[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a reconfigurable toy jeep, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a reconfigurable toy jeep showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a front perspective view of a modified form of the design shown in FIGS. 1 through 6;

FIG. 8 is a front perspective view of the design shown in FIGS. 1 through 6 reconfigured into a toy robotic humanoid configuration;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view thereof, the side opposite being substantially a mirror image;

FIG. 11 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 12 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 13 is a bottom plan view thereof.

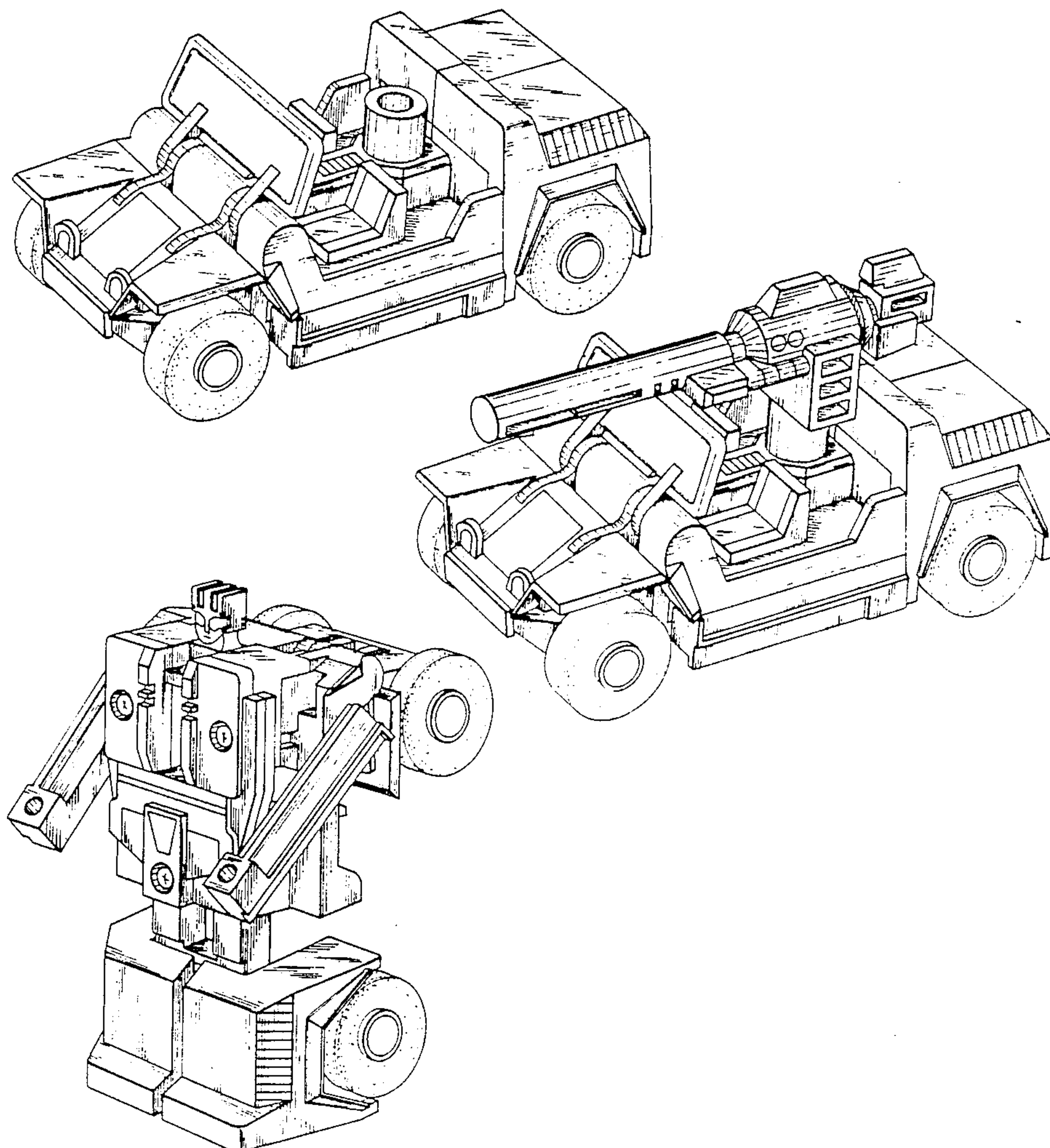

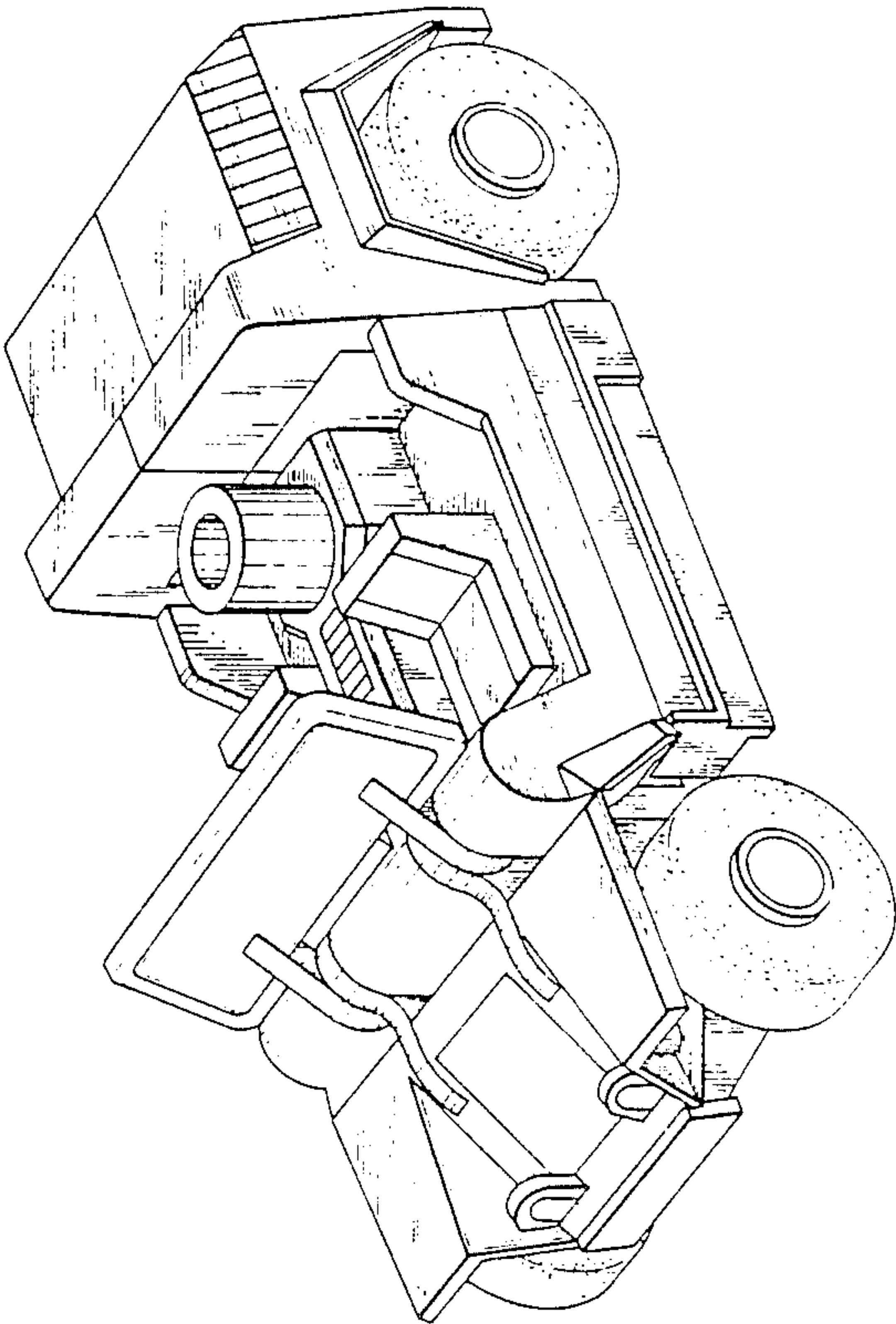

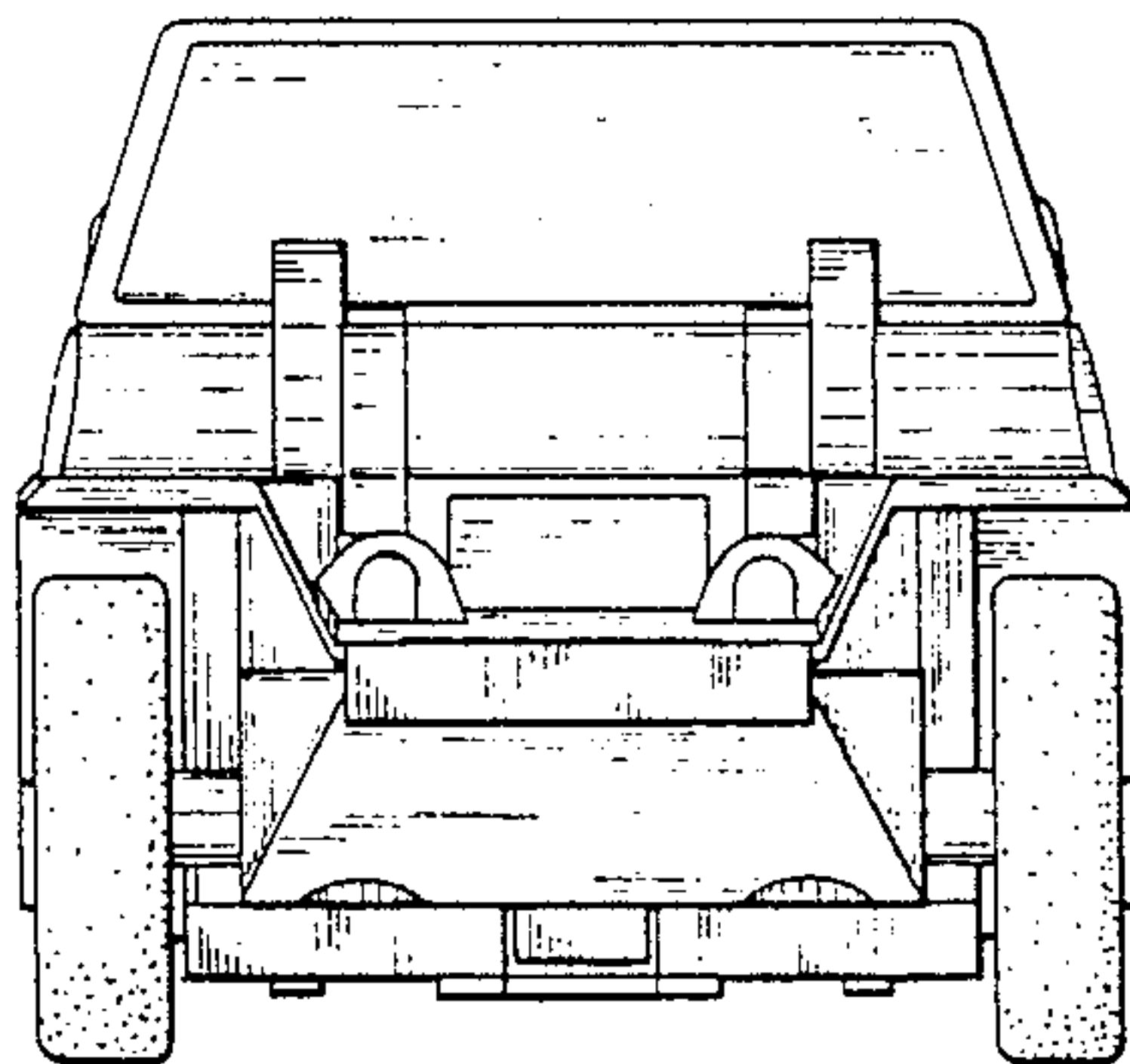

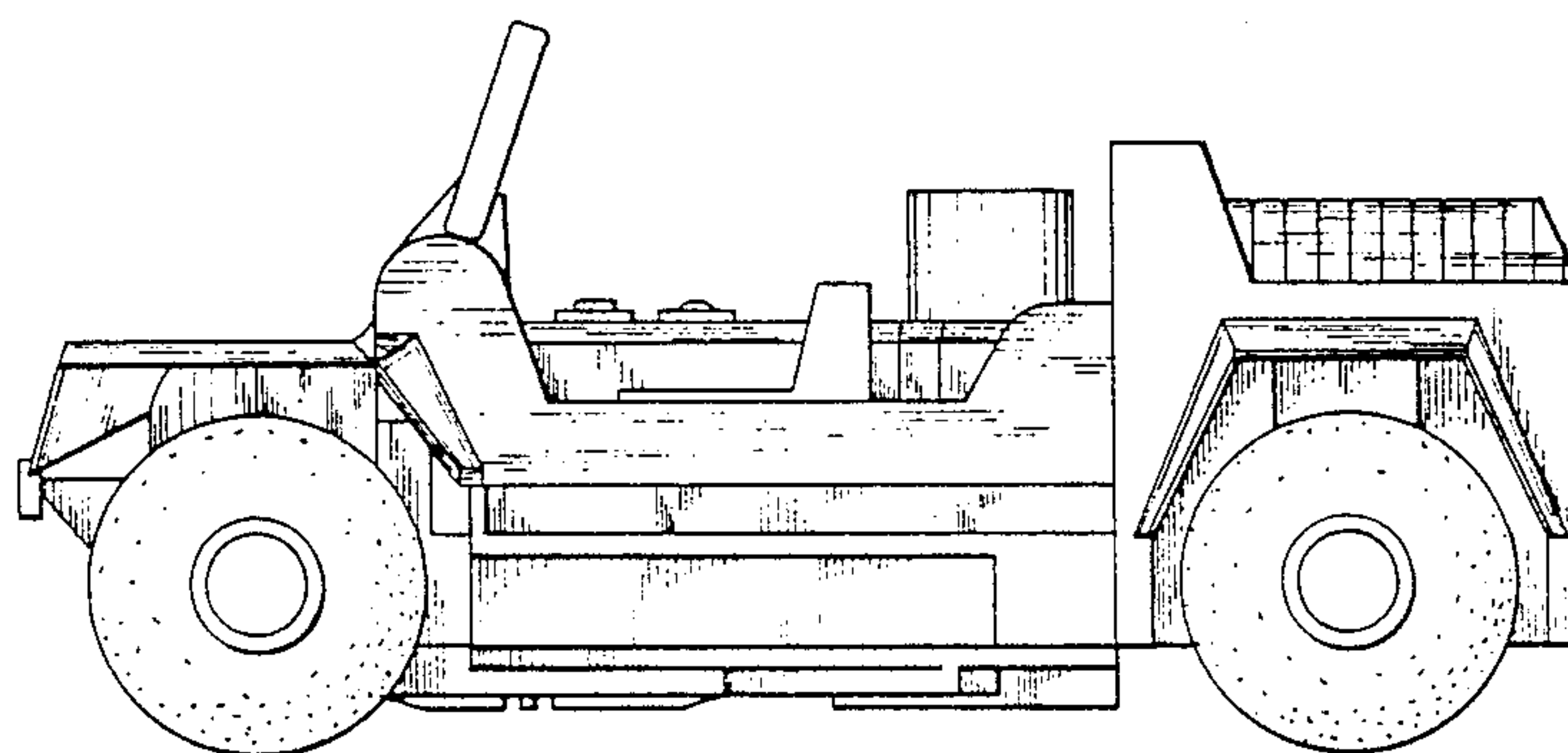

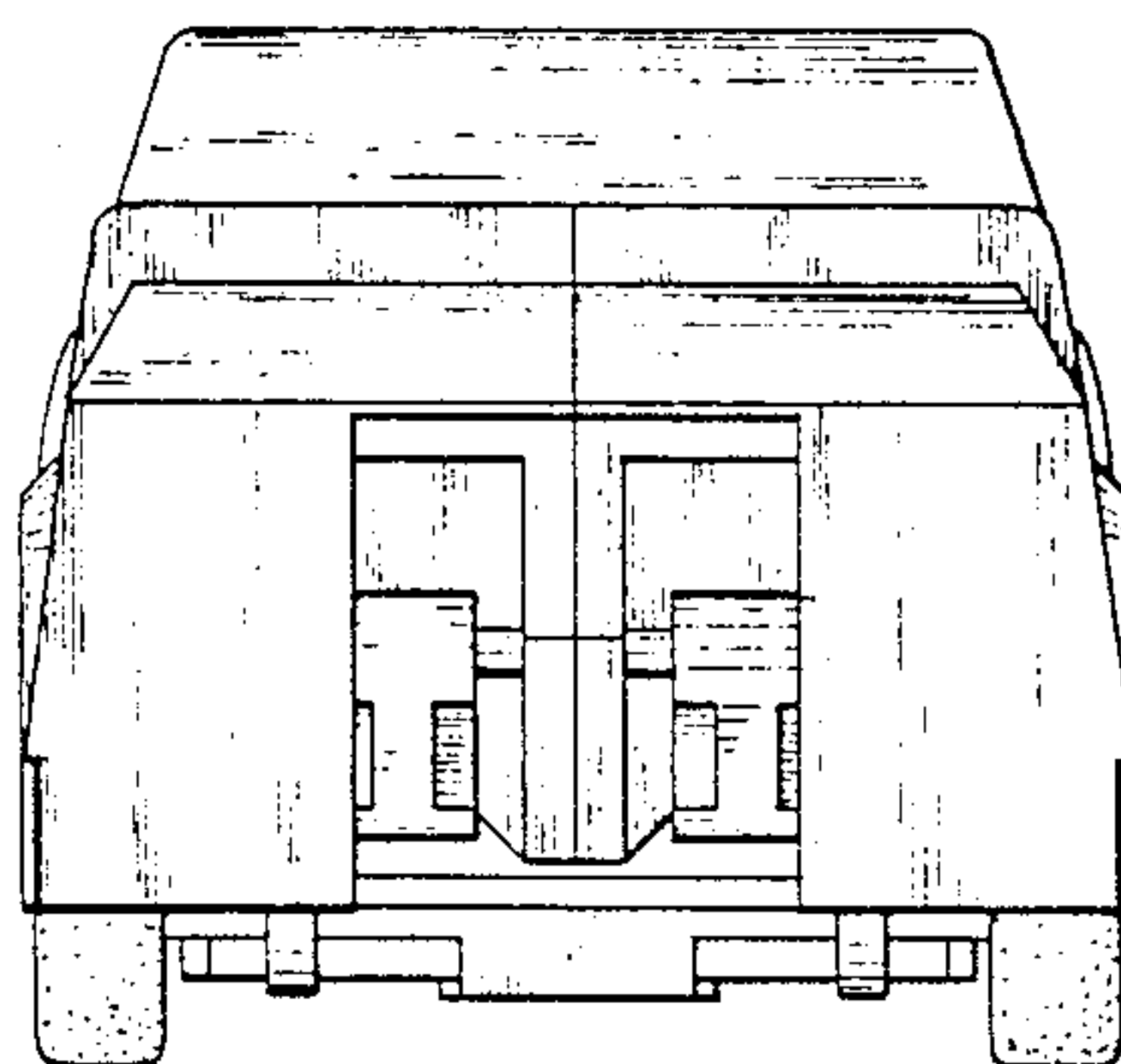

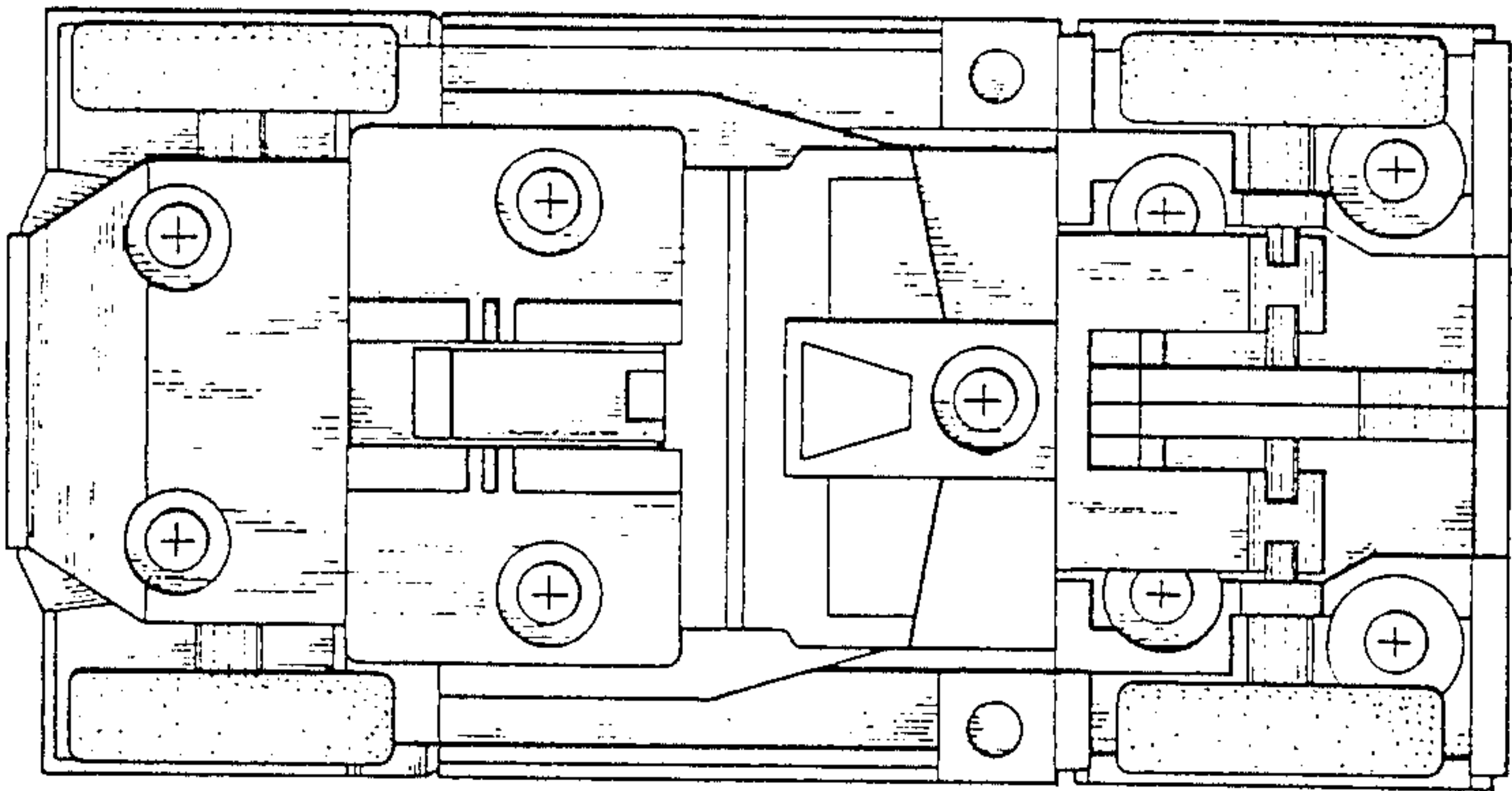
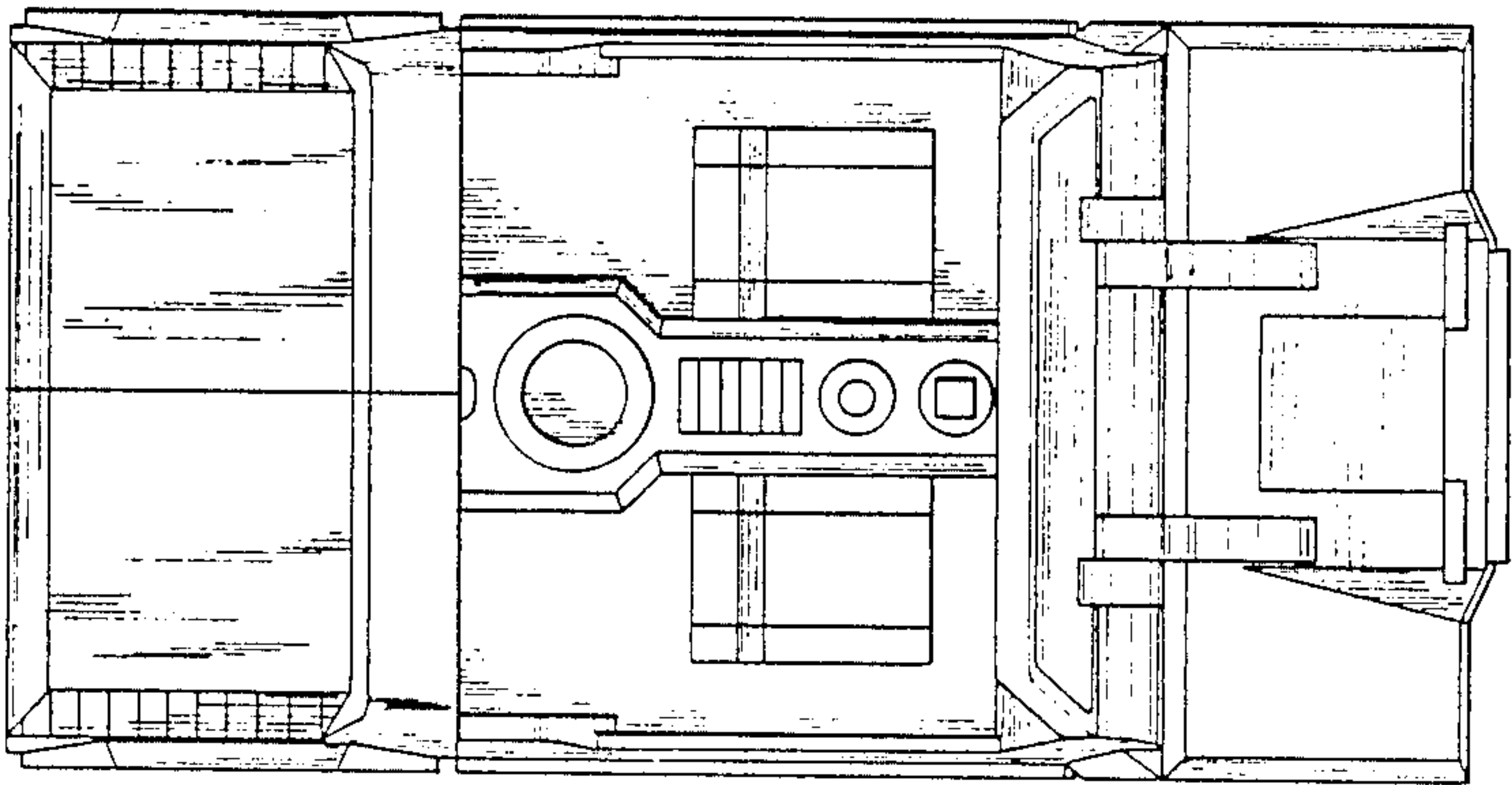

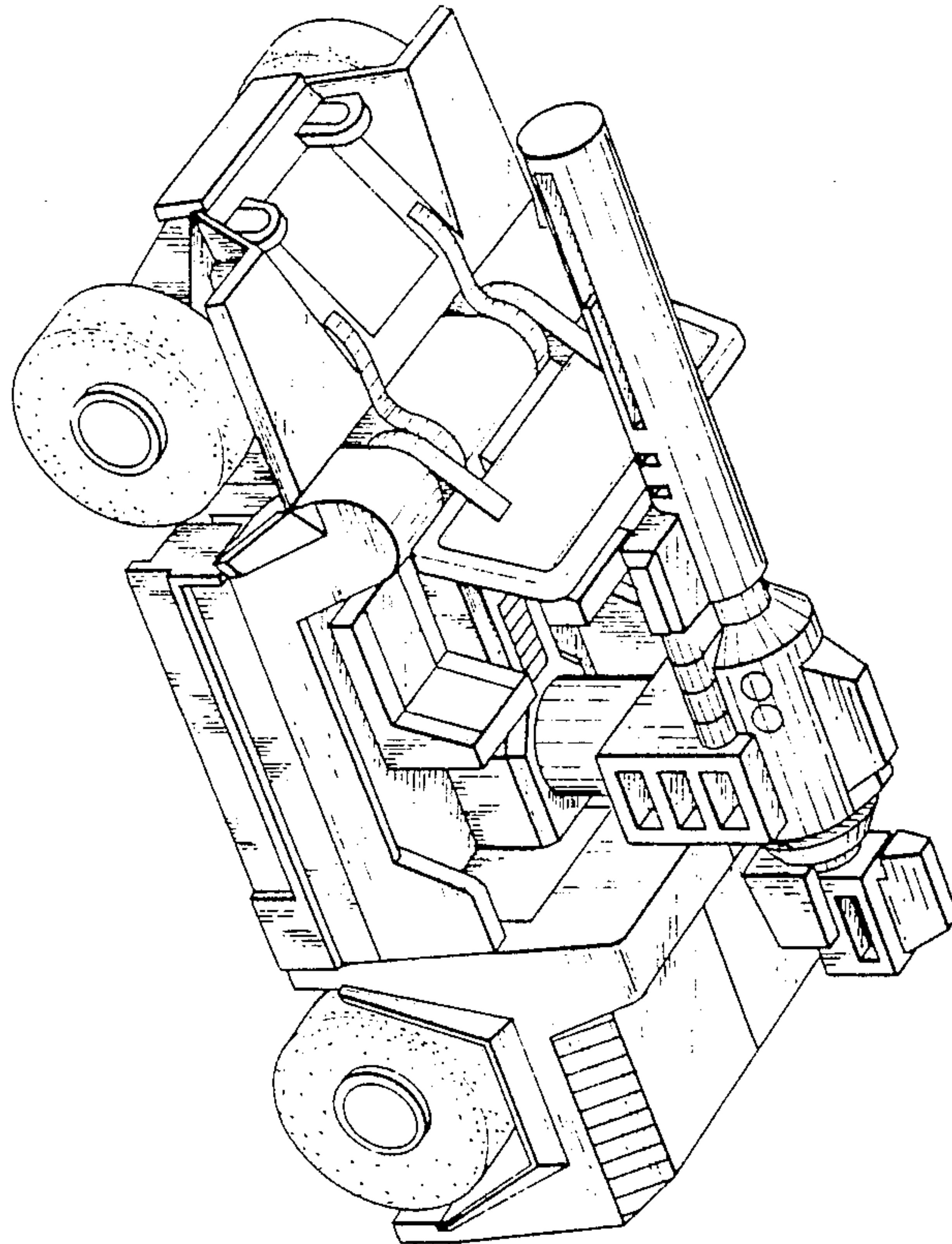

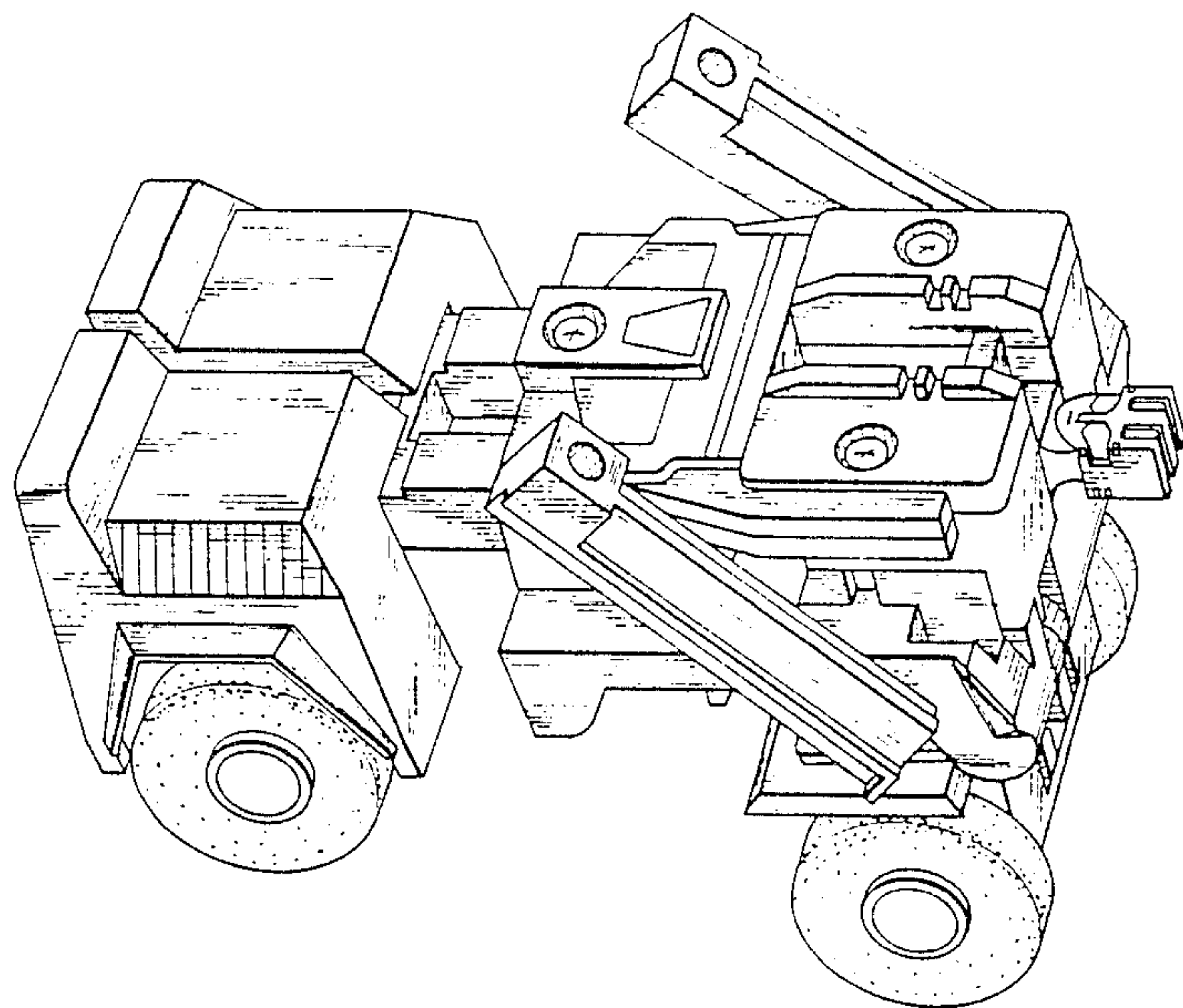

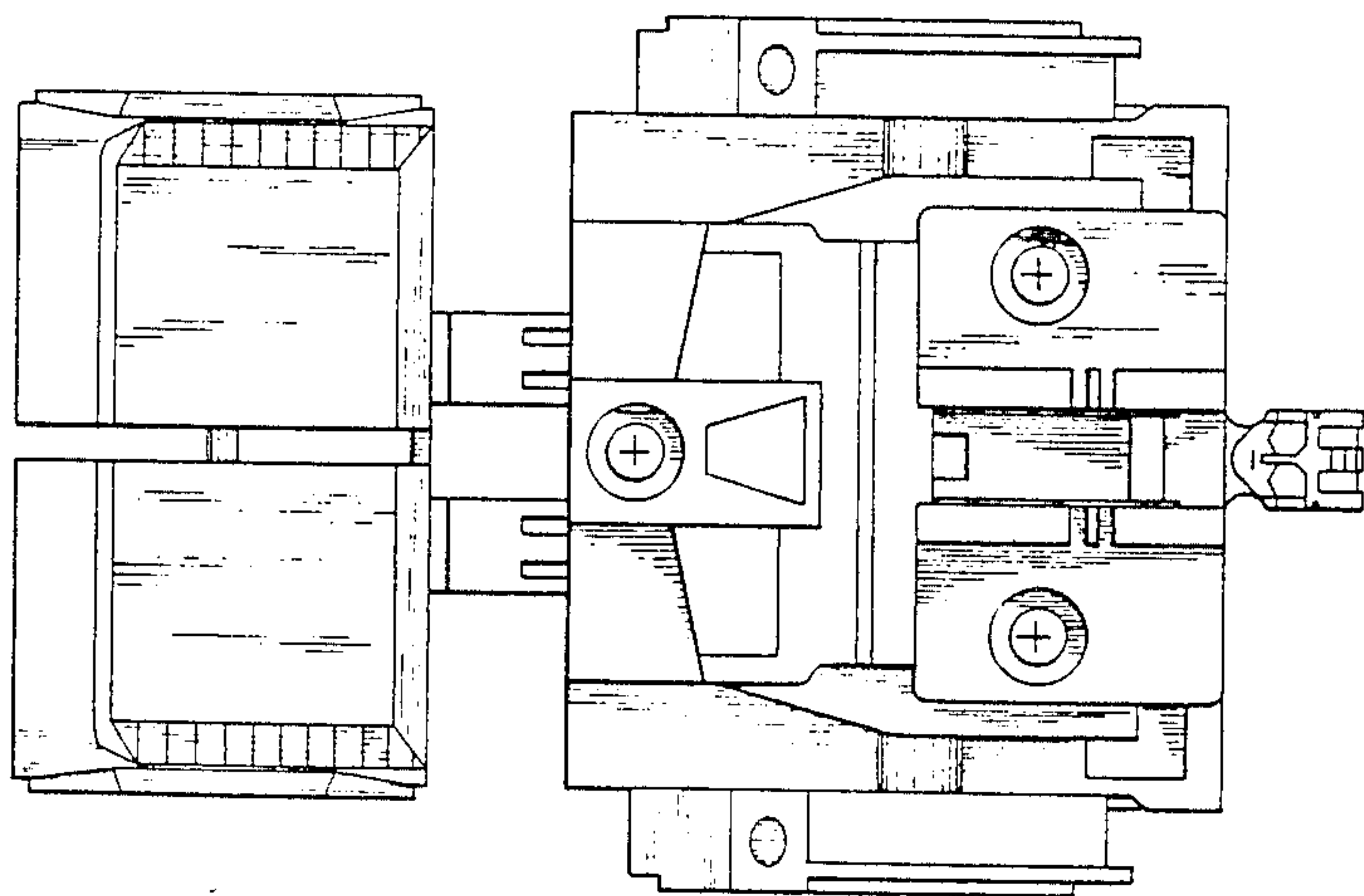

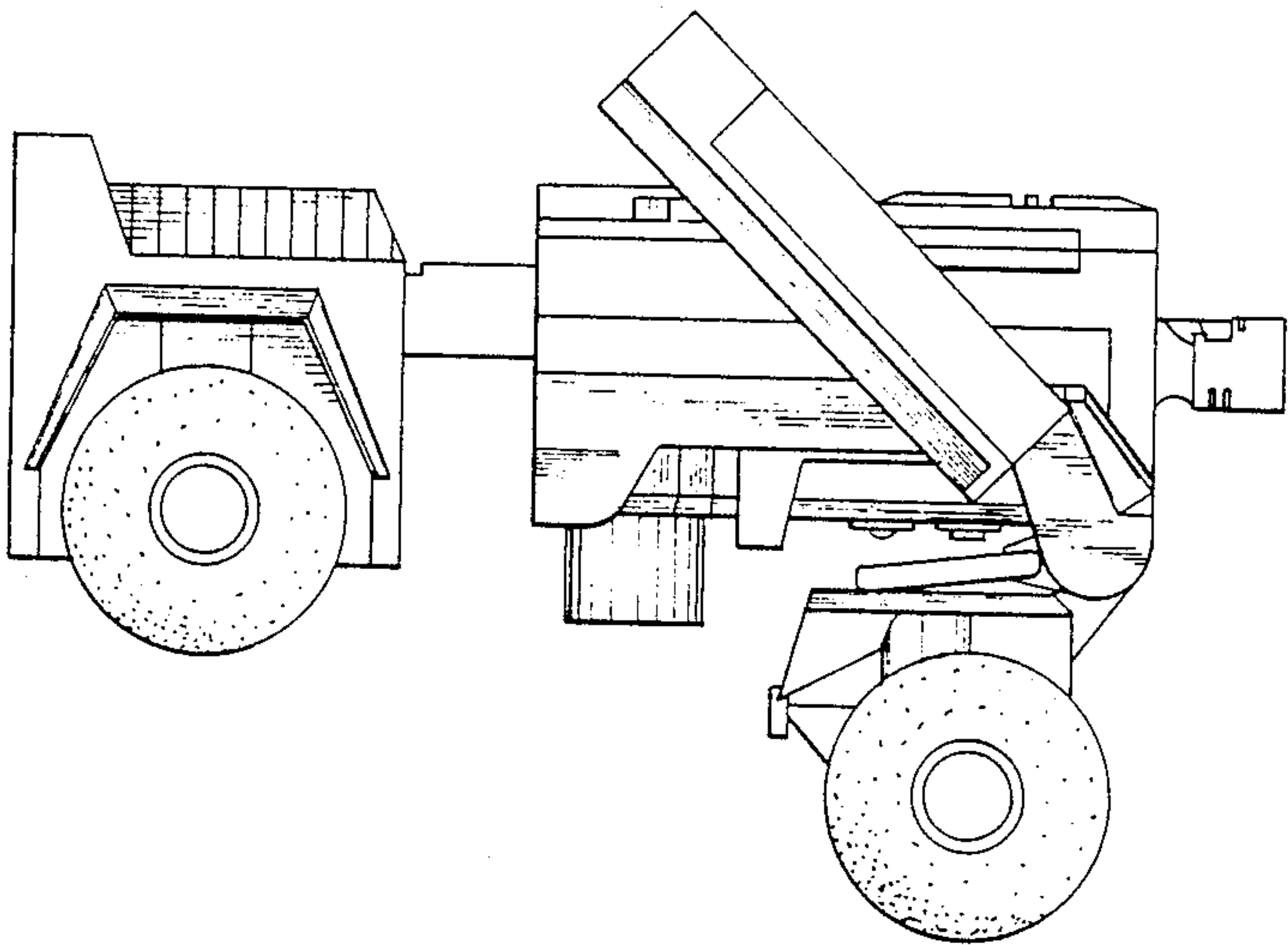

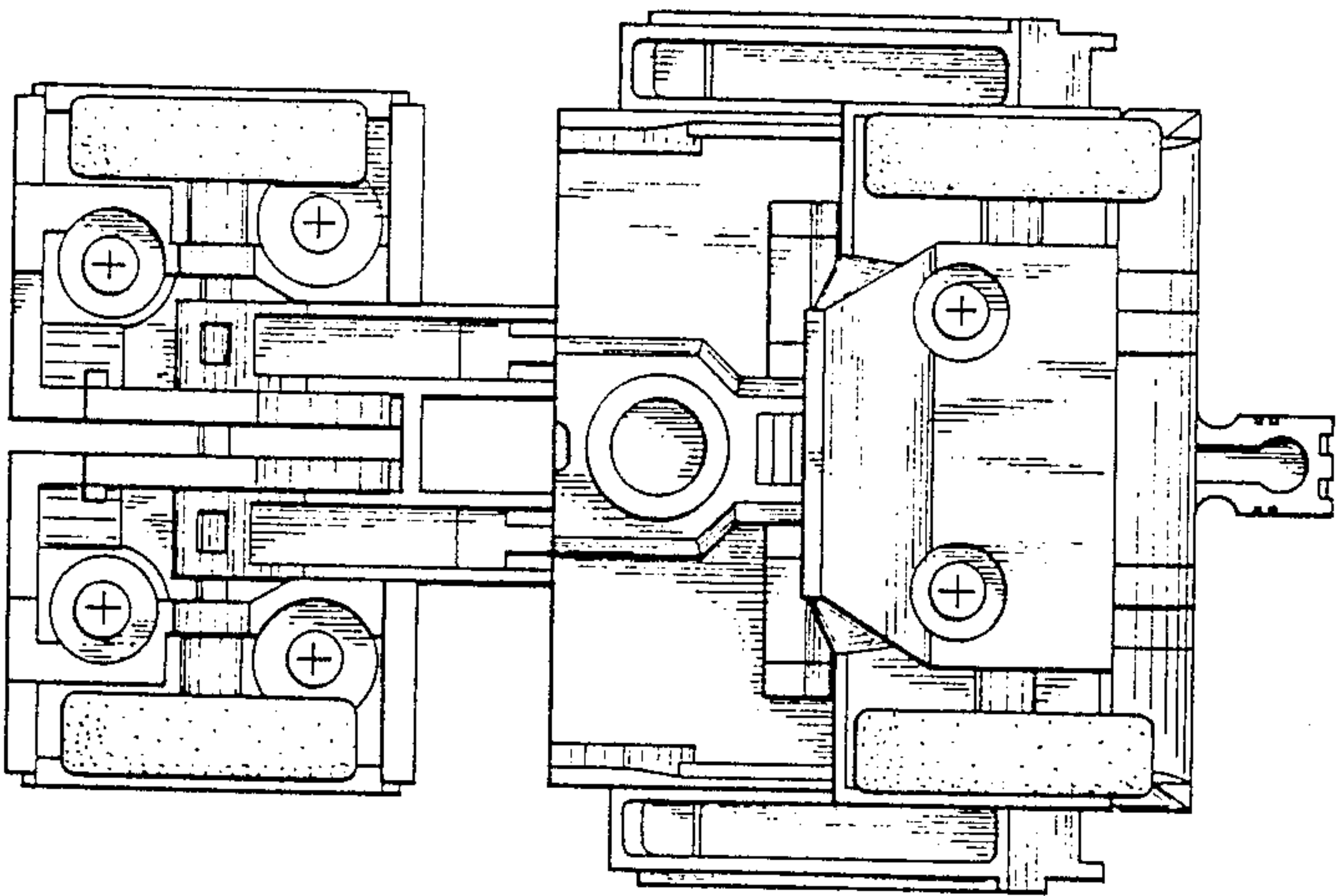

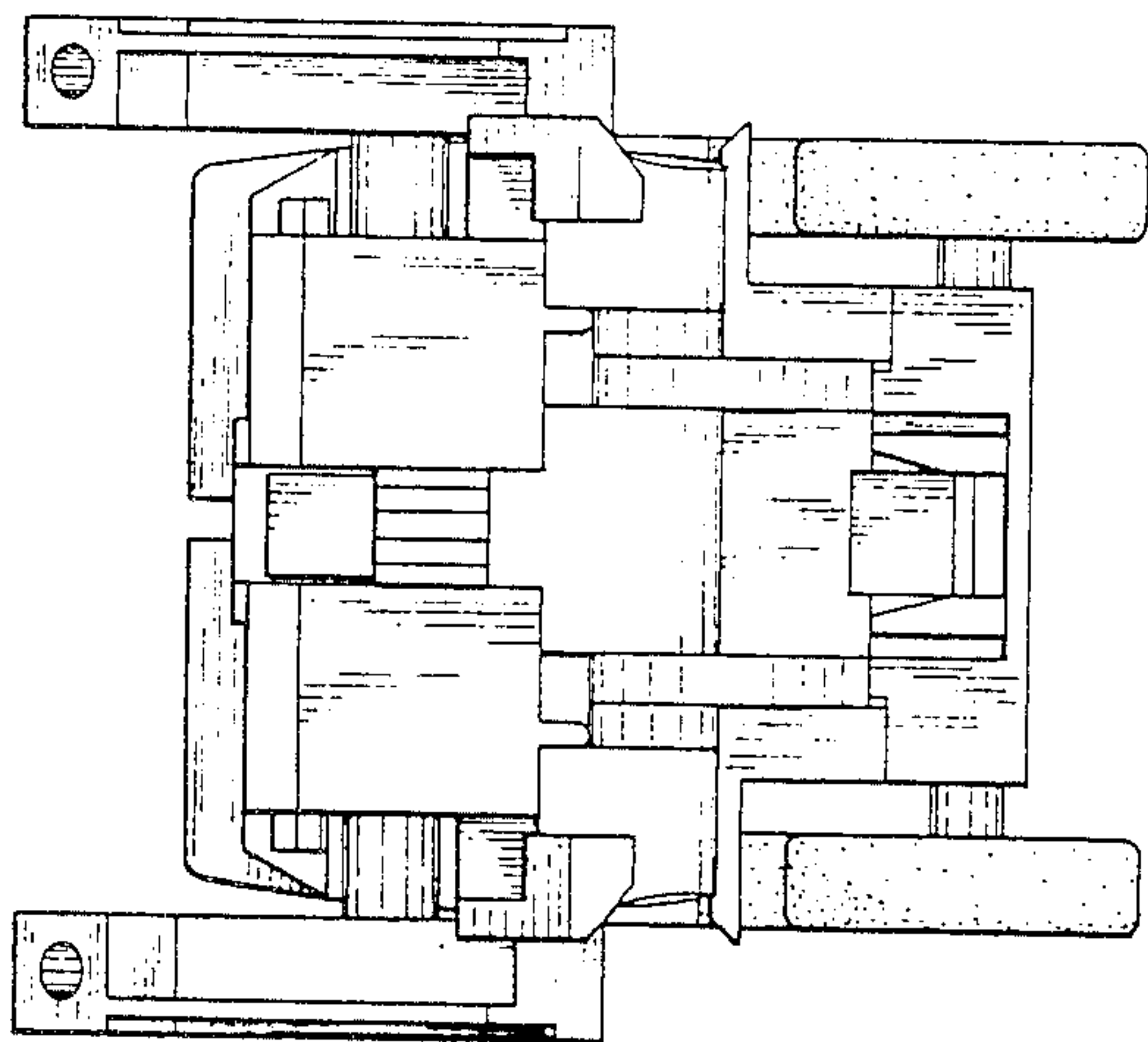

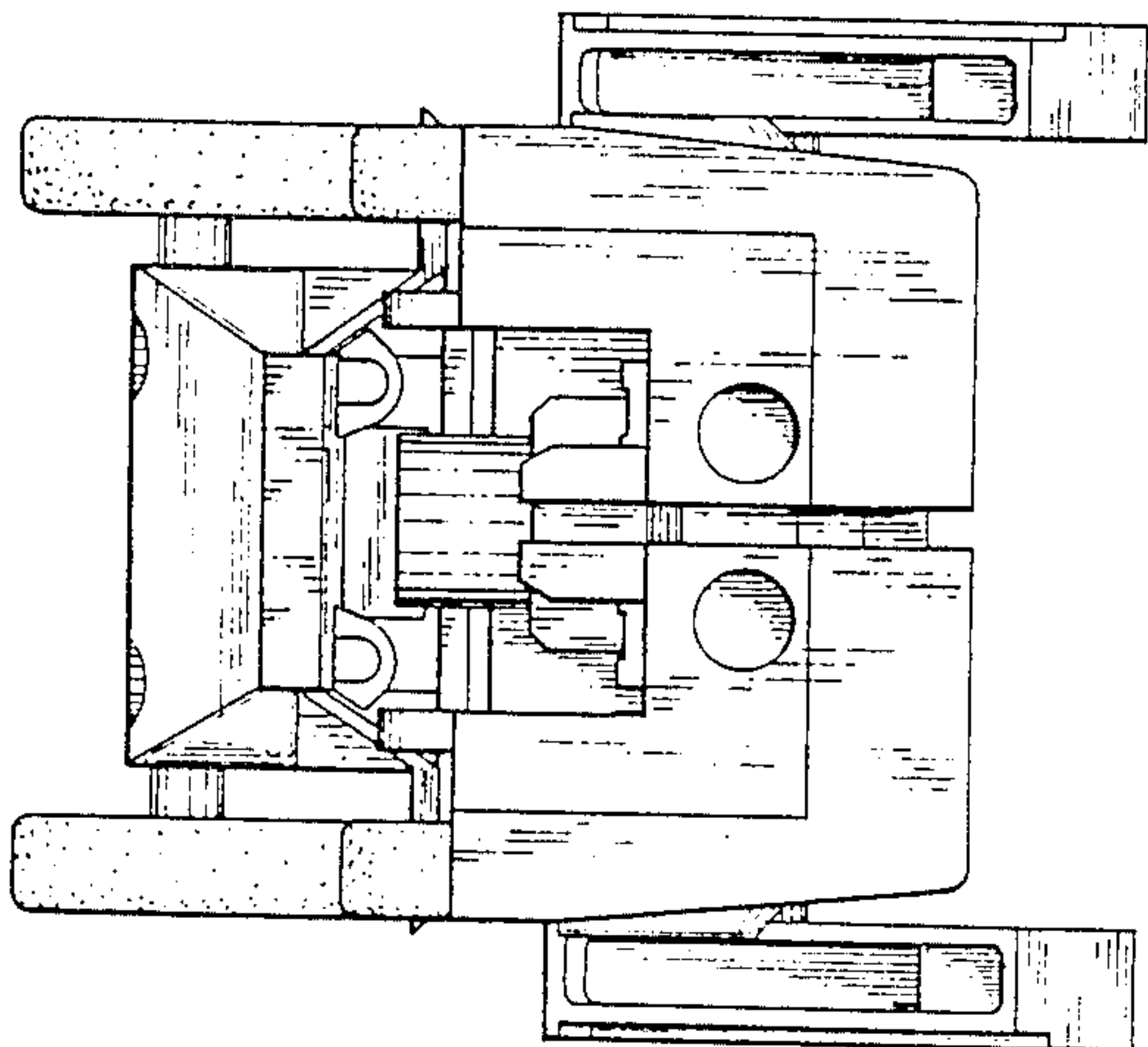
