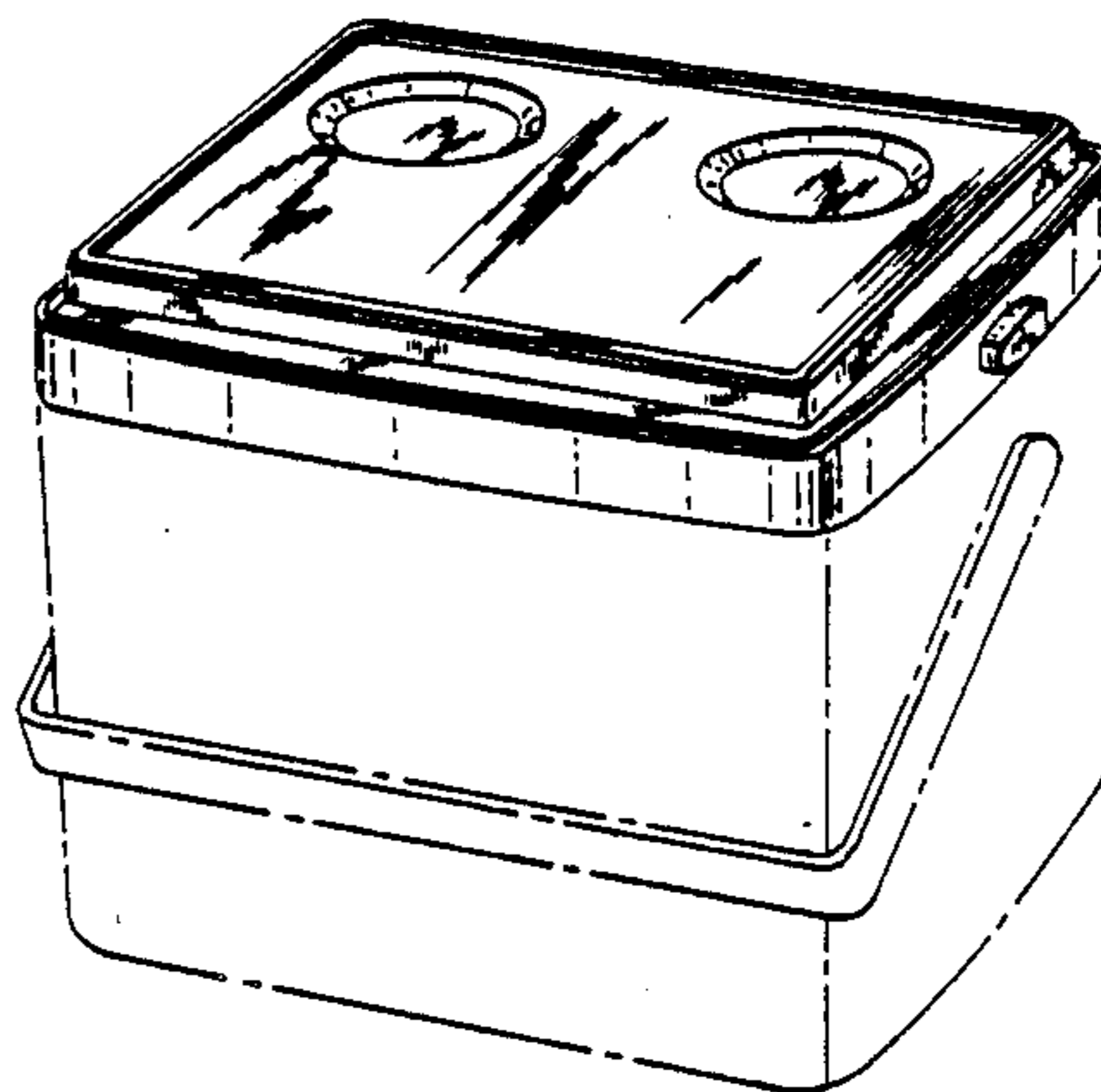
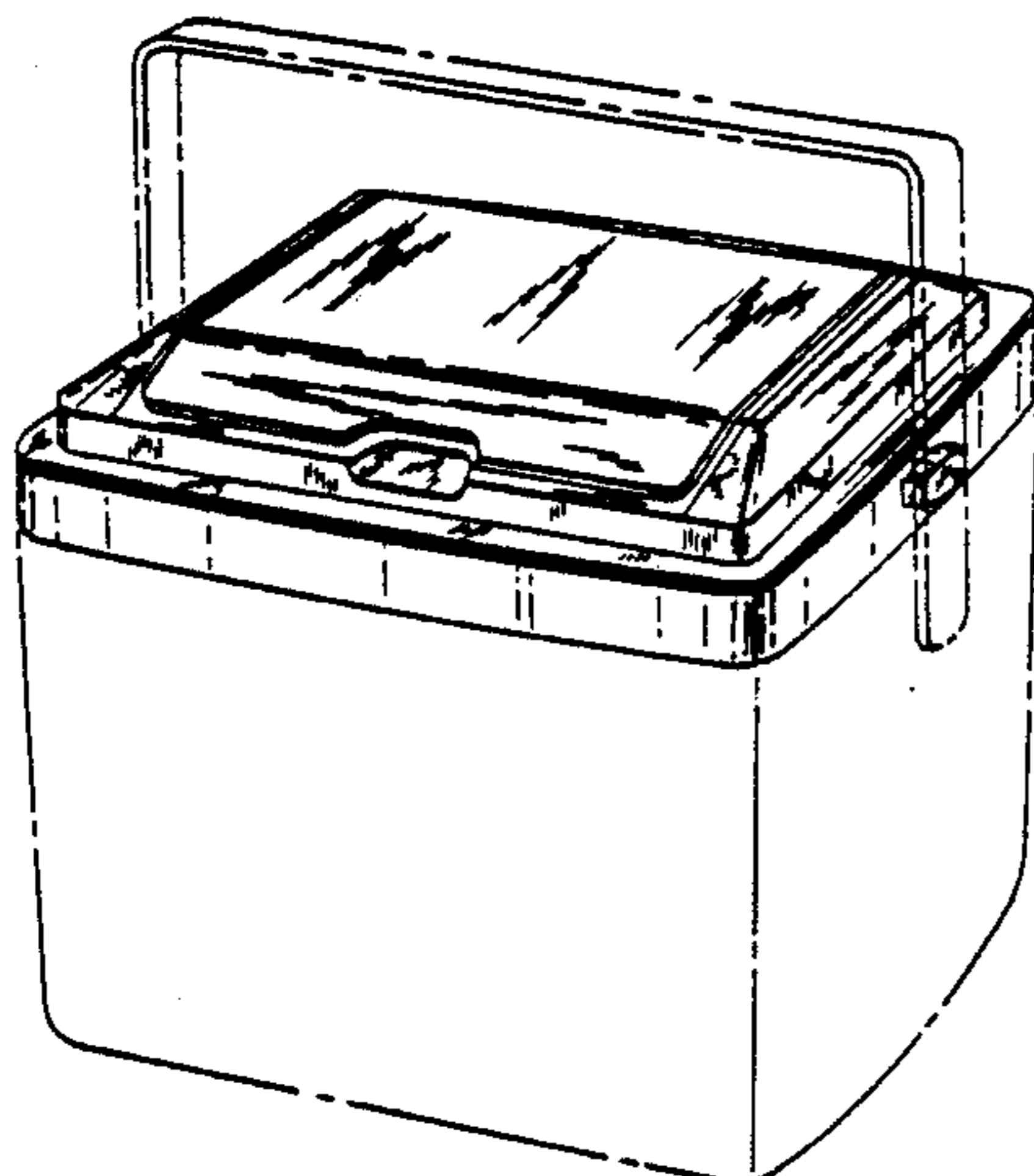

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pocketed lid for cooler, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, right side perspective view of a pocketed lid for cooler, showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom, rear, left side perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is an enlarged front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is an enlarged right side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image; FIG. 5 is an enlarged top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is an enlarged bottom plan view thereof. The broken-line showing of the coolers in FIGS. 1 and 2 are for illustrative purposes only.



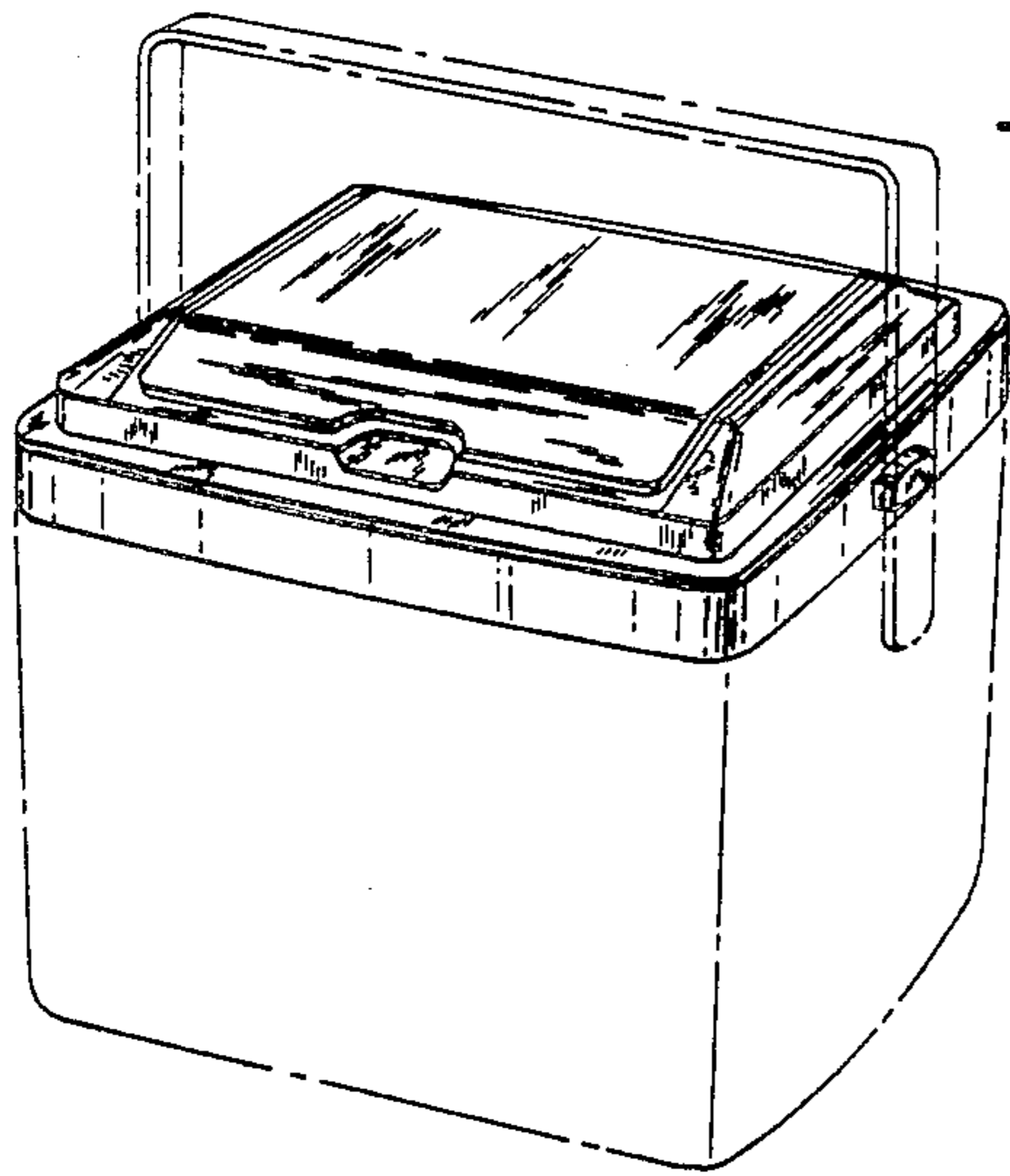

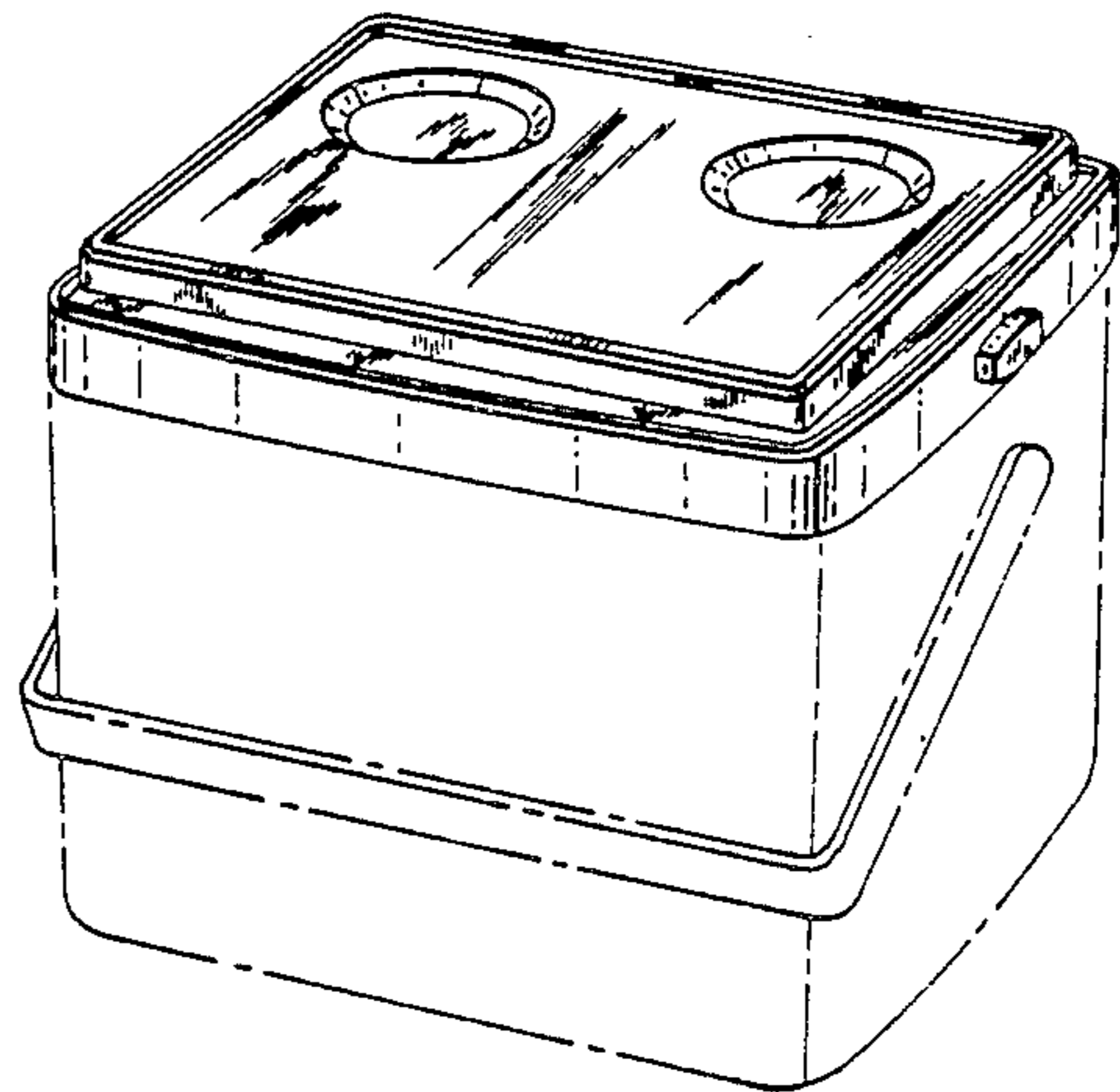

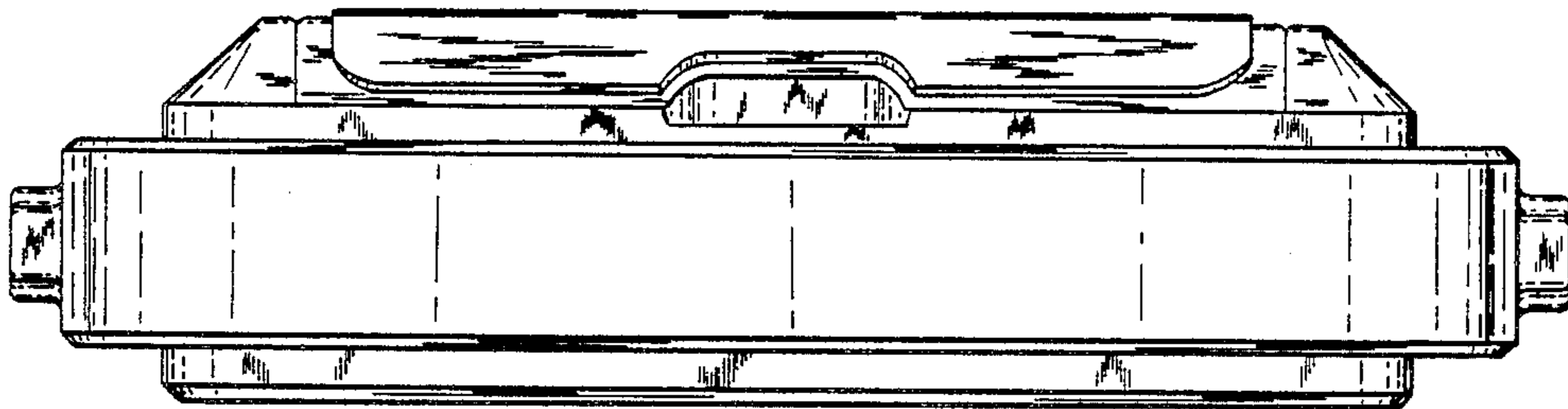

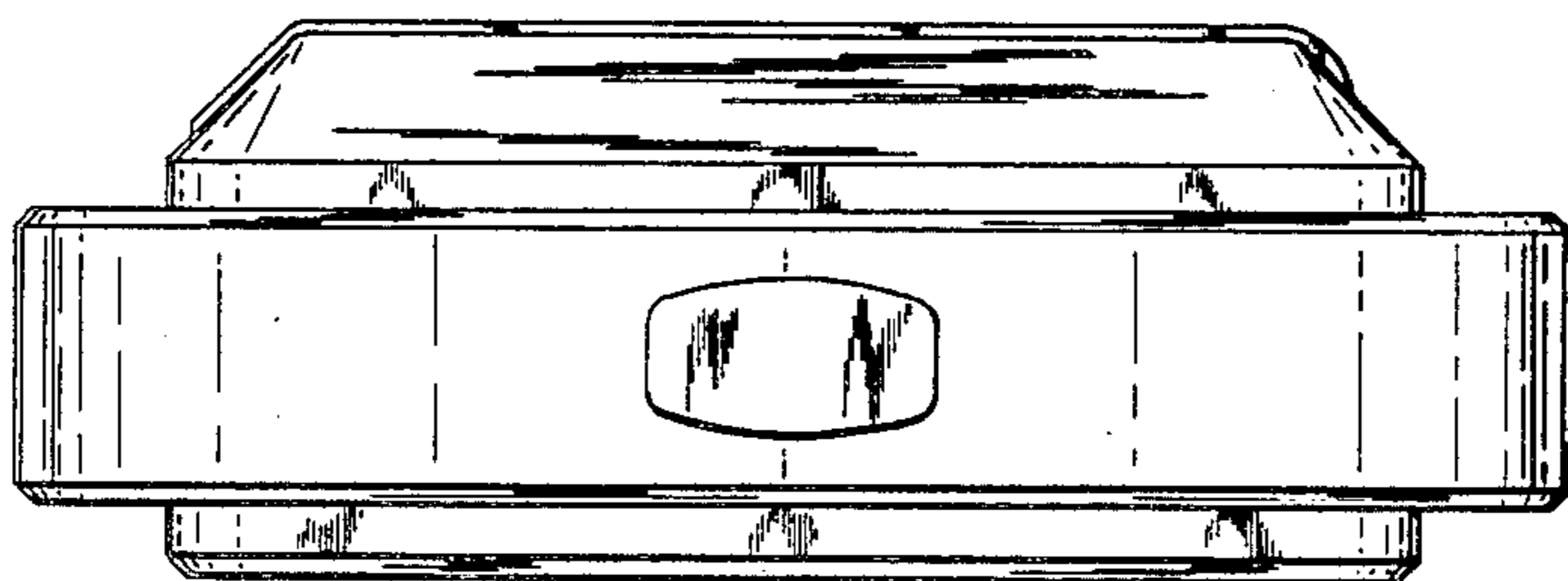

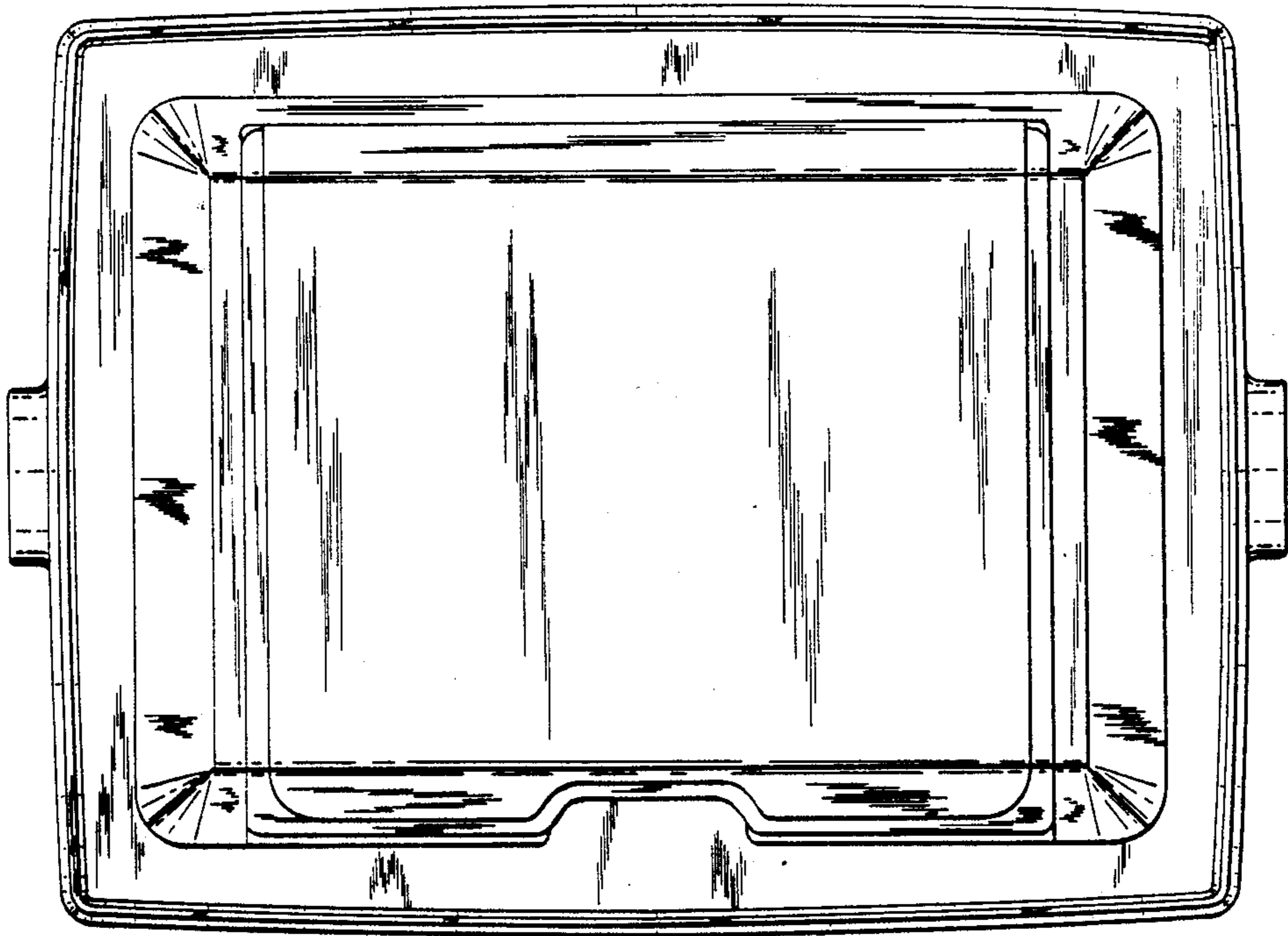

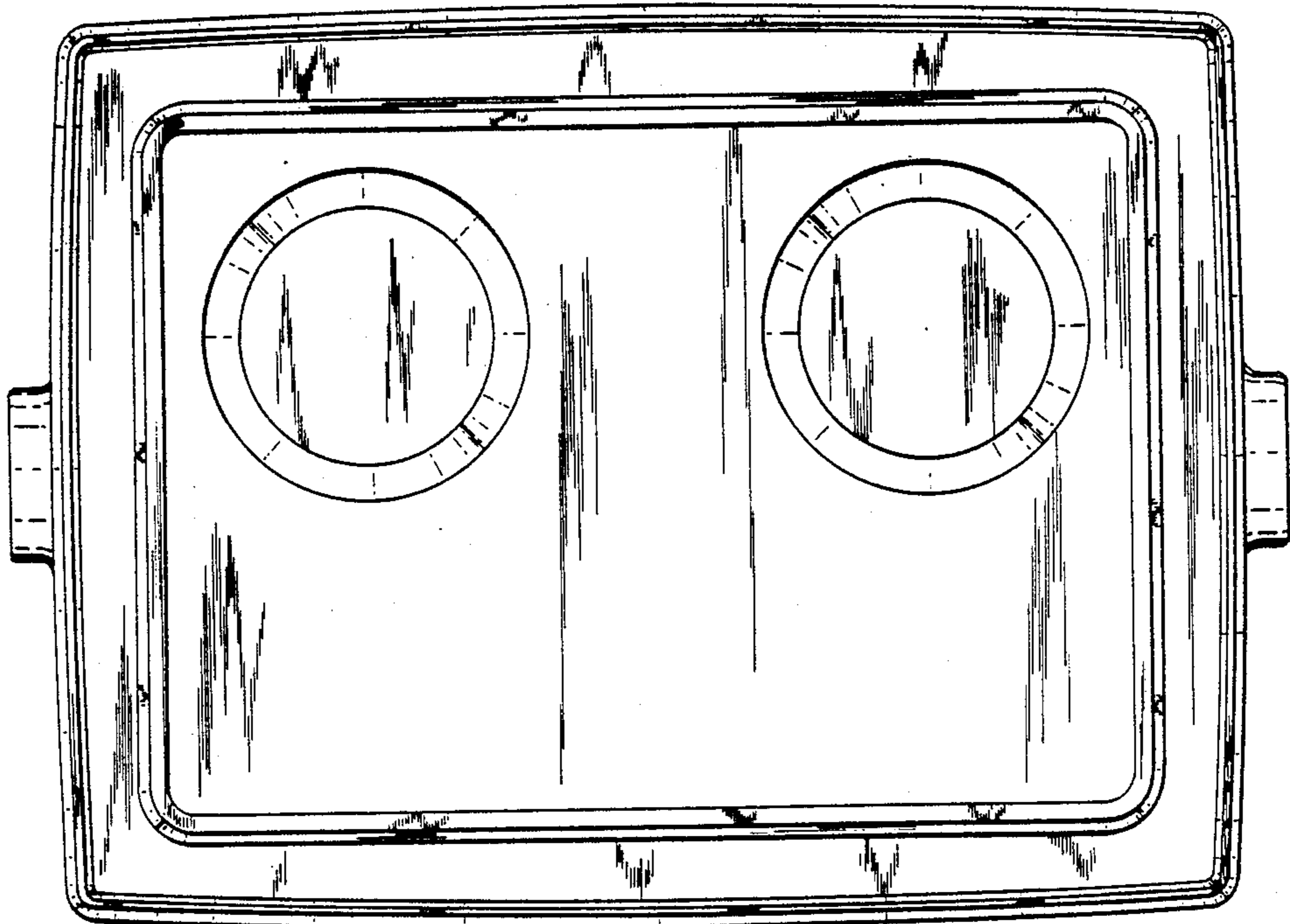
