FIG. 1 is a top, front perspective view of a reader for computer readable printed data showing my new design;

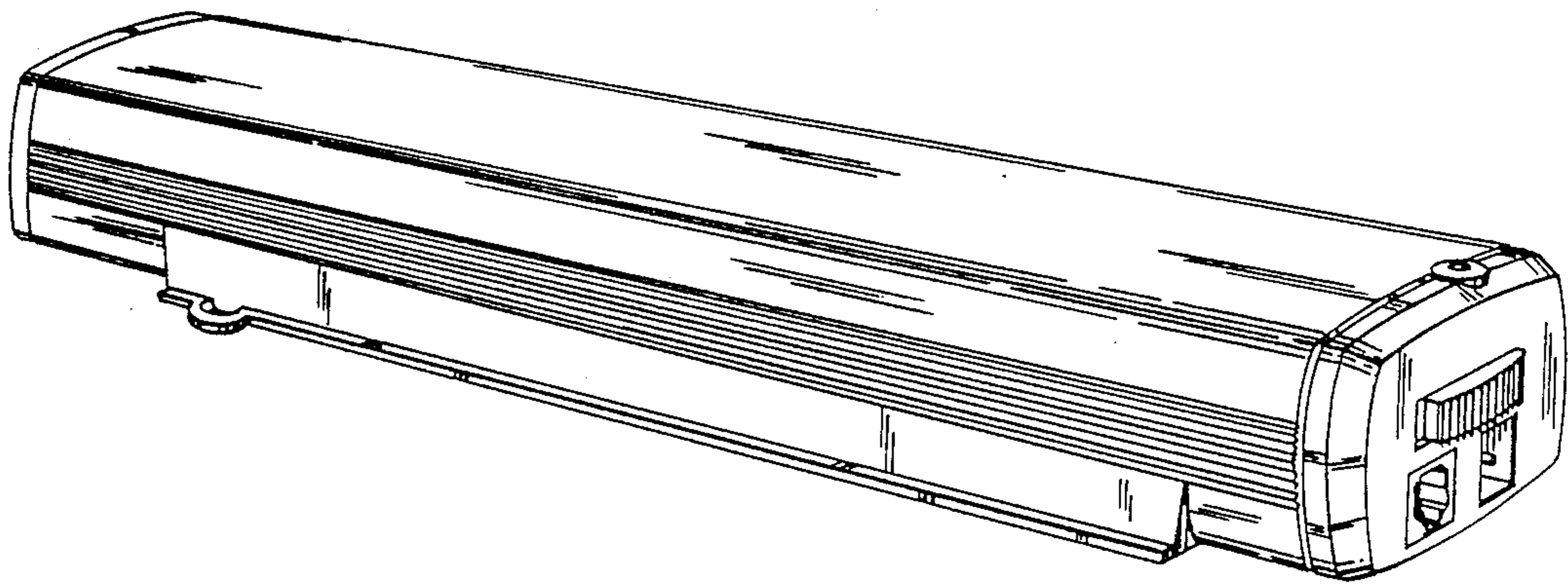
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof on an enlarged scale; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof on an enlarged scale;

FIG. 7 is a left end elevational view thereof on a greatly enlarged scale.



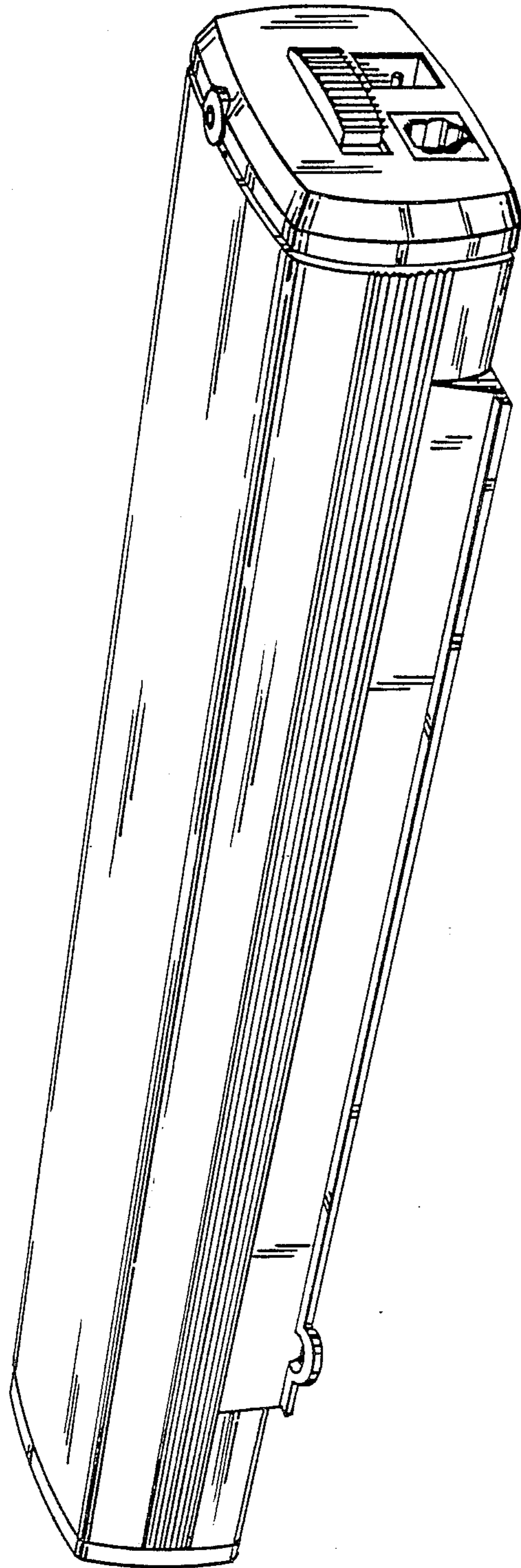

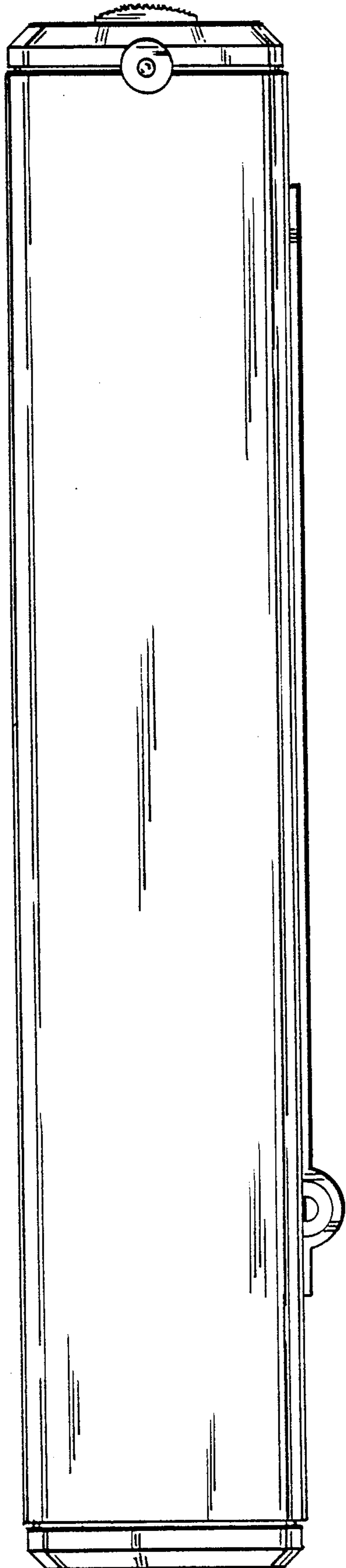

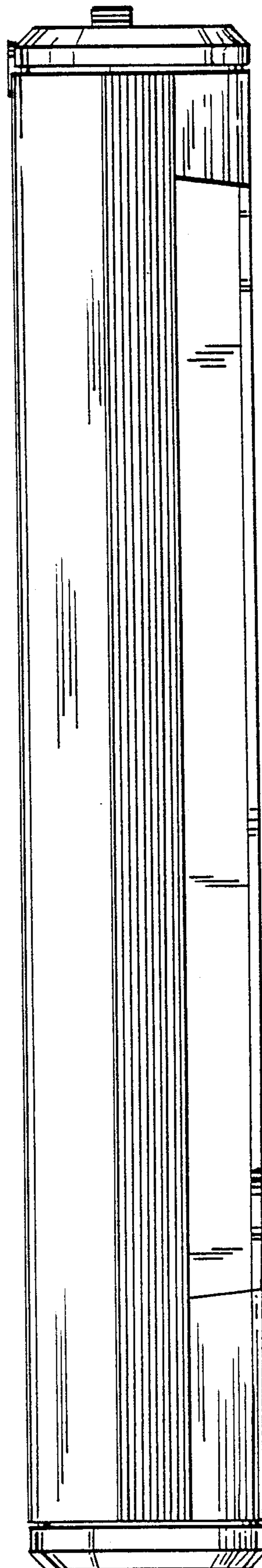

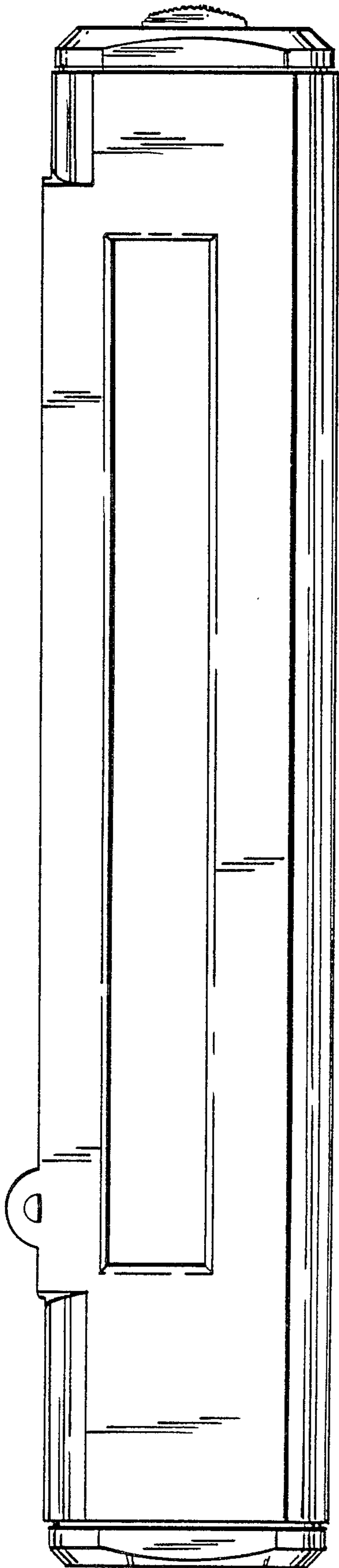

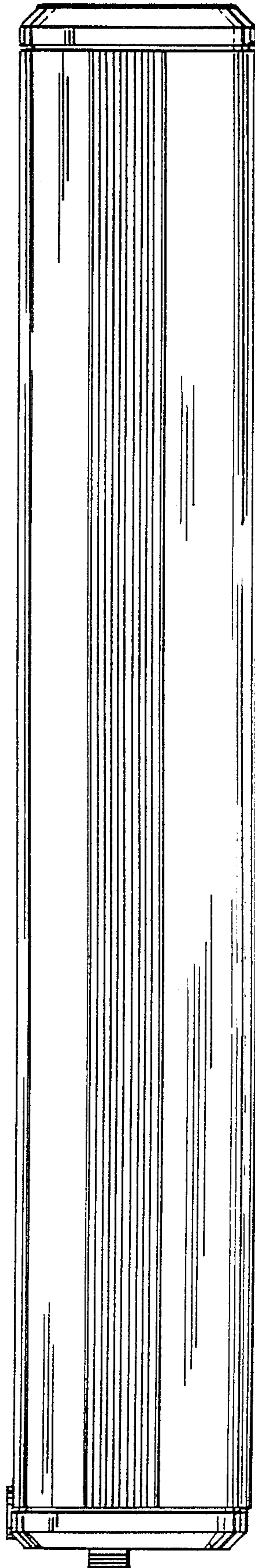

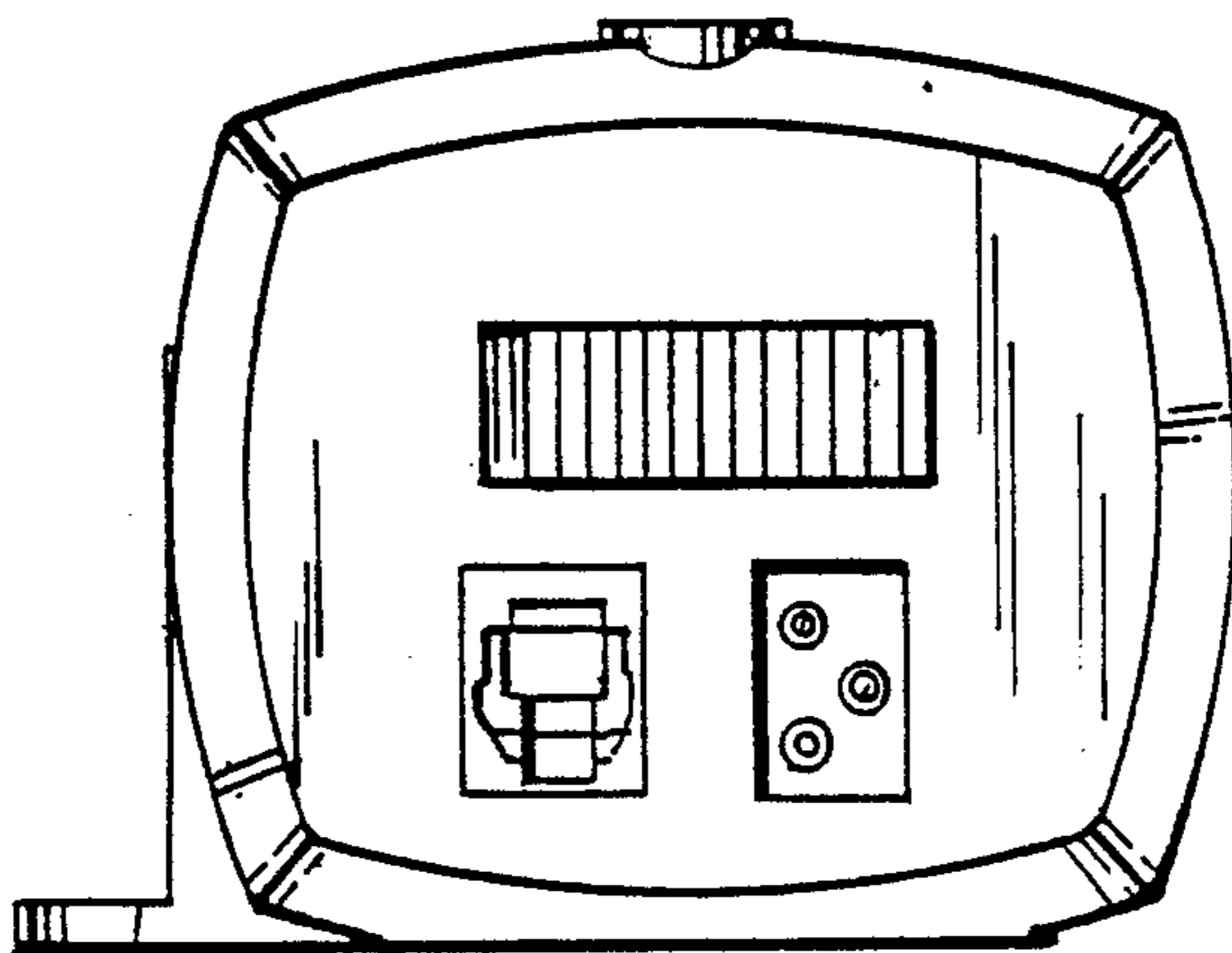

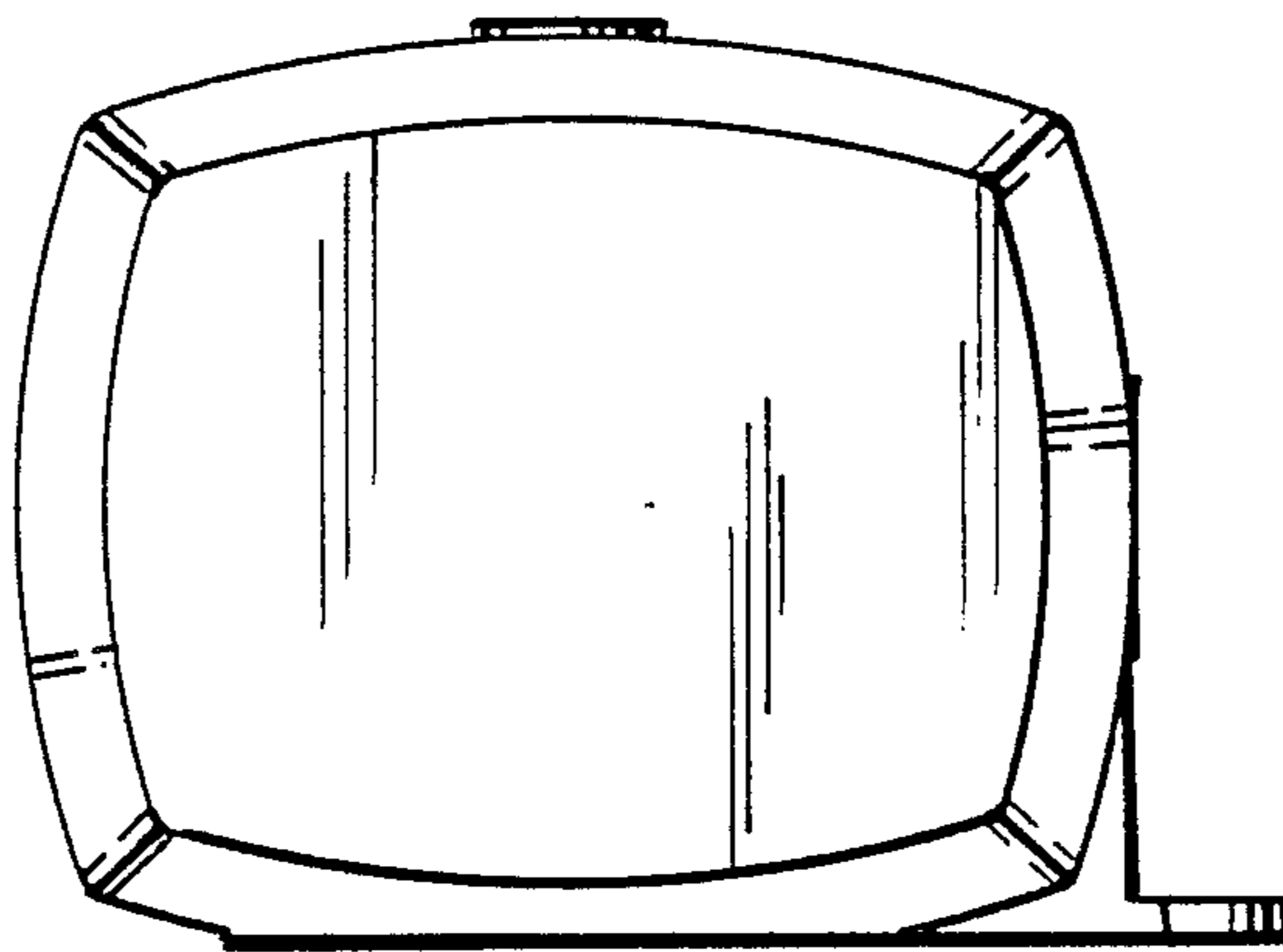
