The ornamental design for an air crash tender vehicle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevation view of an air crash tender vehicle showing my new design, the opposite side elevation view being a mirror image of that shown;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof.

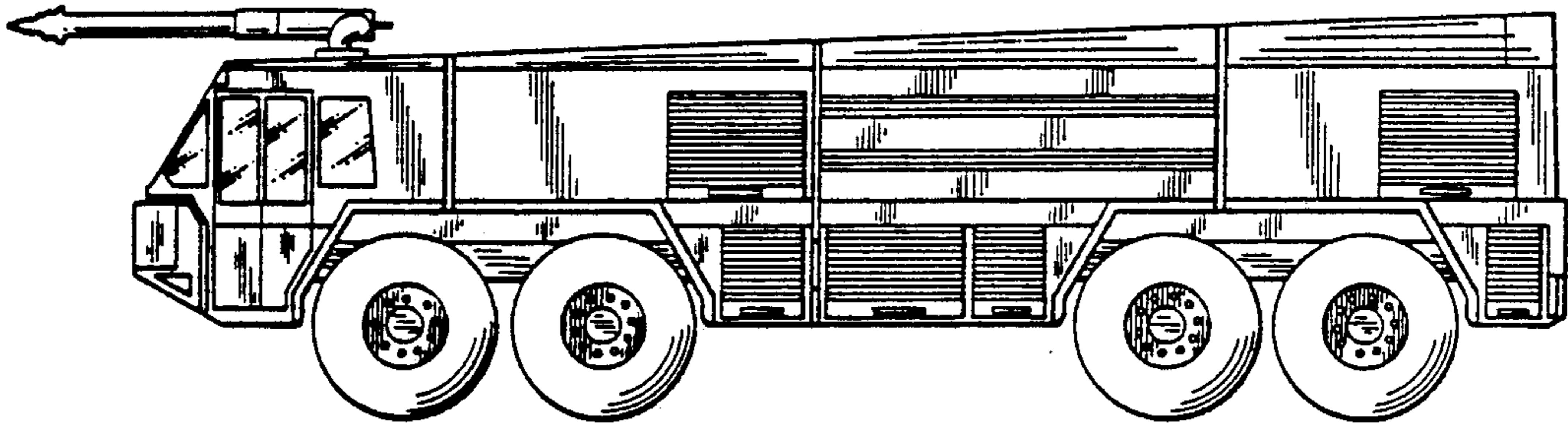

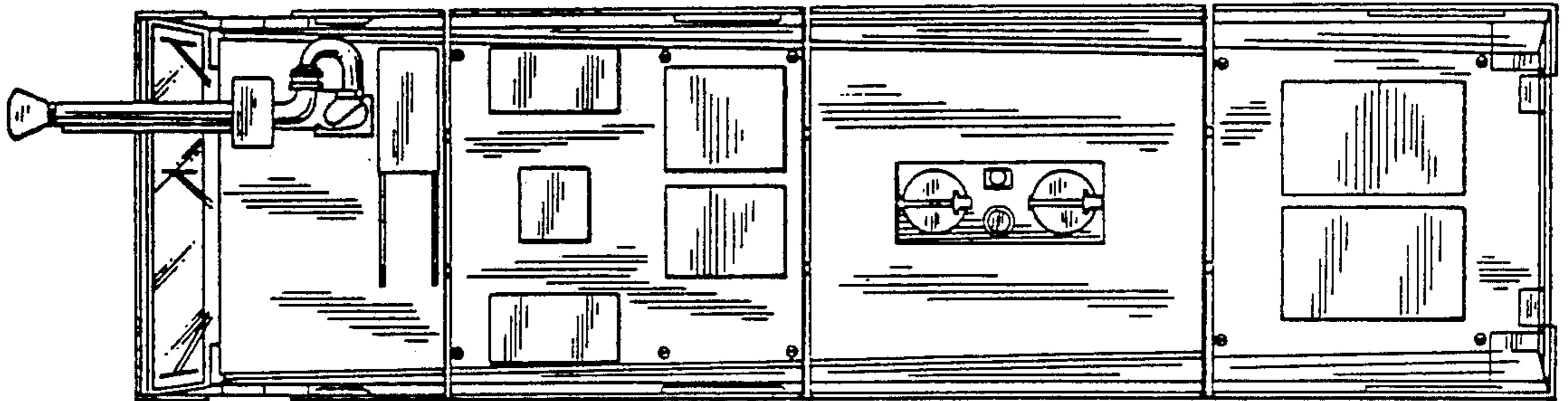
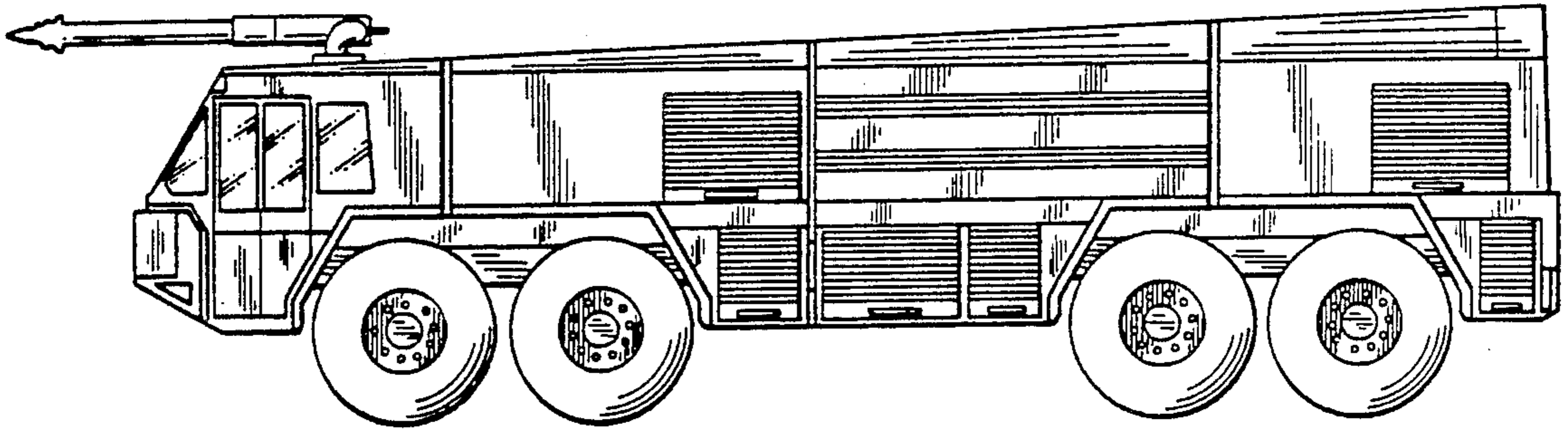

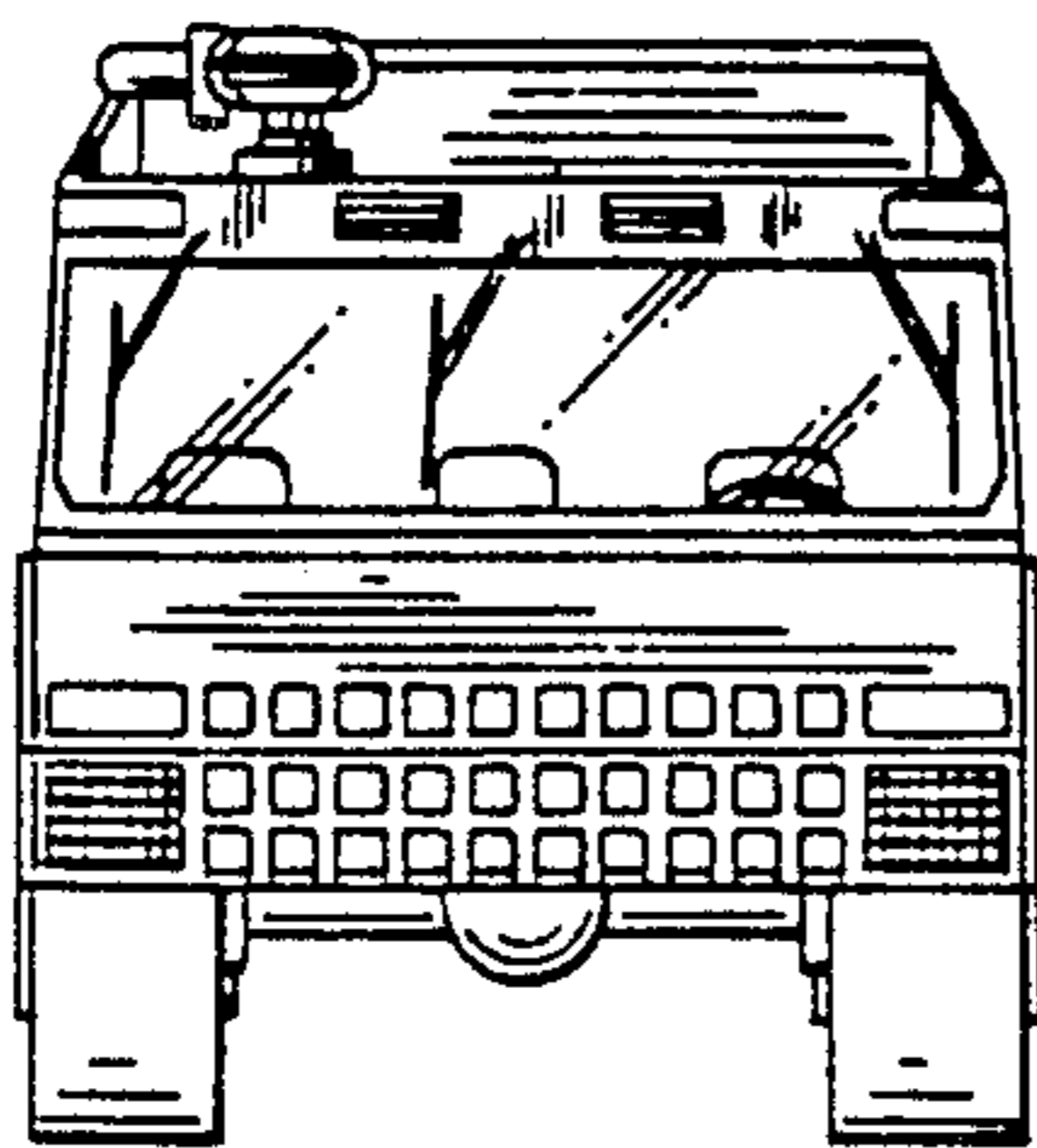

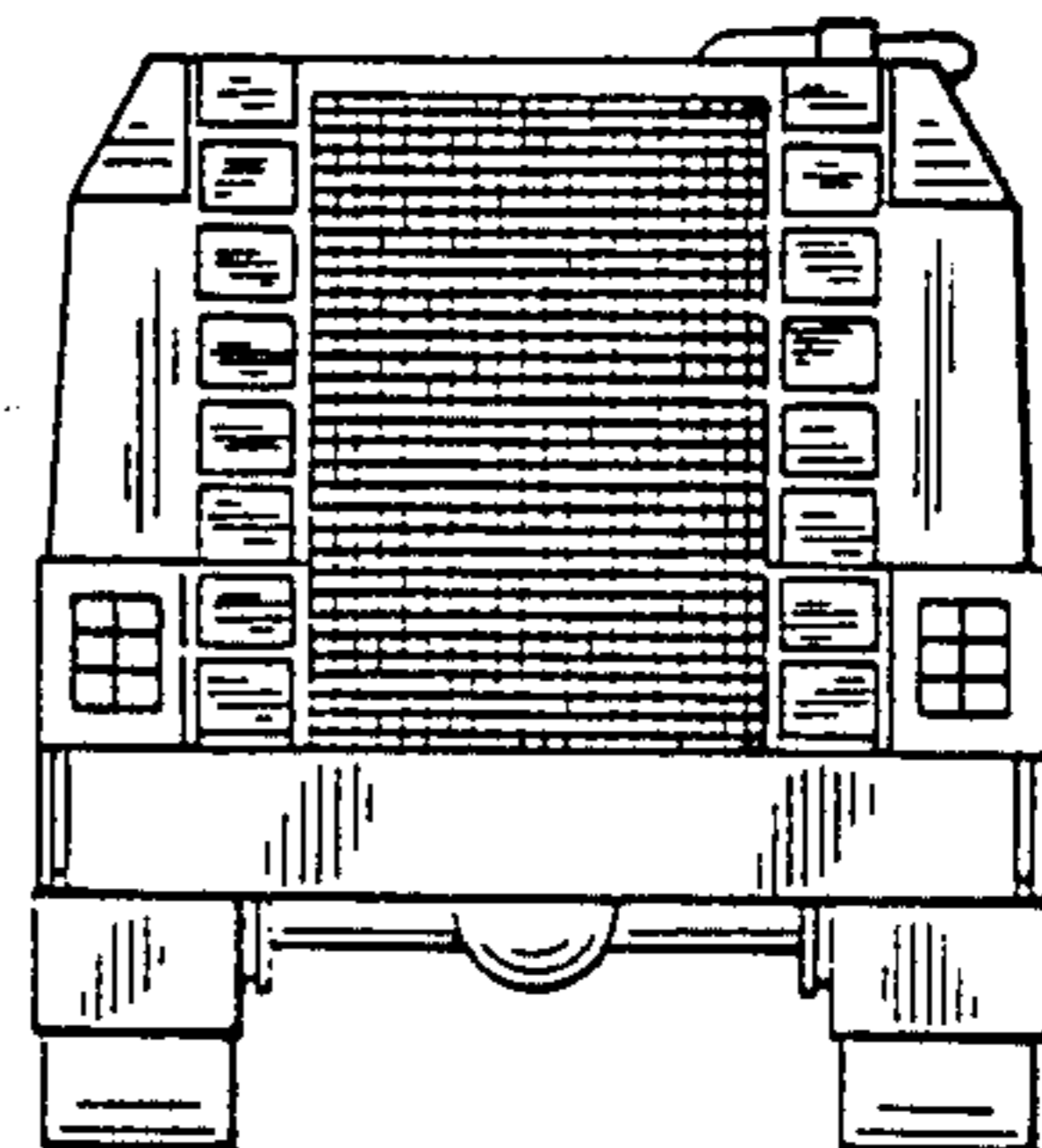
