The ornamental design for a chair as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair showing our design;

FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of a chair showing a second embodiment of our design;

FIG. 3 is a front perspective view of a chair showing a third embodiment of our design in the form of a rocking chair;

FIG. 4 is a front perspective view of a chair showing a fourth embodiment of our design; and

FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view of the chair embodiment shown in FIG. 1.

The sides of the chair forms not shown are mirror images of the respective sides shown.

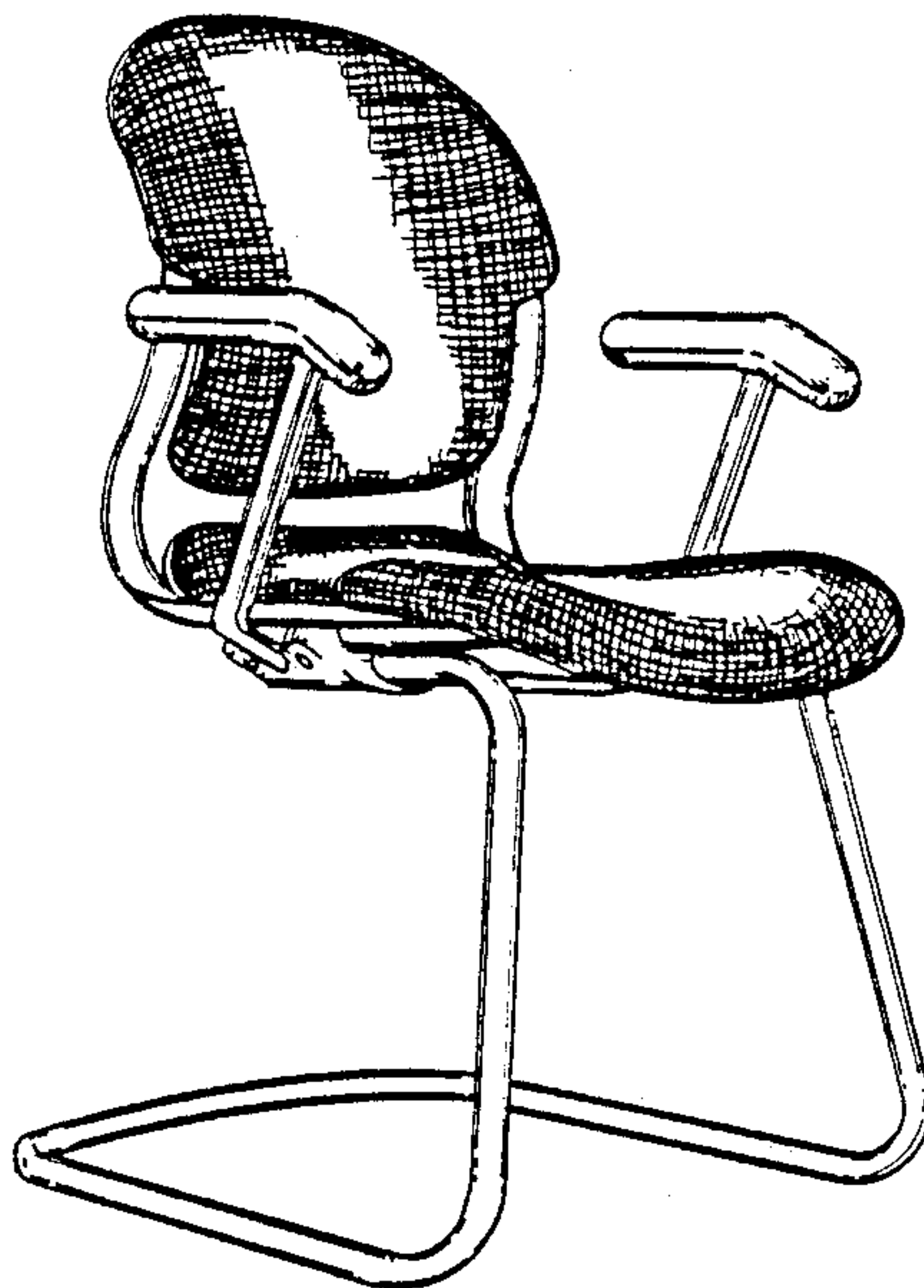

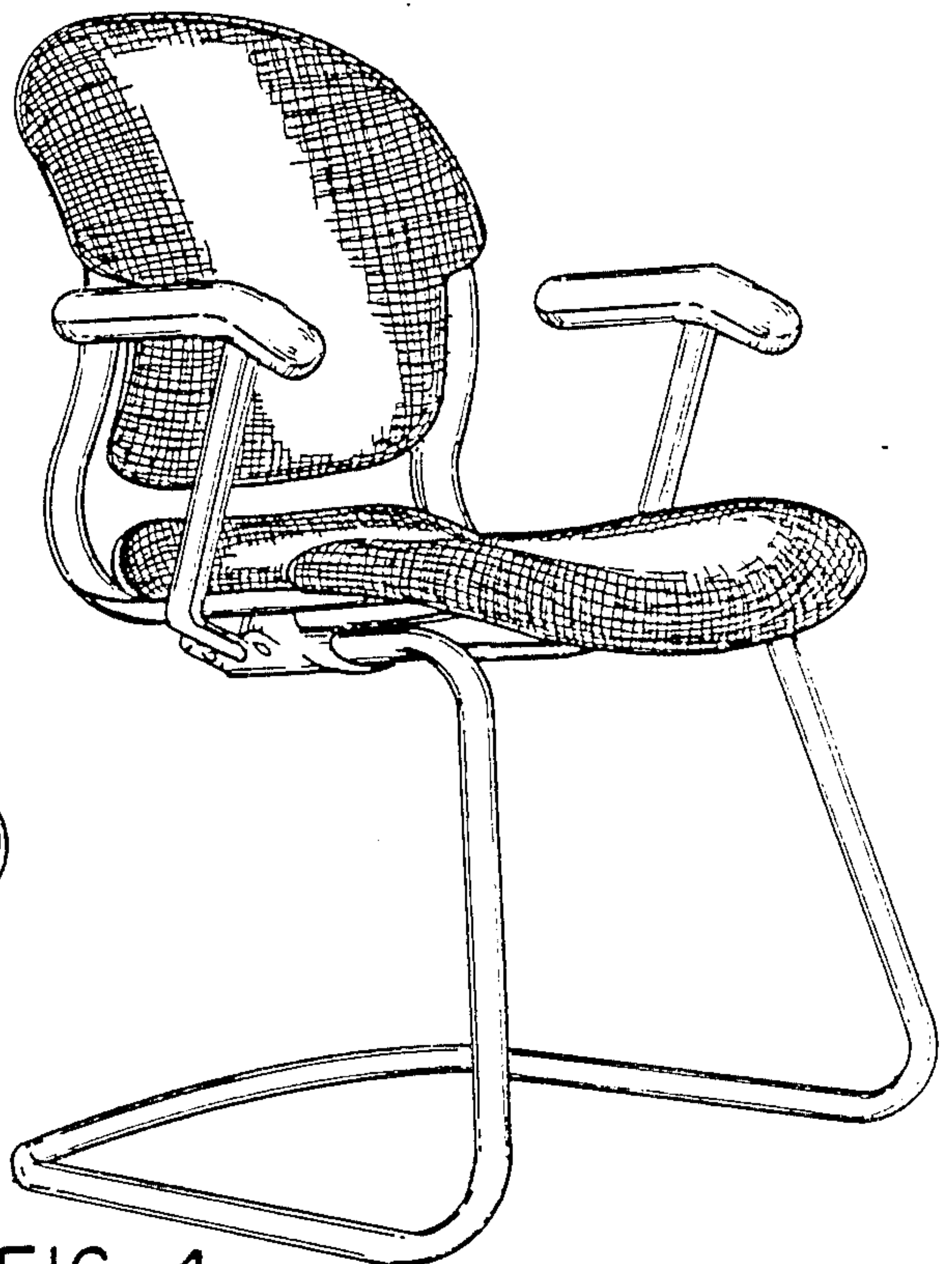

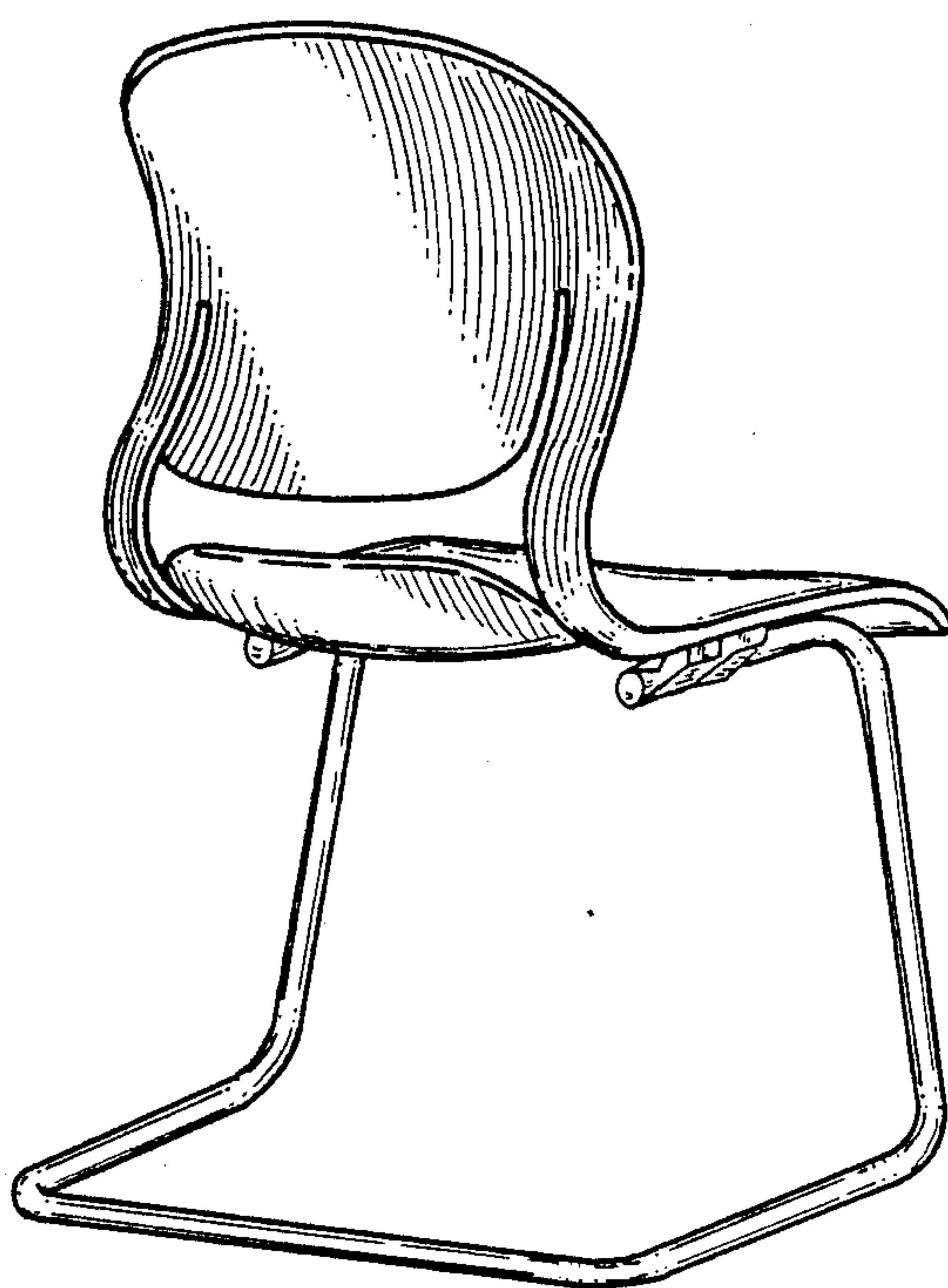
