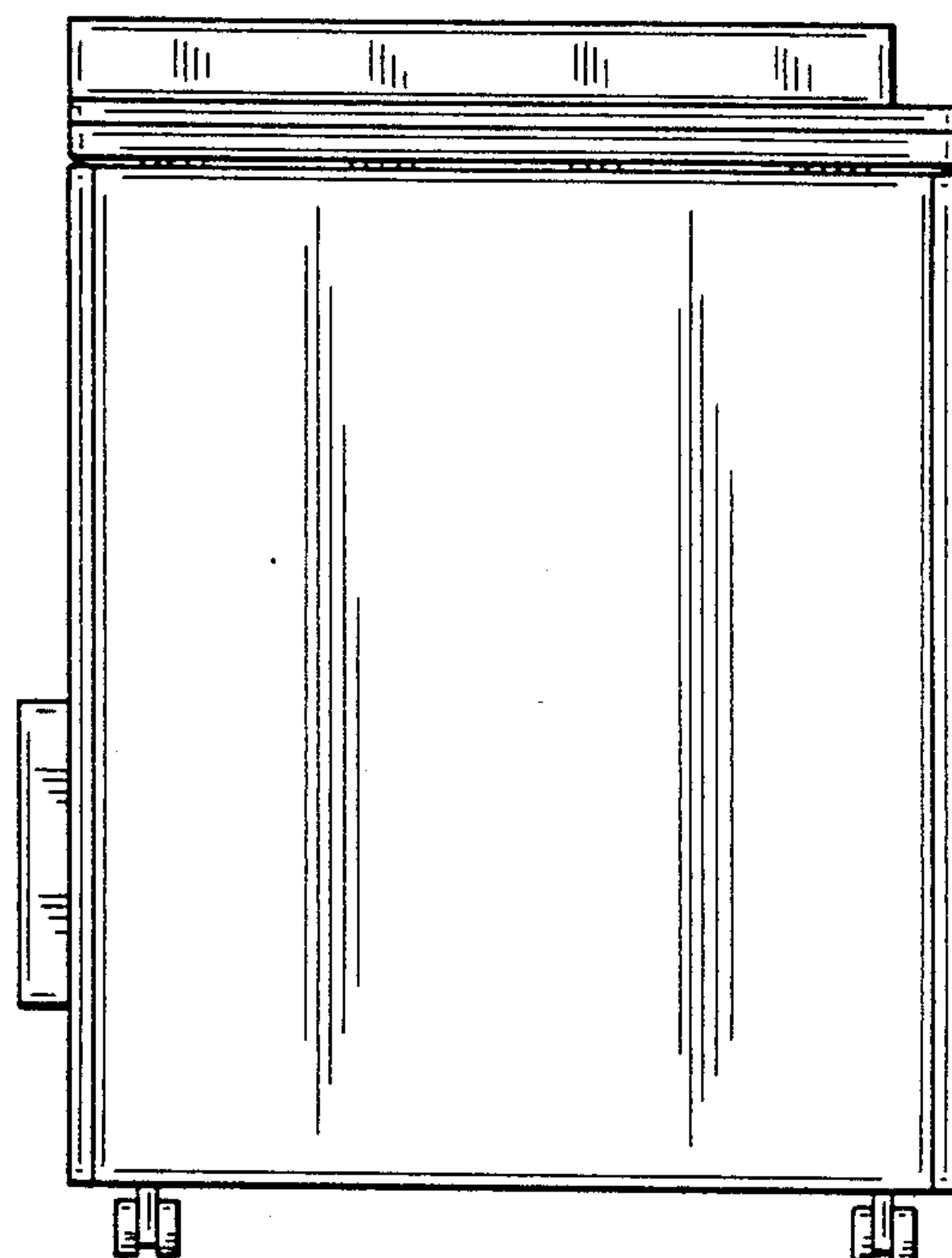

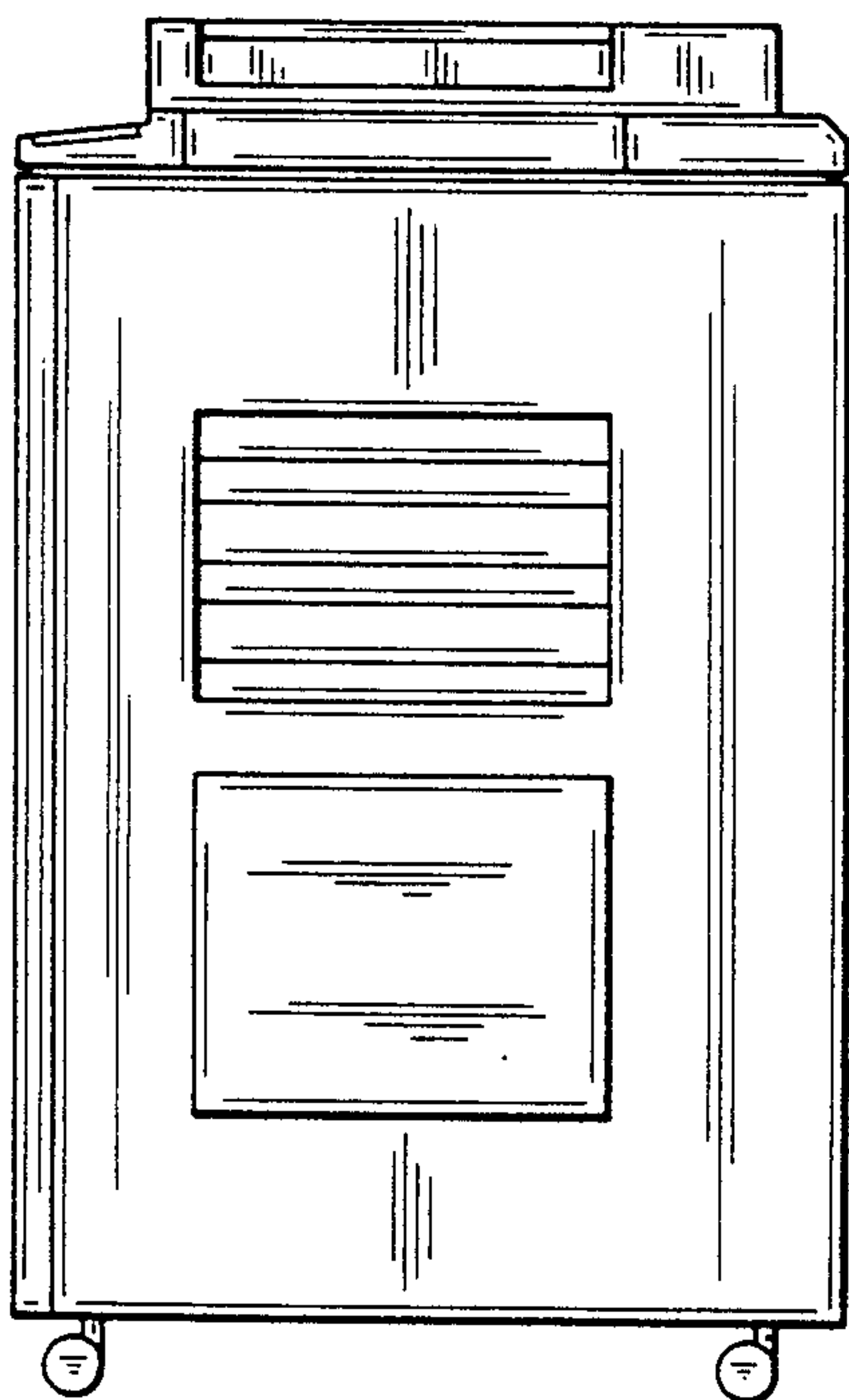

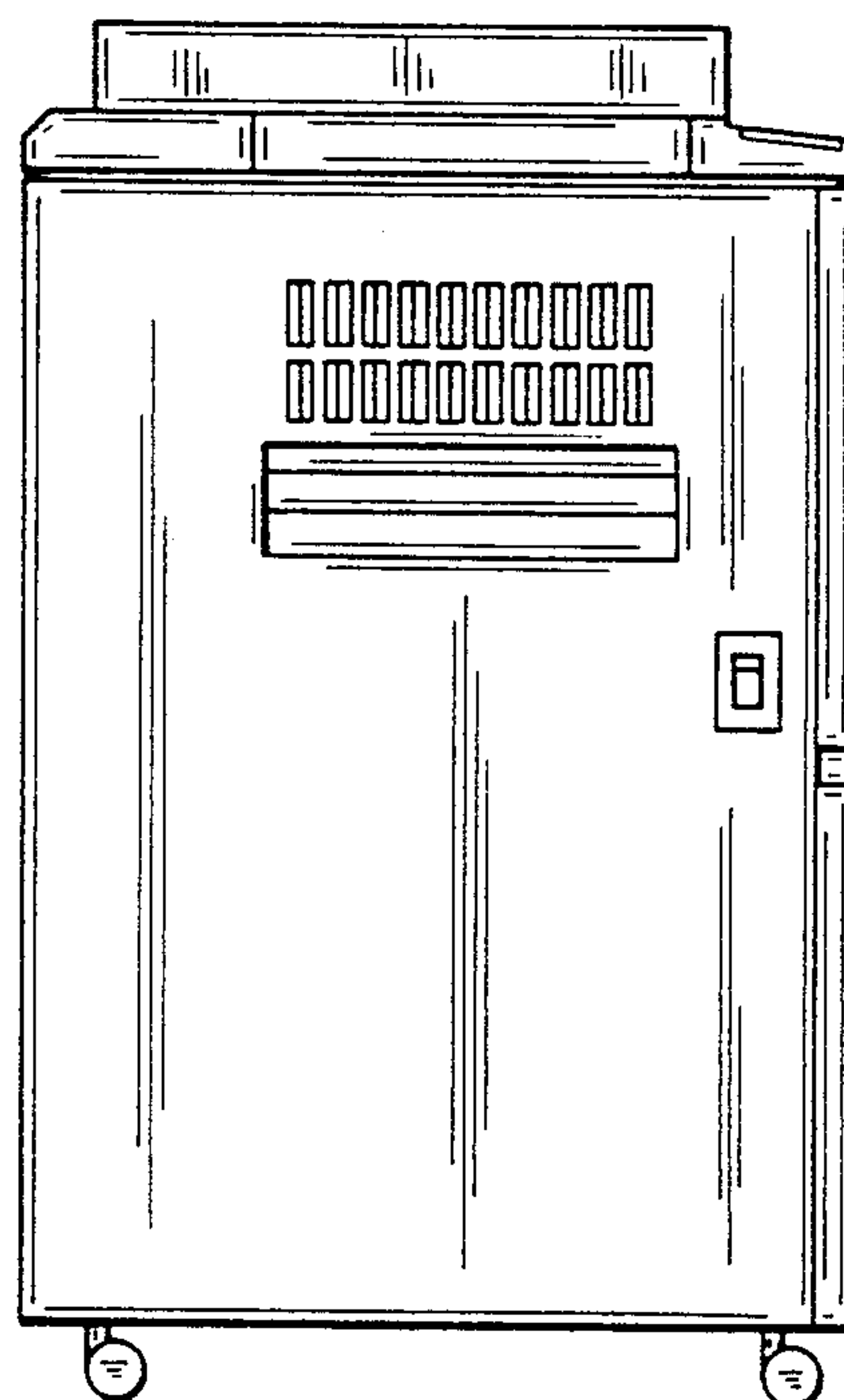
